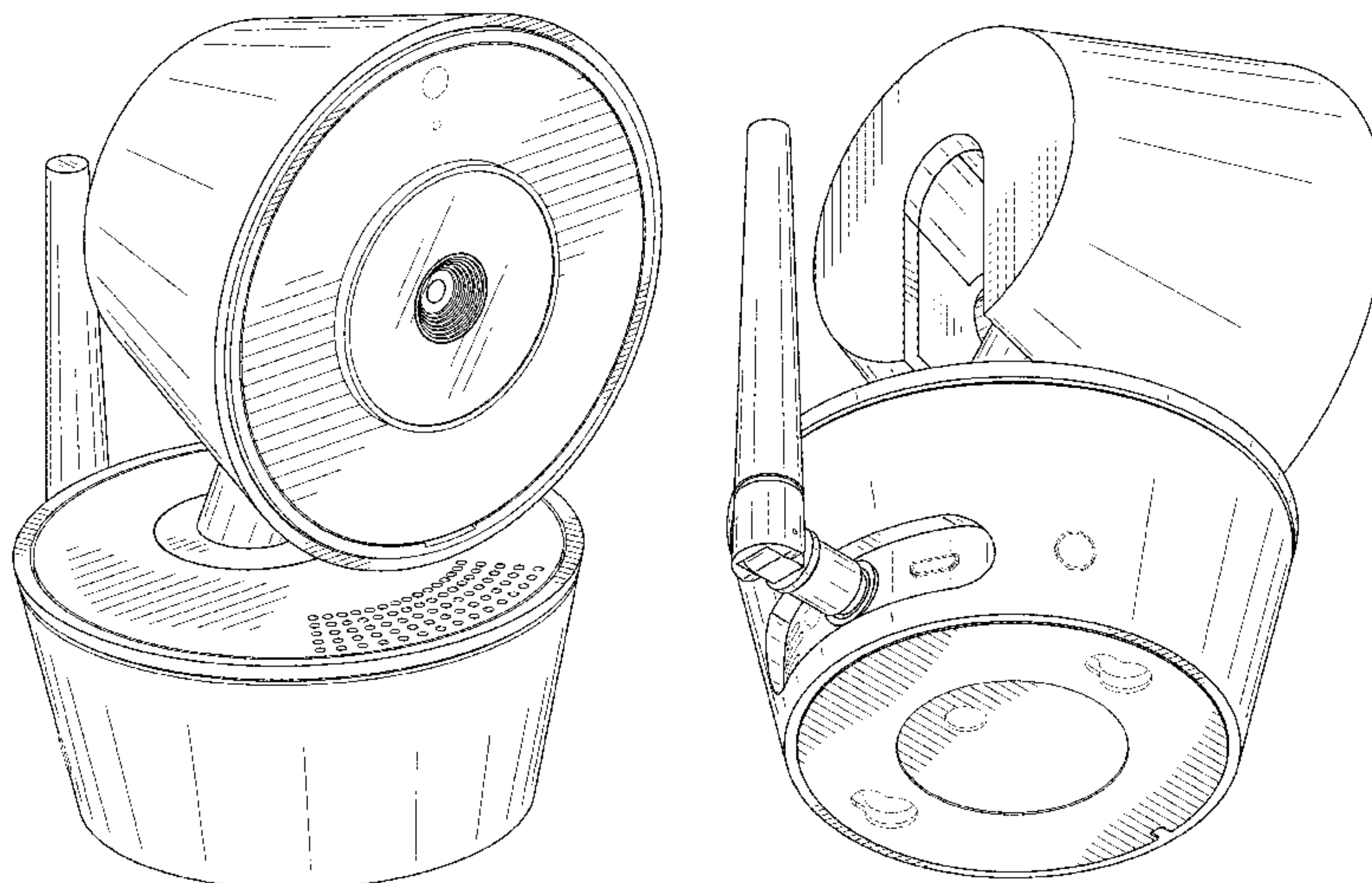
The ornamental design for a camera housing, substantially

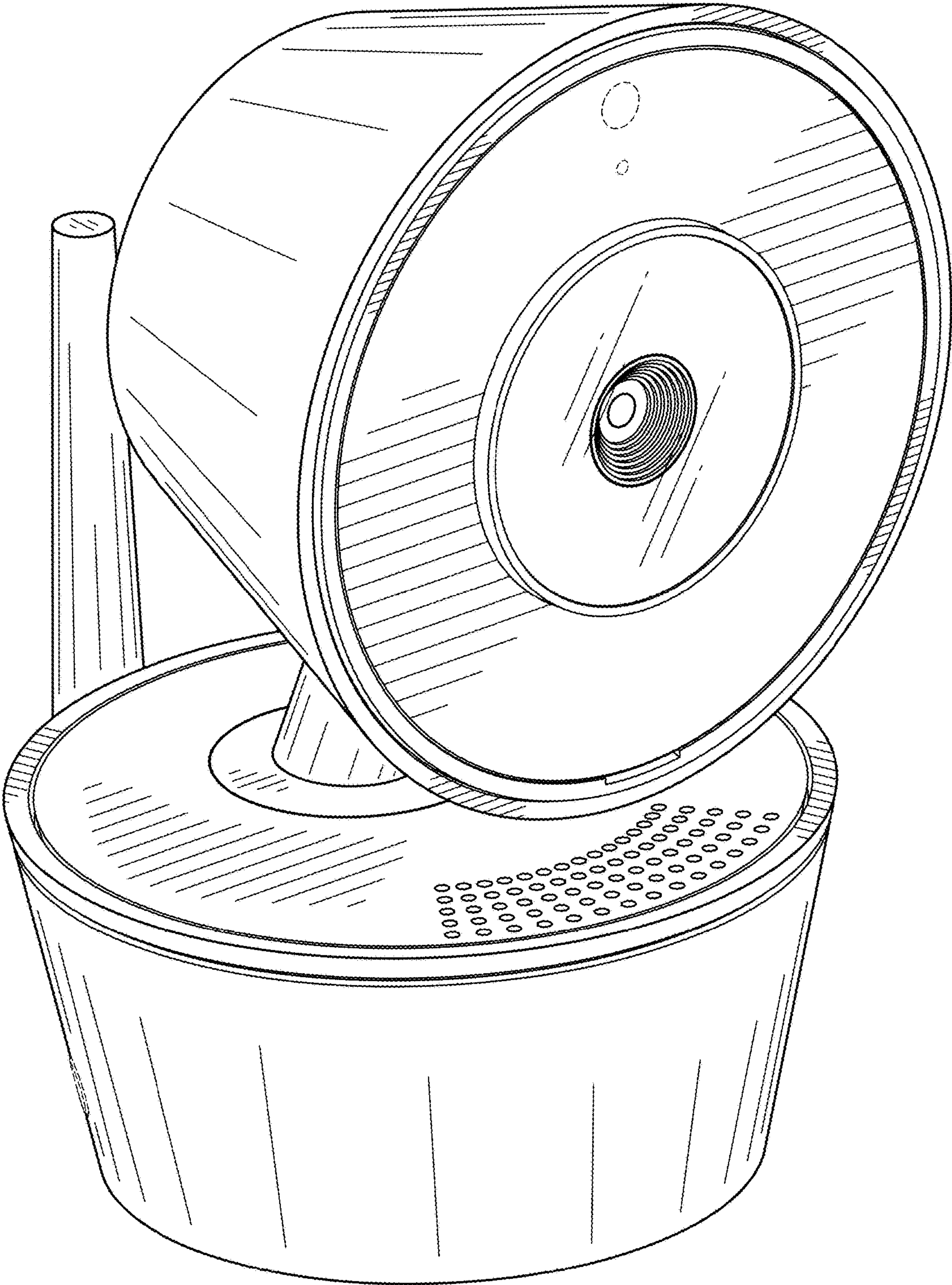

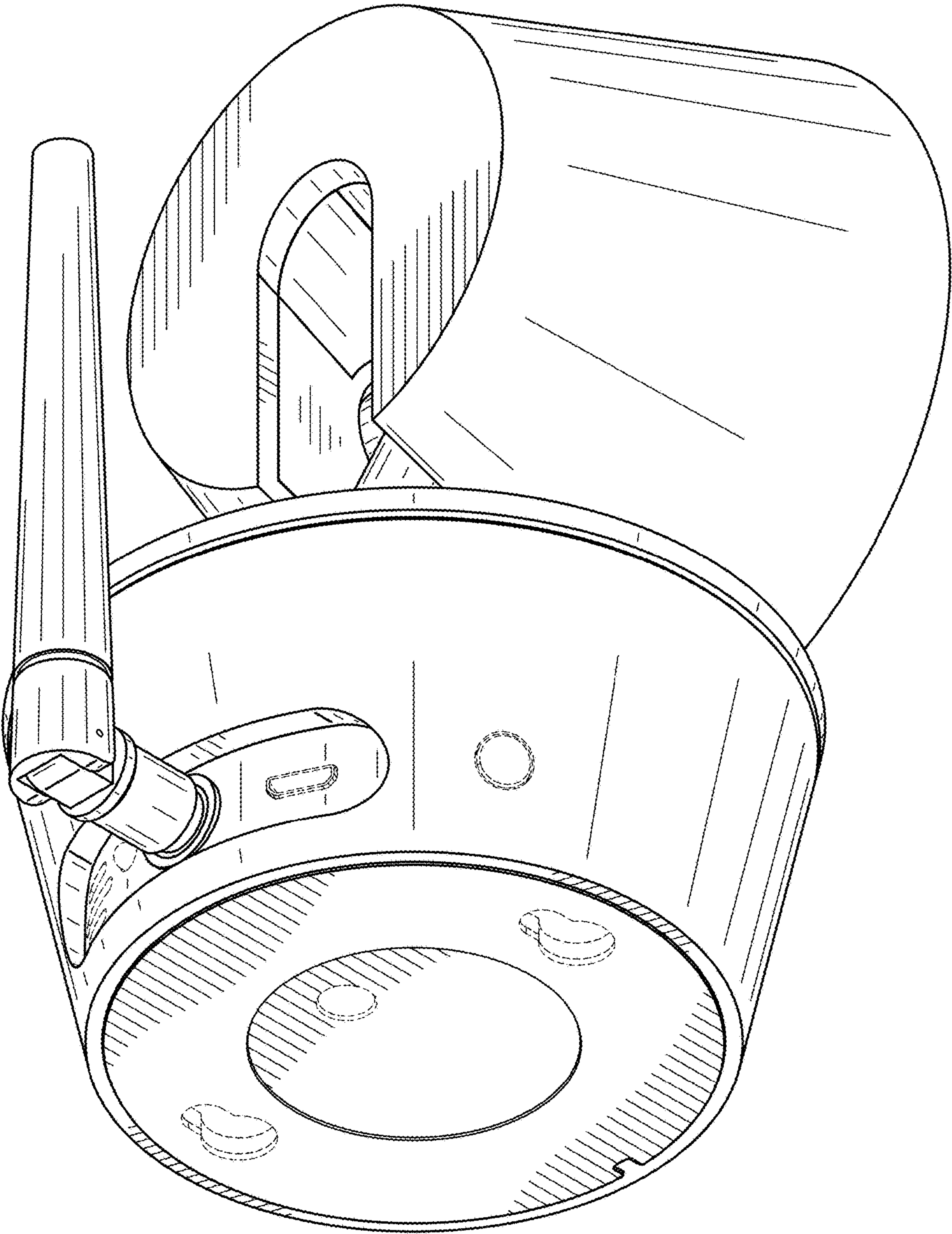

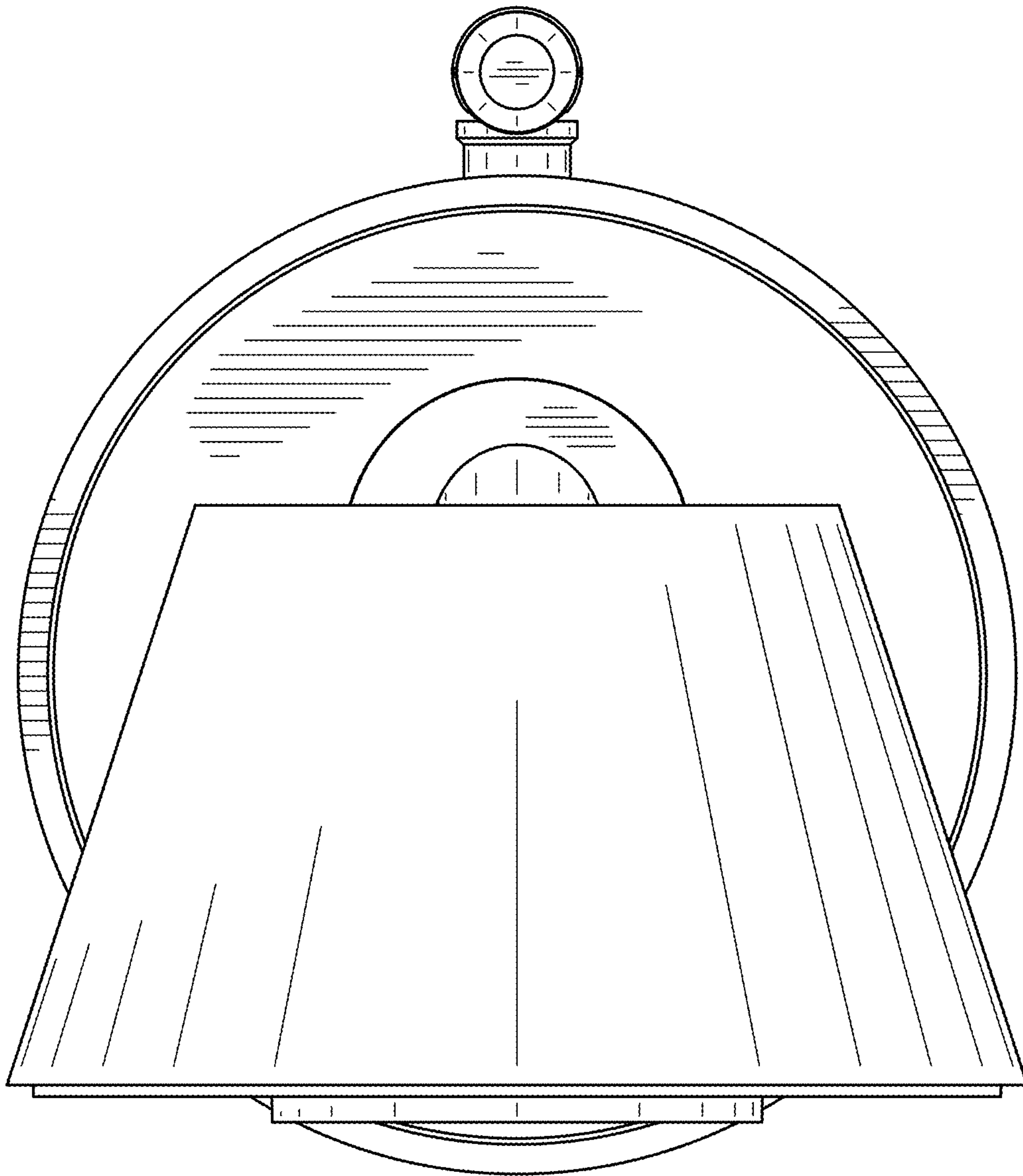

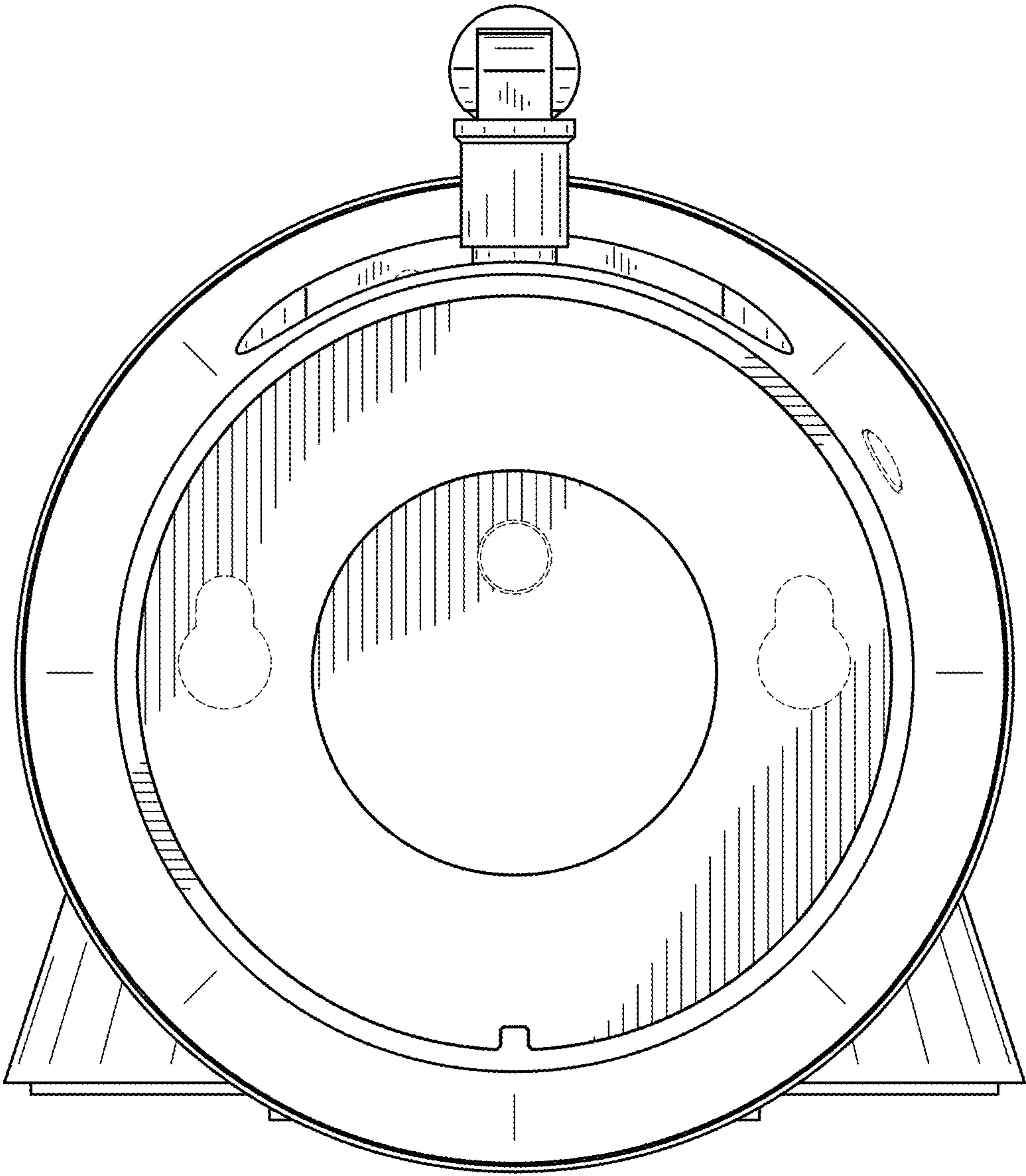

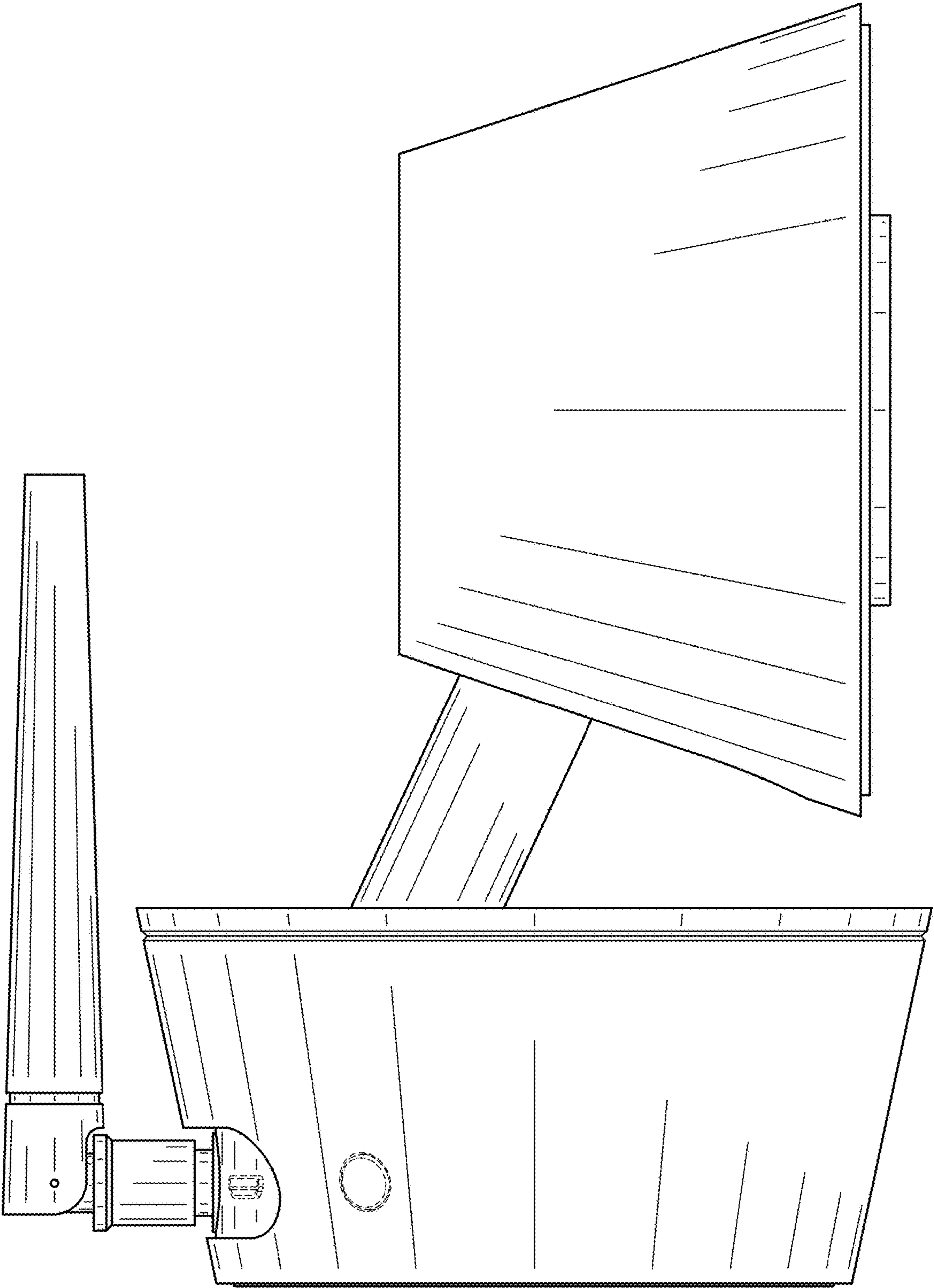

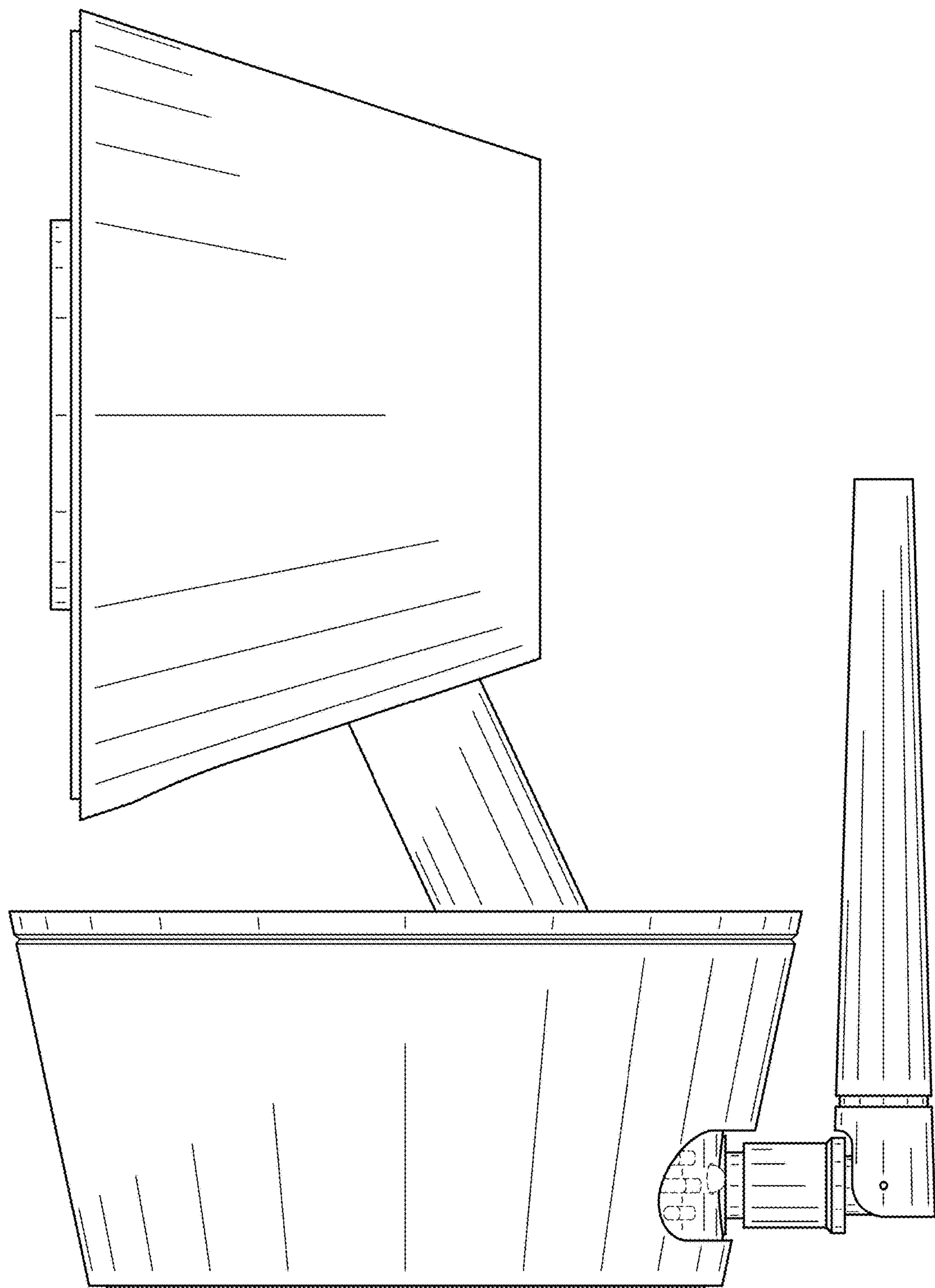

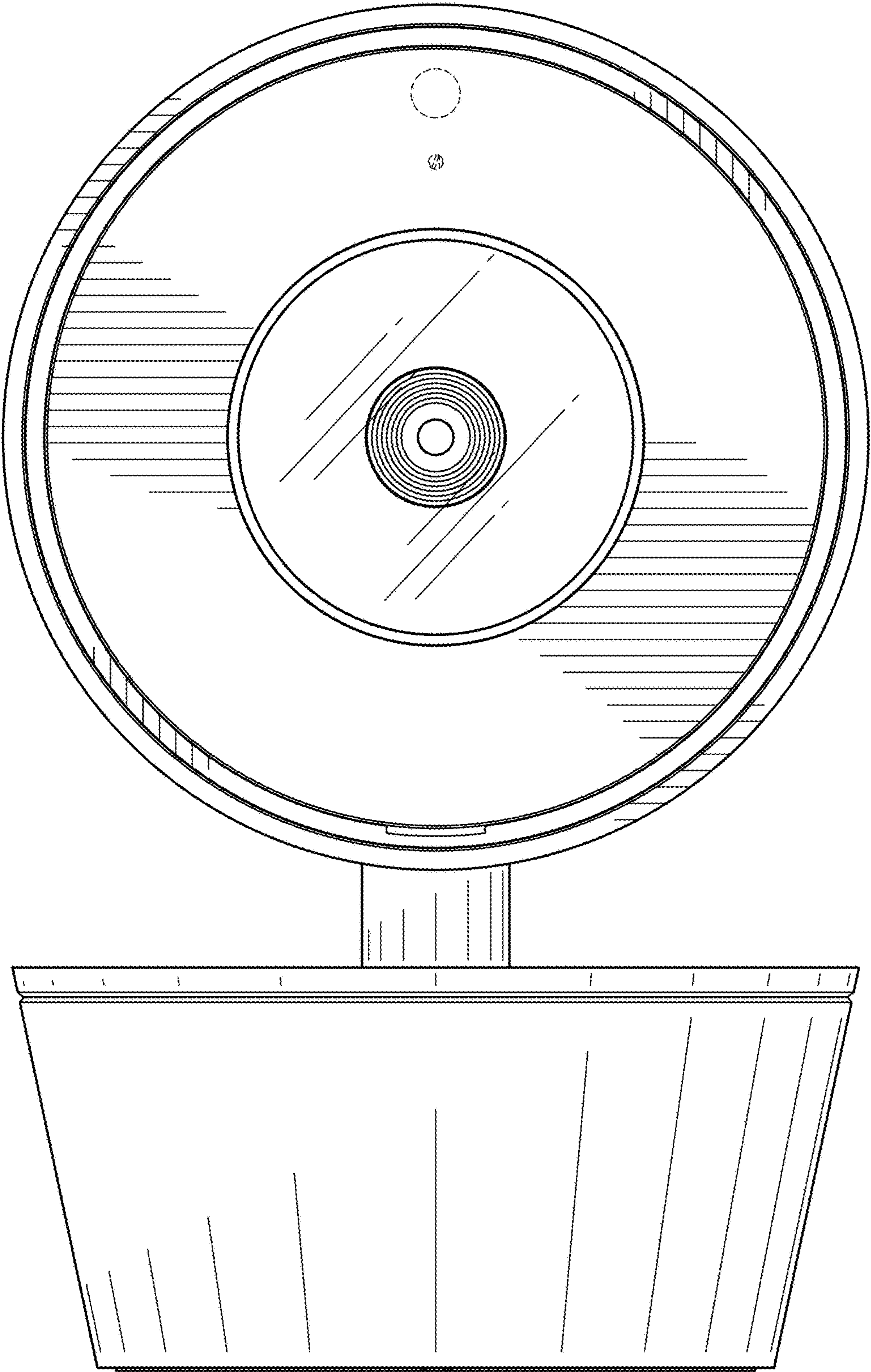

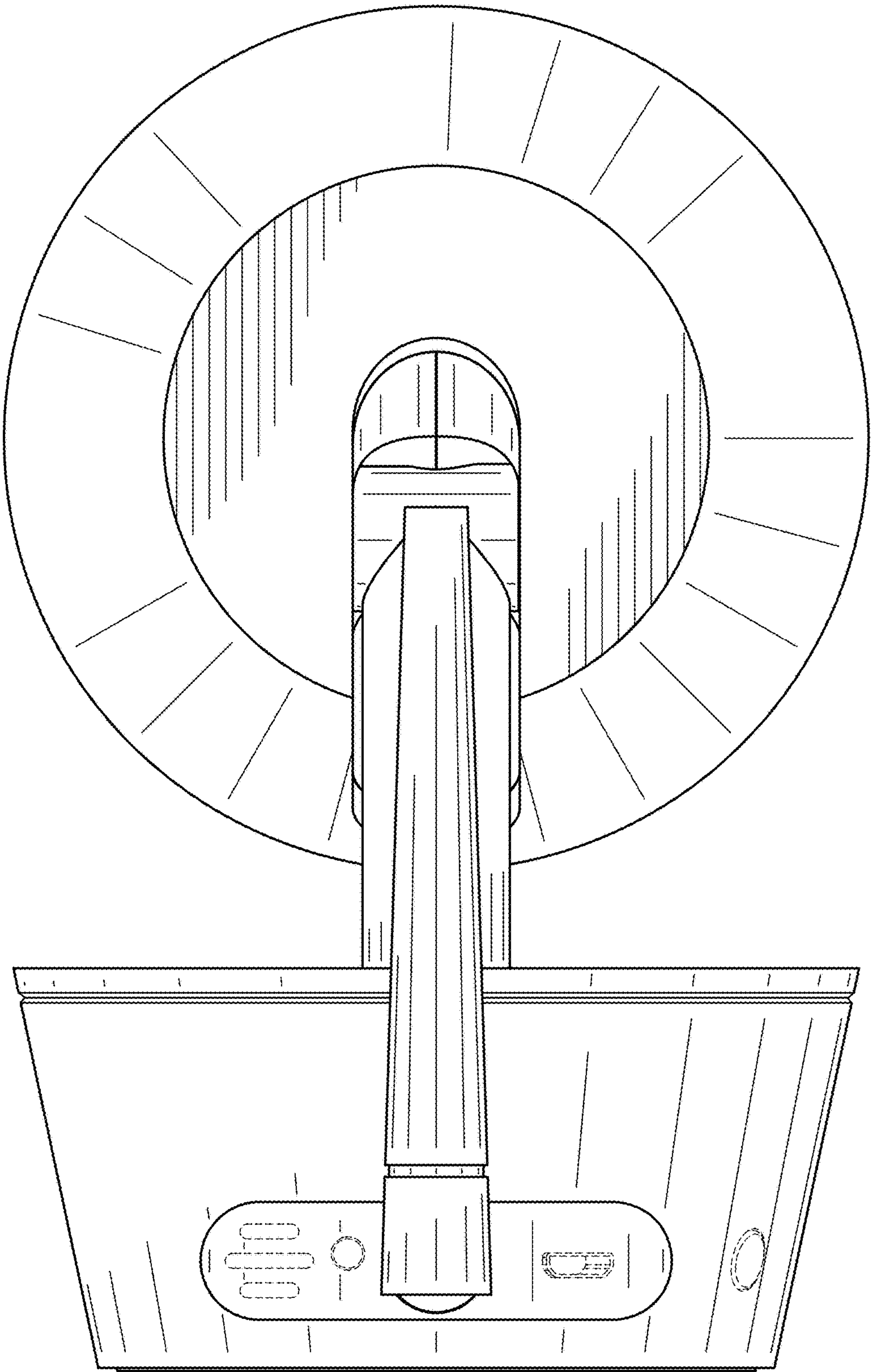

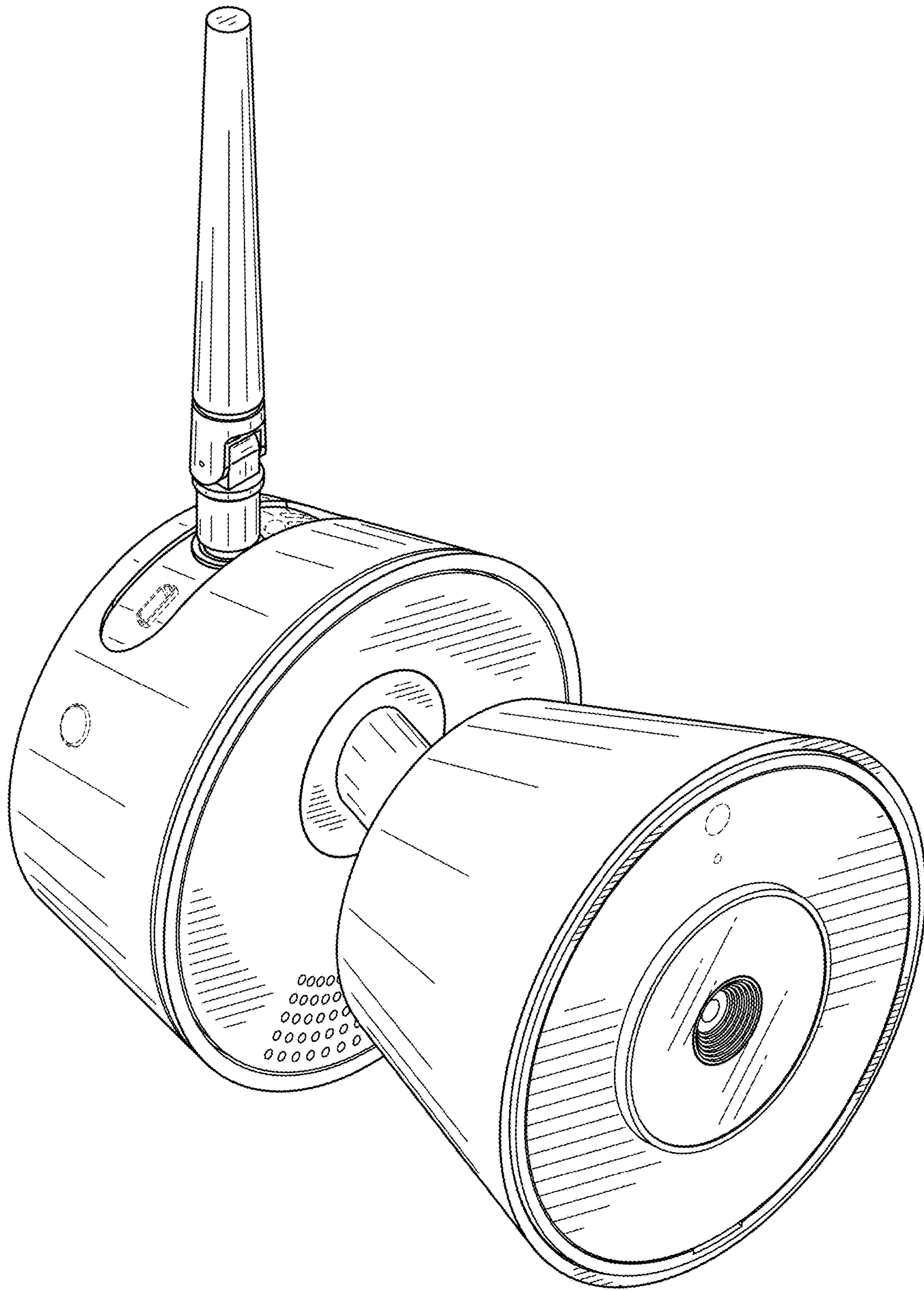

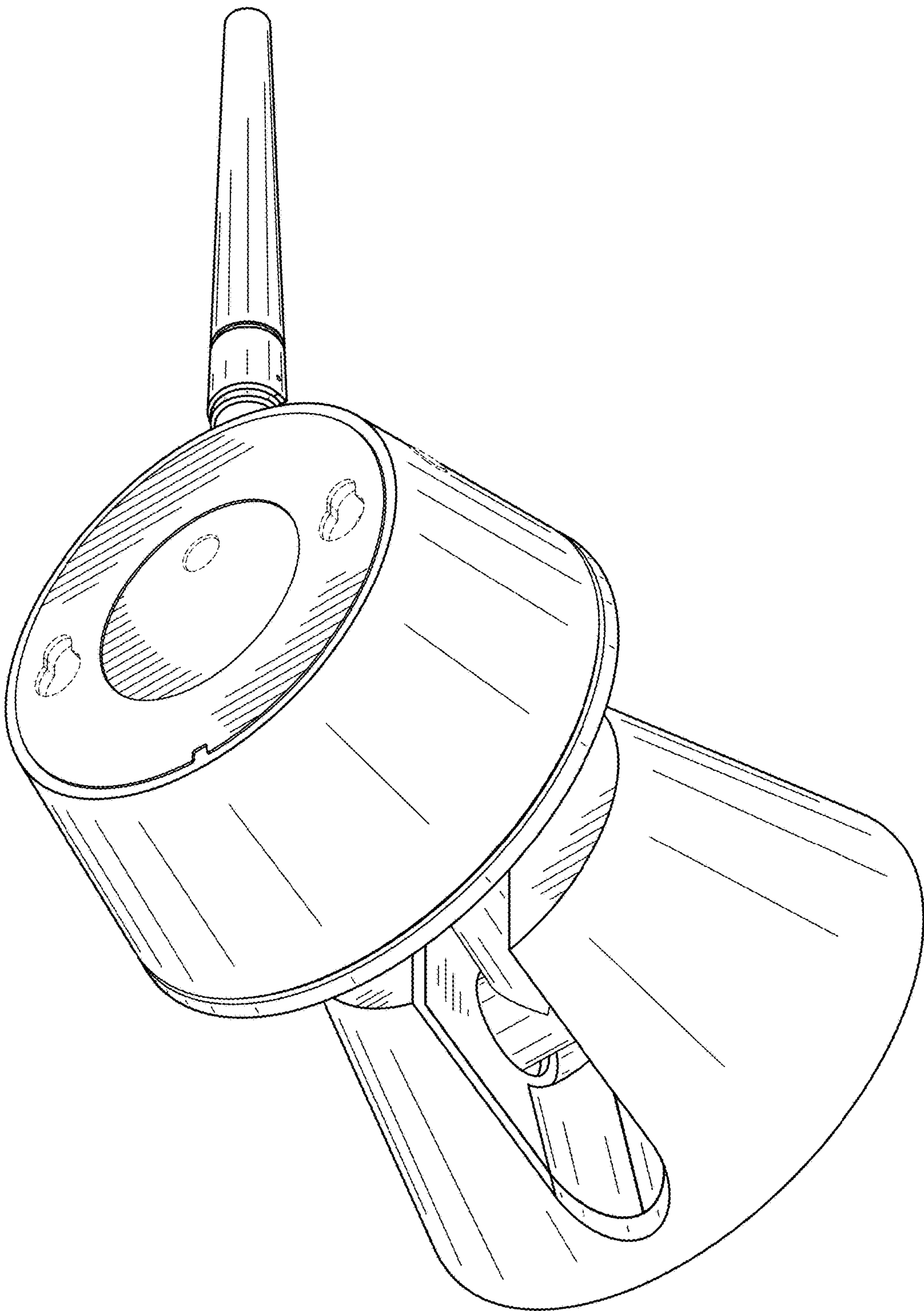

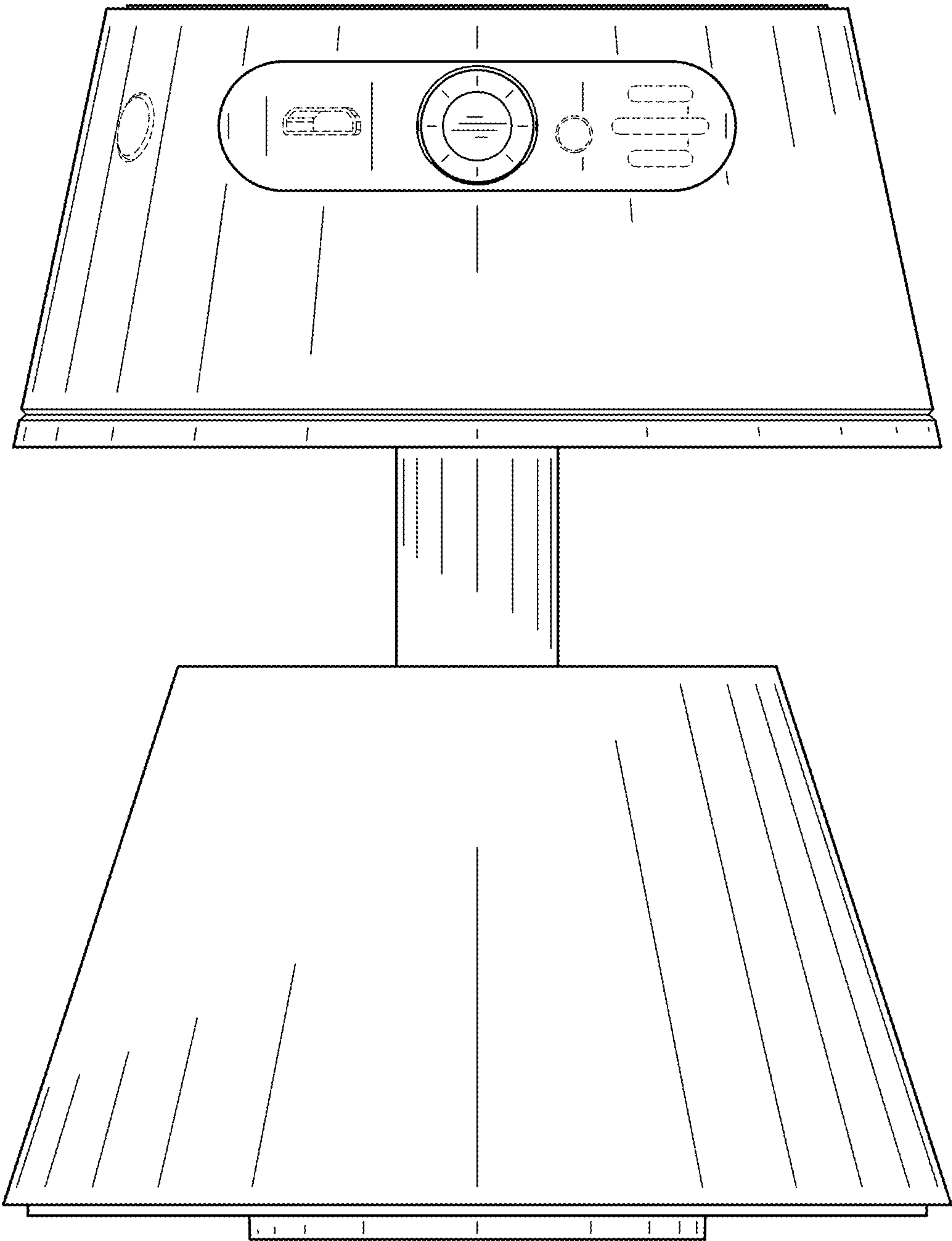

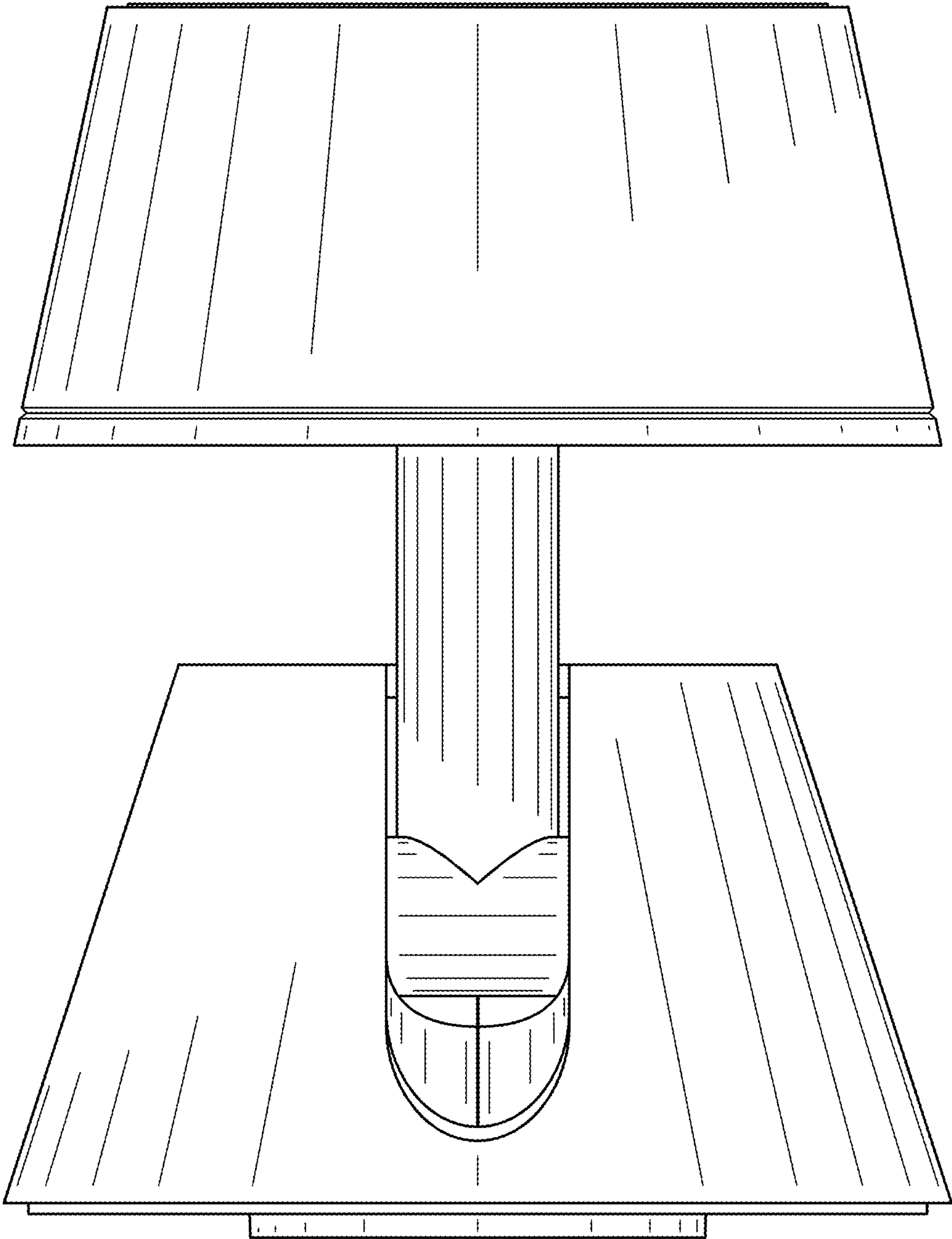

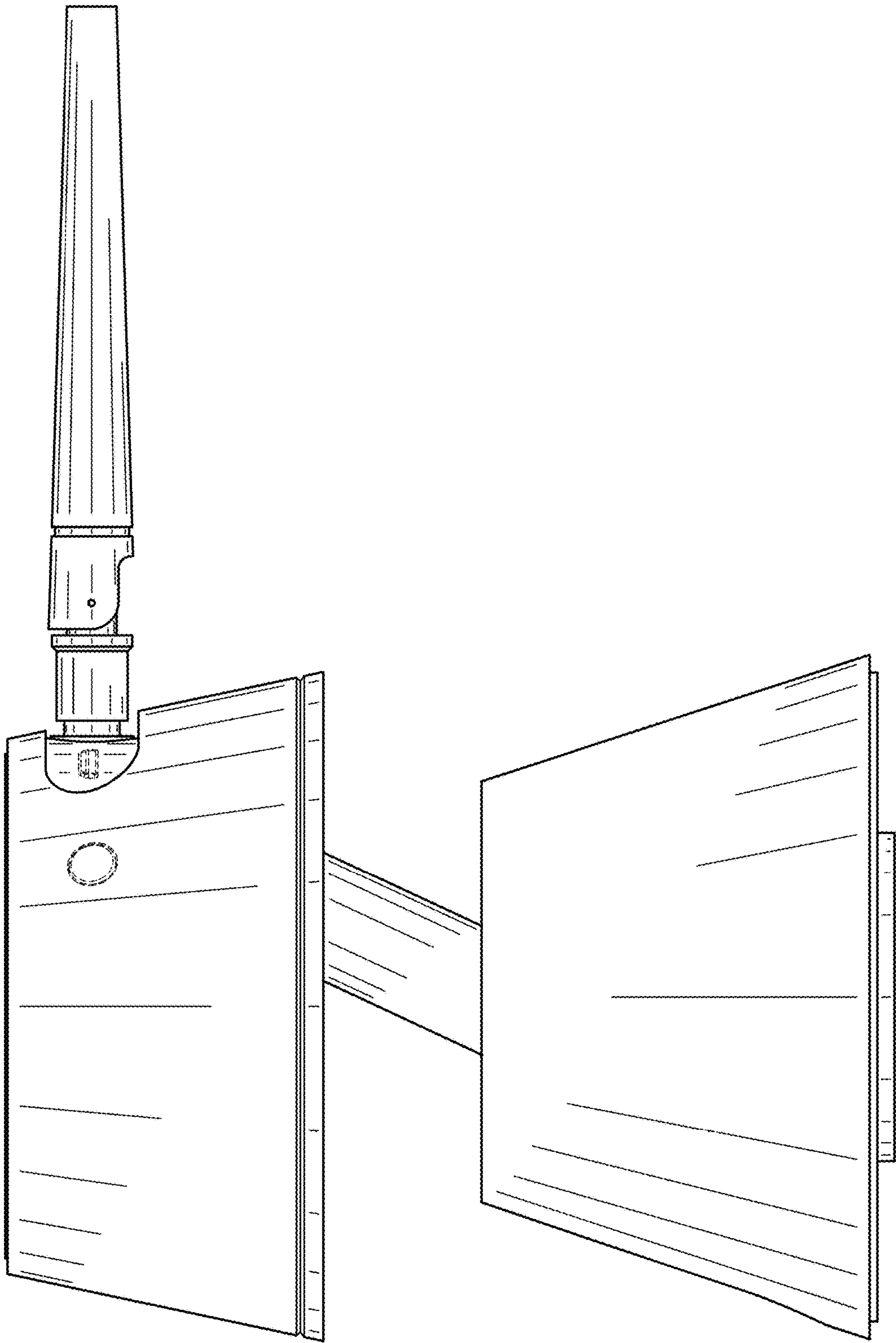

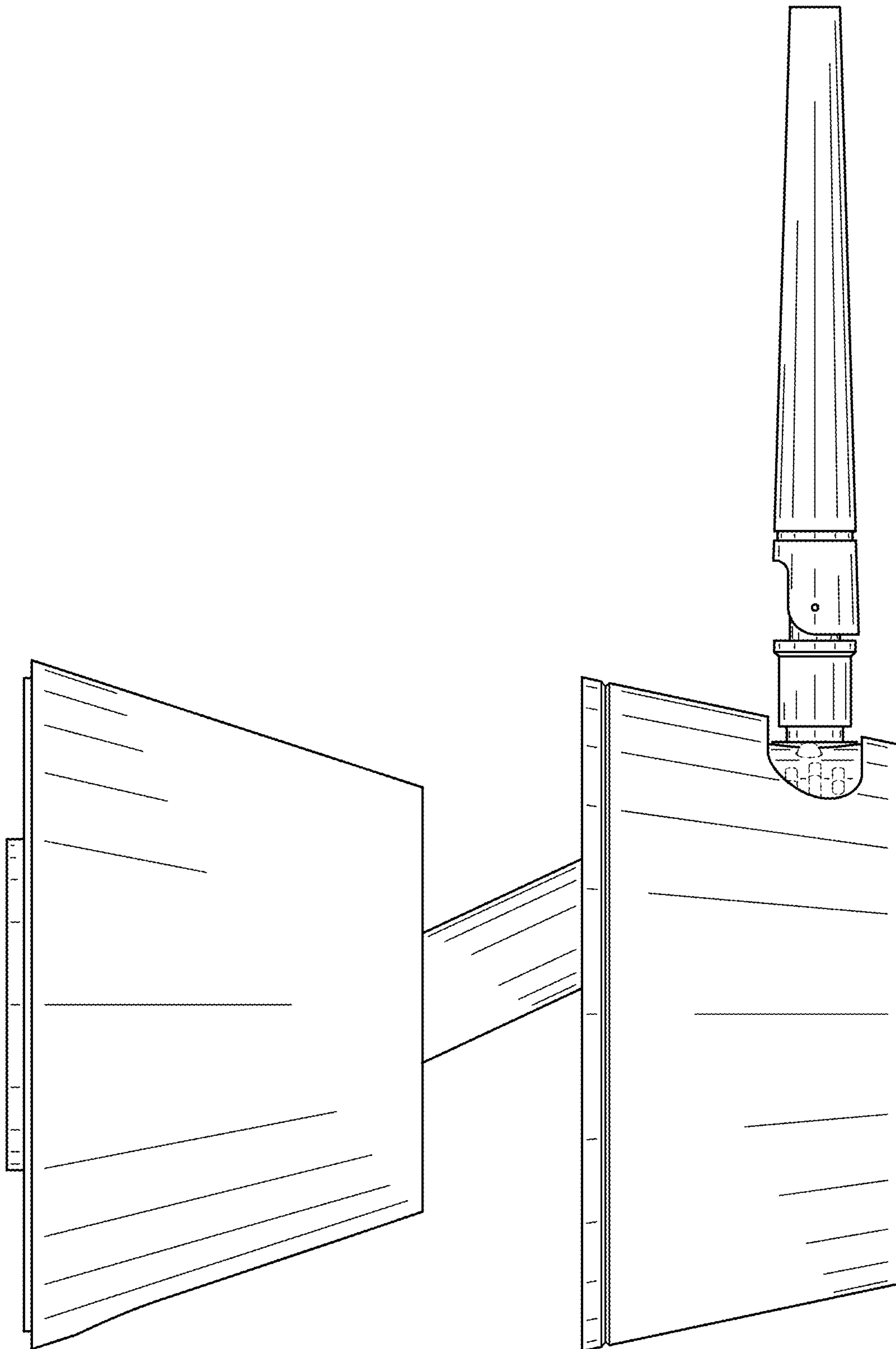

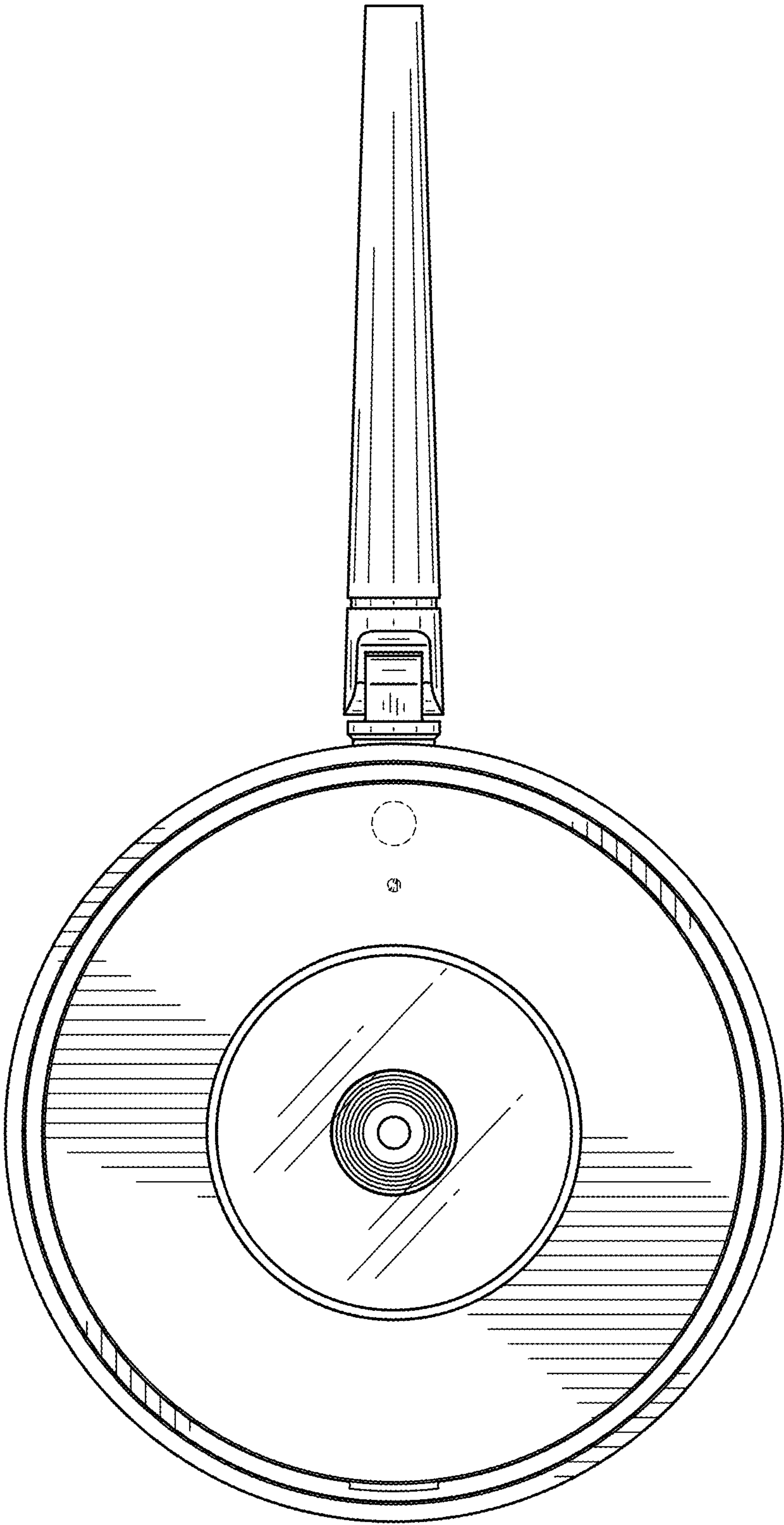

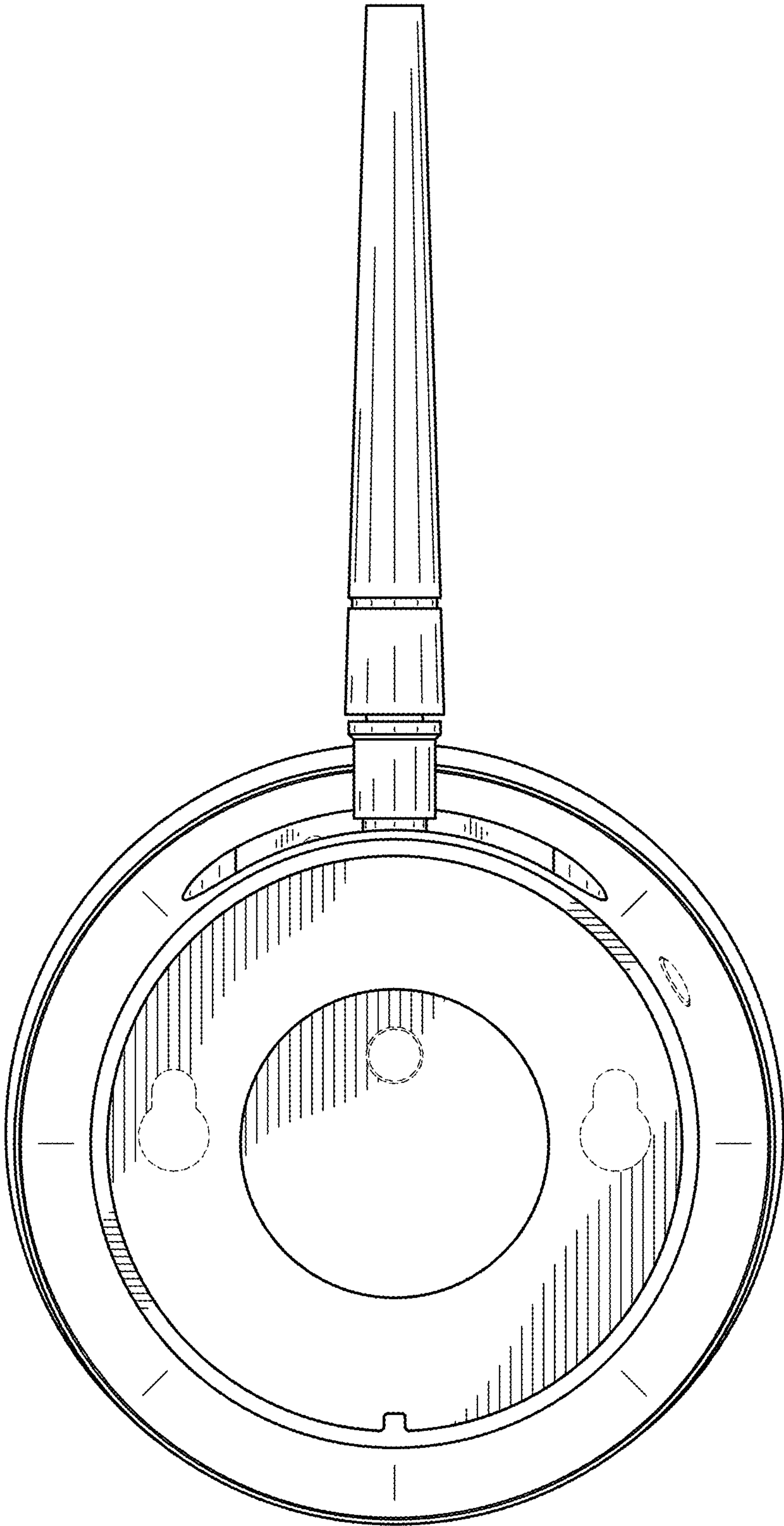
