DESCRIPTION

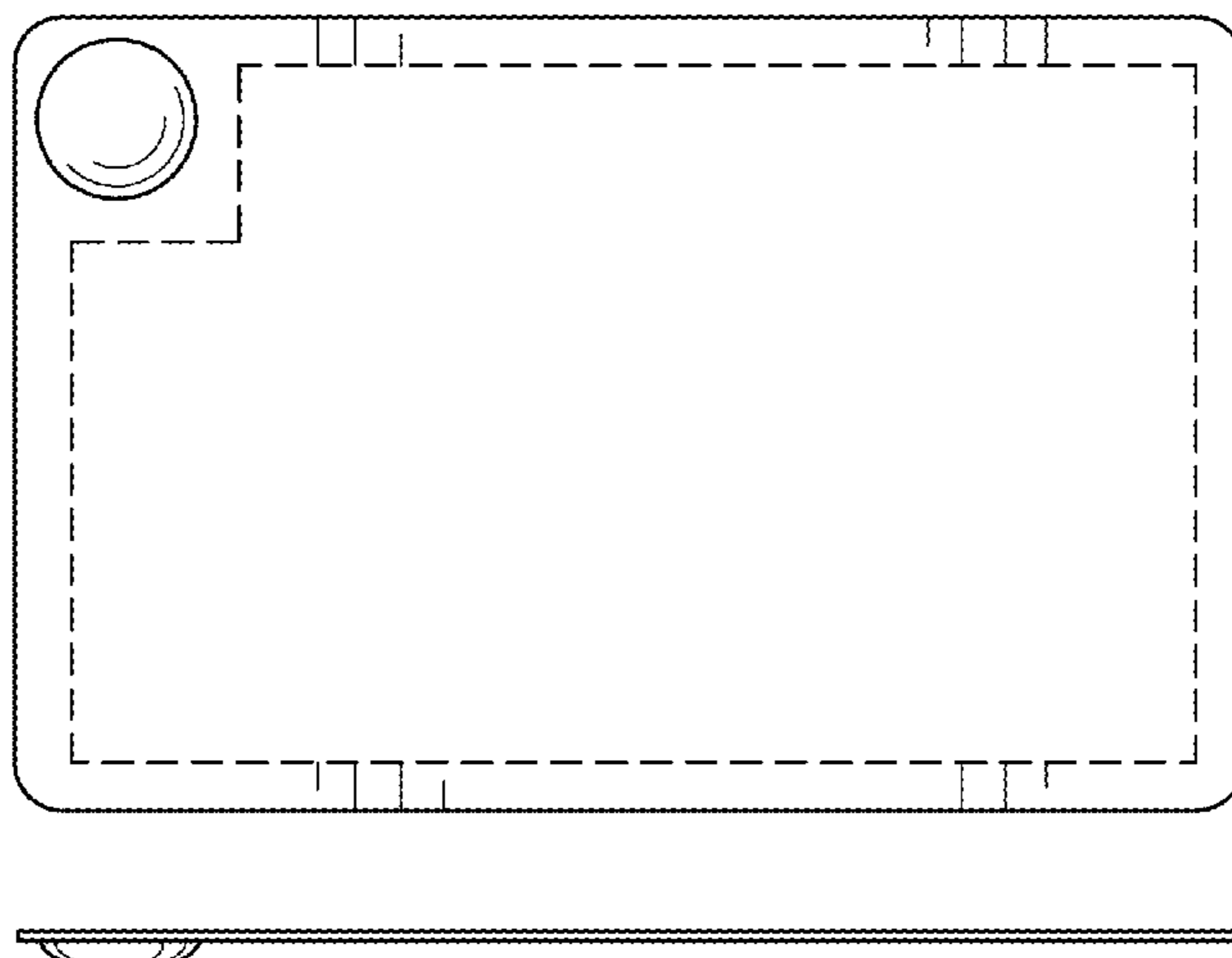
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a pill card according to my design.

 FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof.
 The broken lines that abut a claimed surface represent an unclaimed boundary between claimed and unclaimed surfaces. None of the broken lines form any part of the claimed design.

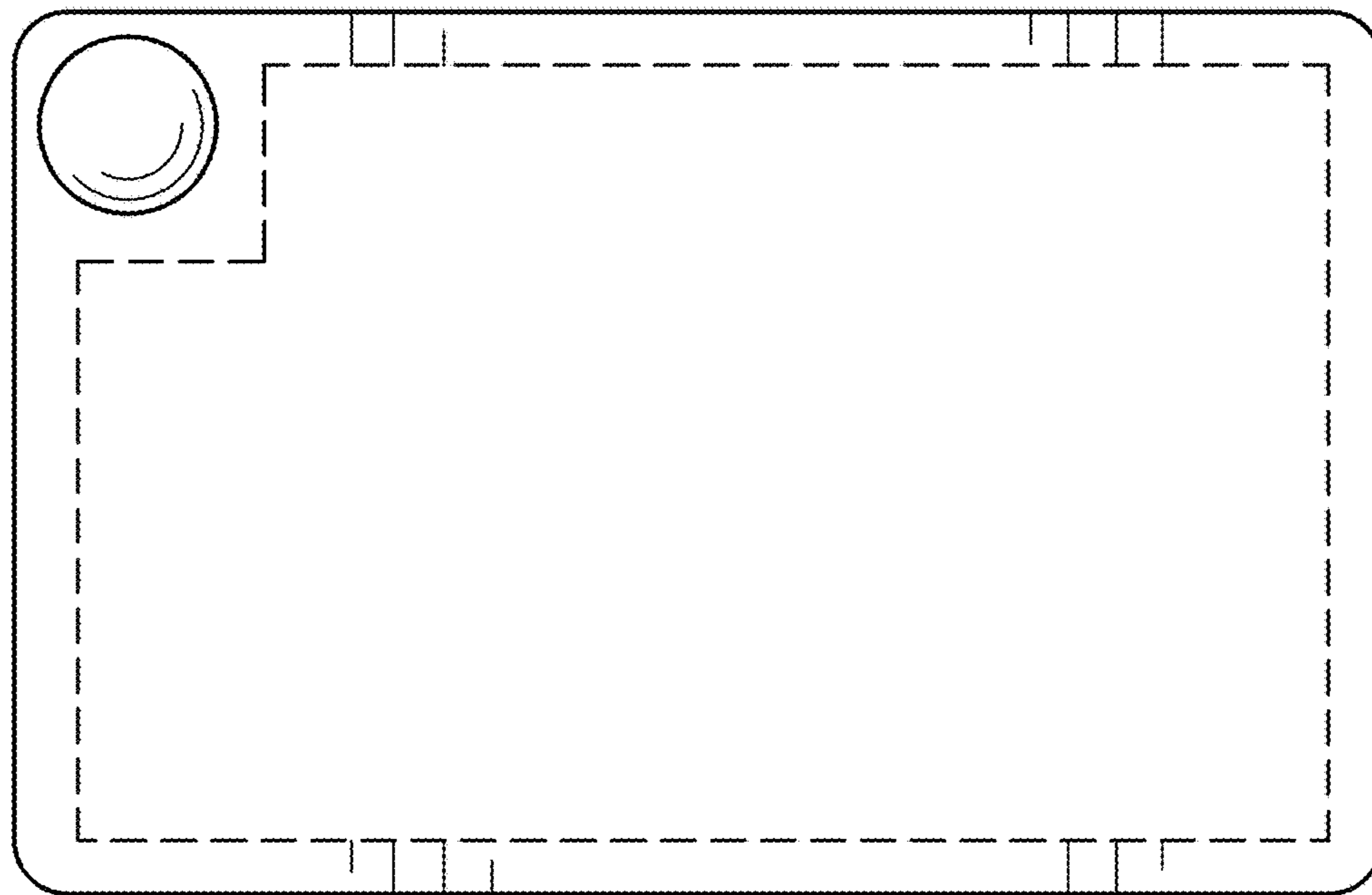

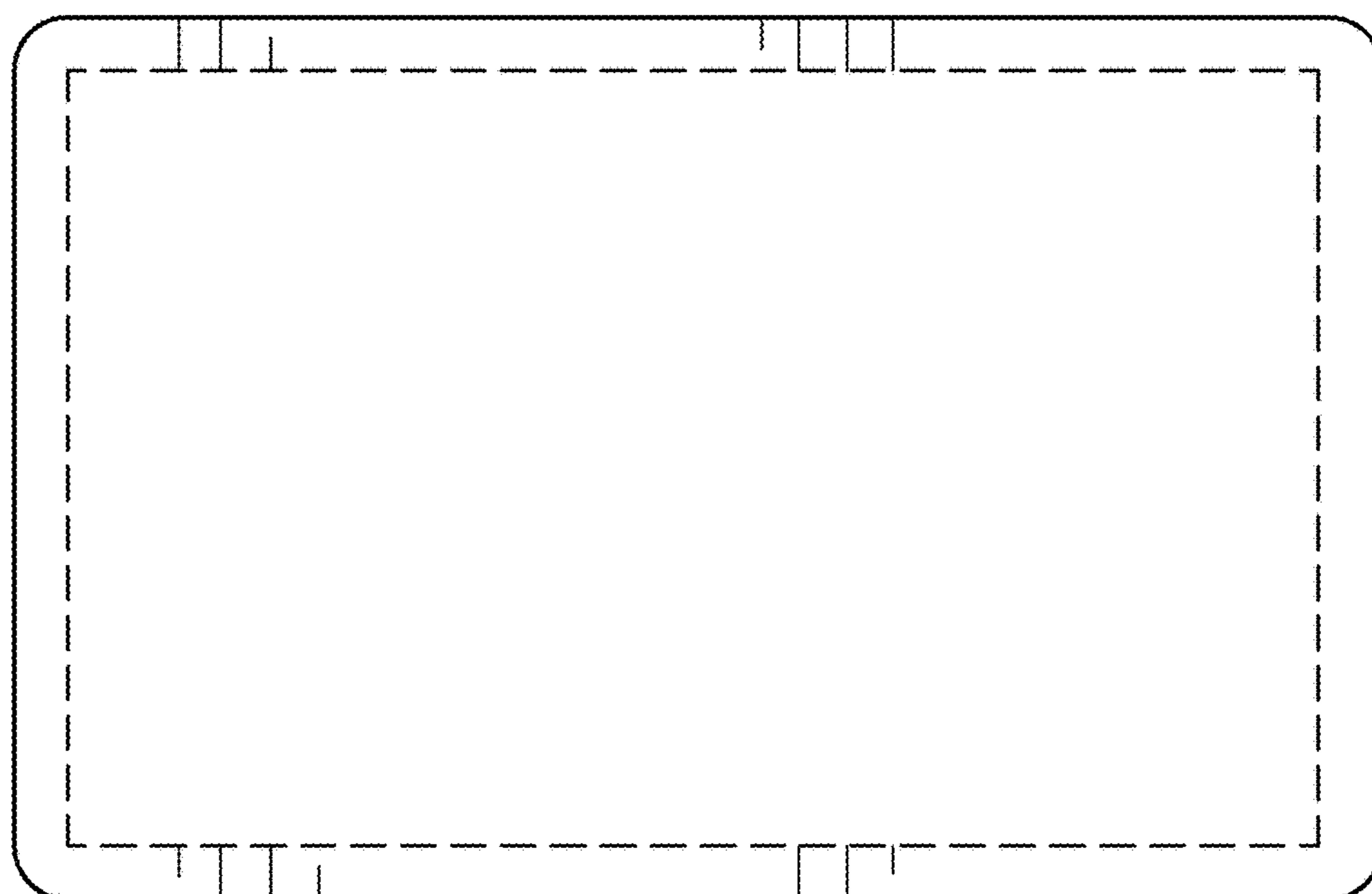

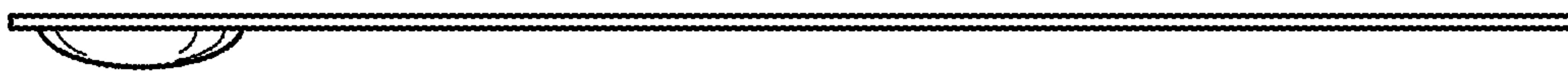
