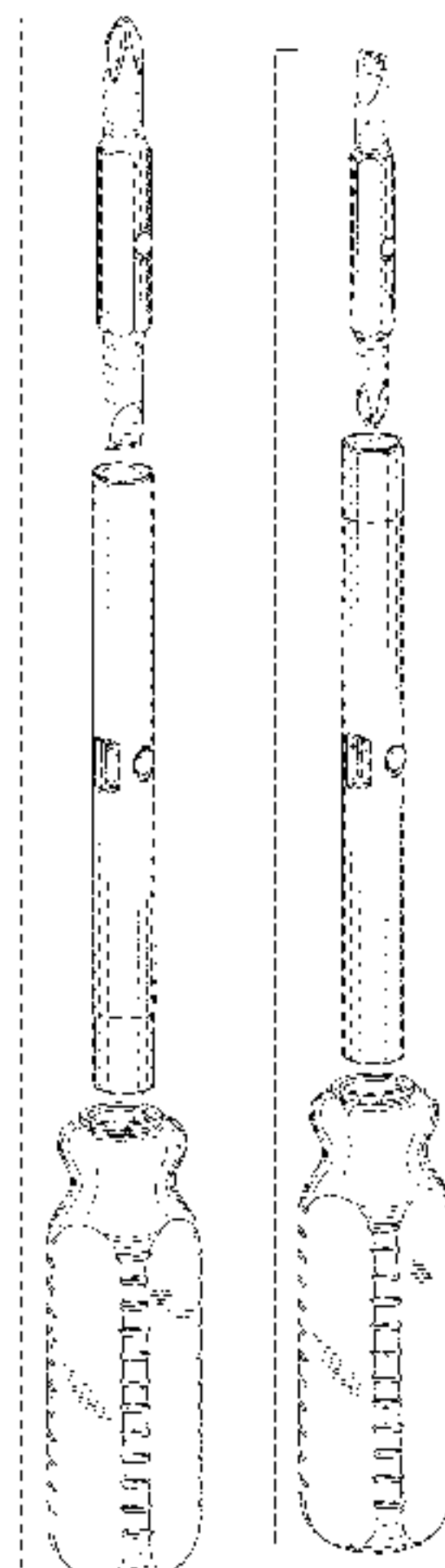

The ornamental design for a screwdriver set, as shown and described.

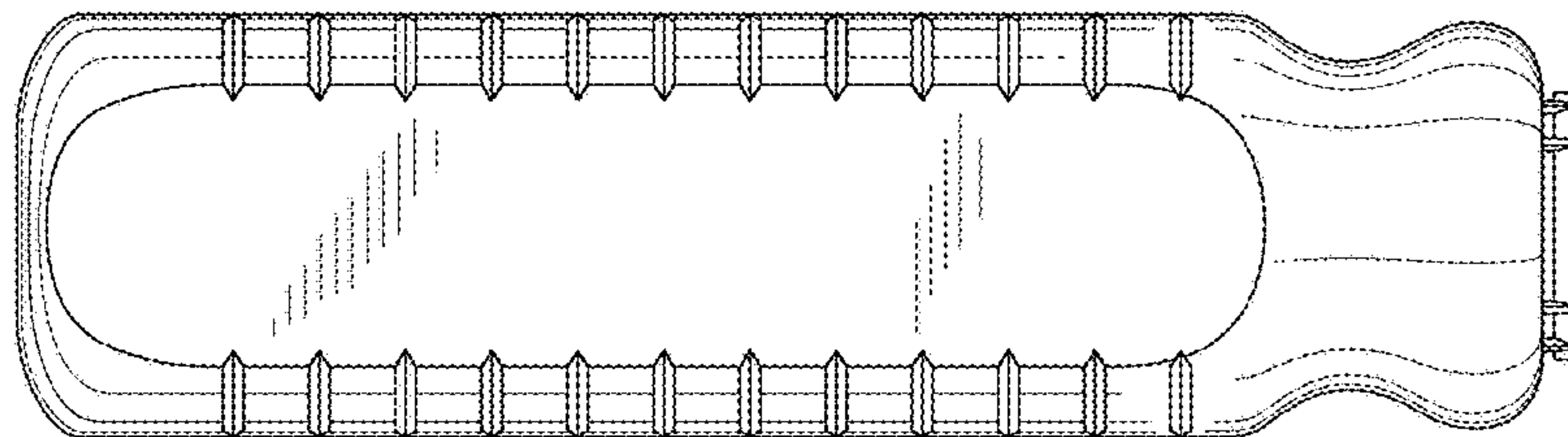

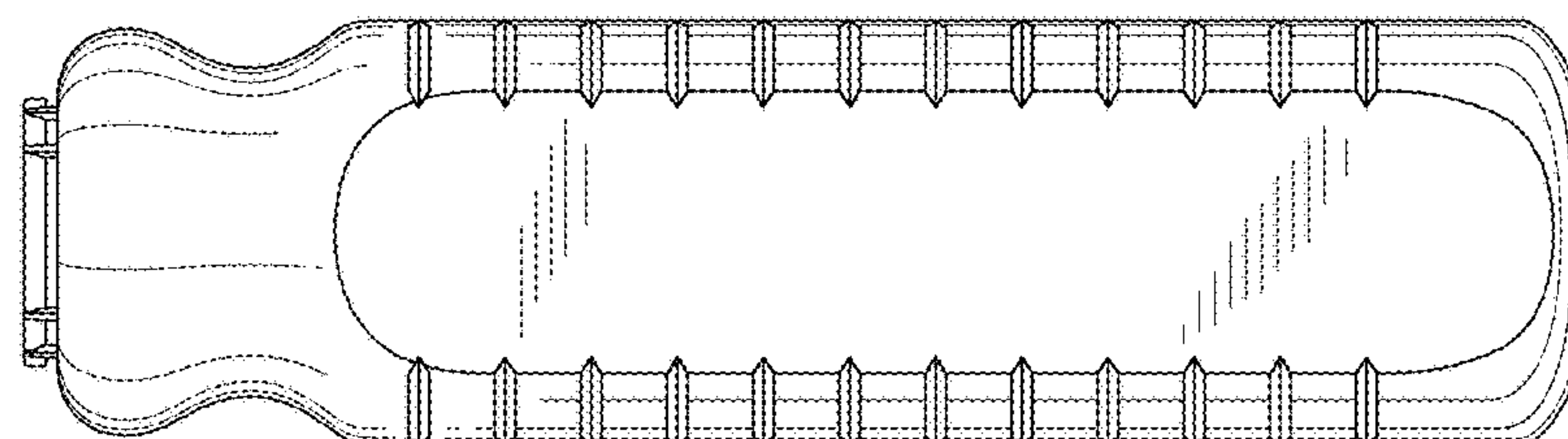

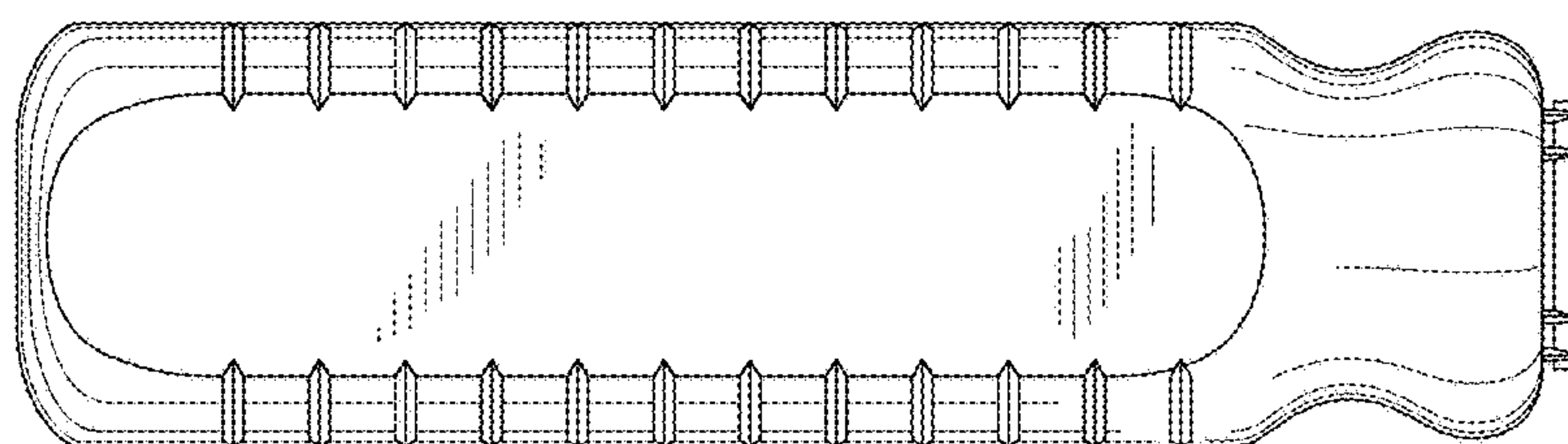

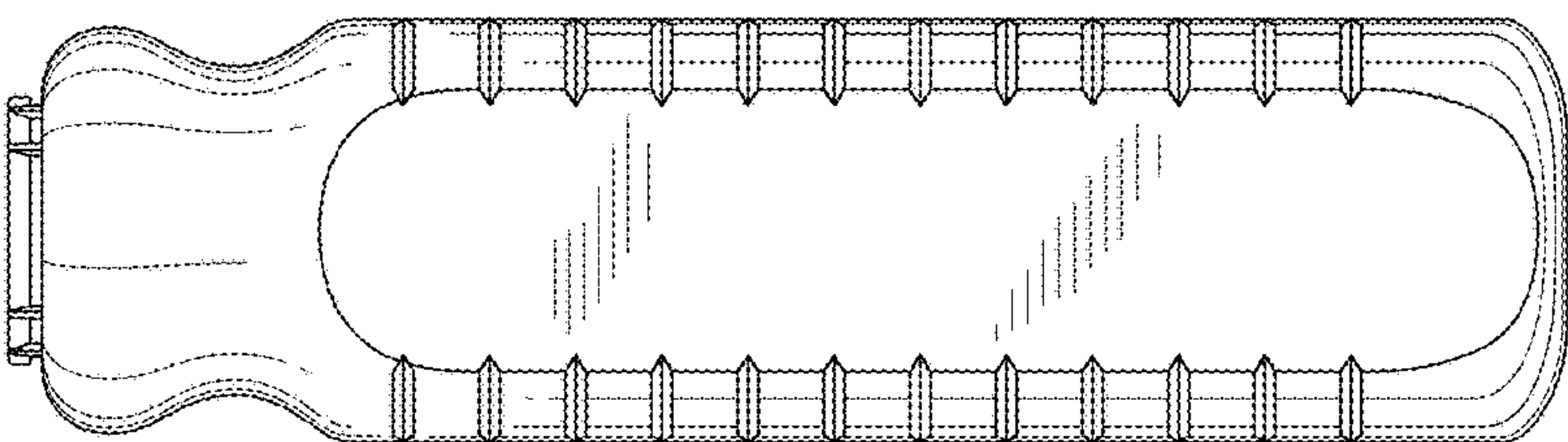

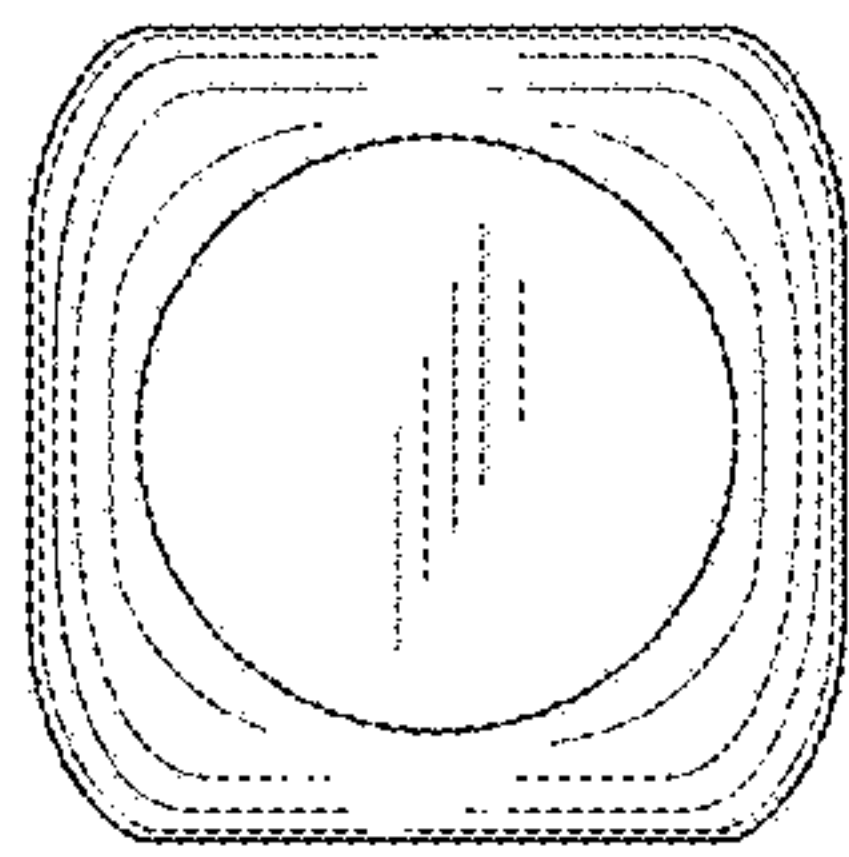

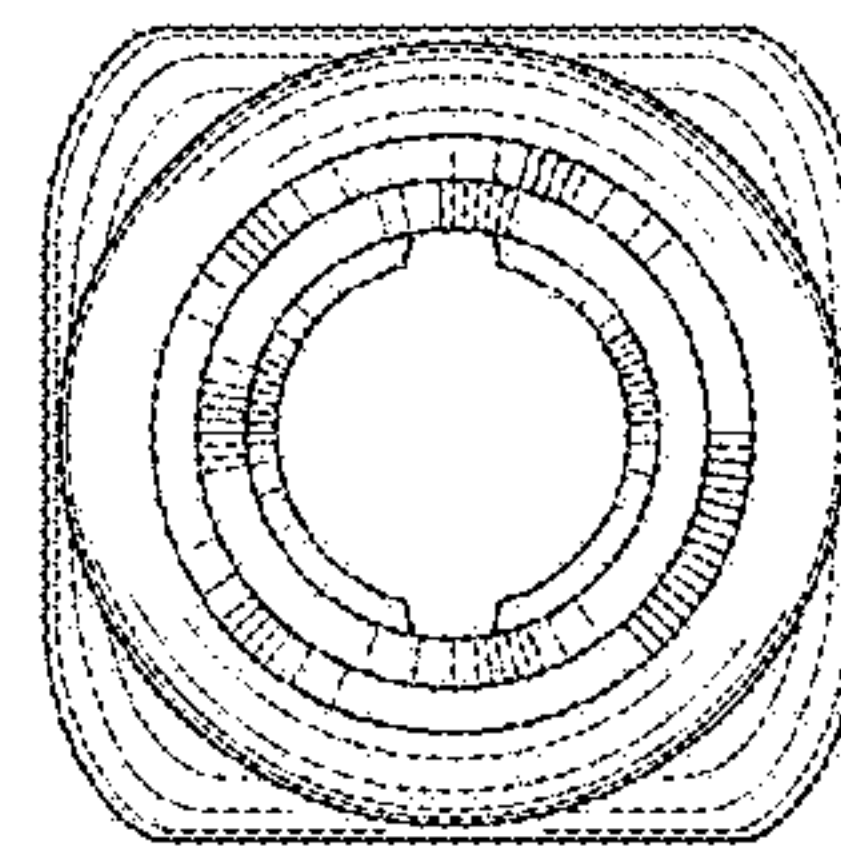

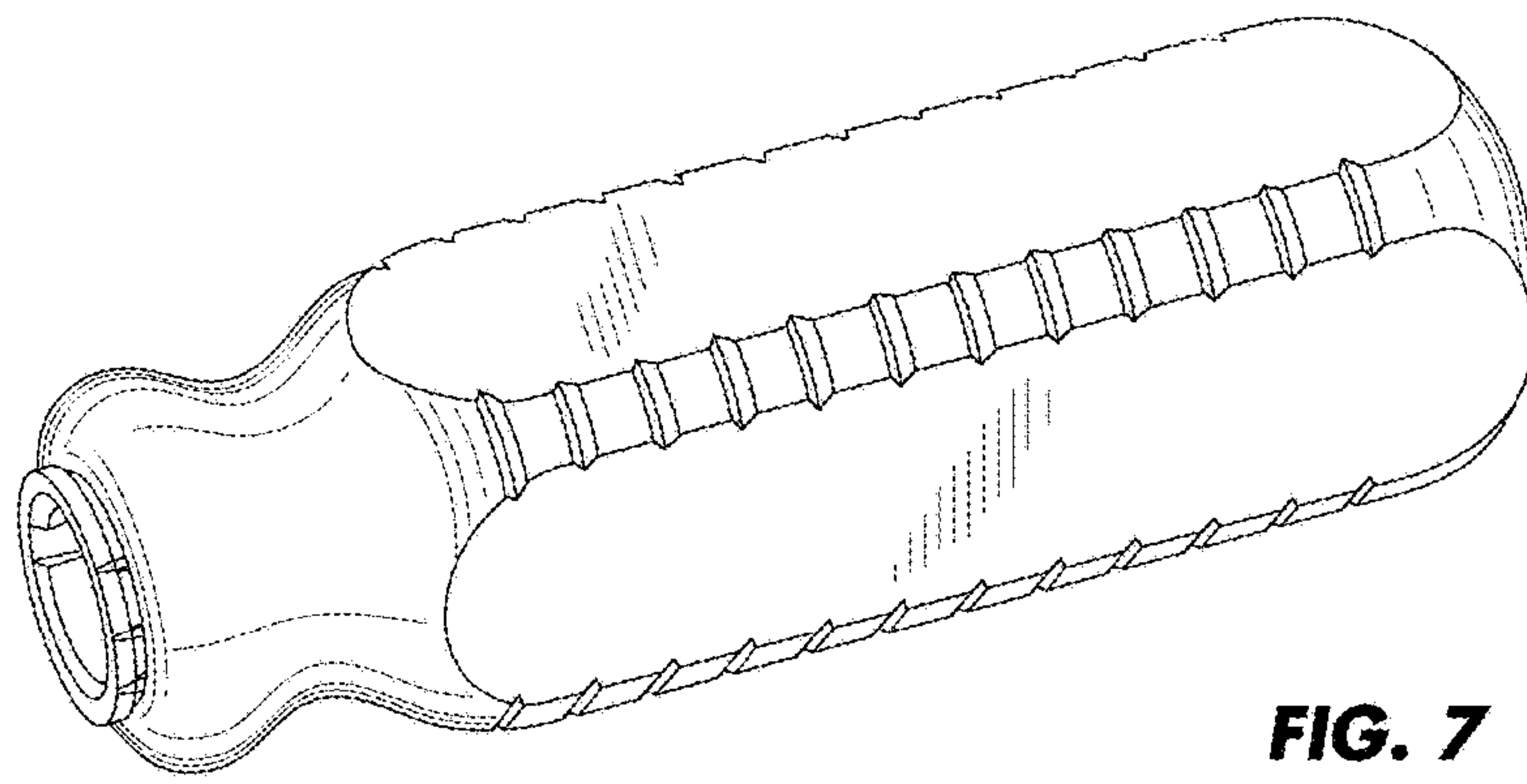

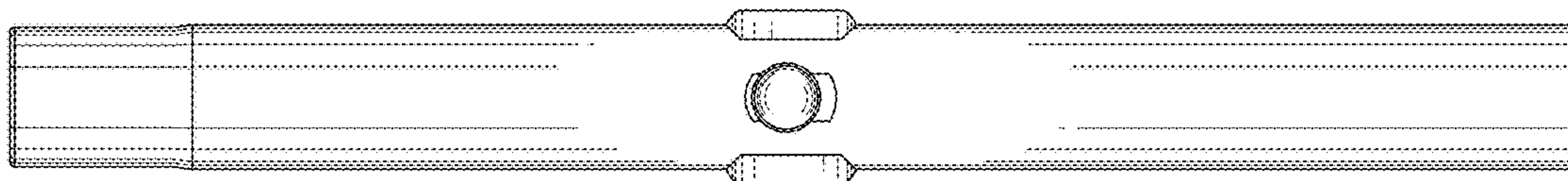

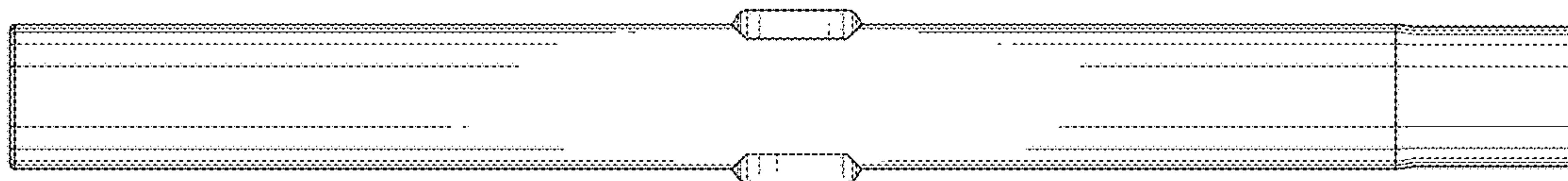

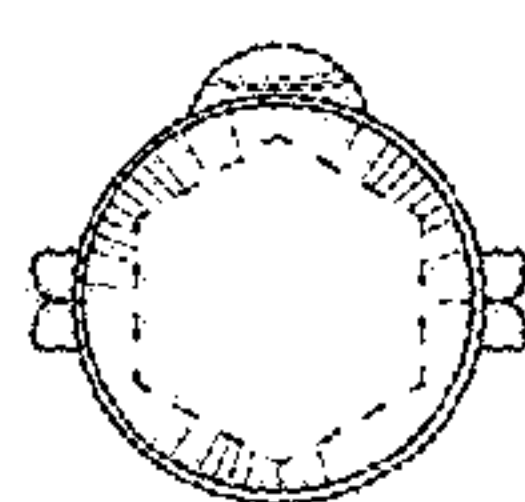

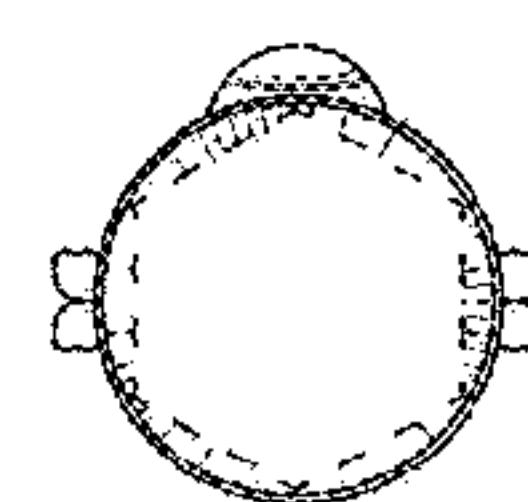

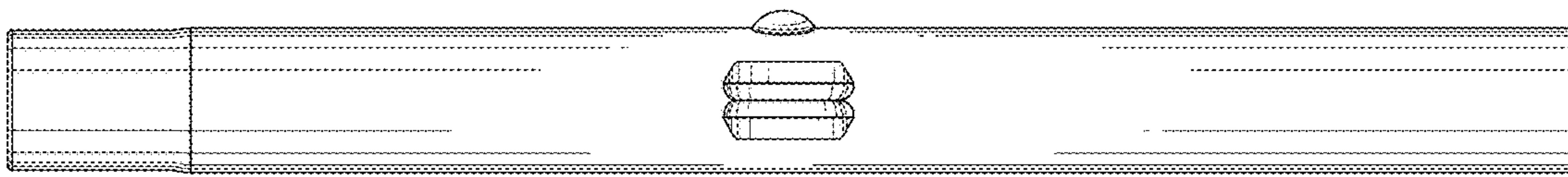

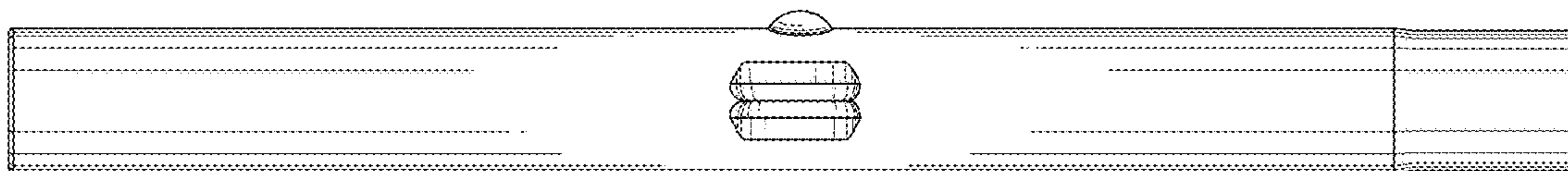

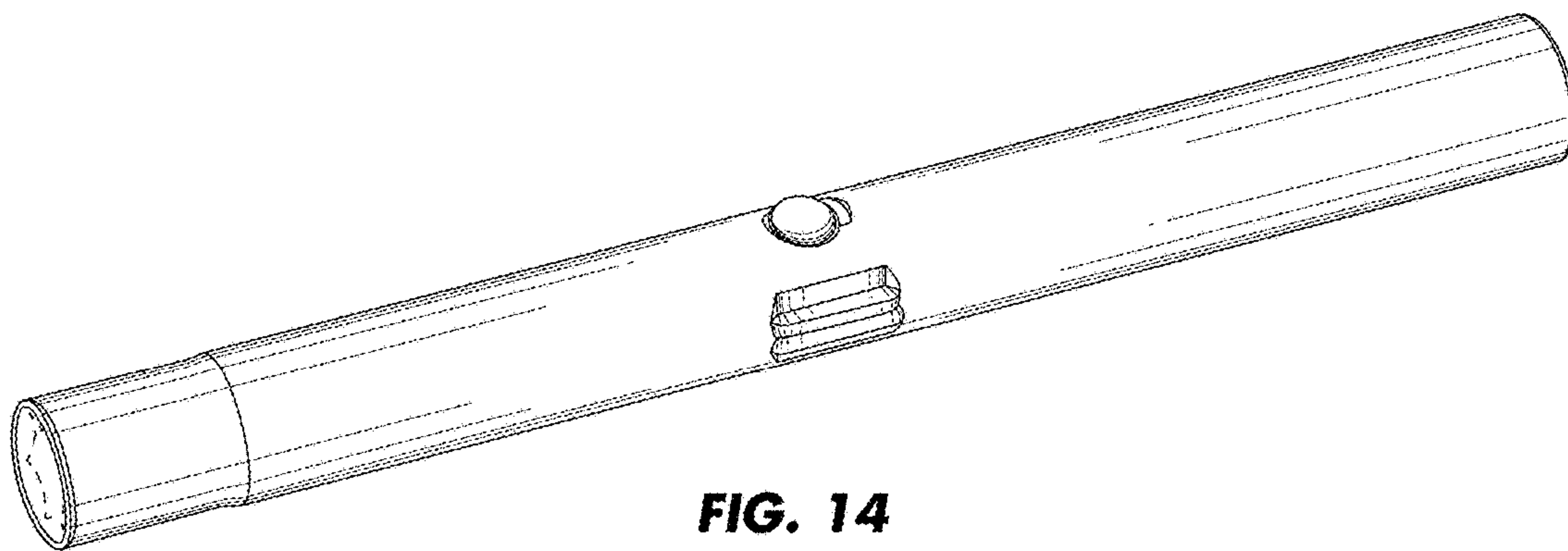

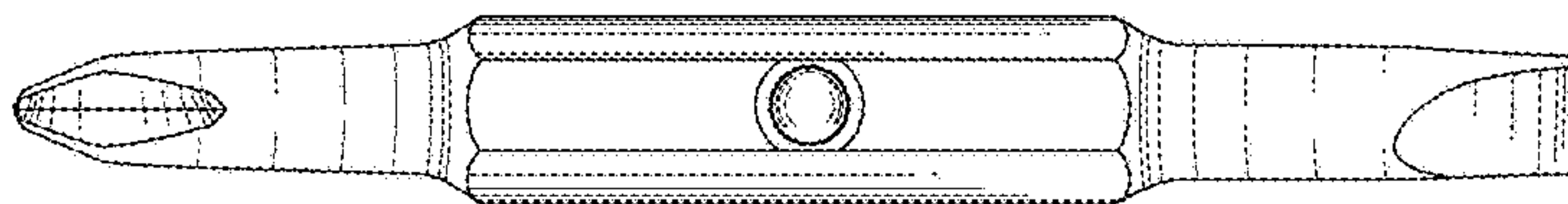

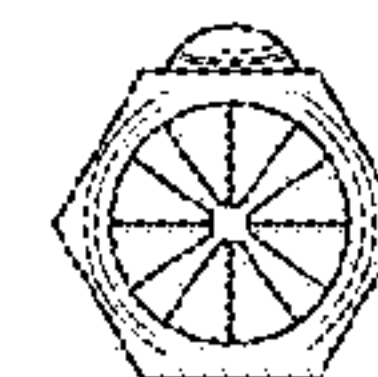

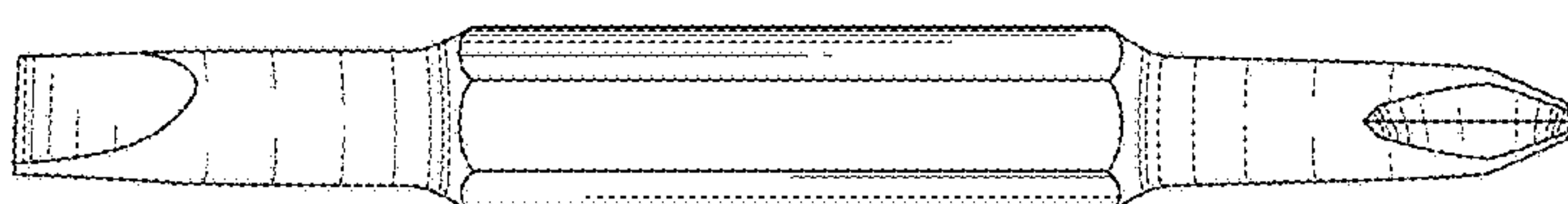

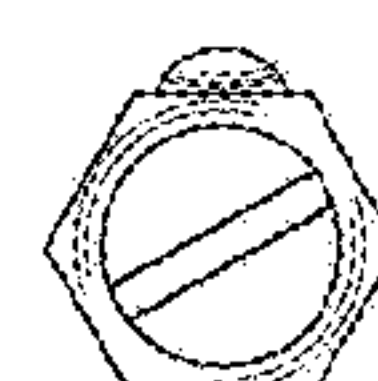

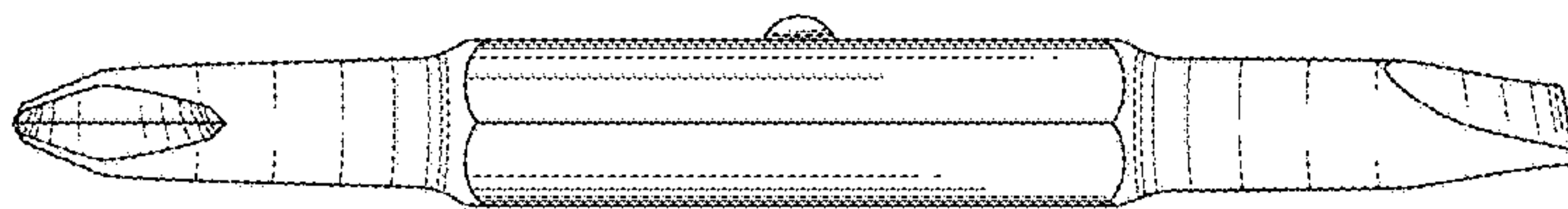

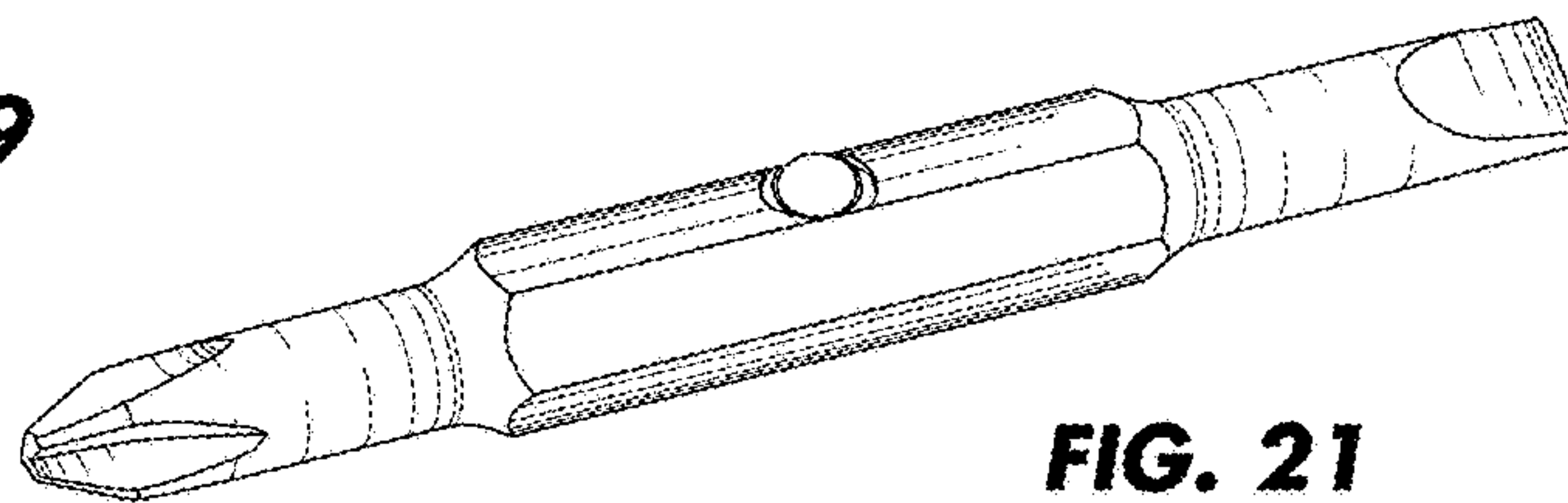

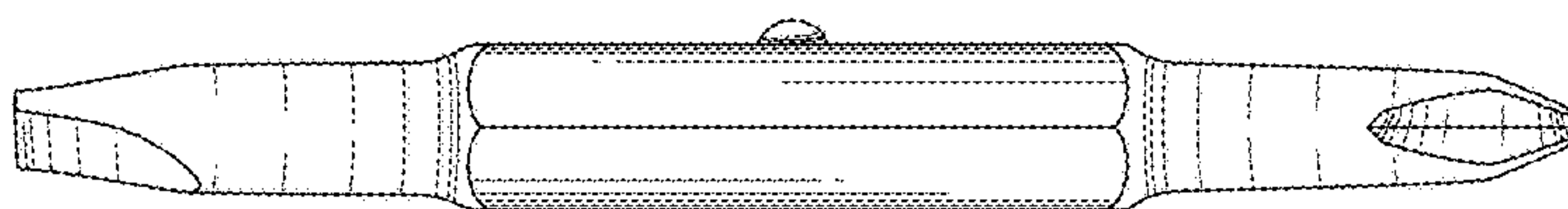

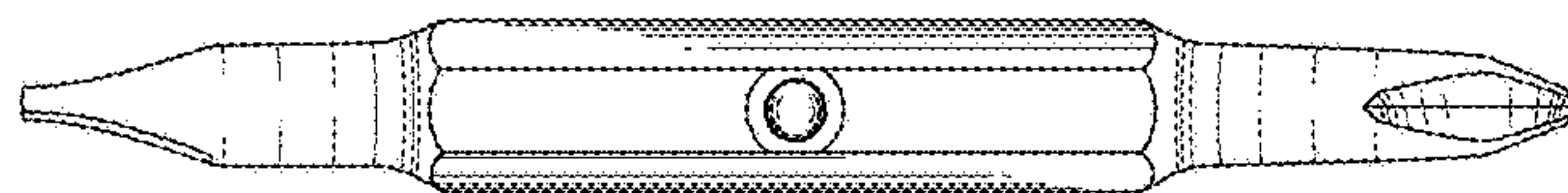

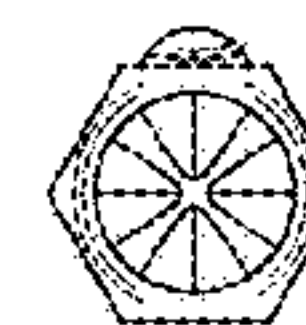

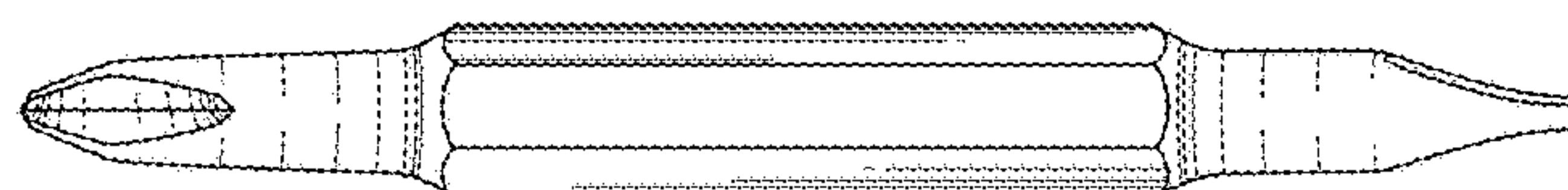

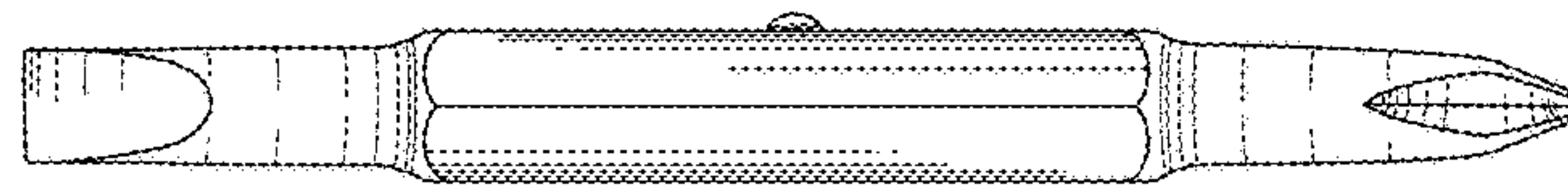

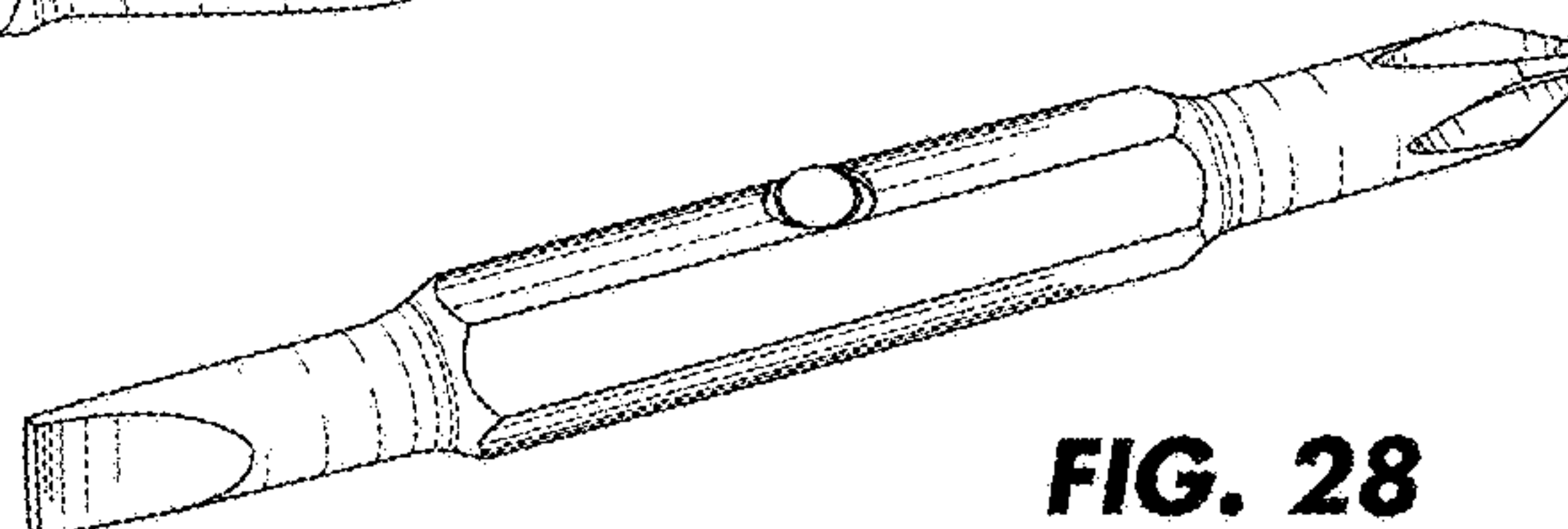

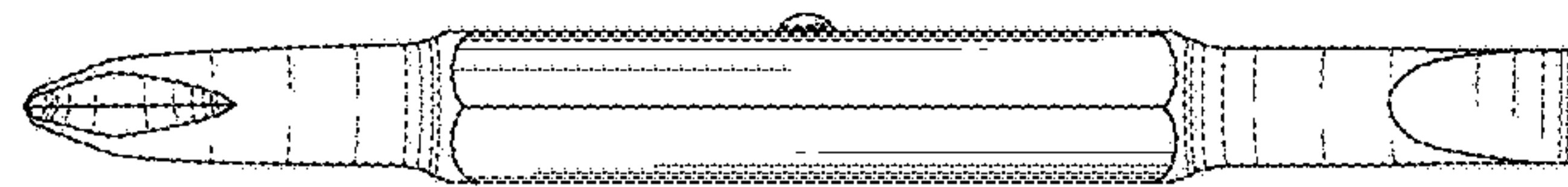
