FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of our a first version of our design;

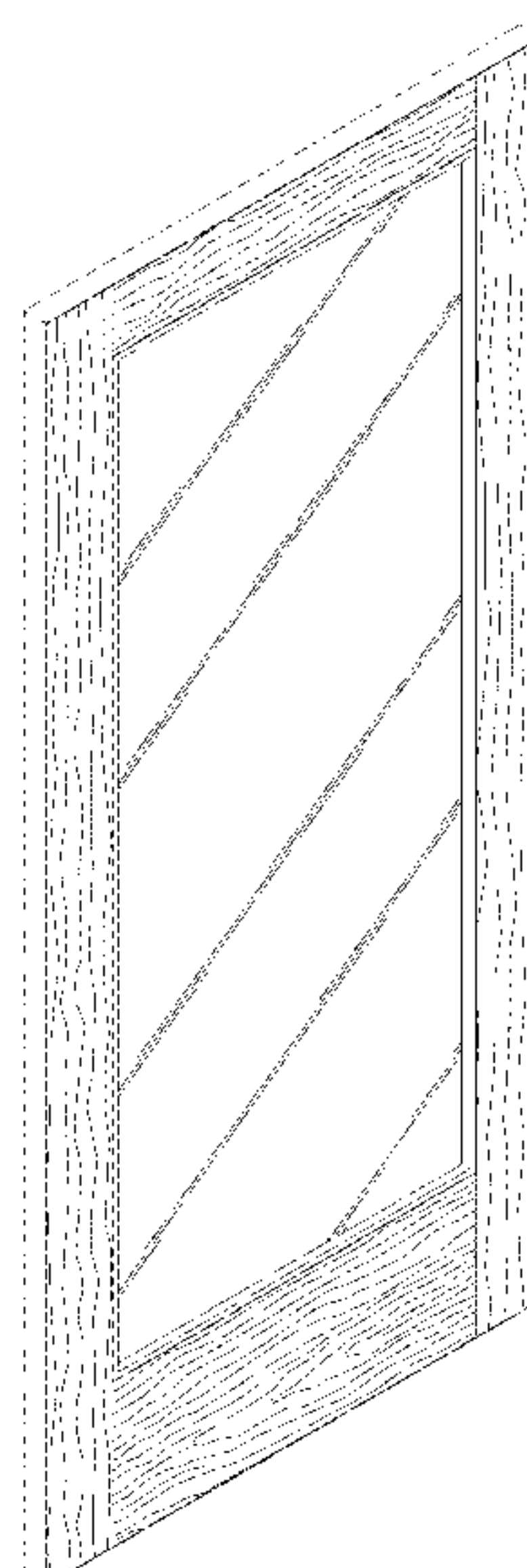
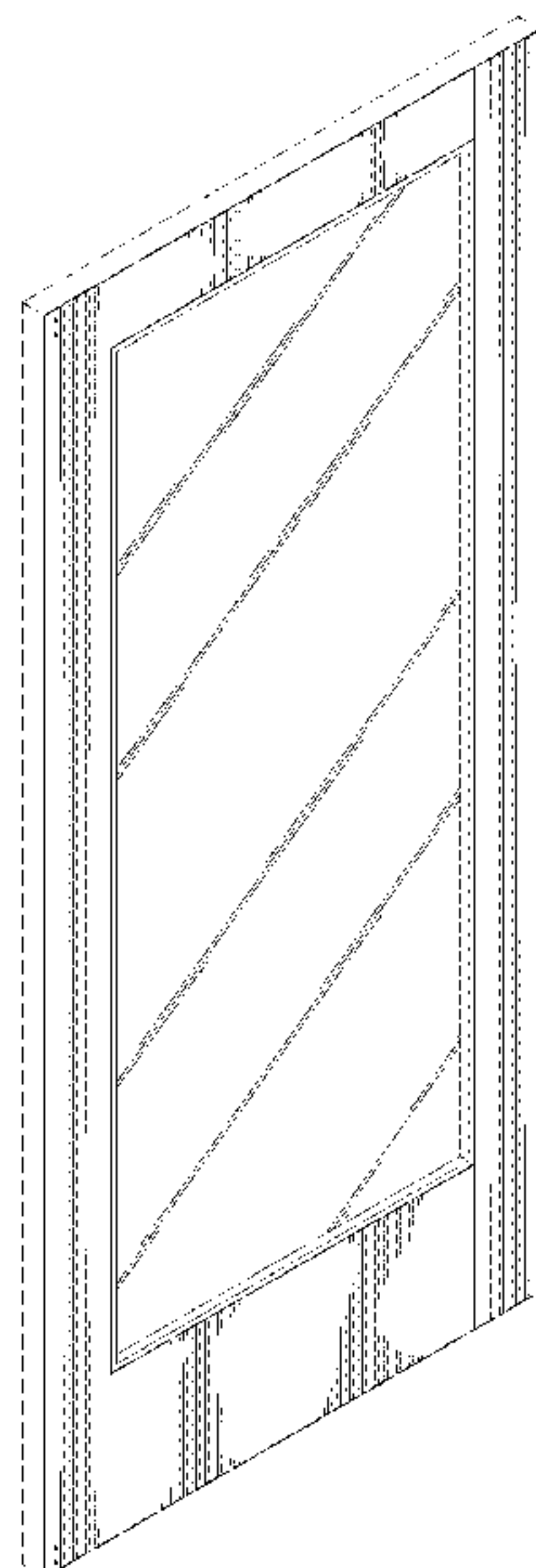
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, with the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

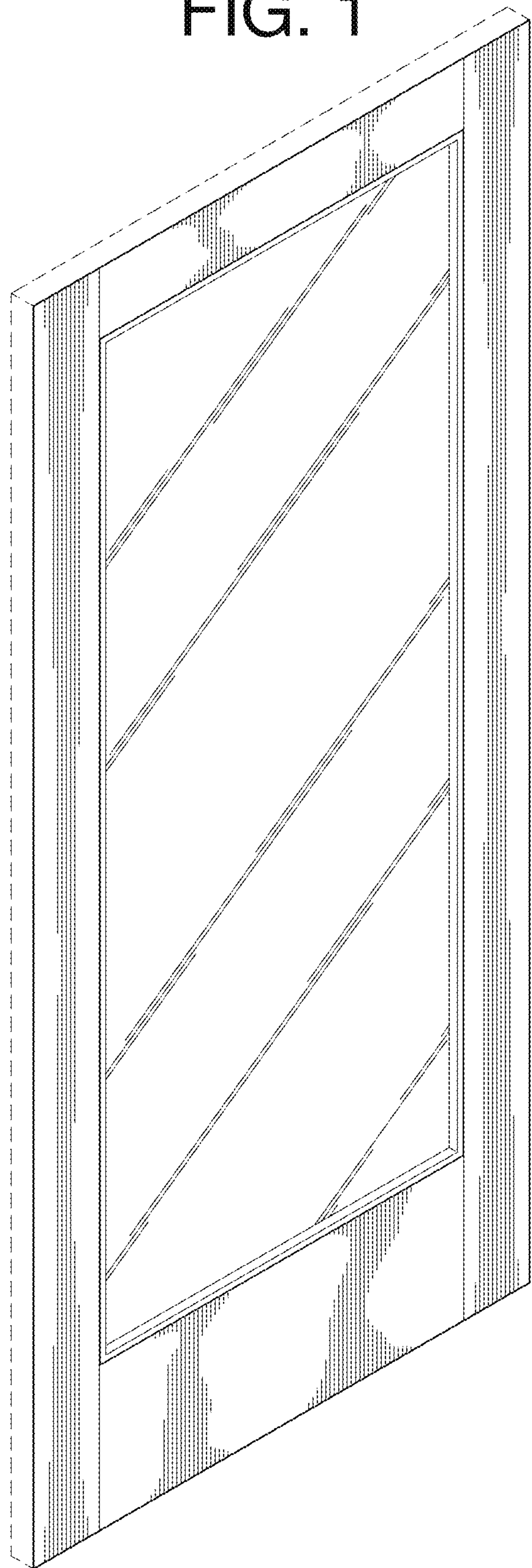

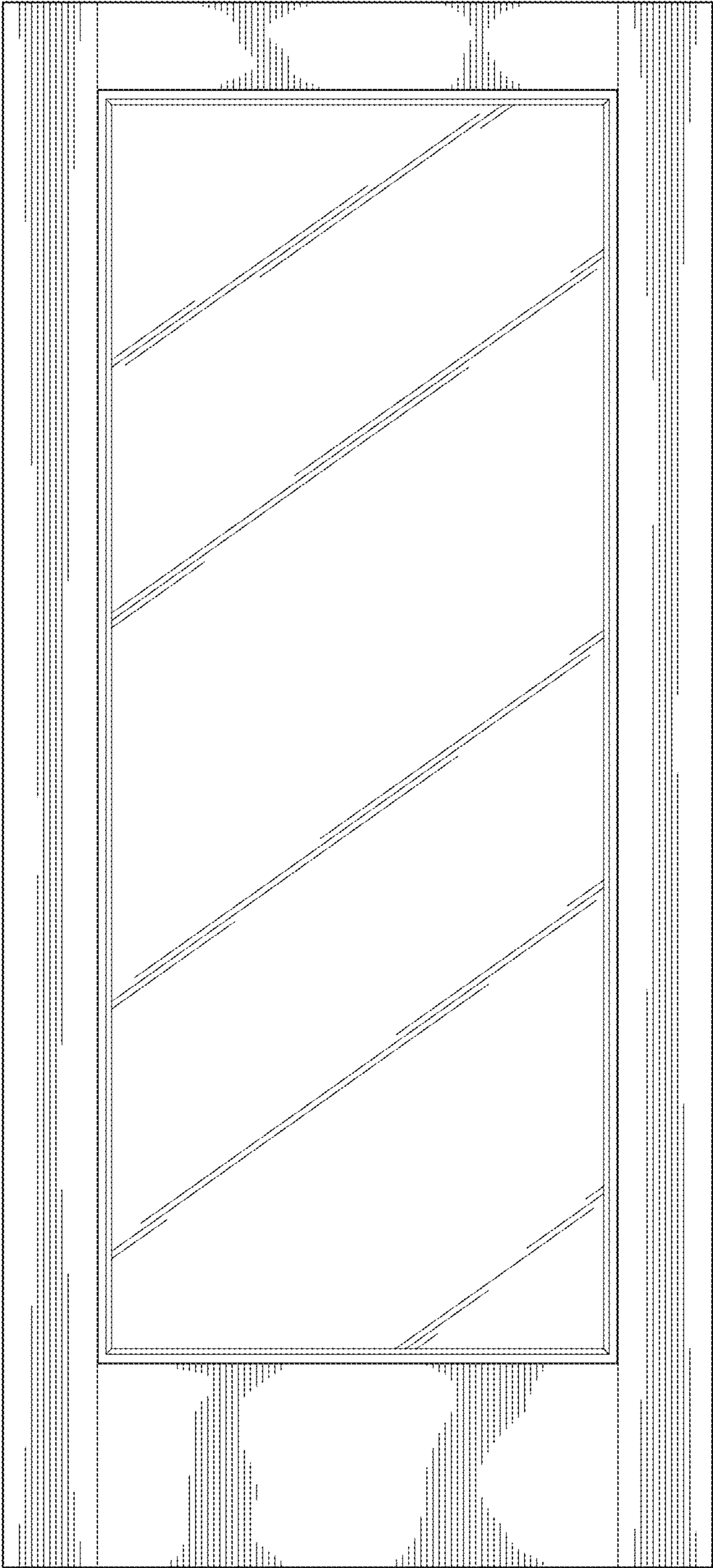

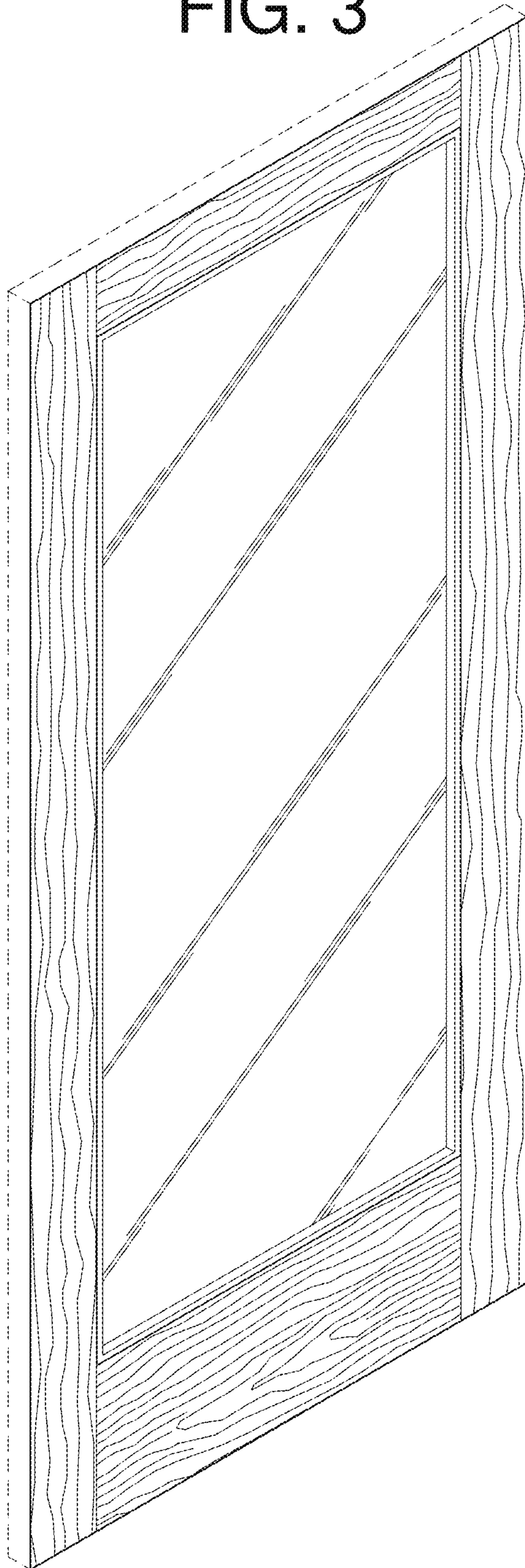
