of FIG. 1.

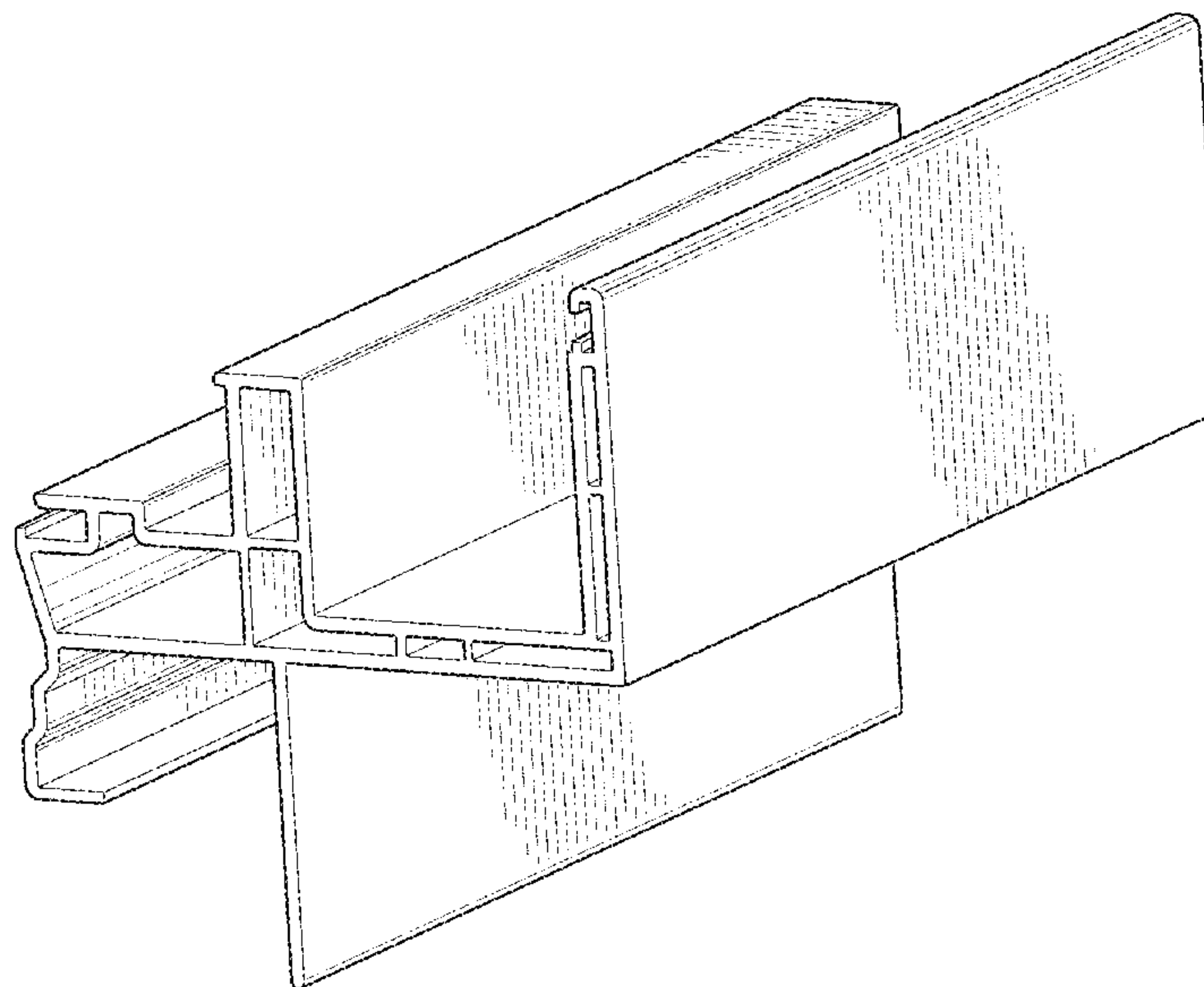
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the window frame component

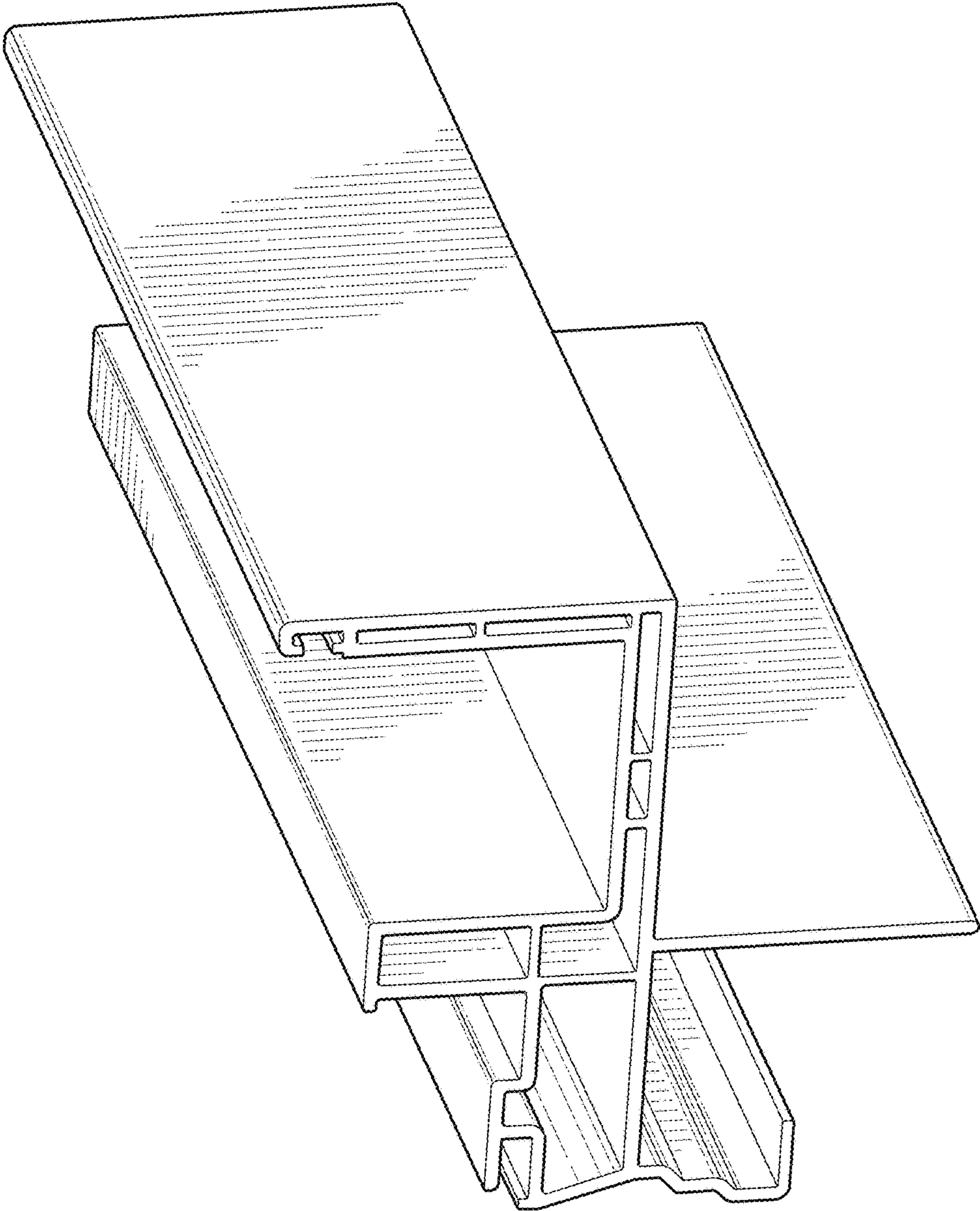

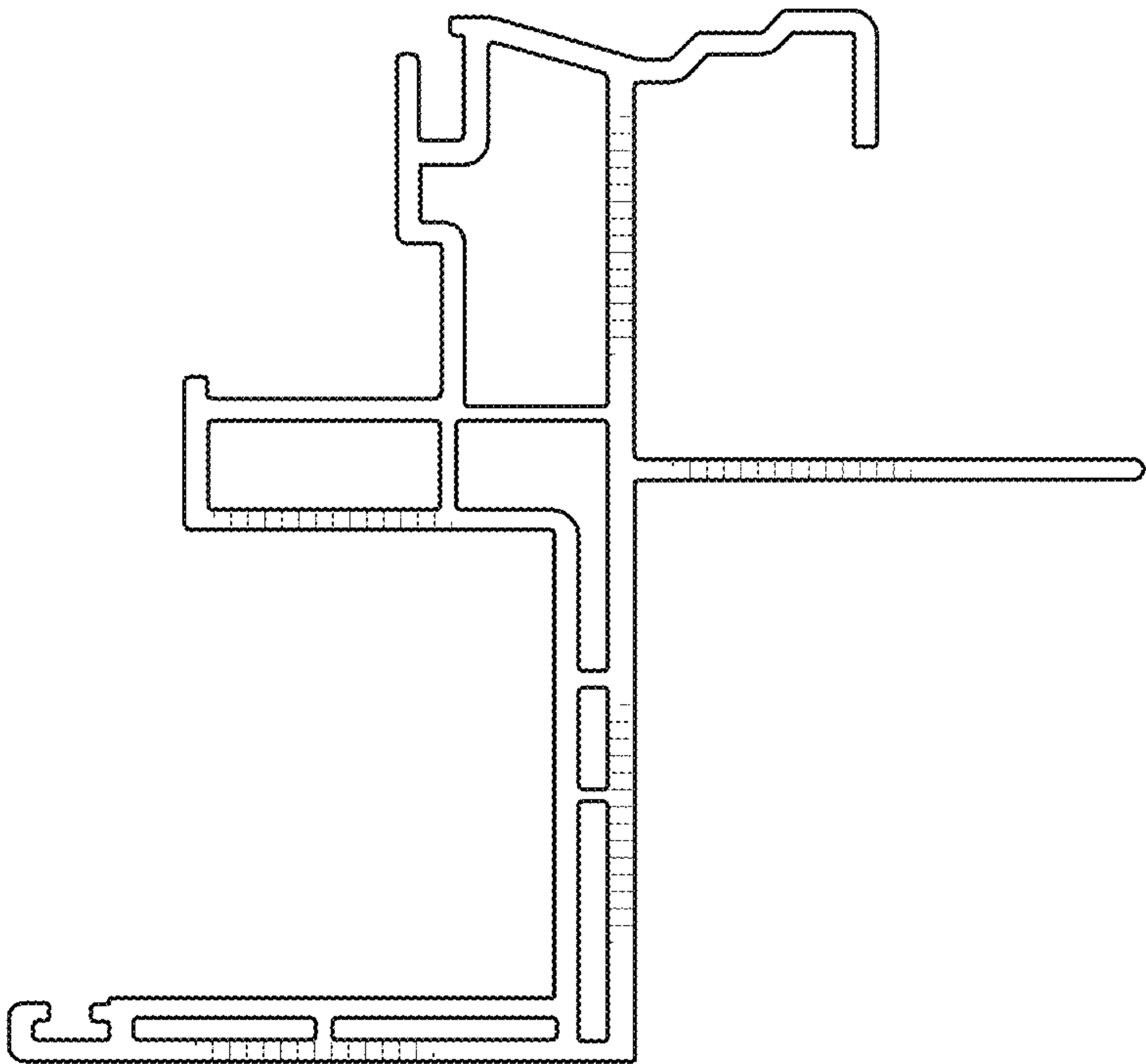

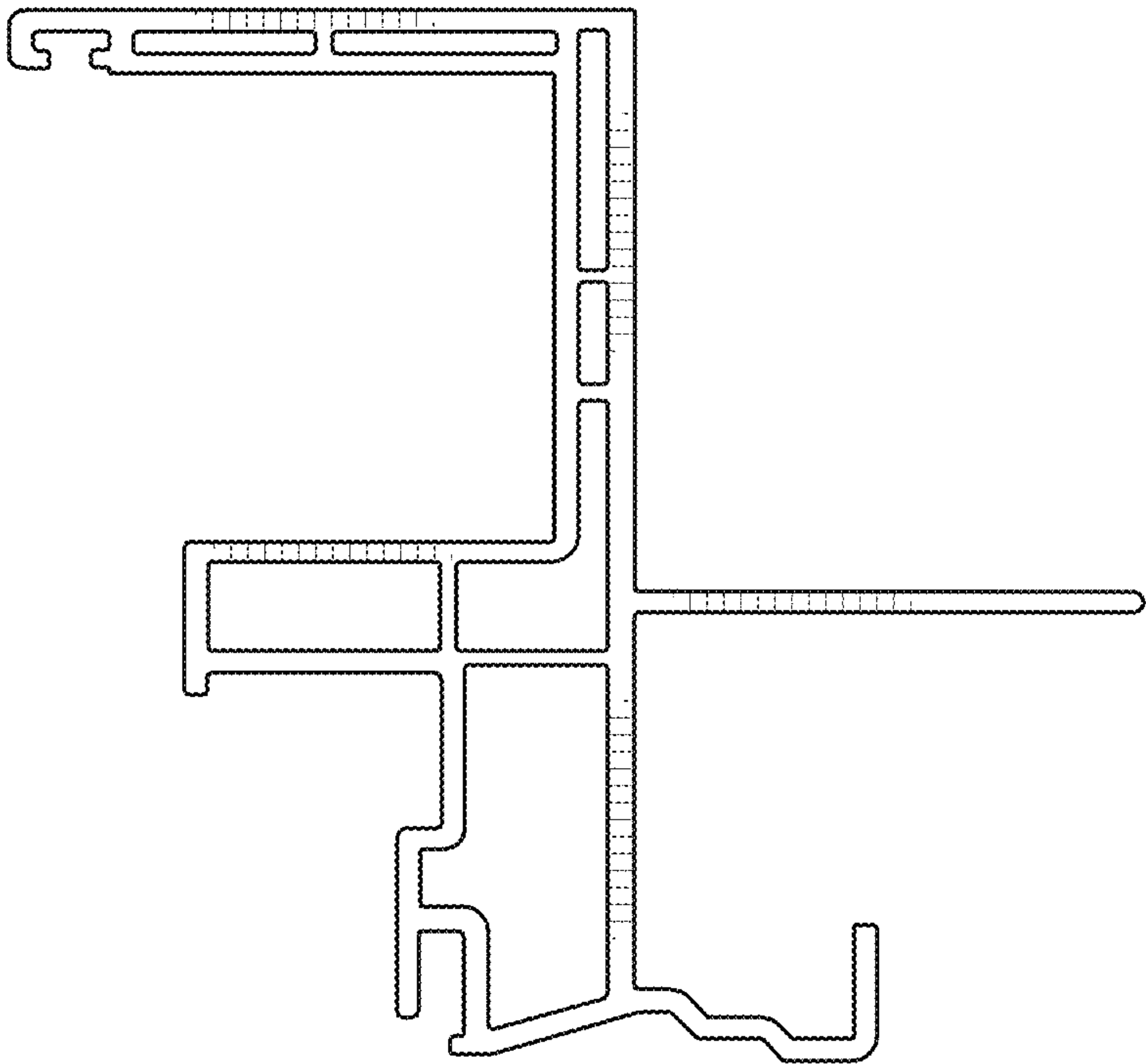

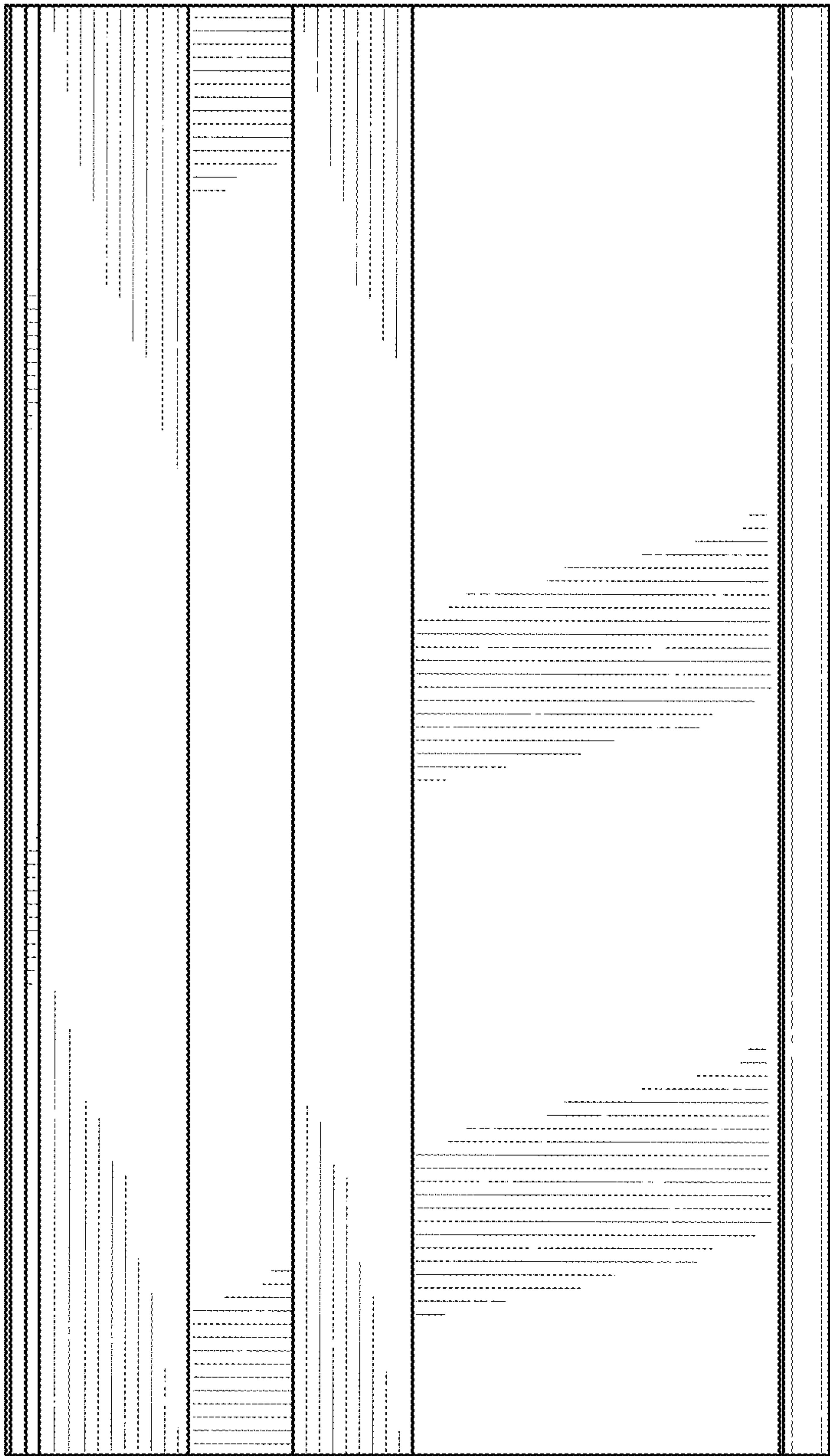

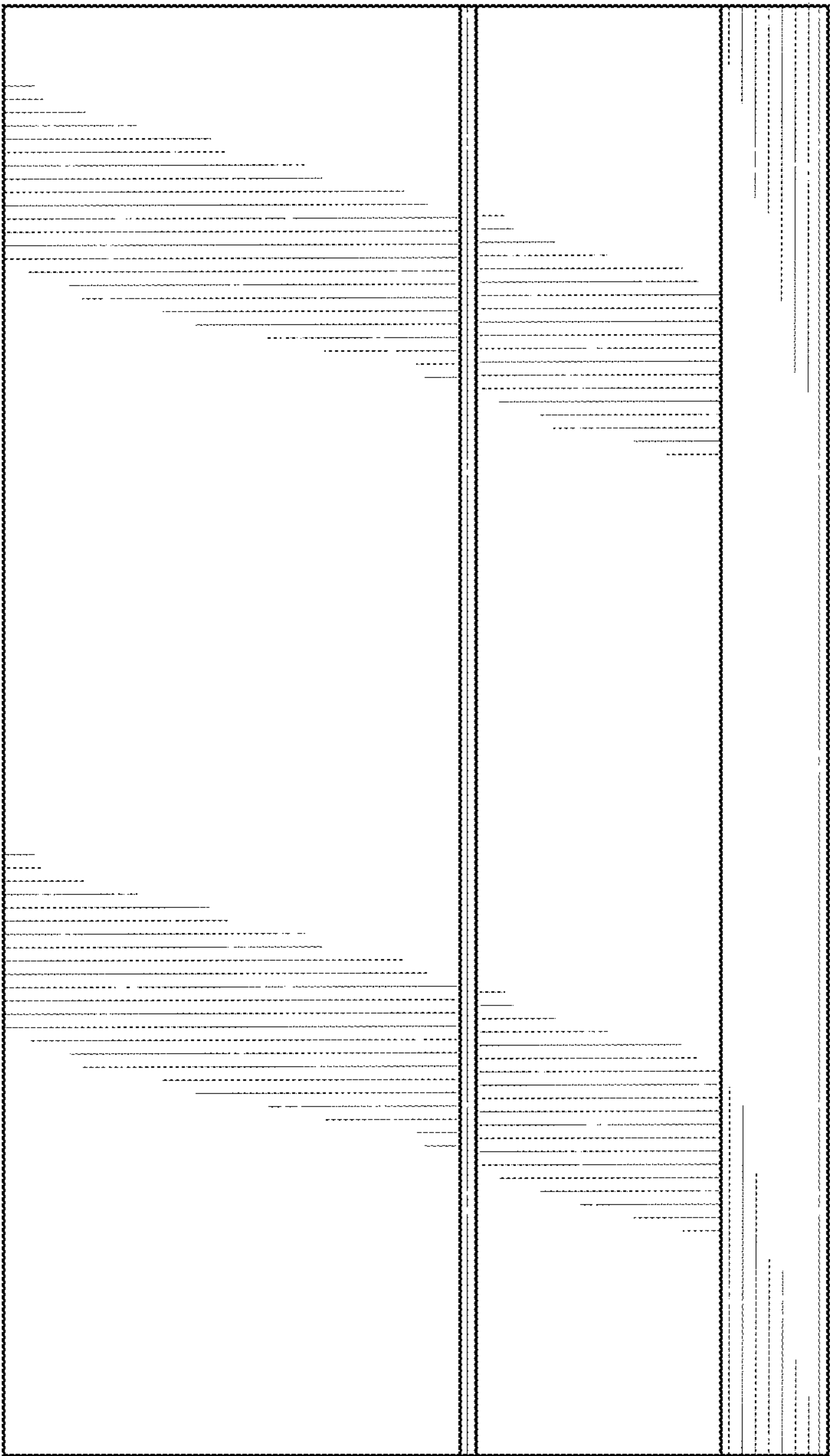

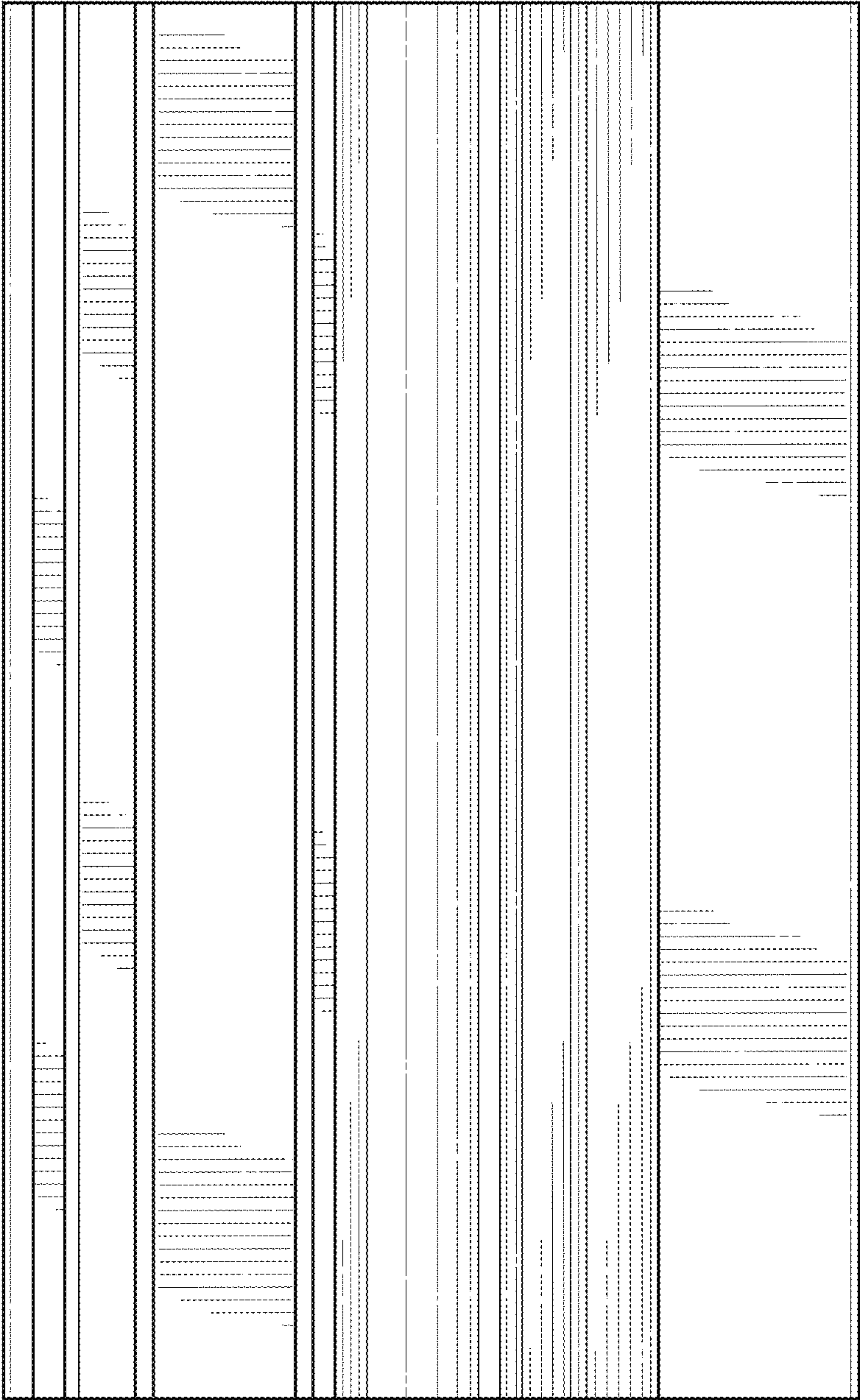

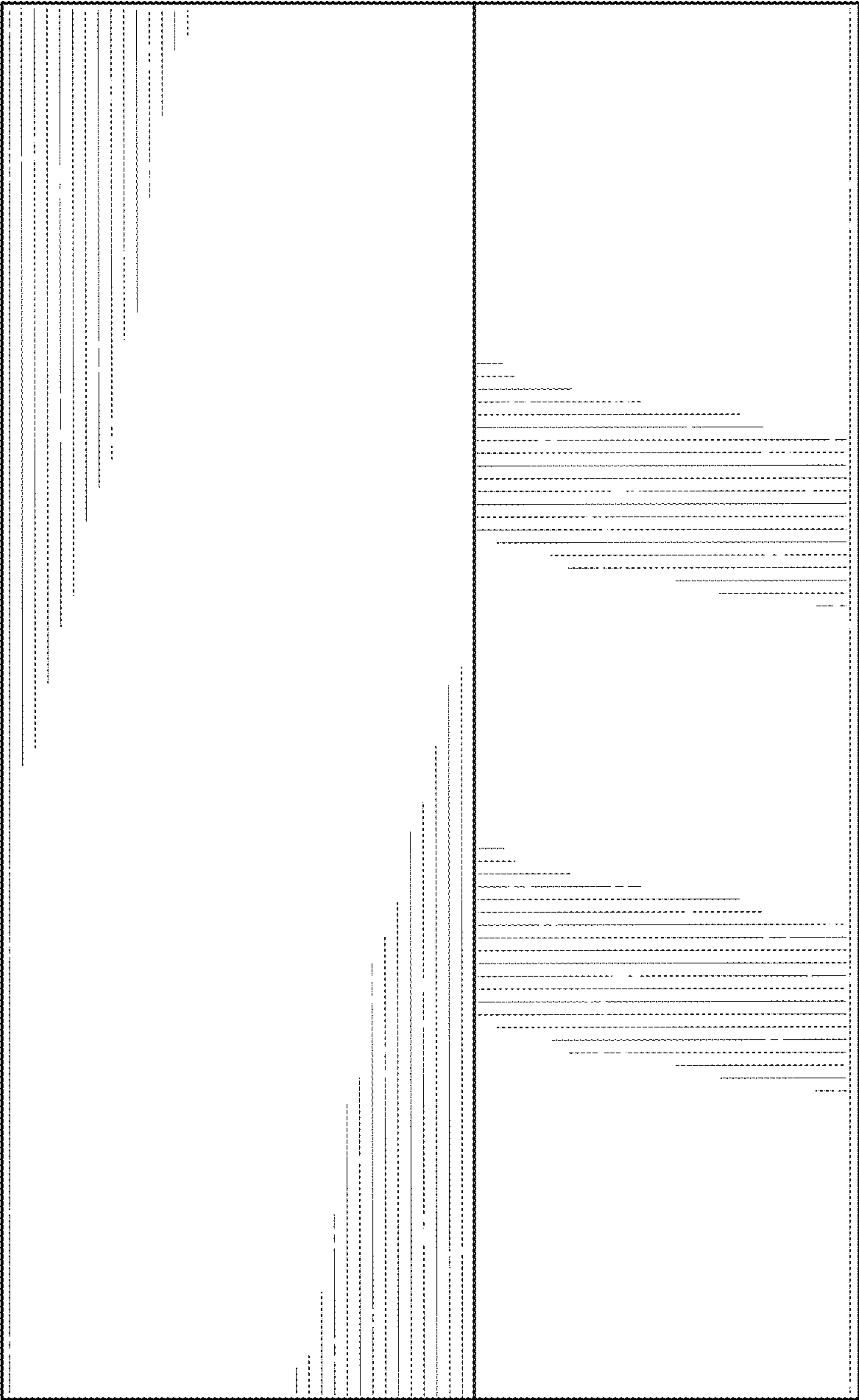
