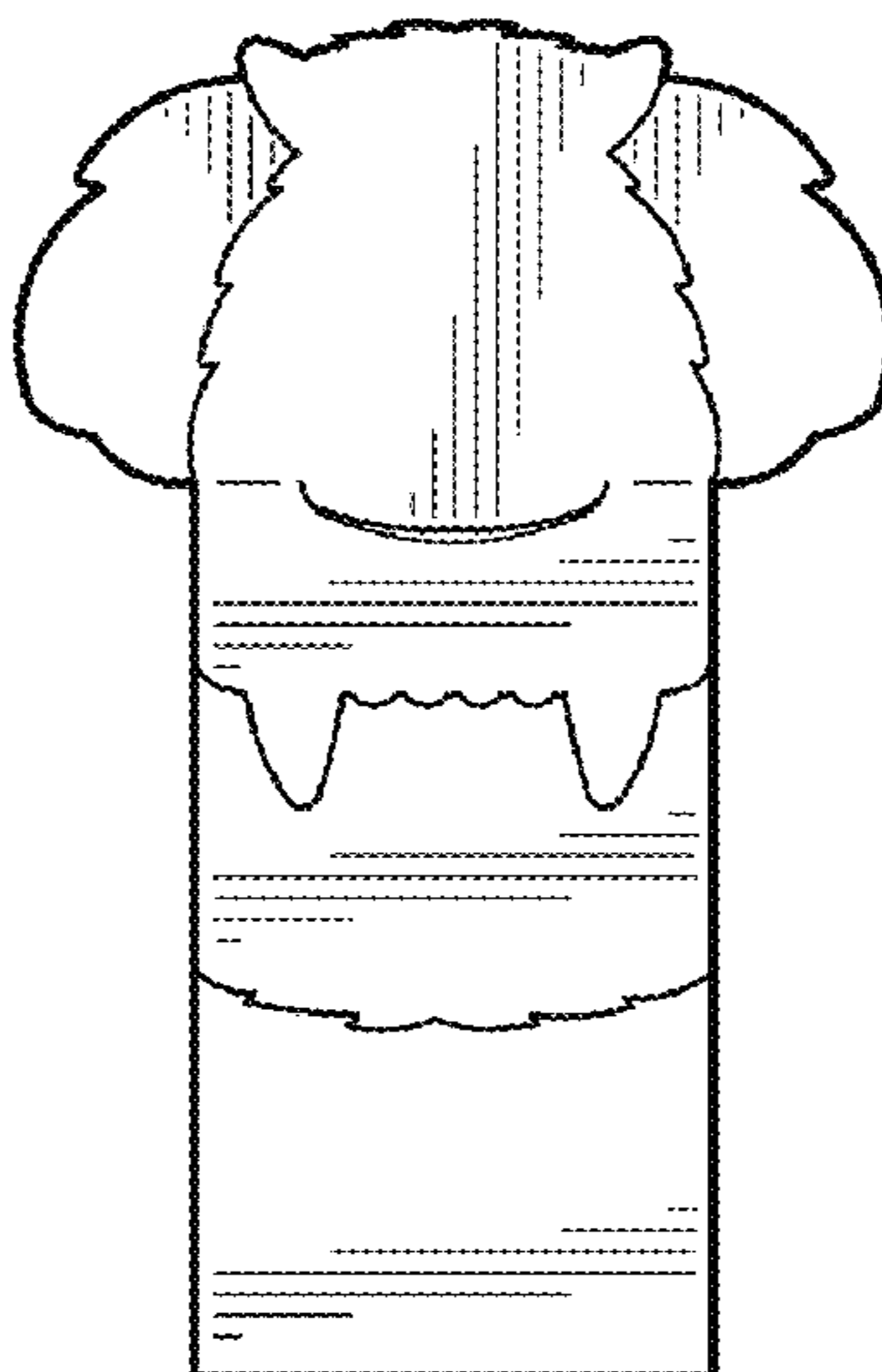

expanding lion;

FIG. 7 is an assembled front elevational view thereof, shown  
in an alternative position;  
FIG. 8 is an assembled side elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 9 is an assembled rear elevational view thereof.

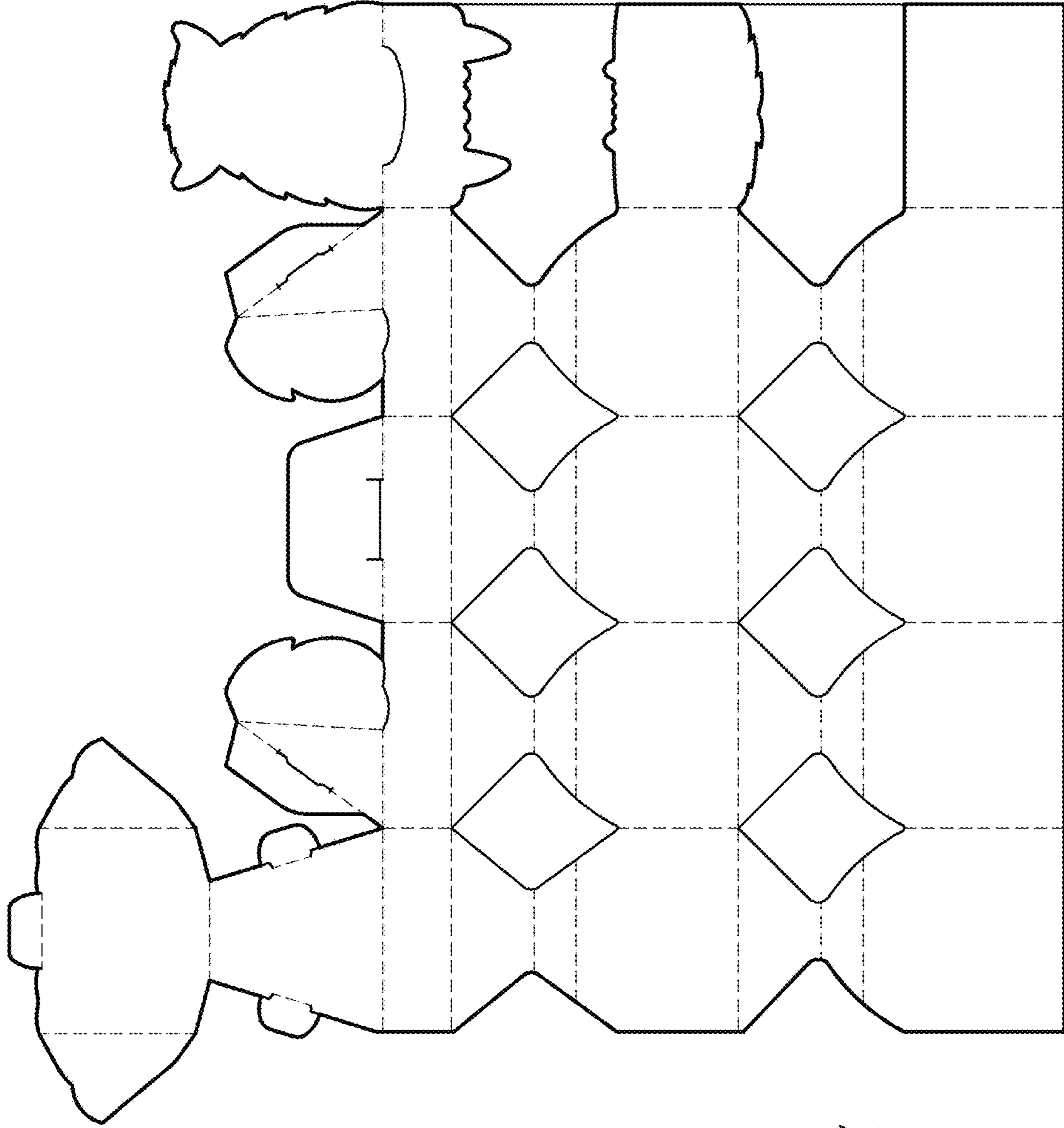

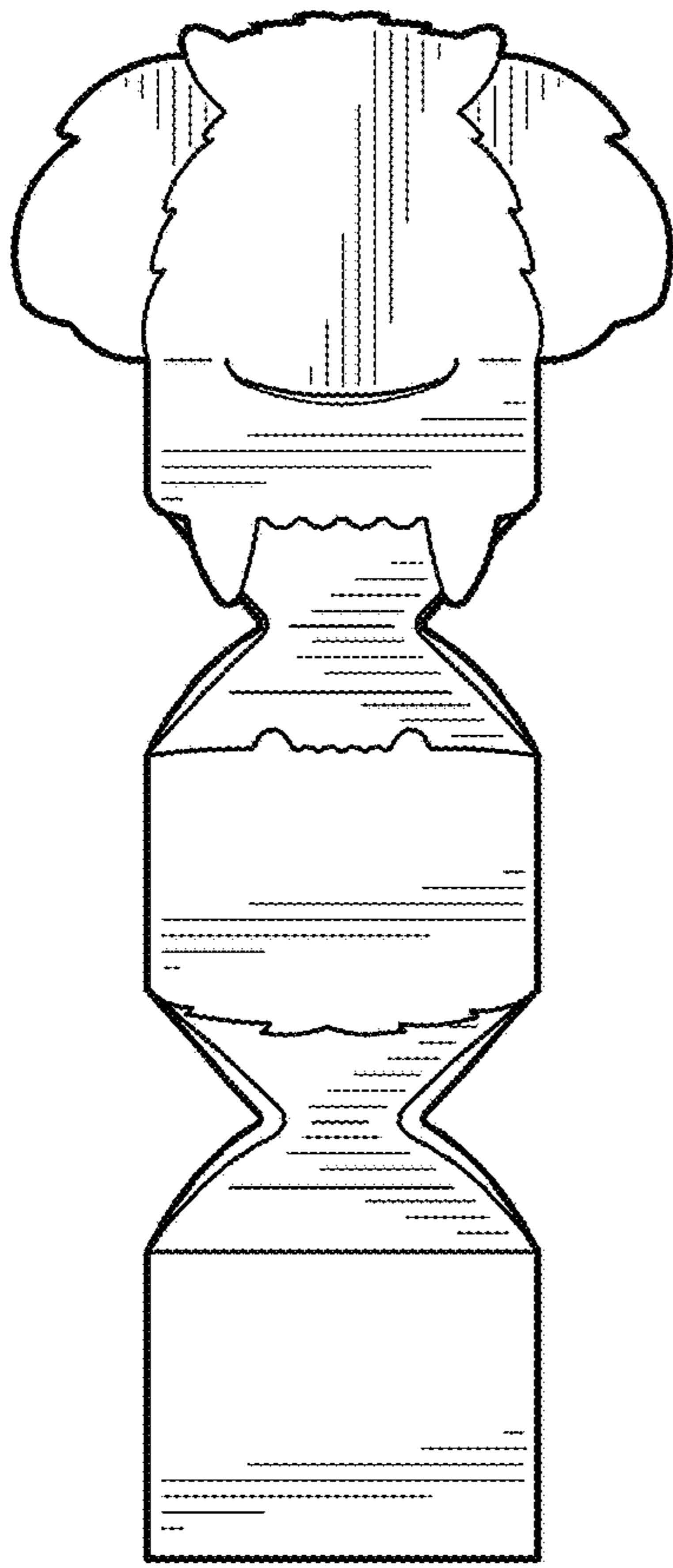

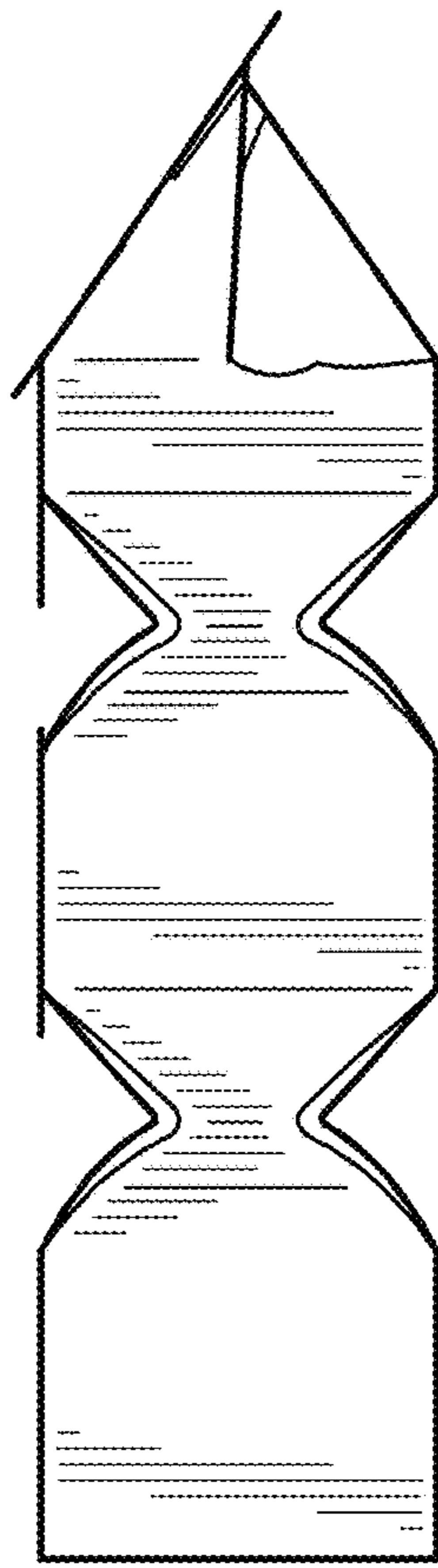

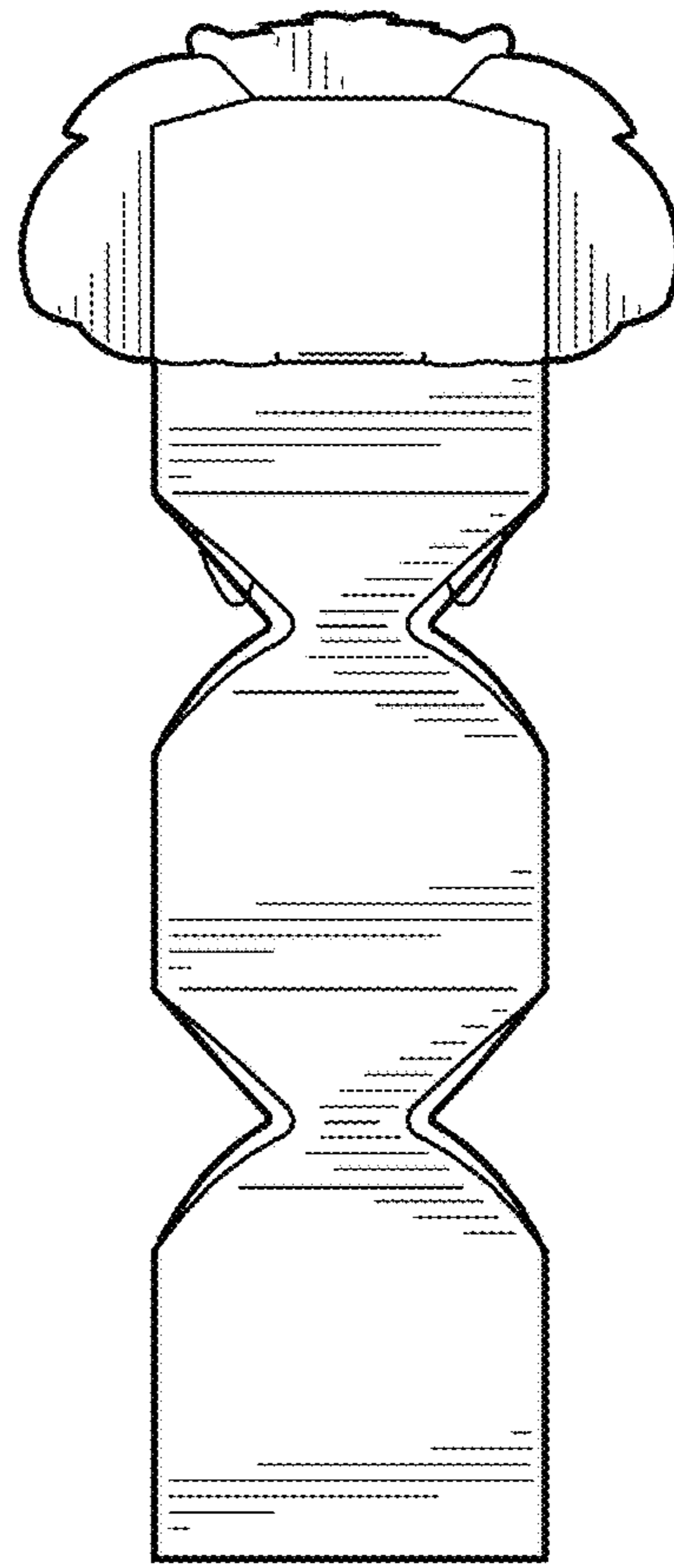

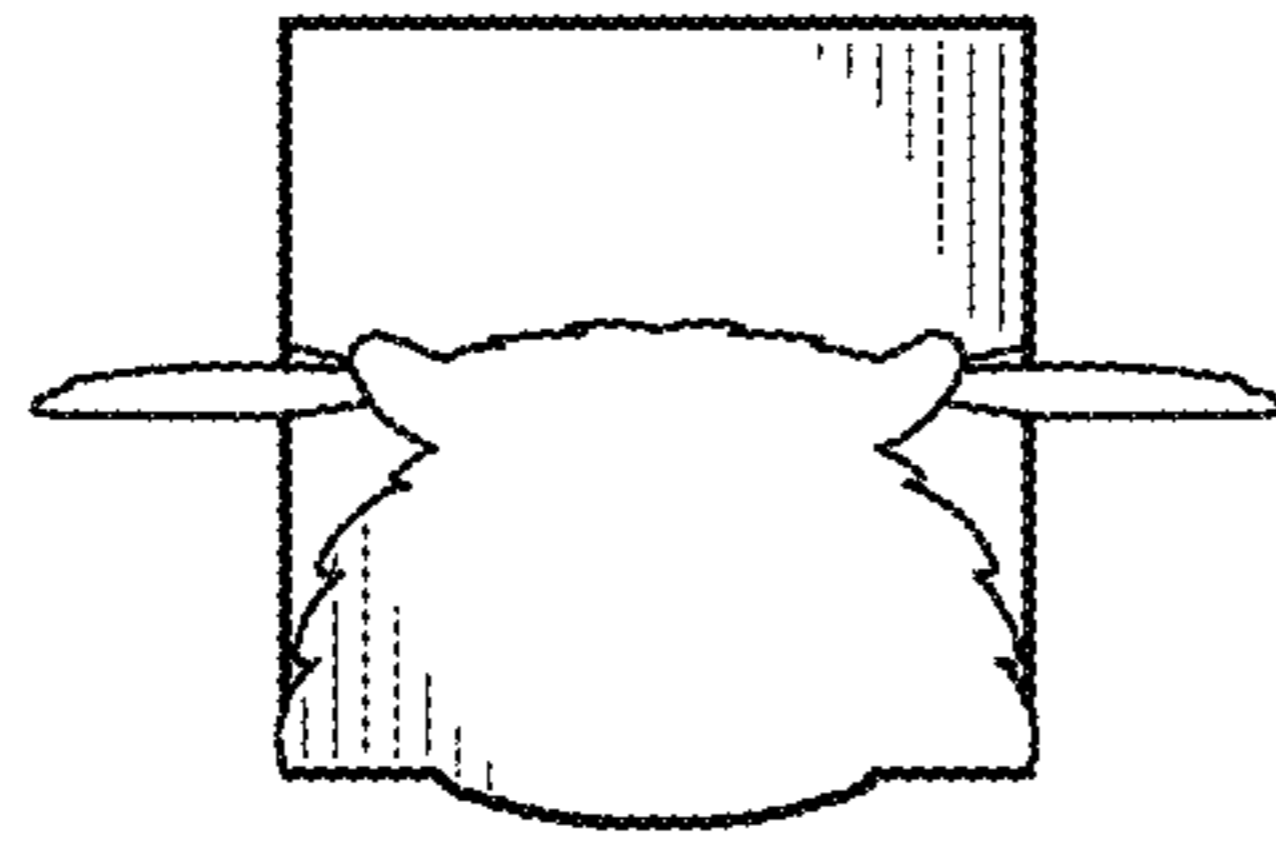

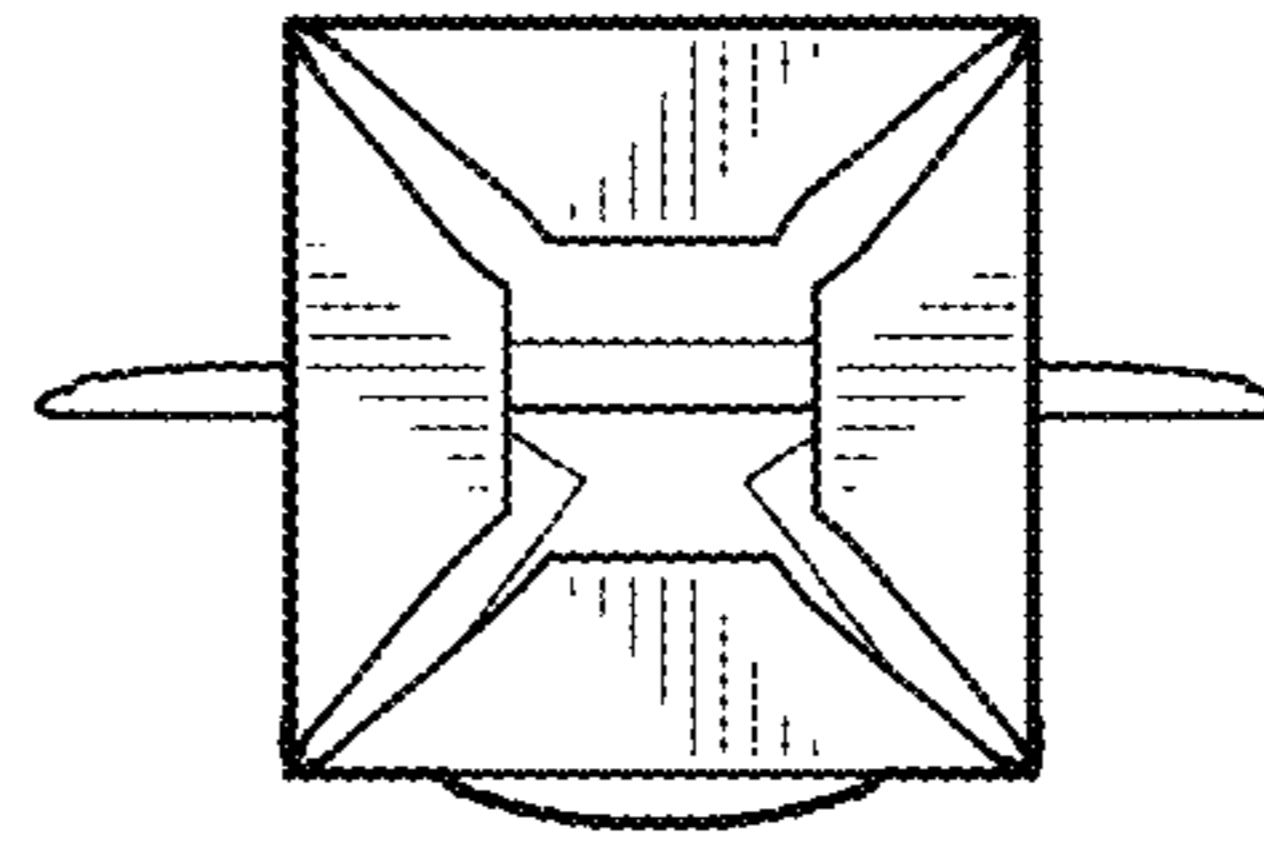

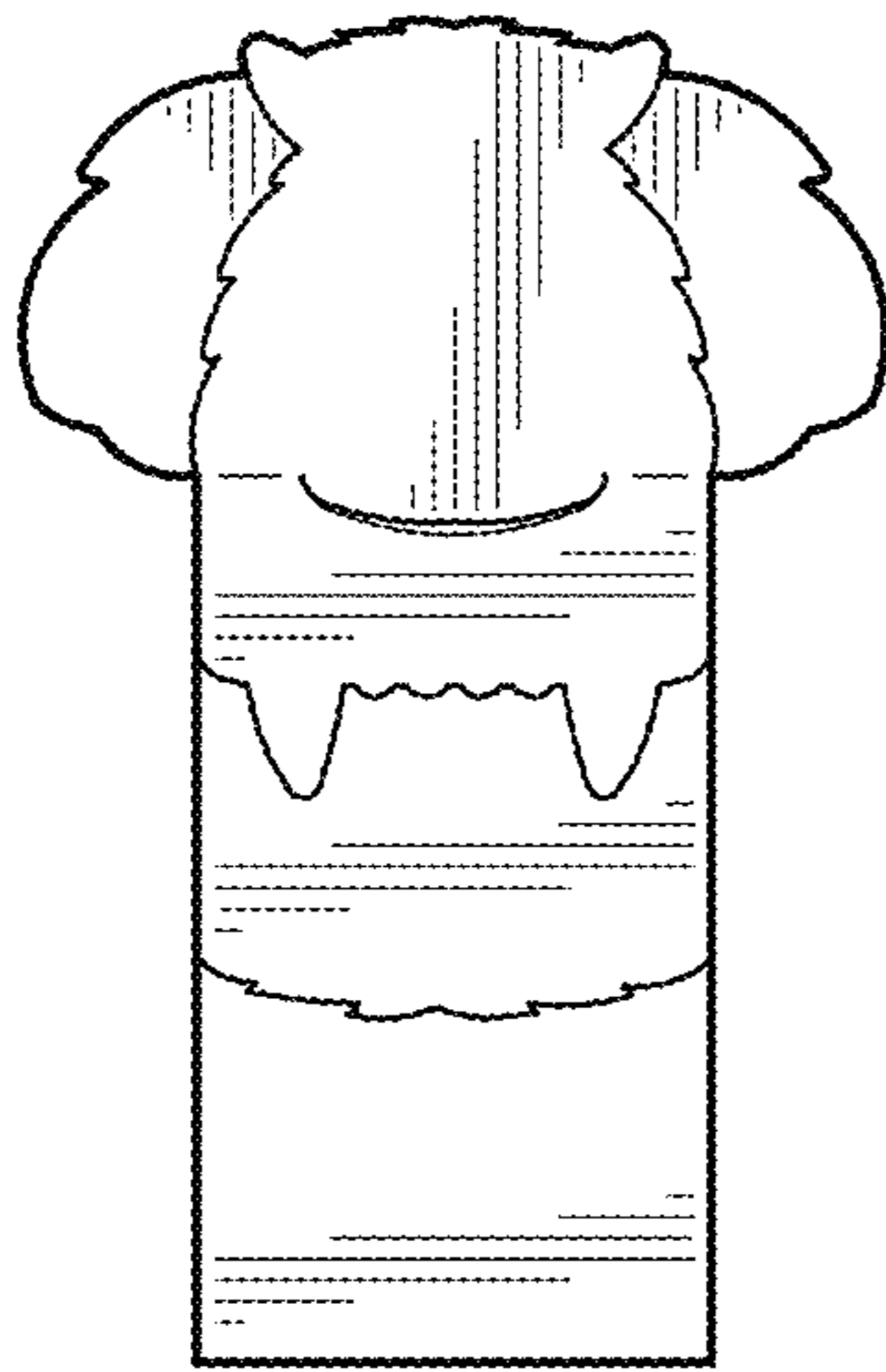

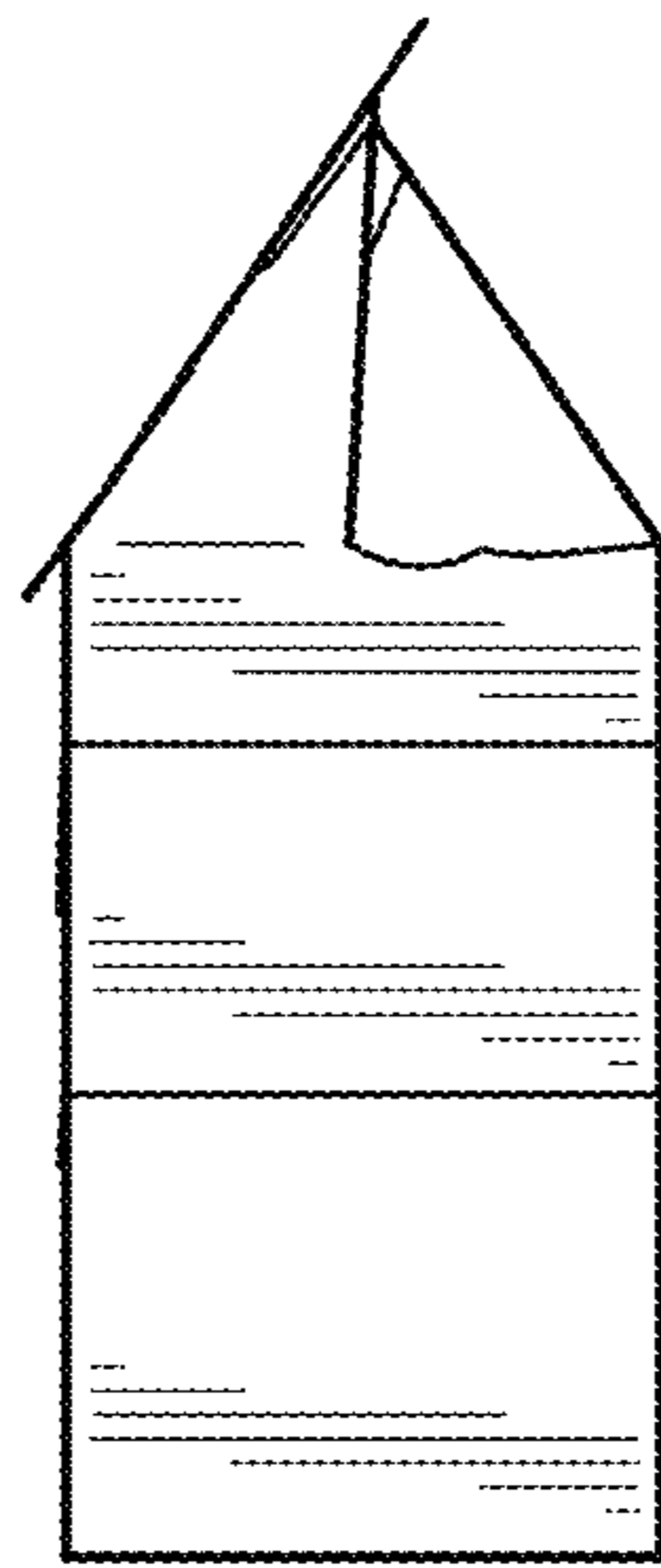

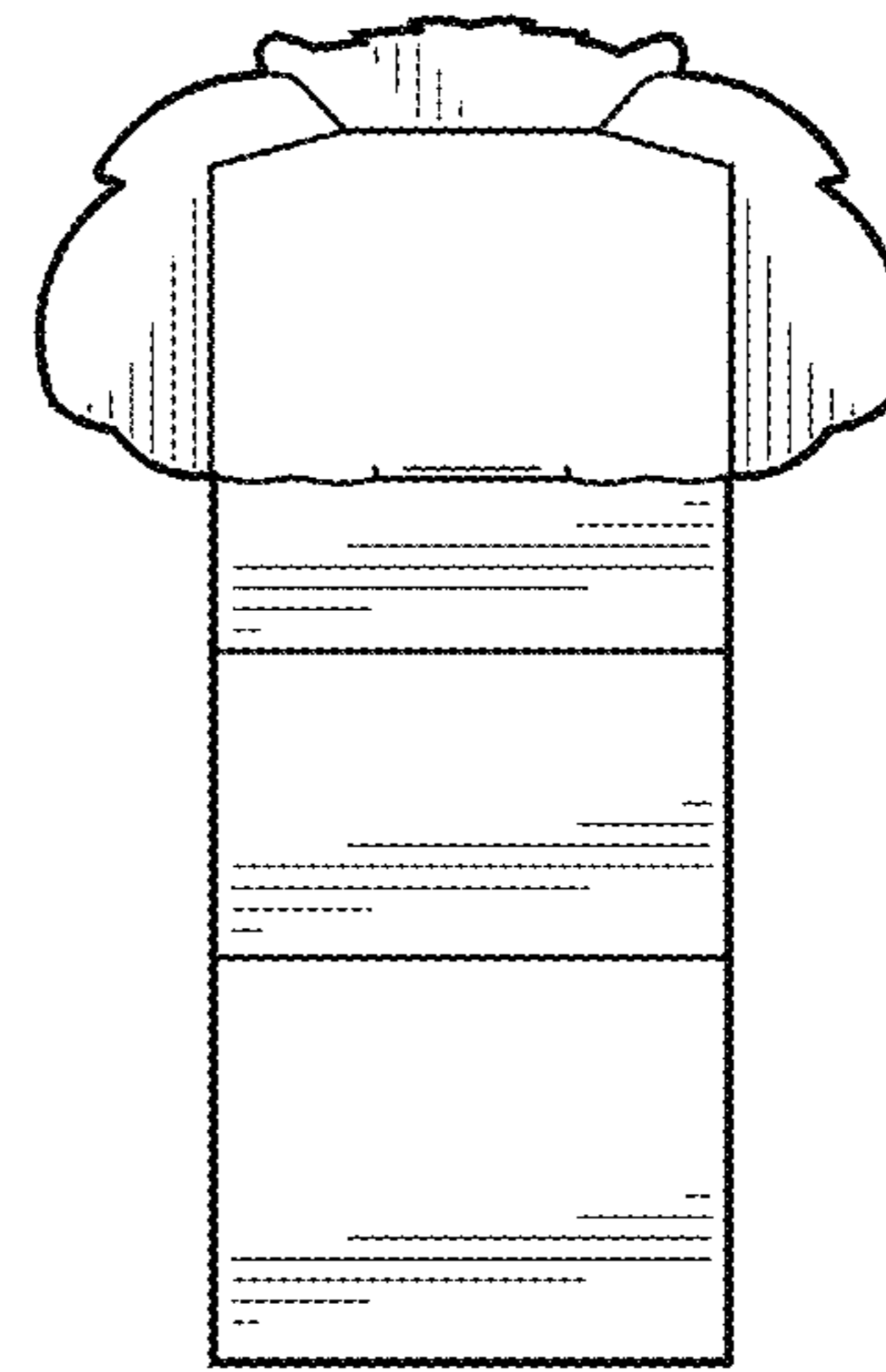
