The ornamental design for a casing for mountable alarm unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the casing secured to a mountable alarm unit.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the casing.

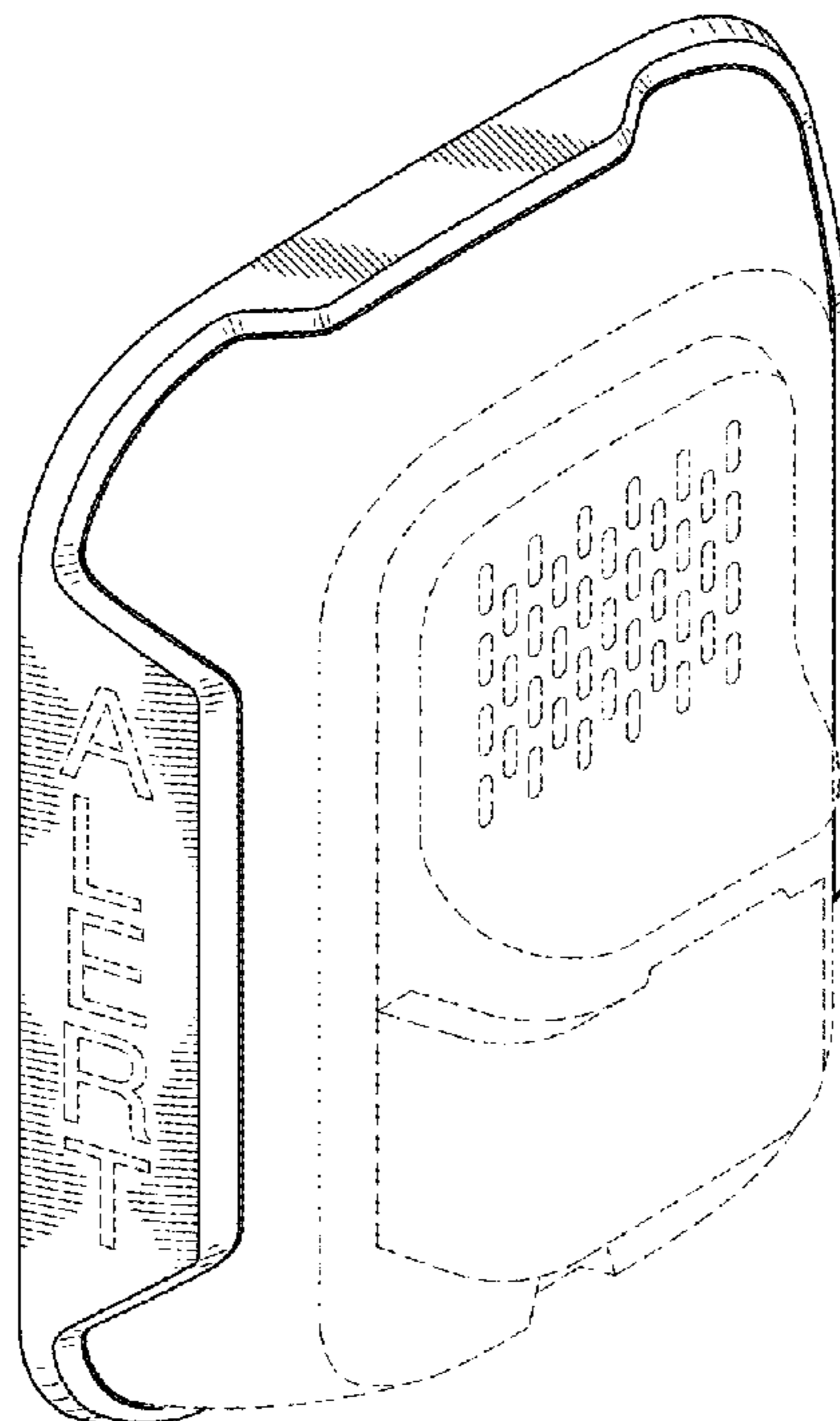

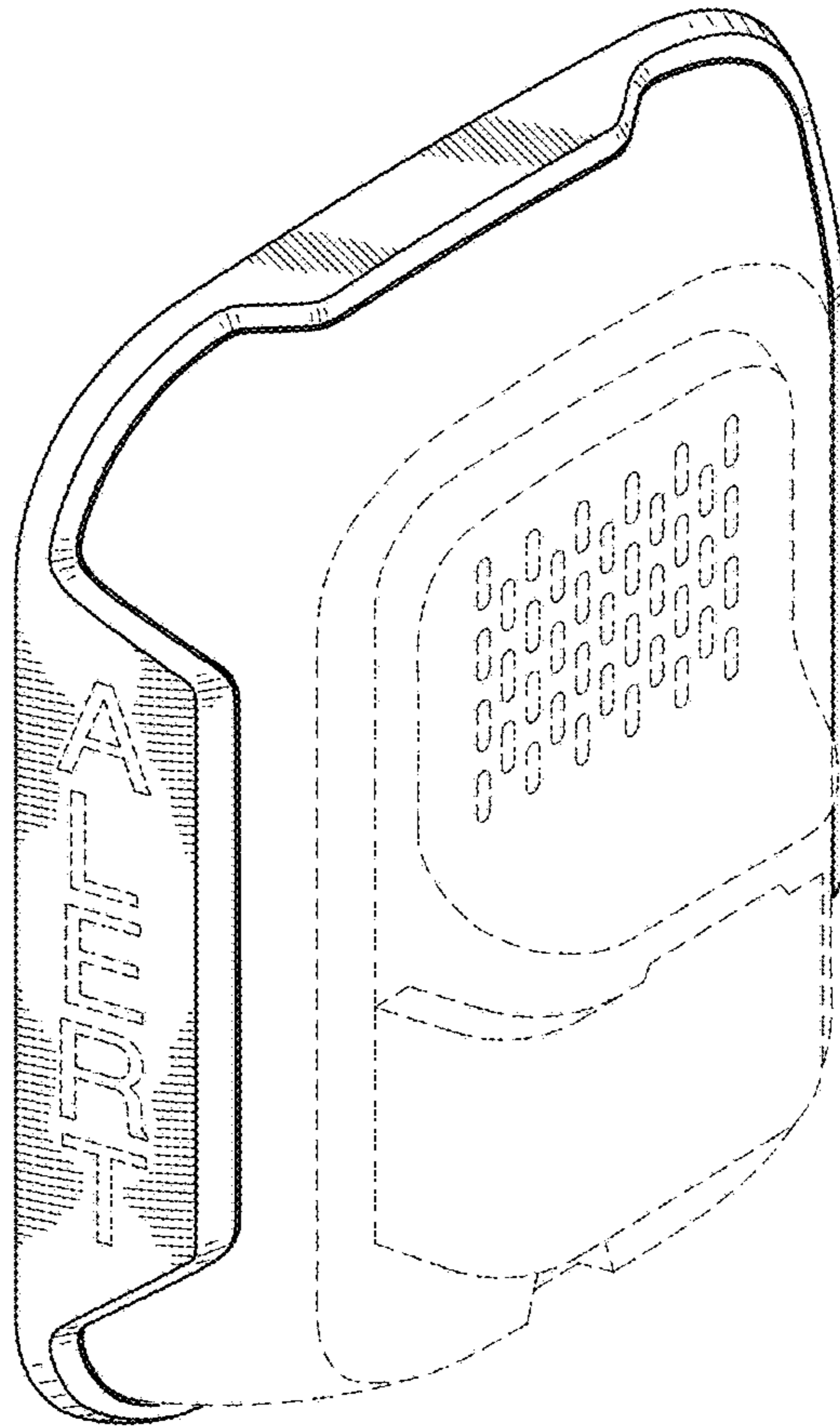

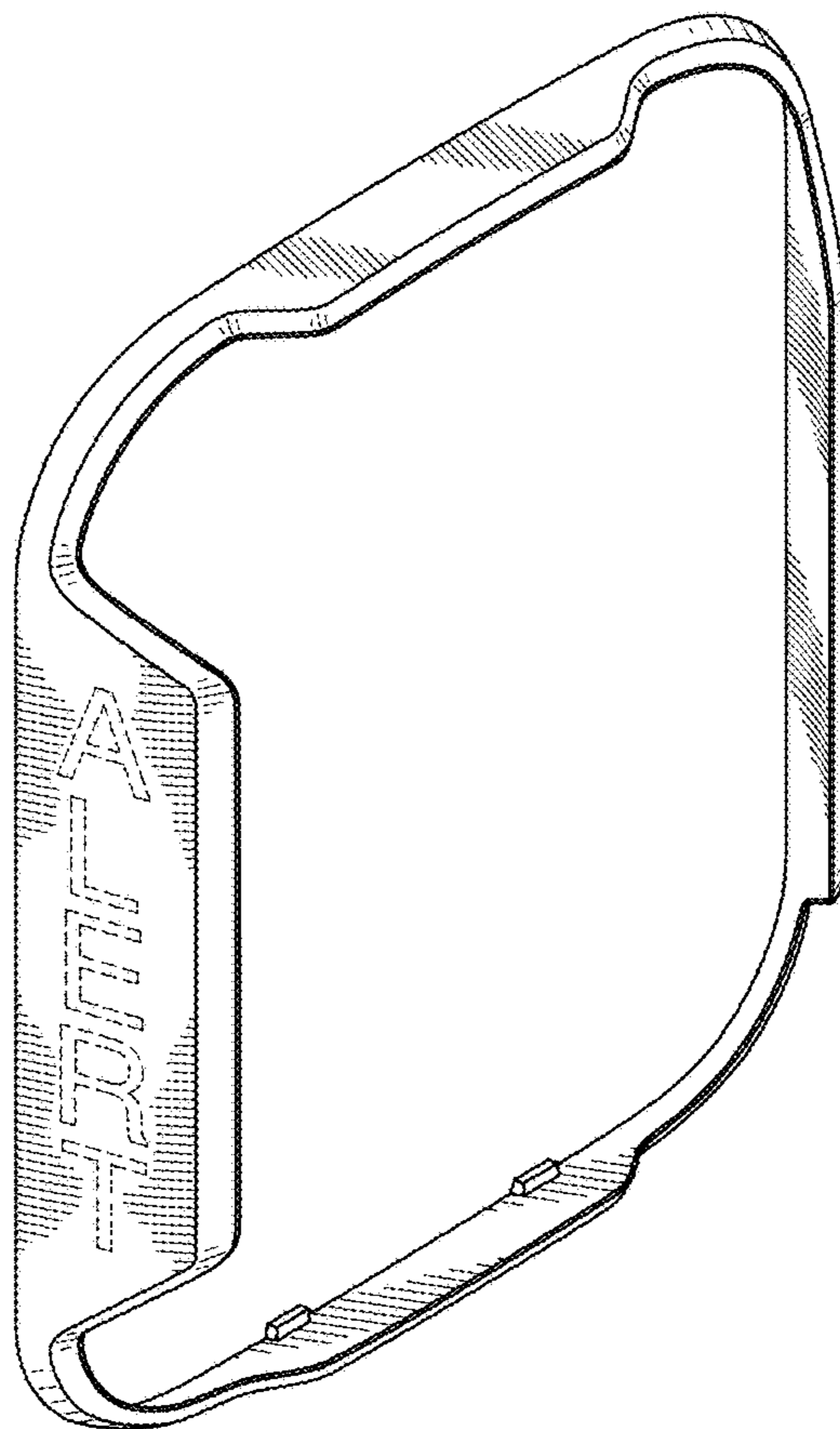

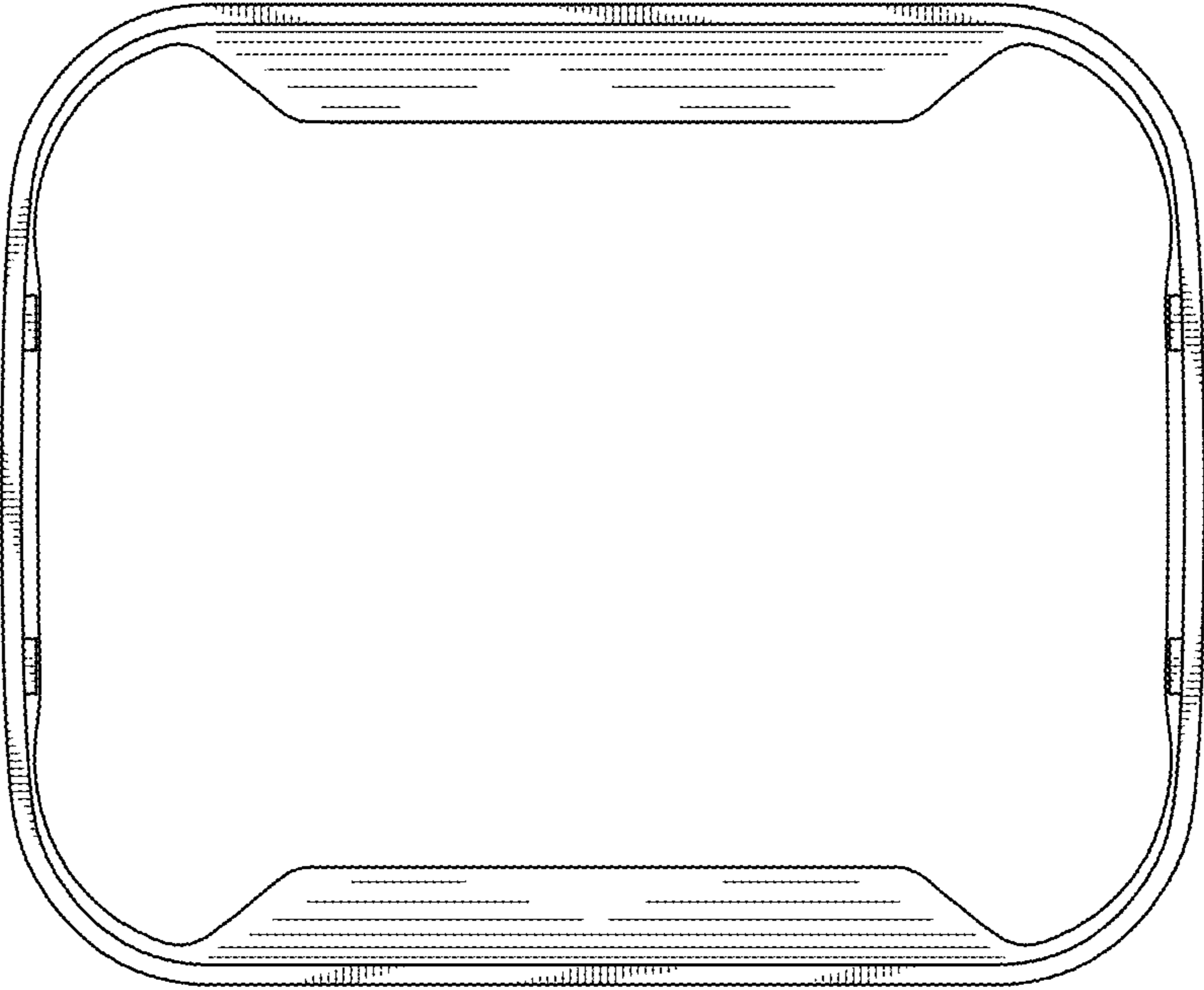

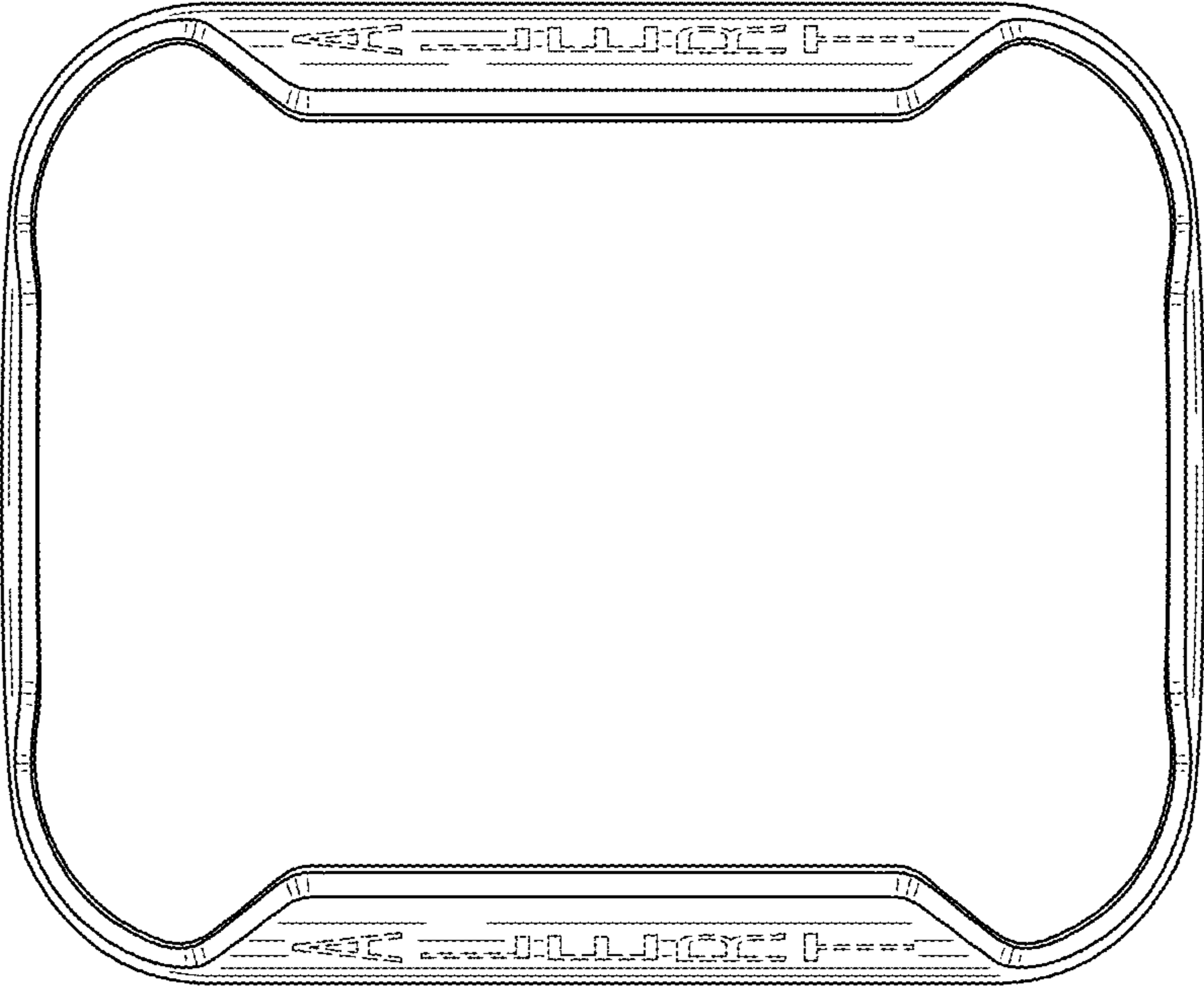

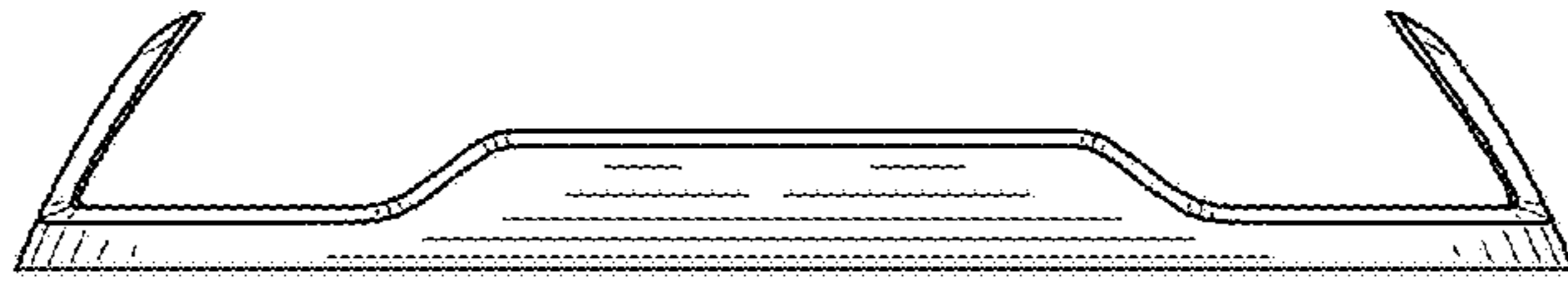

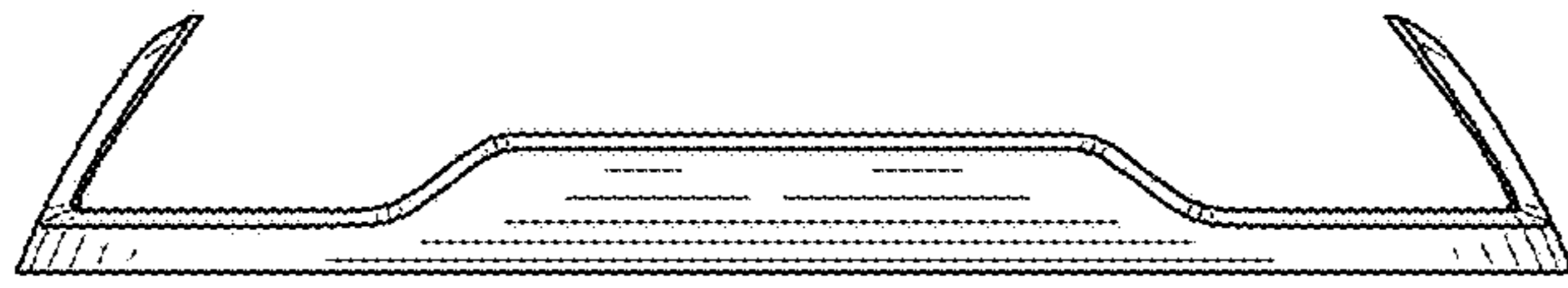

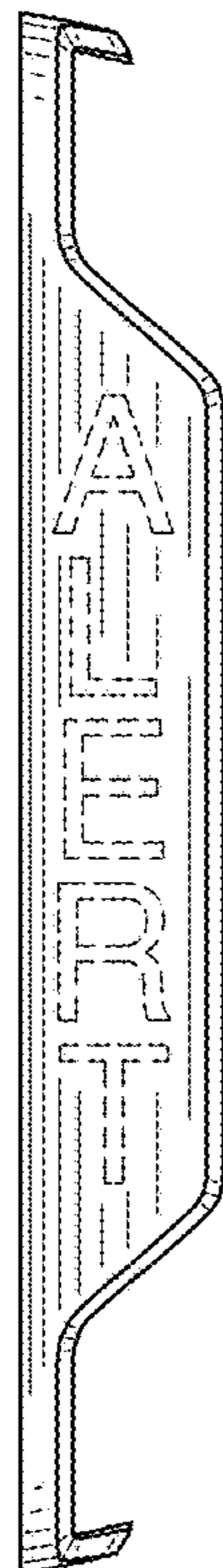
