(57) **CLAIM**

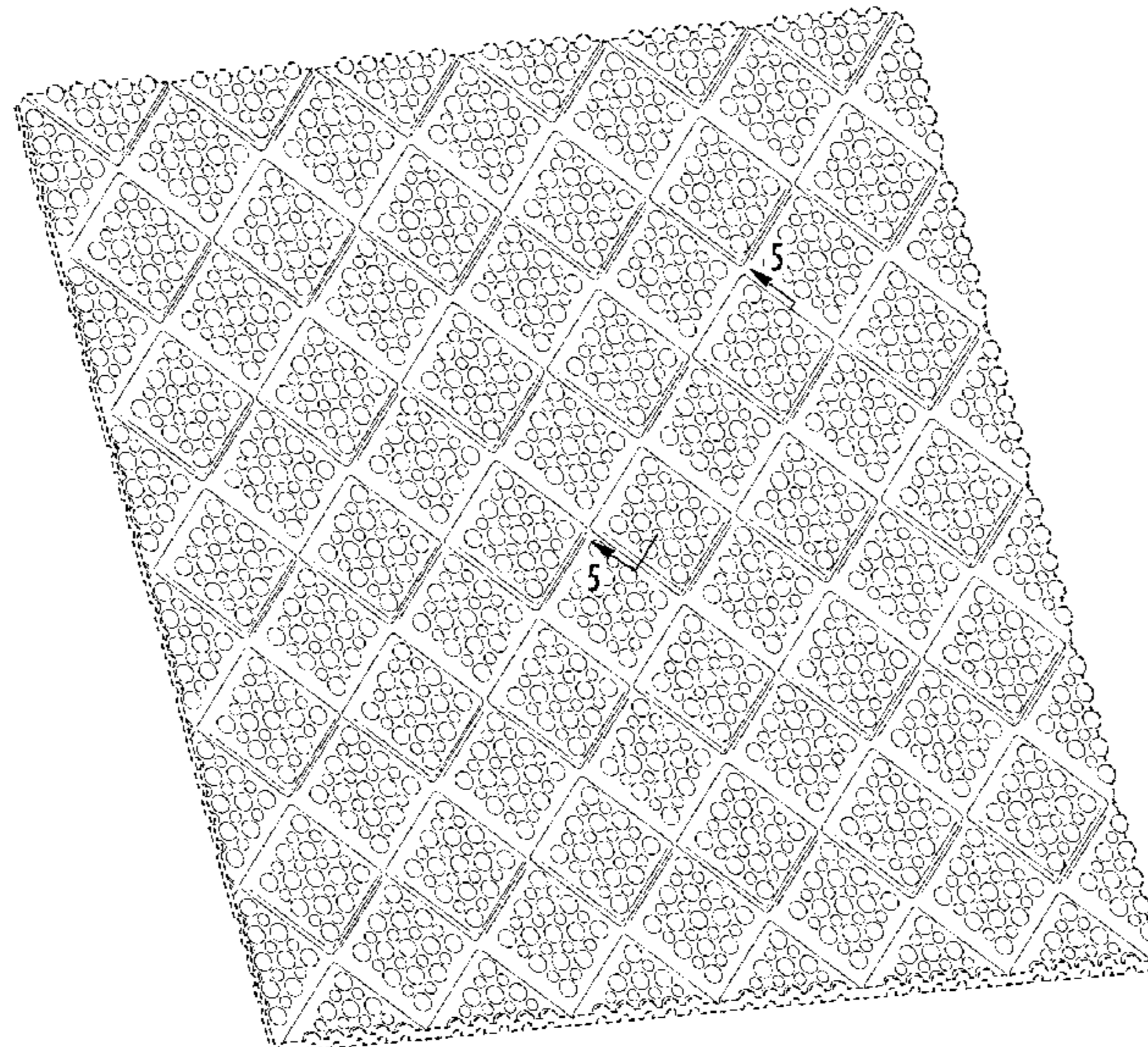
The ornamental design for a nonwoven fabric, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nonwoven fabric, embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 2; and,
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5-5 of FIG. 1.
The broken lines forming a perimeter around FIGS. 1 and 2 depict the boundaries of the claim and form no part thereof. The rear surface and all other broken lines represent portions of the nonwoven fabric that form no part of the claimed design.

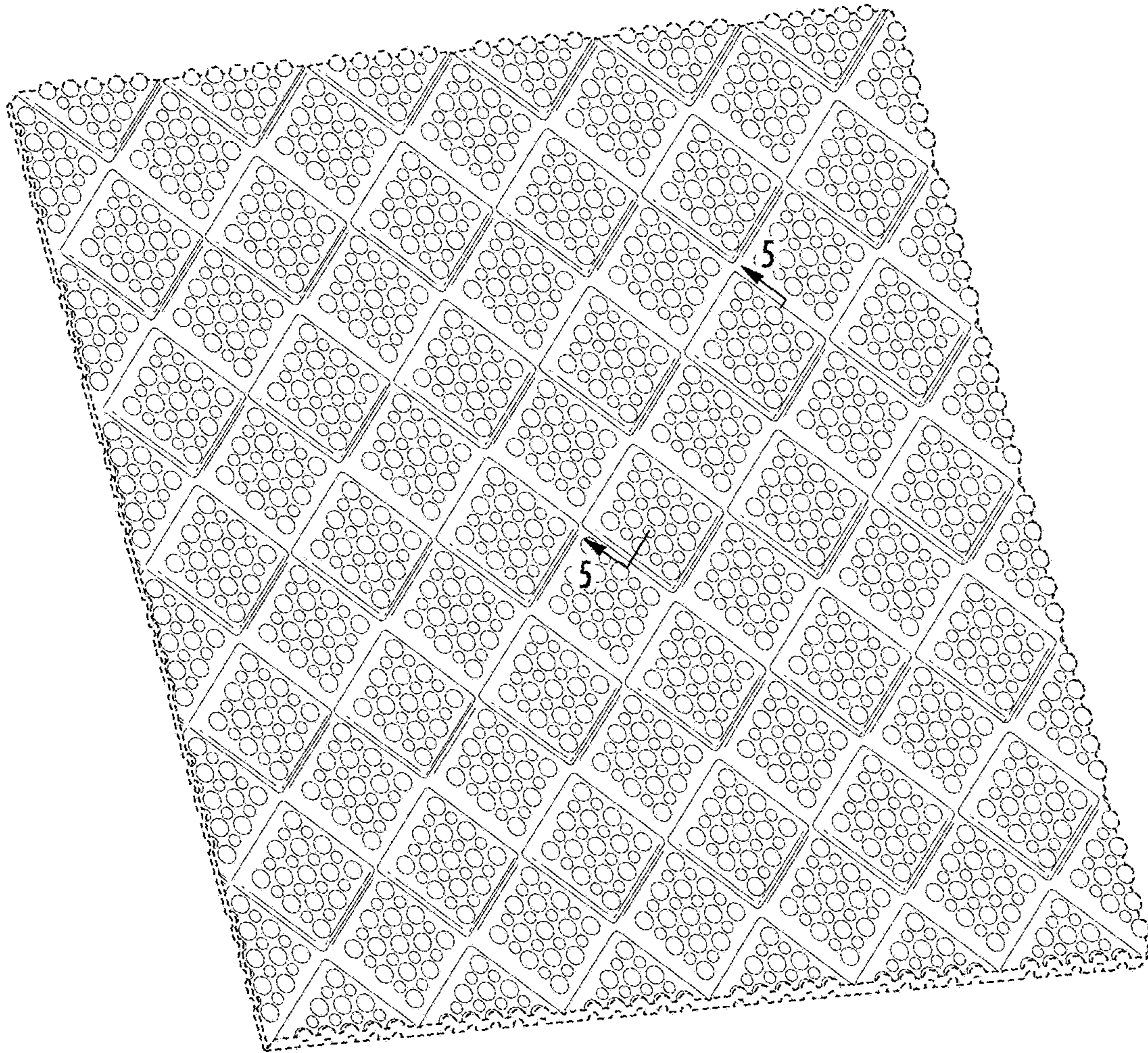

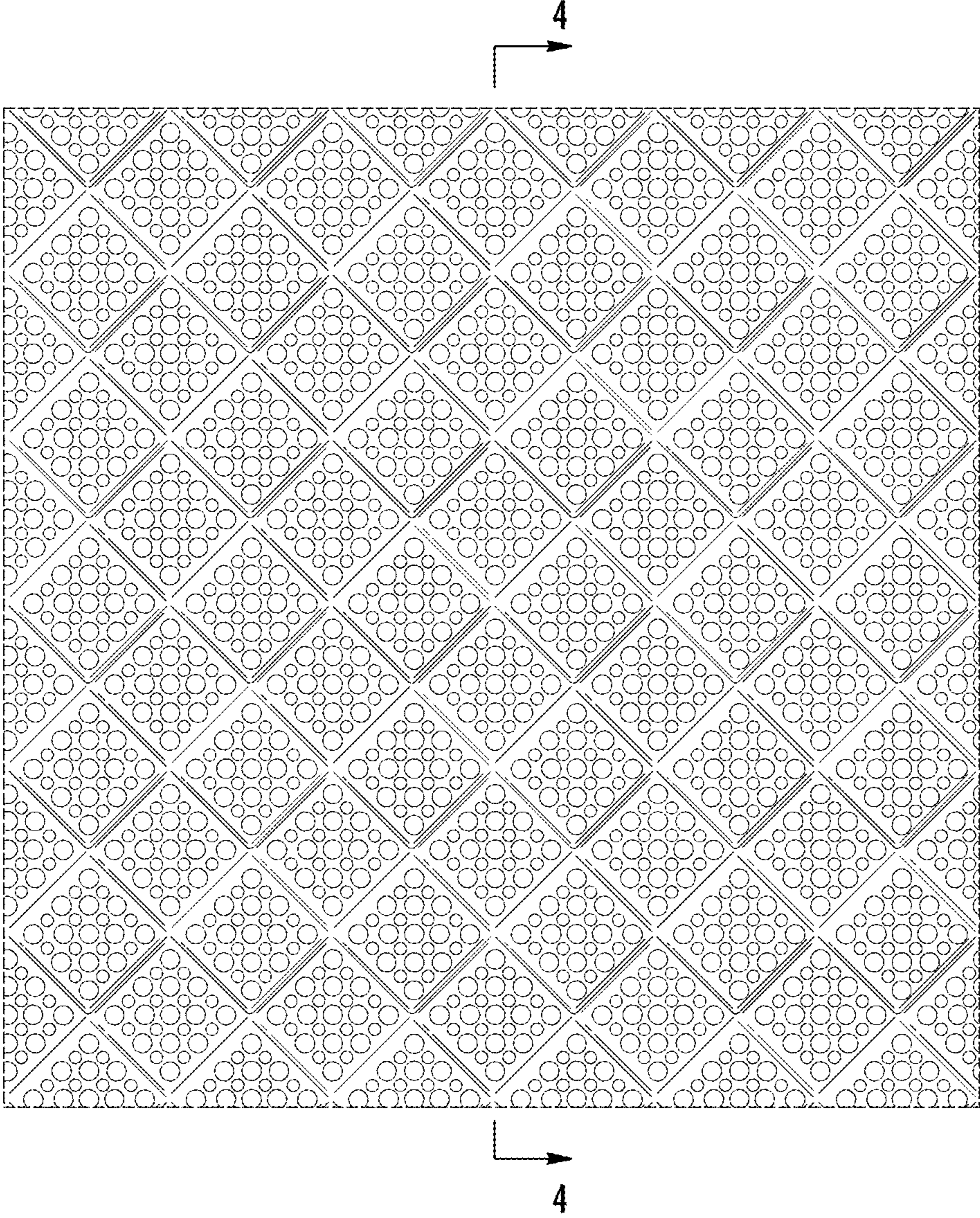

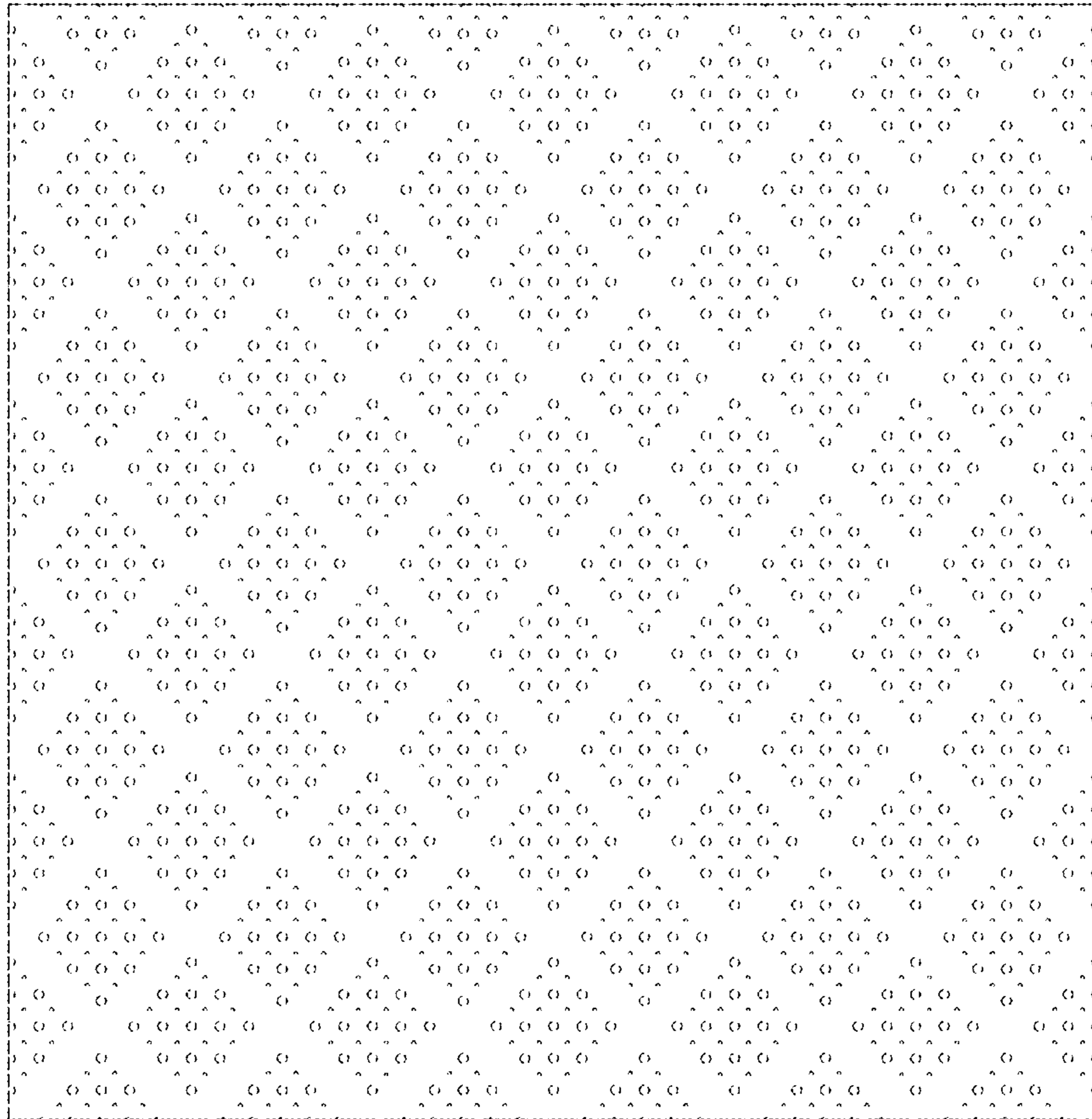
