and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a smart phone, showing my
new design;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

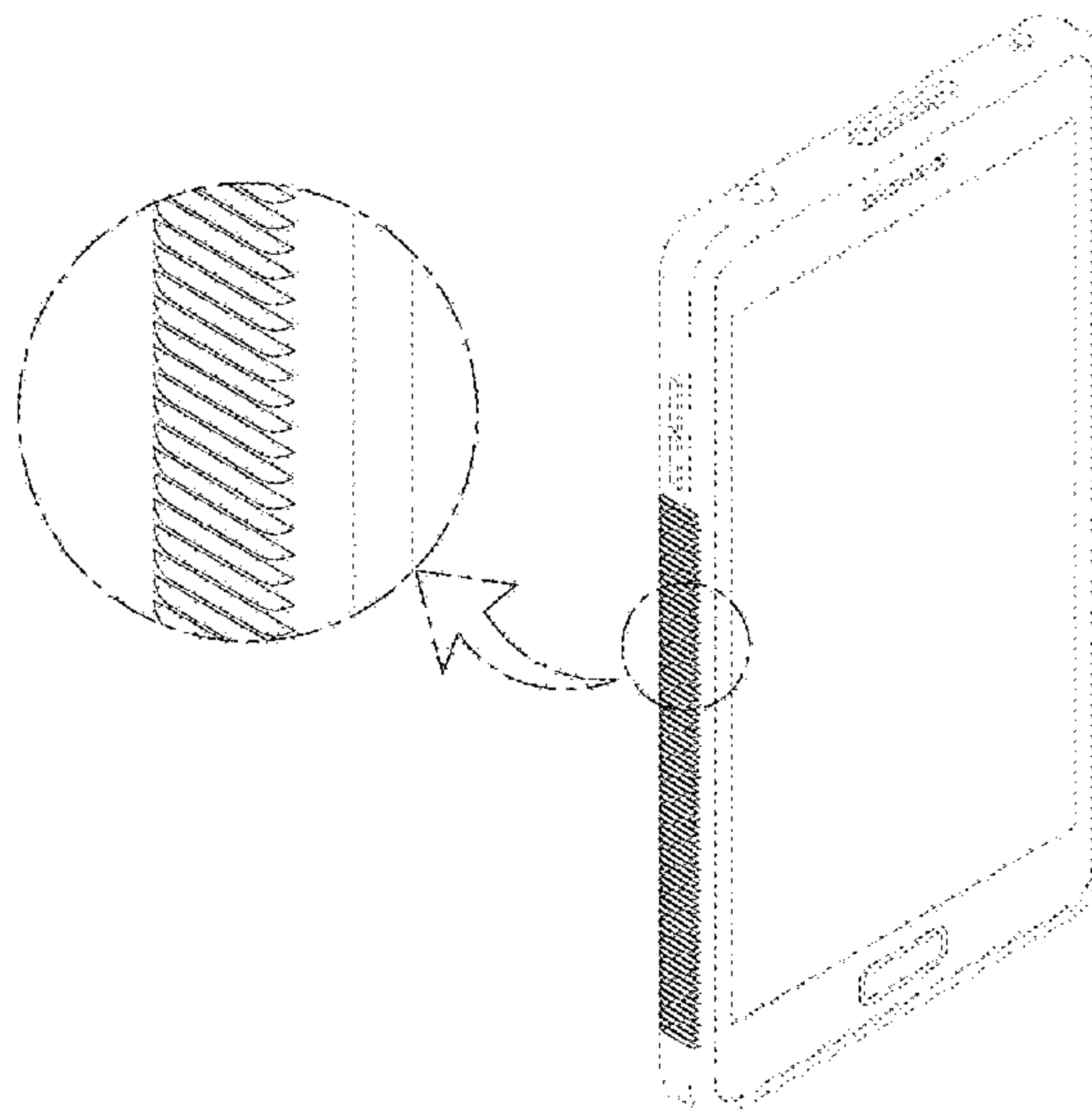
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

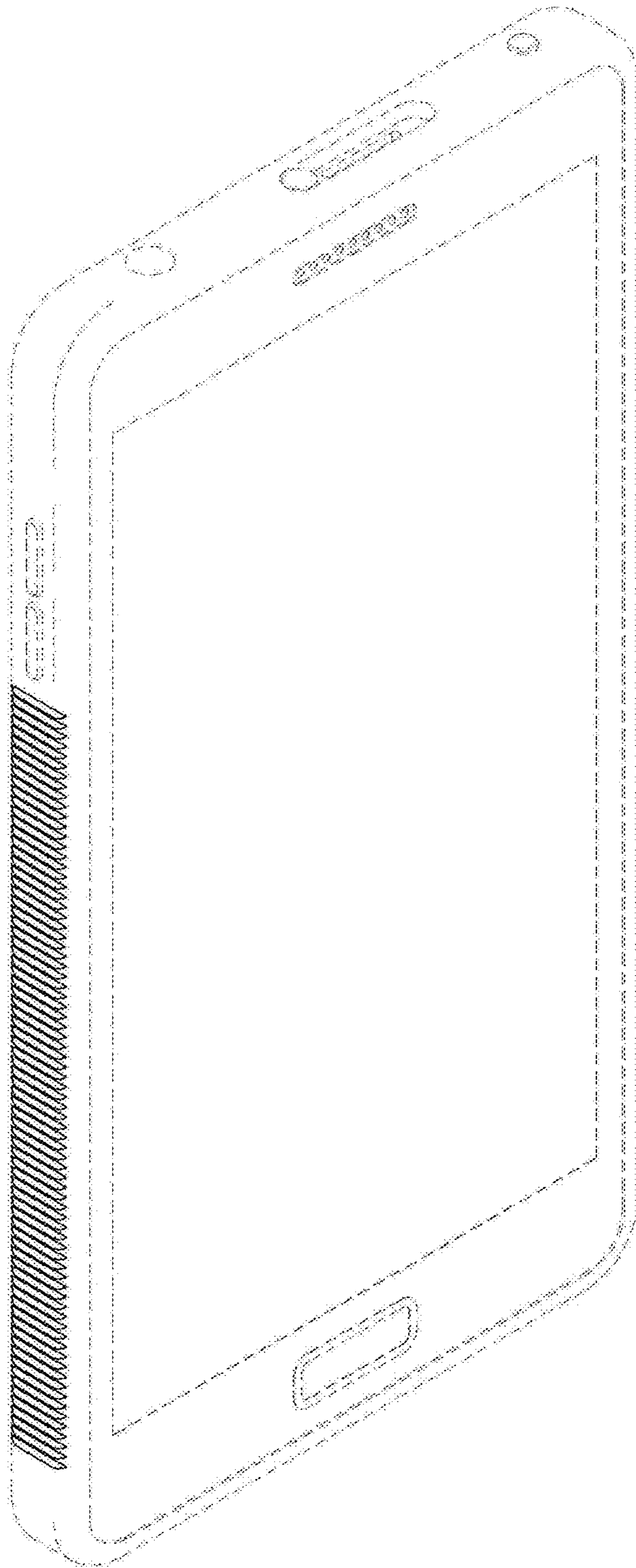

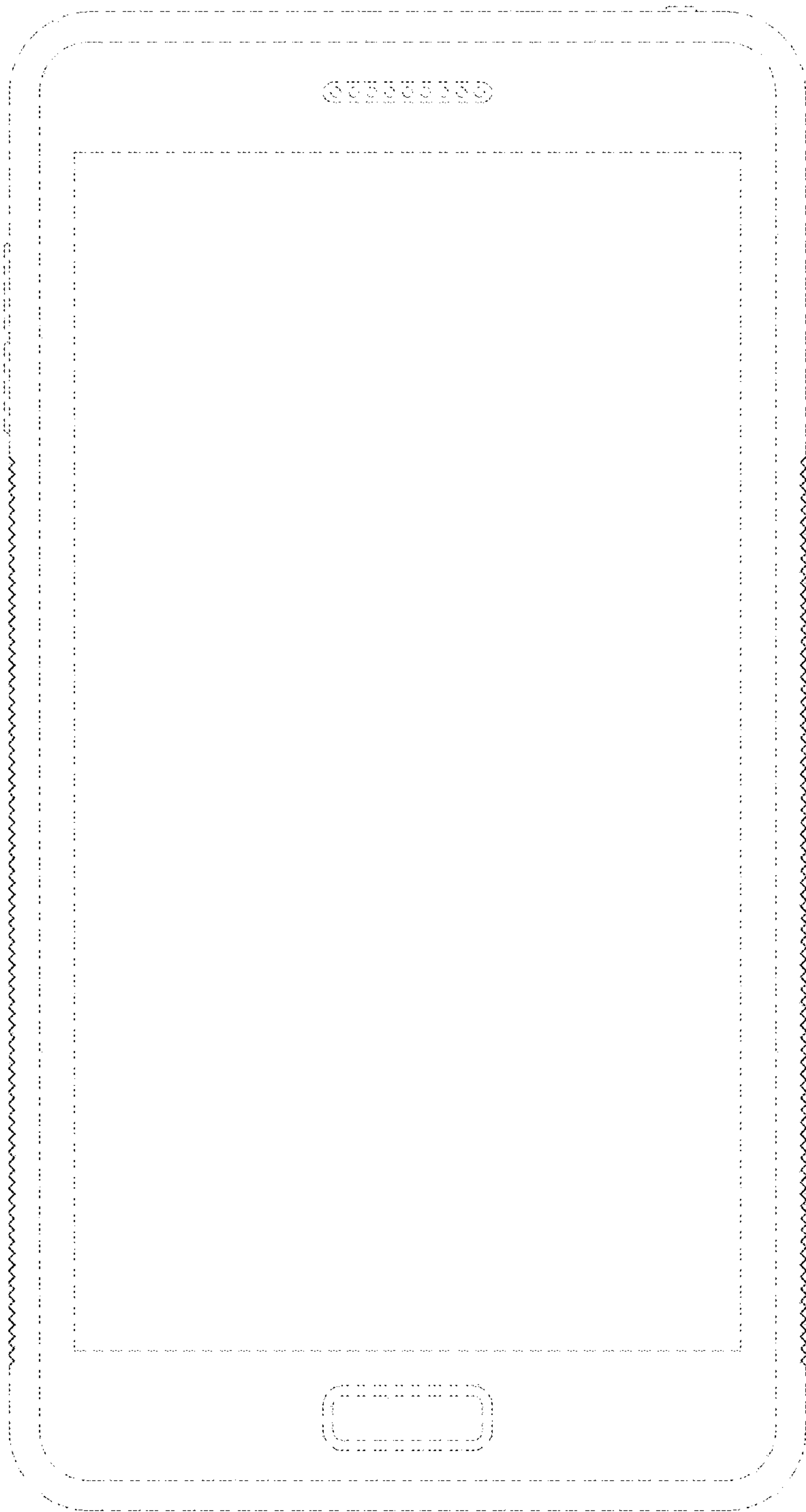

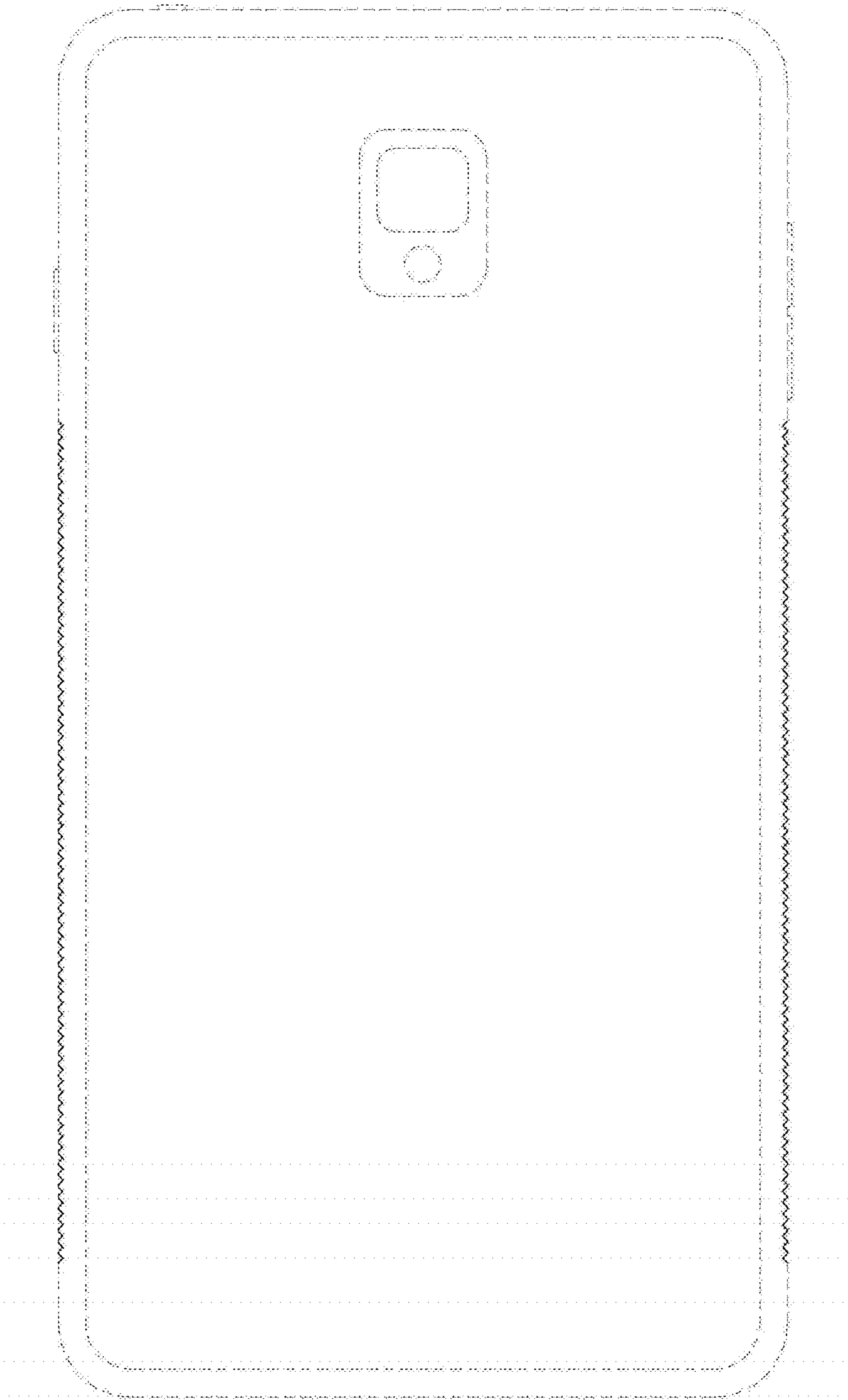

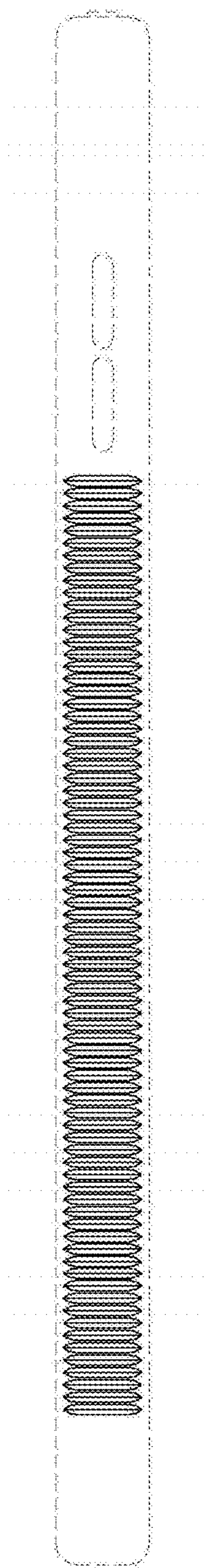

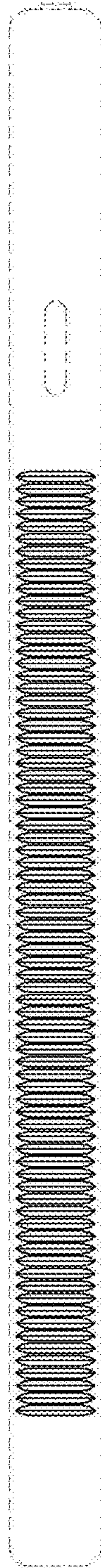

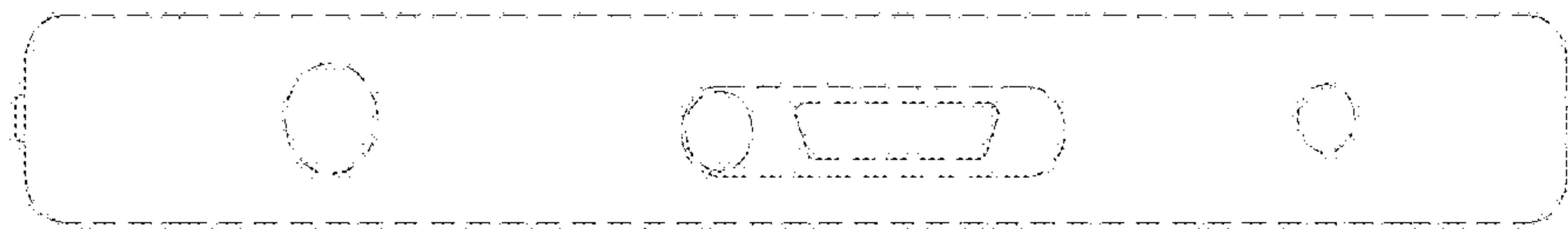

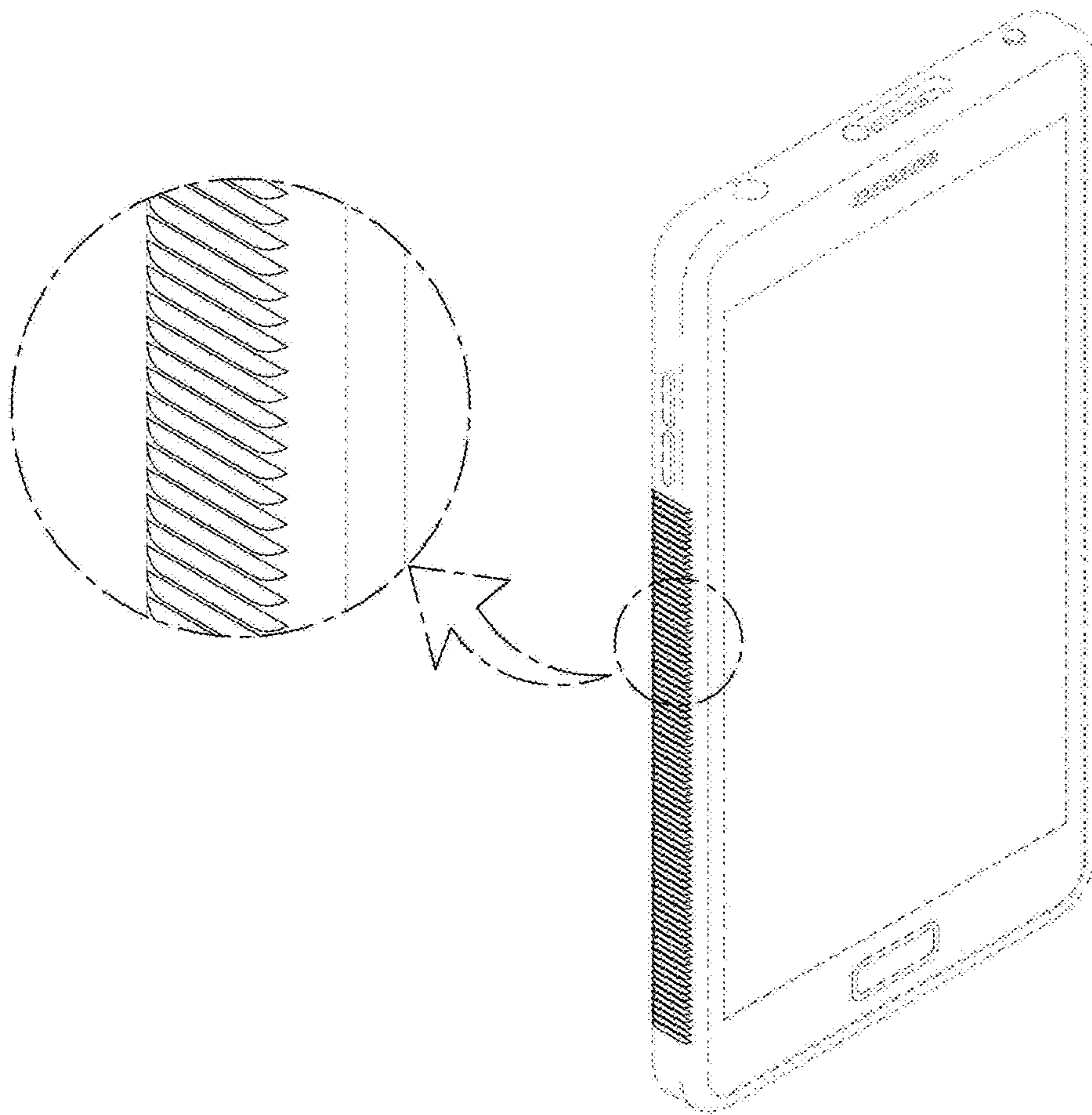

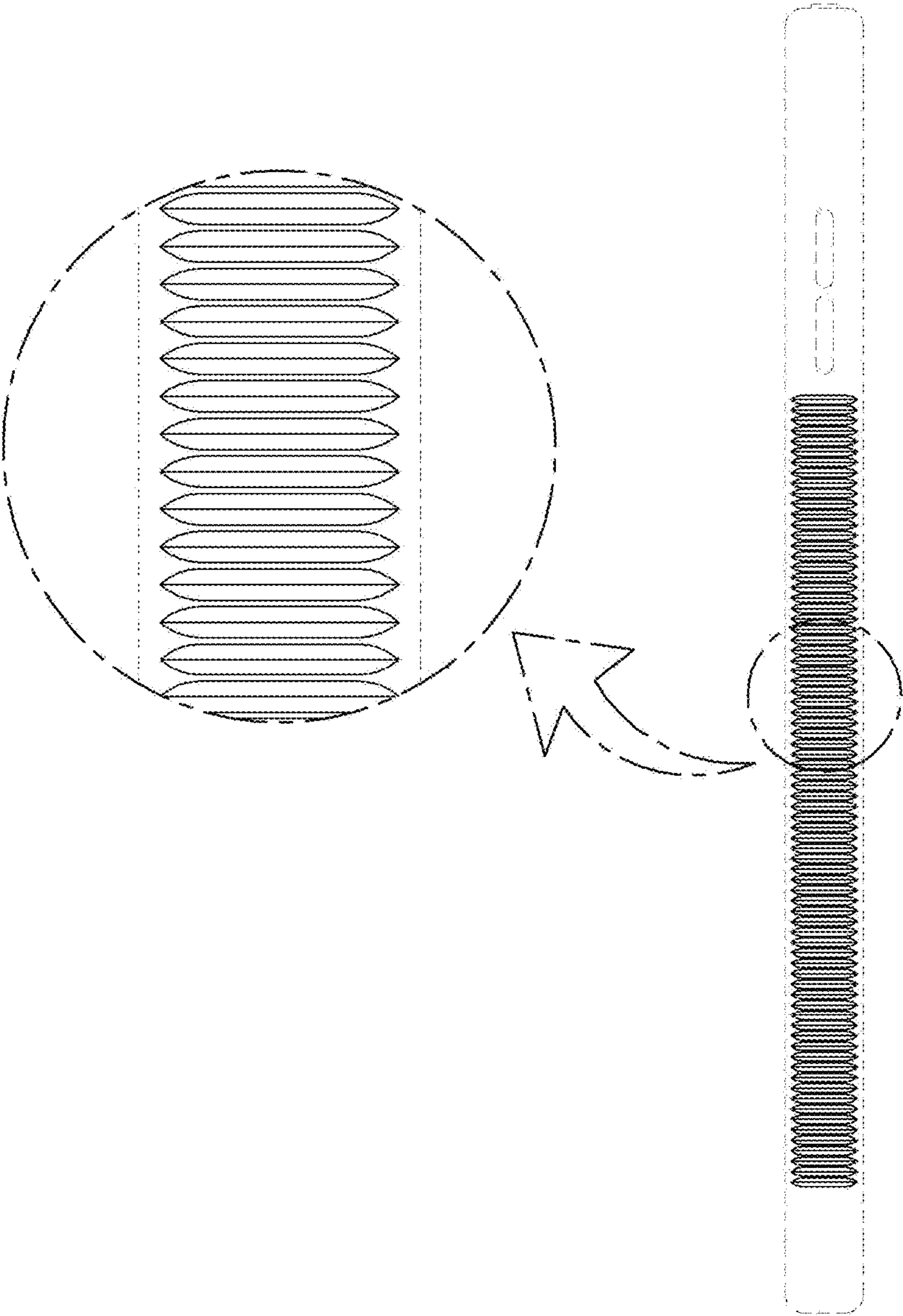
