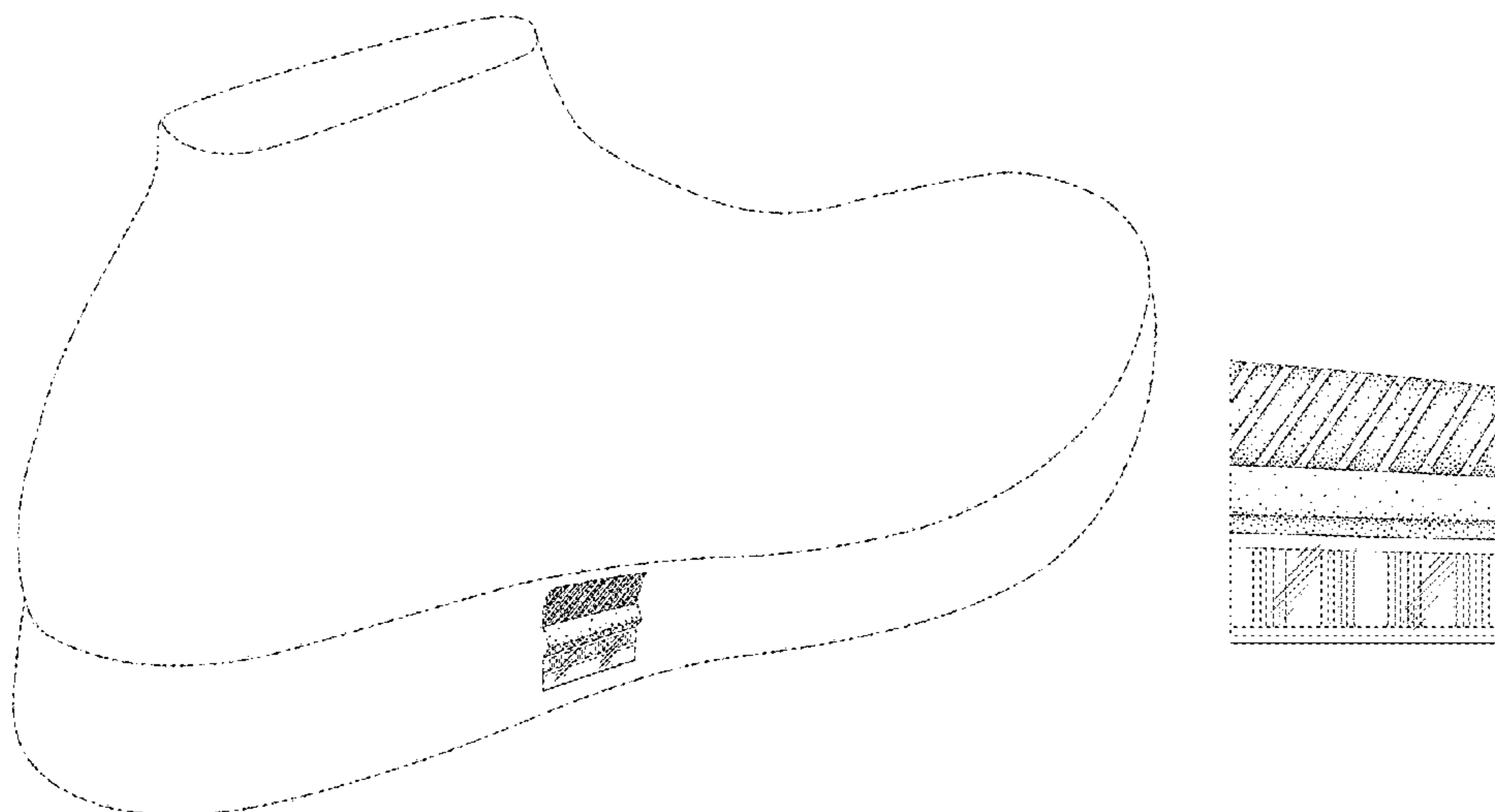
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe midsole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged view of FIG. 1 with unclaimed subject matter omitted; and,
FIG. 5 is an enlarged view of FIG. 2 with unclaimed subject matter omitted.
The oblique line shading in FIGS. 1-5 represents transparency or translucency. The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area represent unclaimed boundaries of the design. The broken lines showing the remainder of the shoe are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

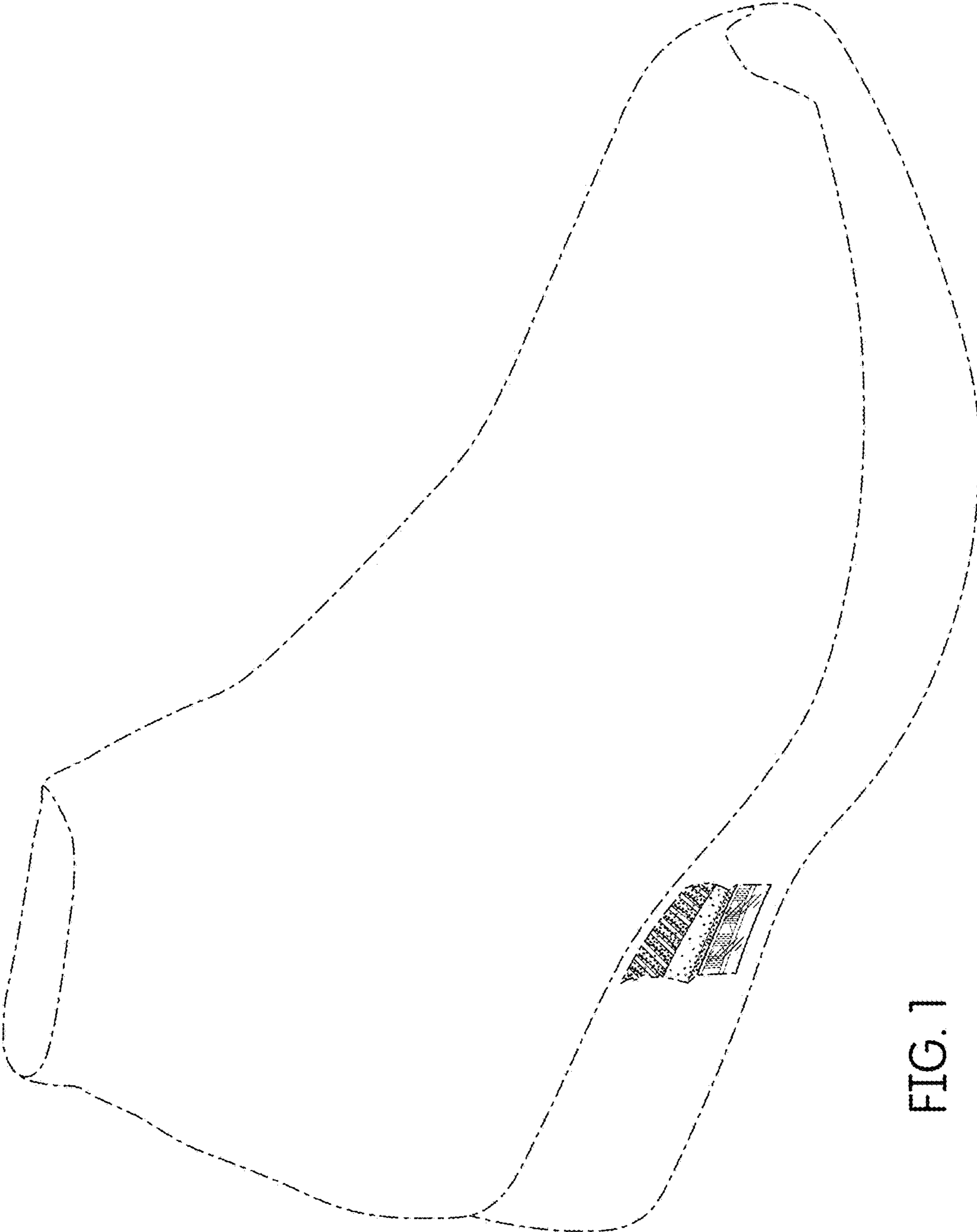

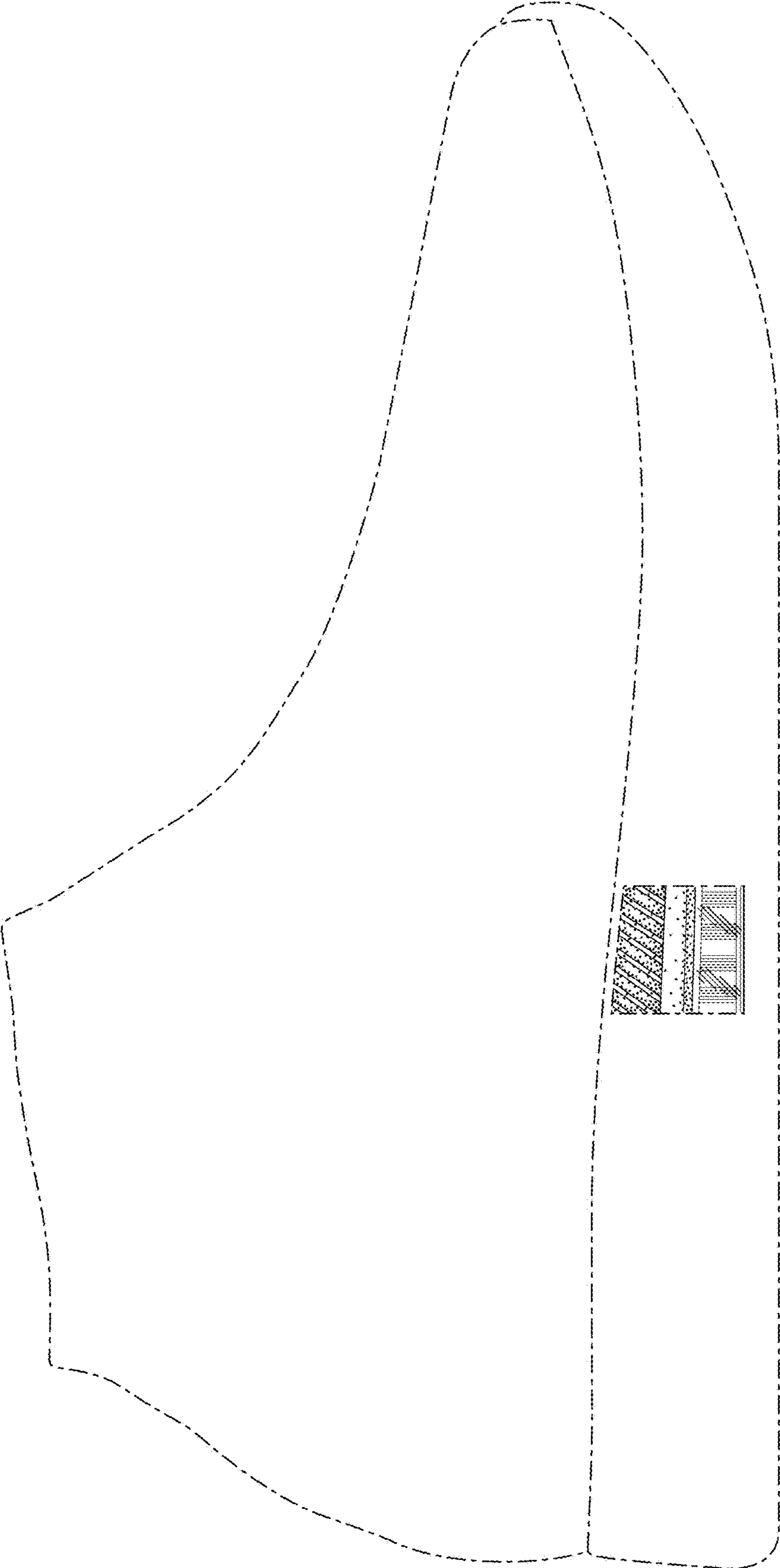

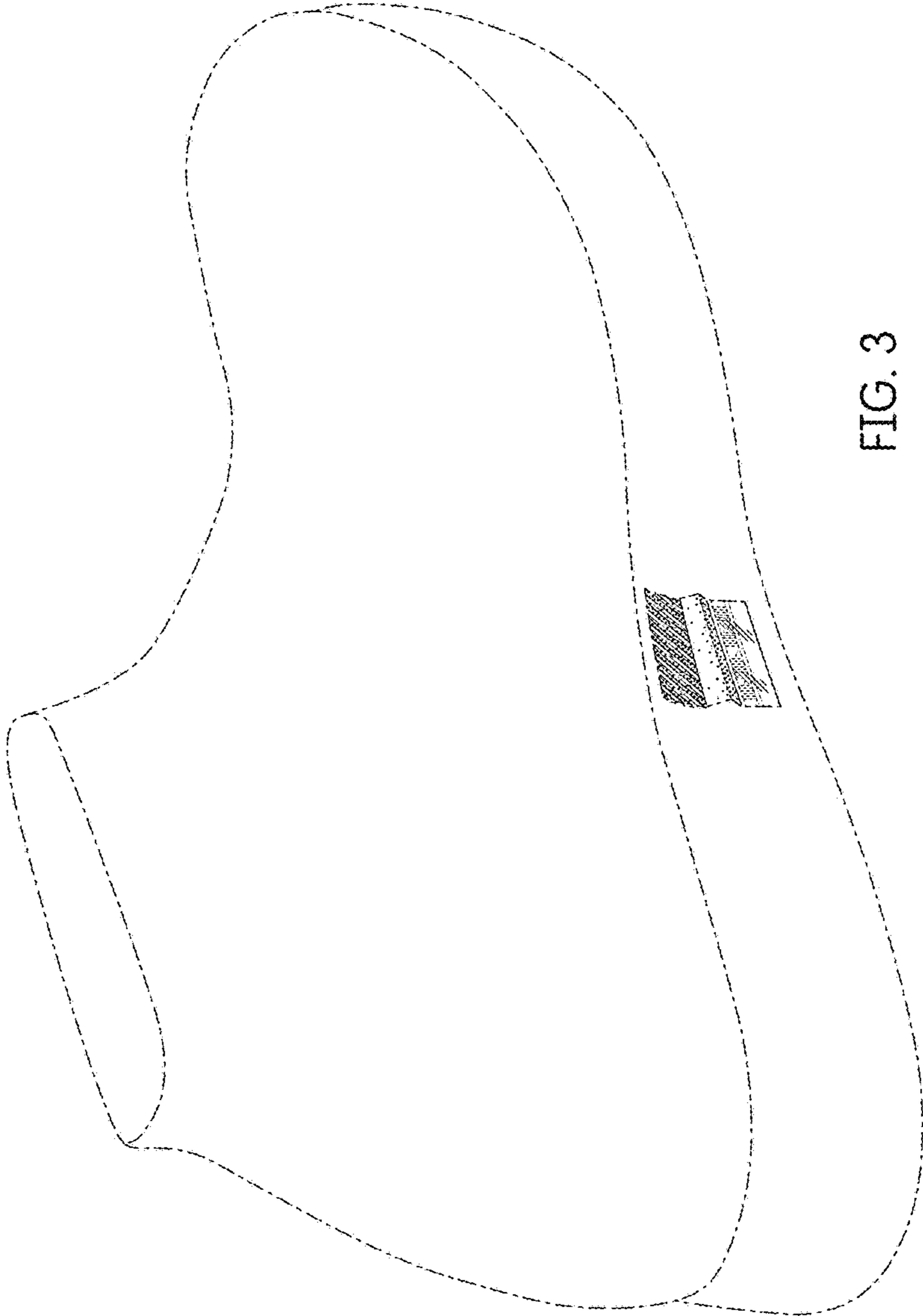

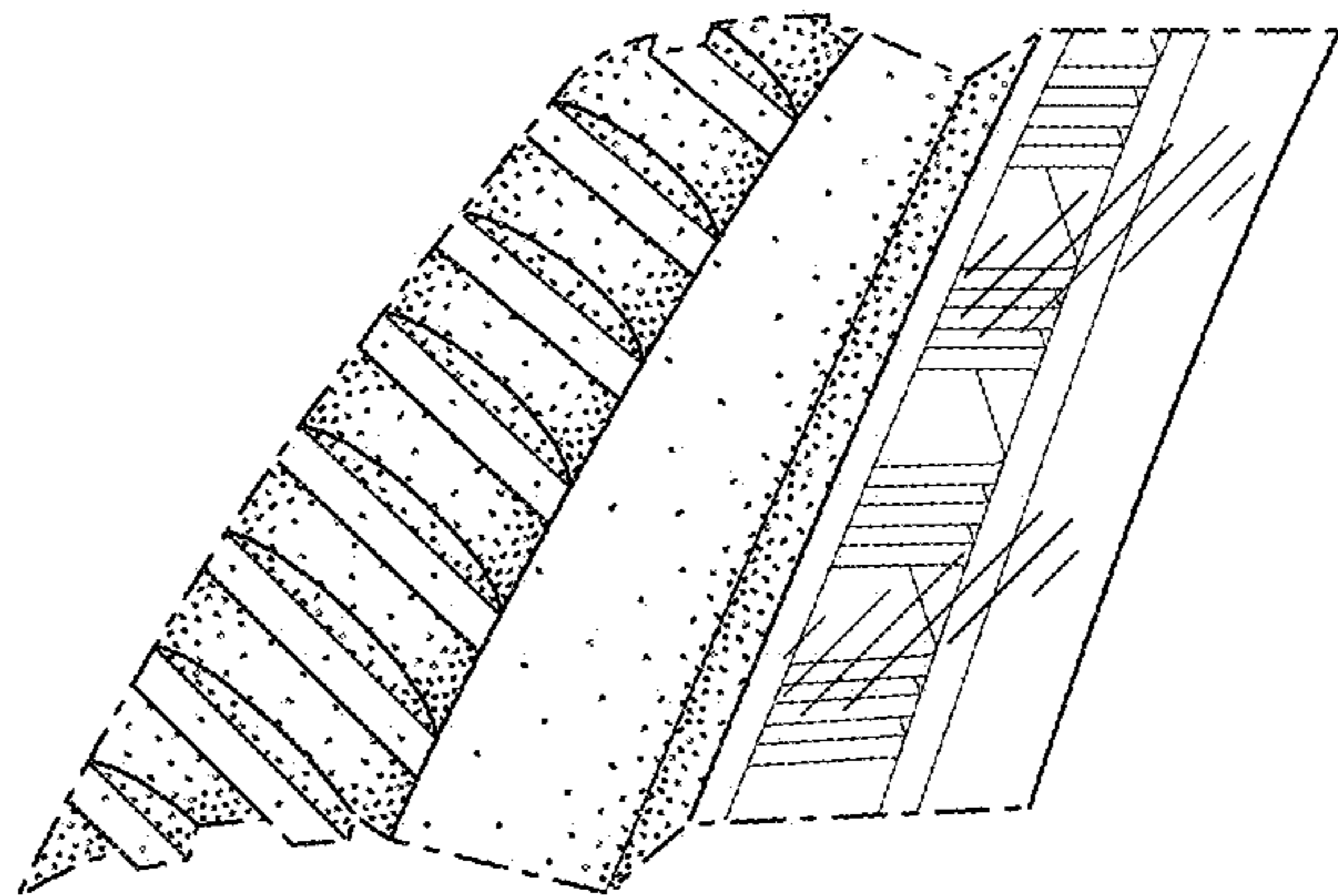

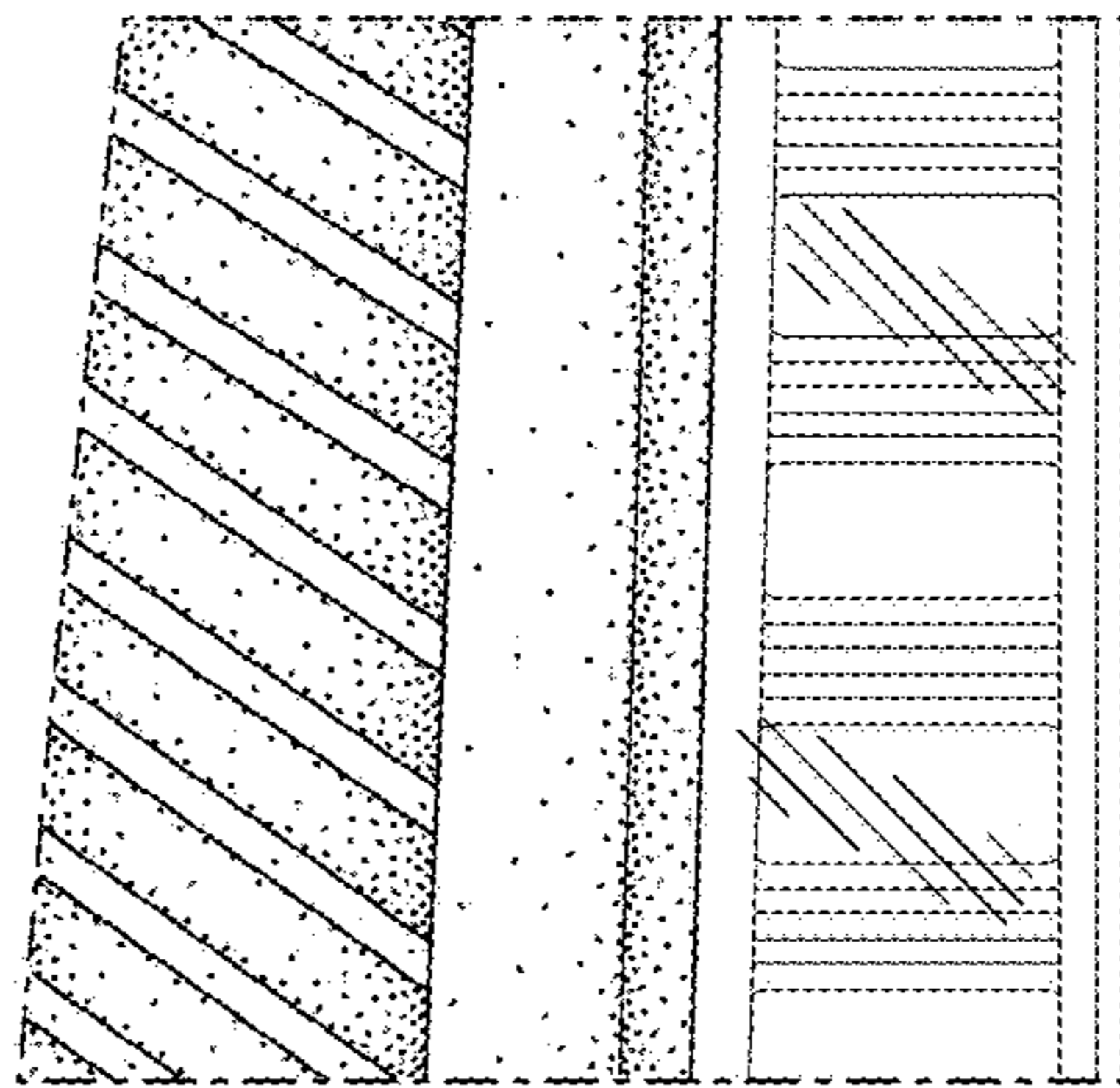
