The ornamental design for a charging dock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a charging dock showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

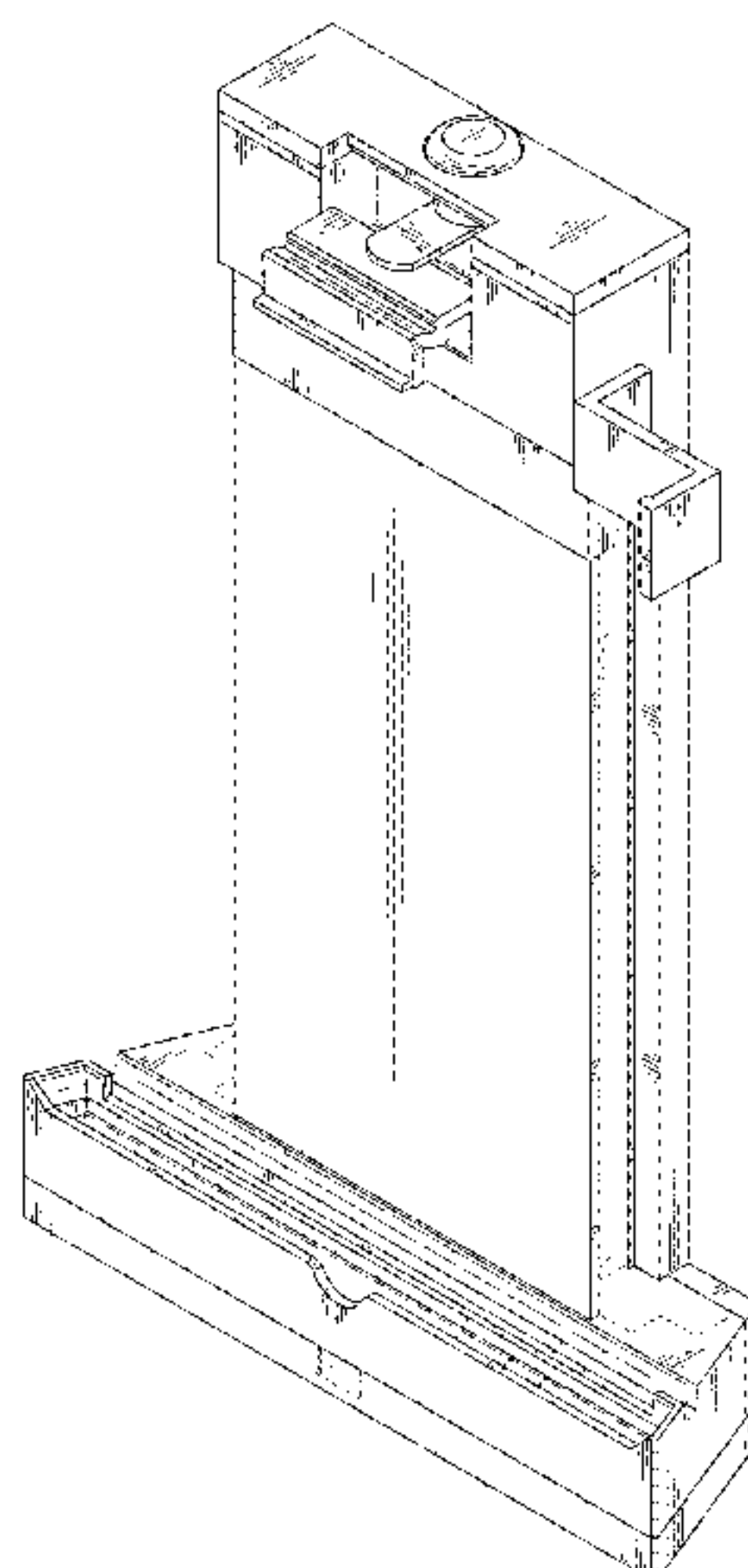
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

The broken lines showing the device seated in the dock depict environmental structure only and form no part of the claim, while all other uniformly dashed broken lines in the drawings depict portions of the charging dock that form no part of the claim. The dot-dash broken lines define the boundary of the claim, which extends to the boundary but does not include the boundary. The unshaded surfaces shown between the broken and solid lines form no part of the claim.

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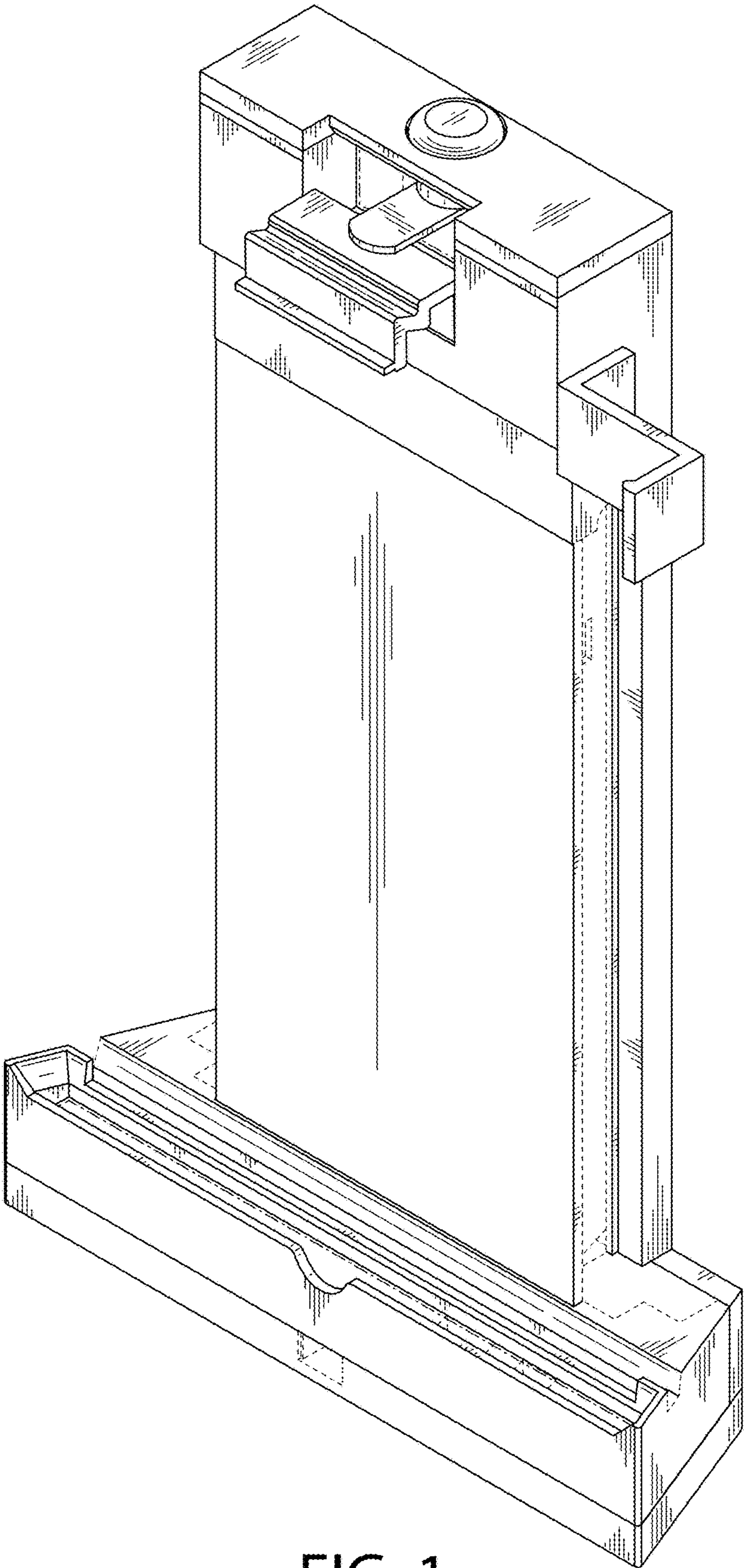

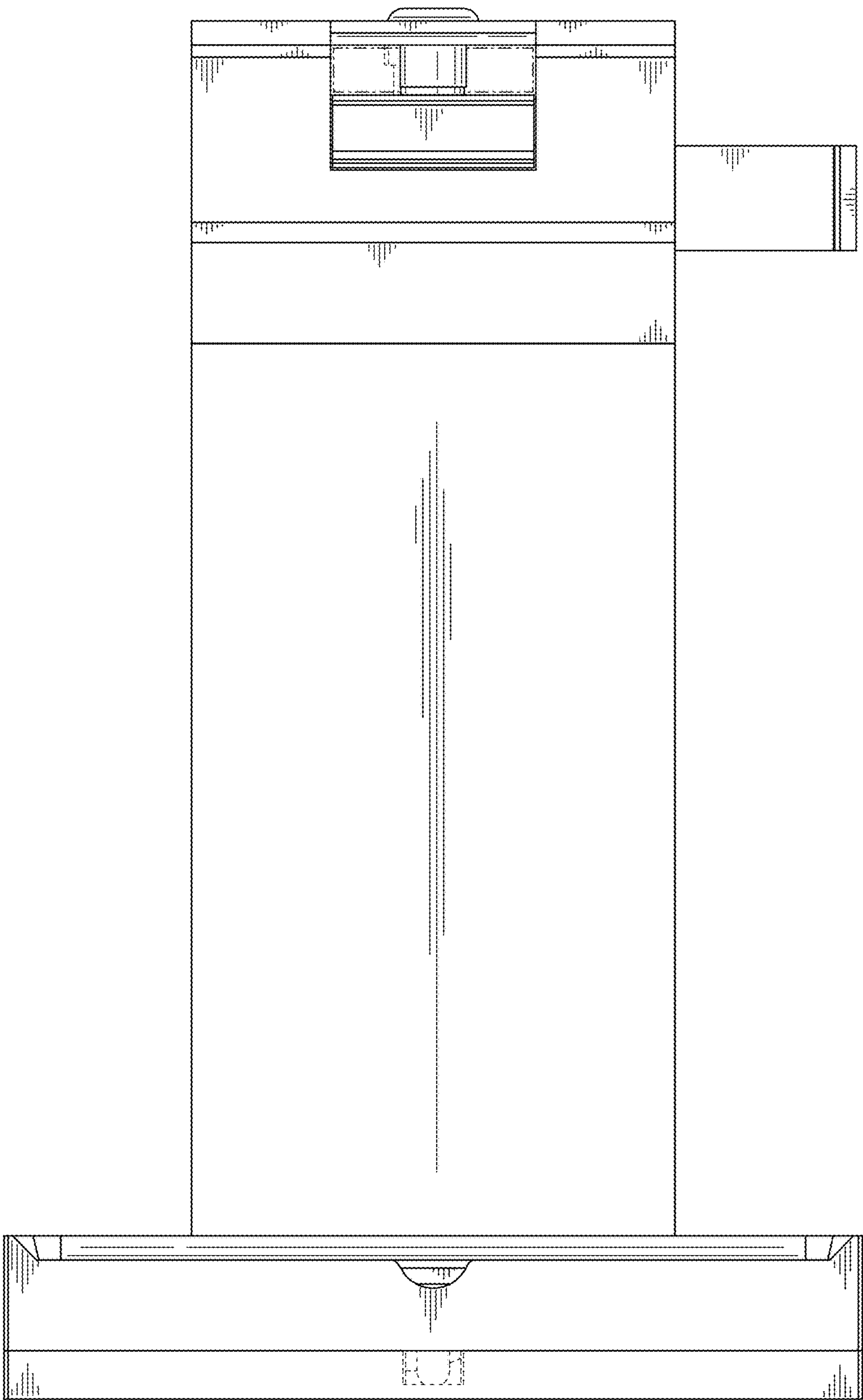

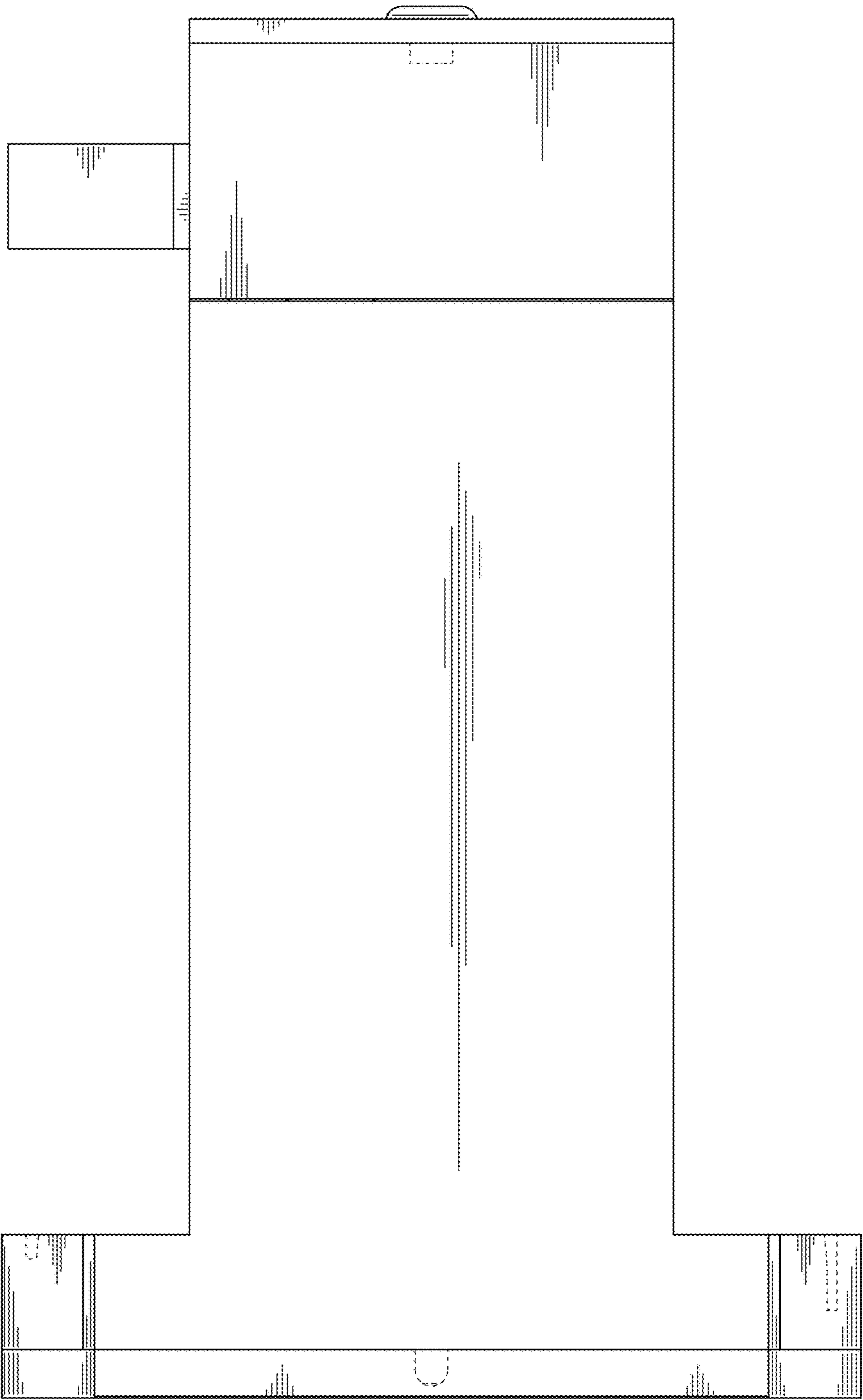

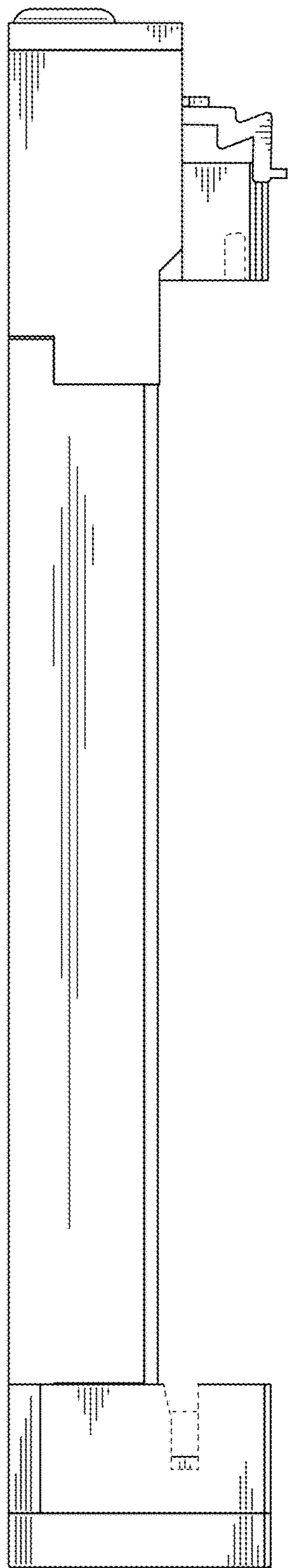

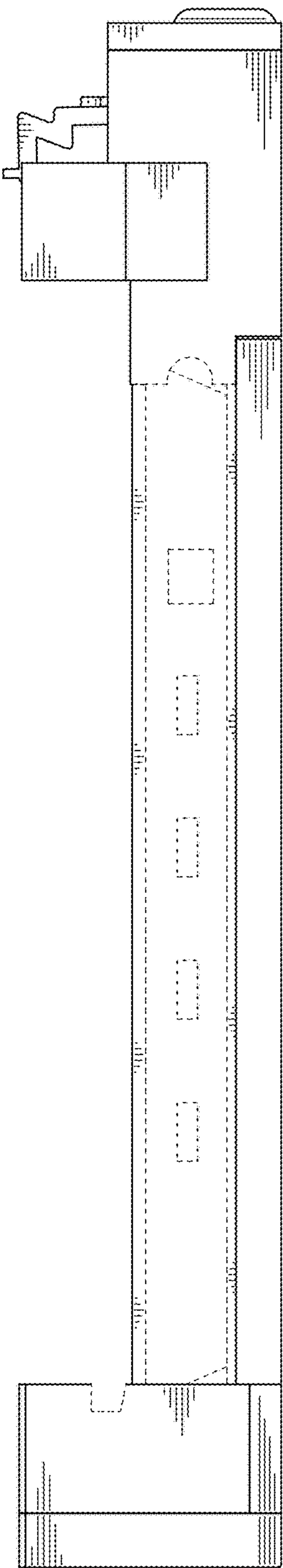

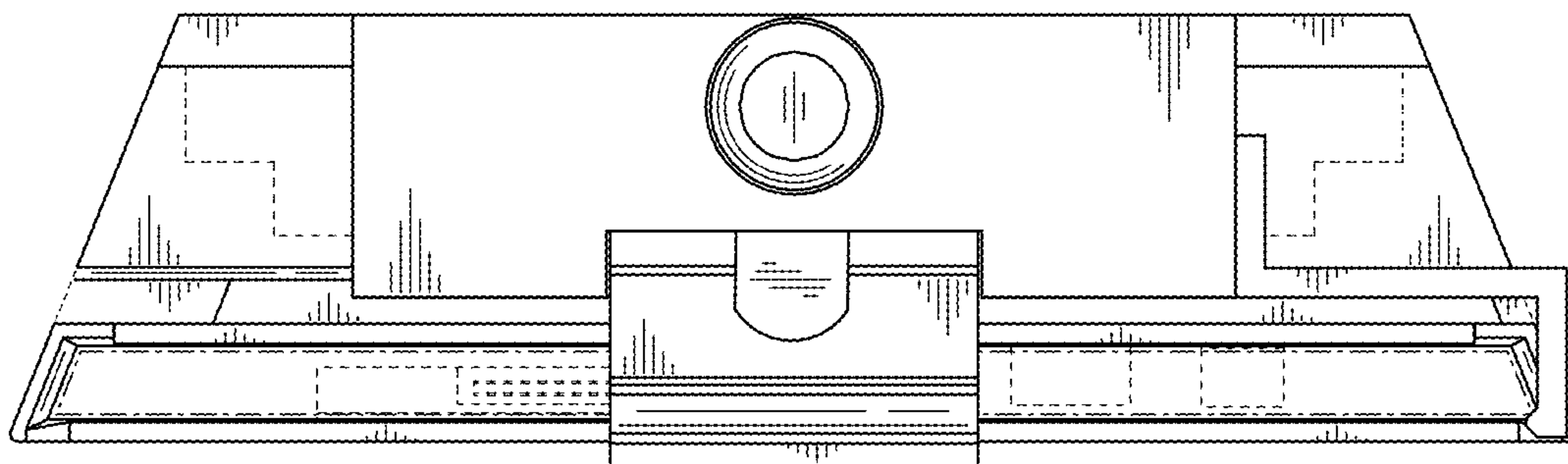

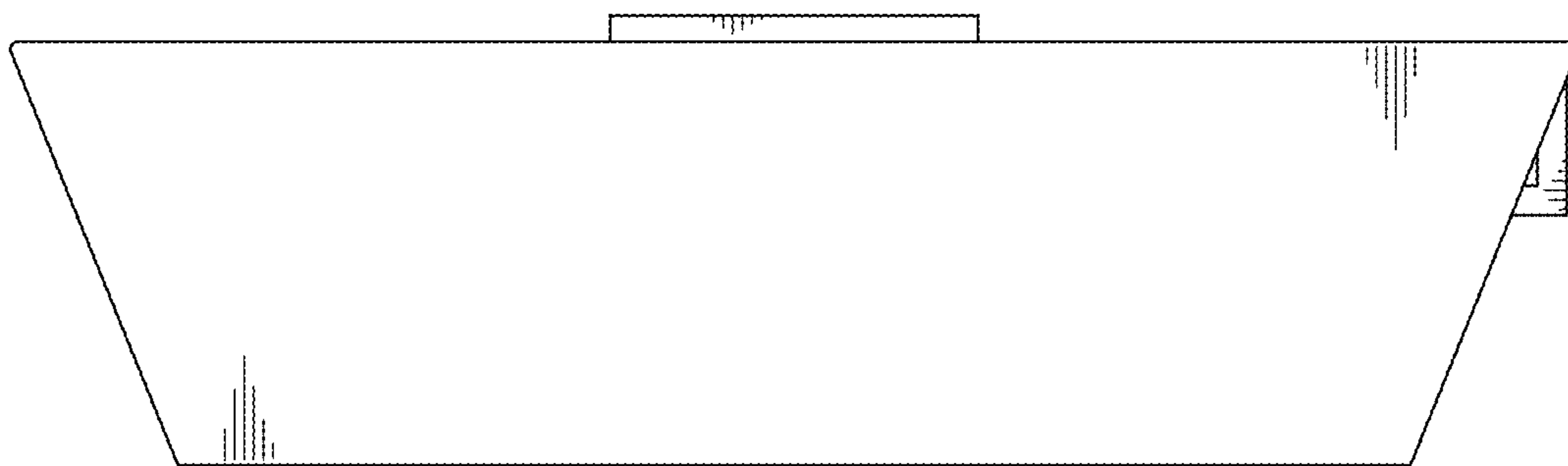

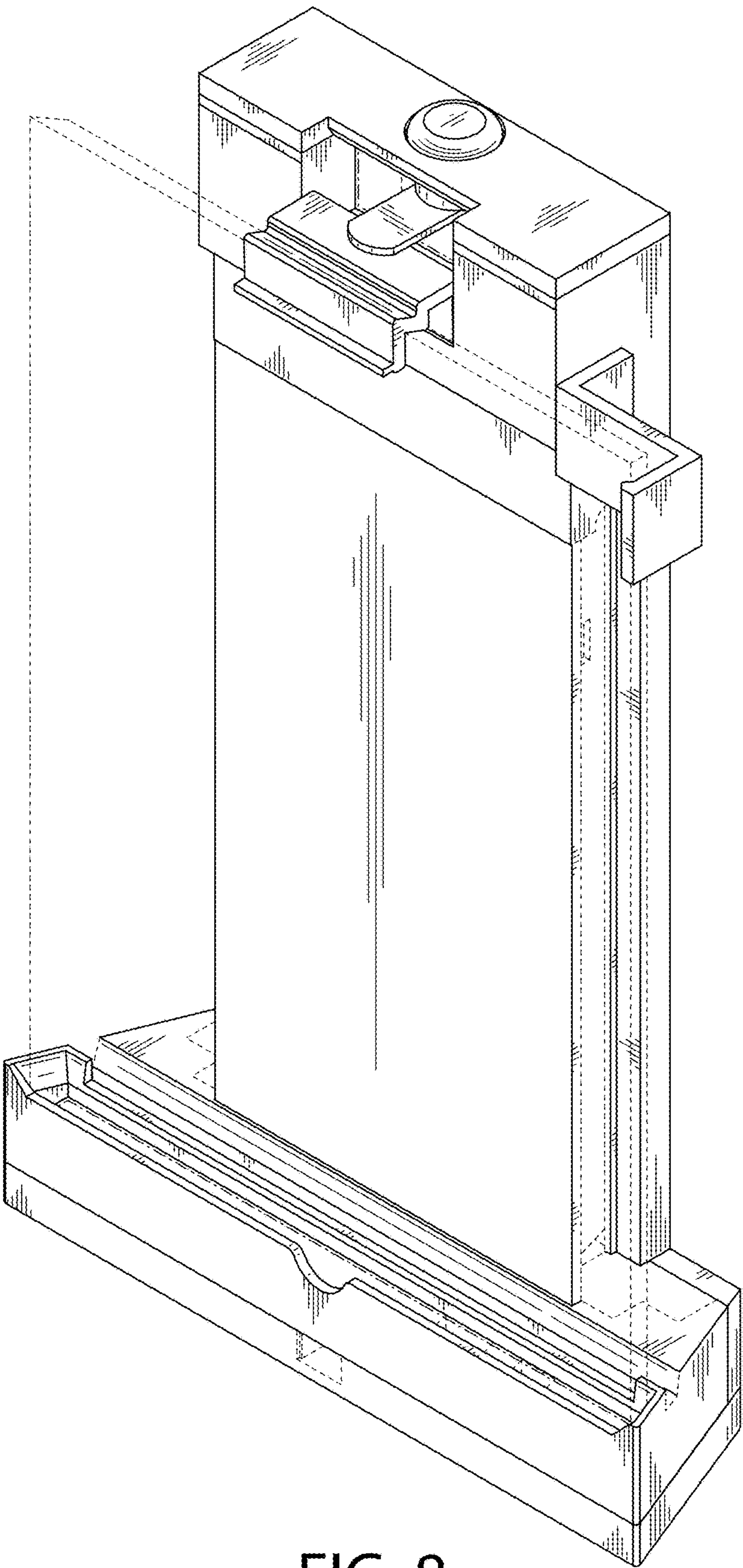
