DESCRIPTION

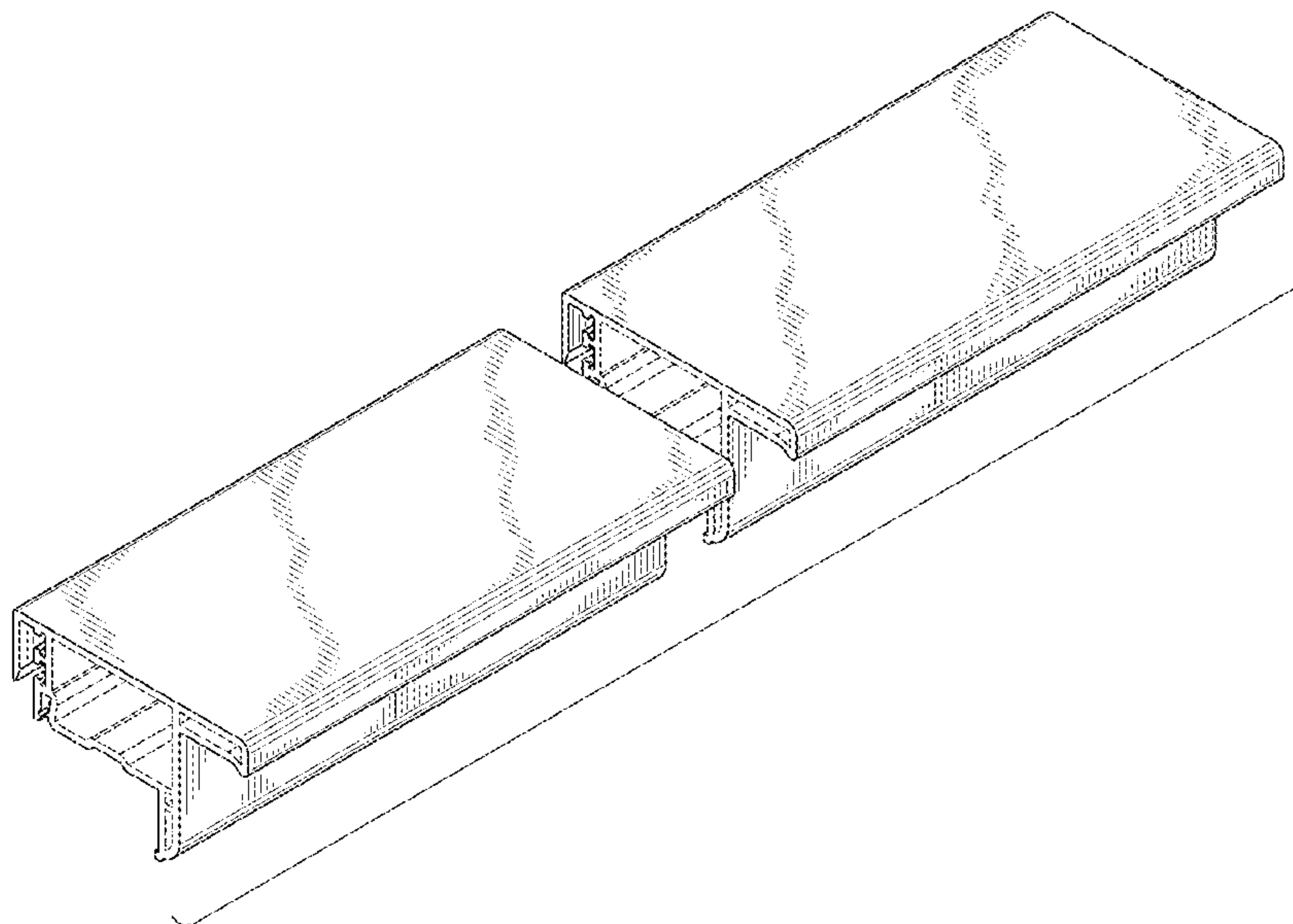
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a window sash extrusion

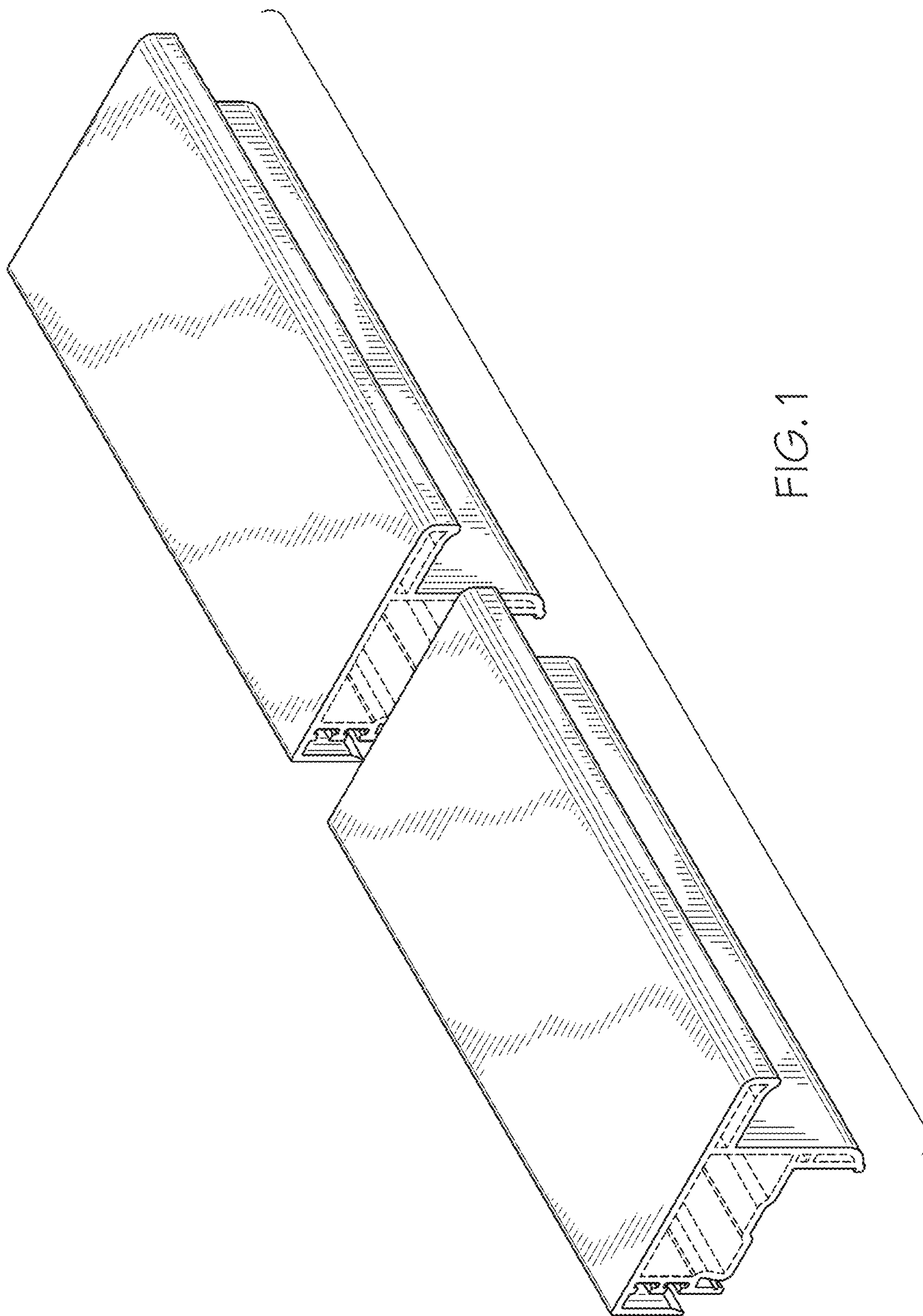
