(57) **CLAIM**

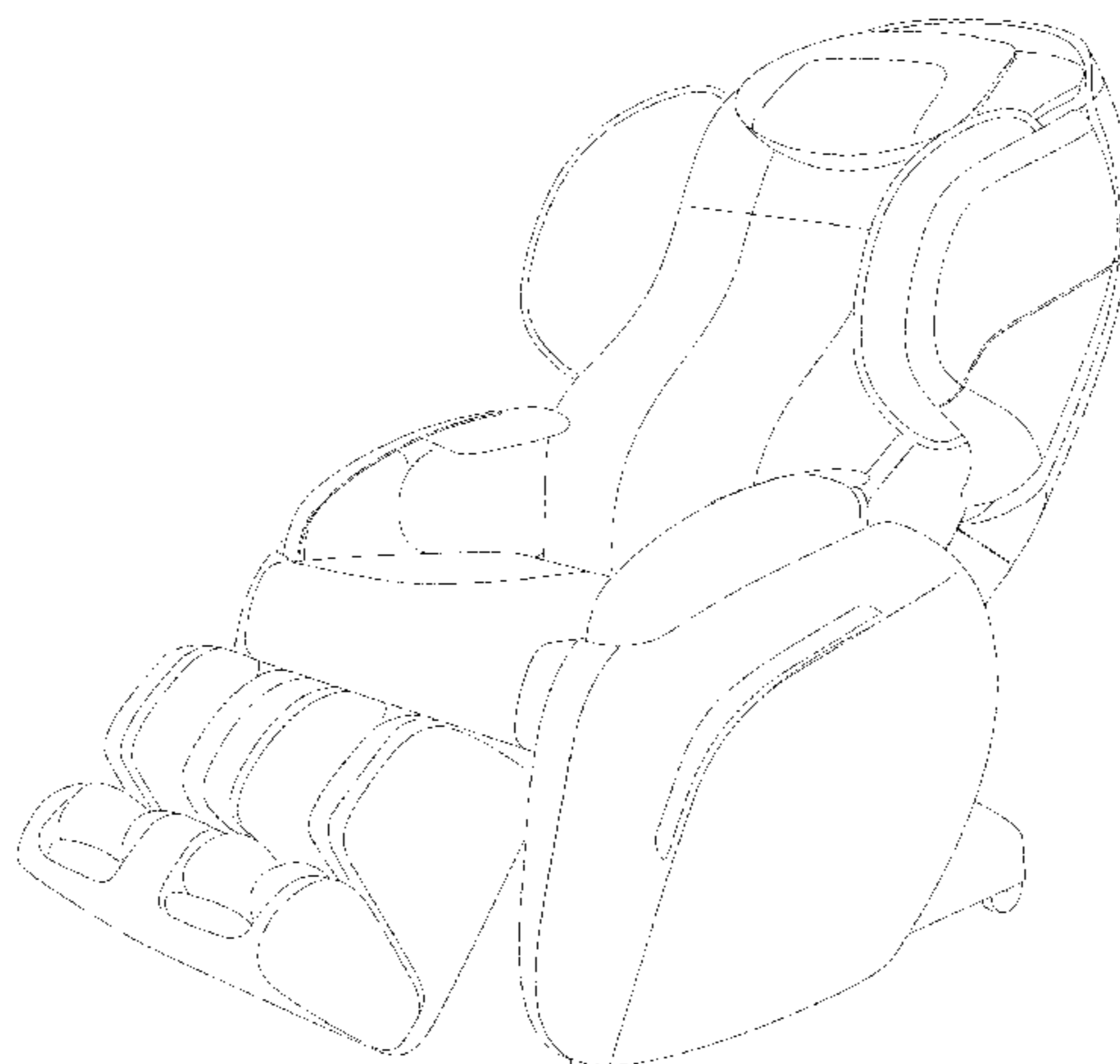
The ornamental design for a massage chair, as shown and

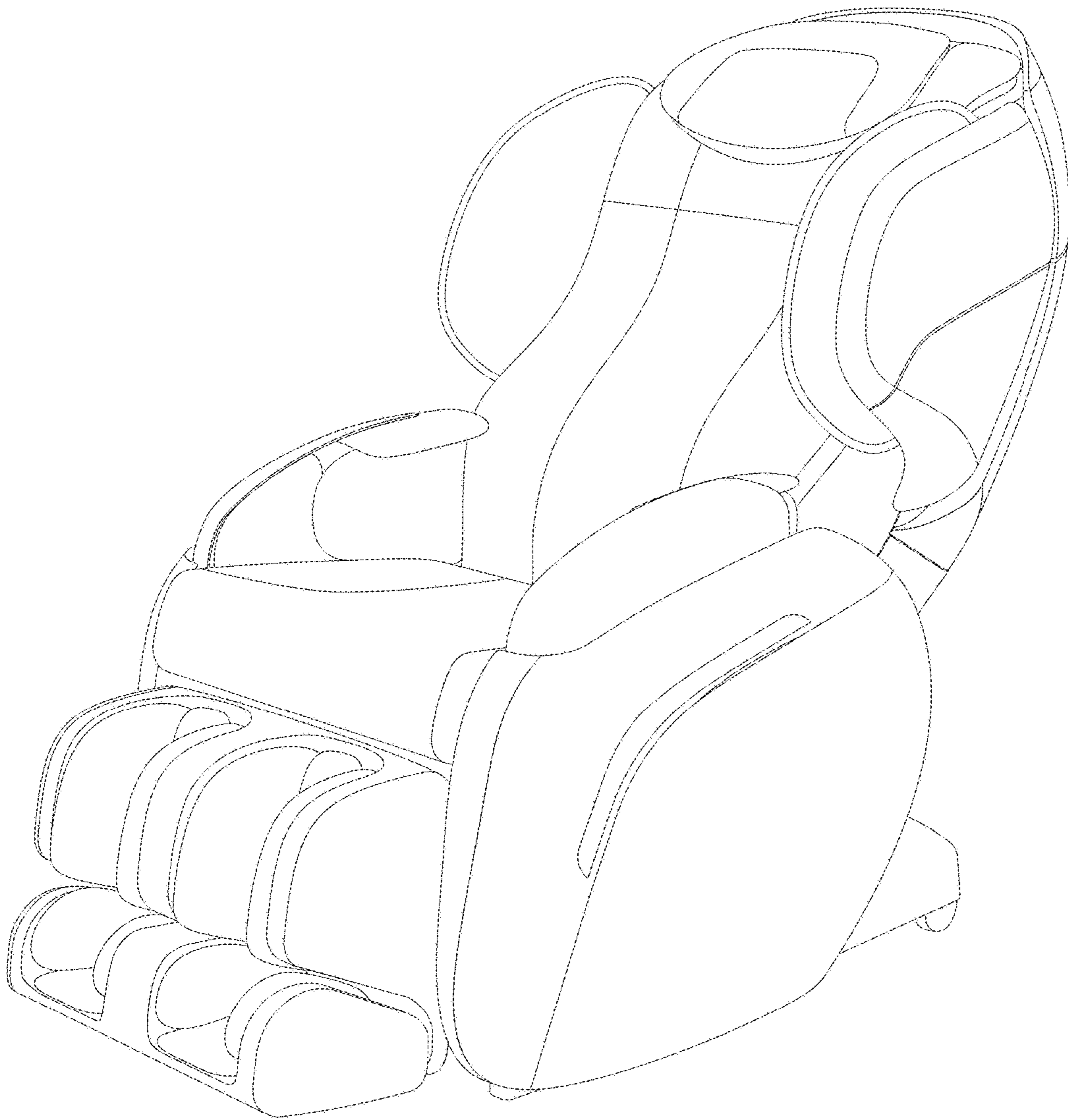

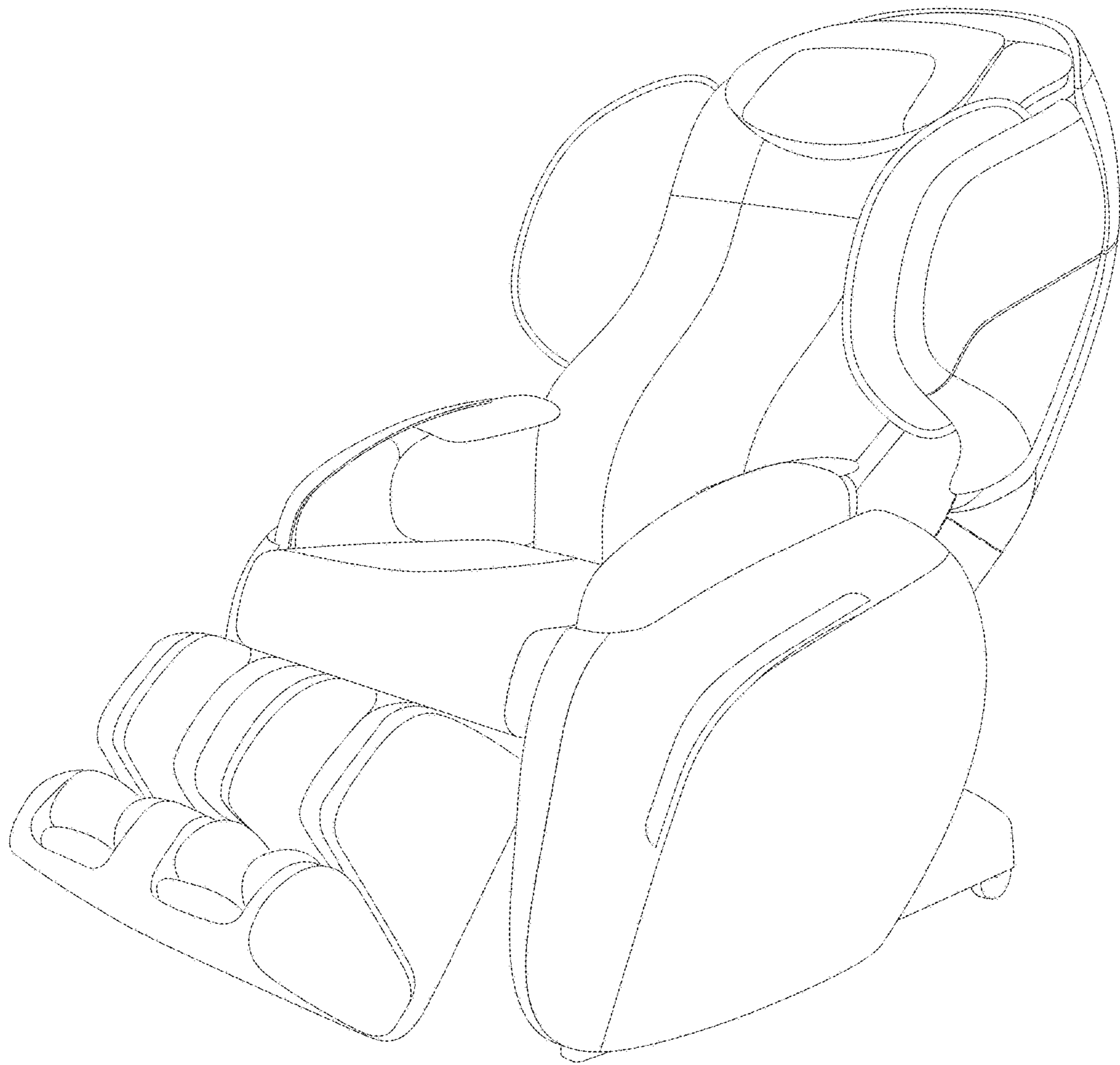

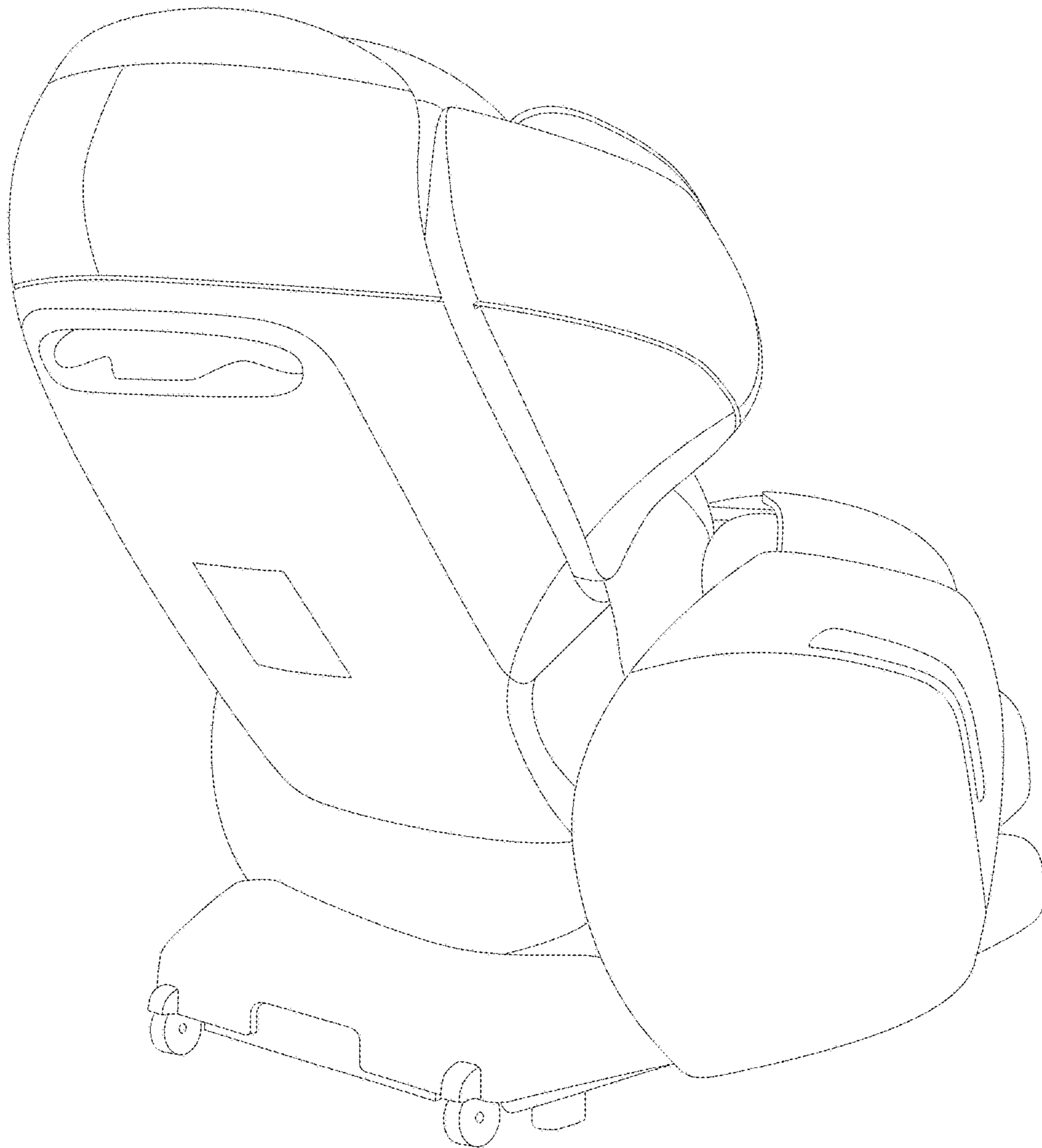

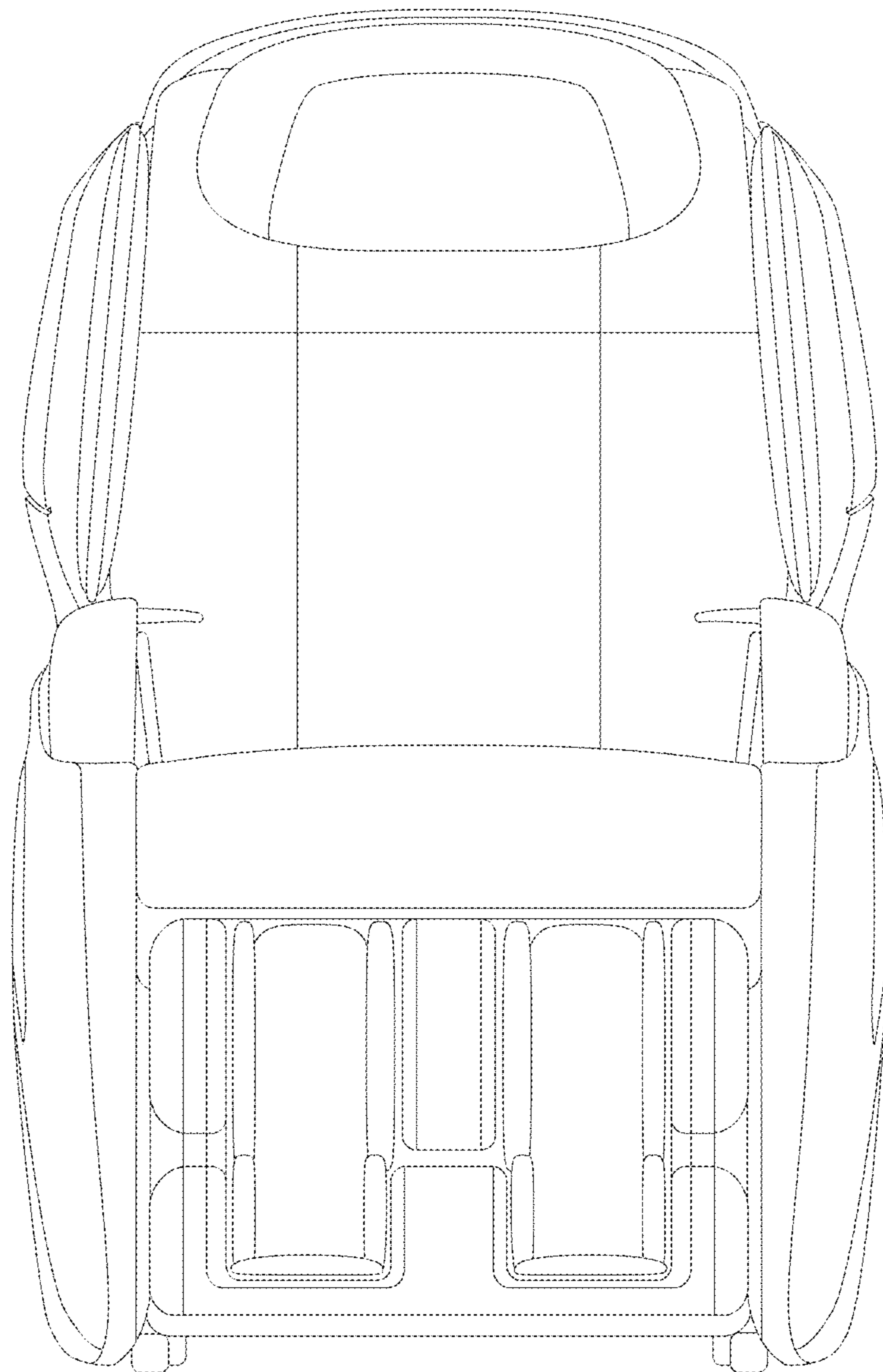

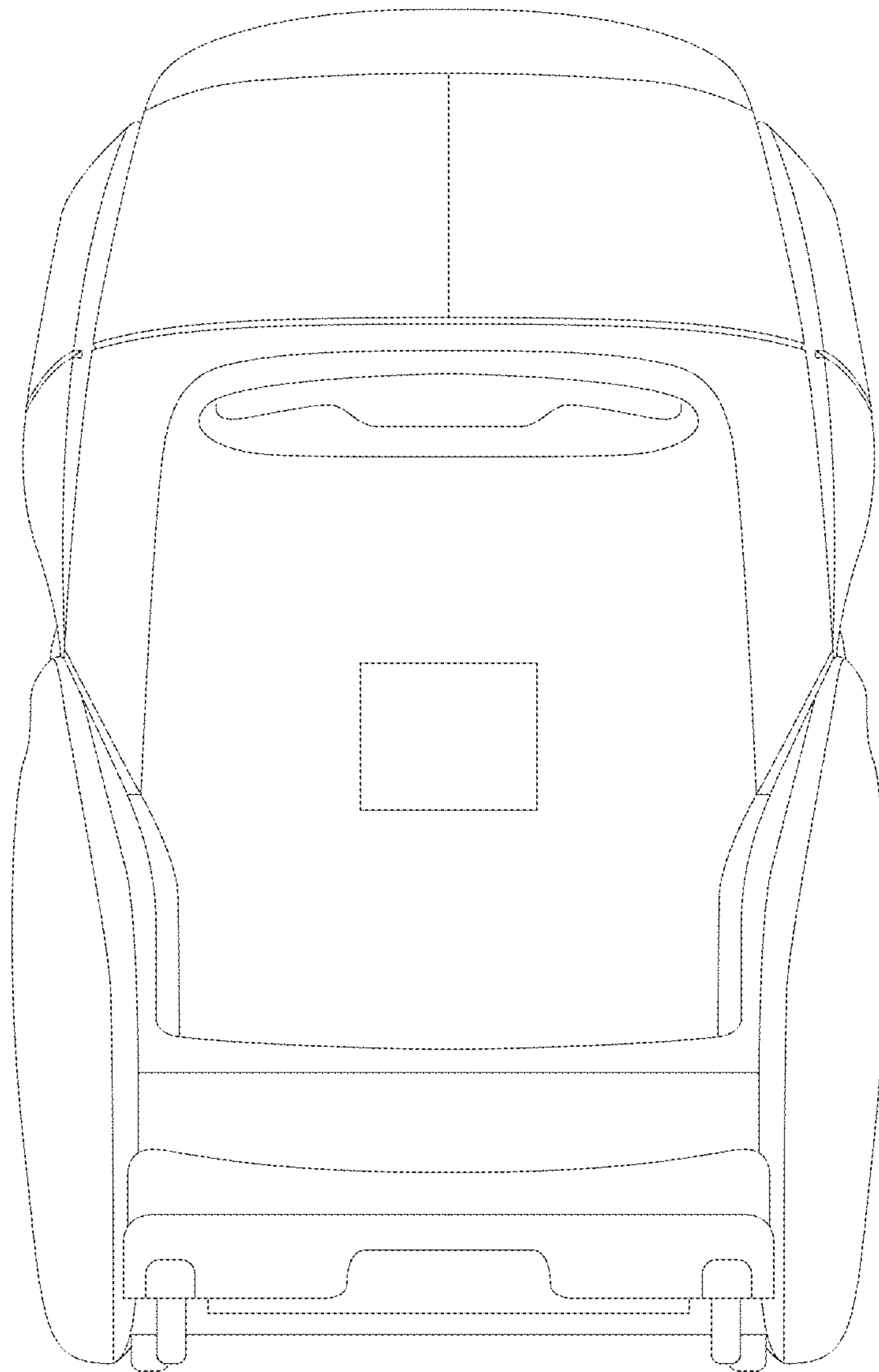

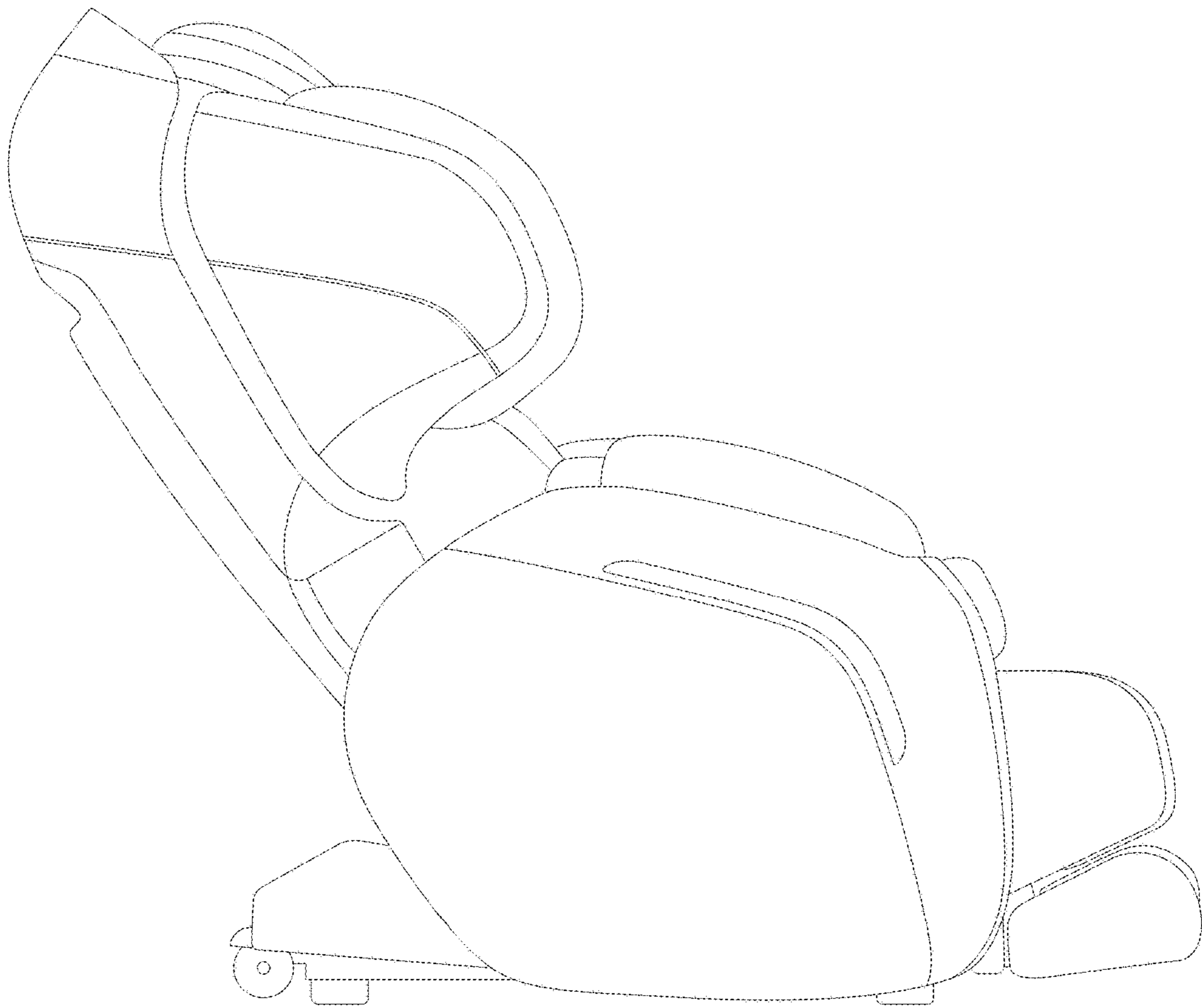

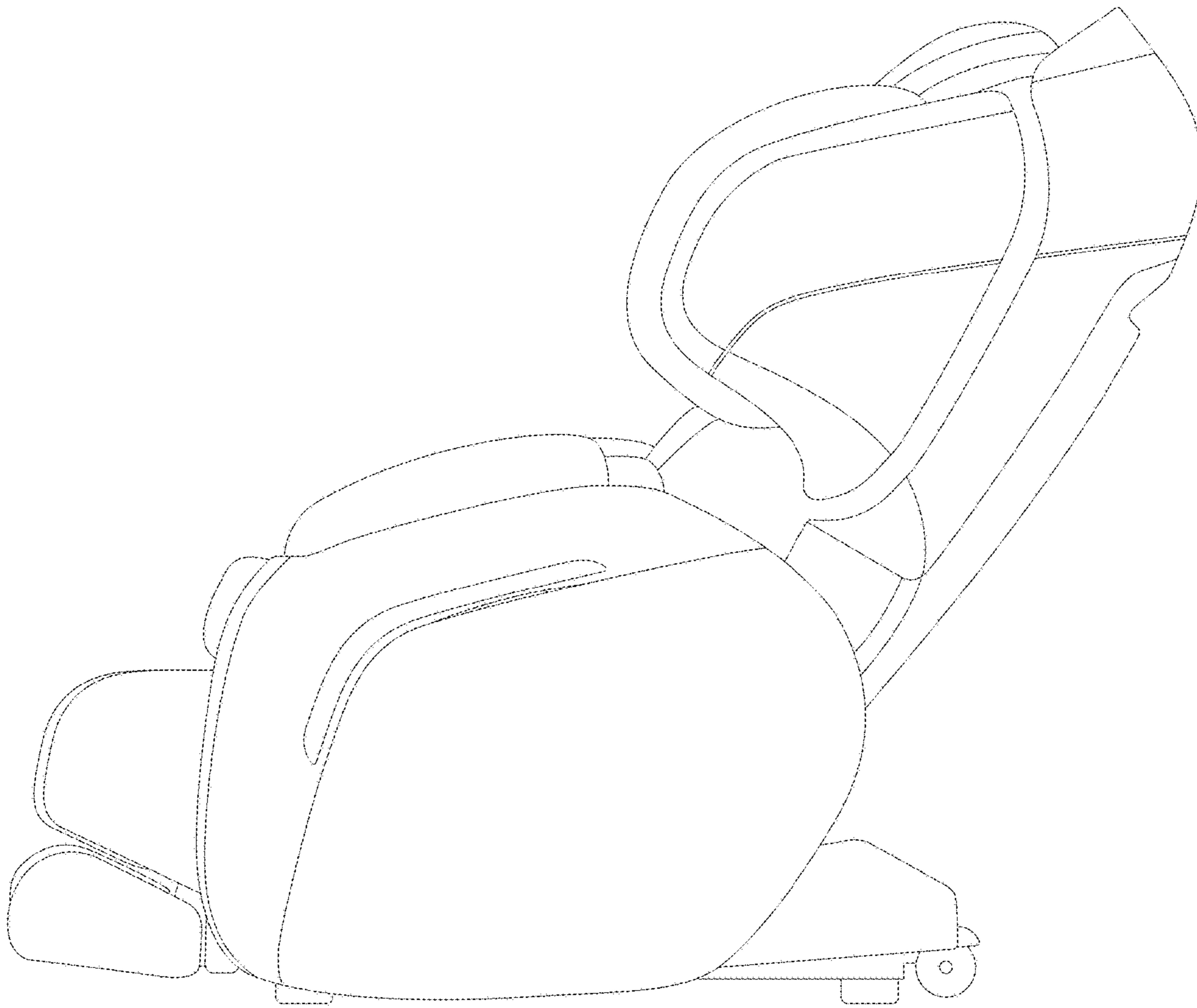

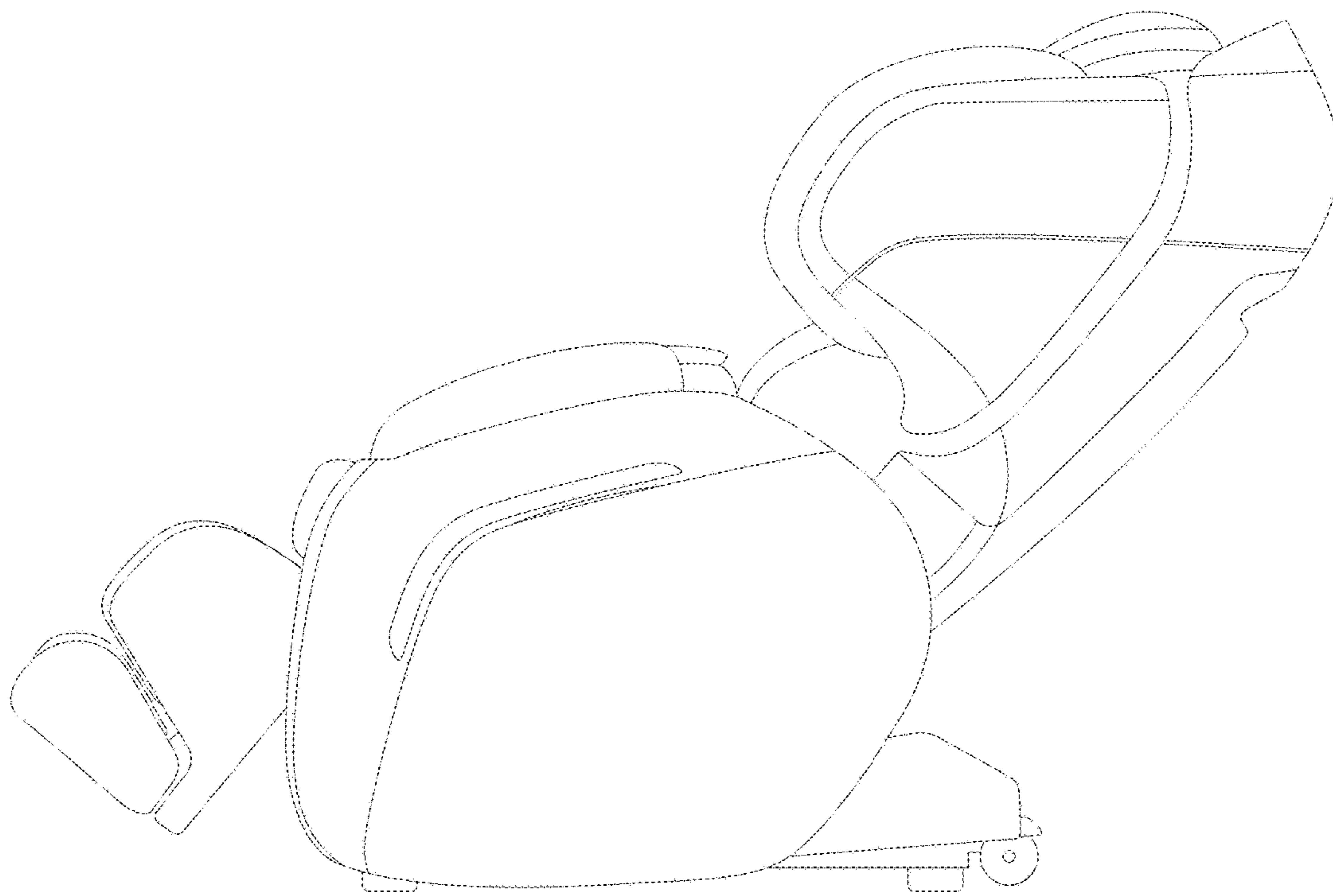

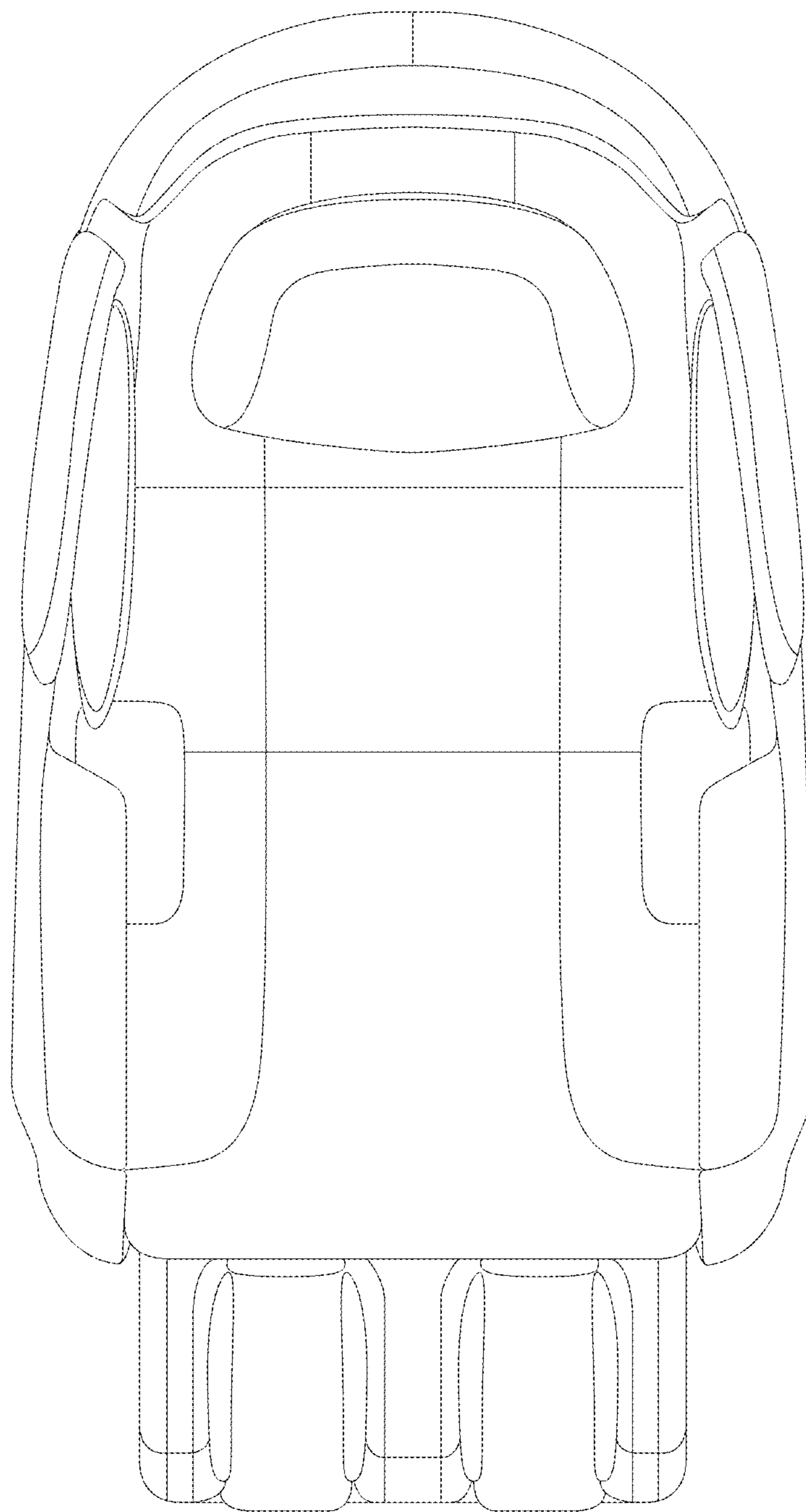

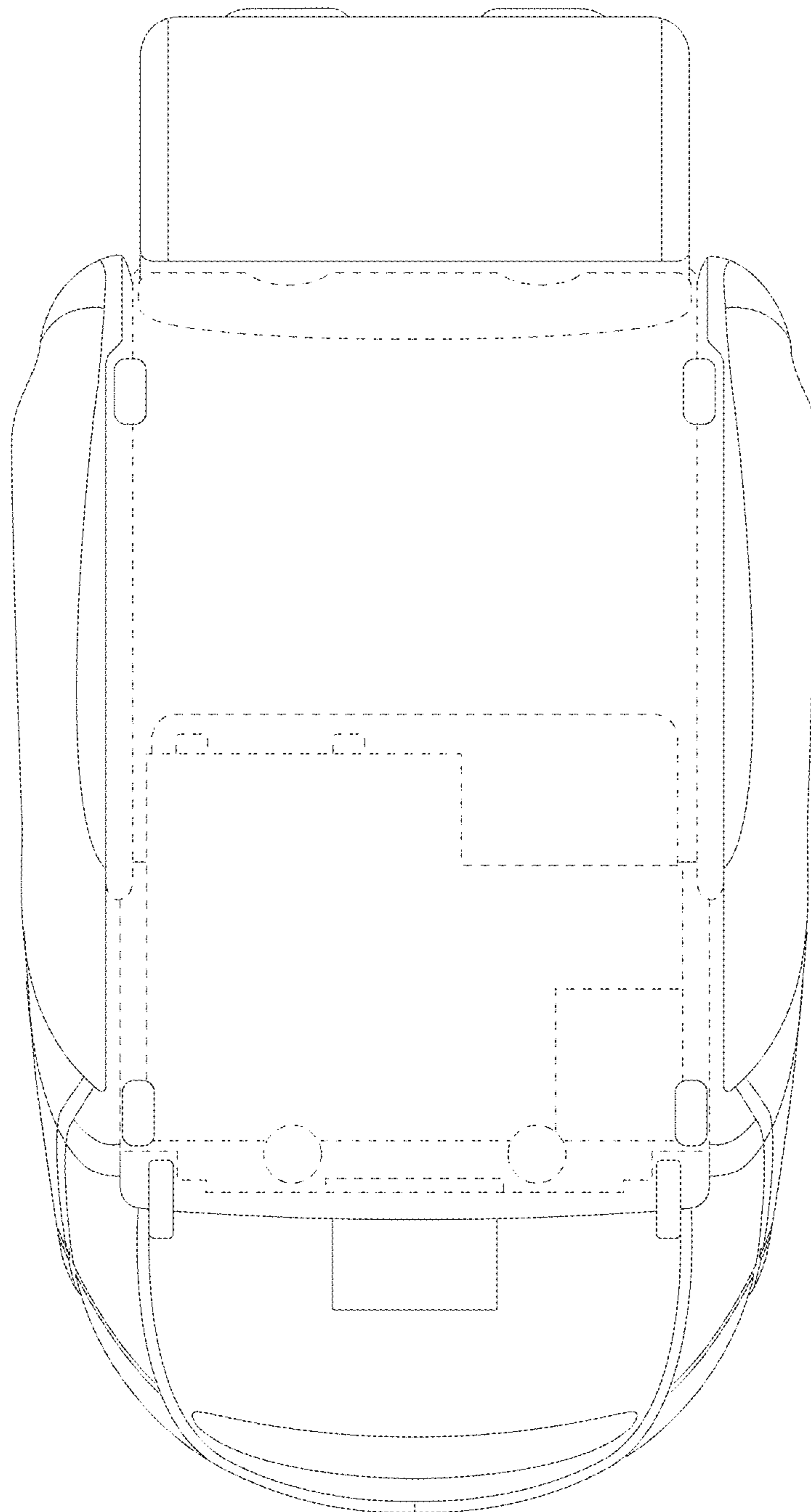
