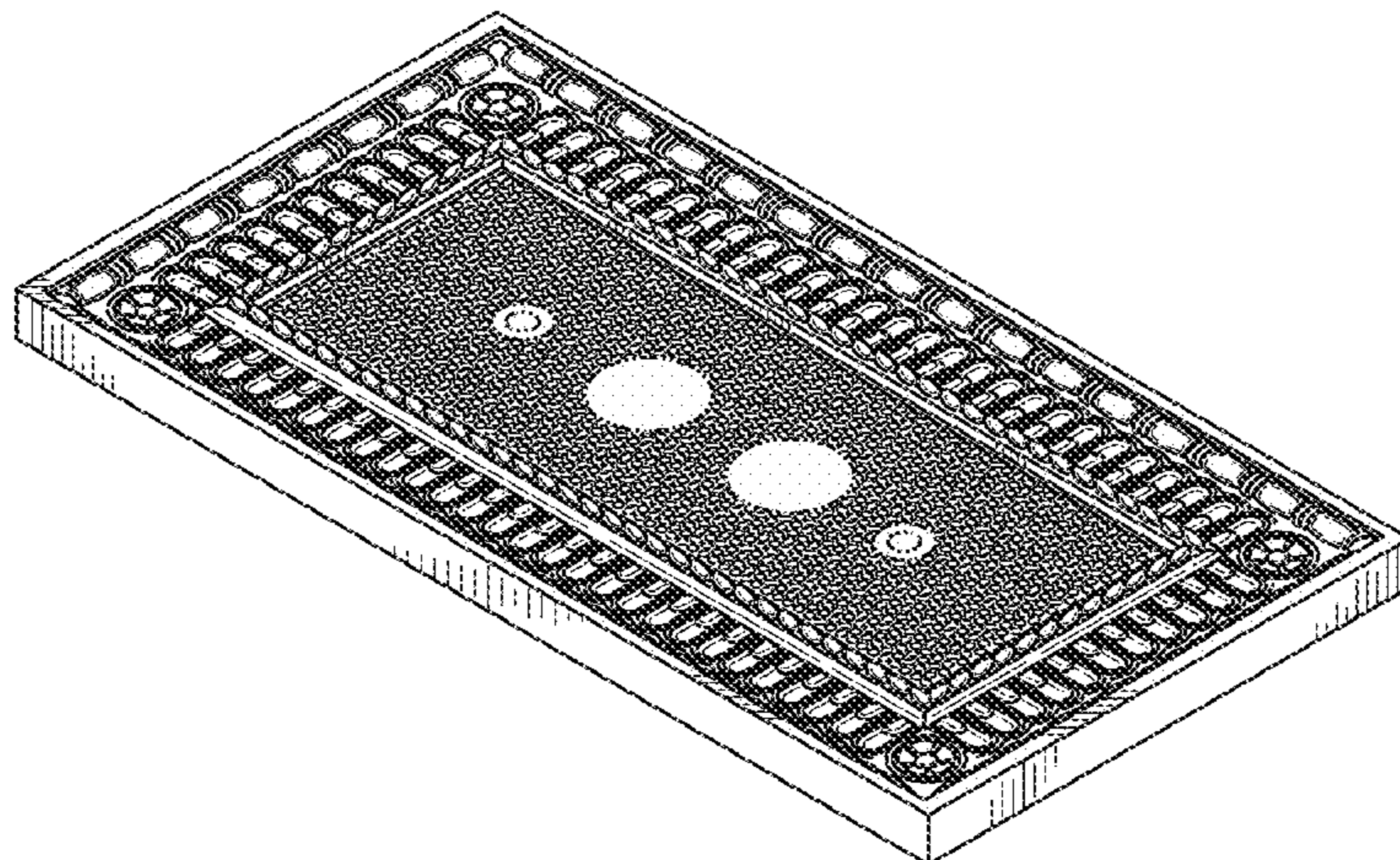
FIG. 15 is a bottom view thereof, the top view being the mirror image thereof; and,

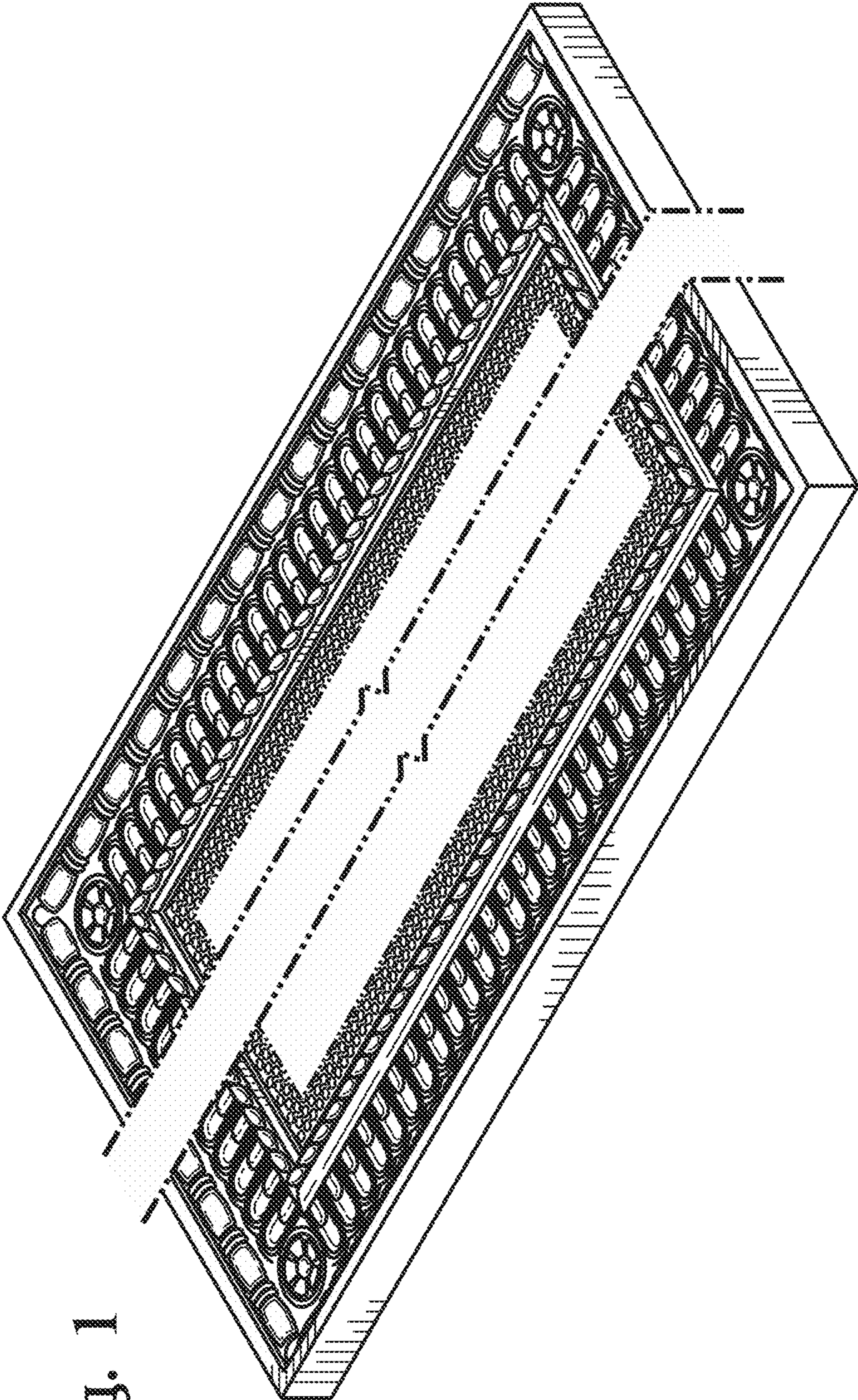

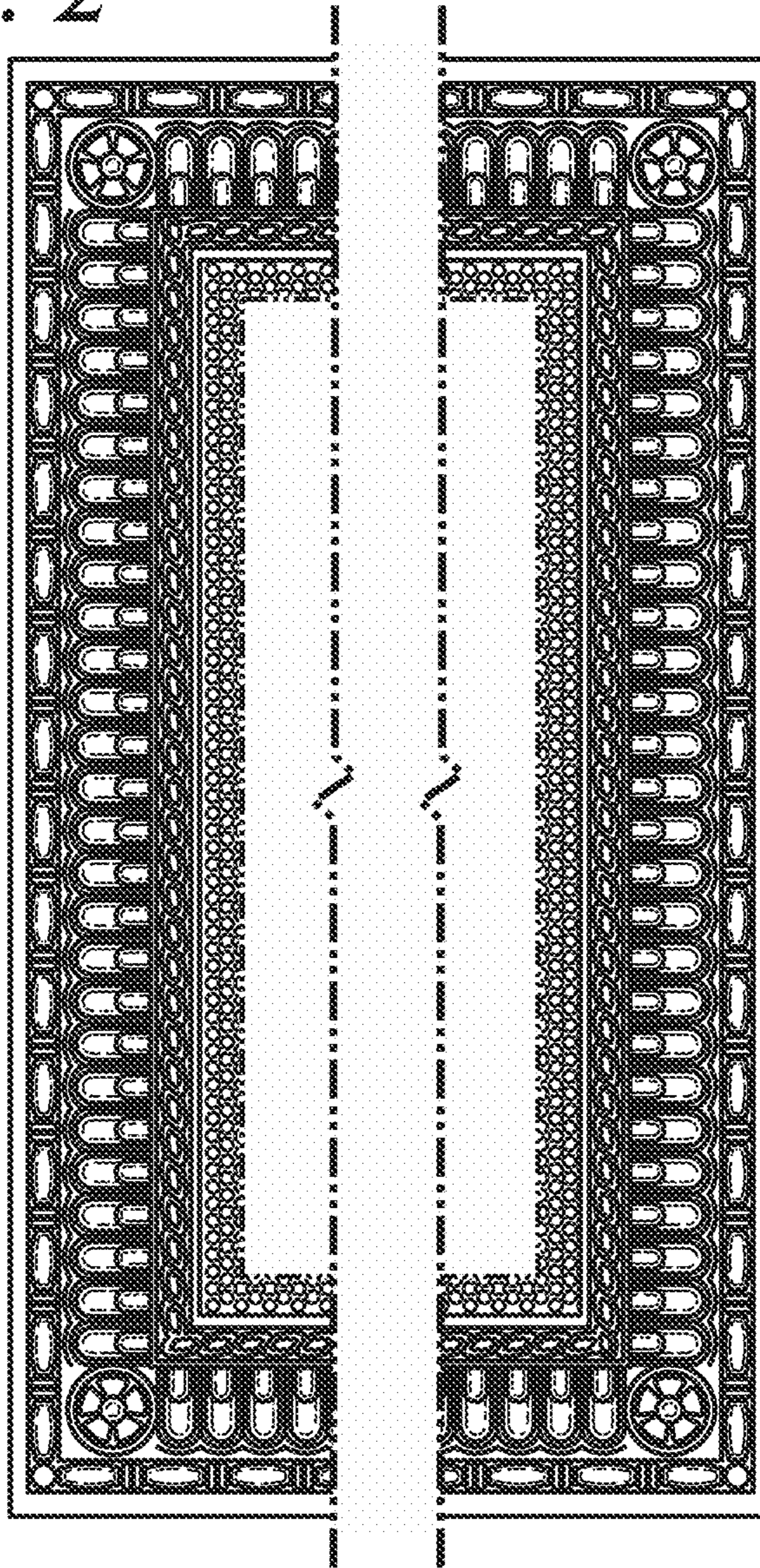
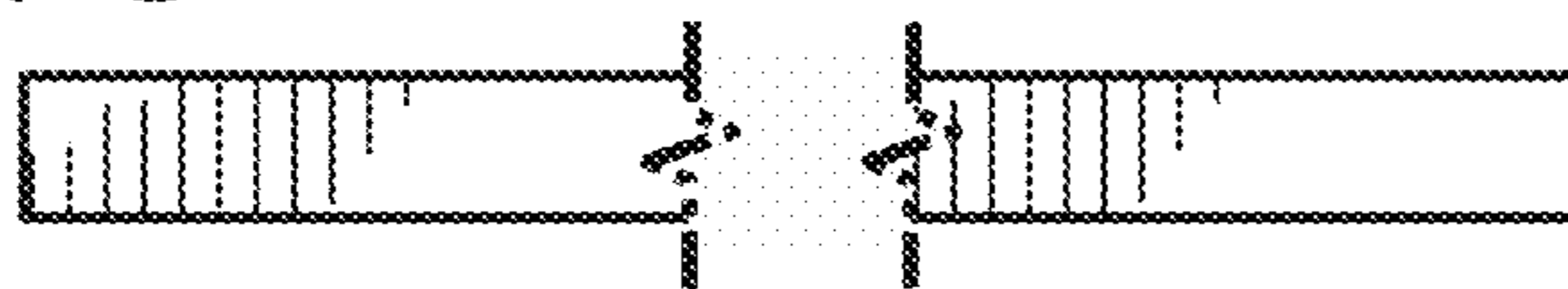

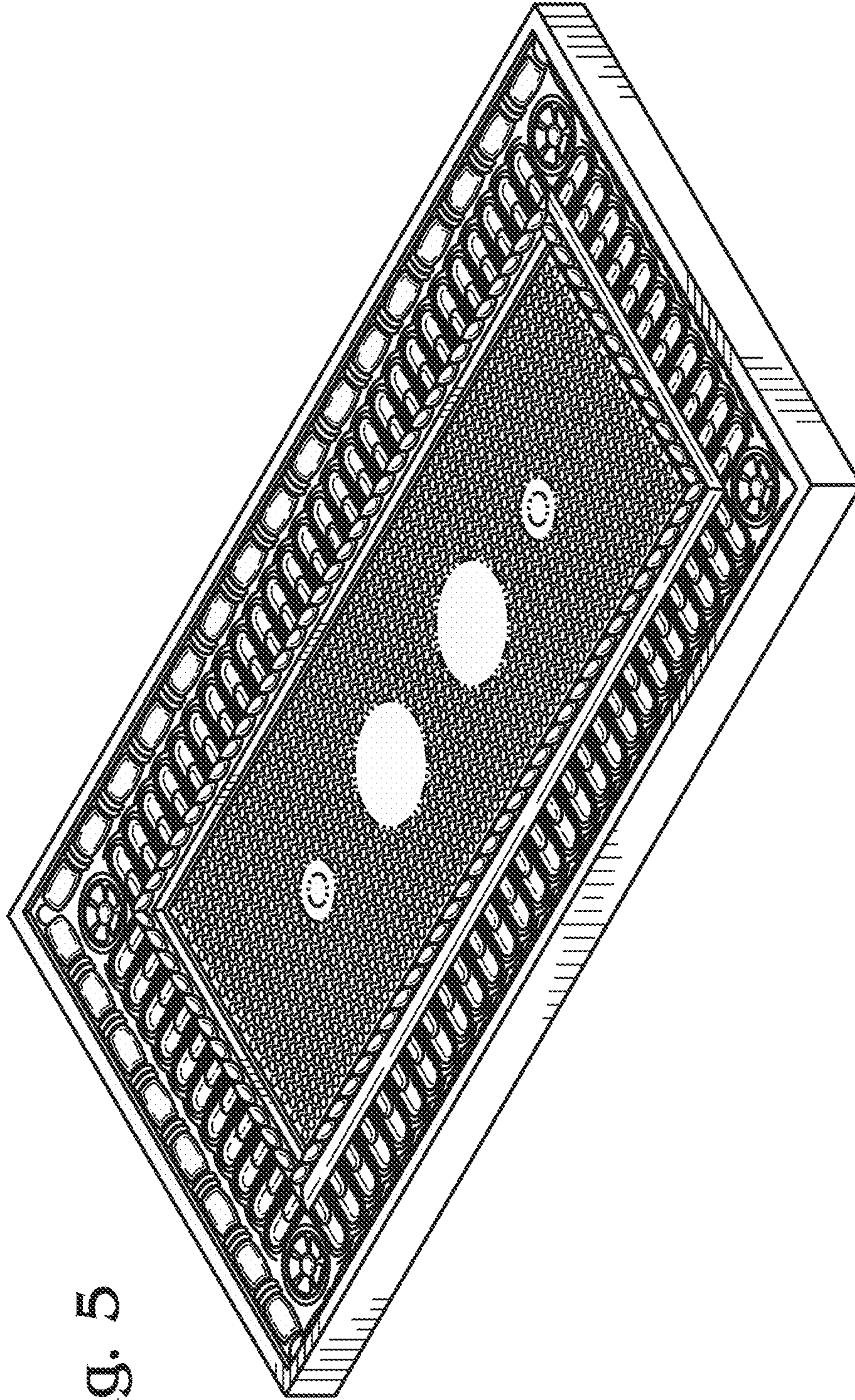

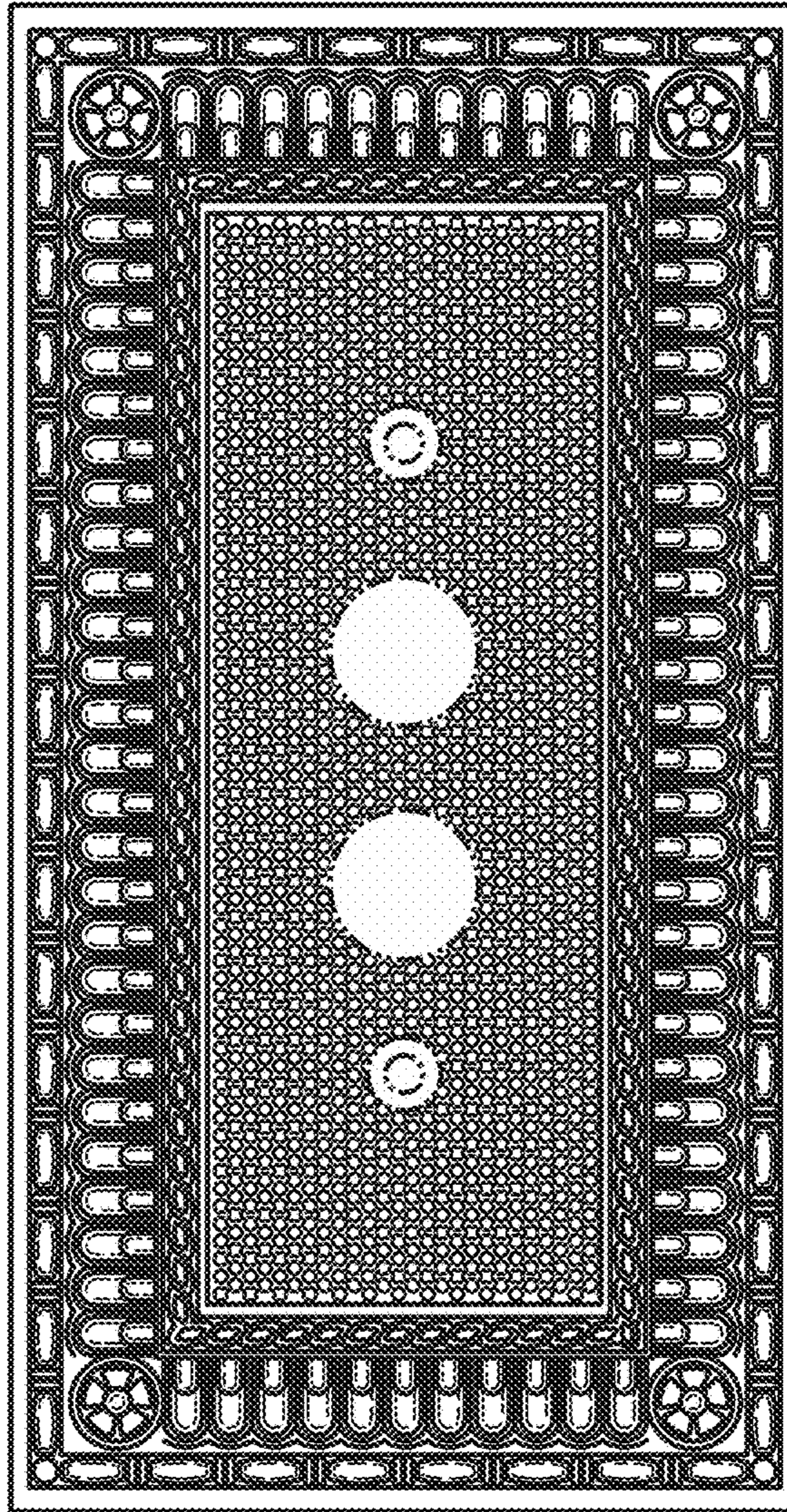

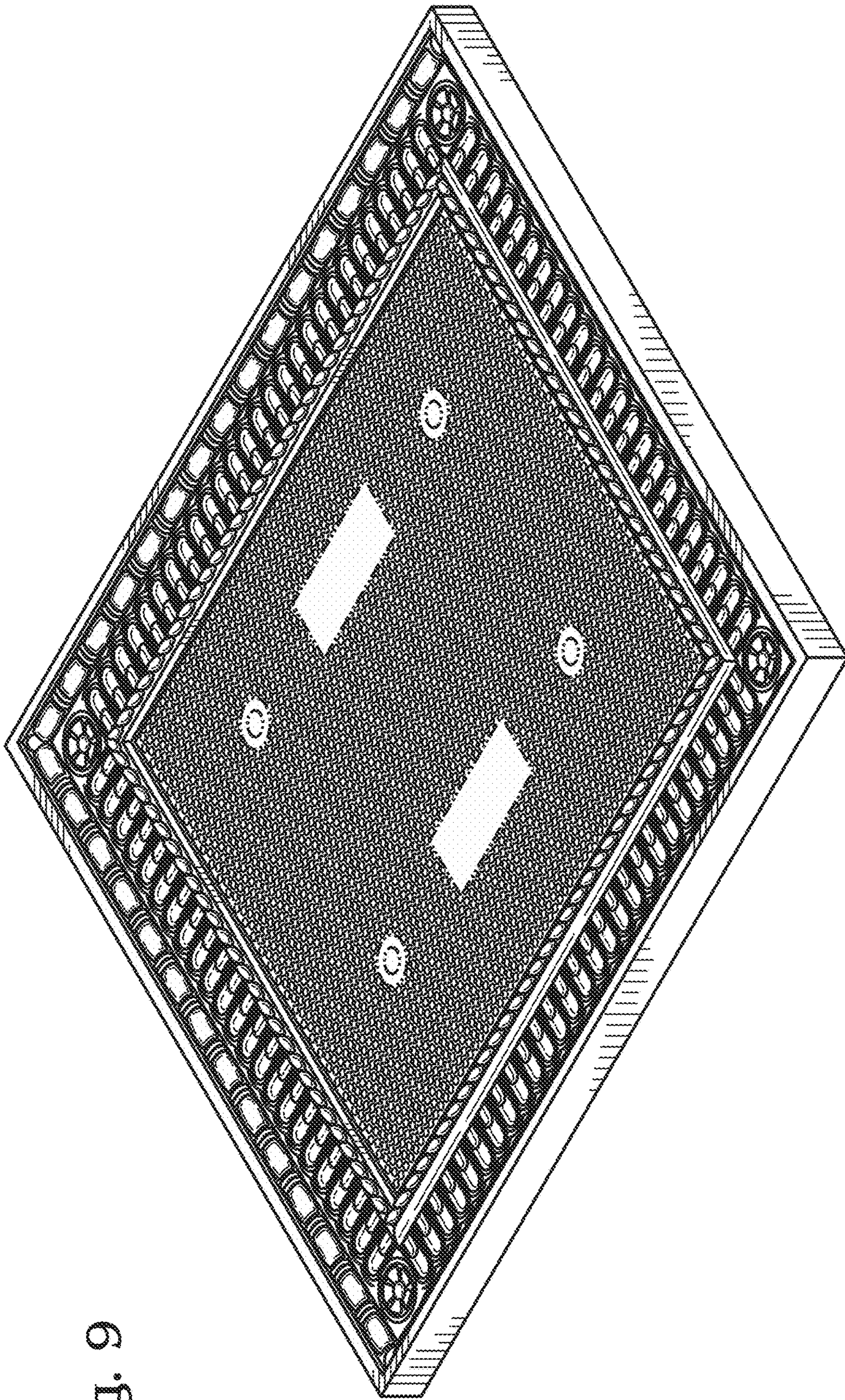

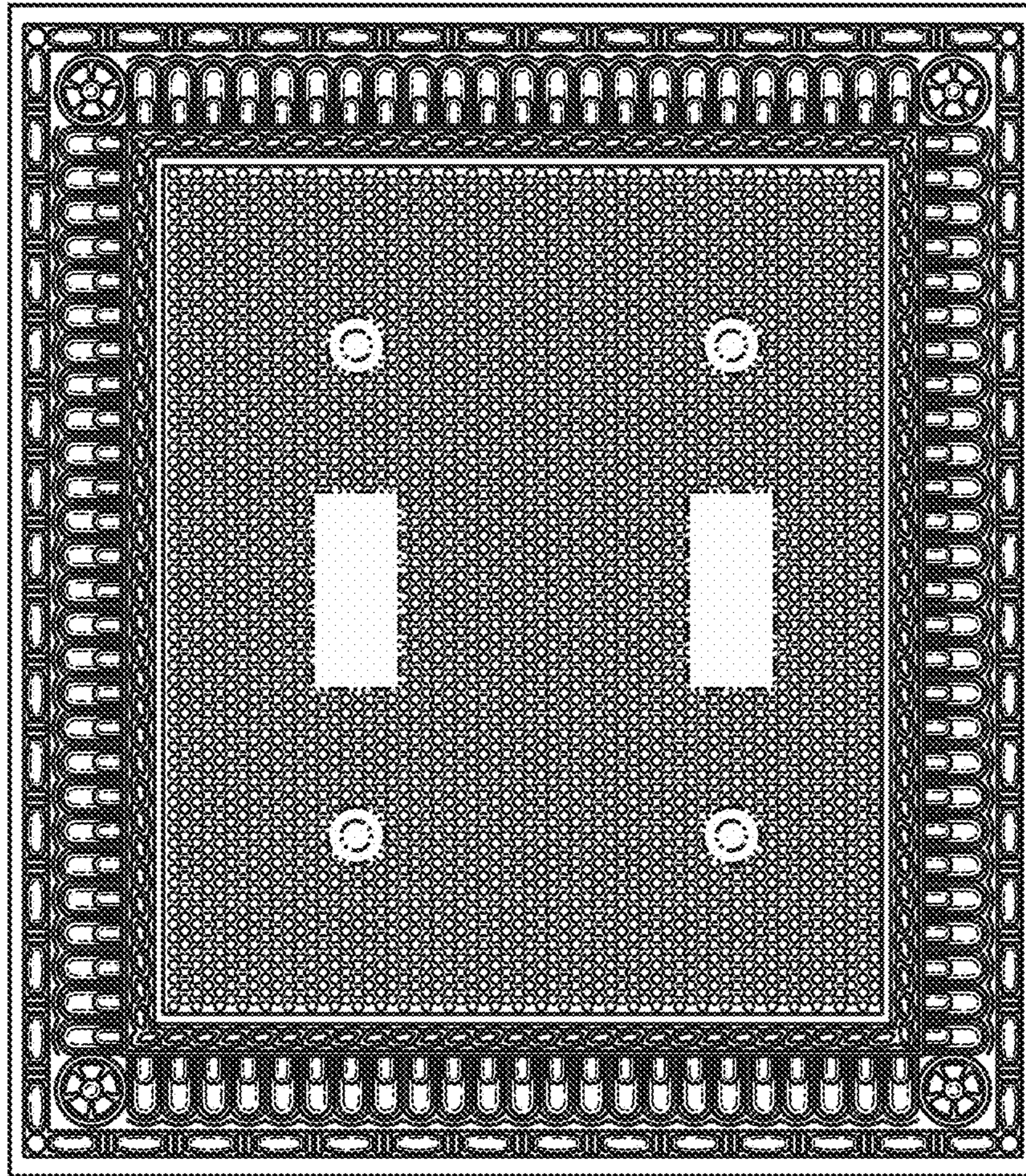

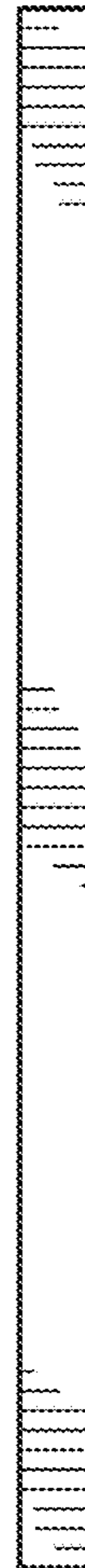

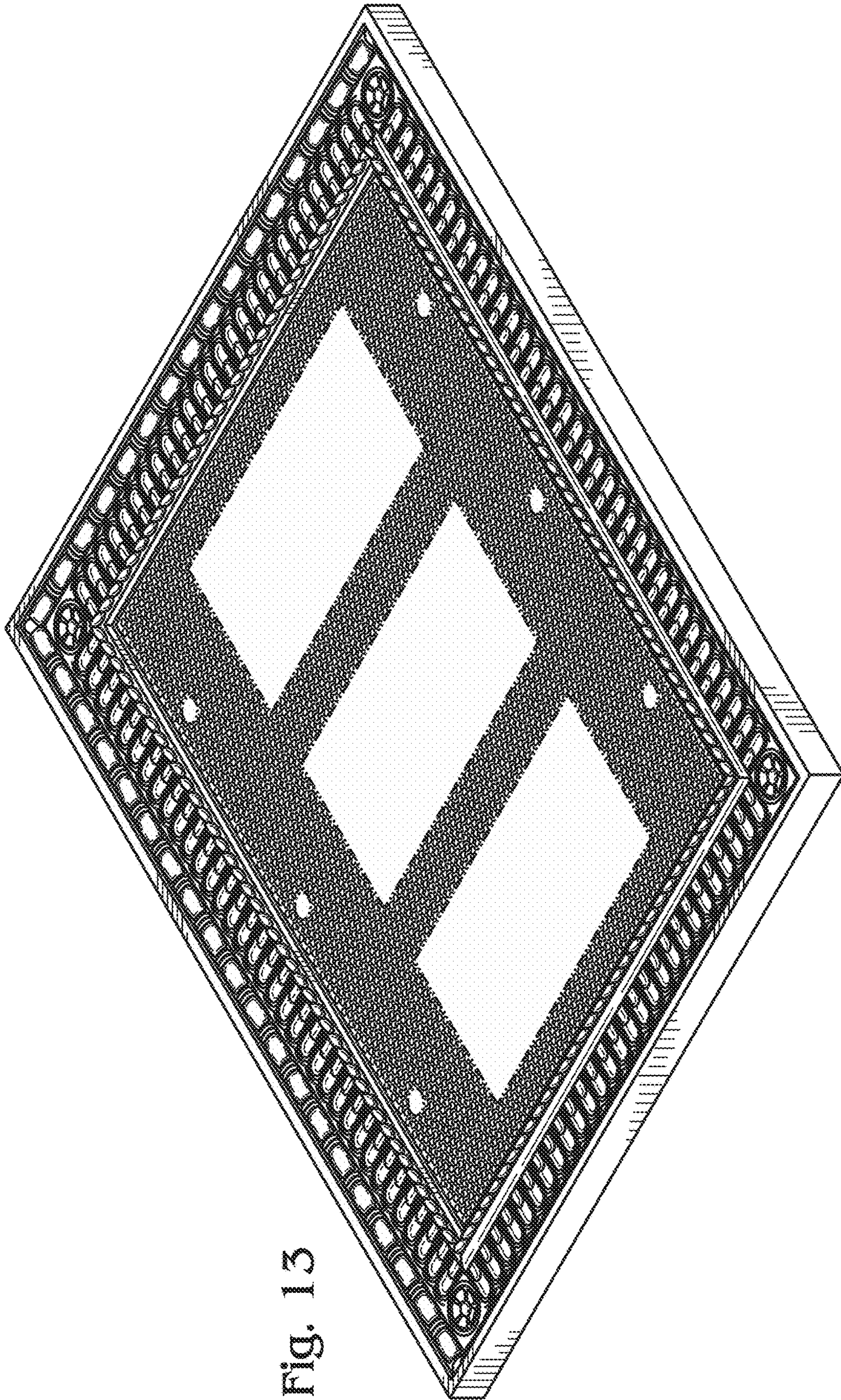

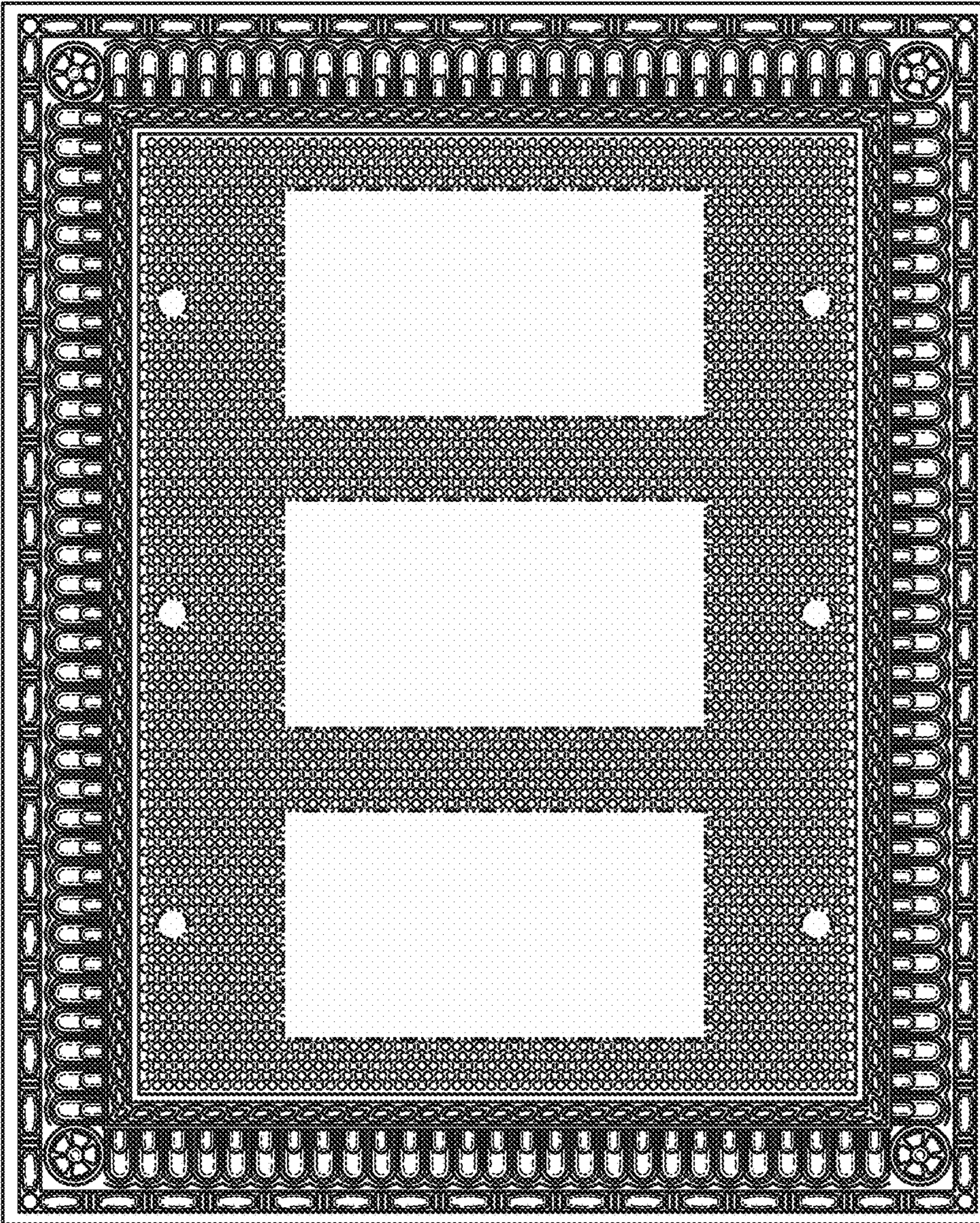
