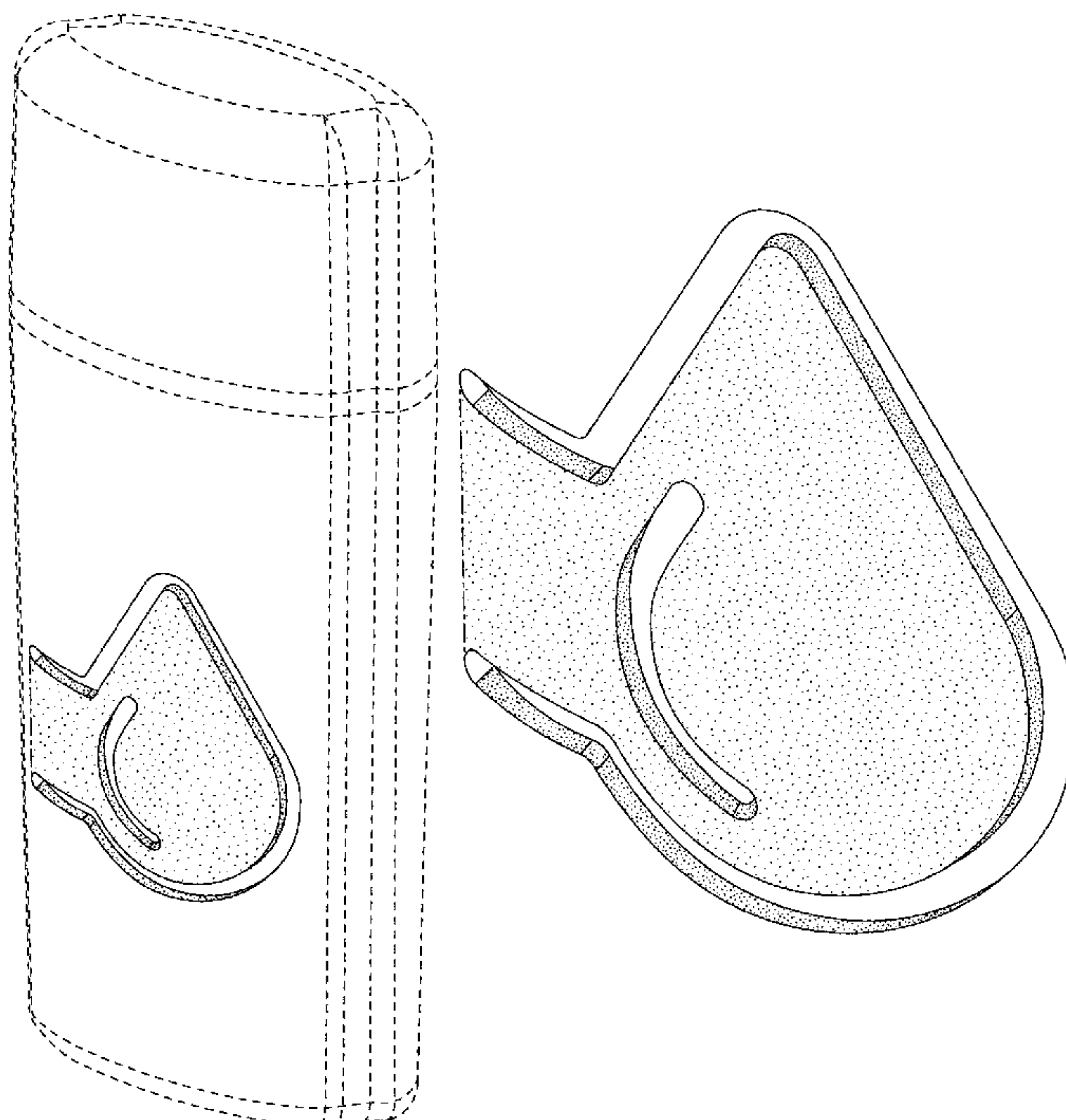
The ornamental design for an actuator button for a container,

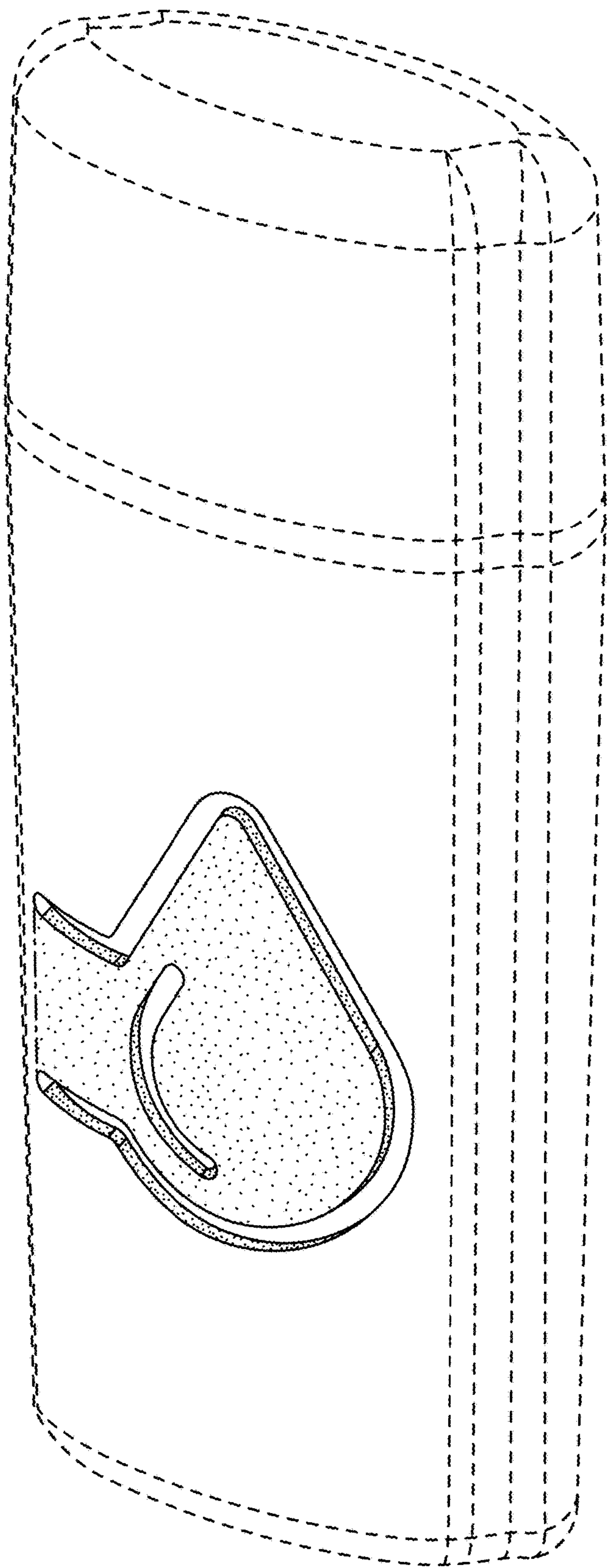

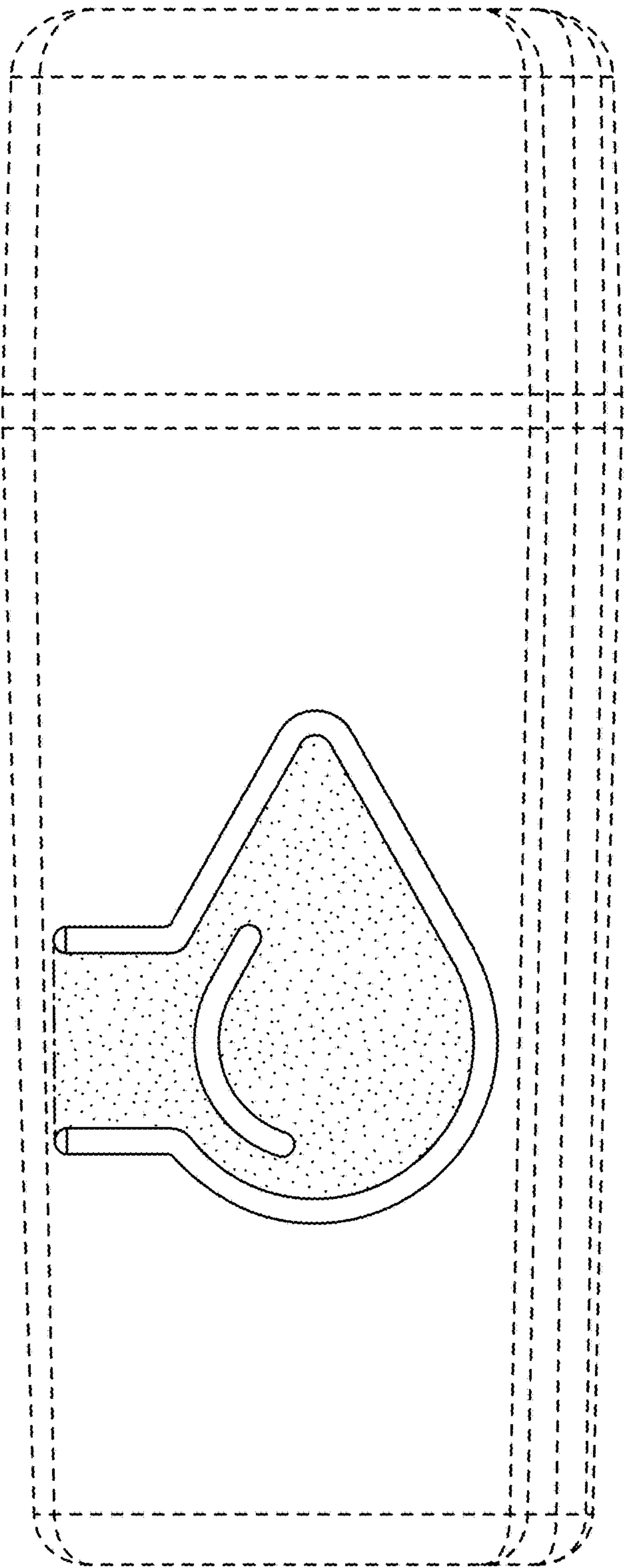

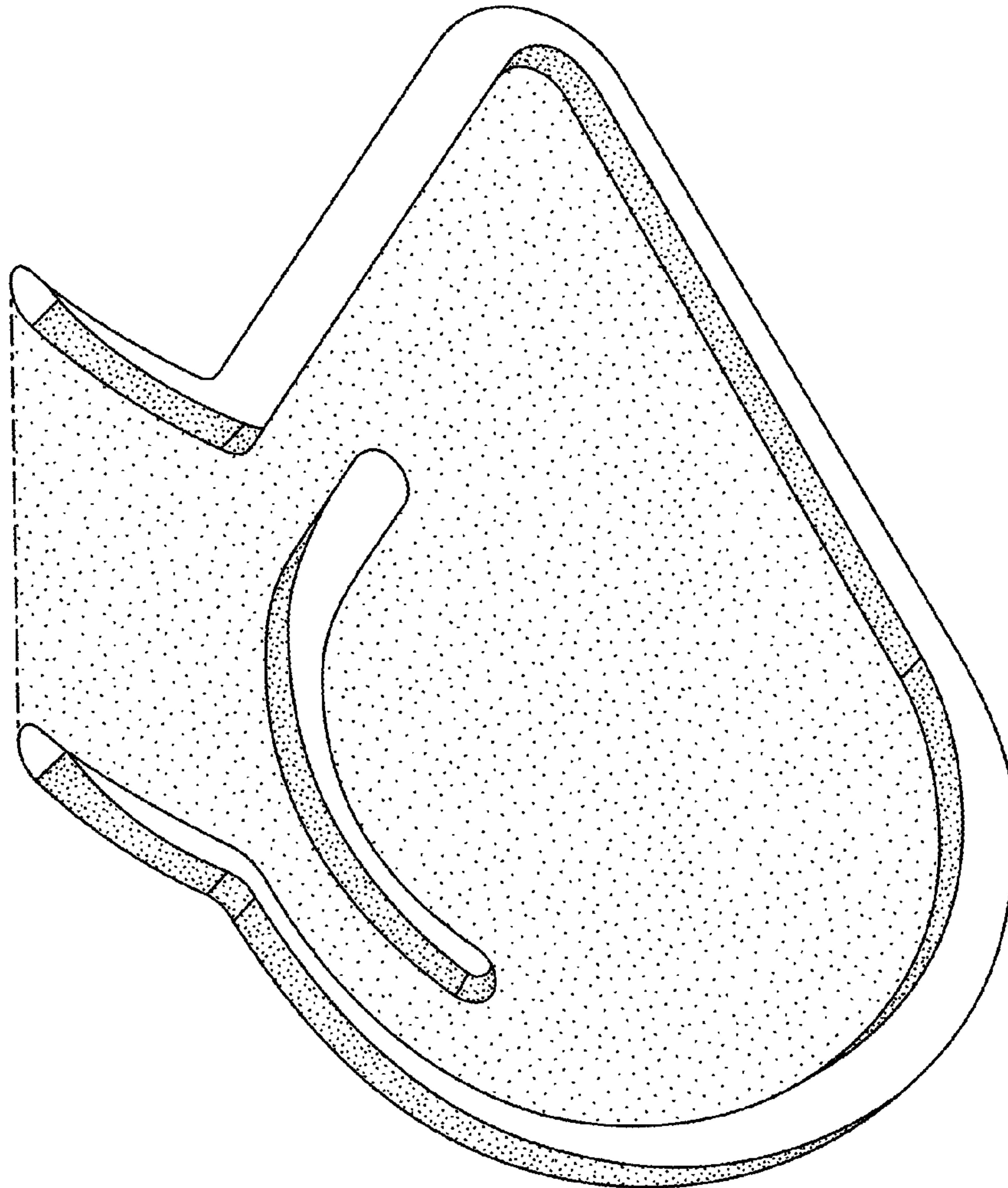

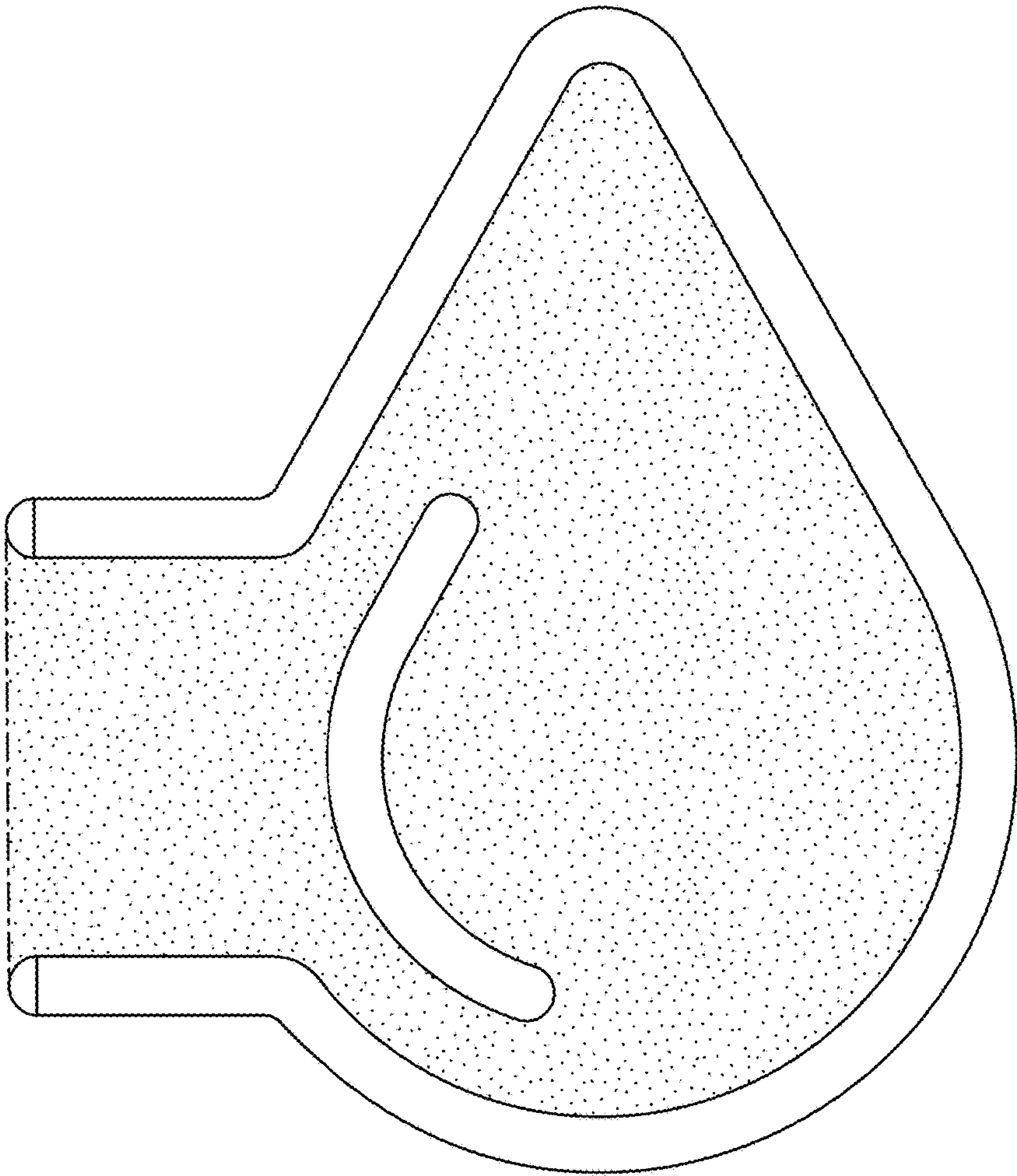
