FIG. 1;

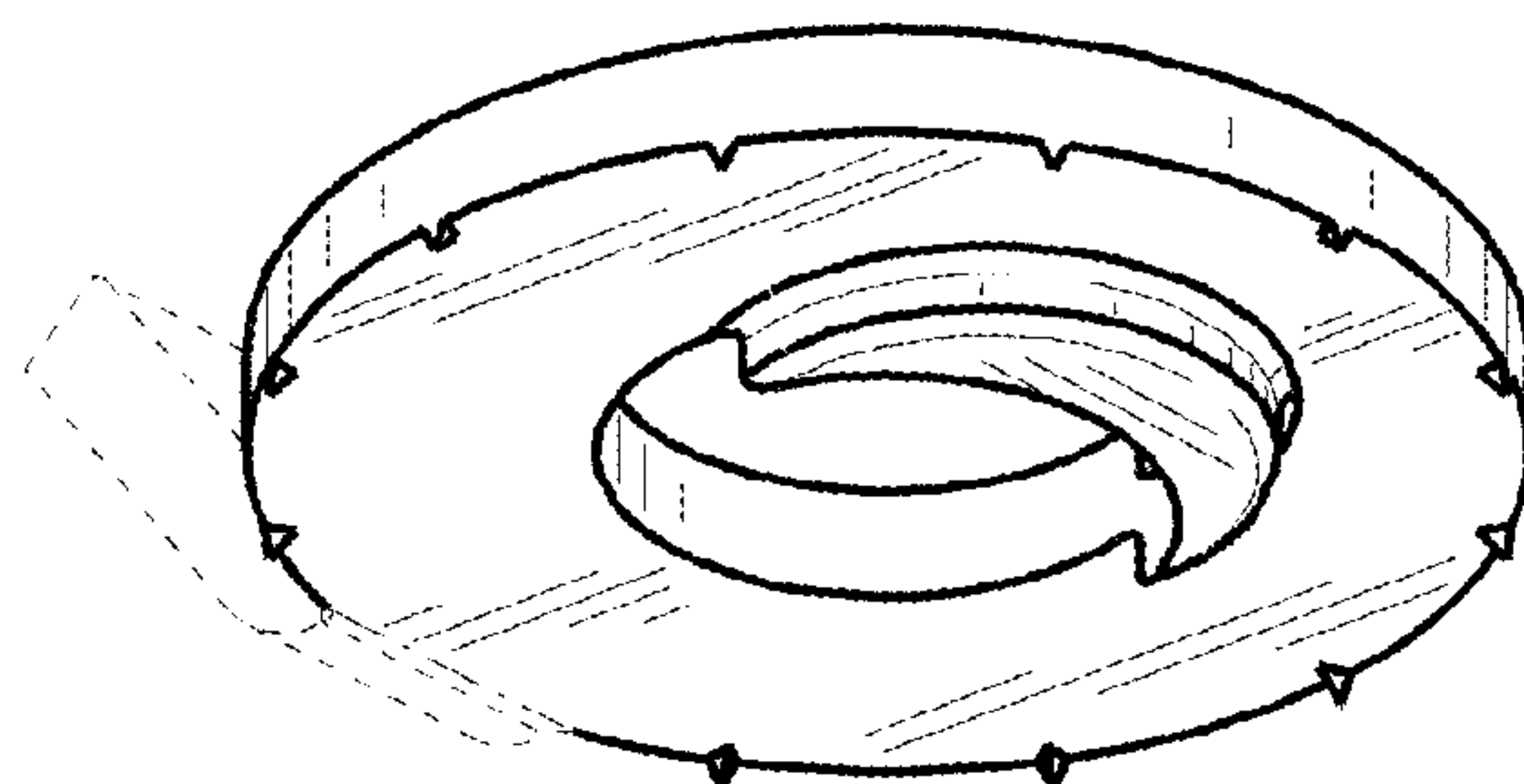
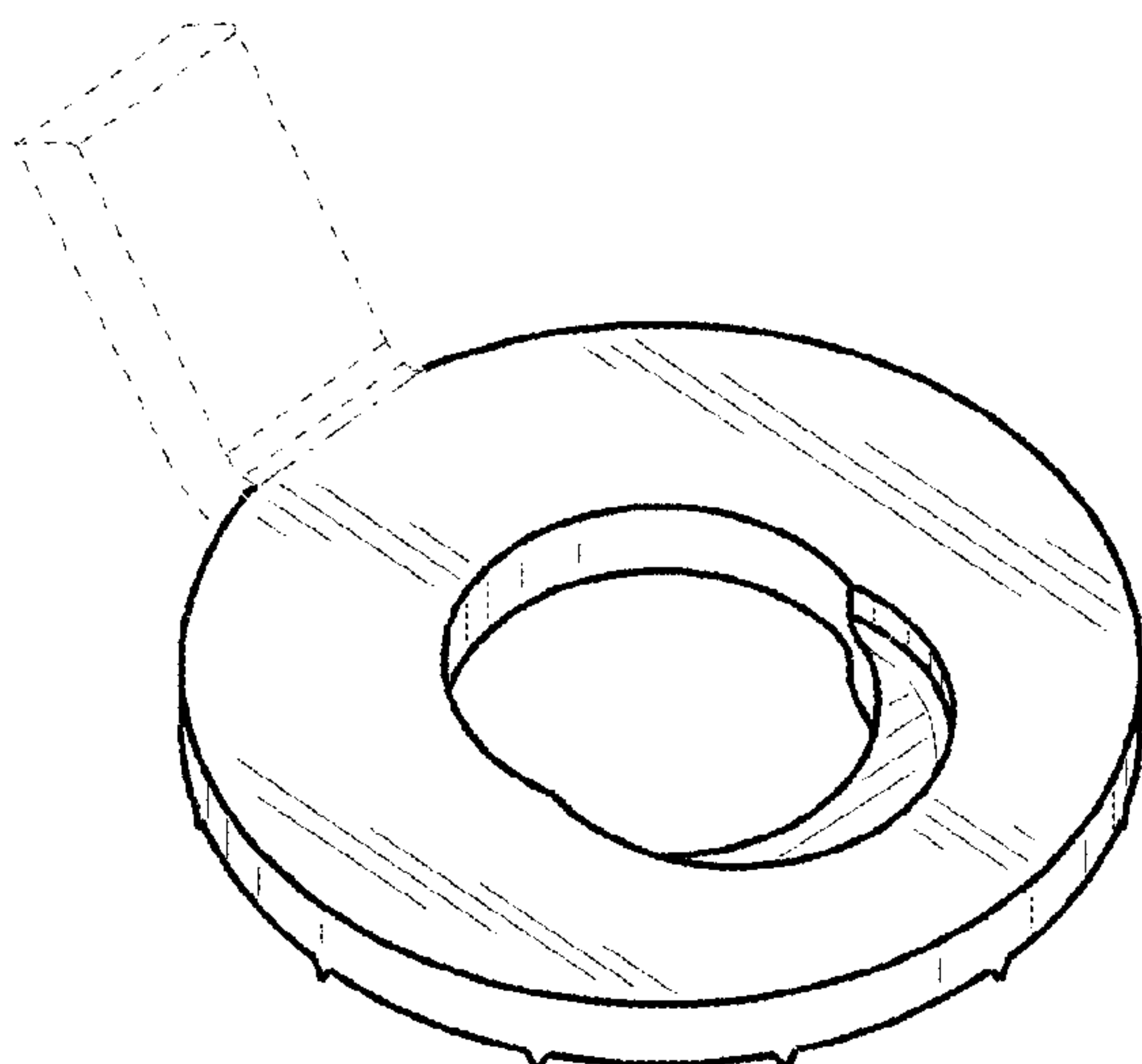
FIG. 6 shows a right elevation view of the offset washer of

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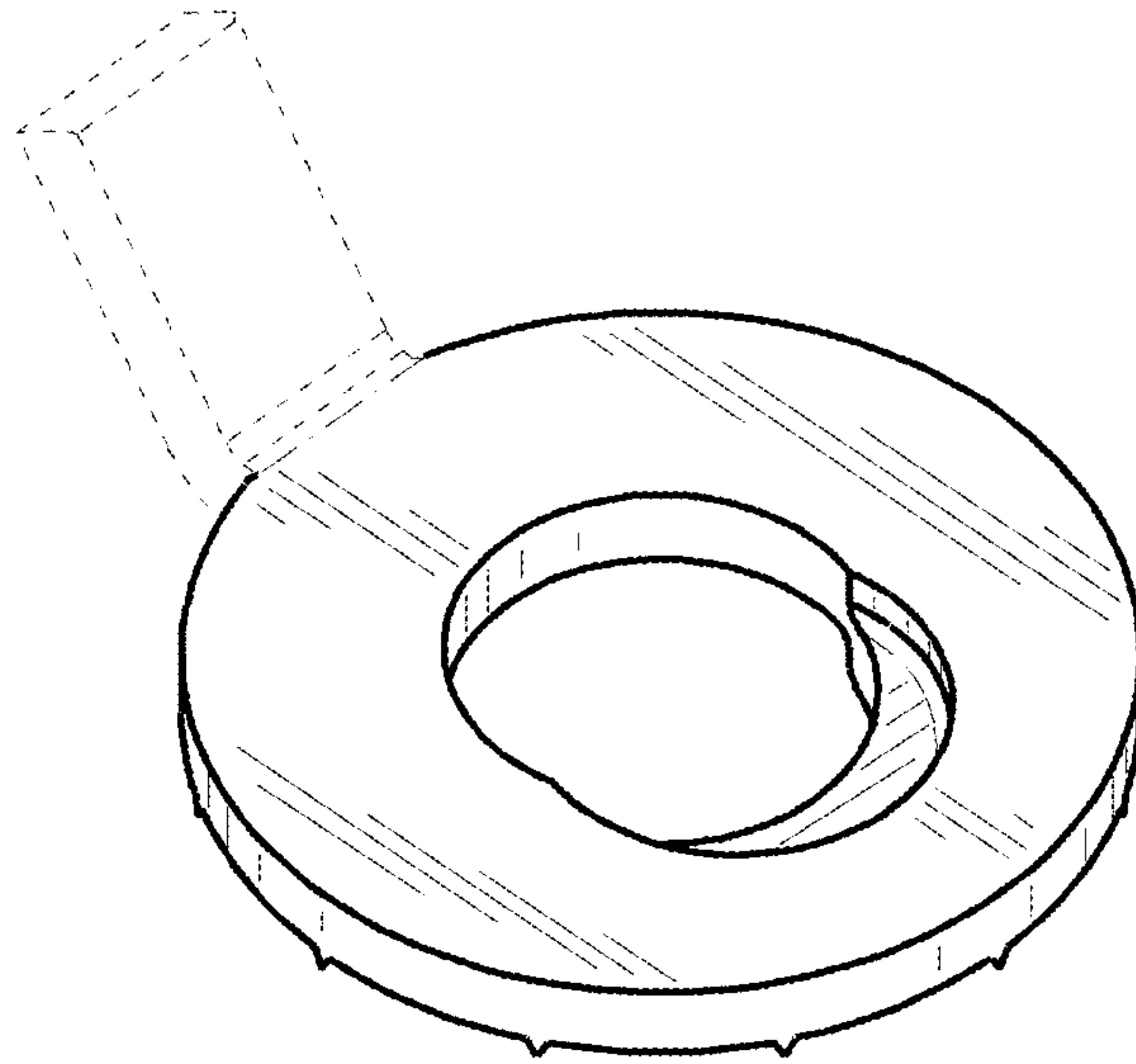

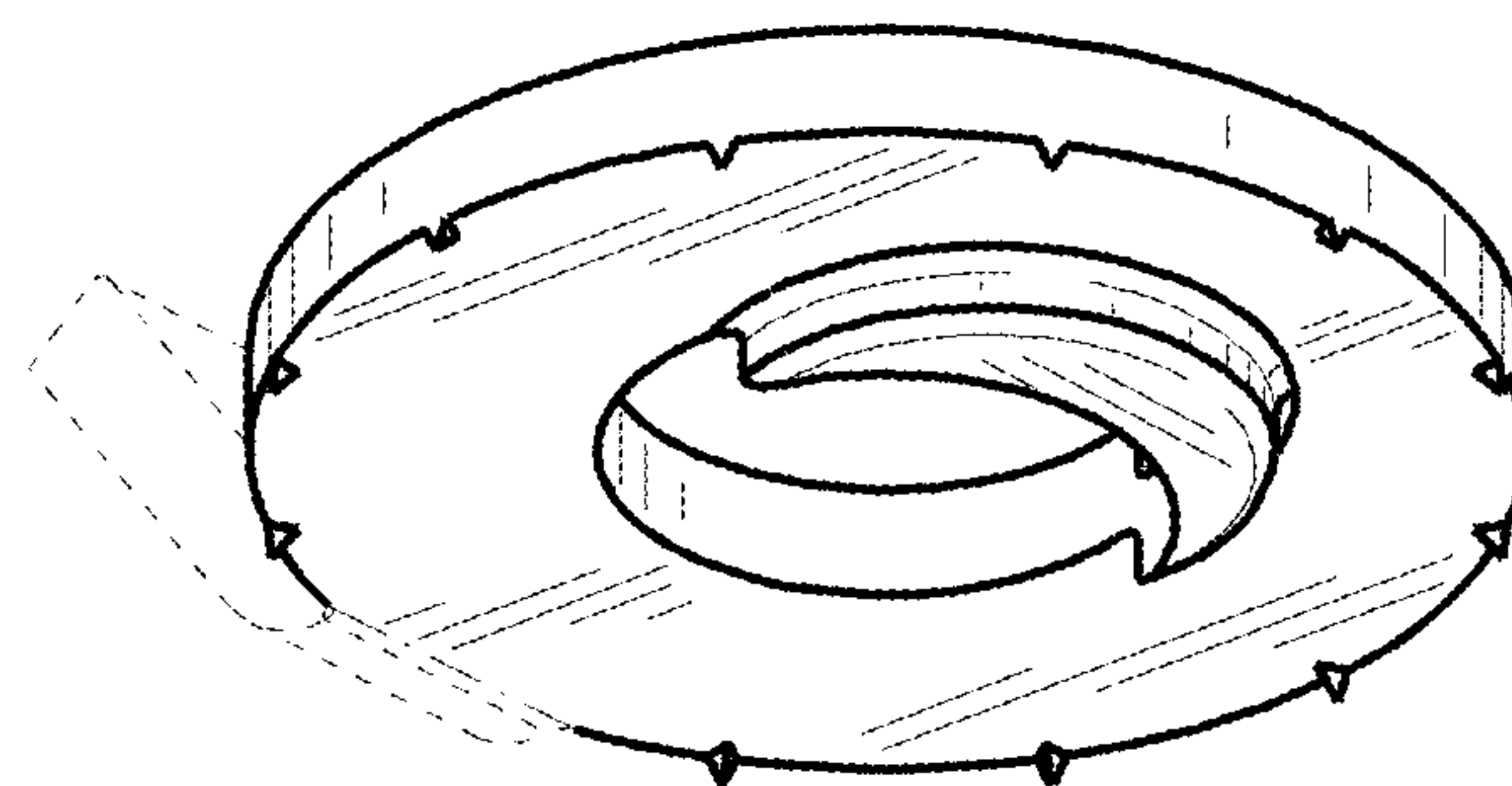

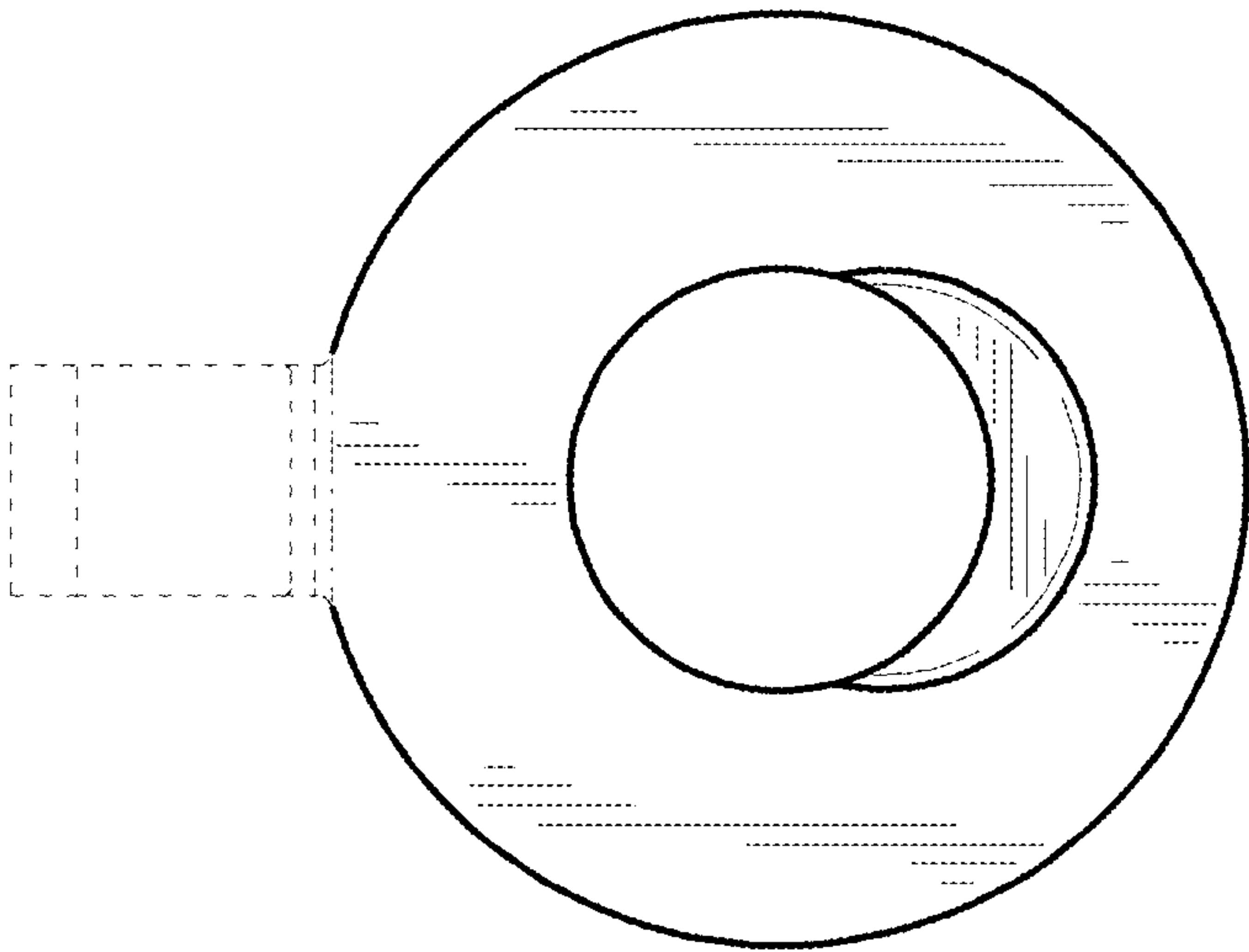

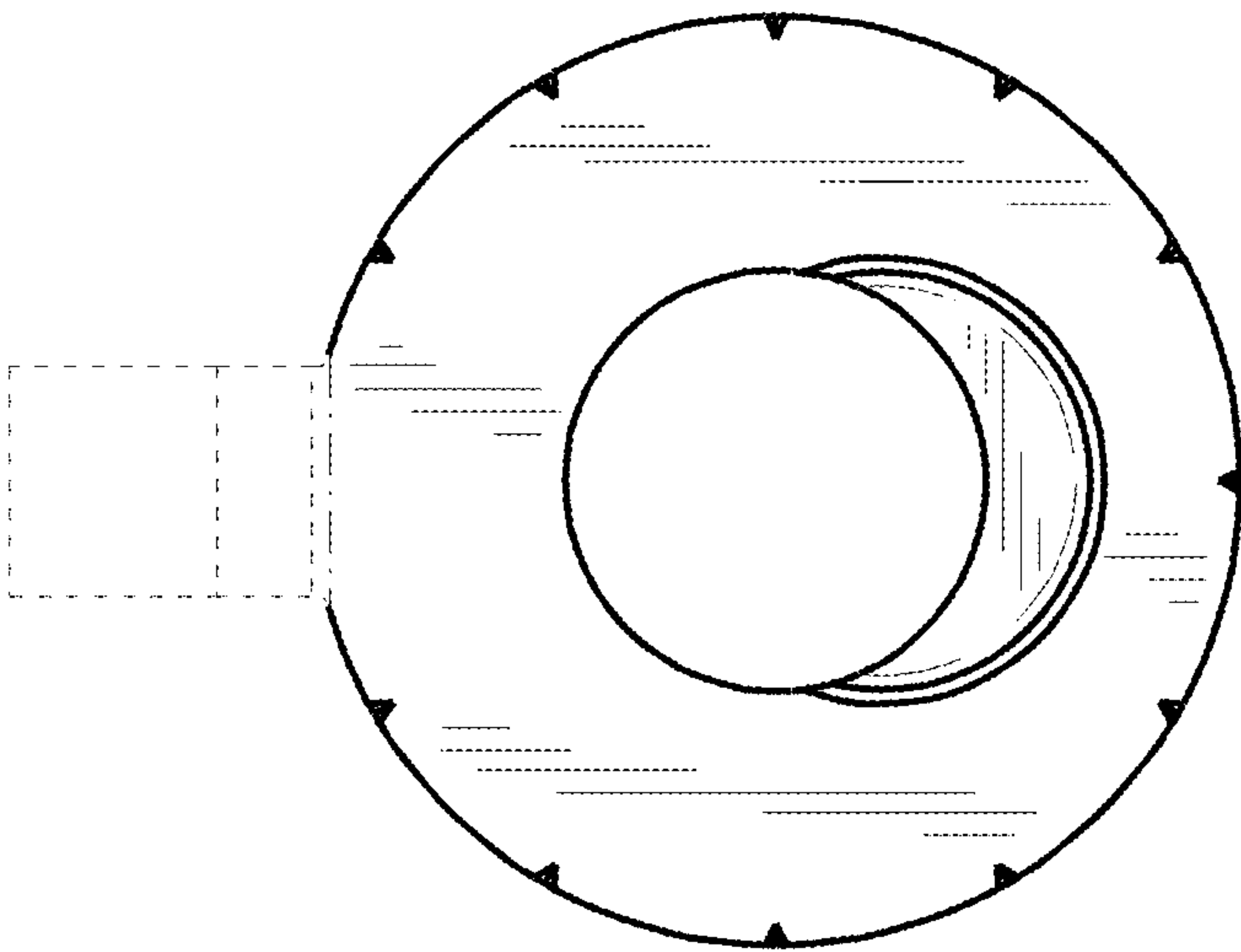

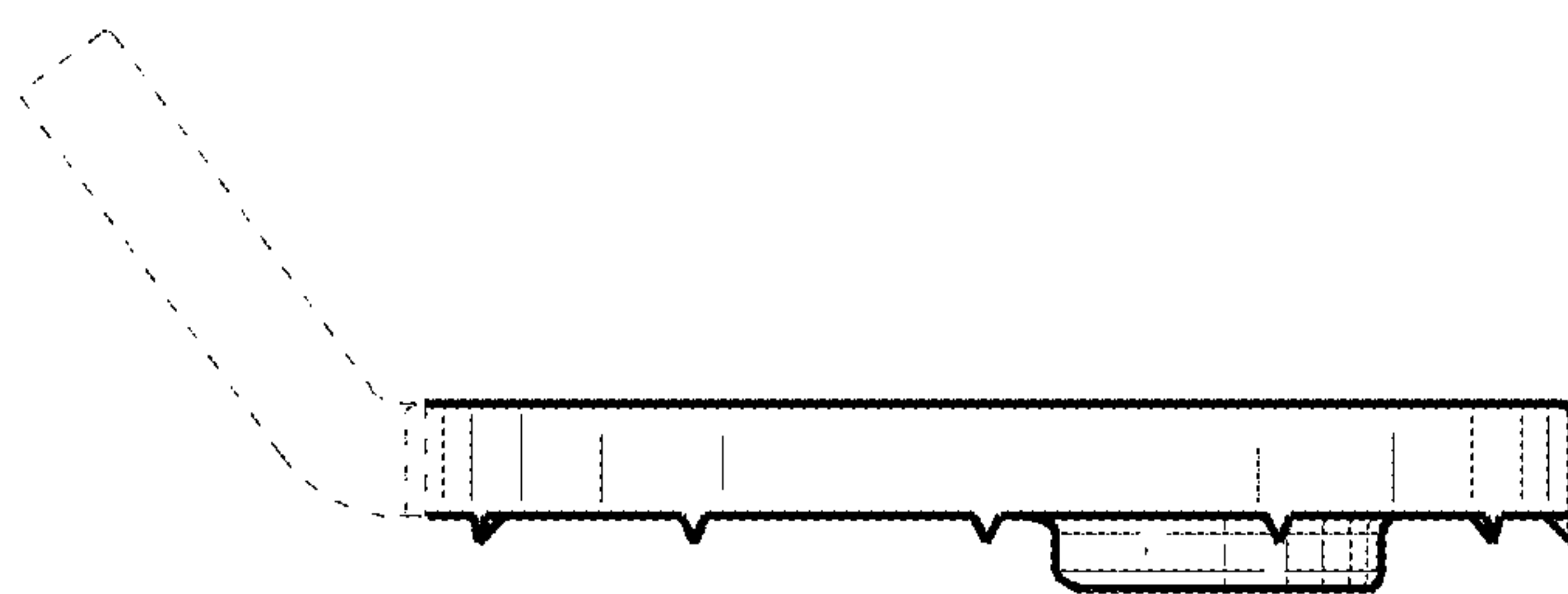

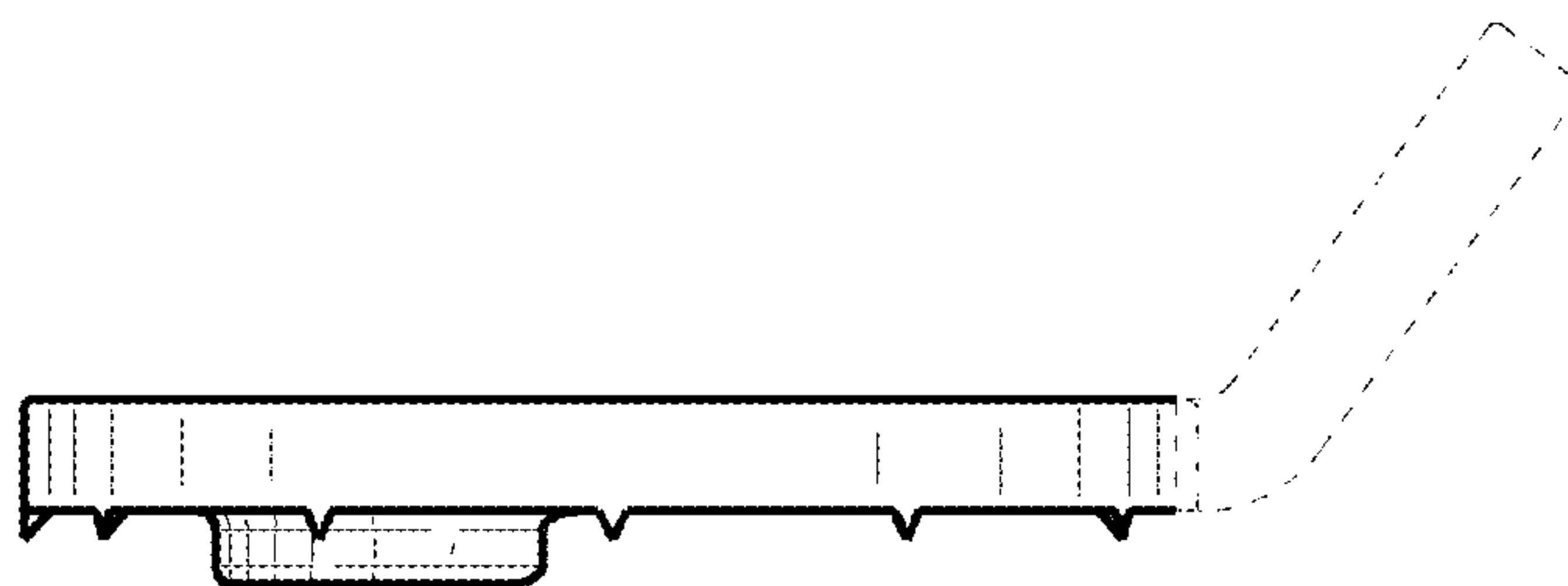

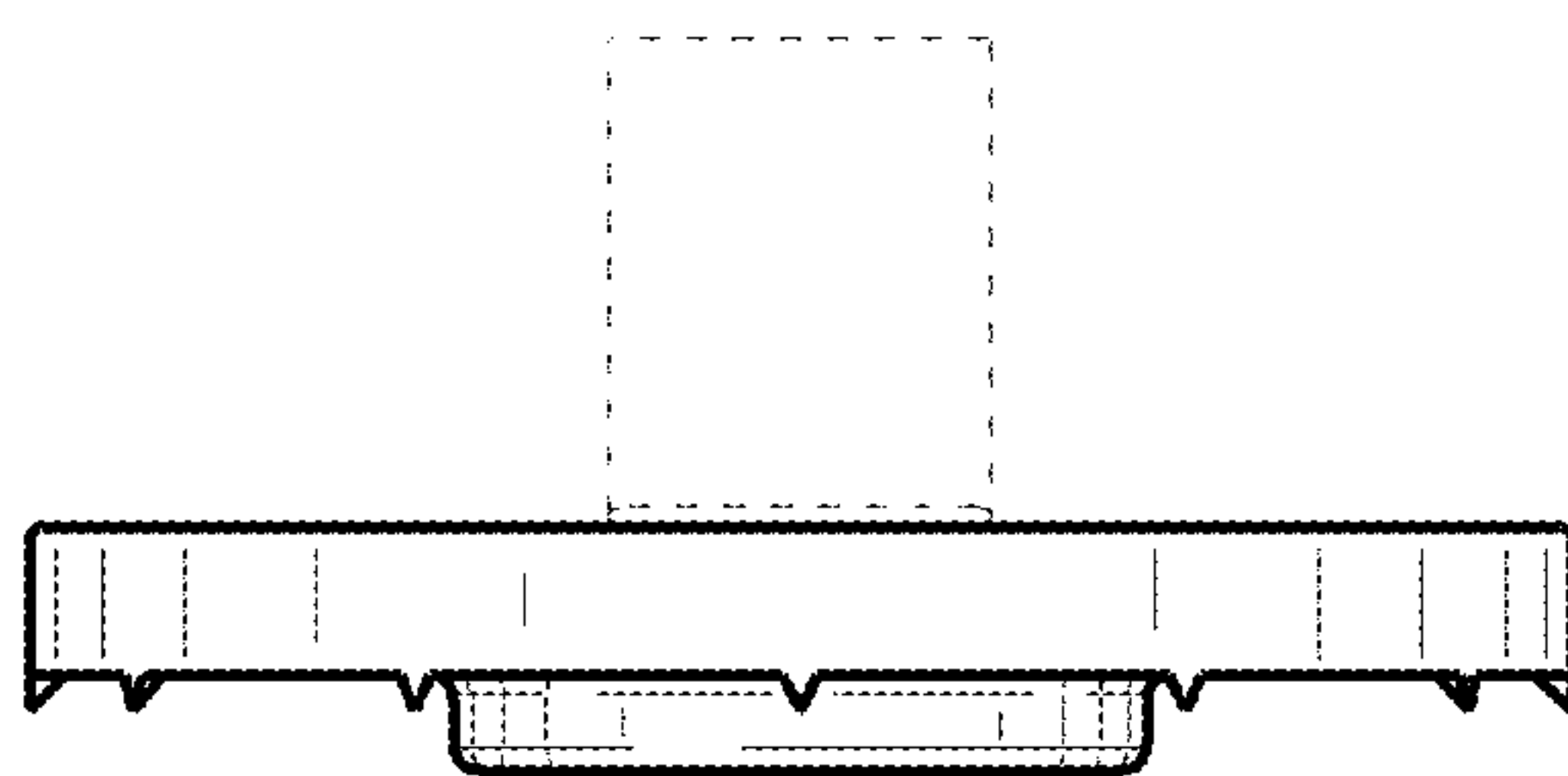

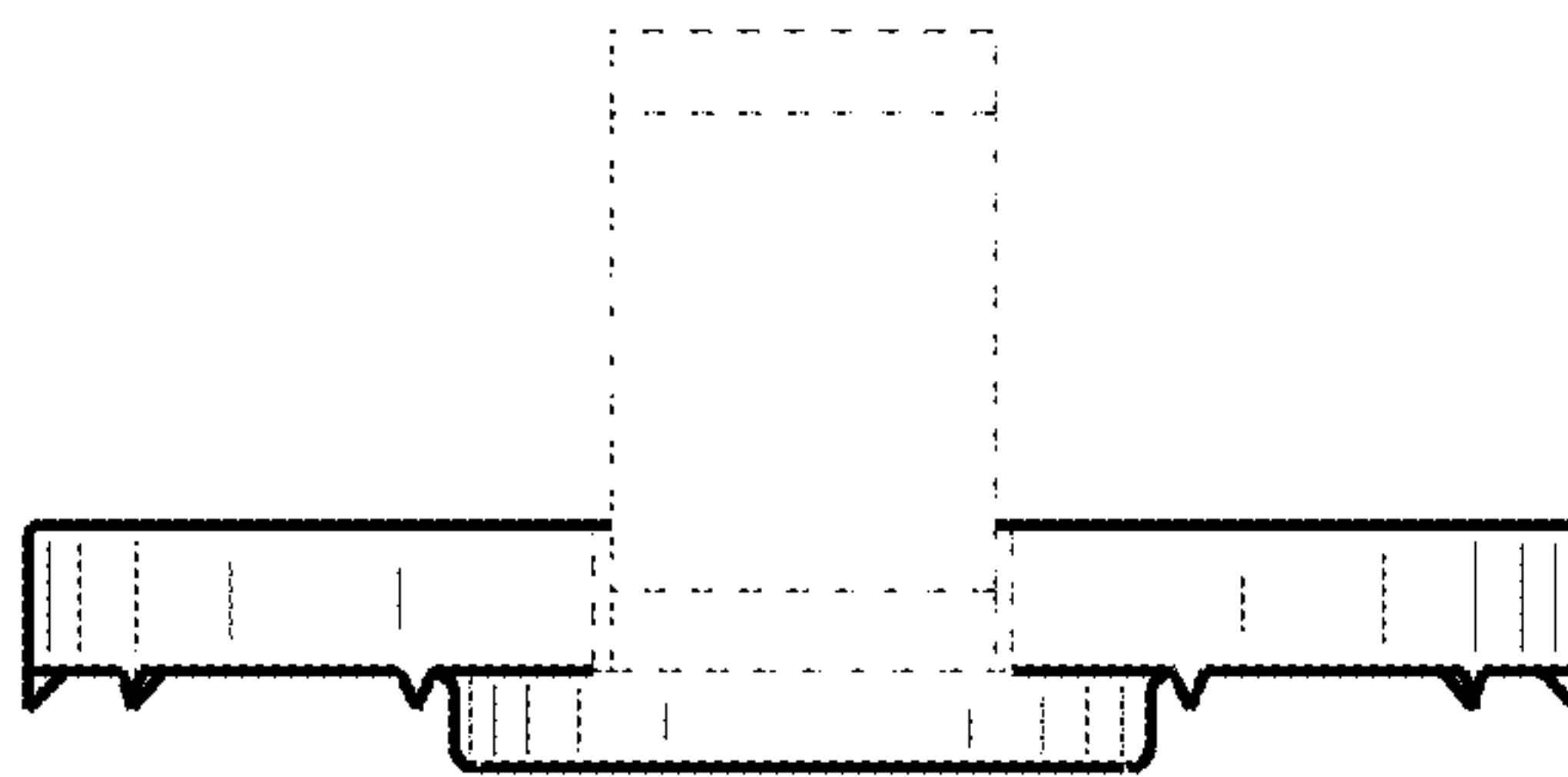
