DESCRIPTION

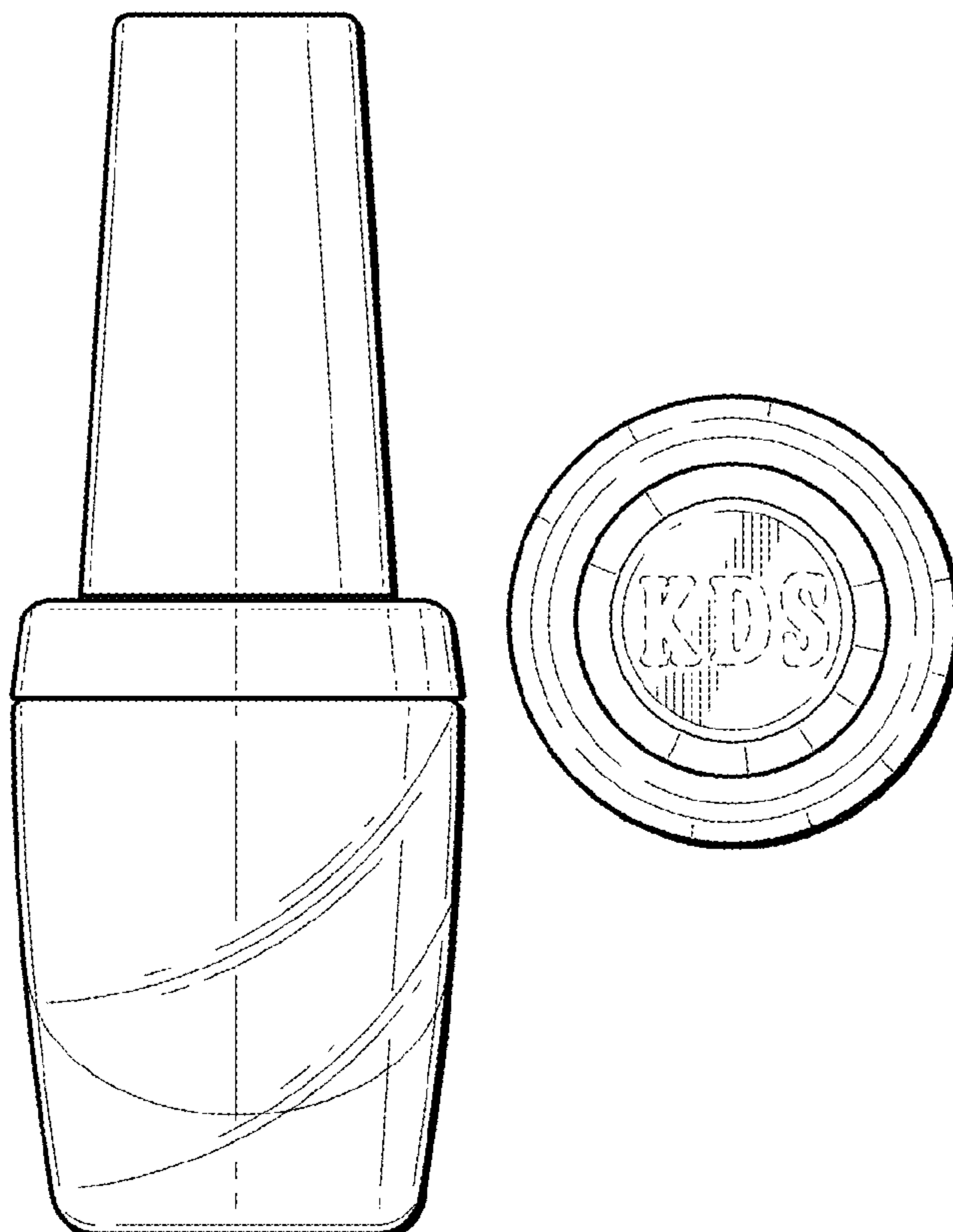
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the fingernail polish bottle, the rear, left and right elevation views being mirror image thereof;

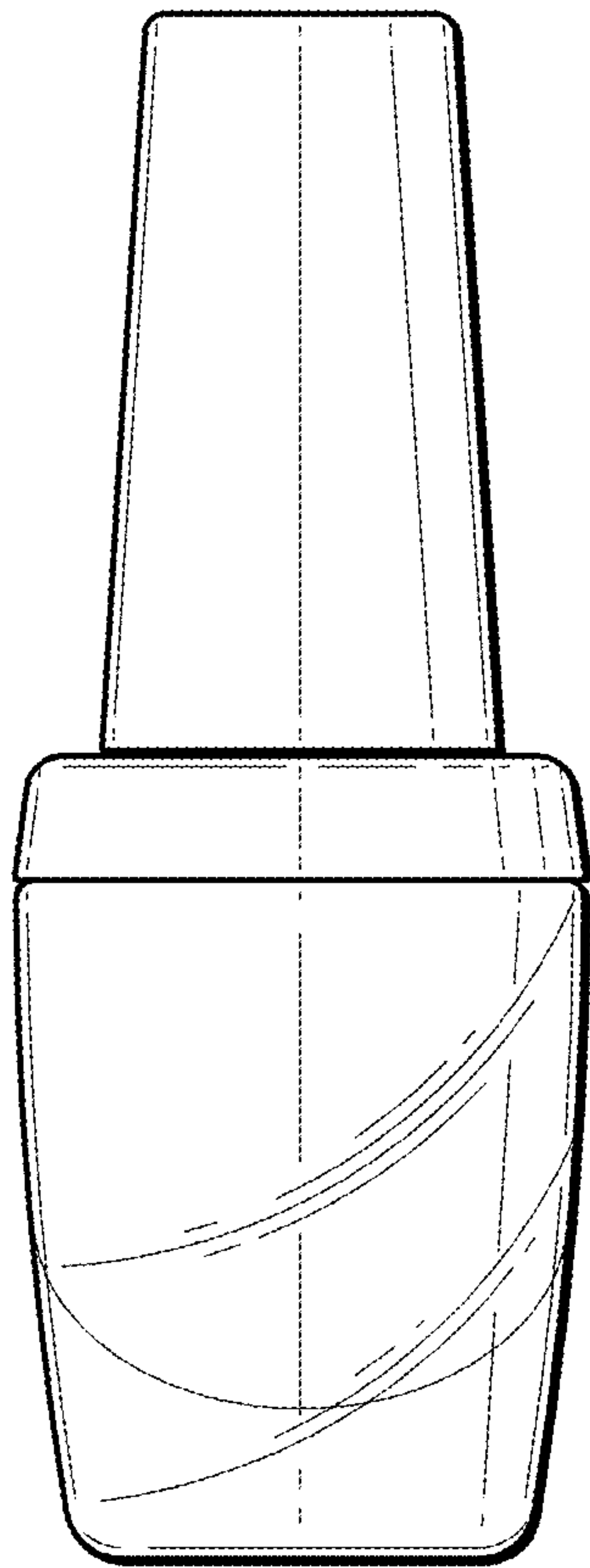

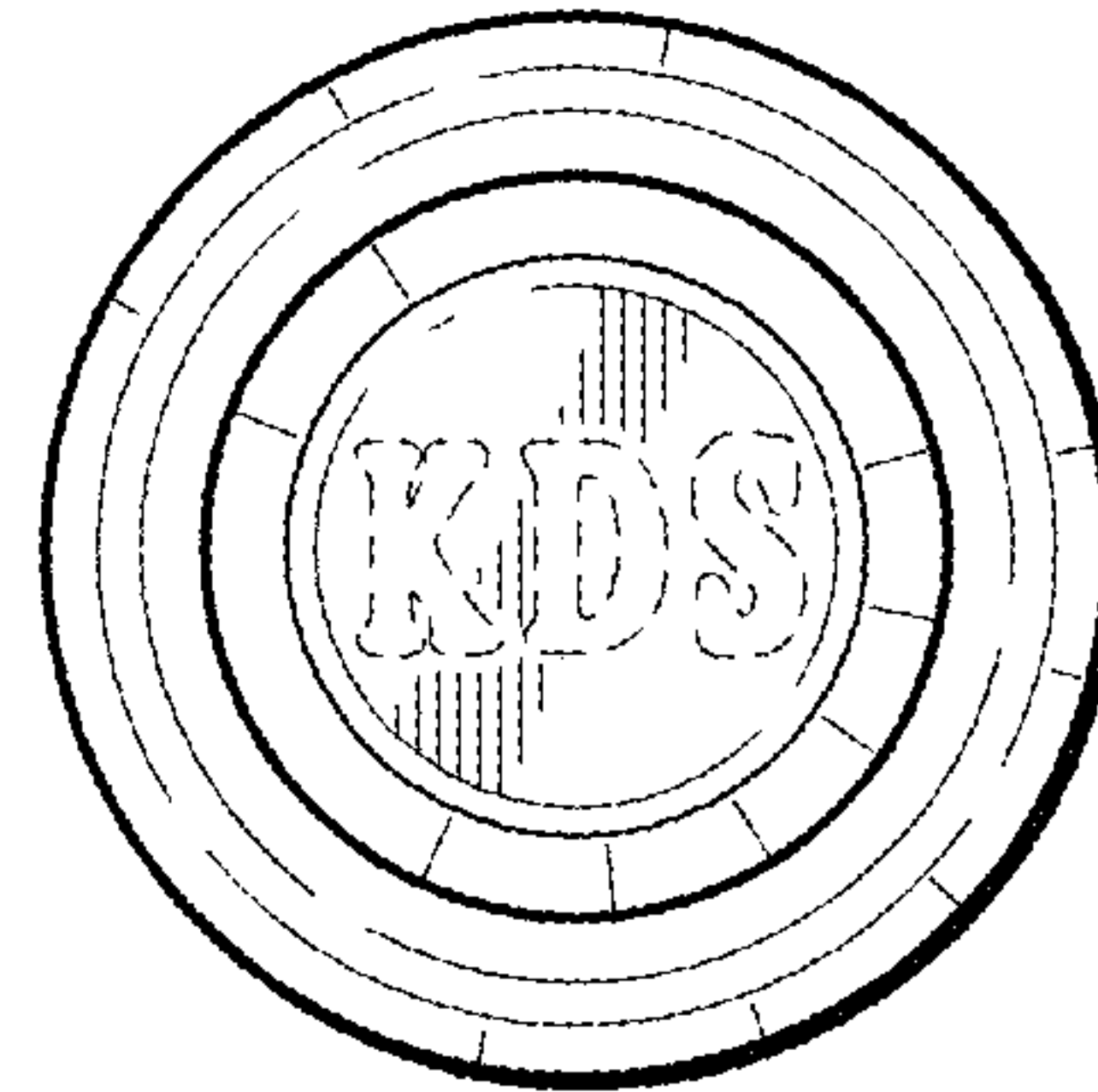

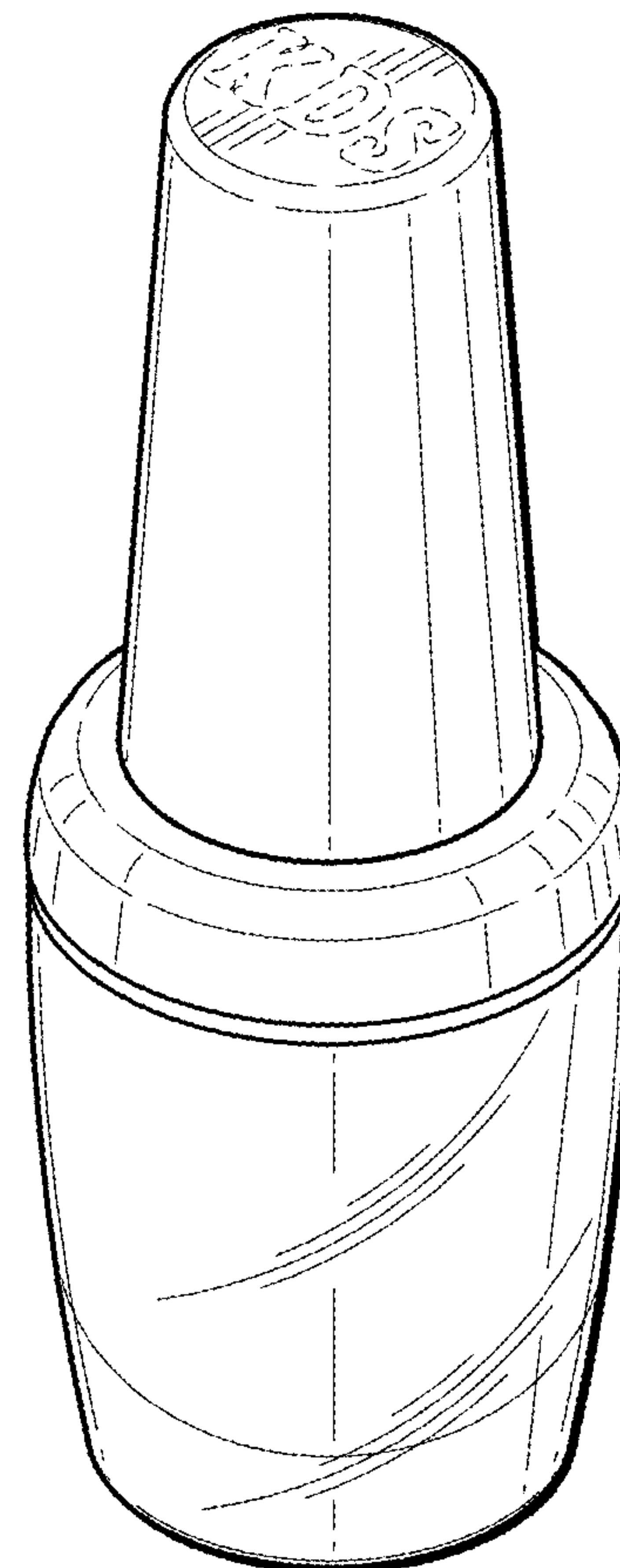
