DESCRIPTION

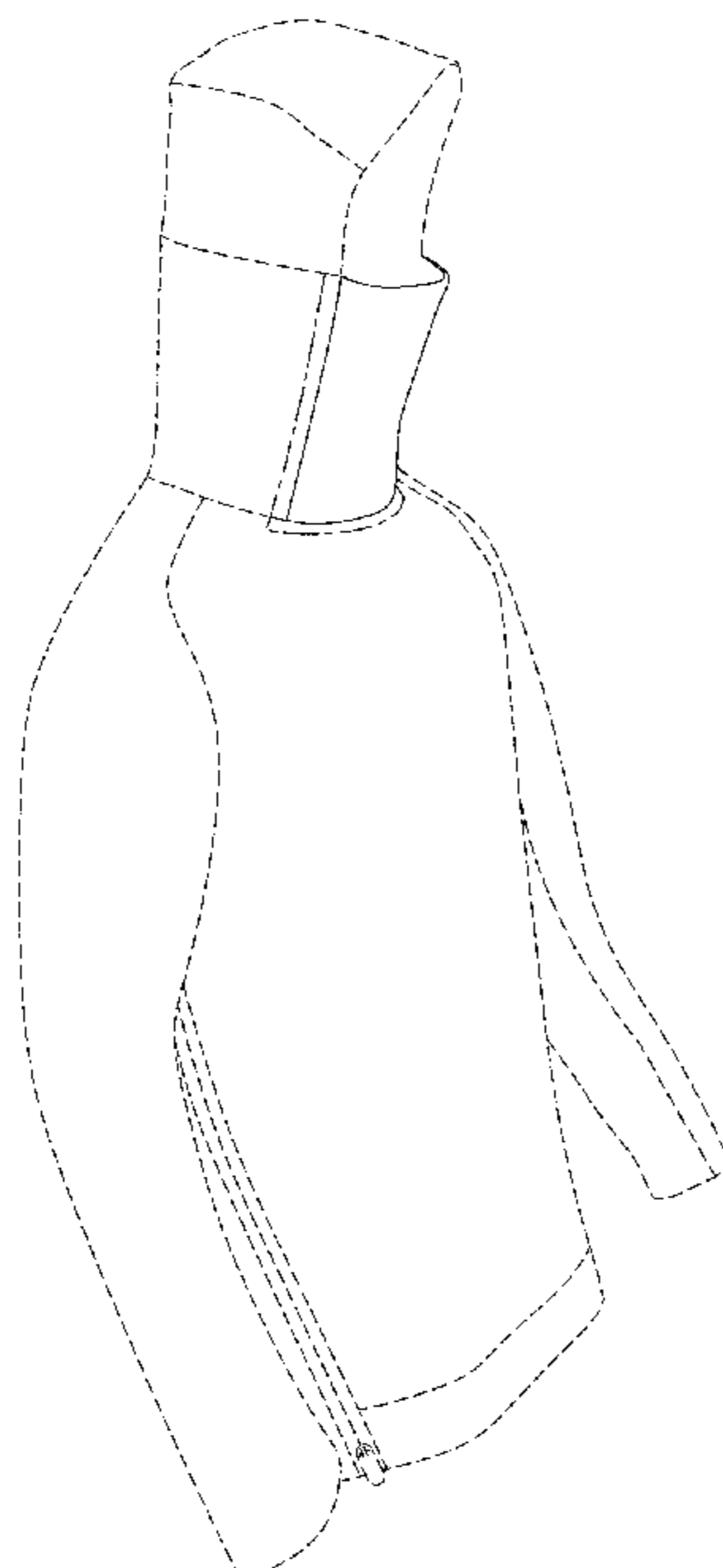
FIG. 1 is a right, front perspective view of a shirt according to the present design;

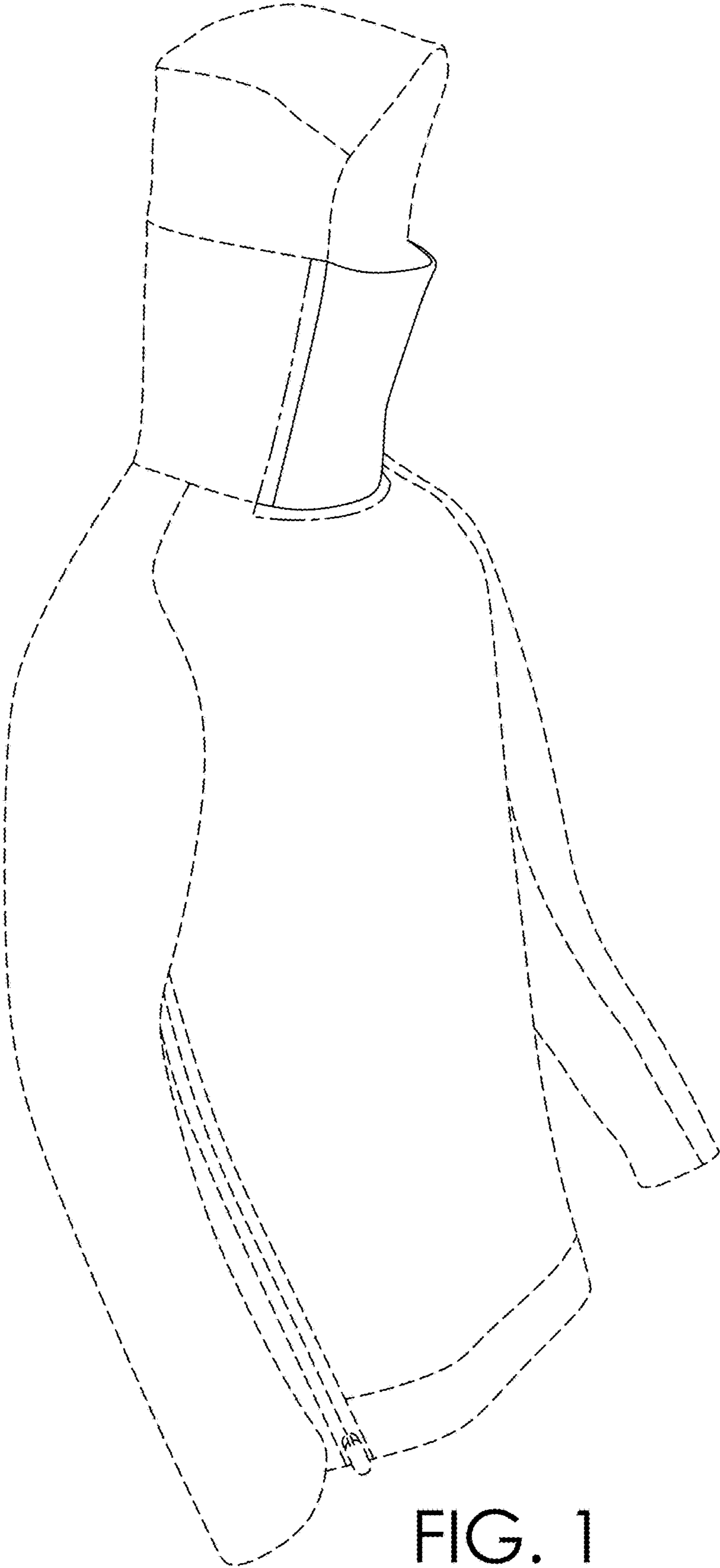

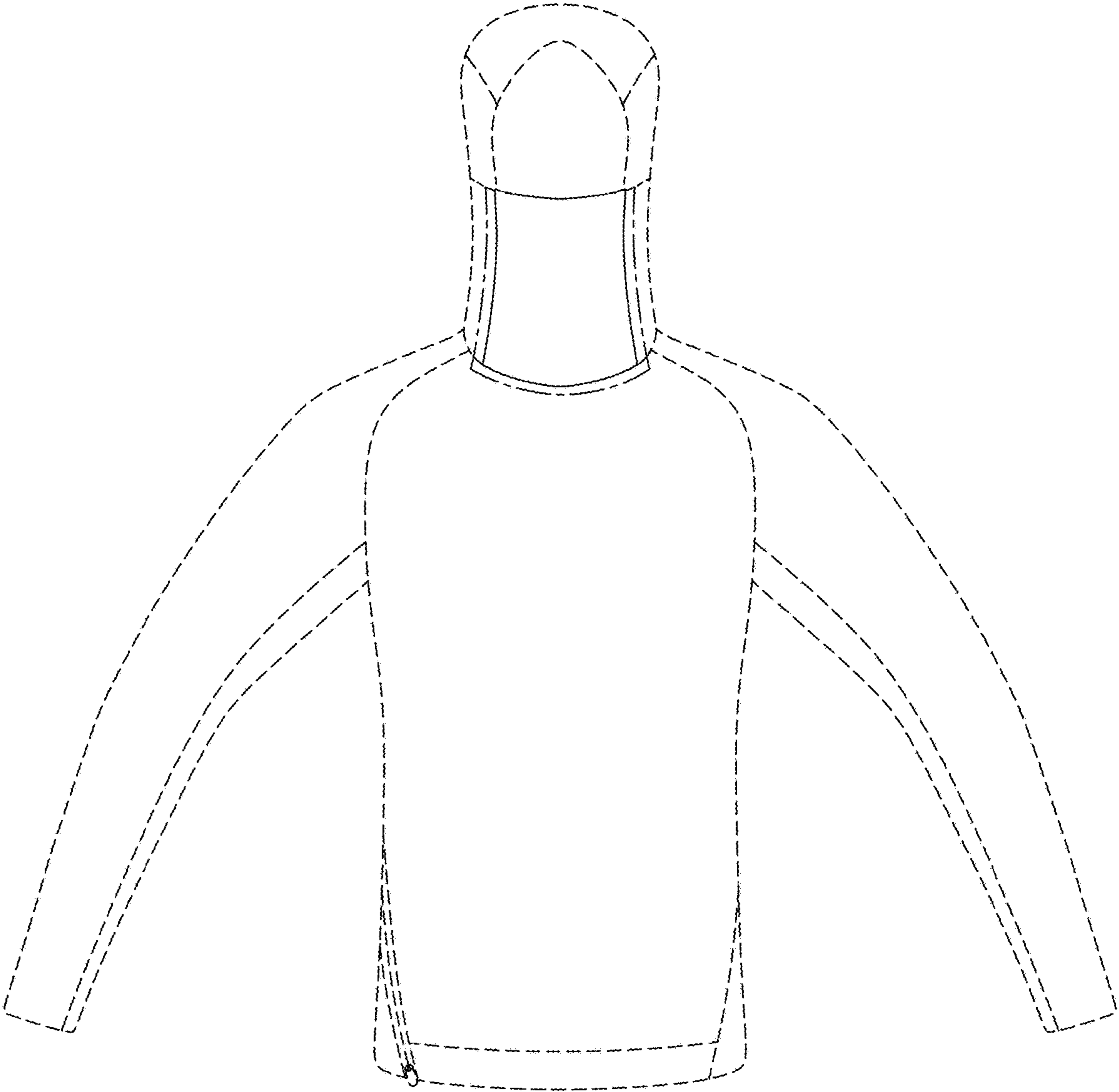

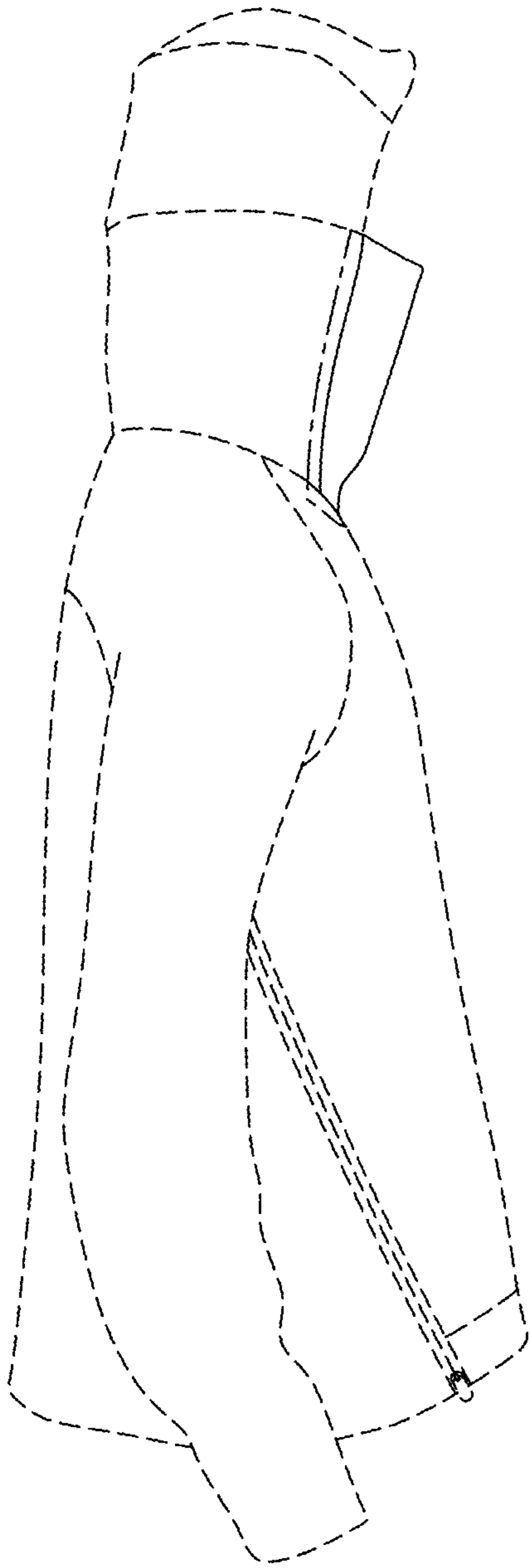

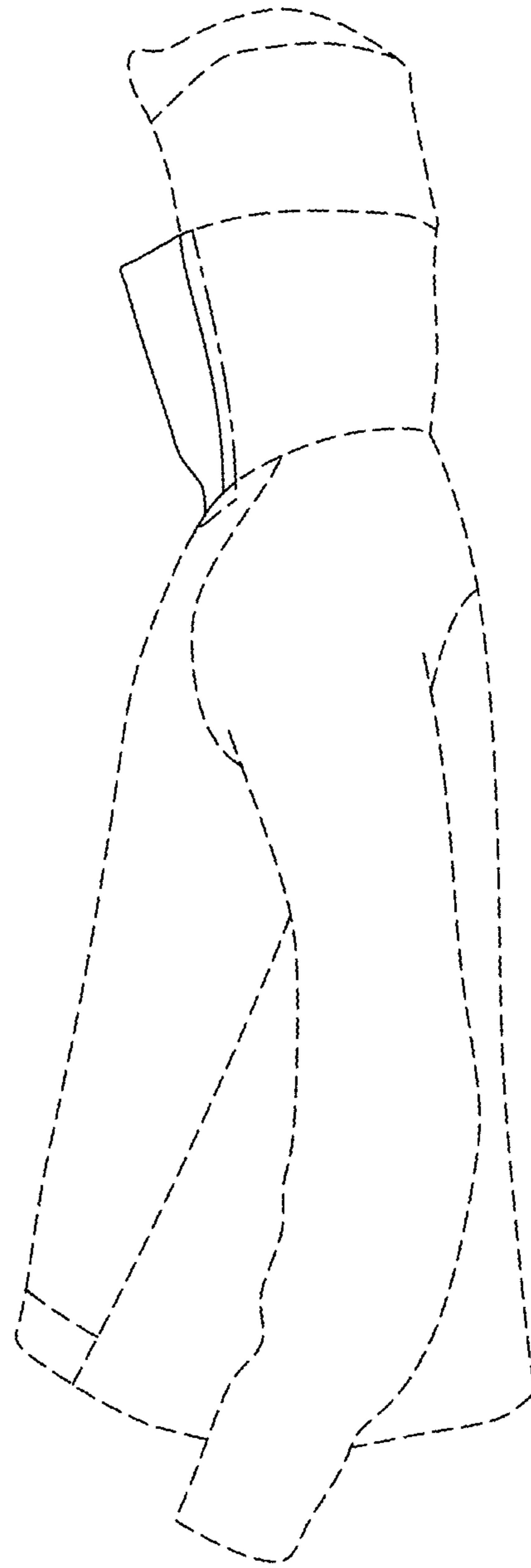

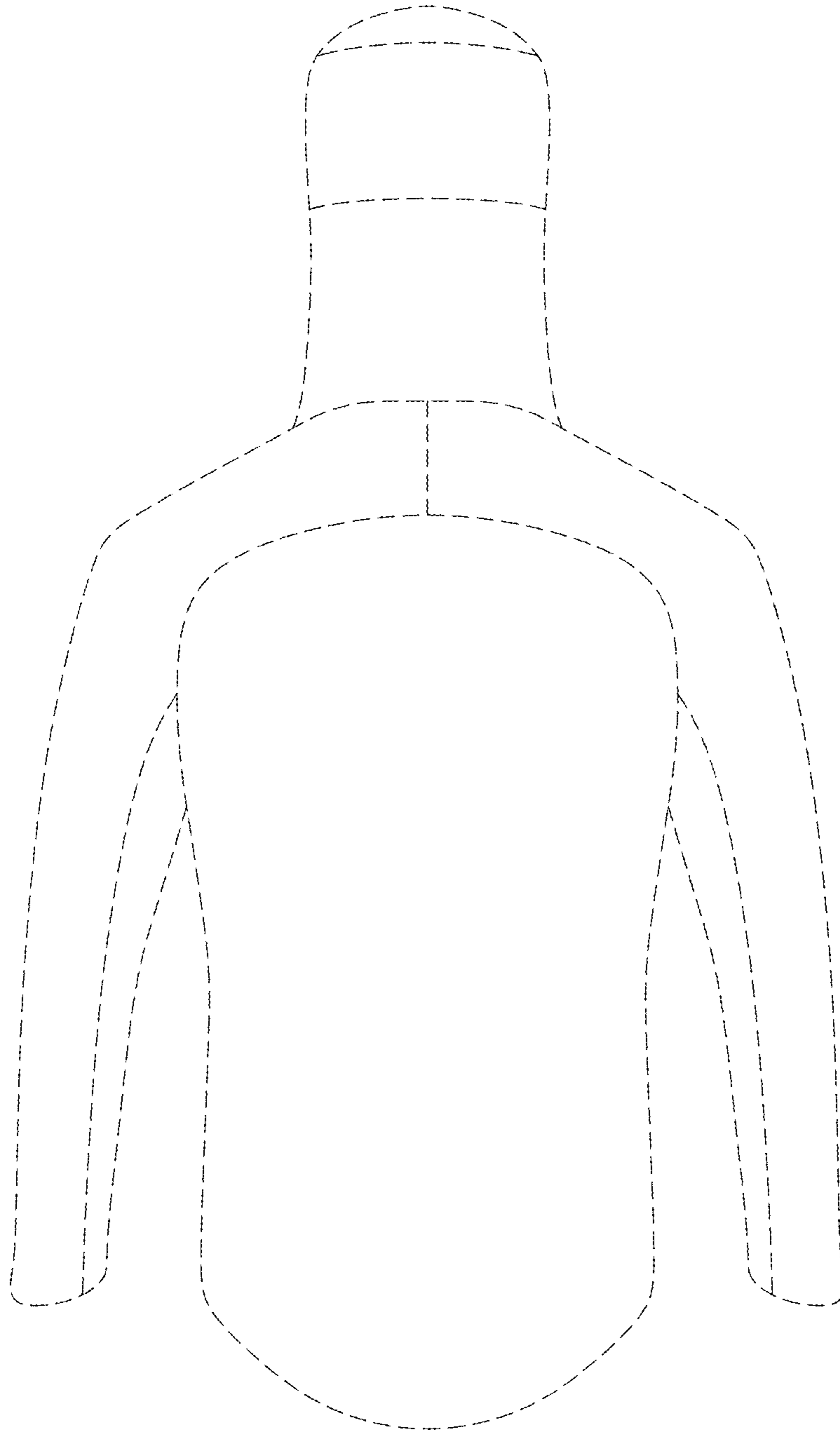
