FIG. 4 is left side view of the notebook with fur of FIG. 1;

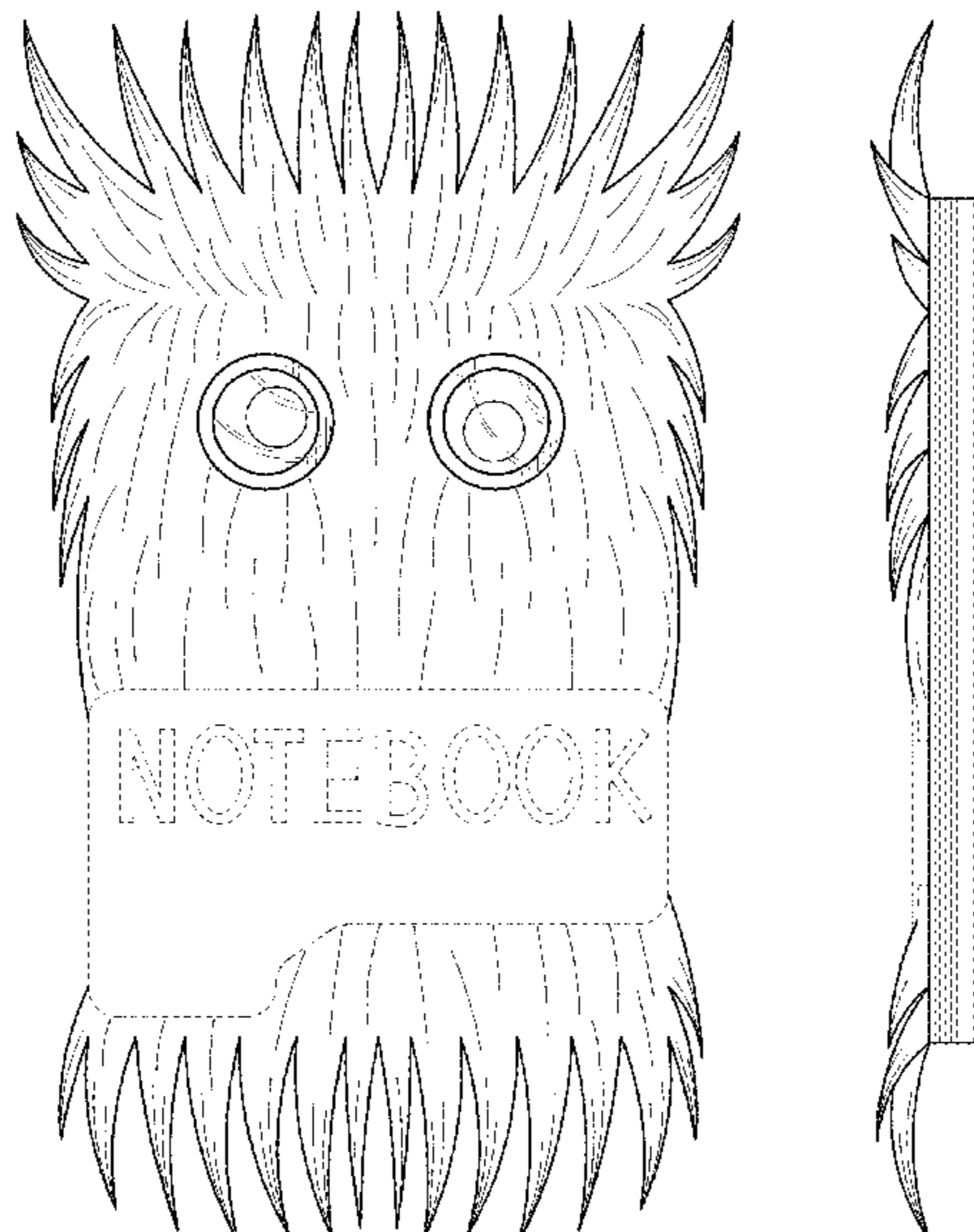
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the notebook with fur of FIG. 1;

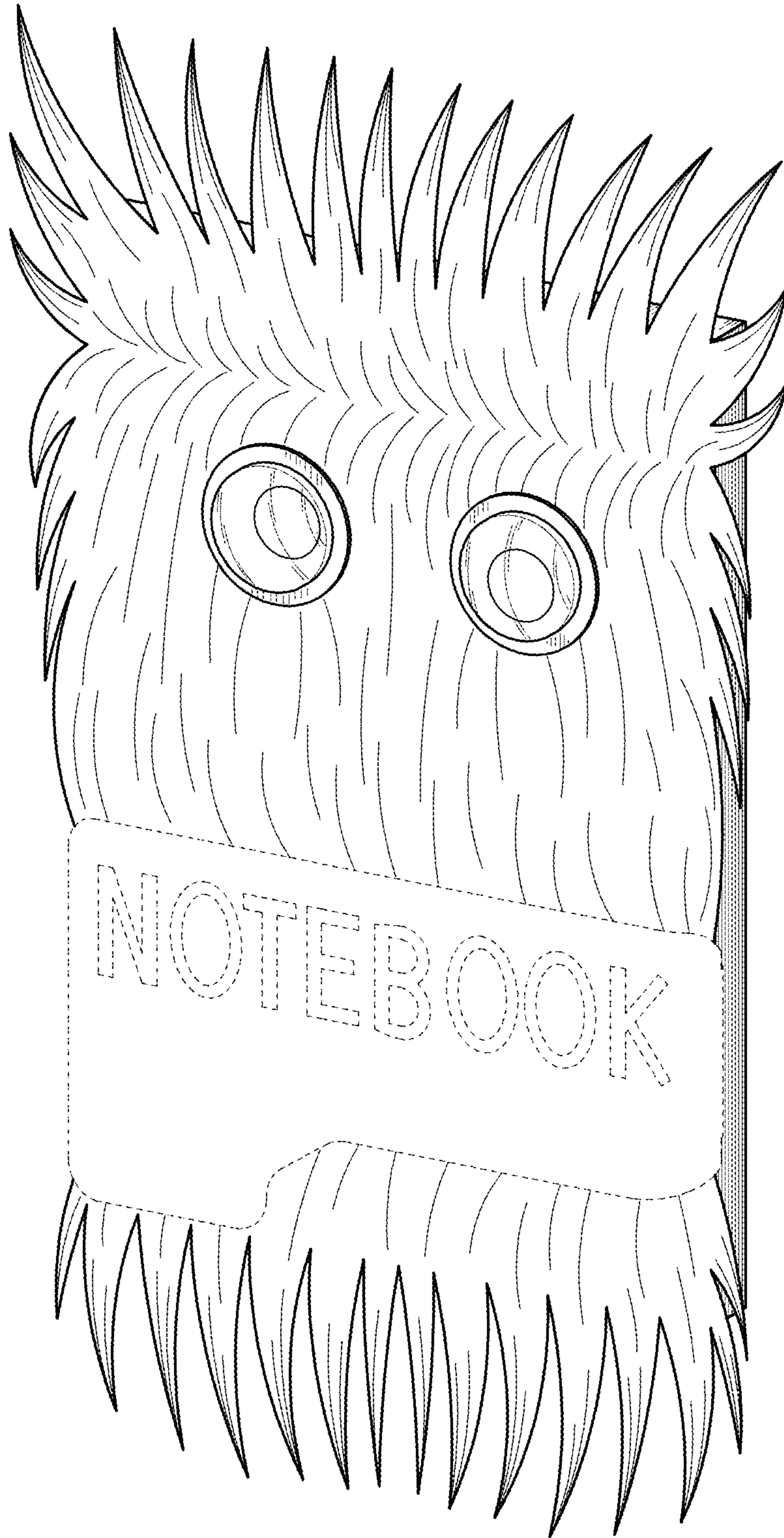

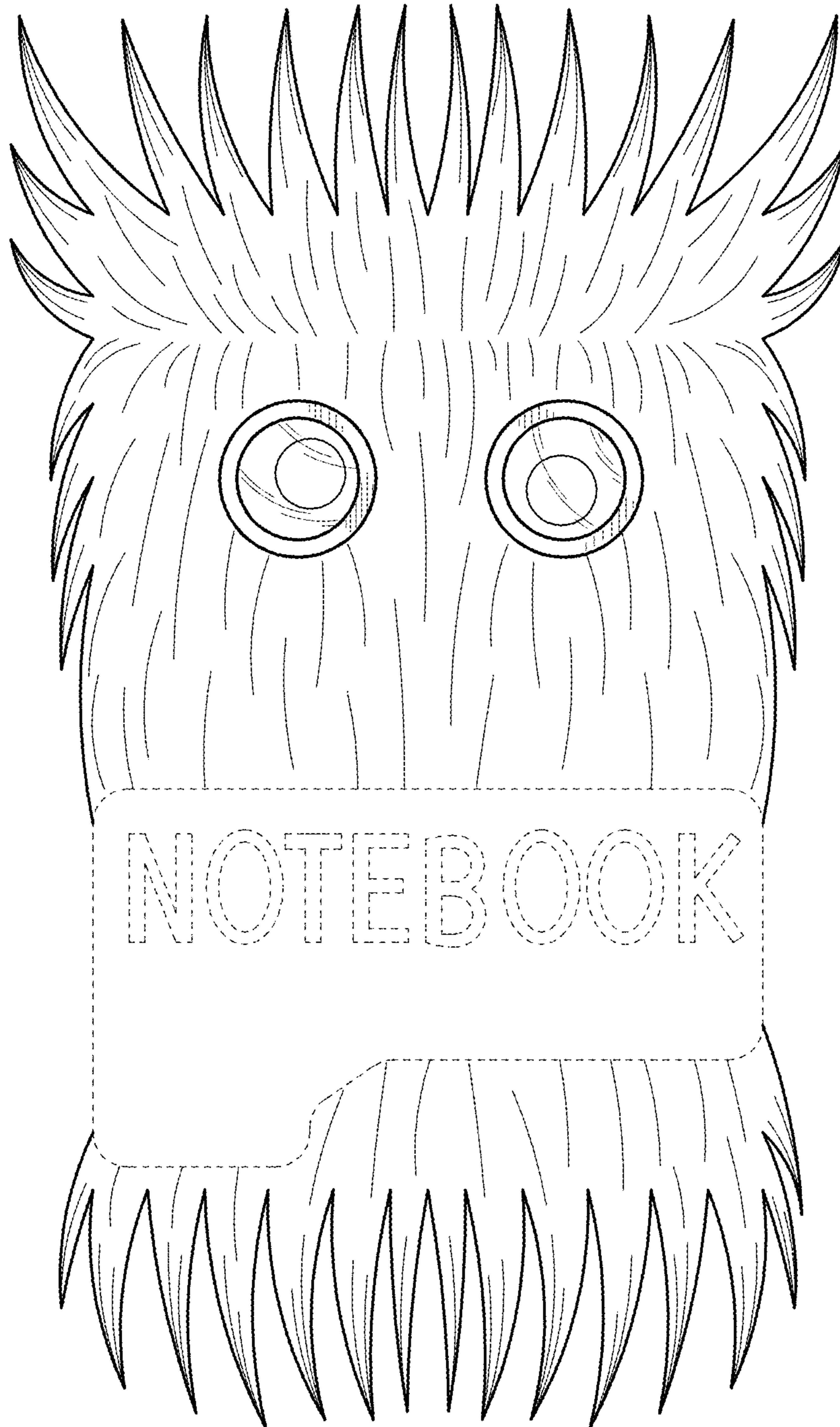

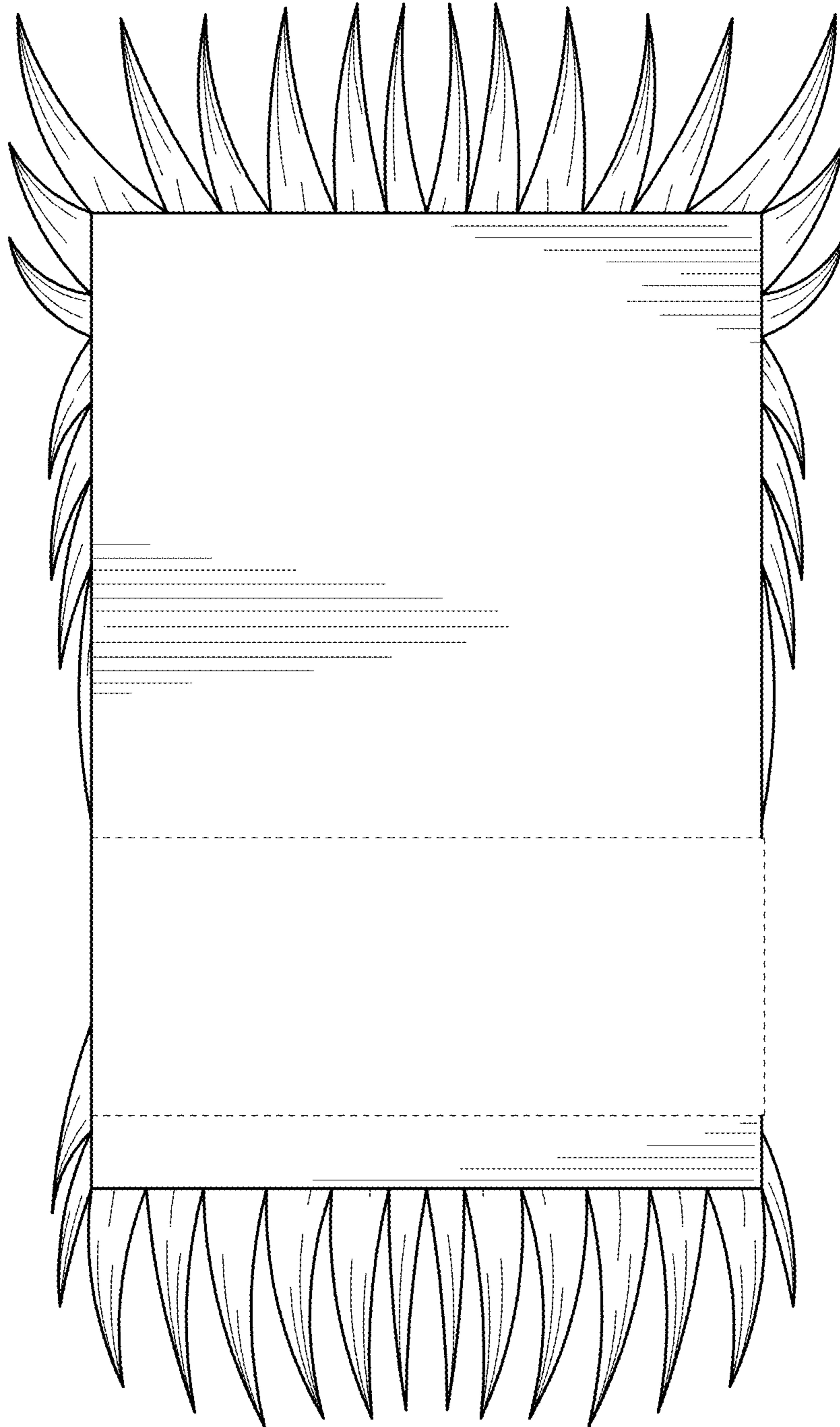

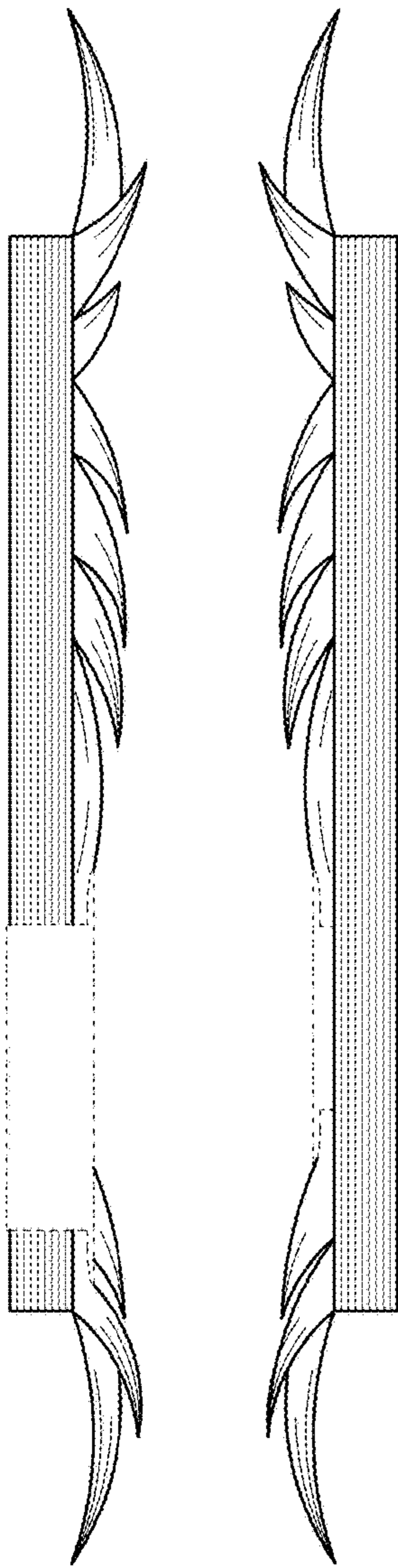


Fig. 4 Fig. 5

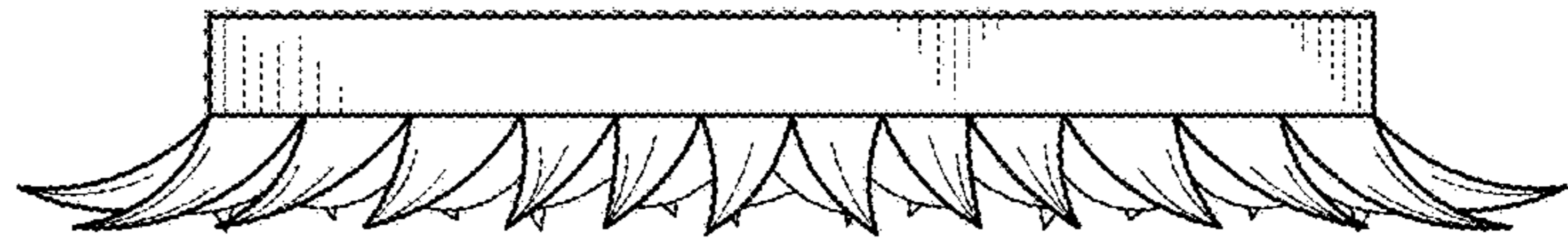

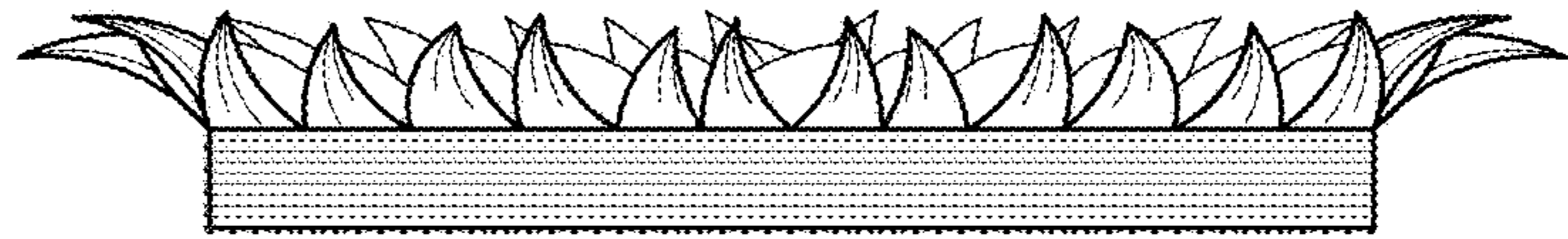
