(57) **CLAIM**

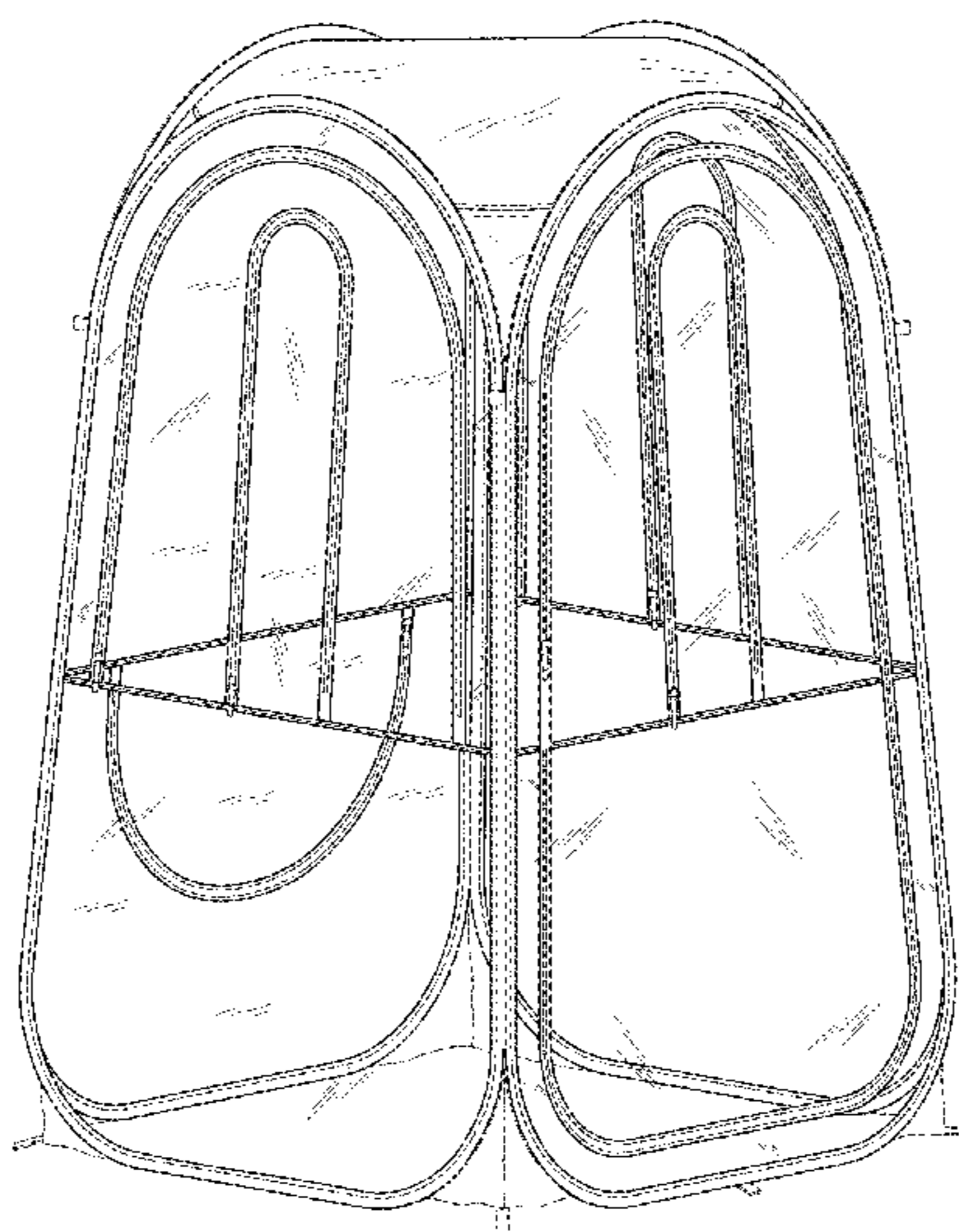
The ornamental design for a personal enclosure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a personal enclosure;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken lines shown within the claimed panels and top of the personal enclosure represent stitching, which forms a part of the claim. The zipper pulls and all other broken lines represent the environment in which the article resides and form no part of the claimed design.

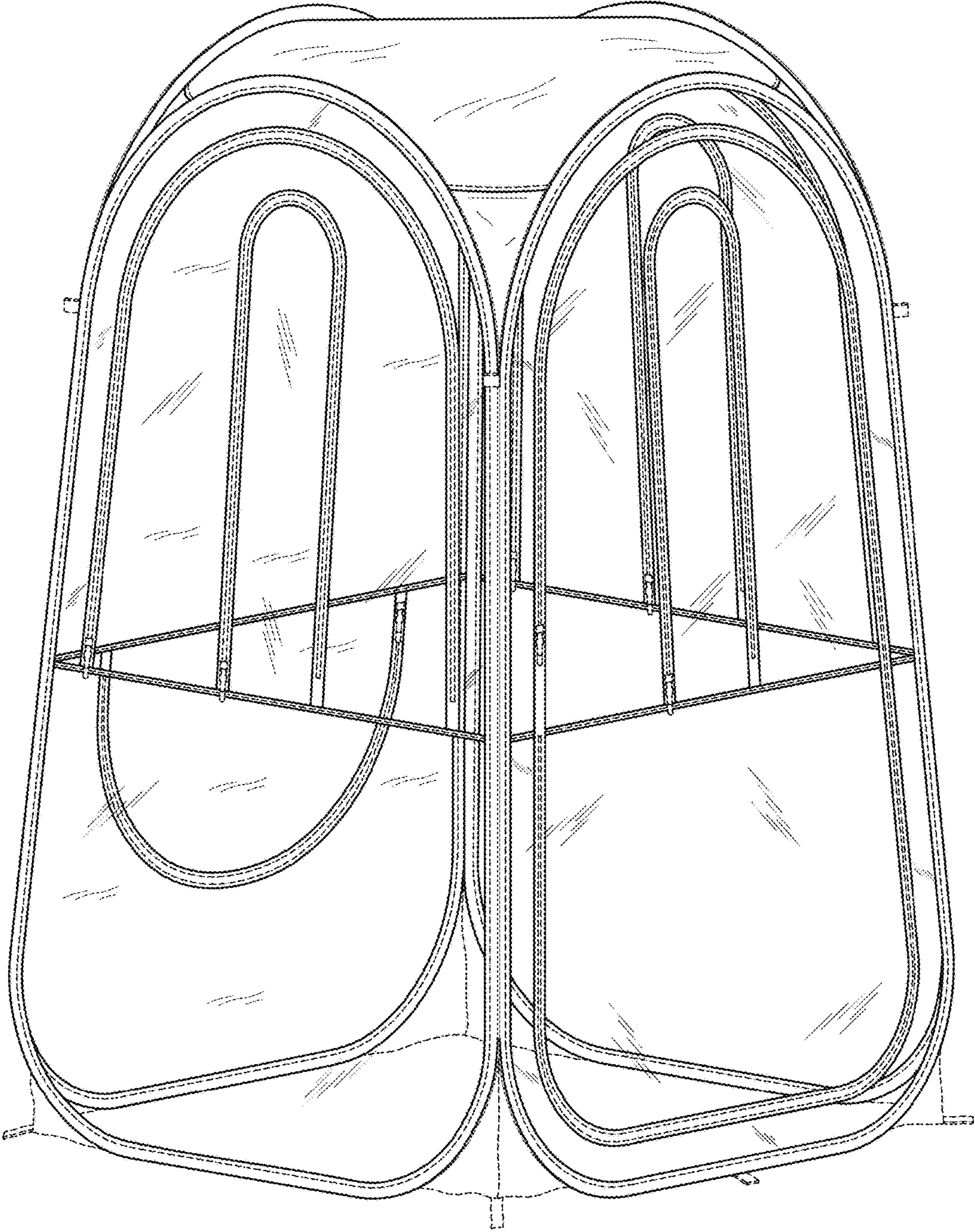

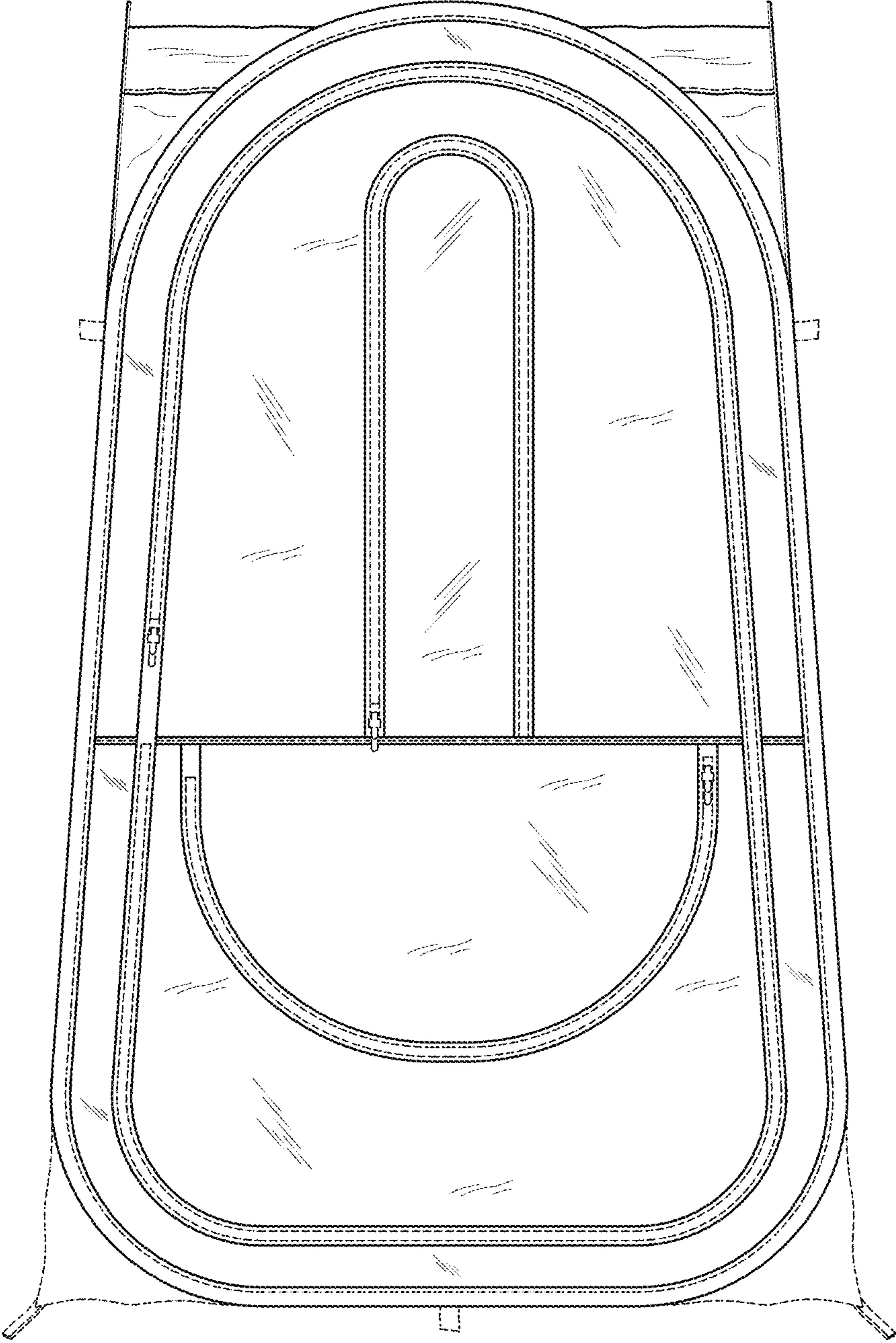

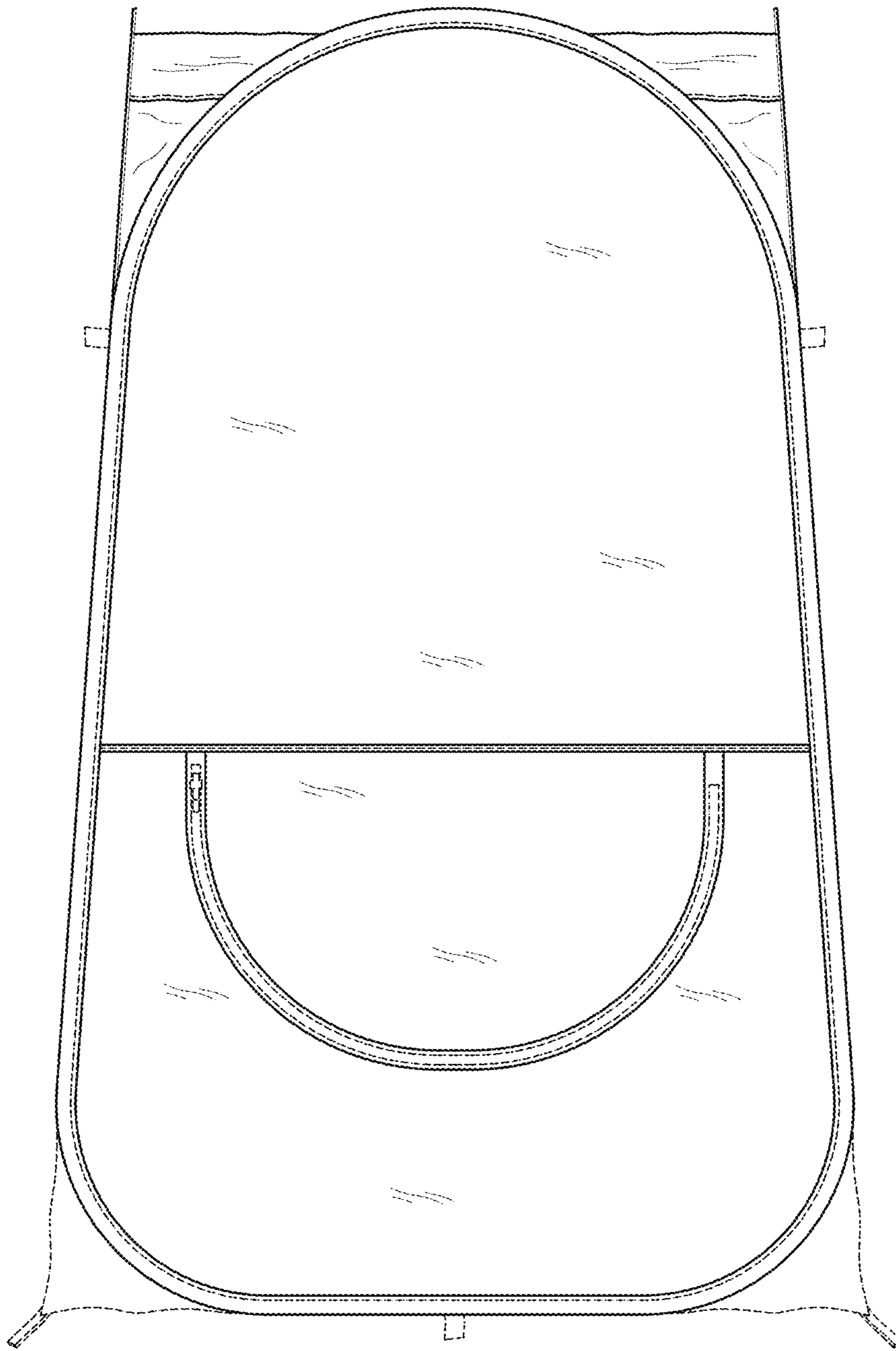

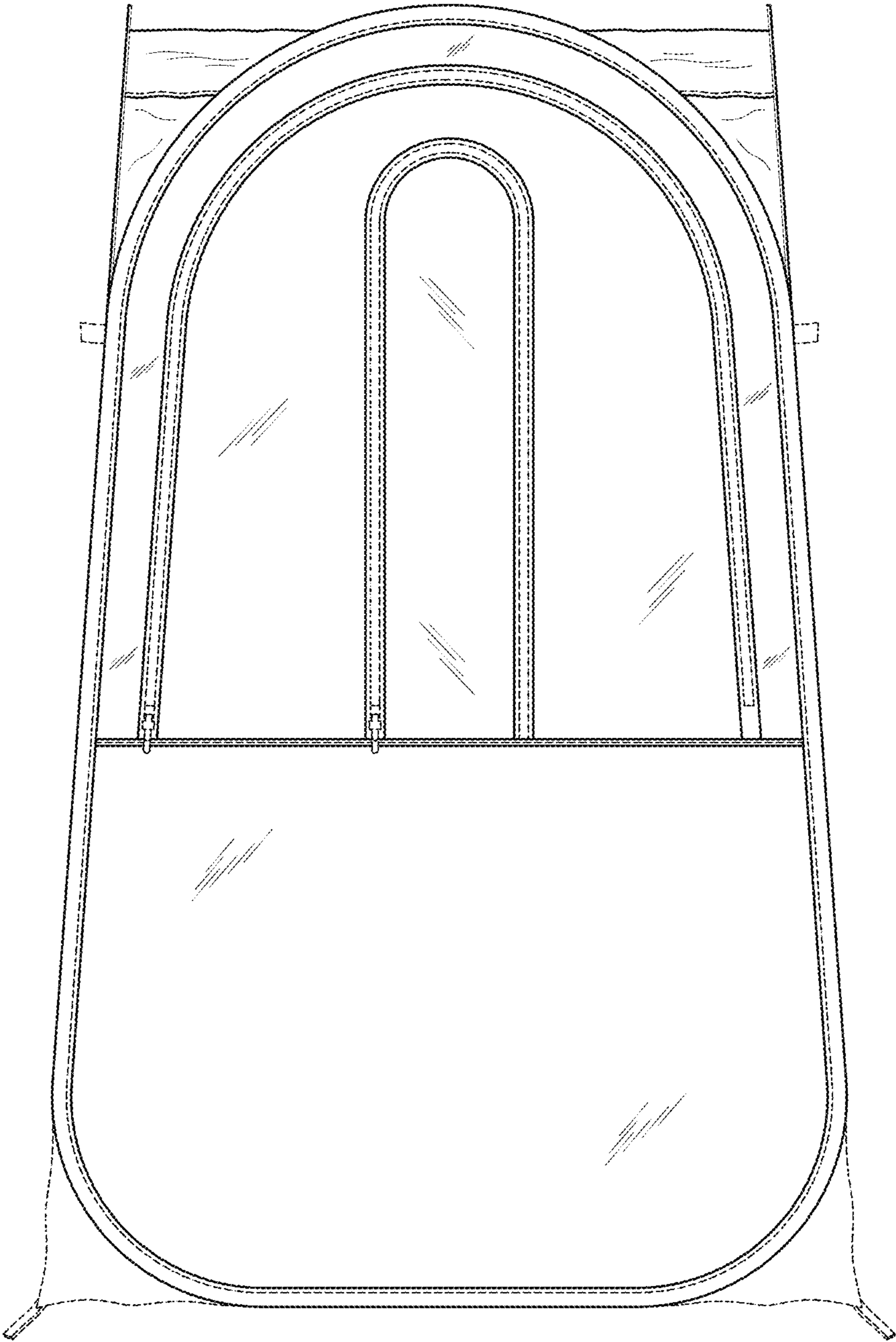

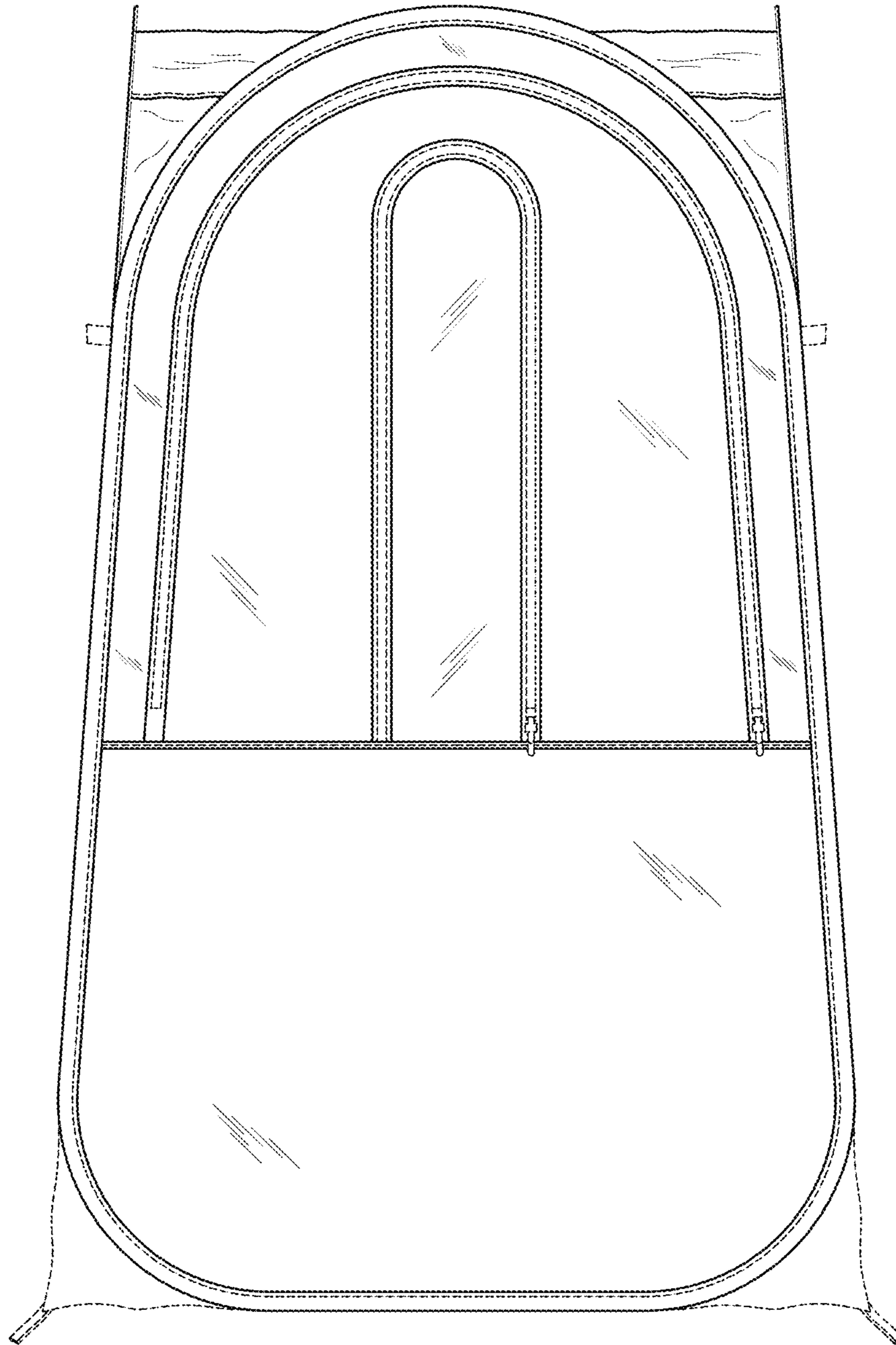

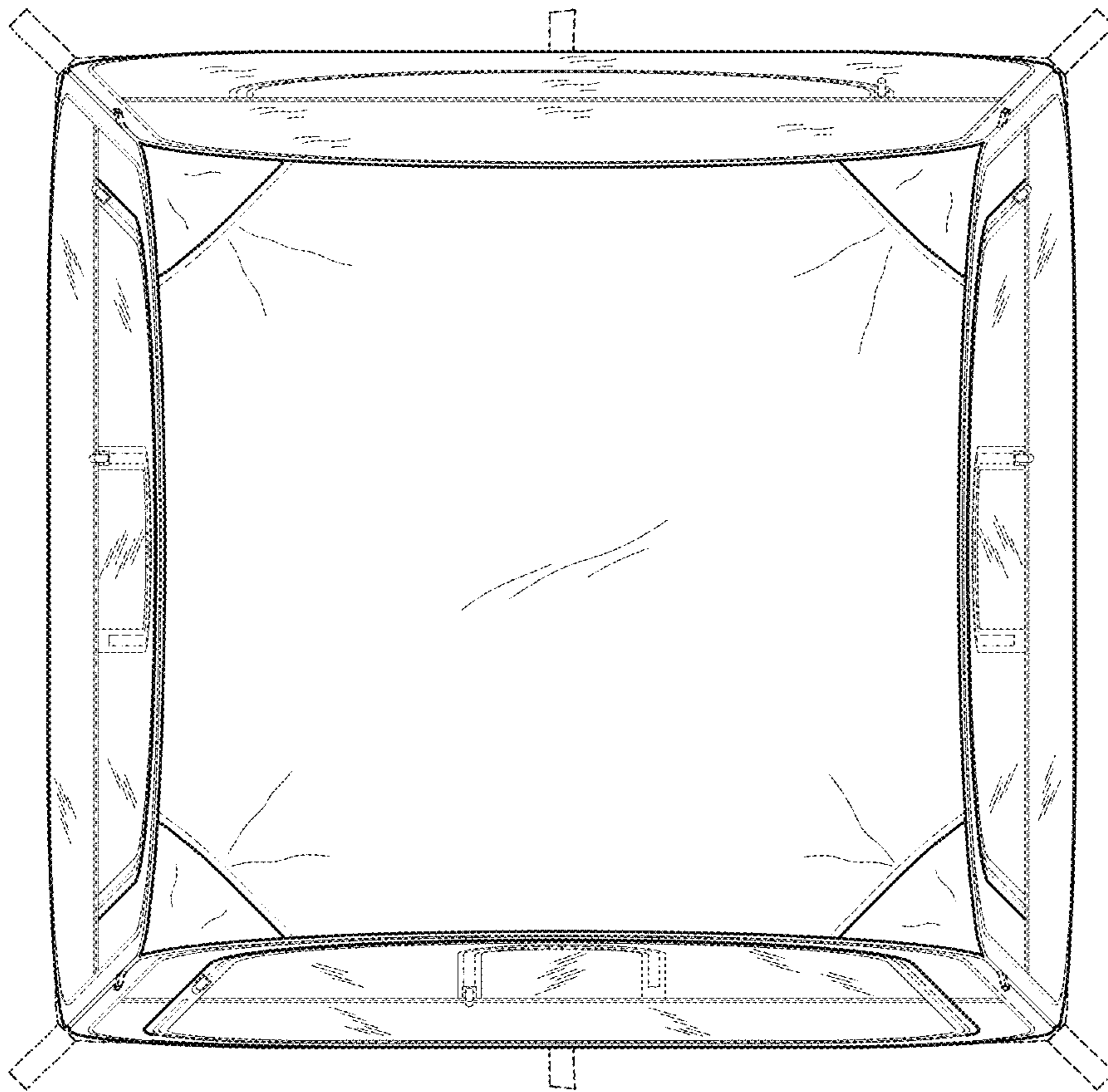

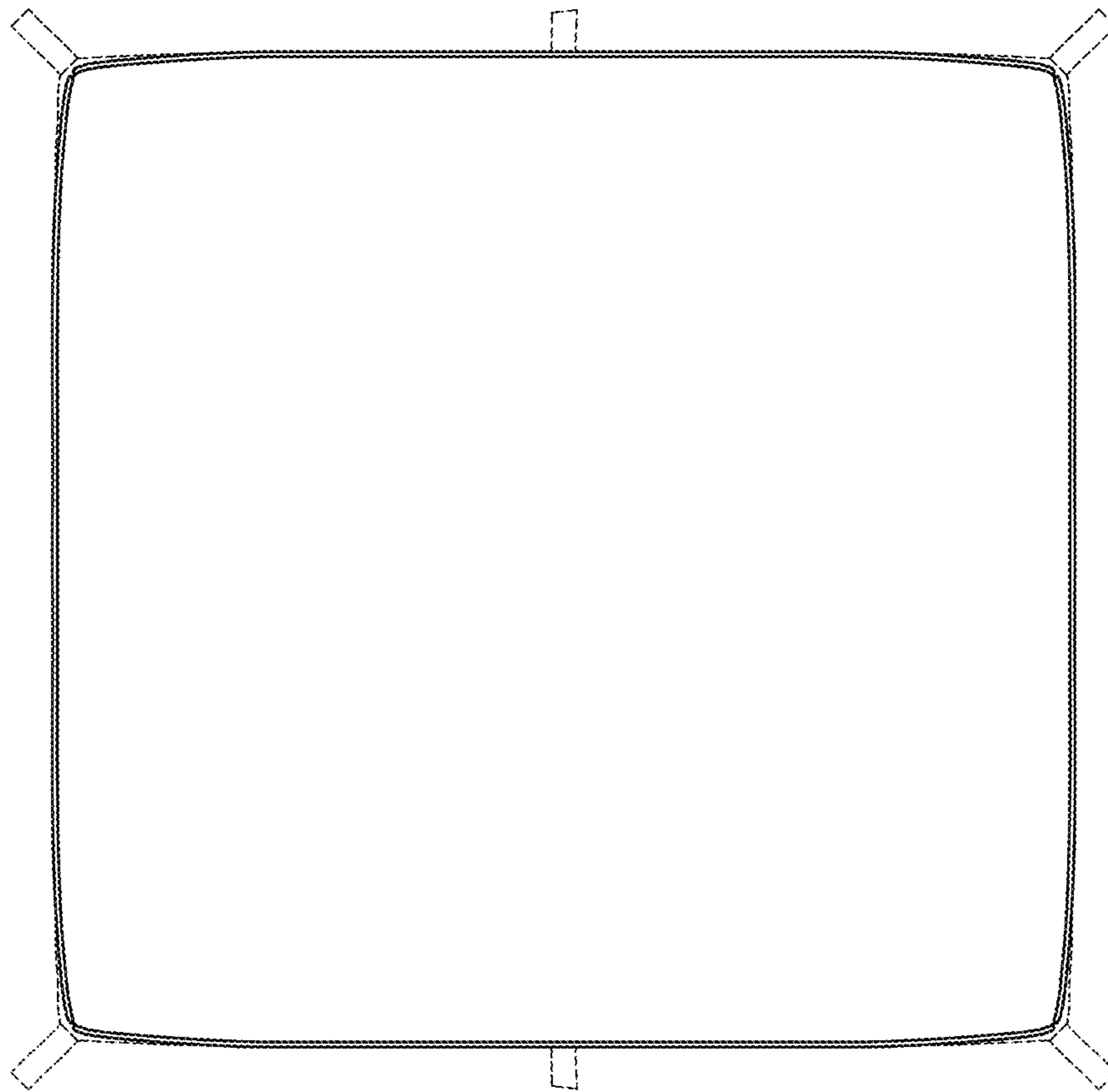
