DESCRIPTION

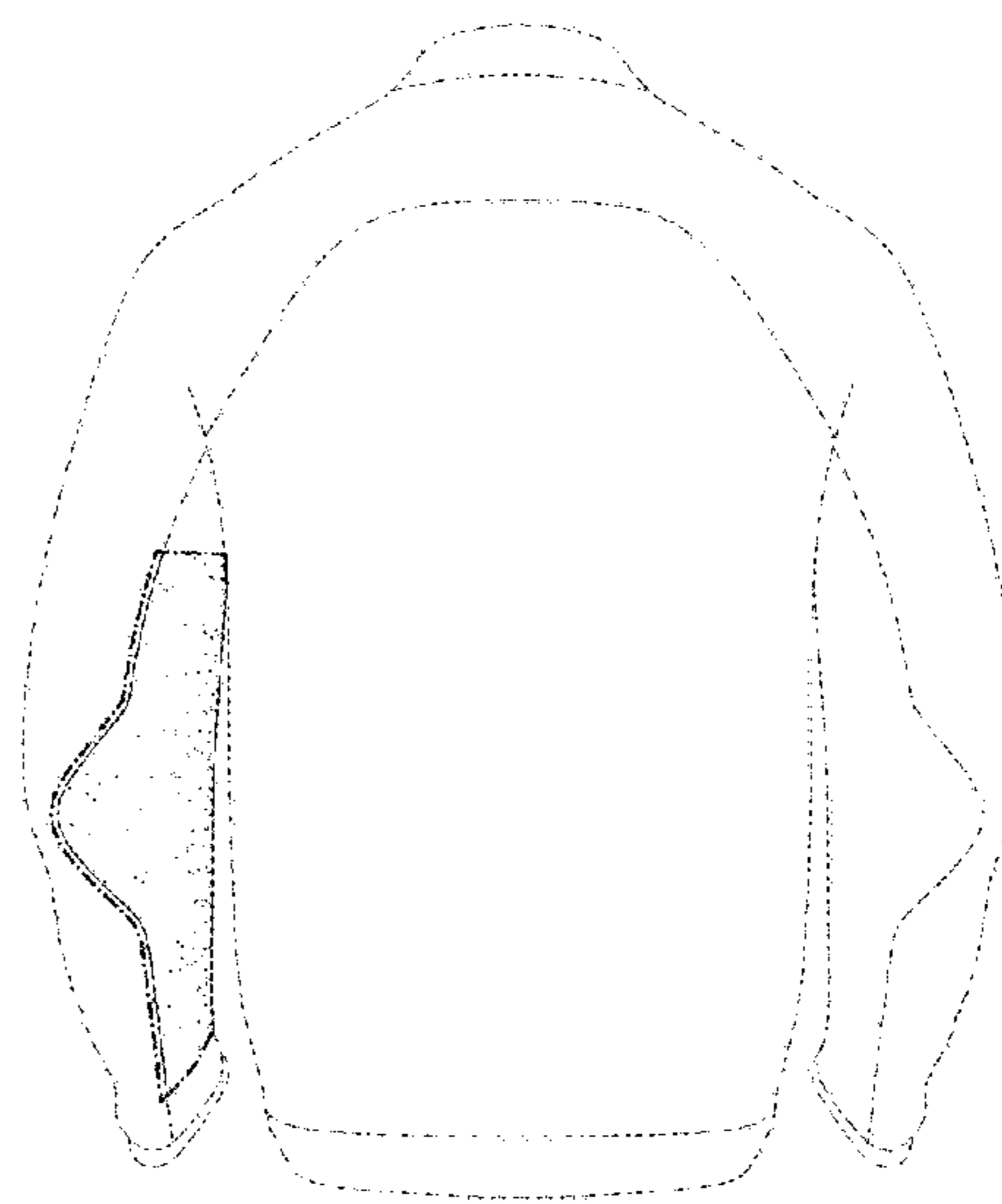
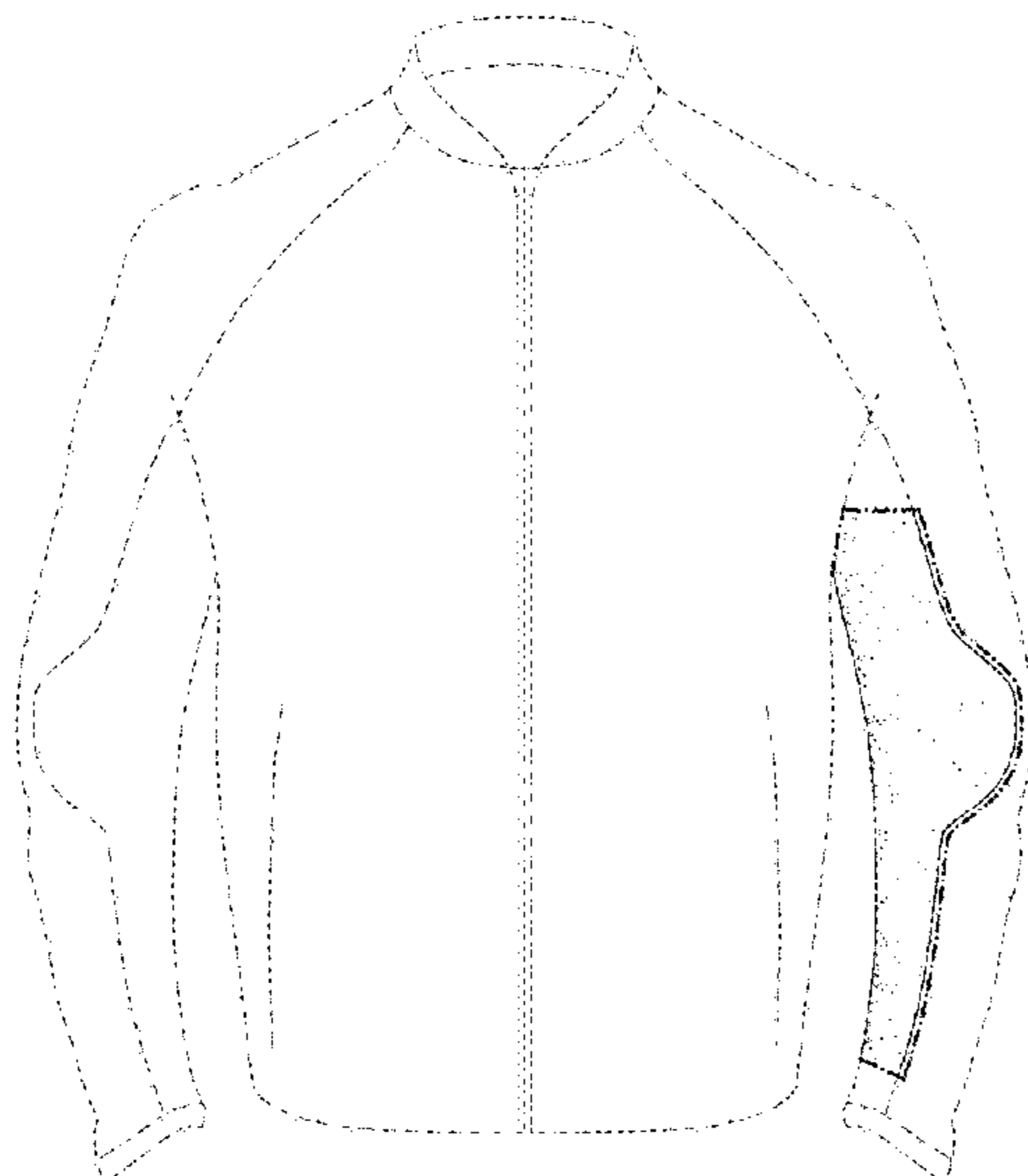
FIG. 1 is a front view of a garment in an as-worn configuration according to the present design; FIG. 2 is a back view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom-up view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front view of the garment in a laid-flat configuration according to the present design; and, FIG. 5 is a back view thereof.

The long and short broken lines are boundary lines, which define the bounds of the claimed design. These boundaries do not exist in reality in the article embodying the design. It is understood that the claimed design extends to these boundaries but does not include the boundaries.

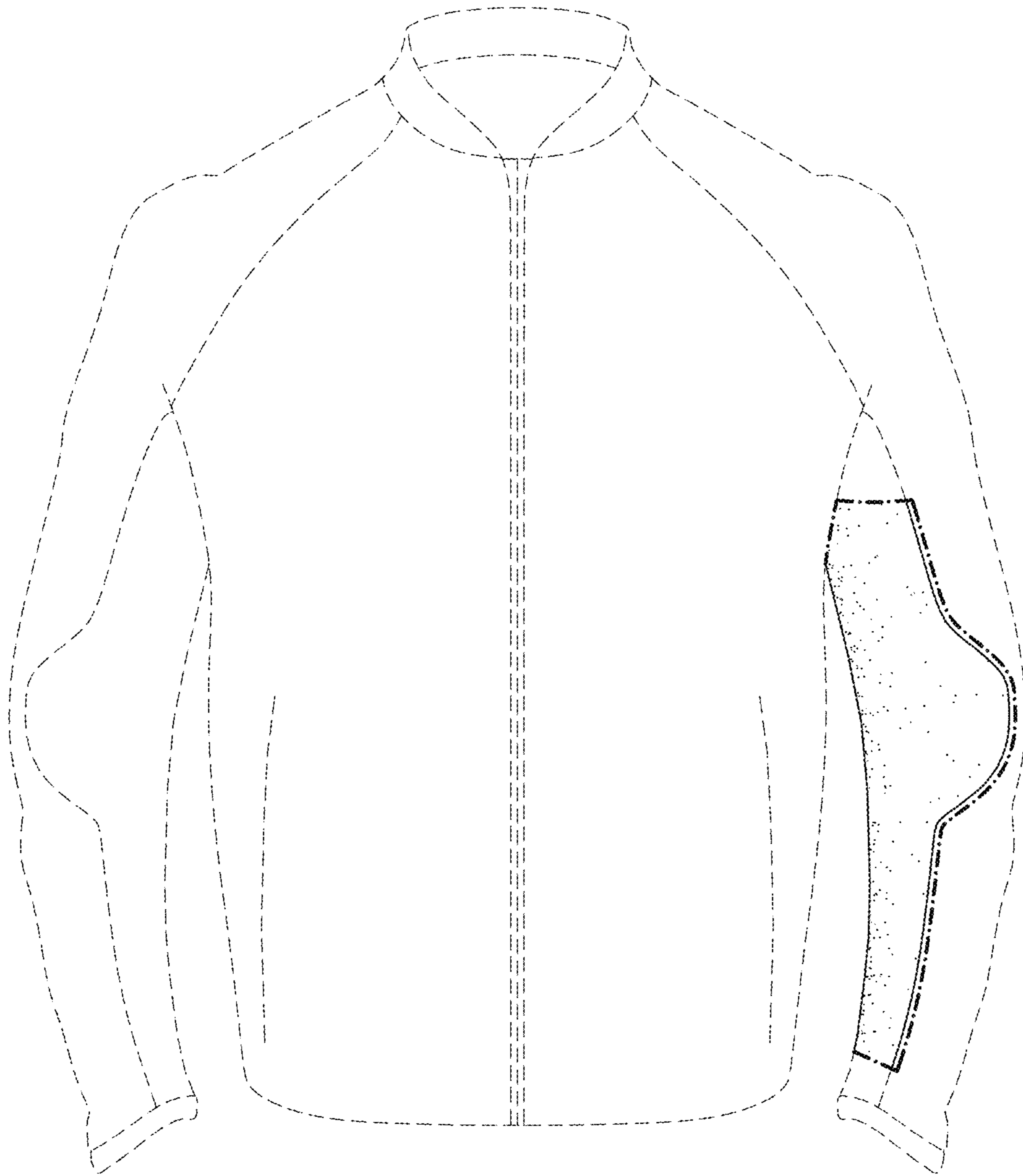

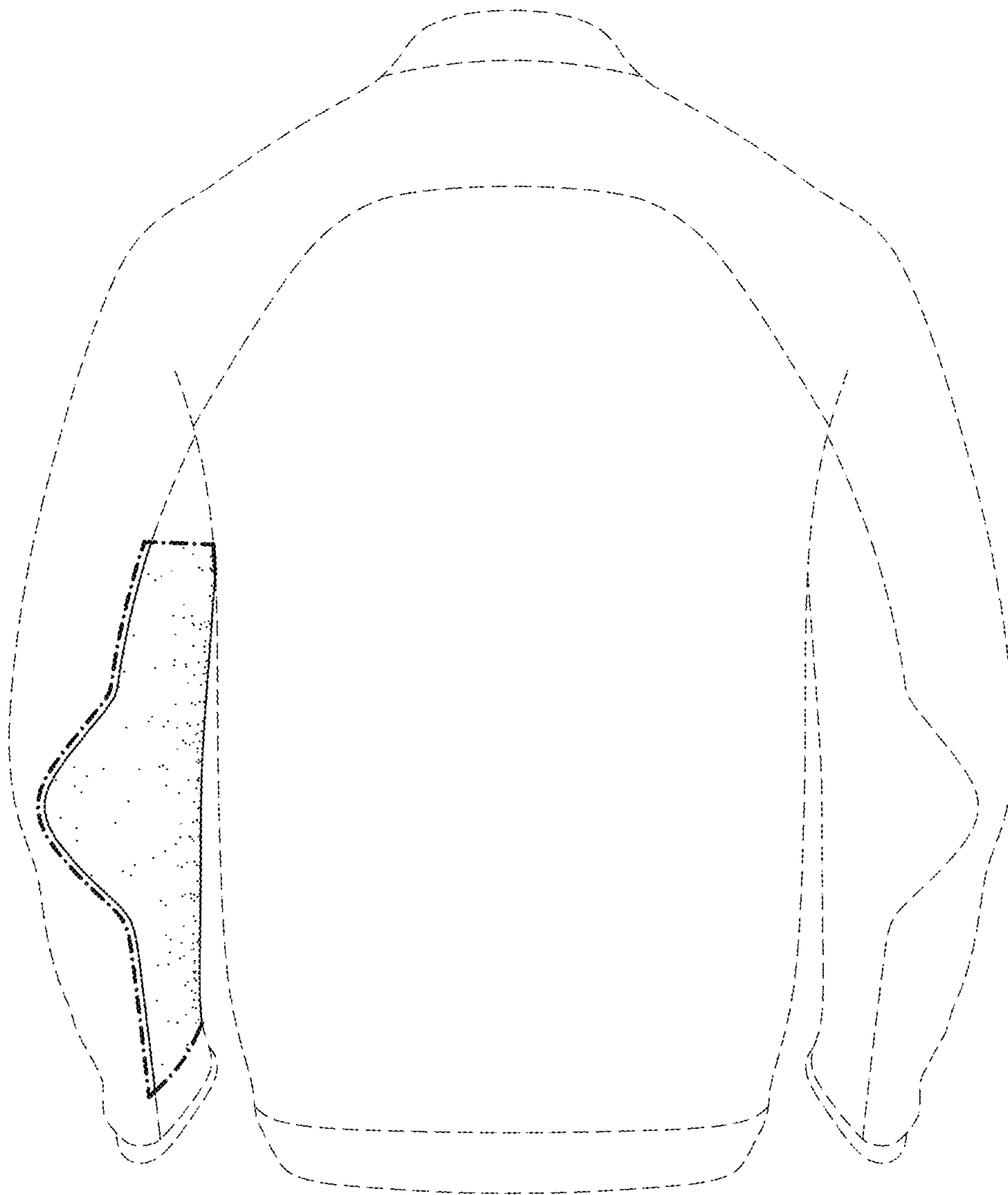

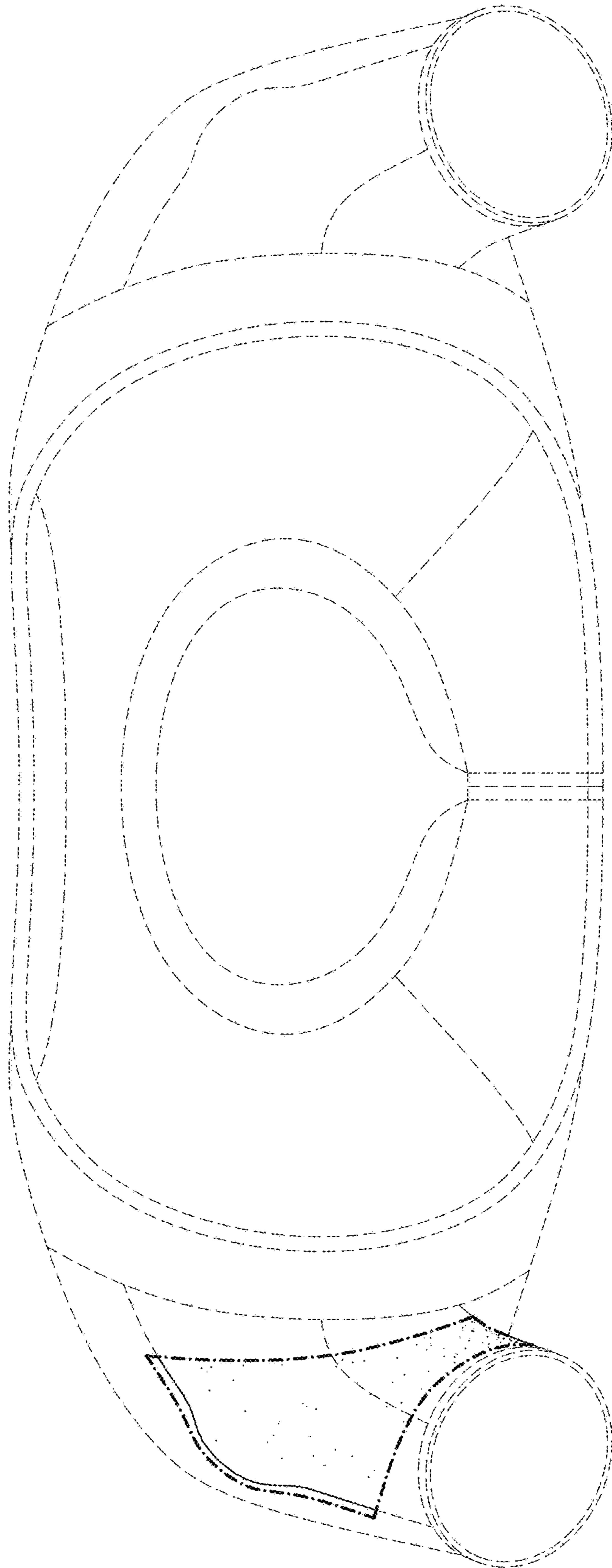

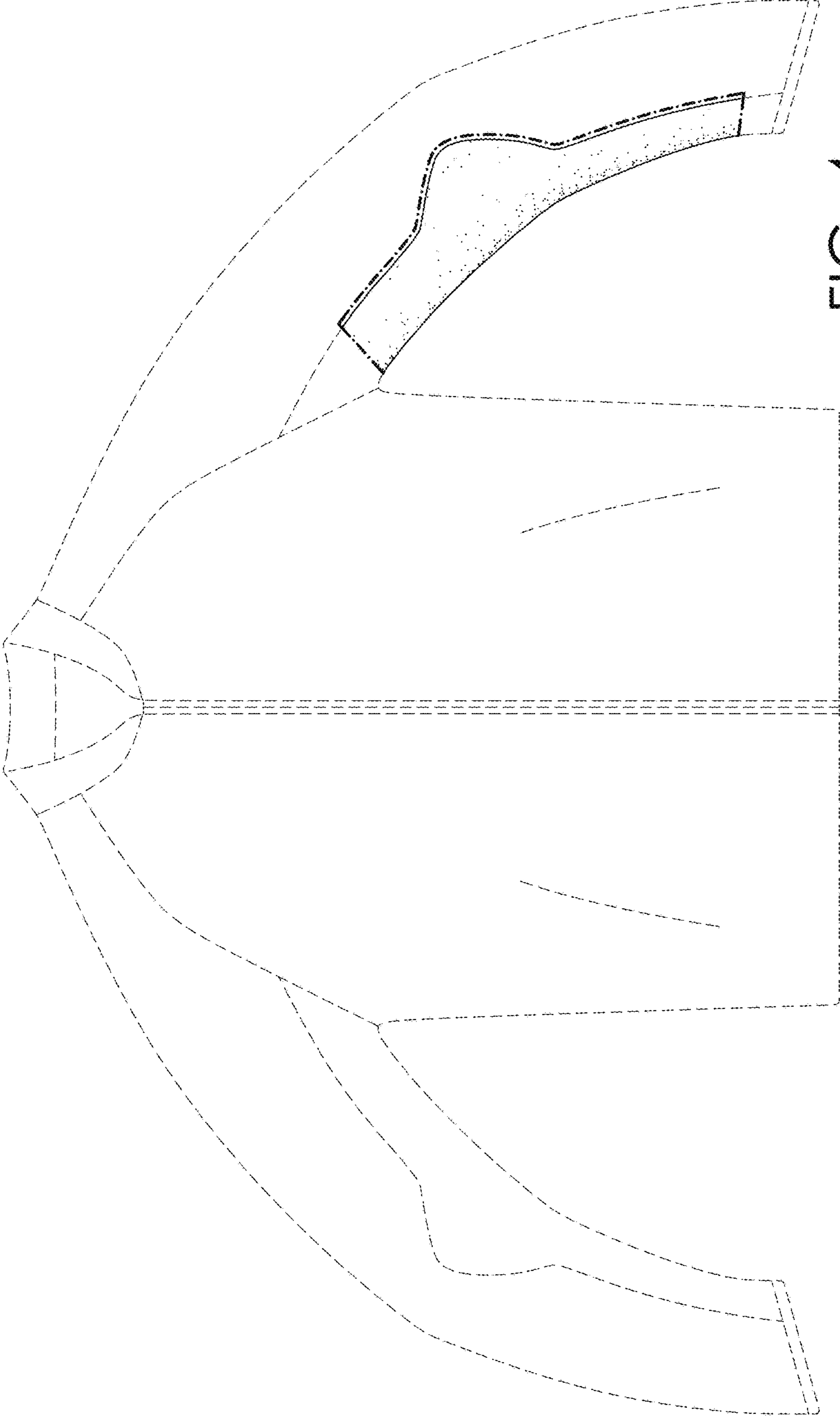

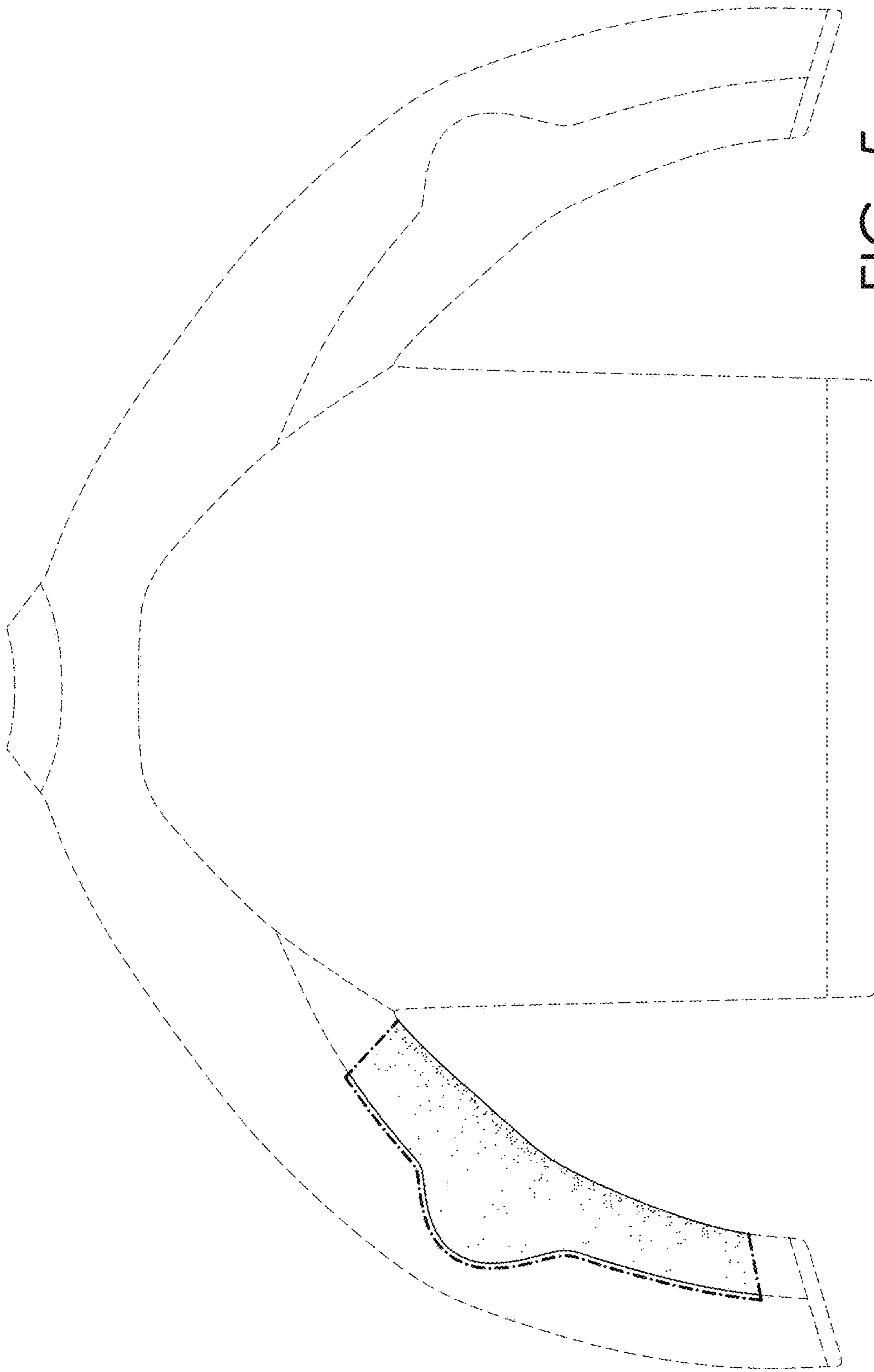
