(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe upper showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is an enlarged view of the FIG. 2 side view, shown isolated from the environment.

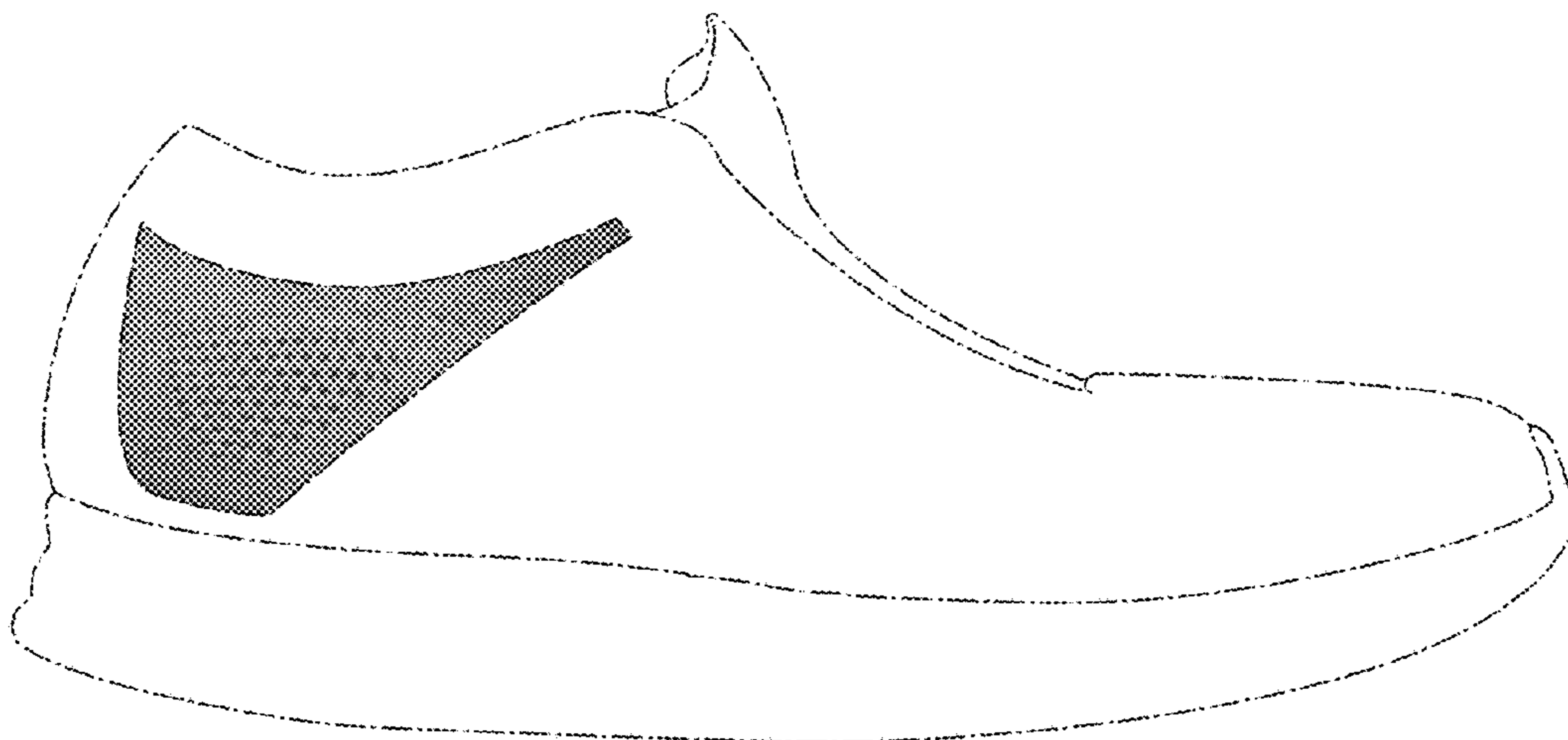

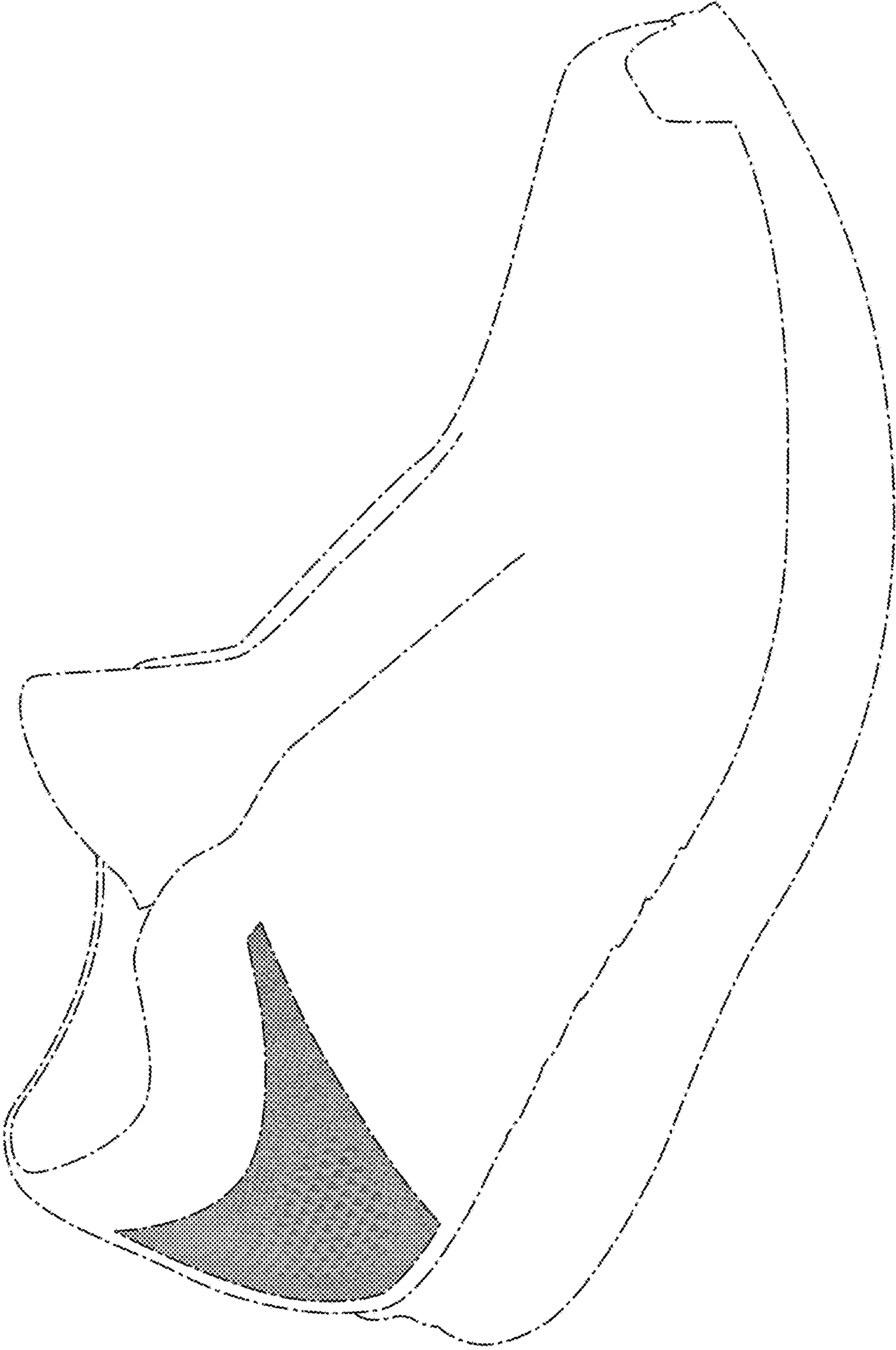

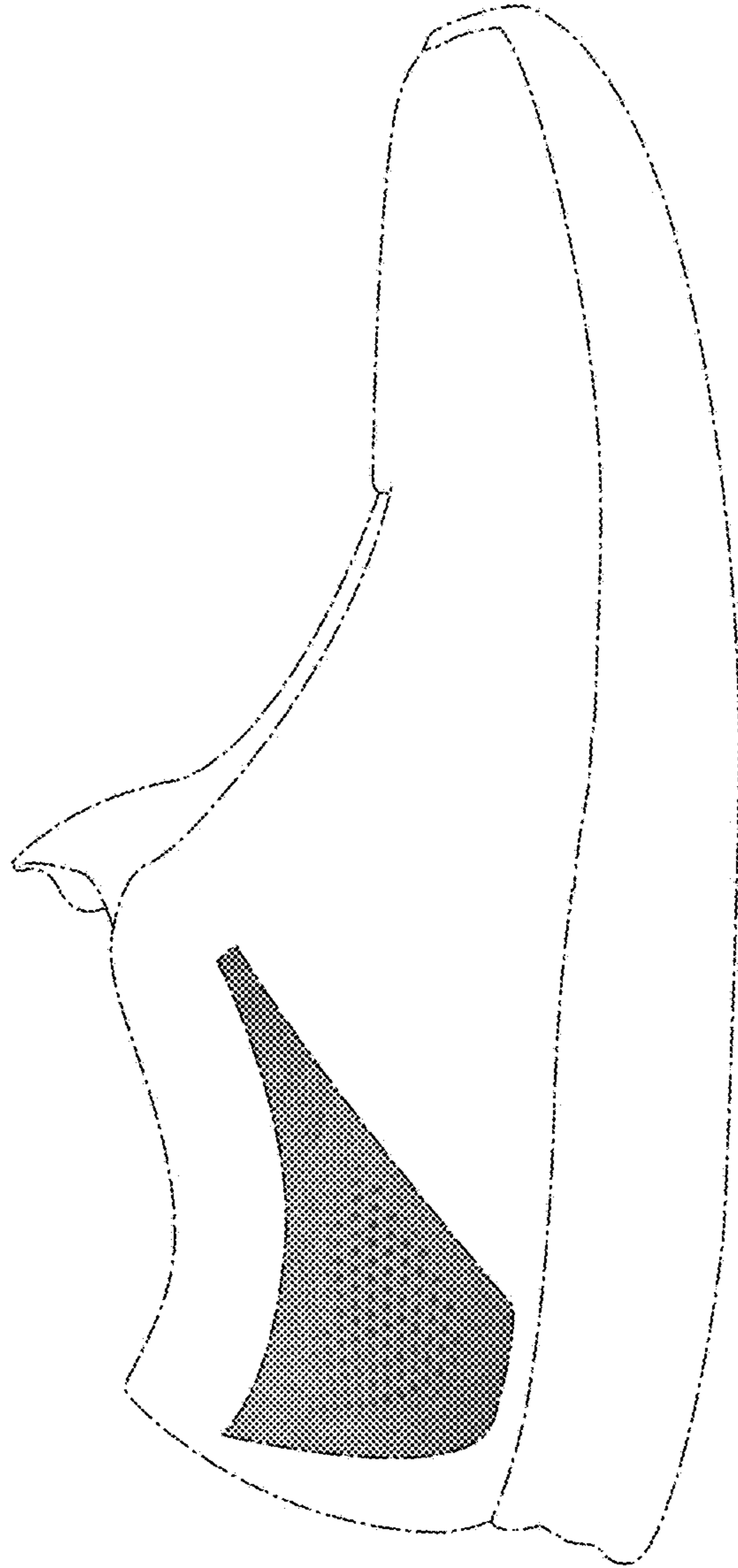

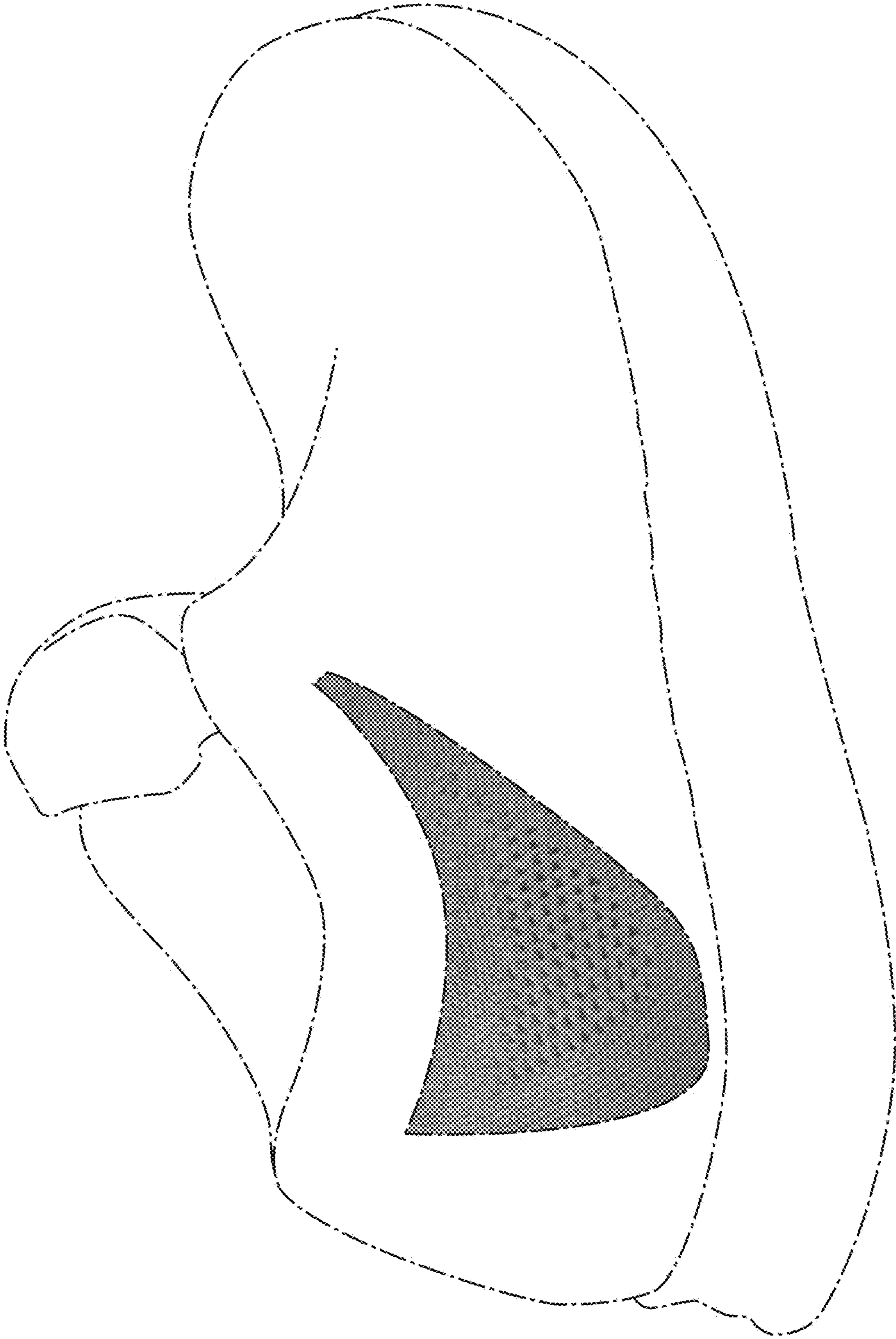

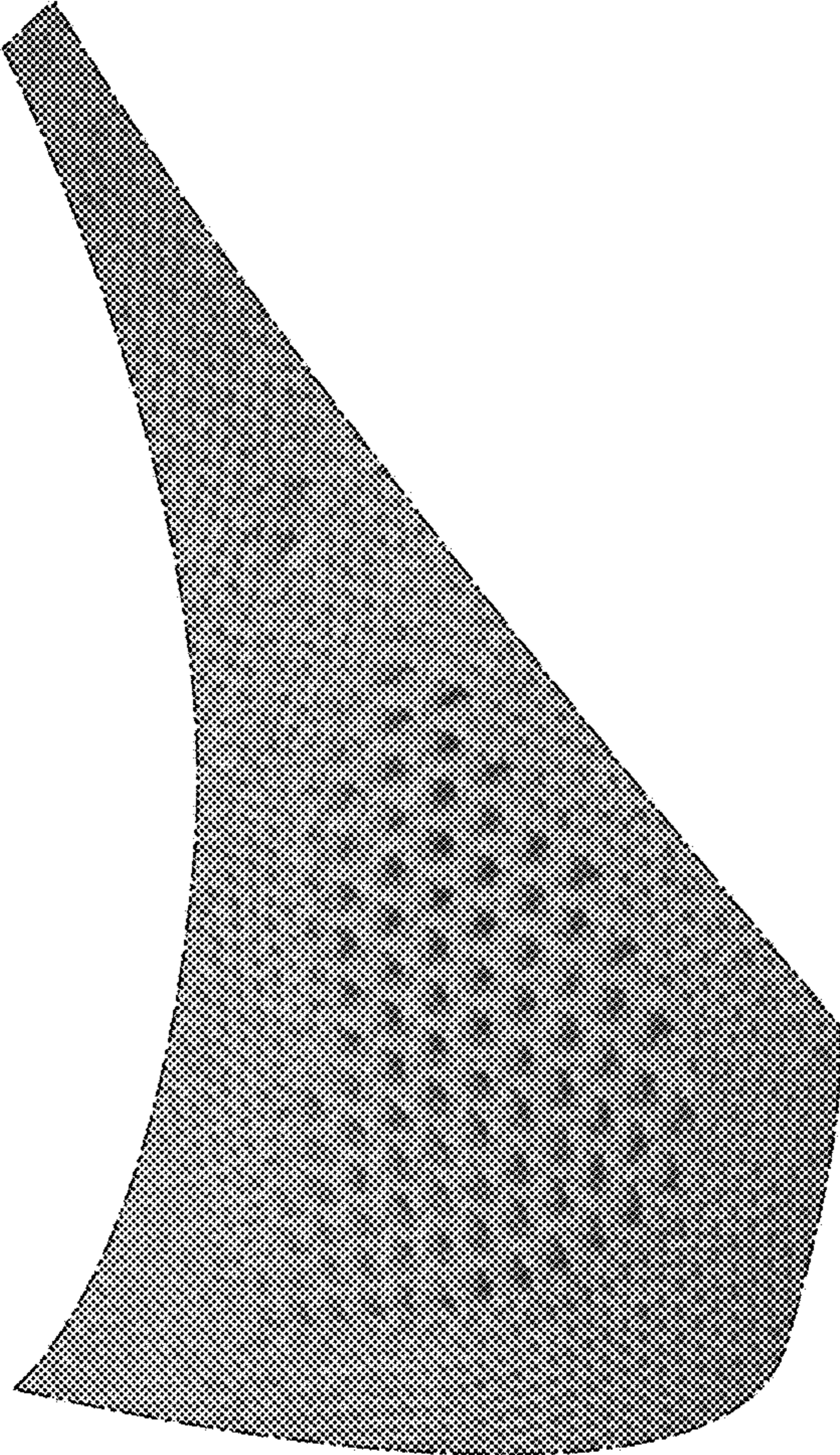
