(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a drill caddy, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a drill caddy in a locked position.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of a drill caddy in a locked position, the left side elevation view being a mirror image. The dot-dot-dash line depicting an outline of a slat wall represent environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design. Additionally, the uniformly short dashed lines depicting a tab protruding from the drill caddy form no part of the claimed design.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of a drill caddy.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of a drill caddy. The uniformly short dashed lines depicting a tab protruding from the drill caddy form no part of the claimed design.

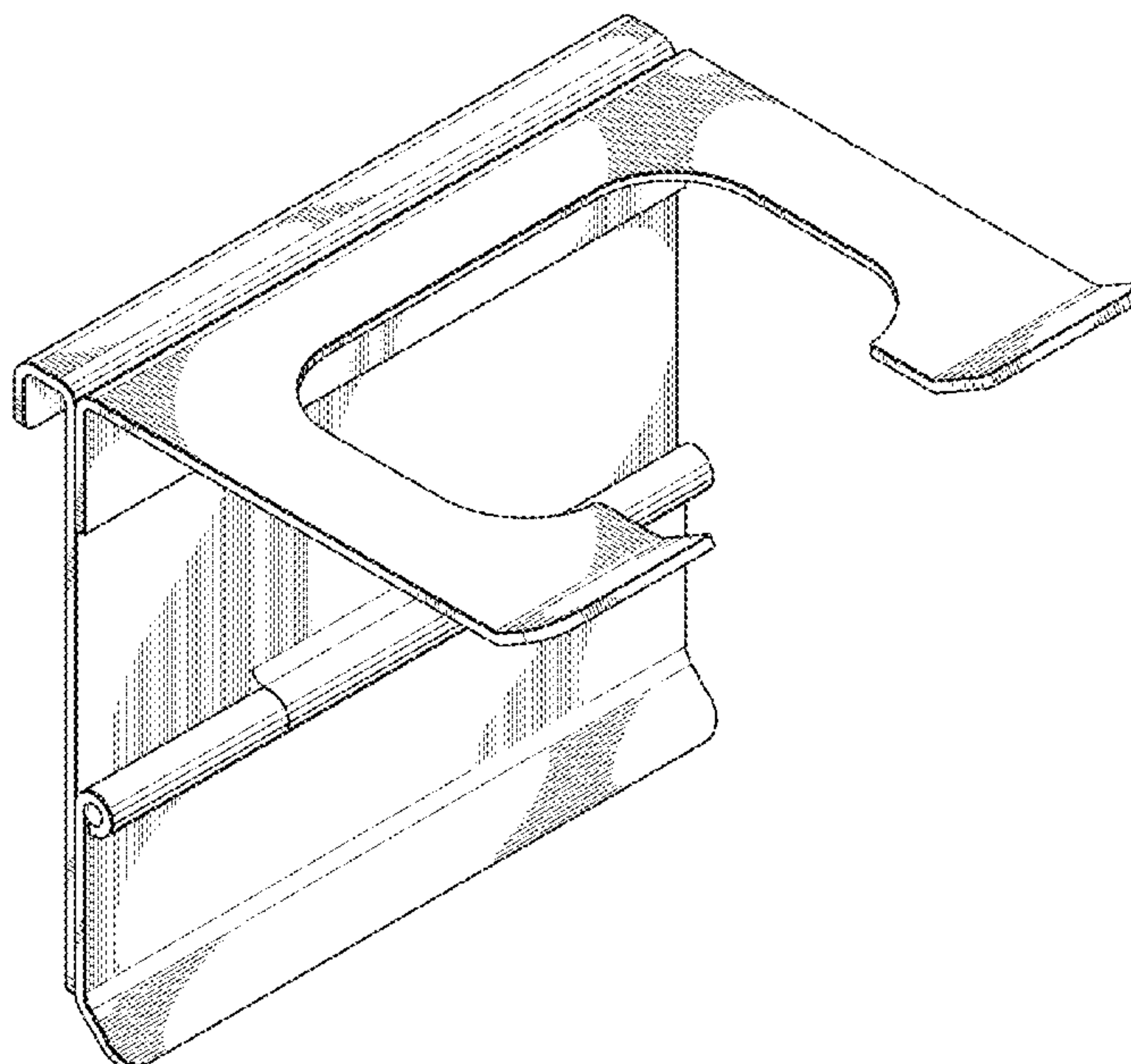
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a drill caddy.

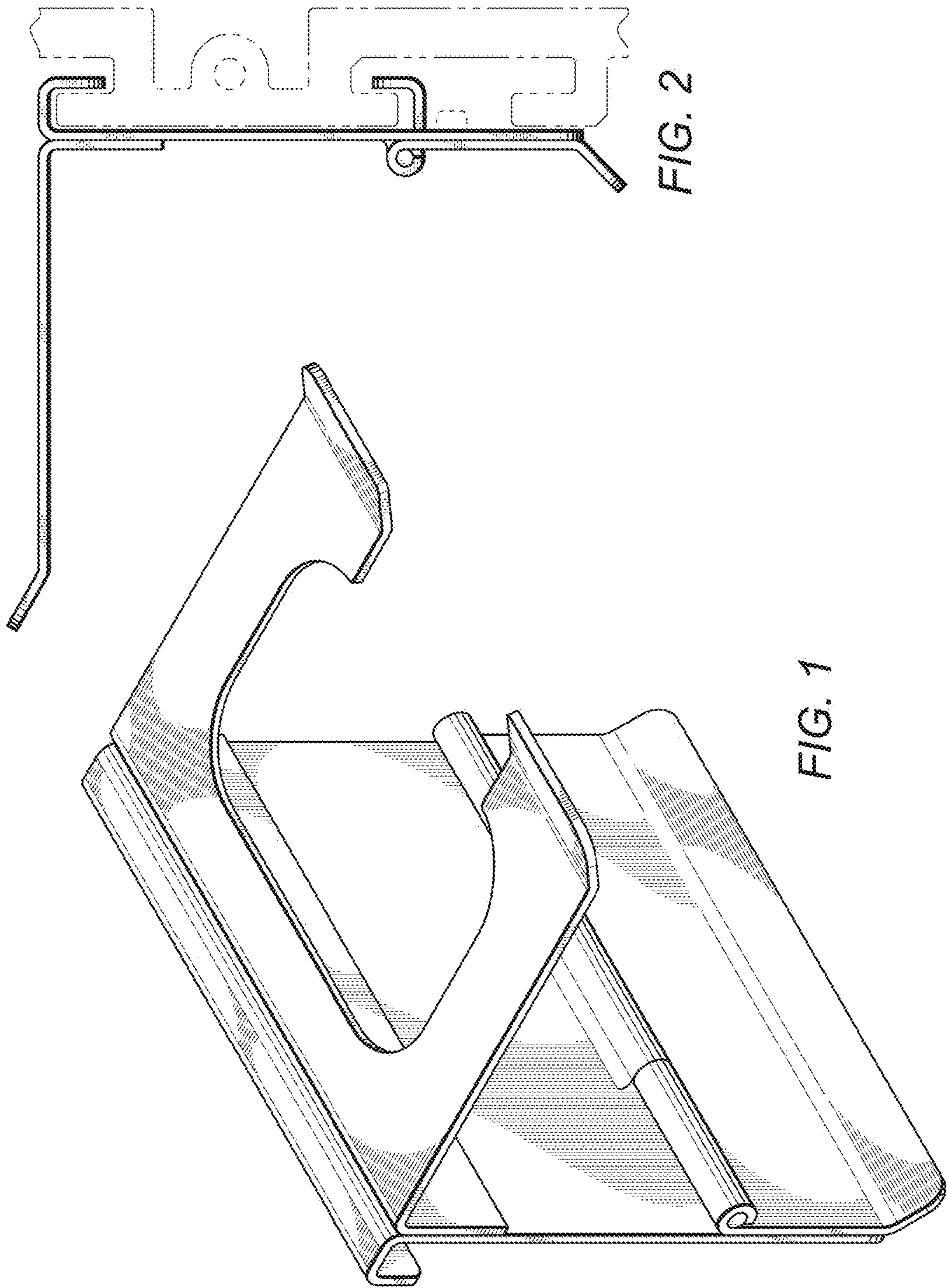
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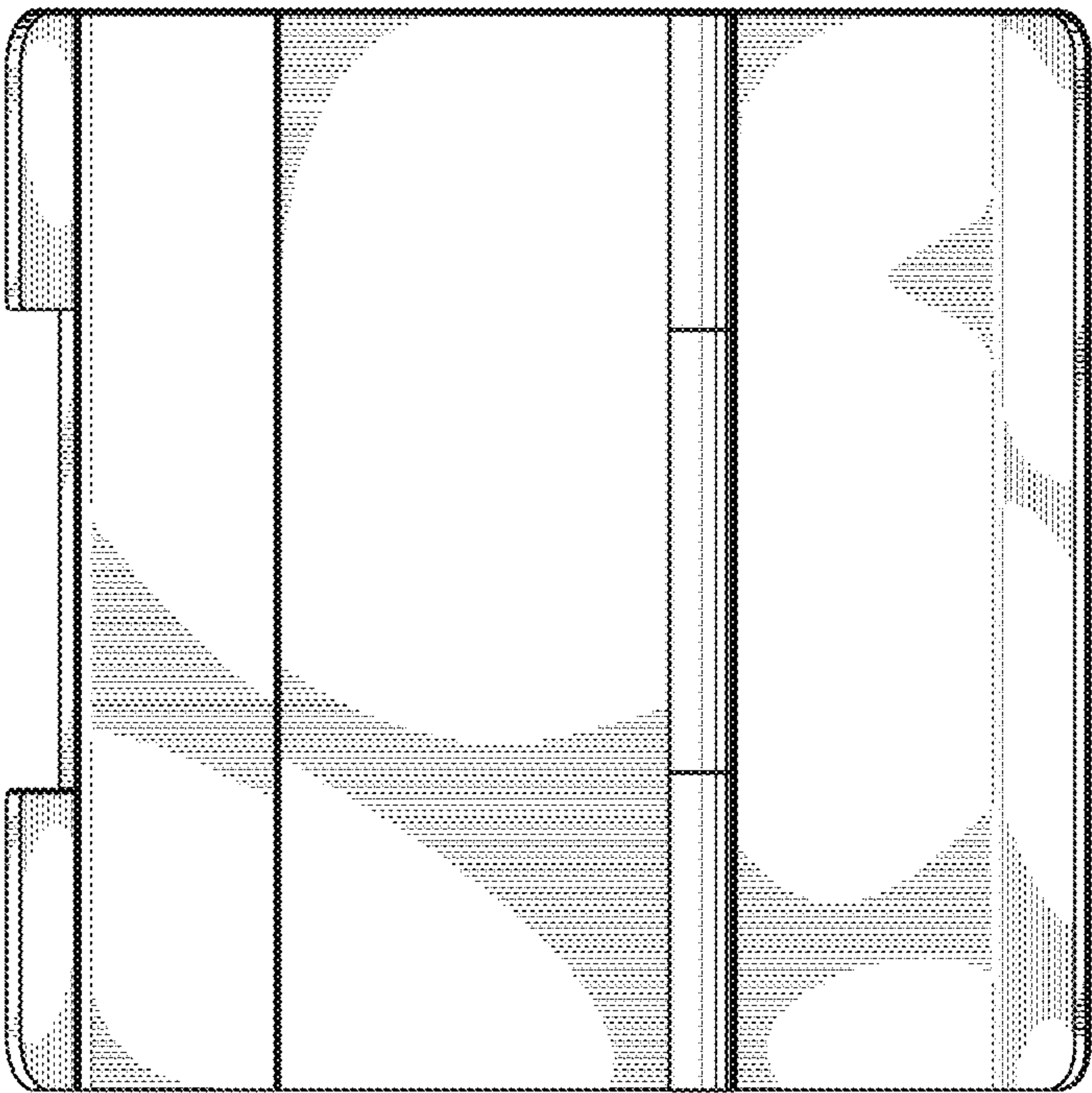

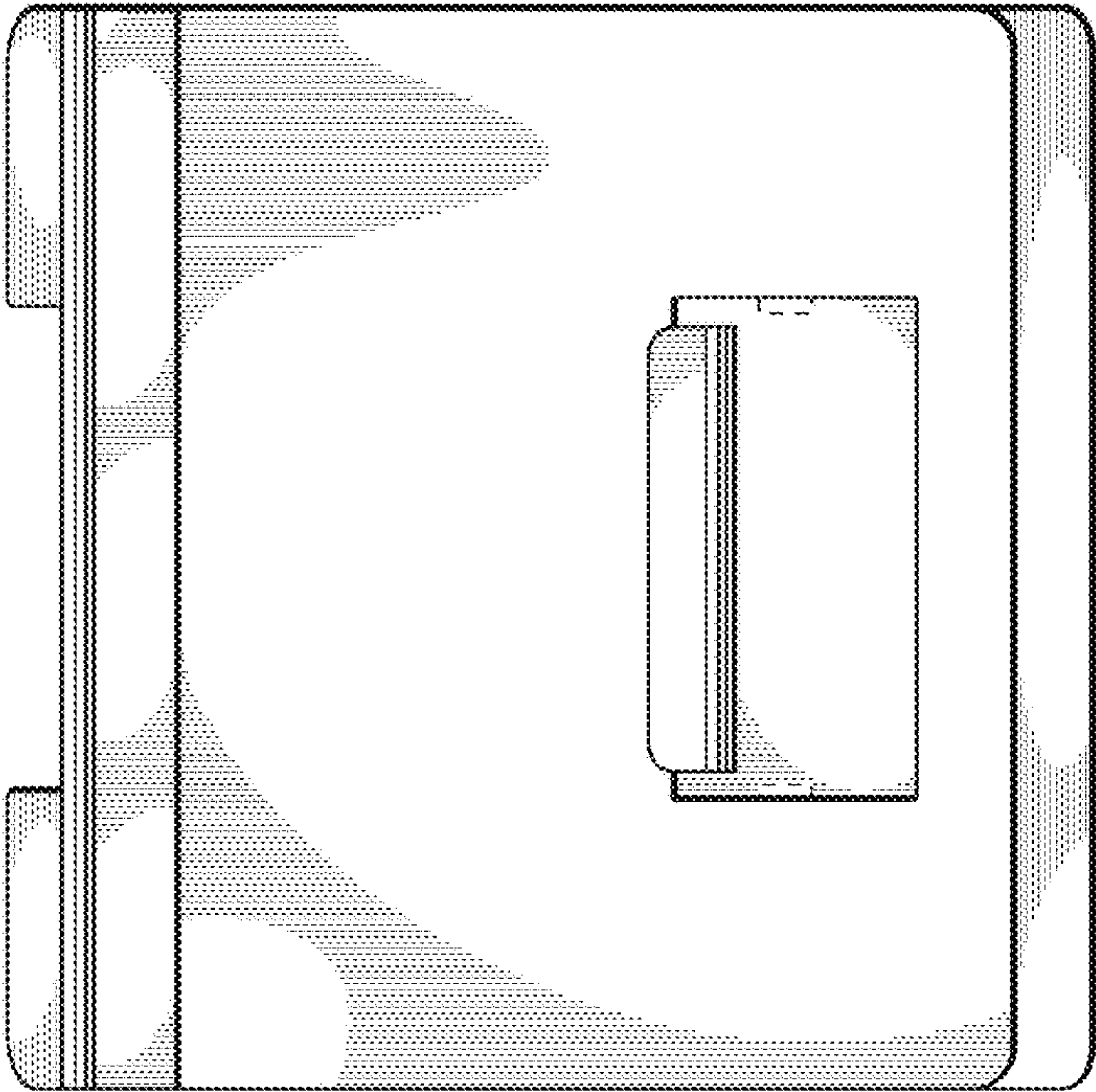

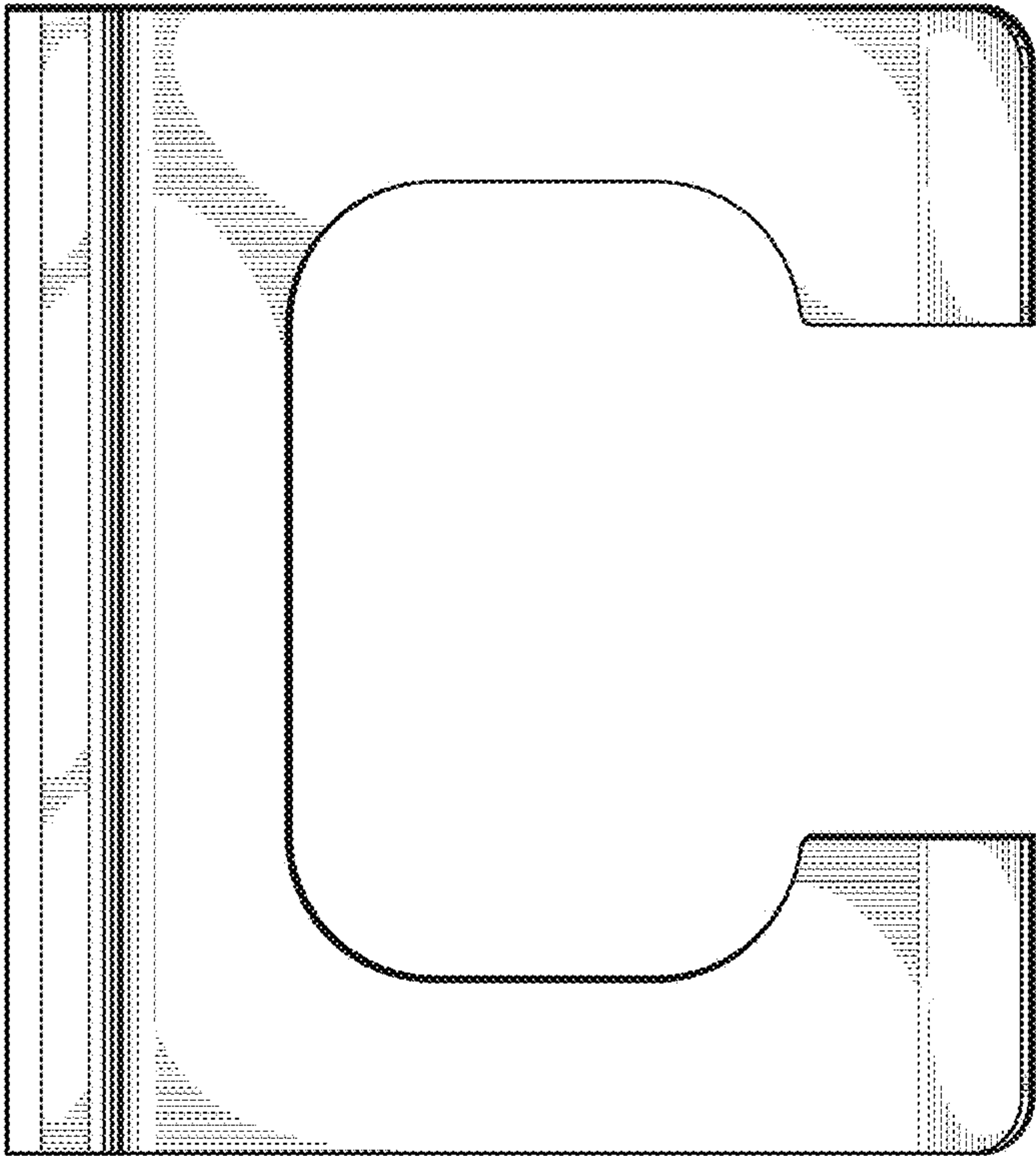

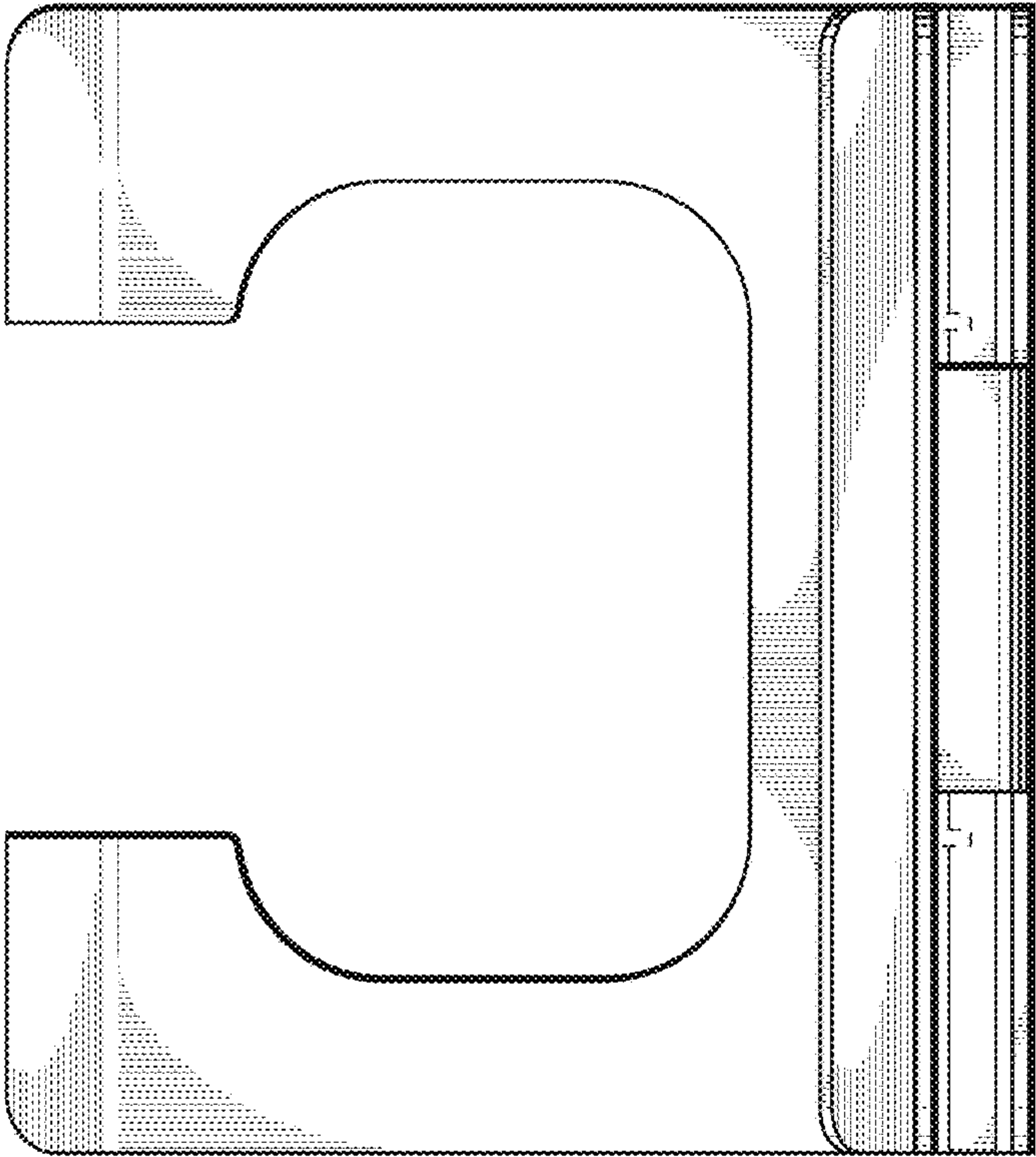

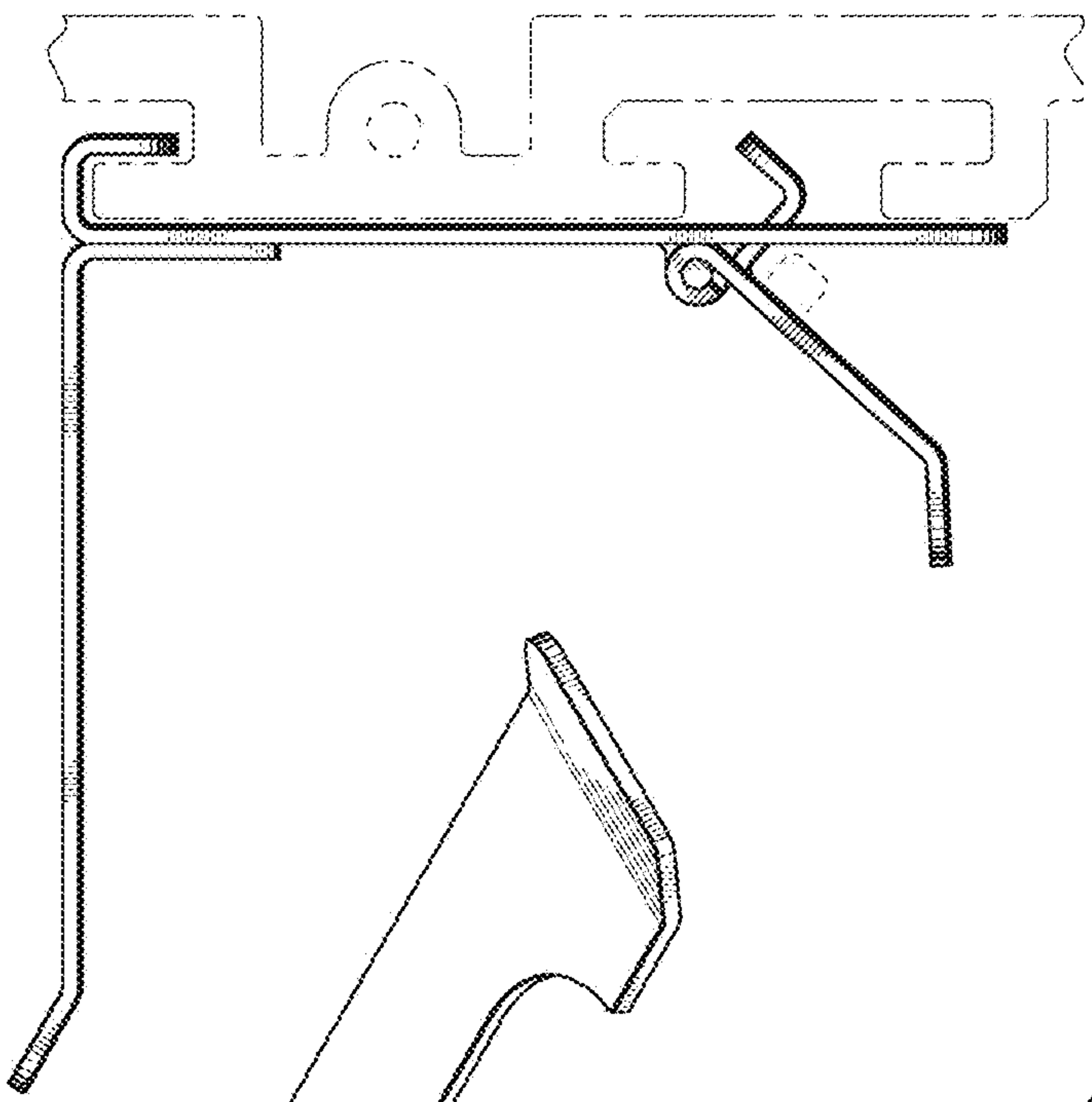

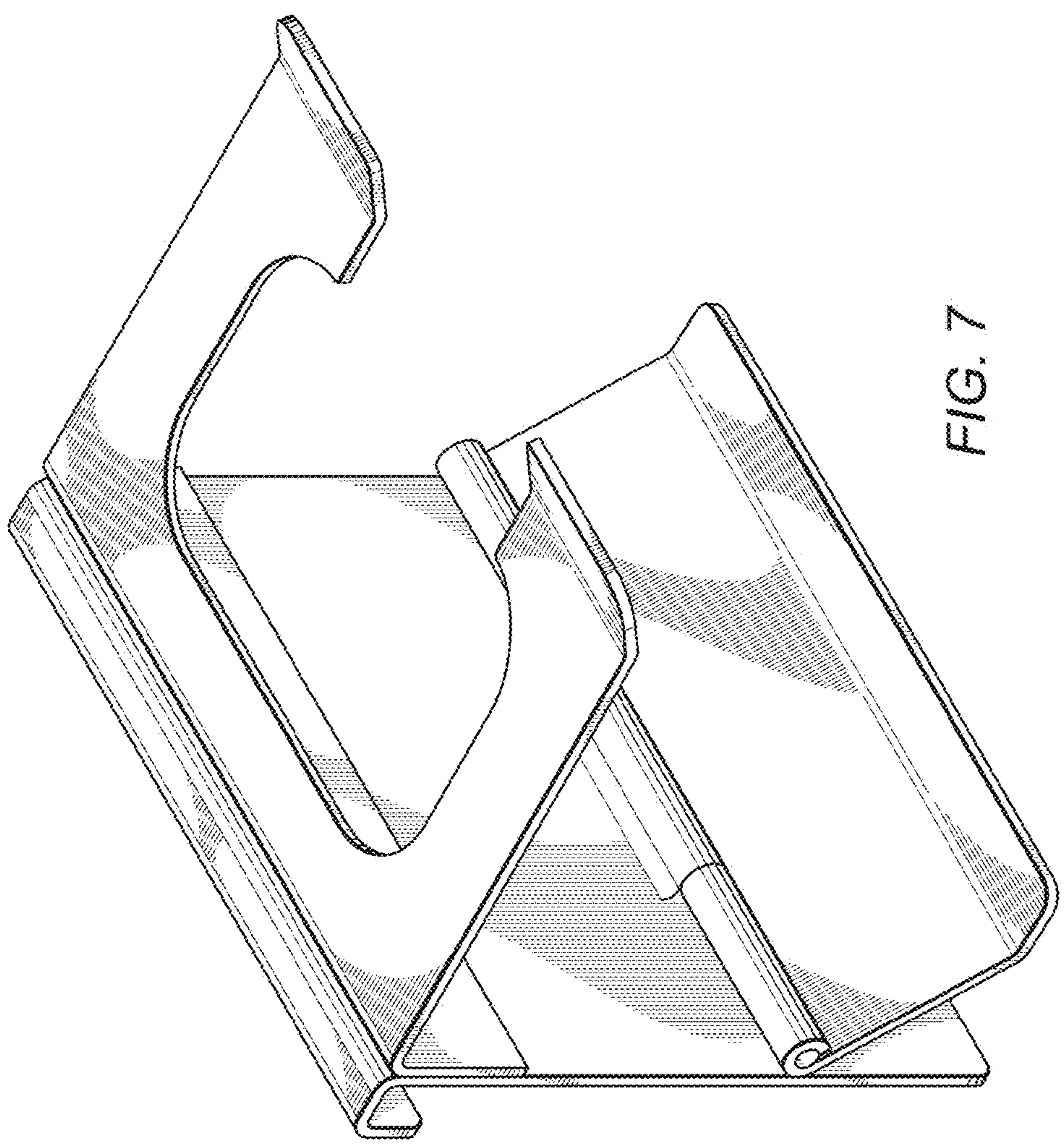
