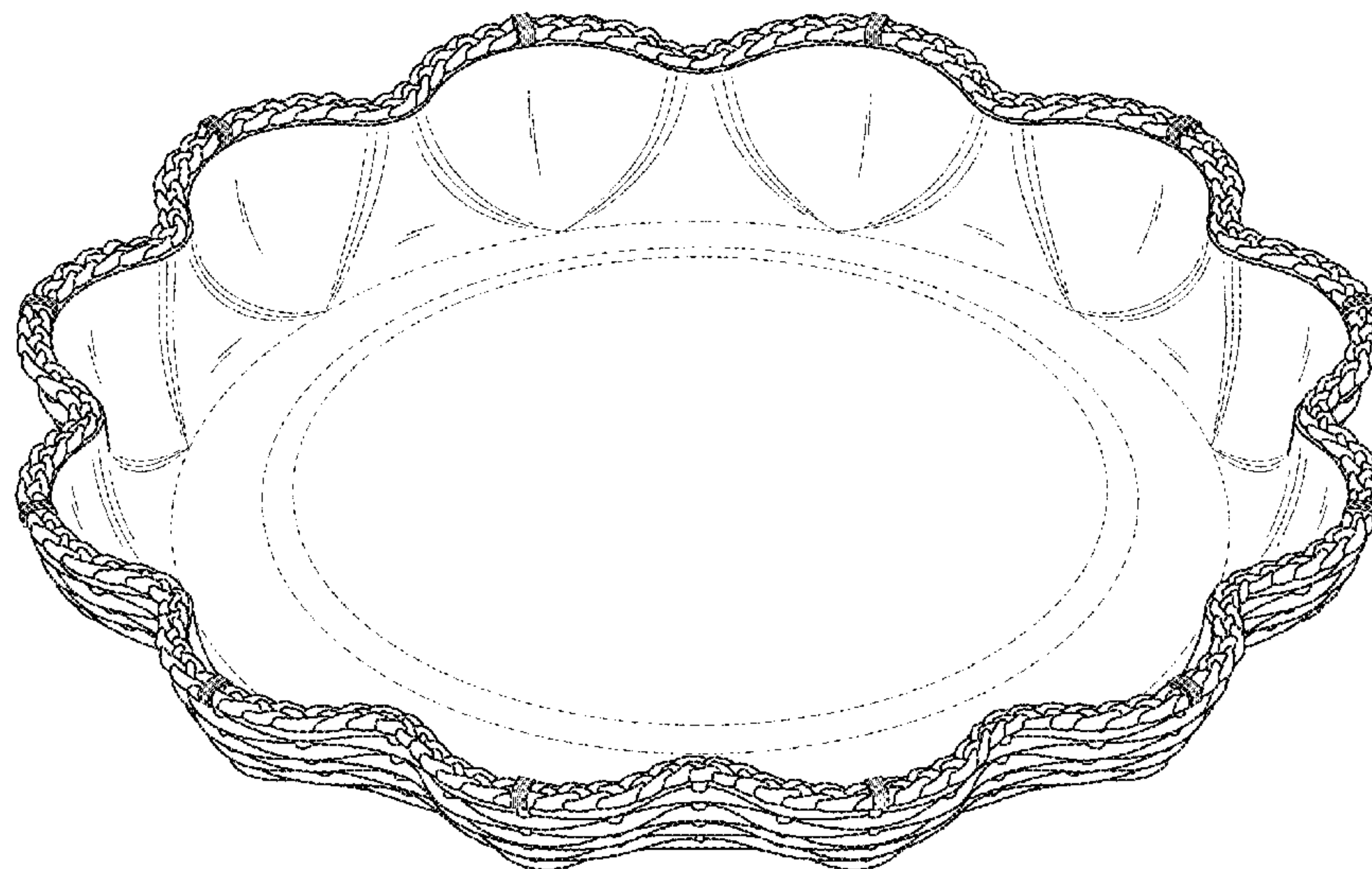
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a food tray with wicker appear-
ance, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an embodiment of a
food tray showing our claimed design.
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the tray design of FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the tray design of FIG.
2, the rear elevational view, left elevational view and right
elevational views being identical thereto.
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the tray design of FIG. 2.
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view of the tray design of FIG. 2
taken in the direction of cutting plane 5-5 of FIG. 2; and,
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view of the tray design of FIG. 2
taken in the direction of cutting plane 6-6 of FIG. 2.
The broken lines represent portions of the structure that
forms no part of the claim.

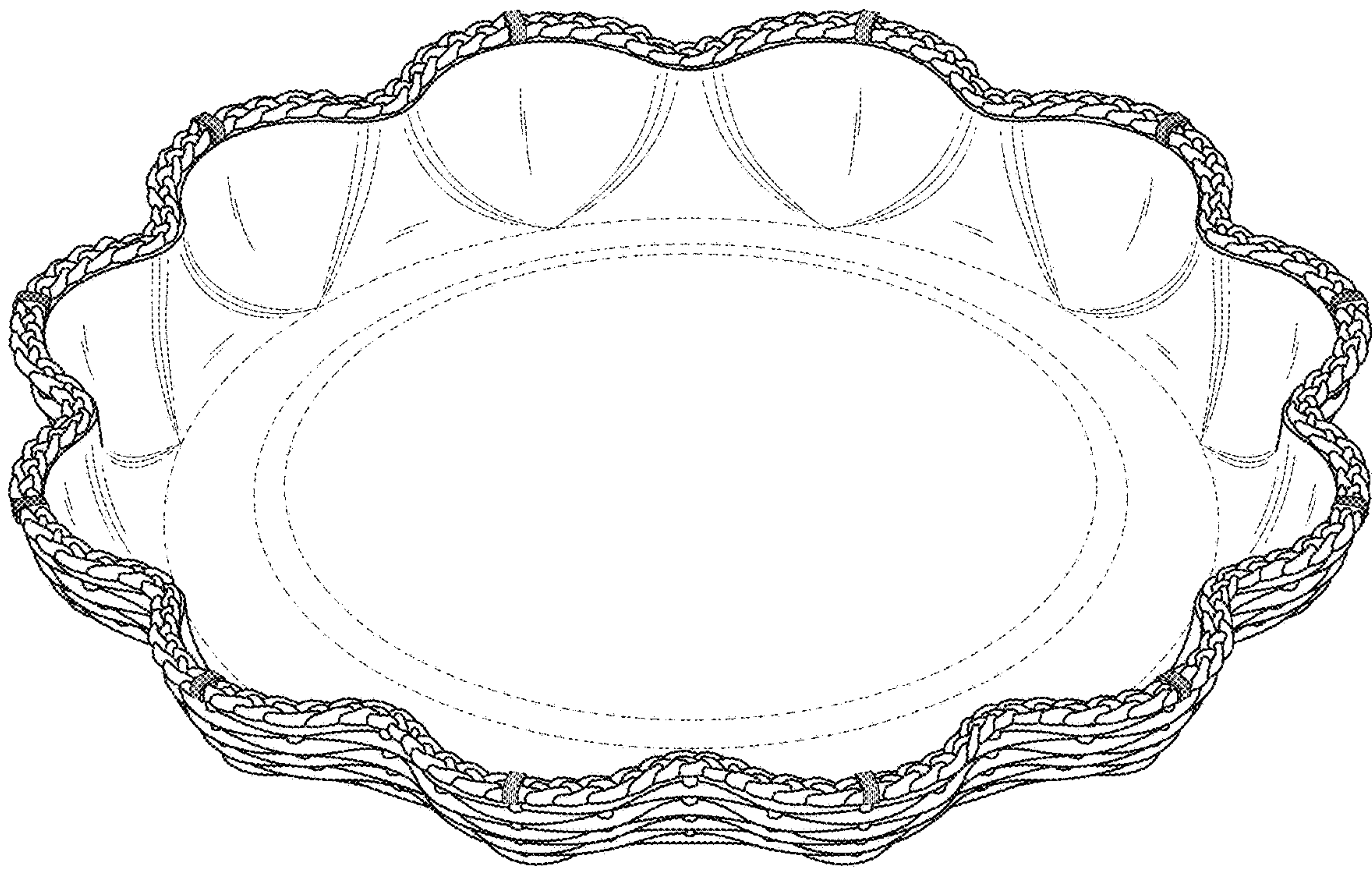

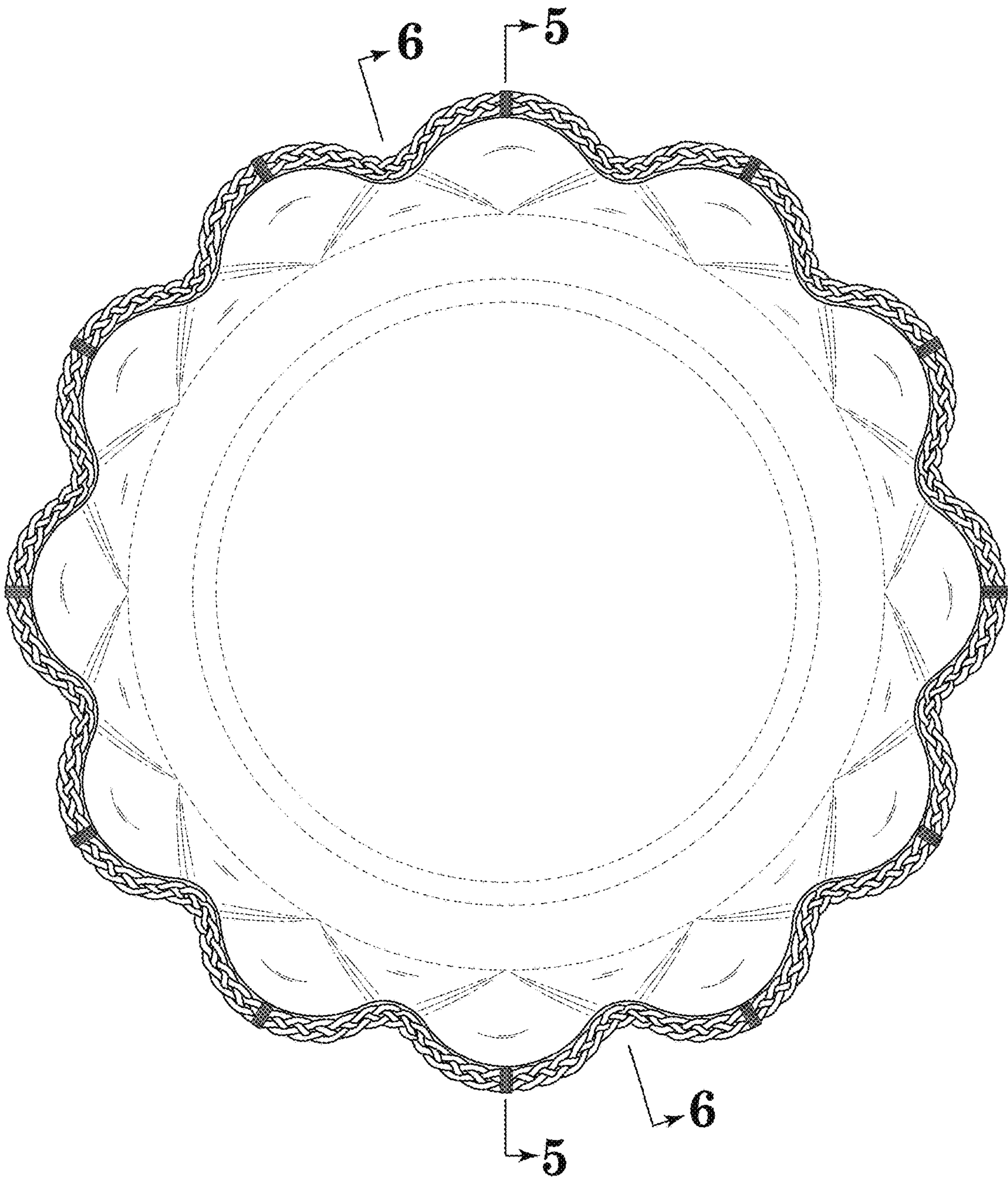

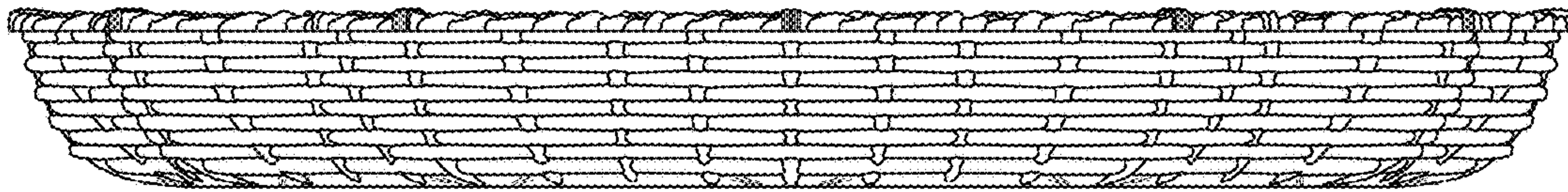

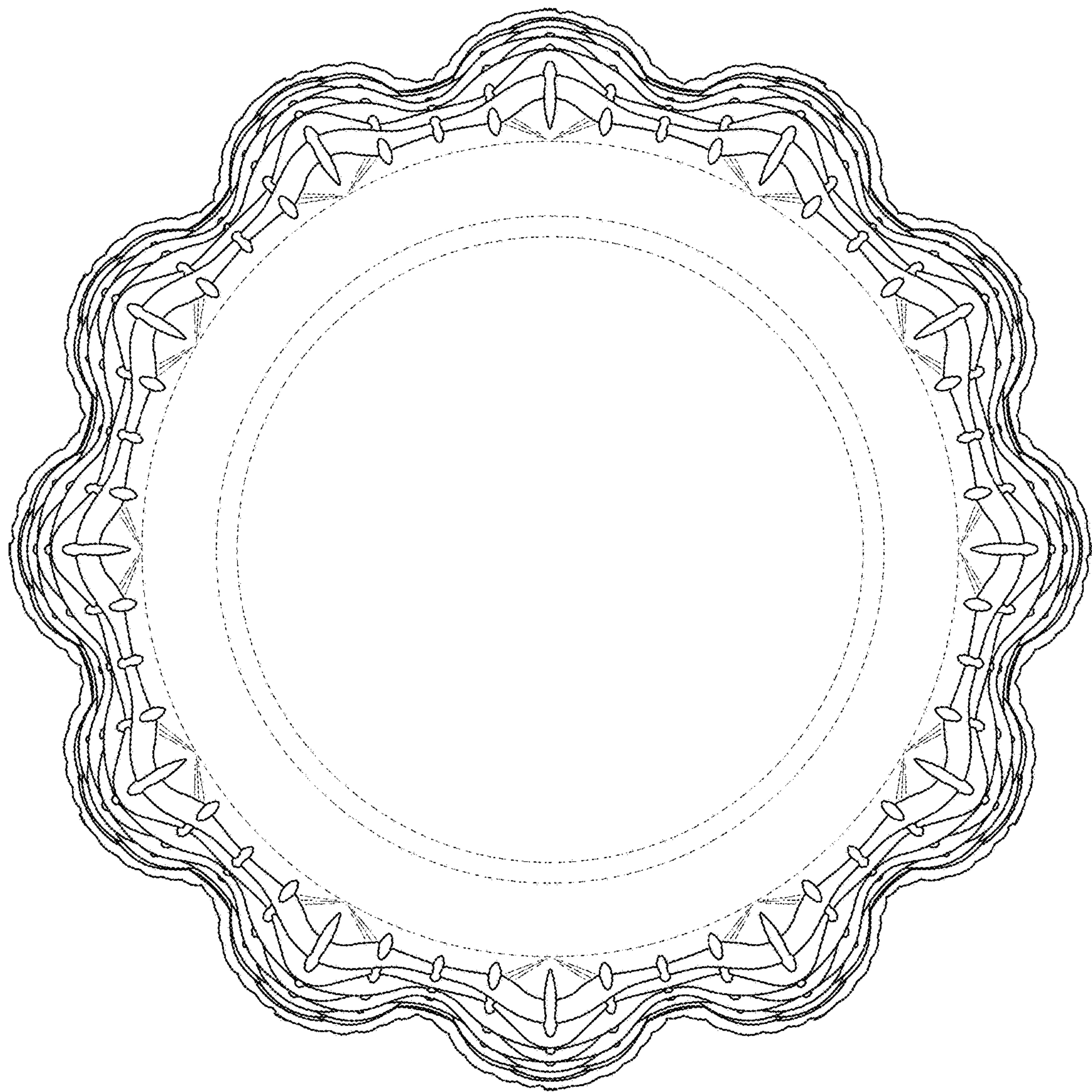

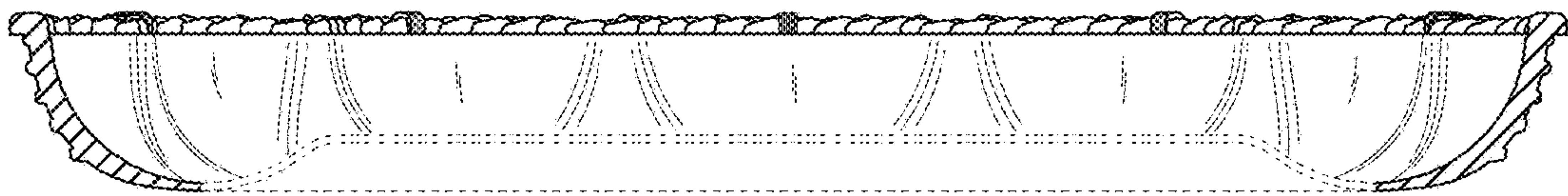

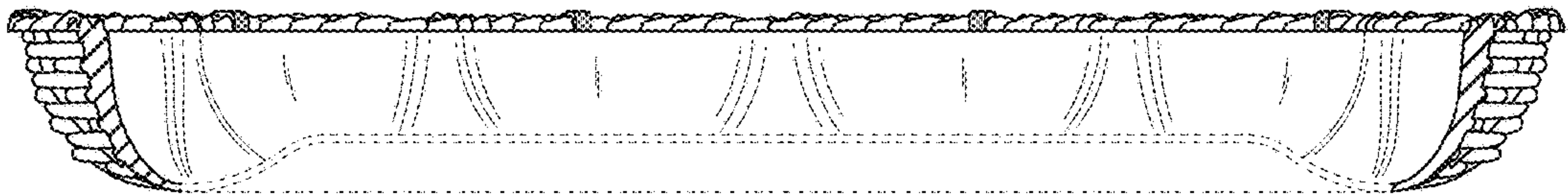
