FIG. 5 is a right lateral view of the string instrument head stock.

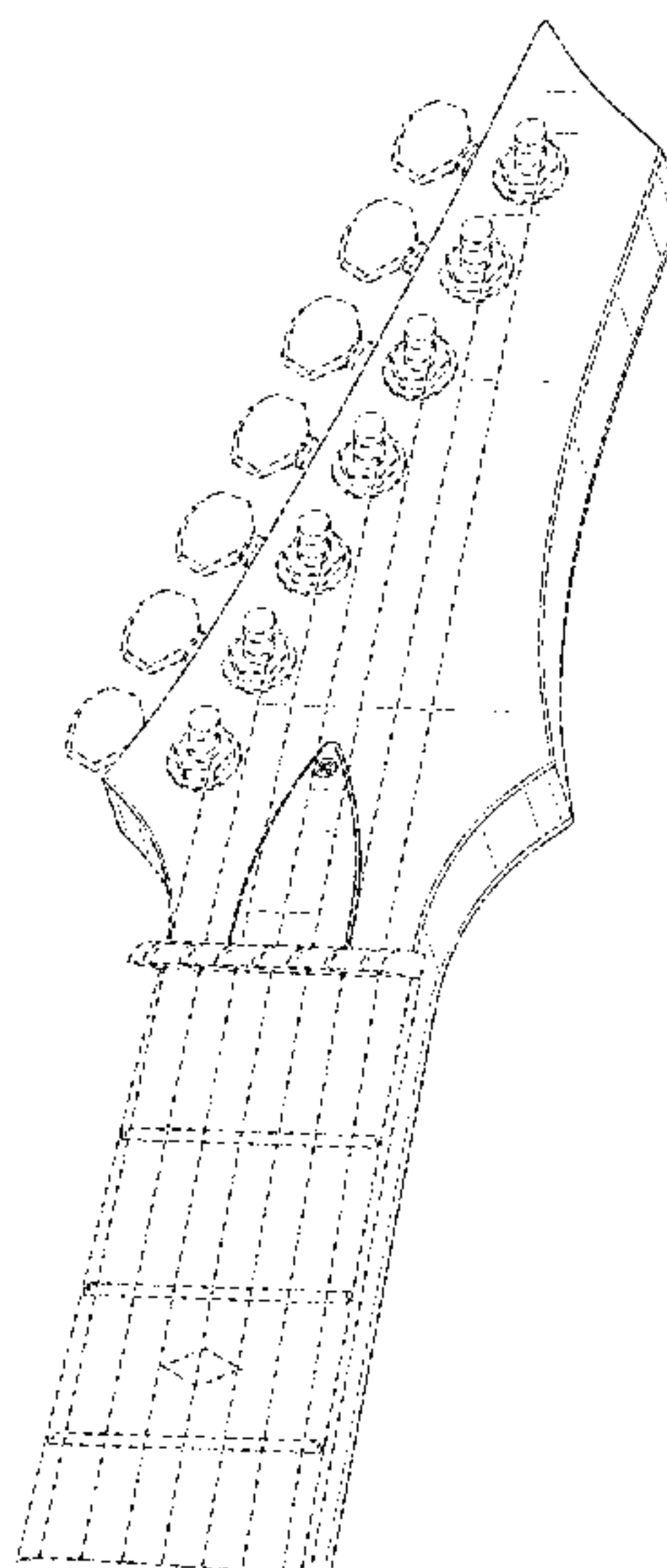
FIG. 6 is a top view of the string instrument head stock.

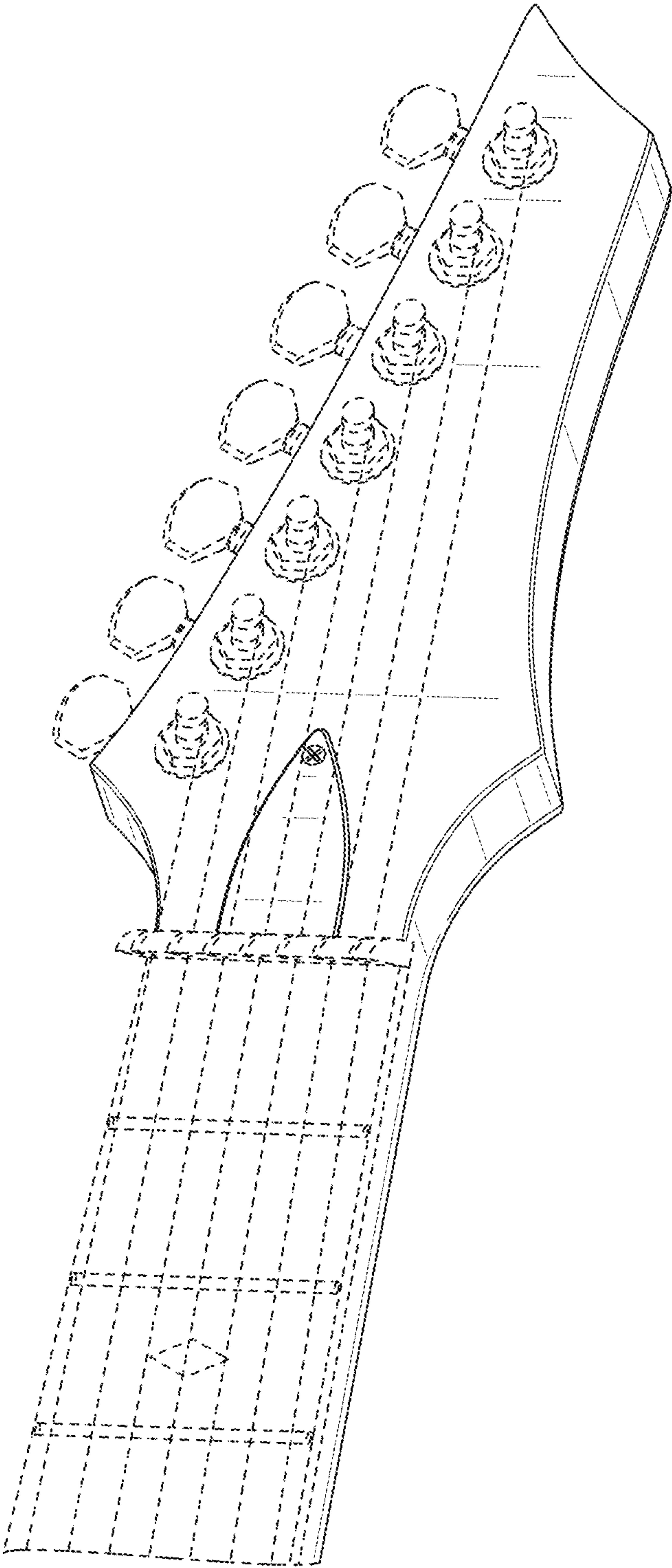

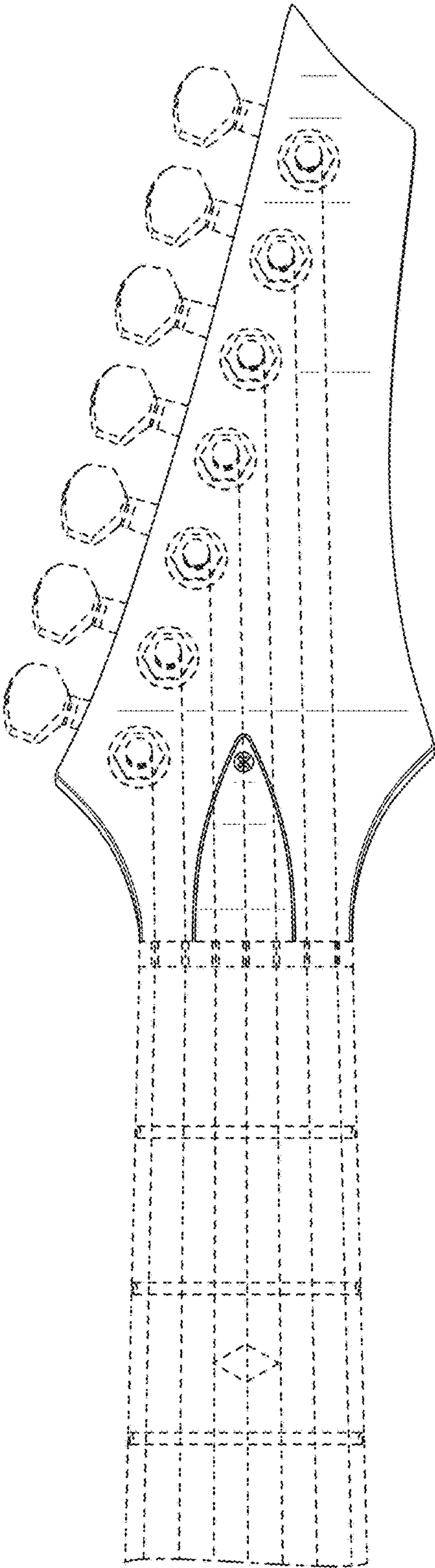

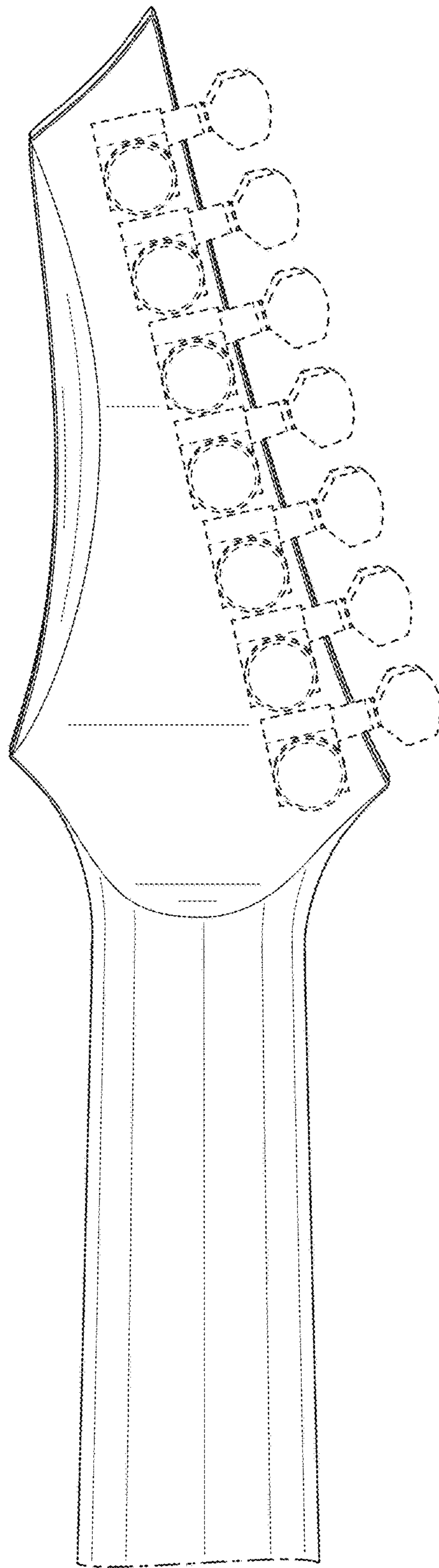

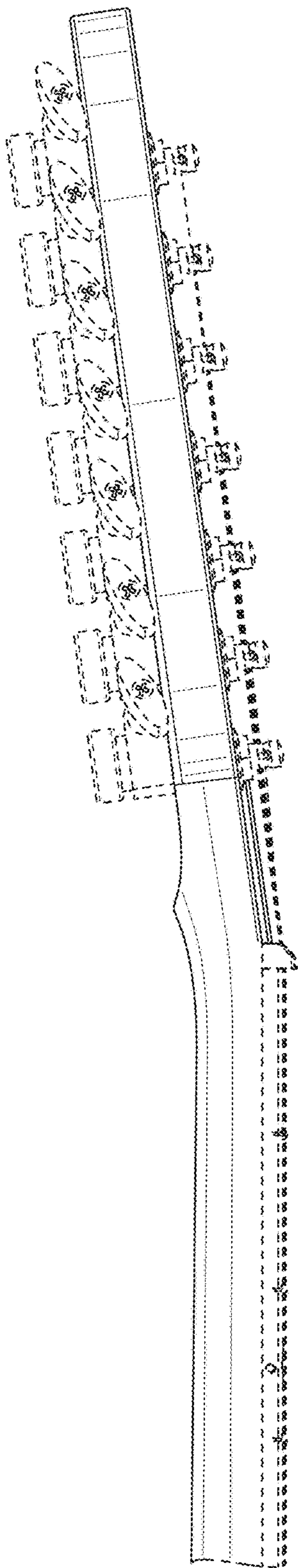

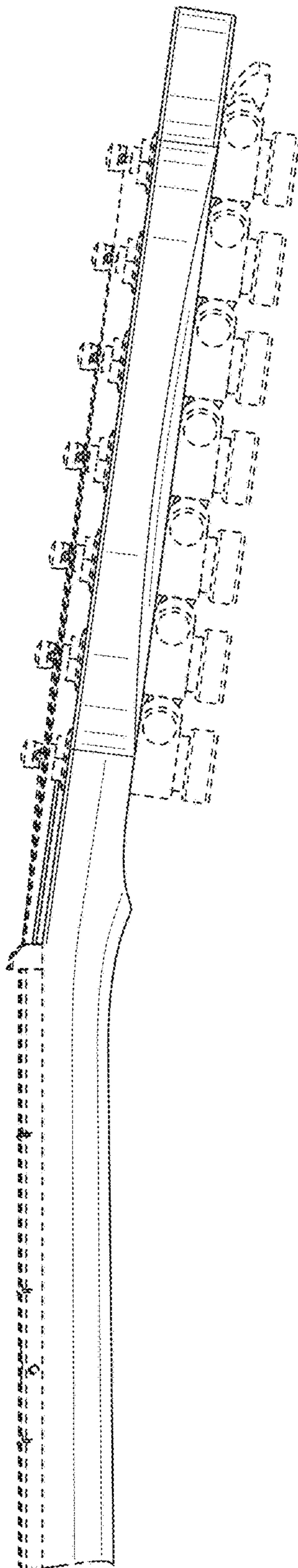

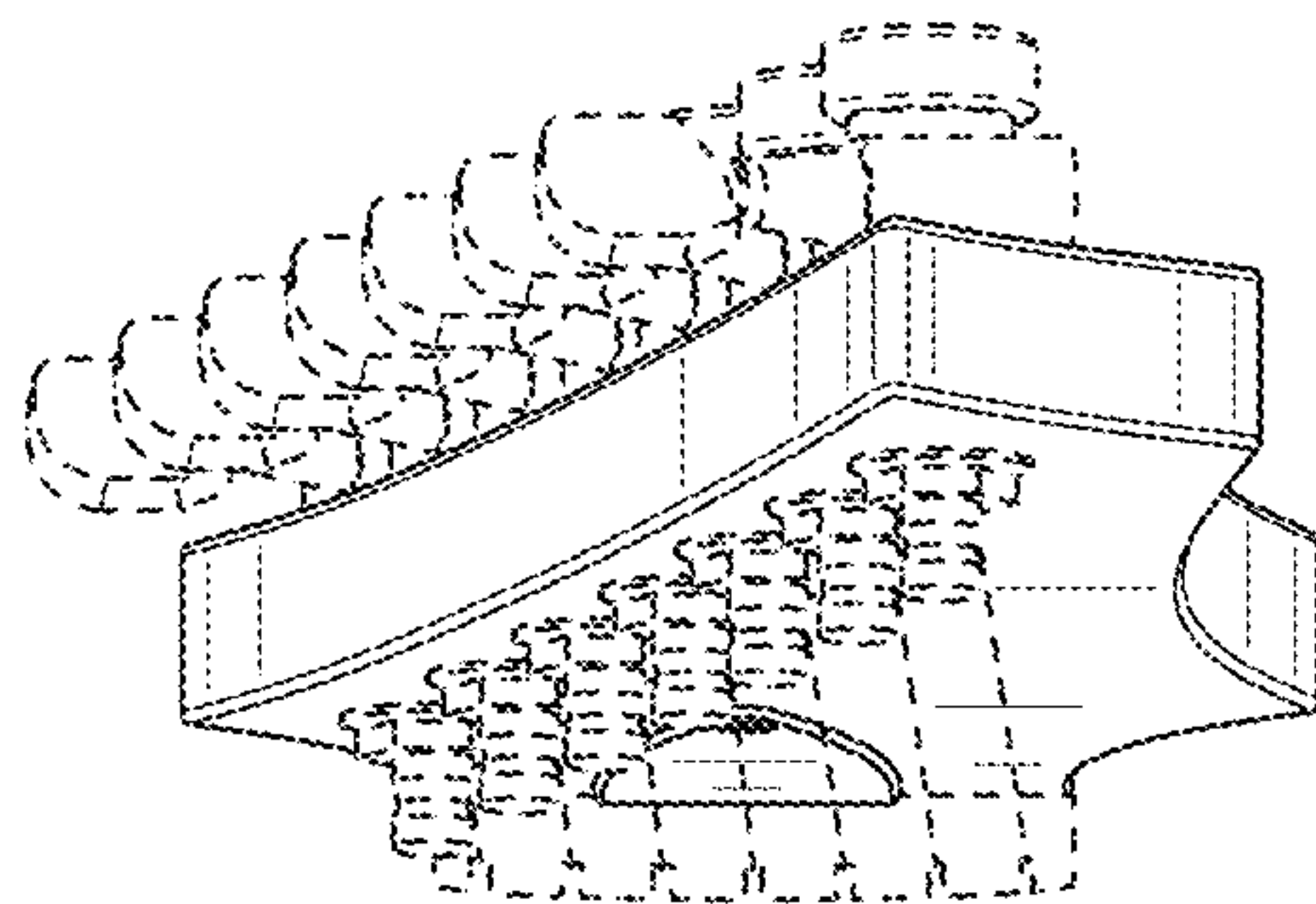

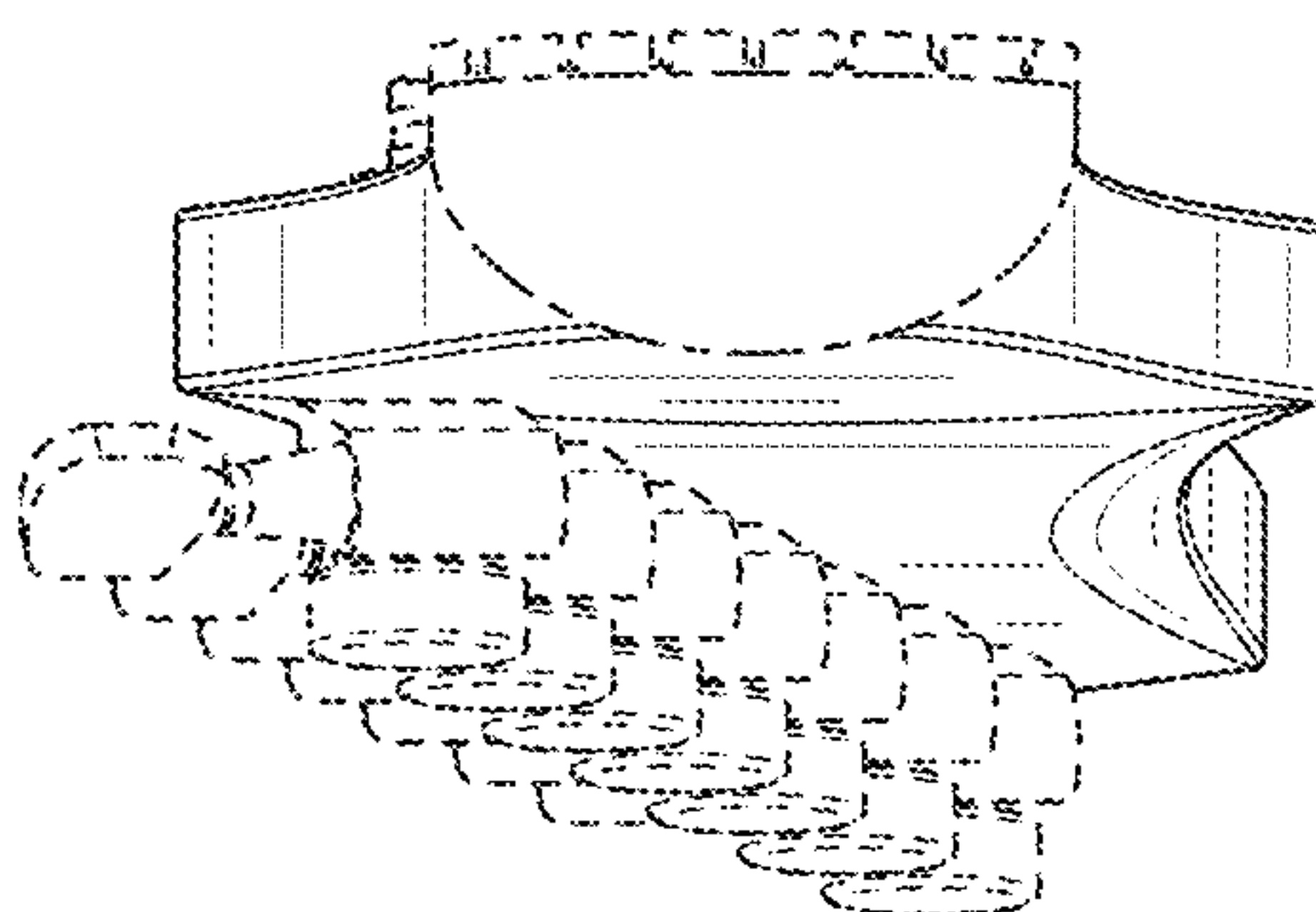

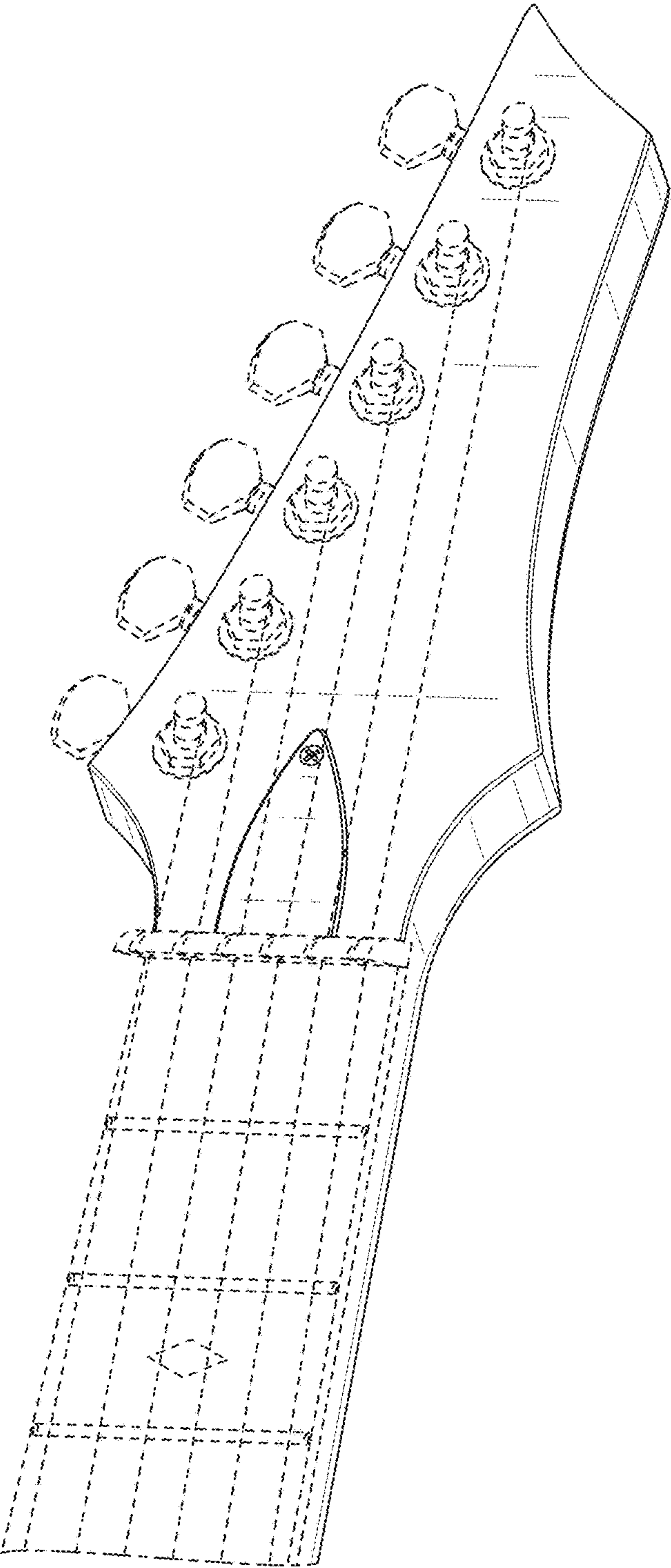
