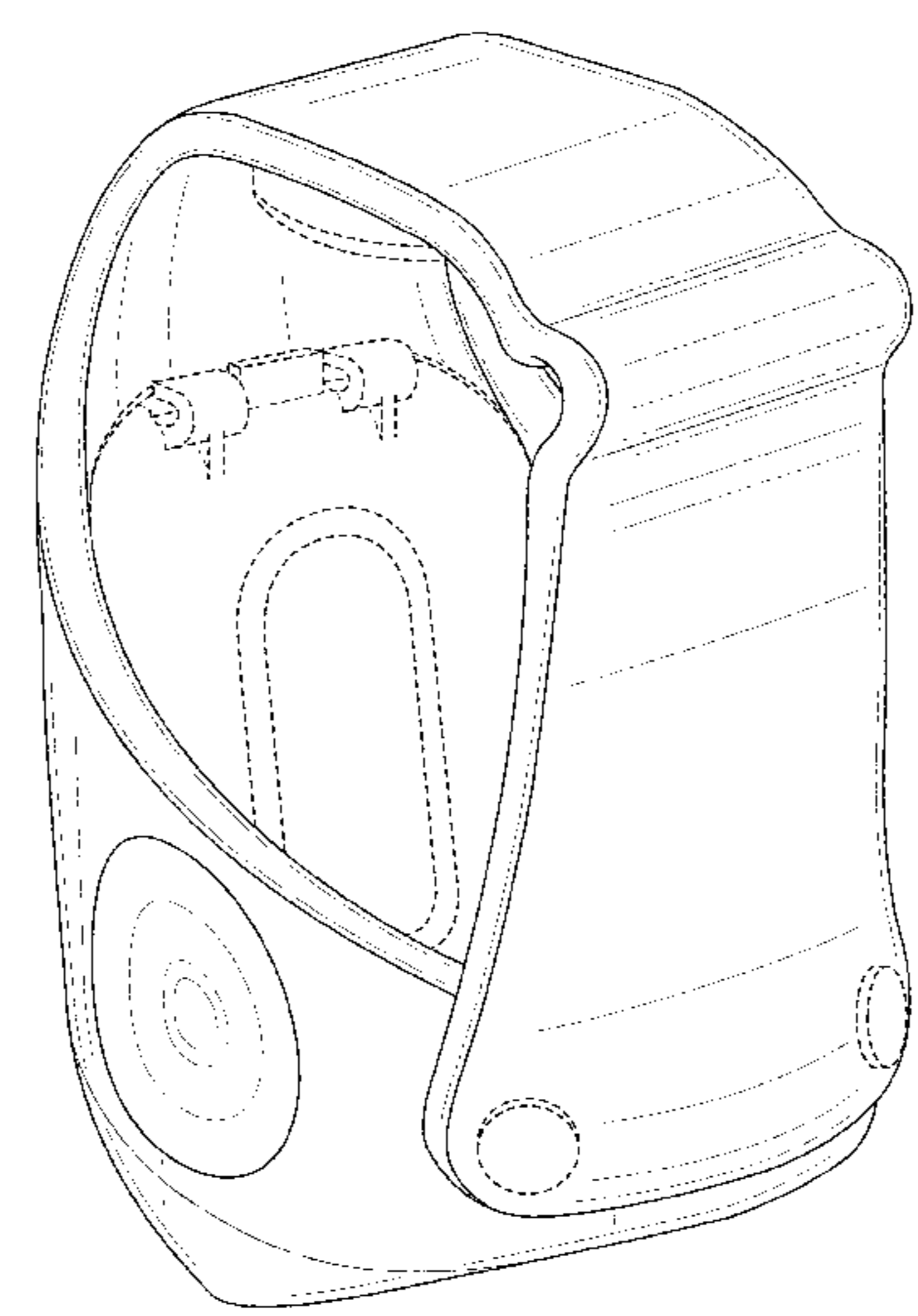
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cover for an inhaler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cover for an inhaler, shown without environment and in the closed position;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the cover for an inhaler, shown with an inhaler and in the closed position; and,
FIG. 9 is another perspective view of the cover for an inhaler, shown in the open position.
The broken lines depict portions of the article and environment that form no part of the claimed design.

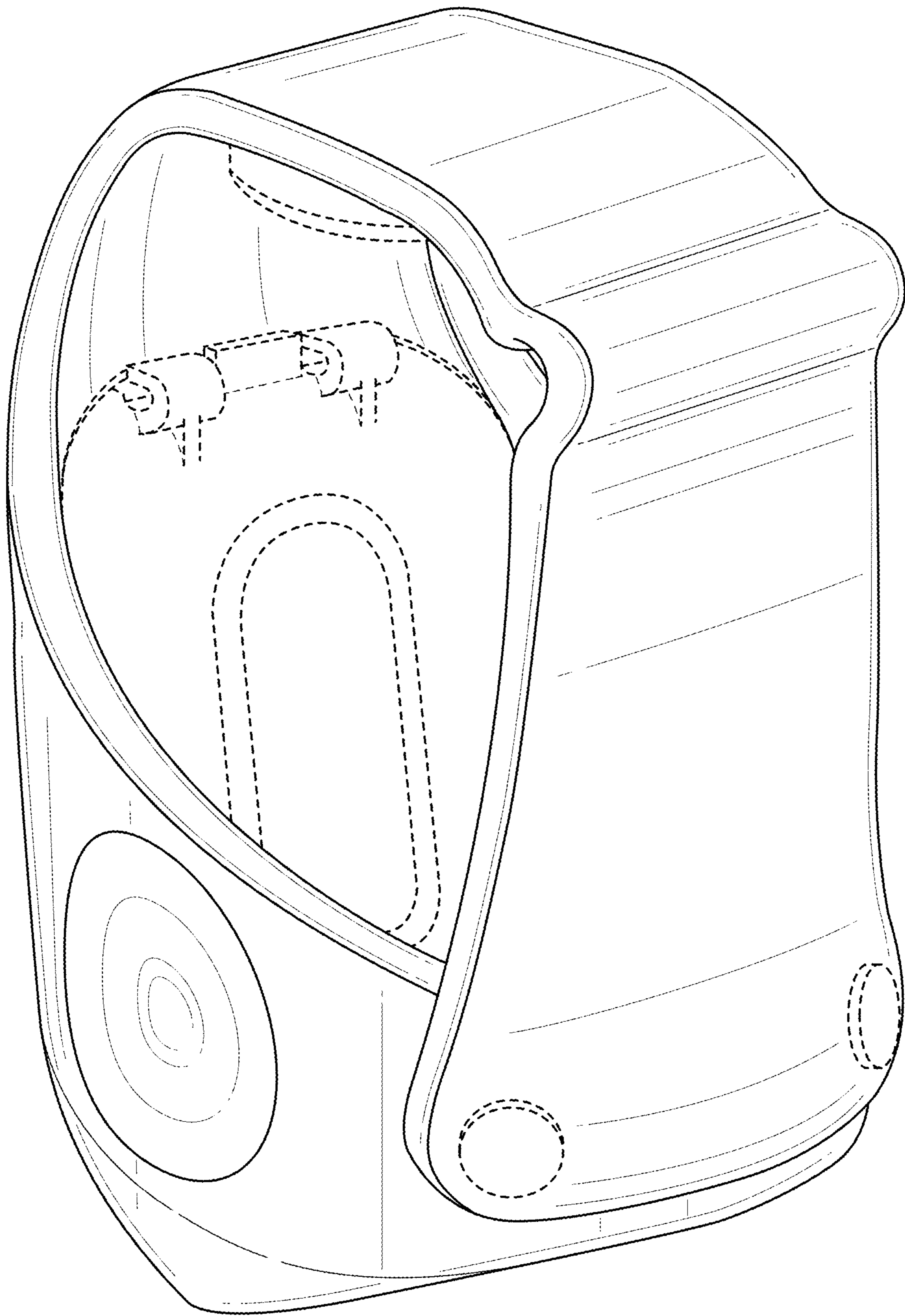

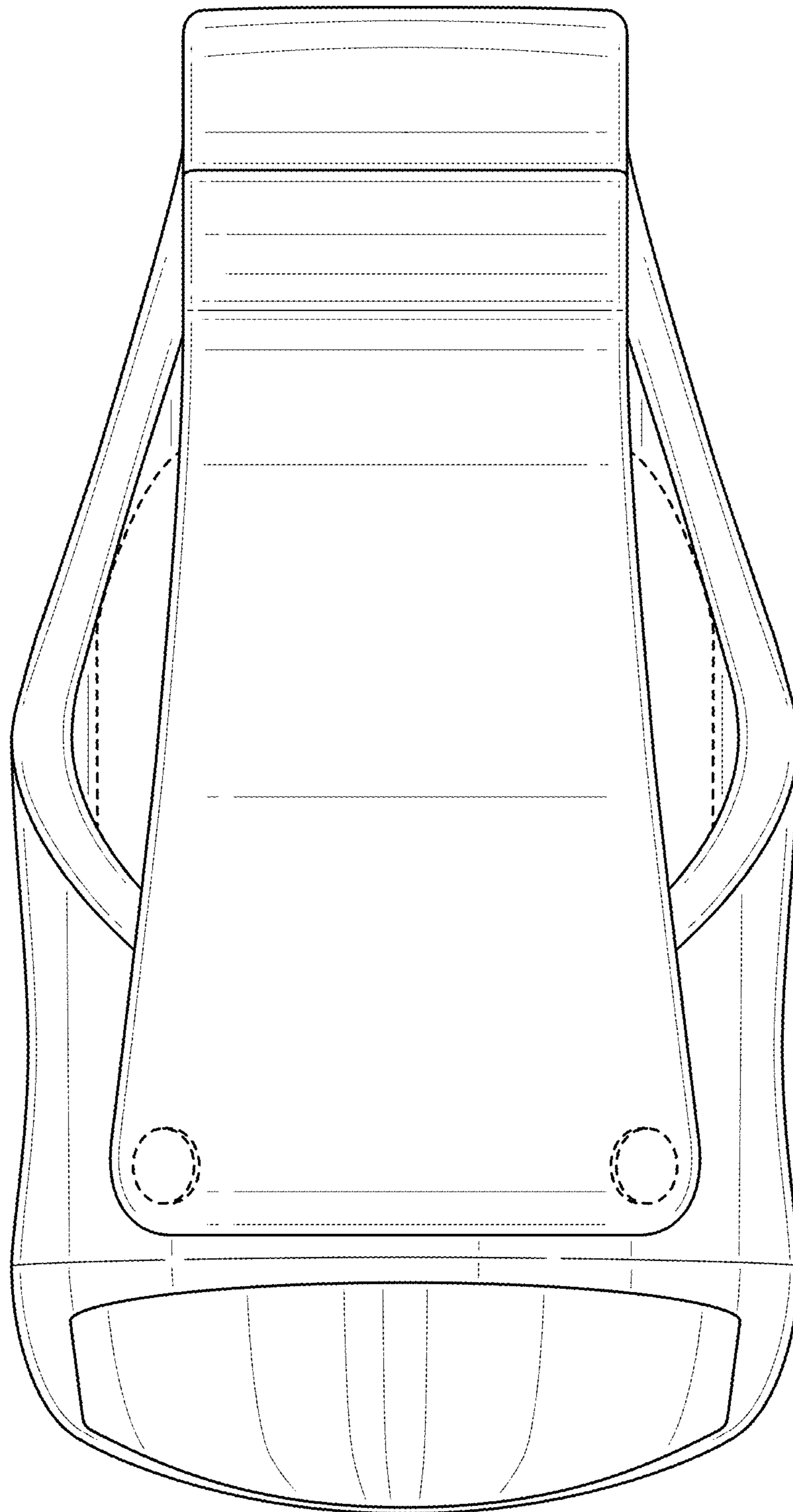

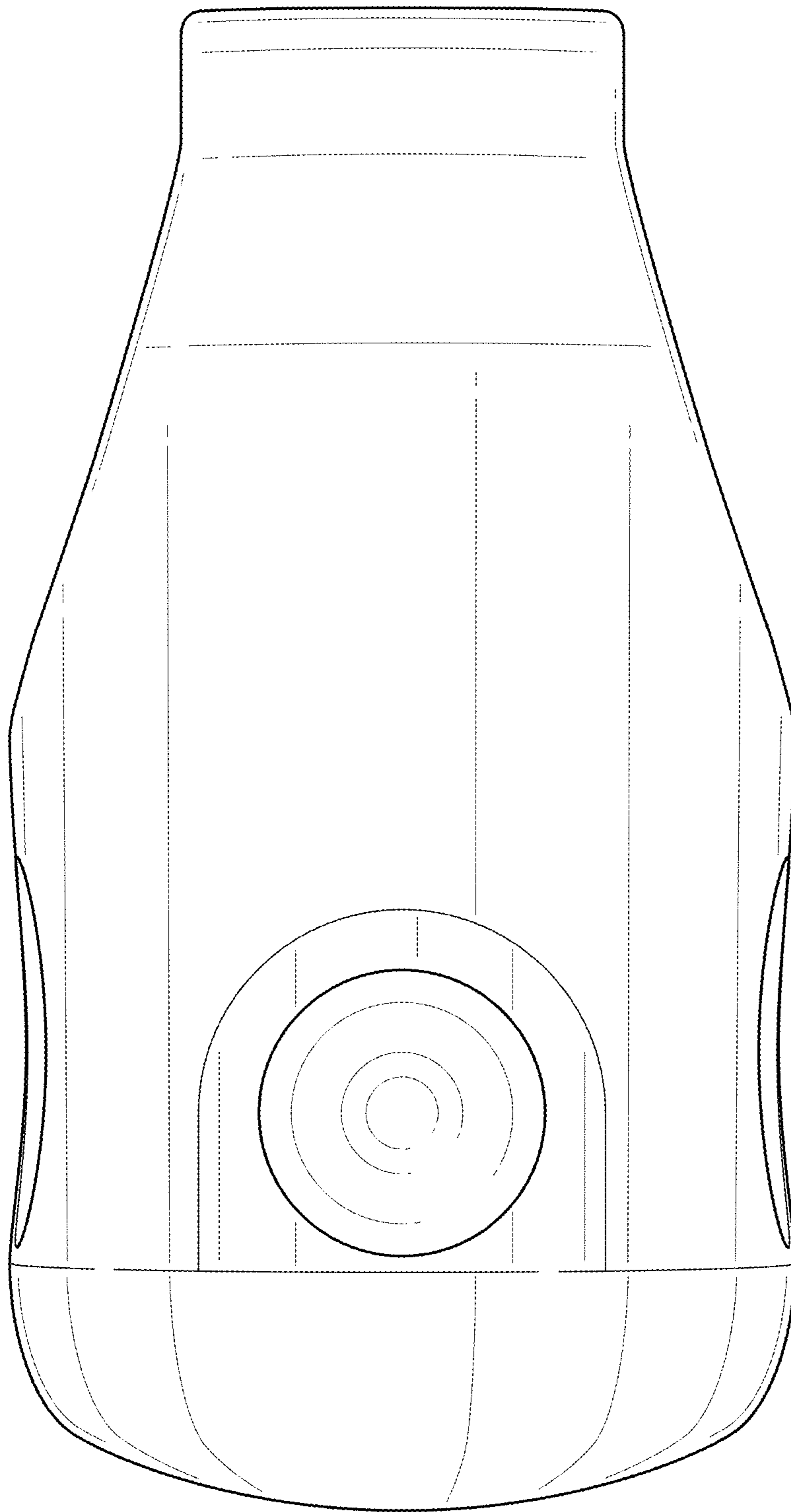

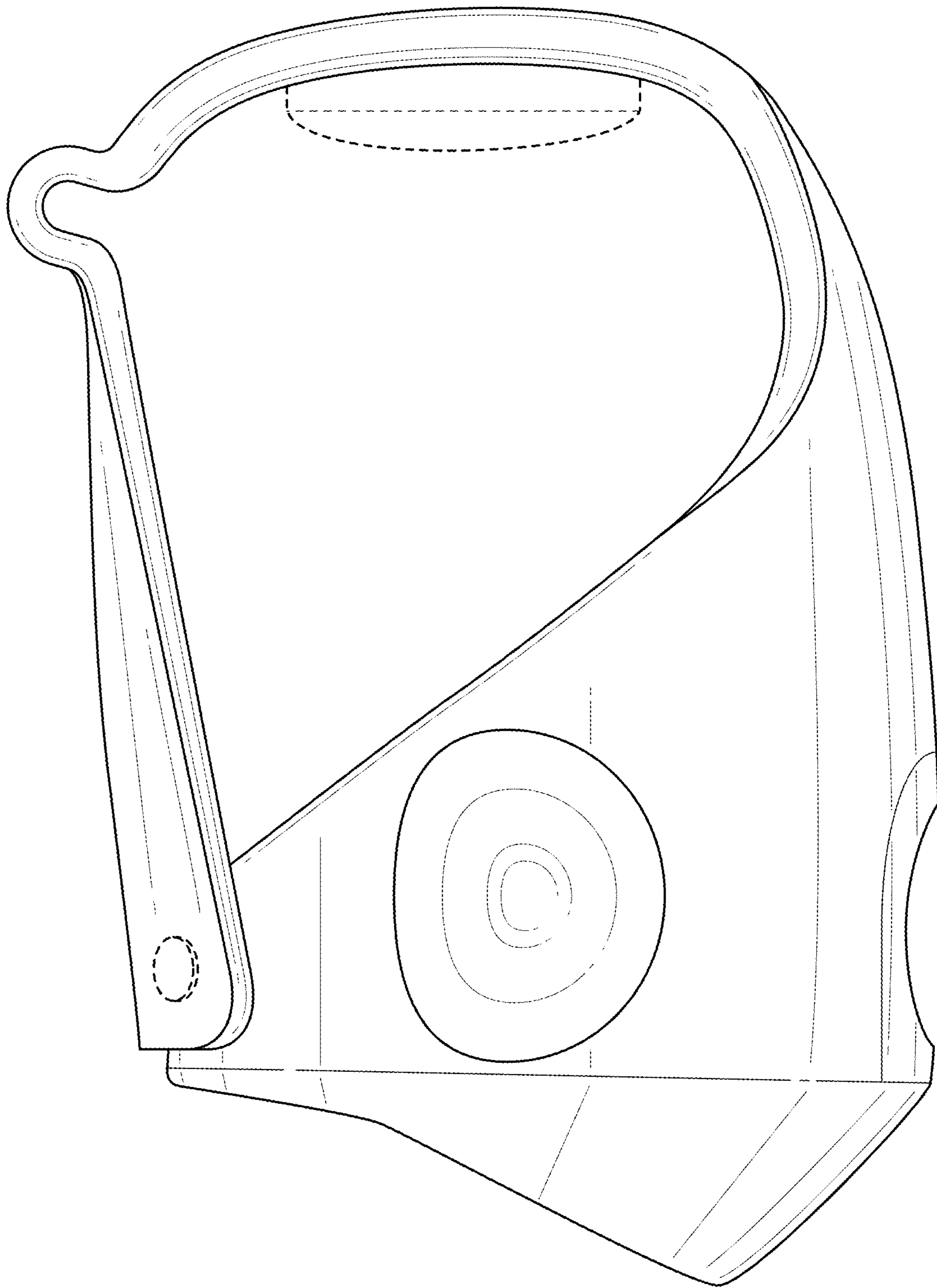

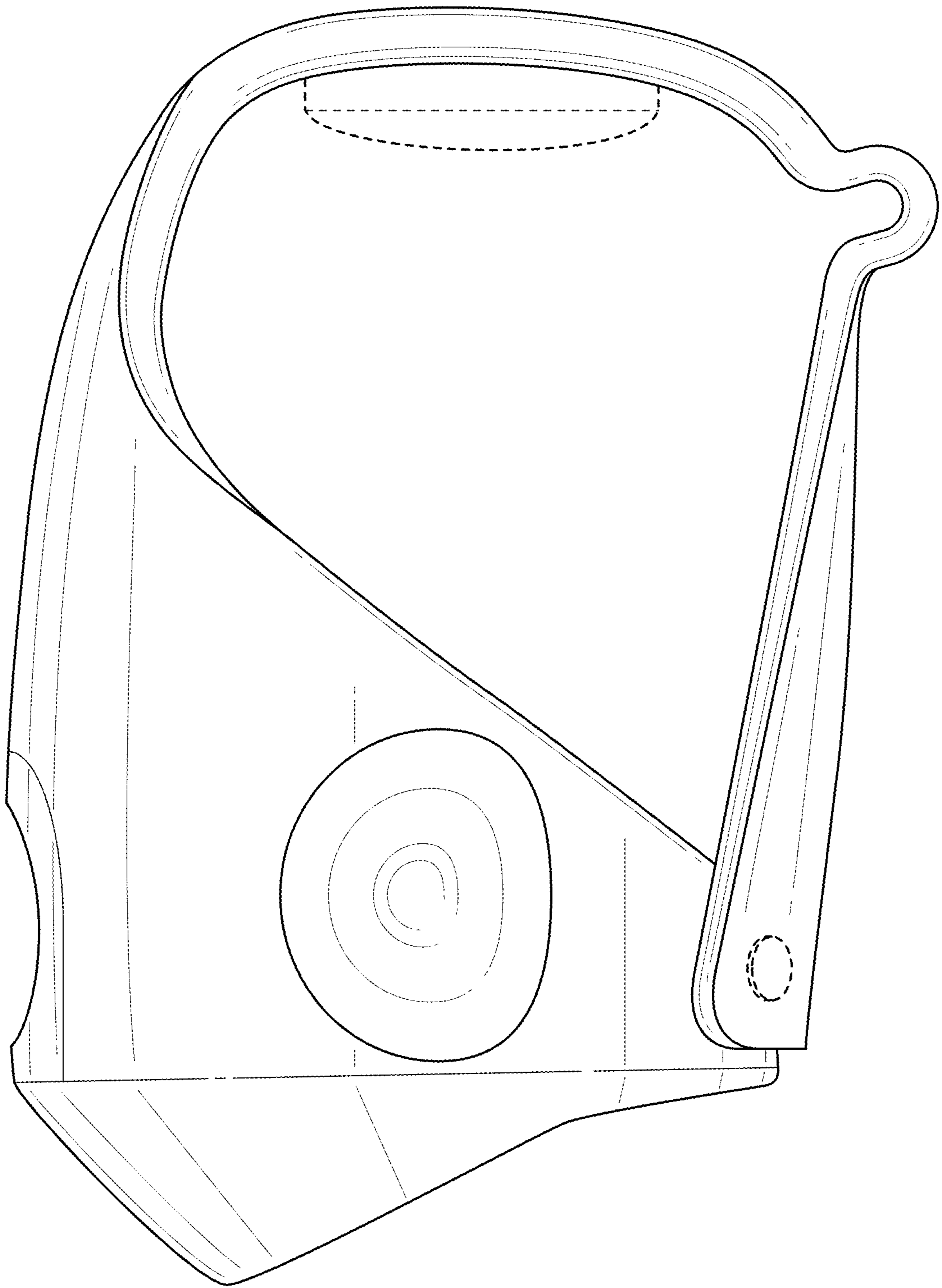

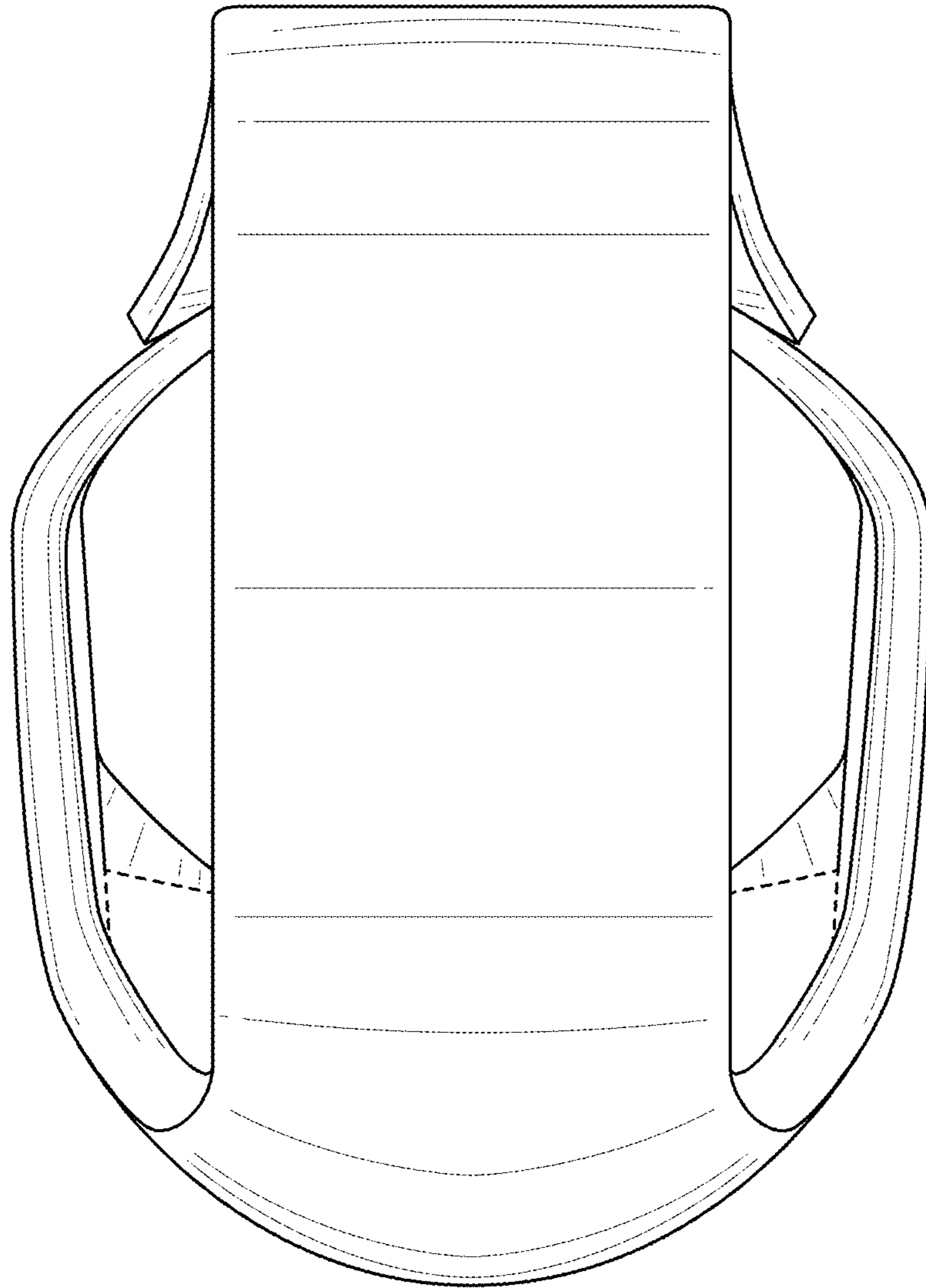

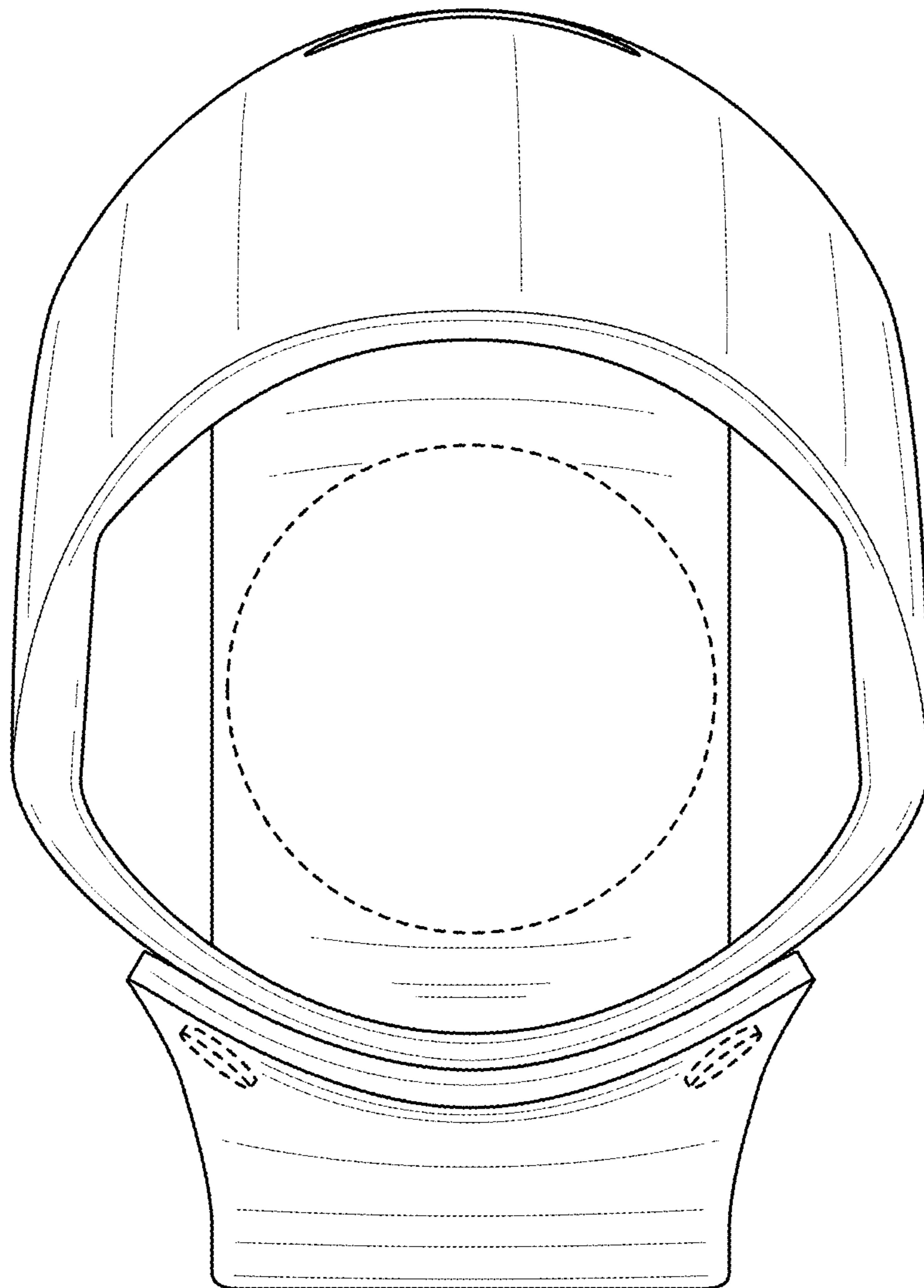

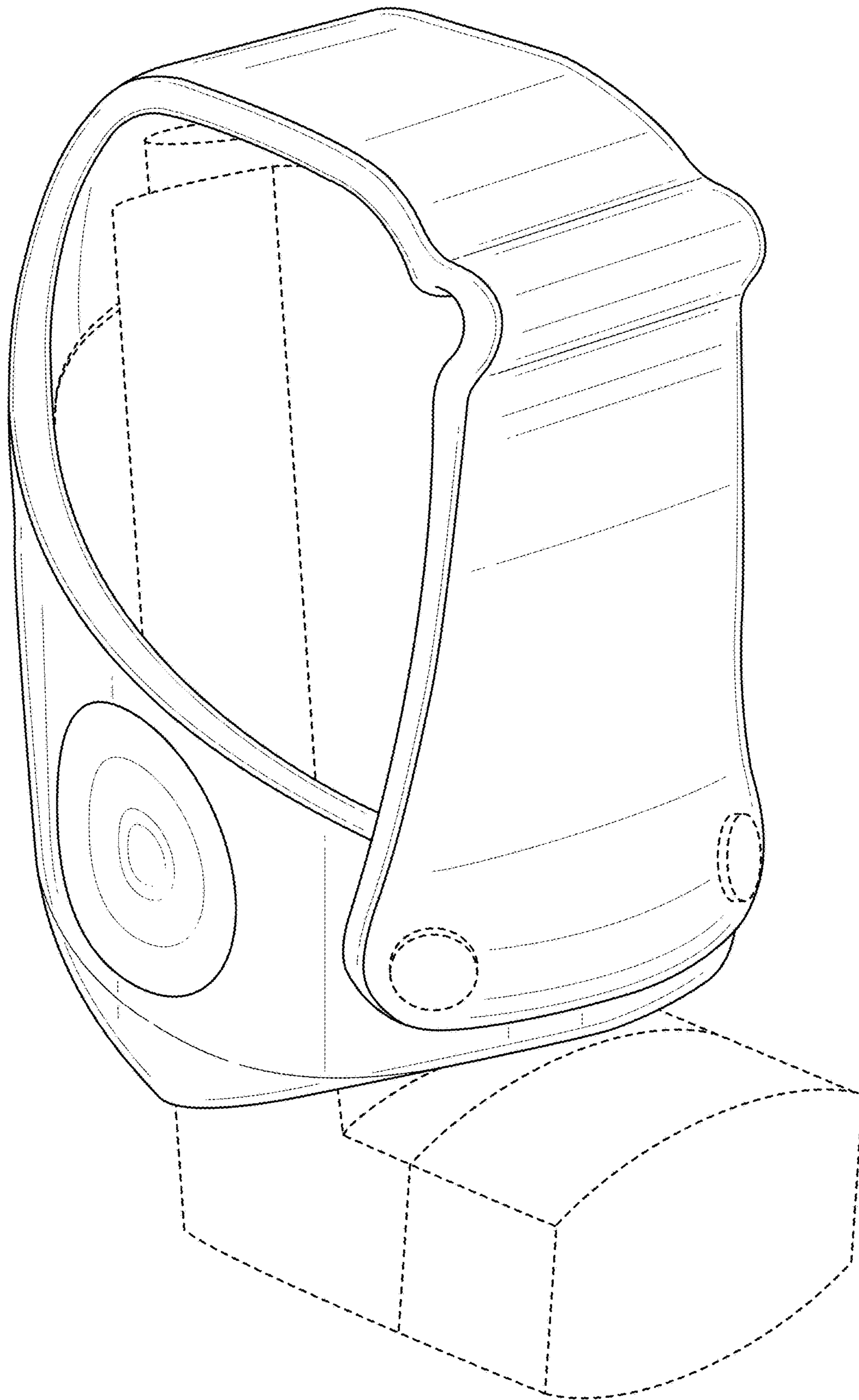

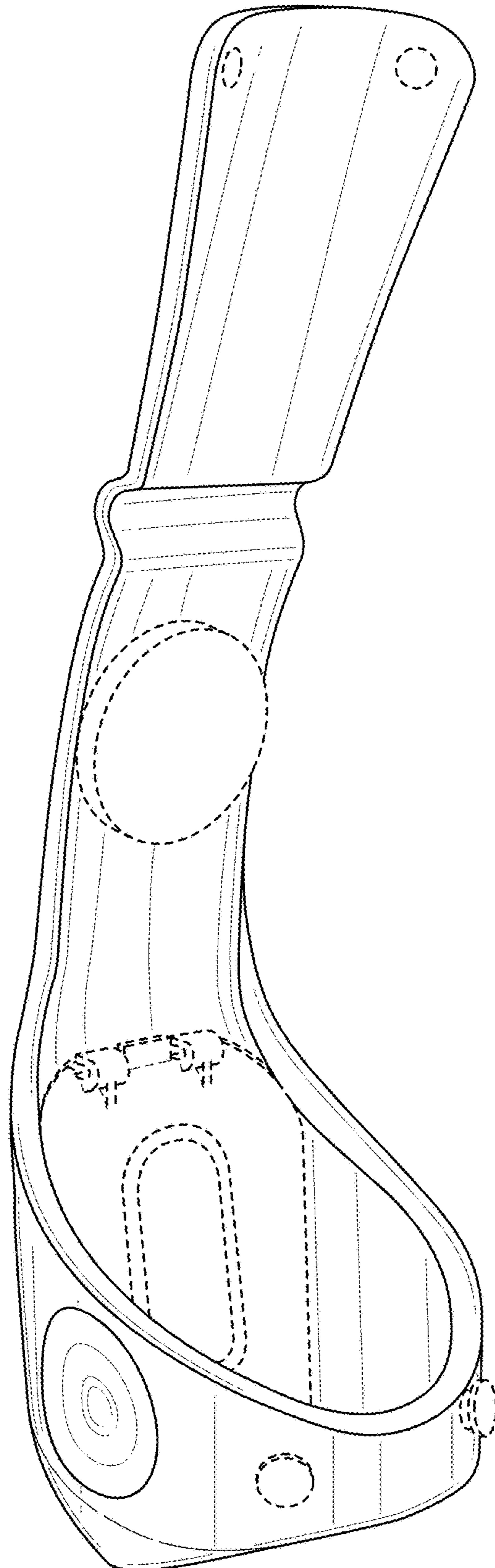
