(57) **CLAIM**

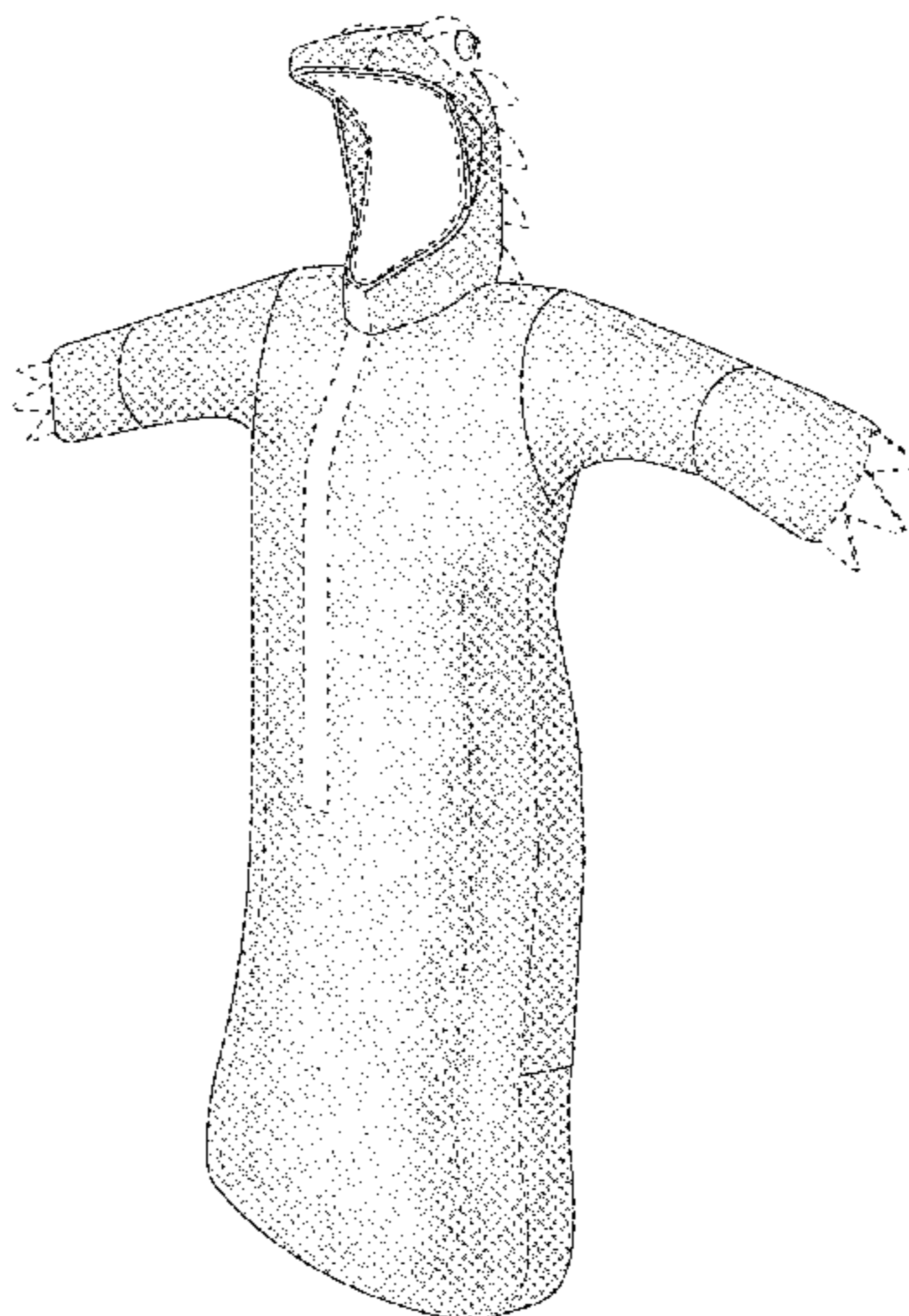
The ornamental design for a sleeping bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

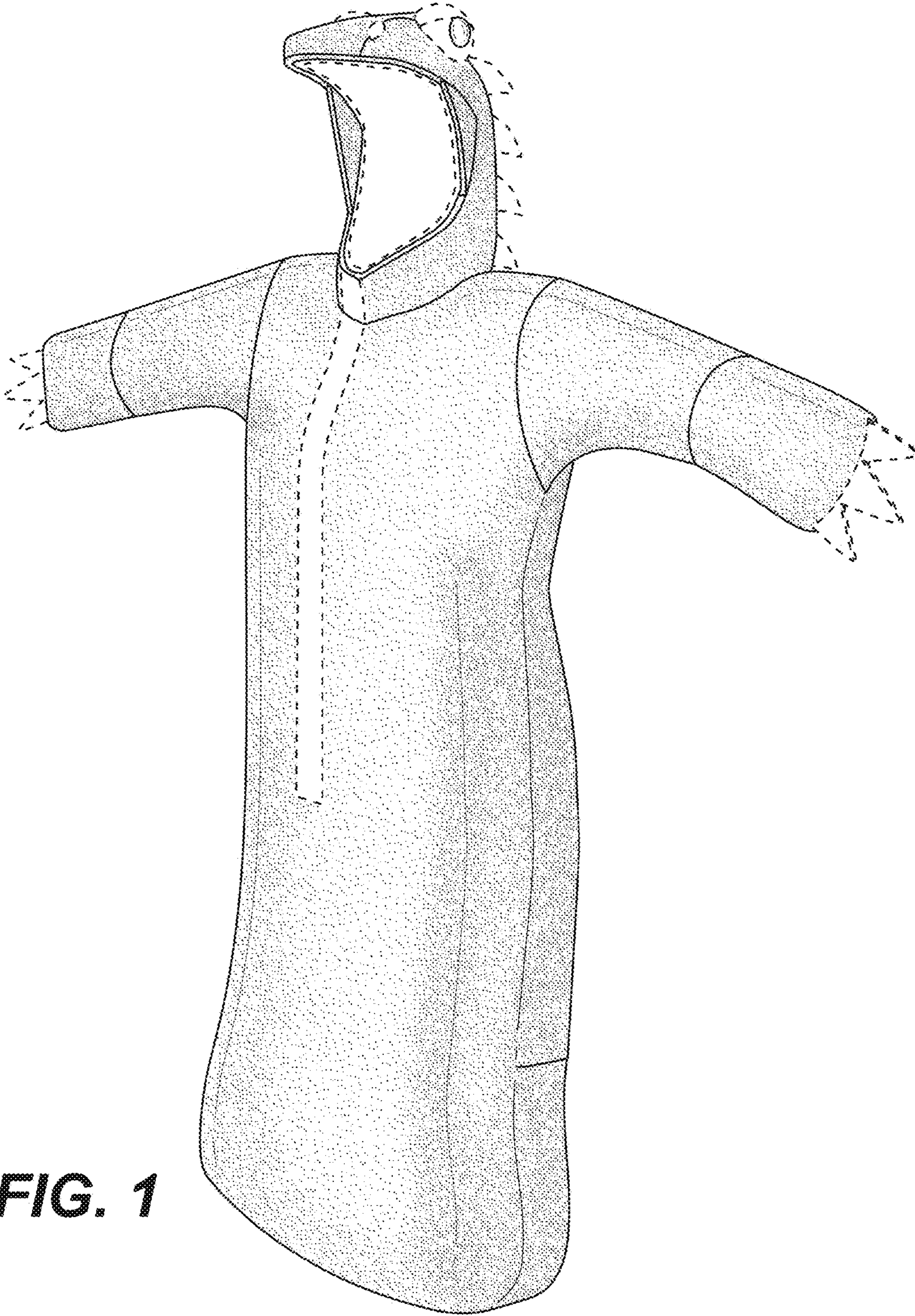

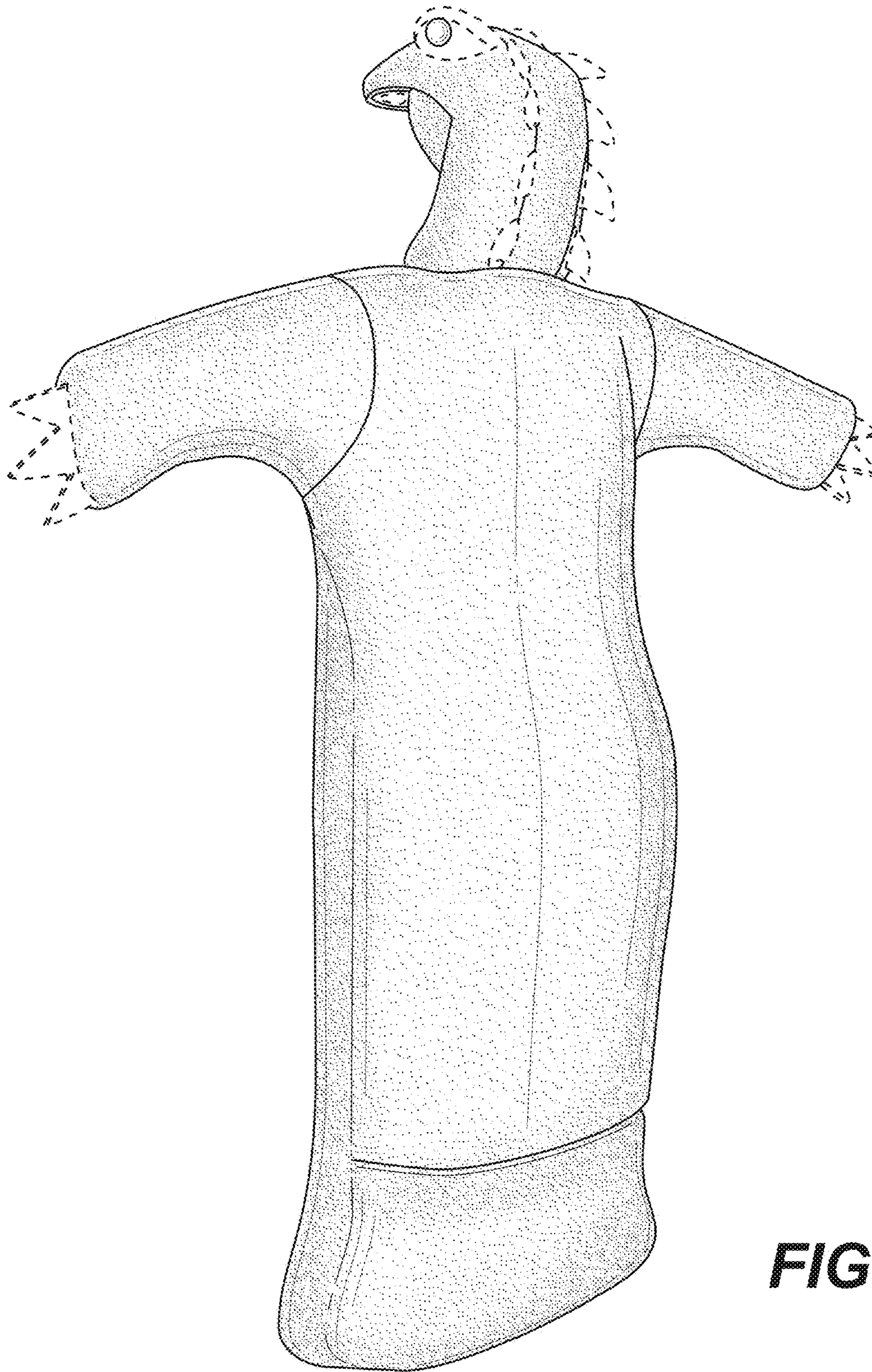

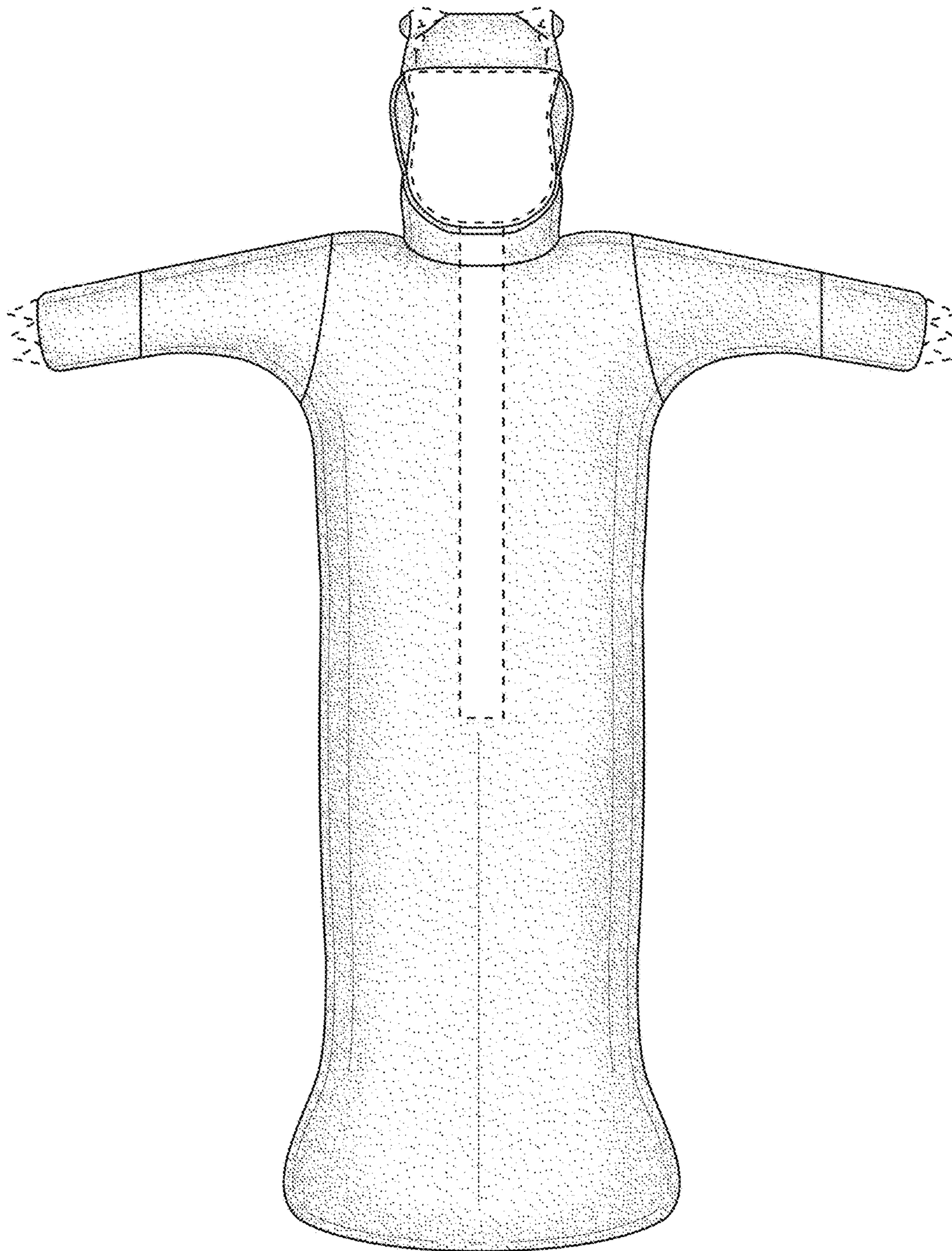

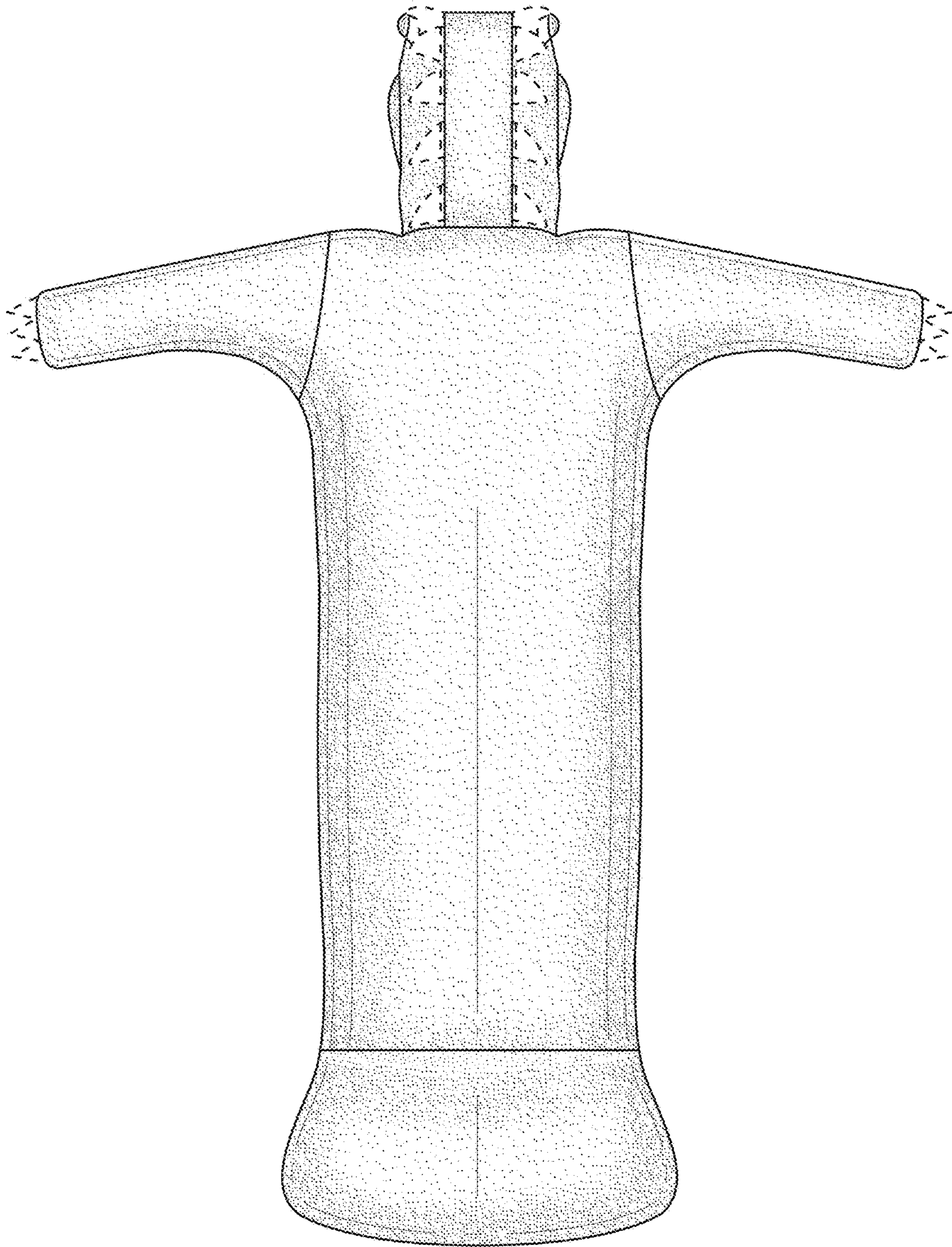

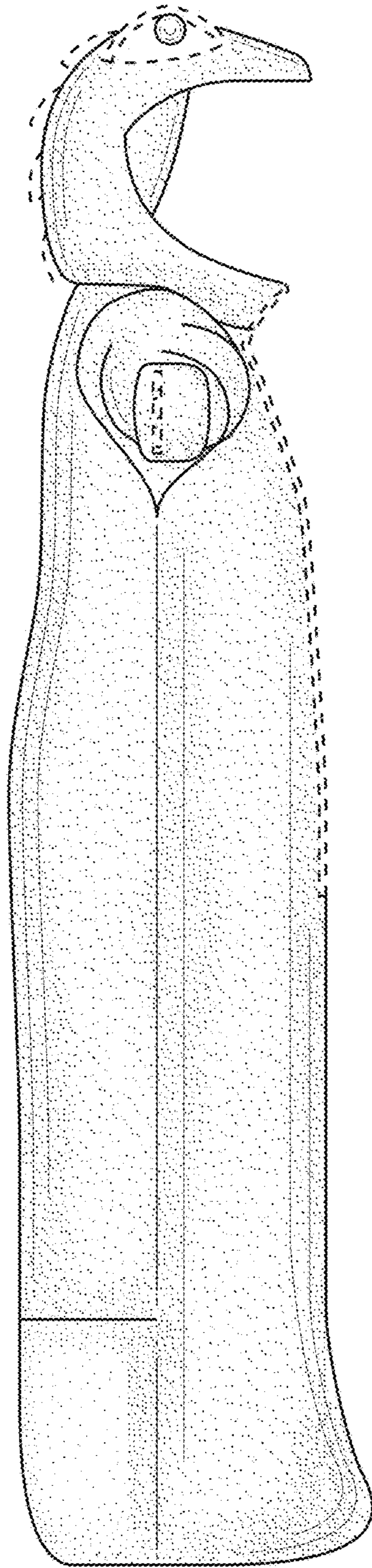

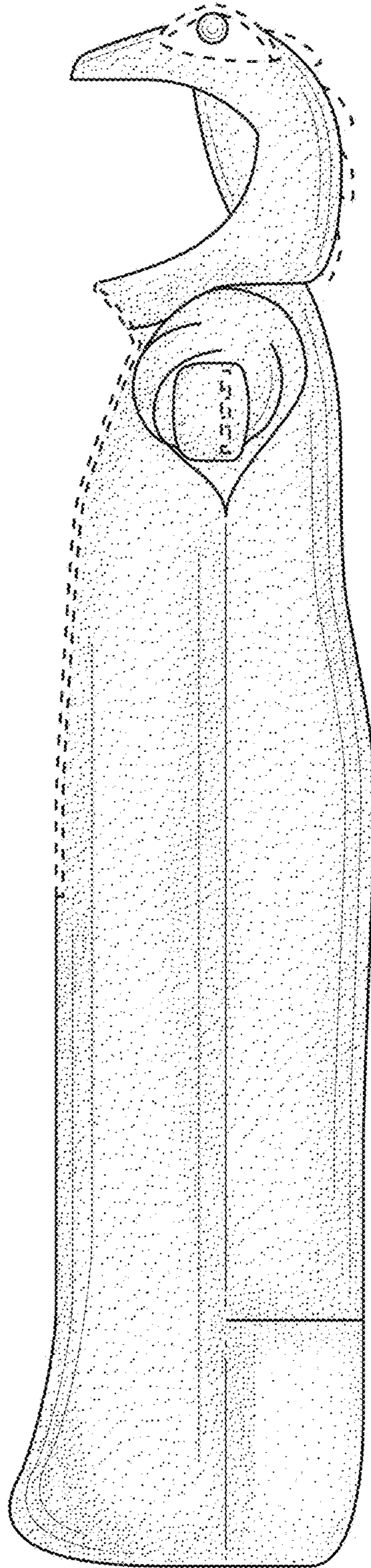

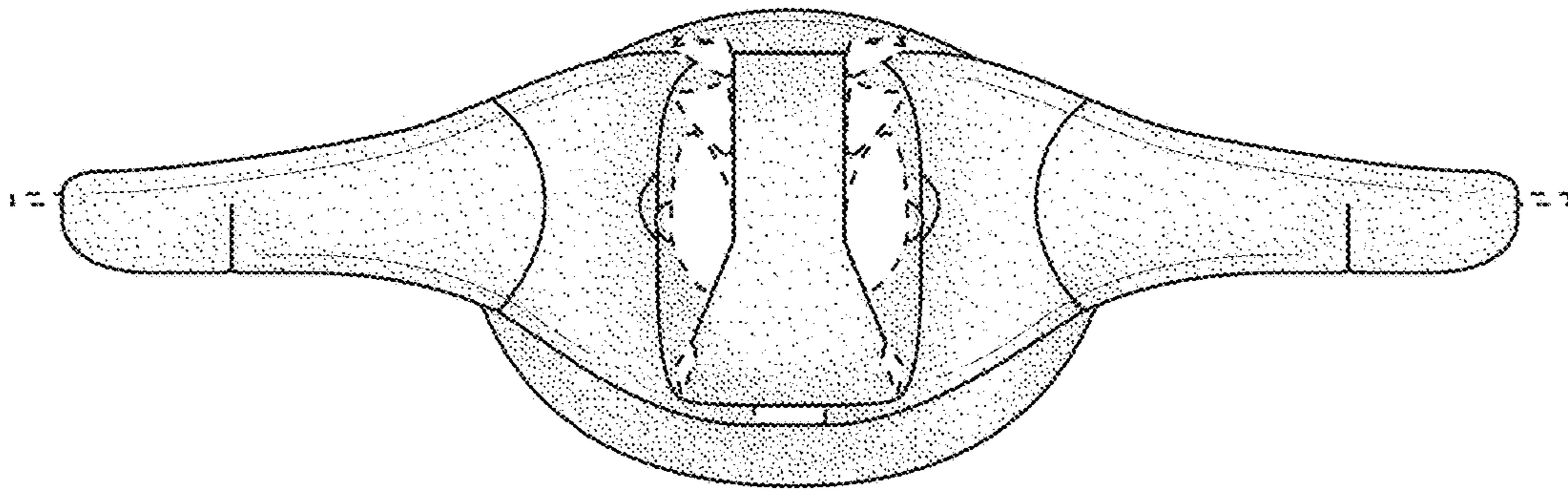

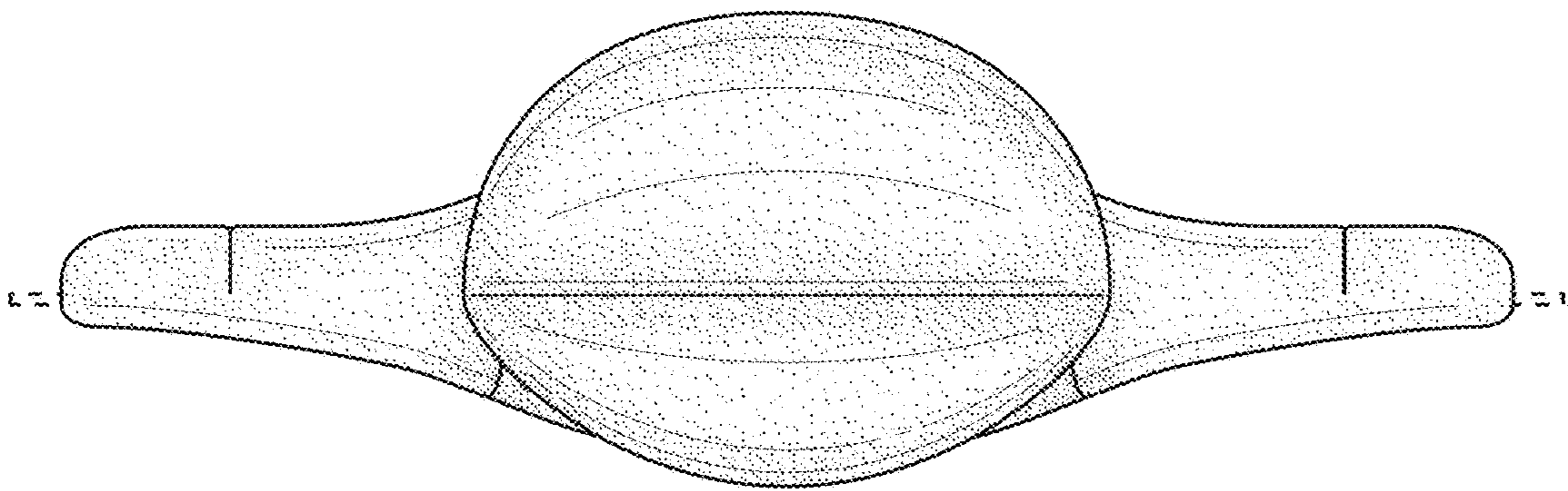

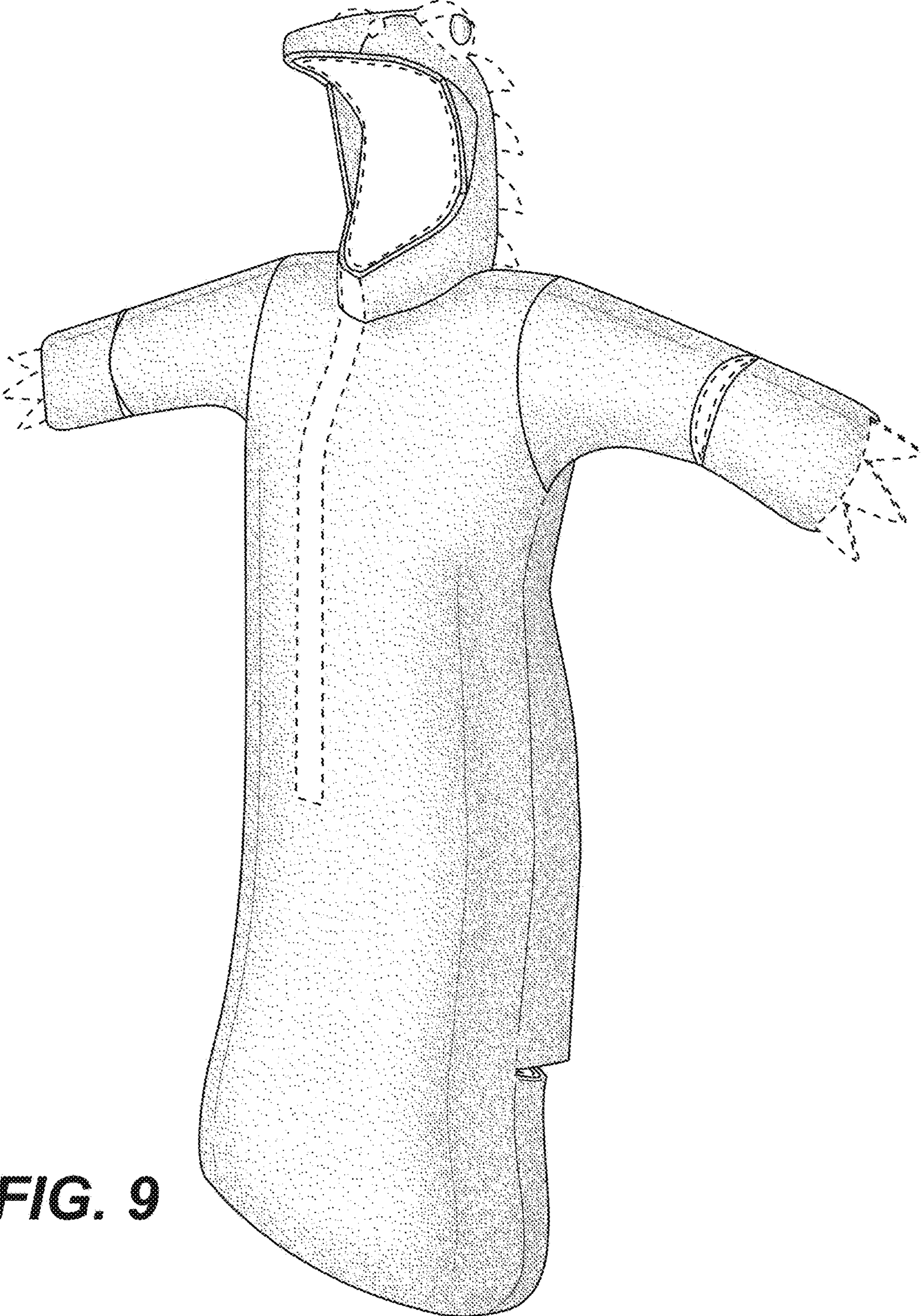

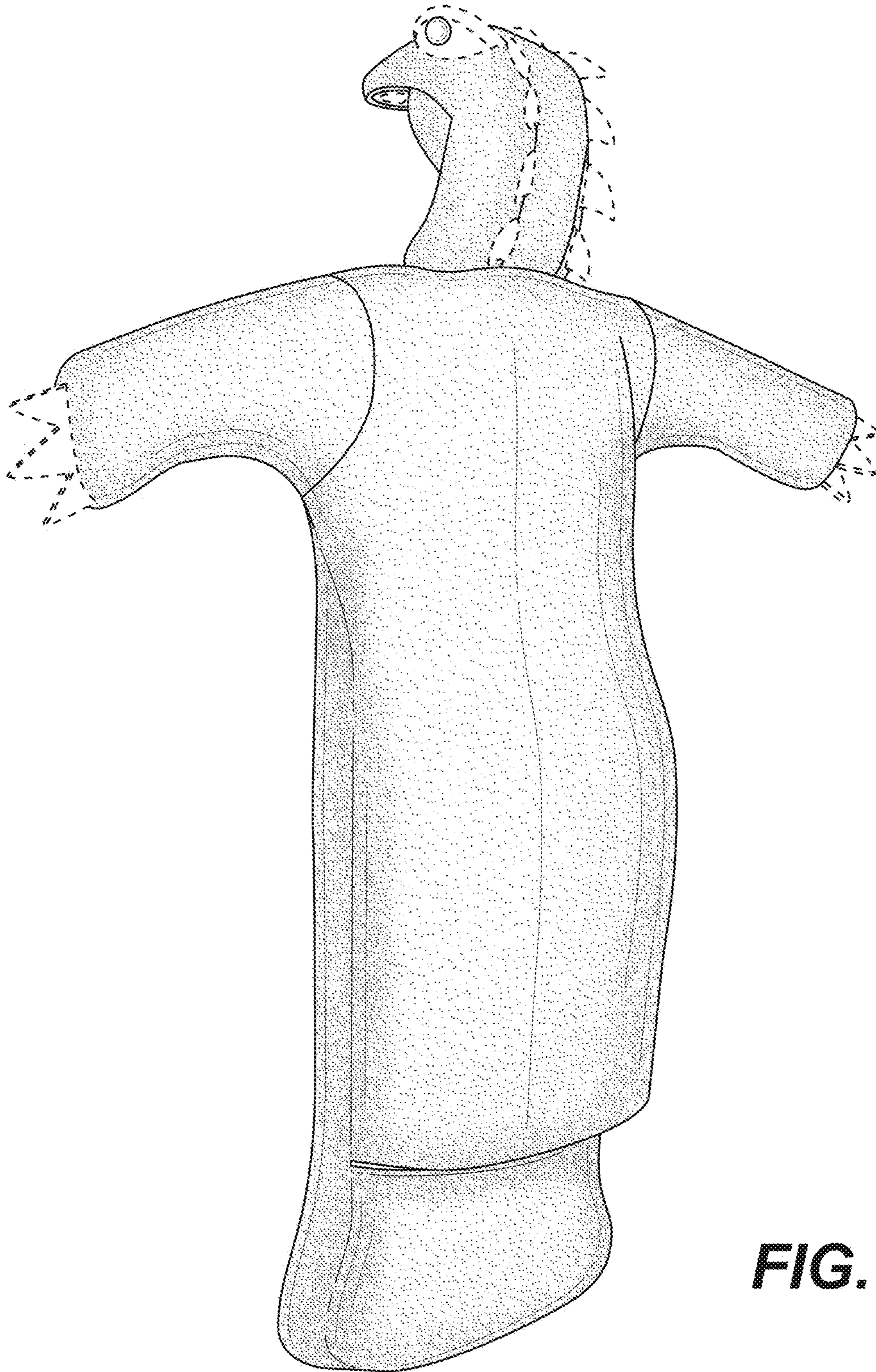

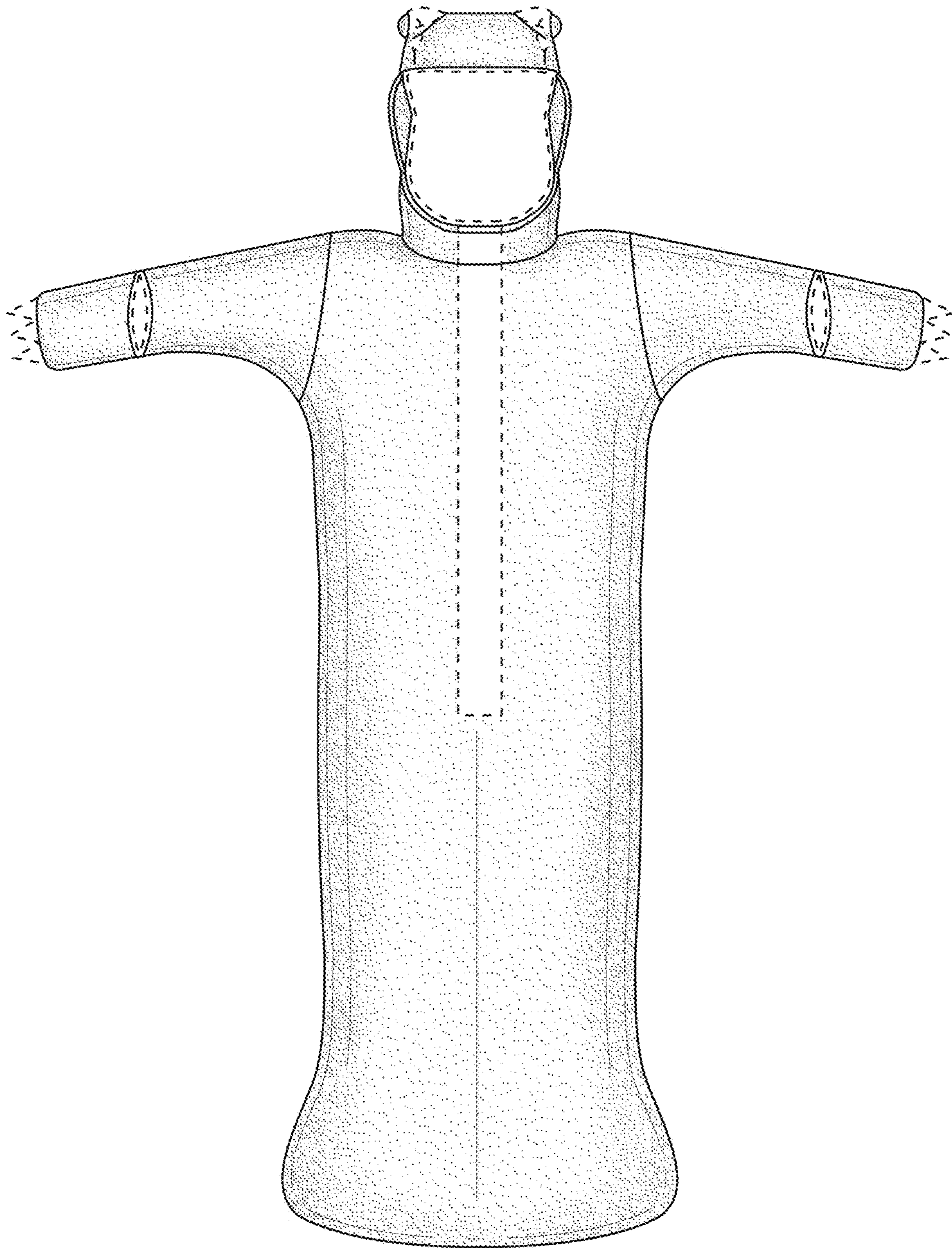

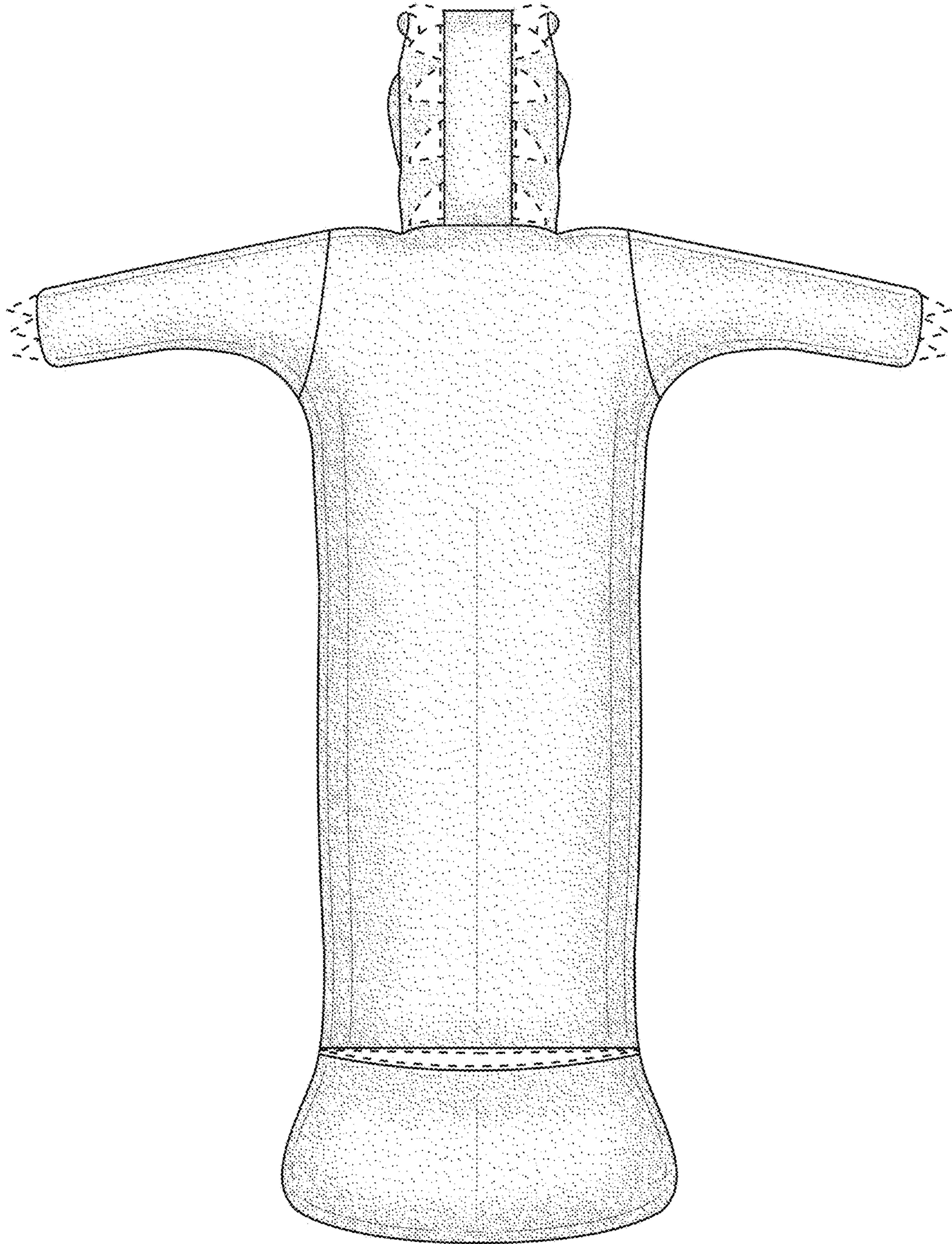

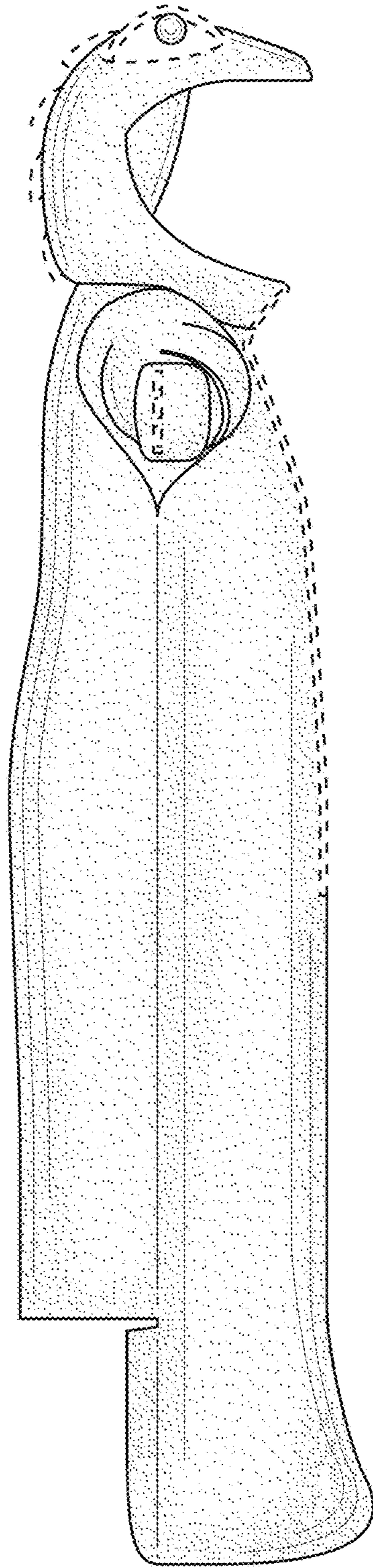

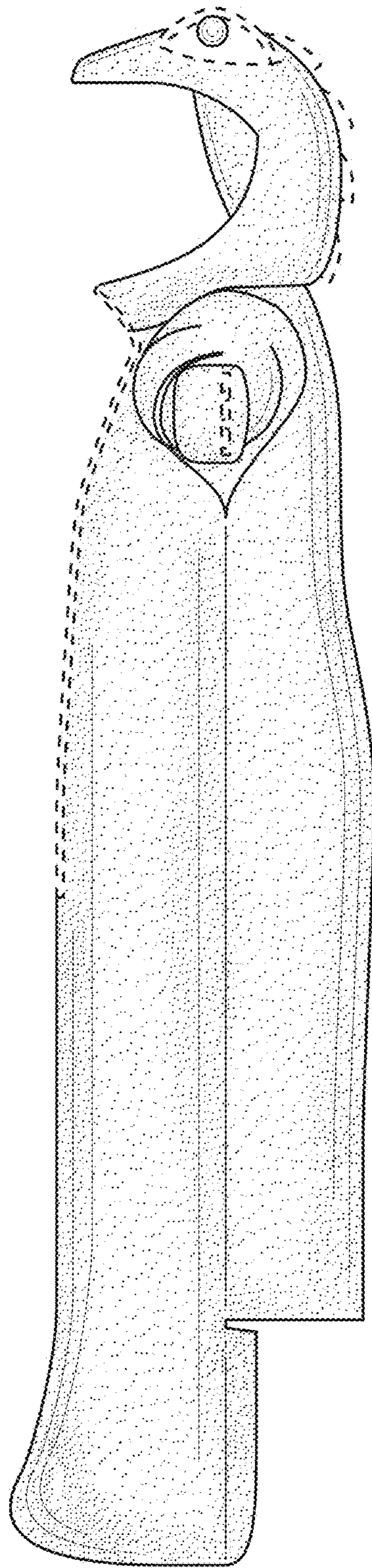

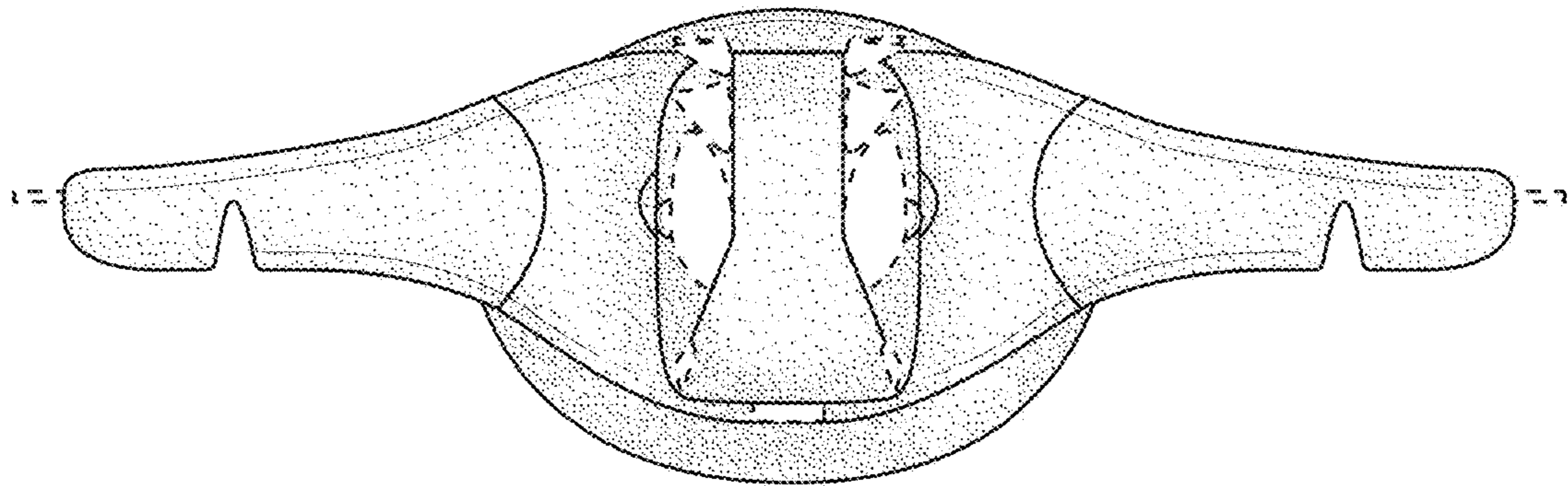

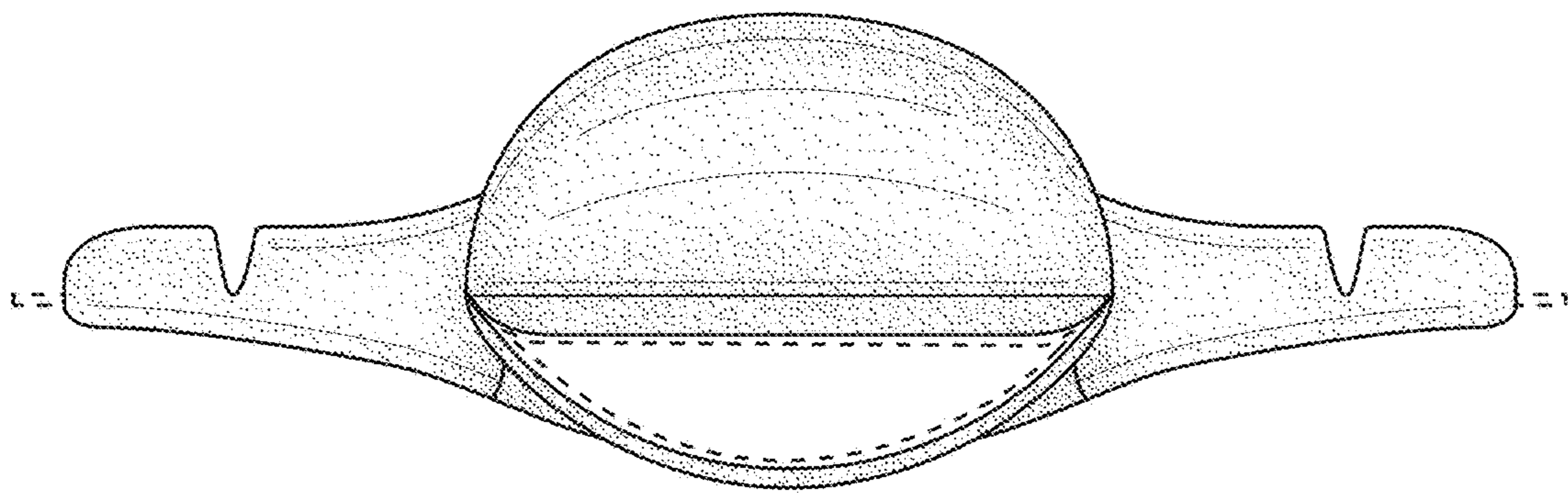
