FIG. 4 is a left side view of the connector holder of FIG. 1.

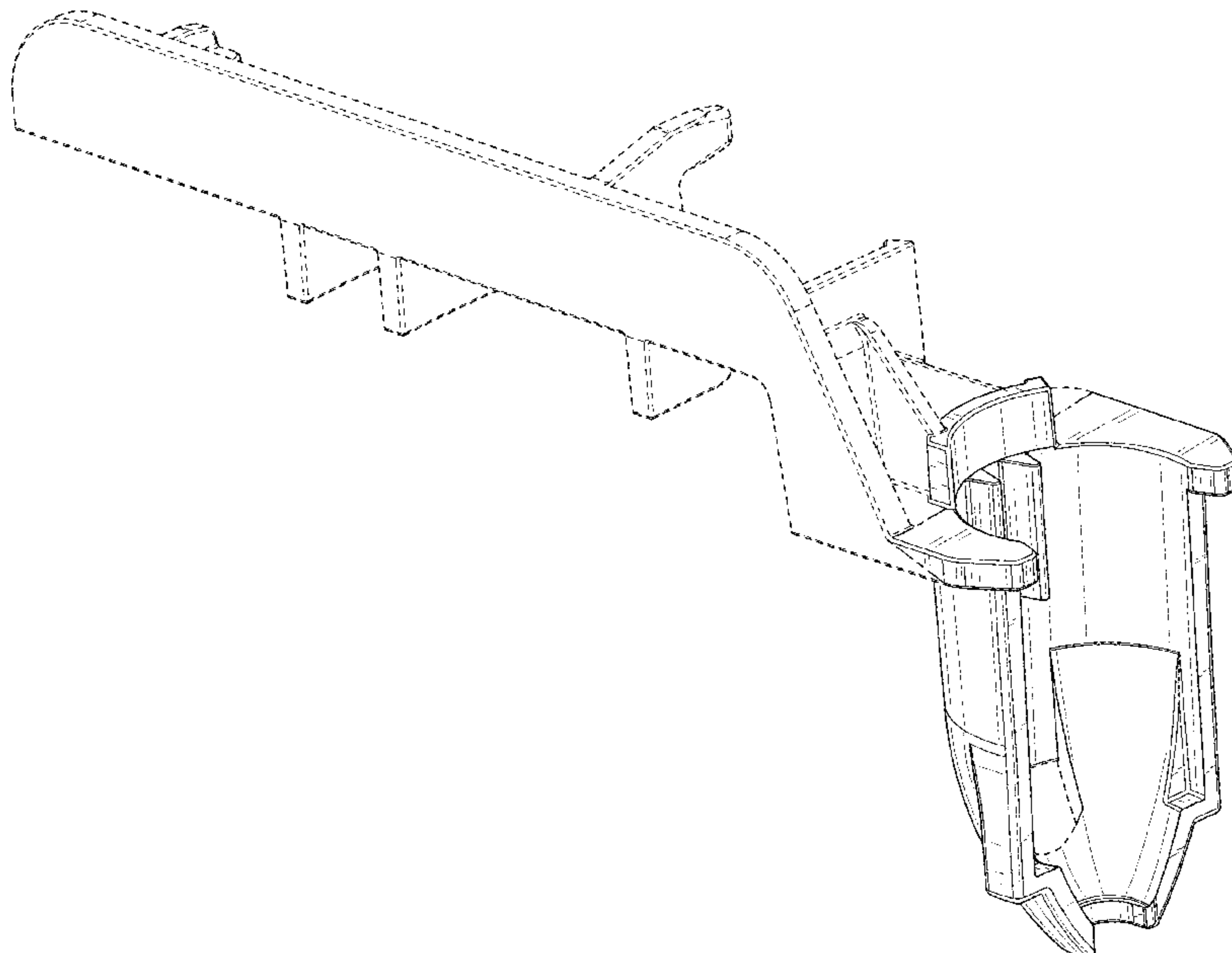
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the connector holder of FIG. 1.

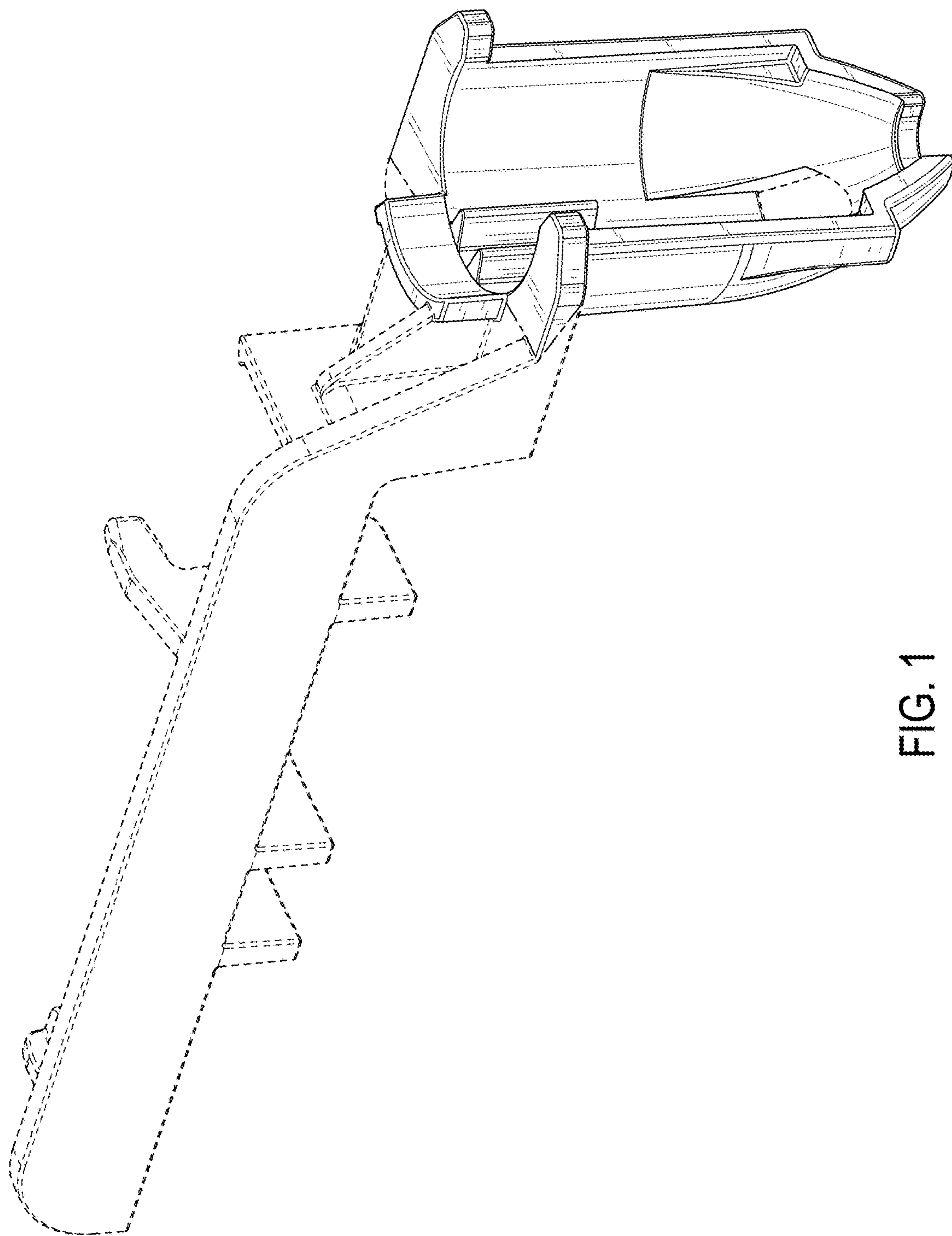

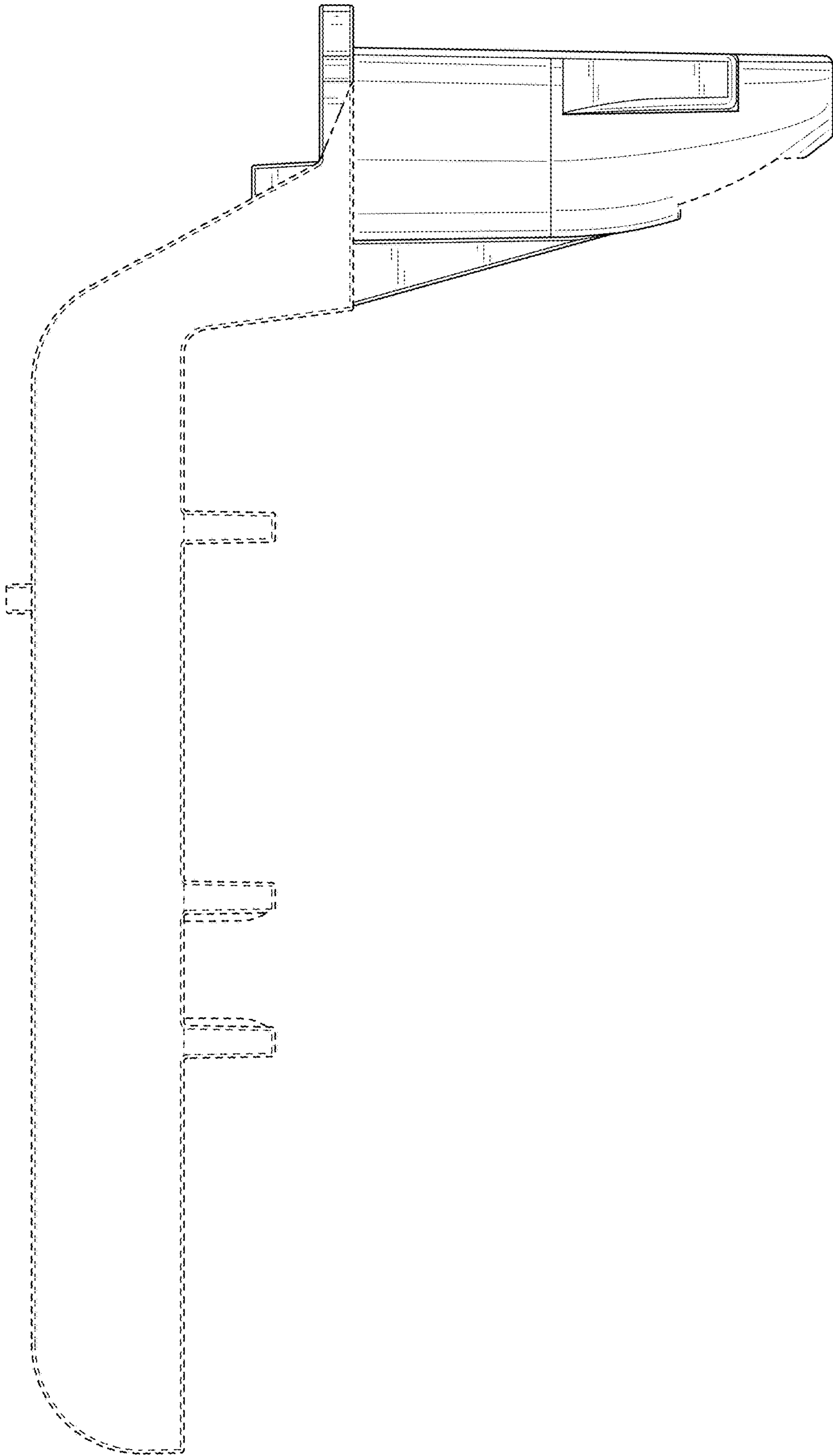

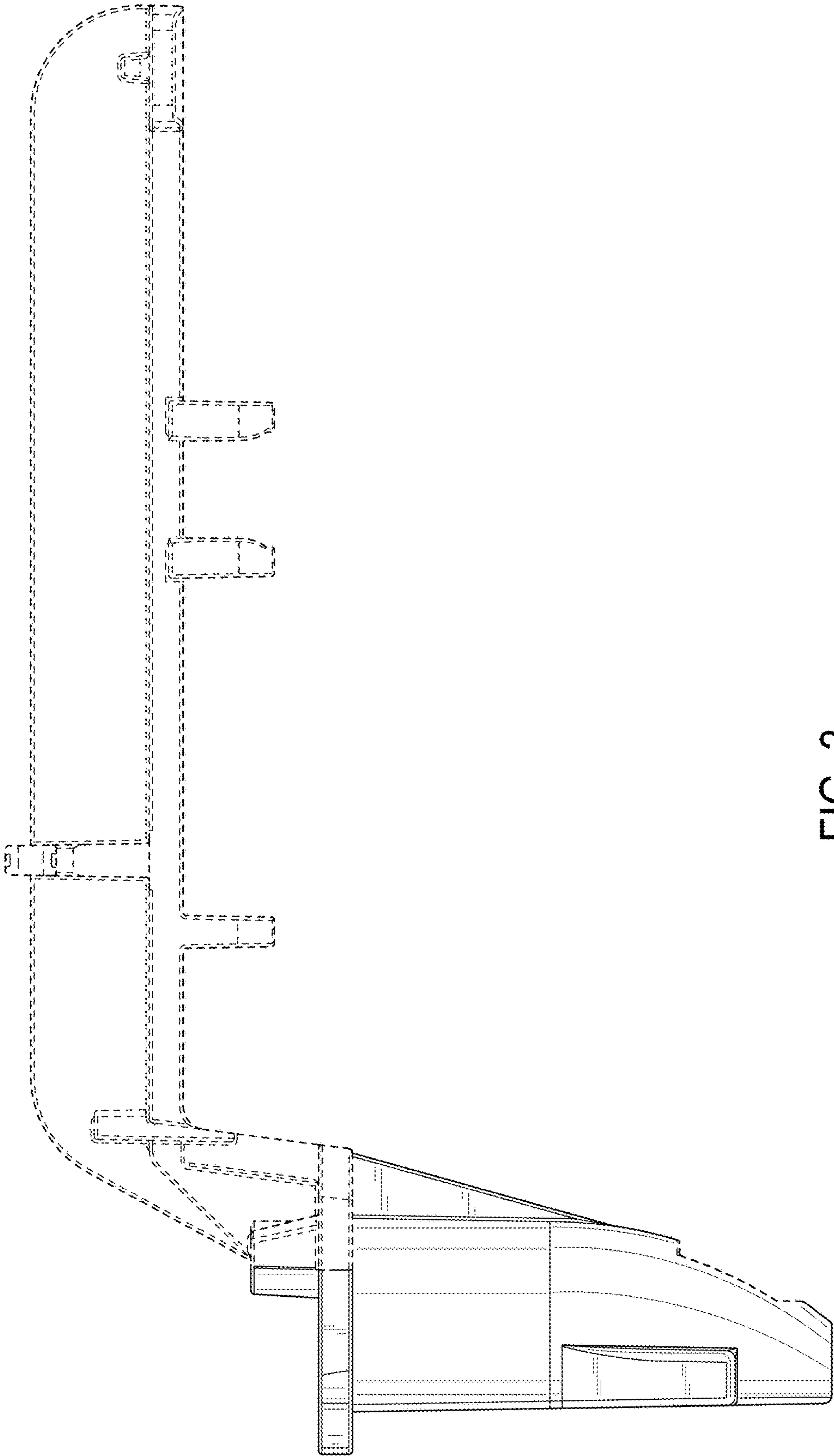

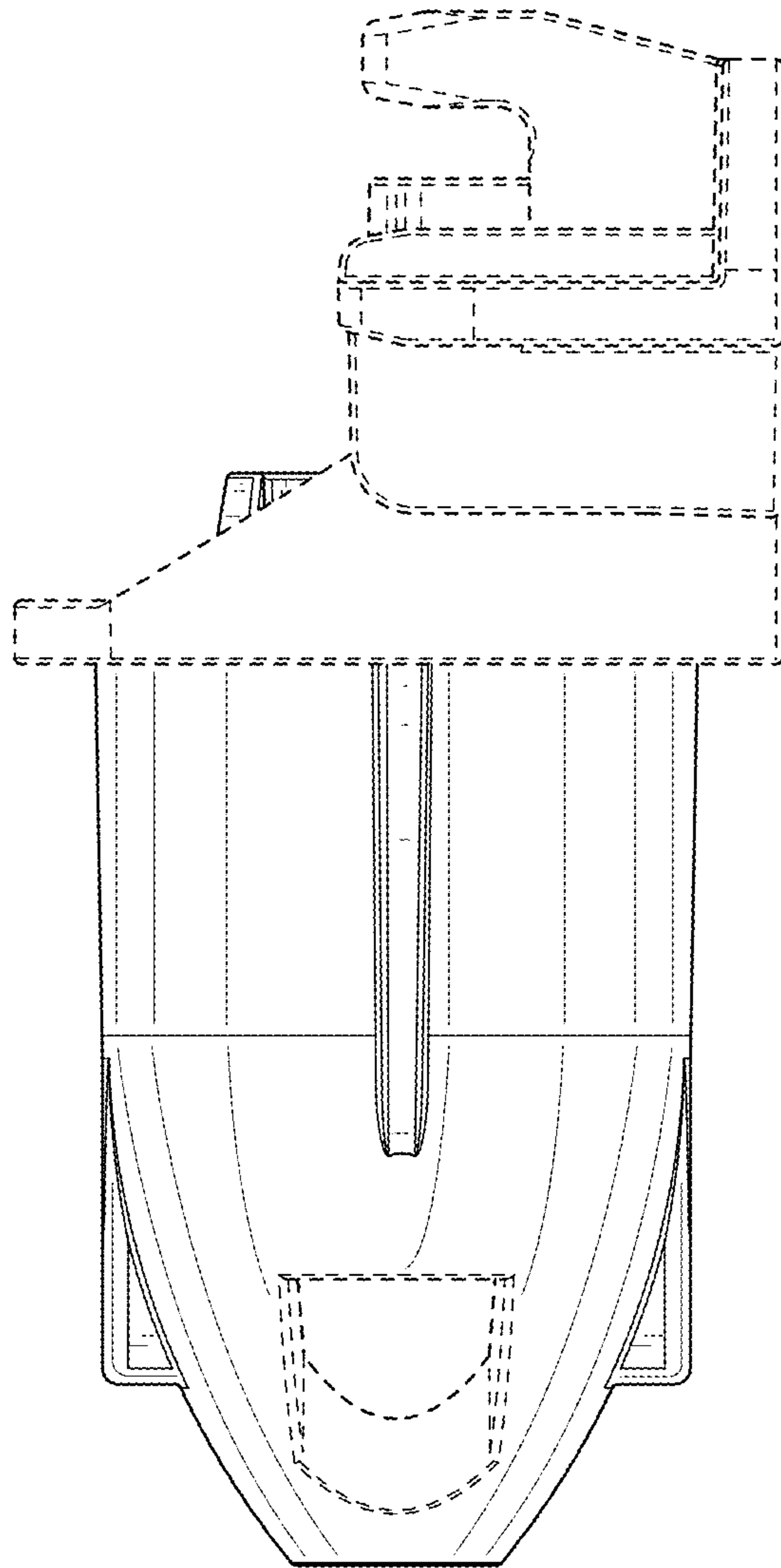

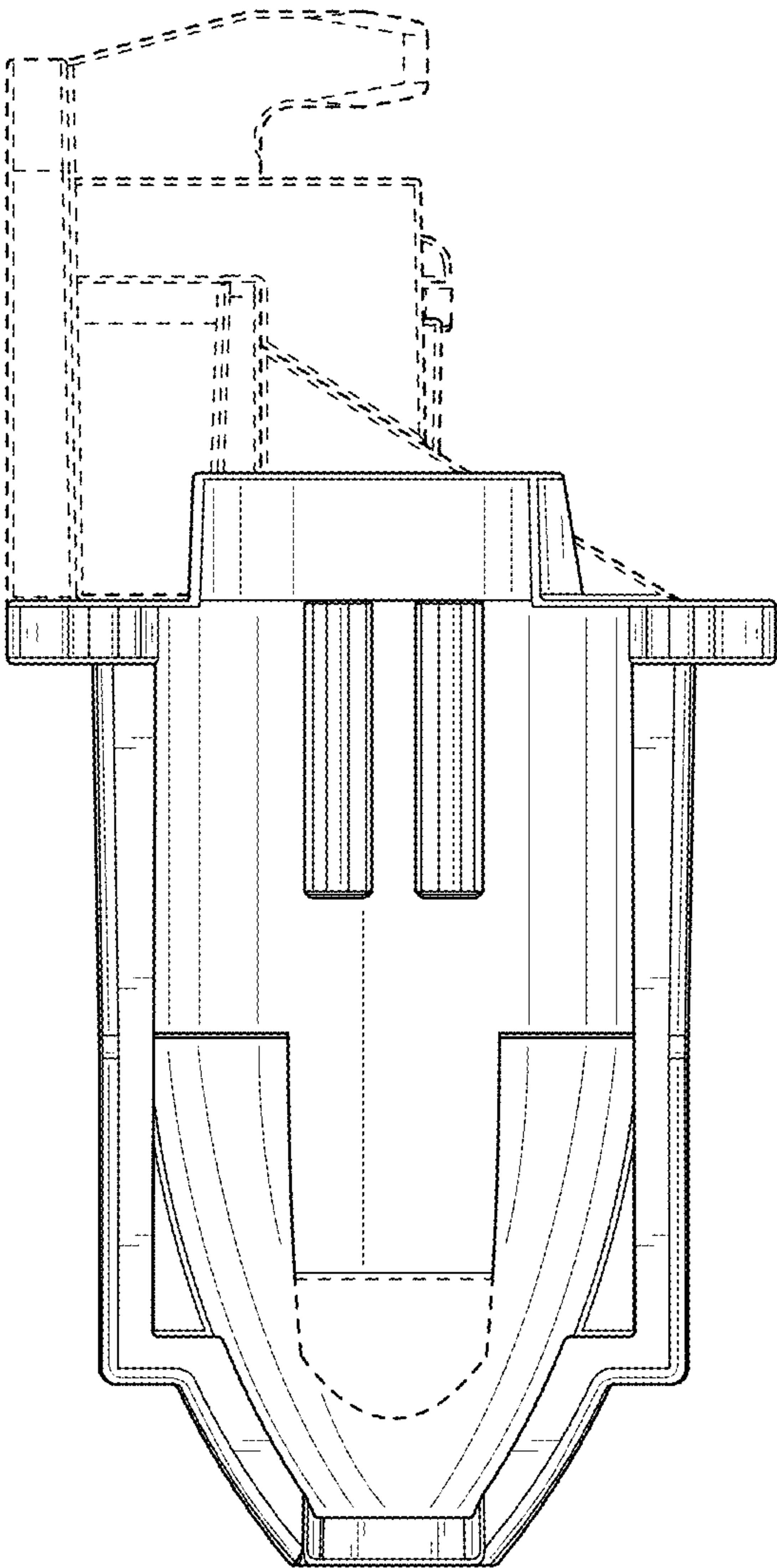

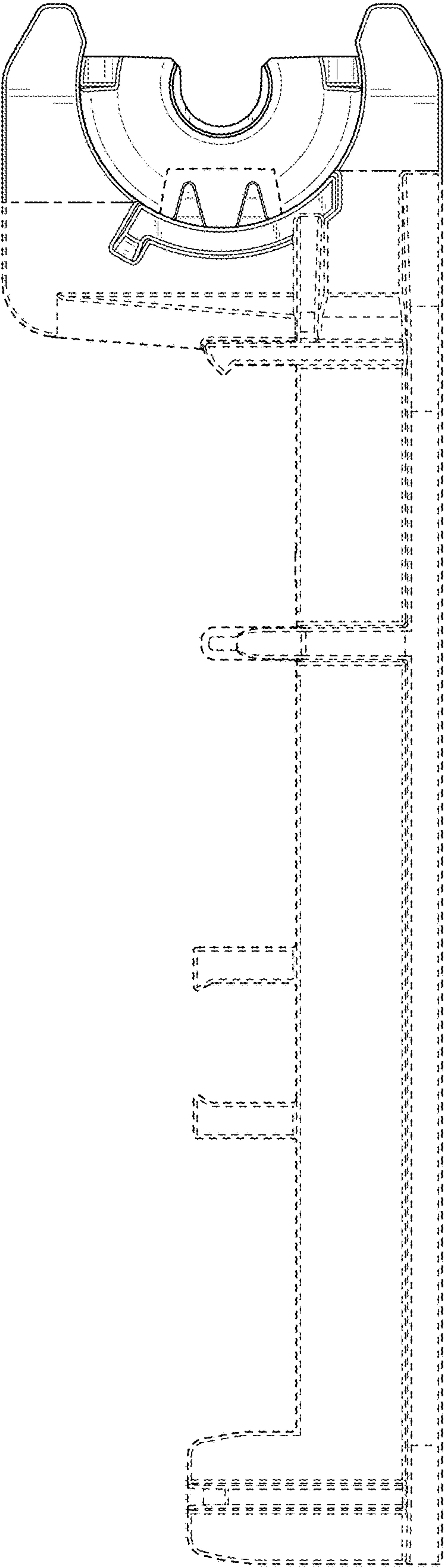

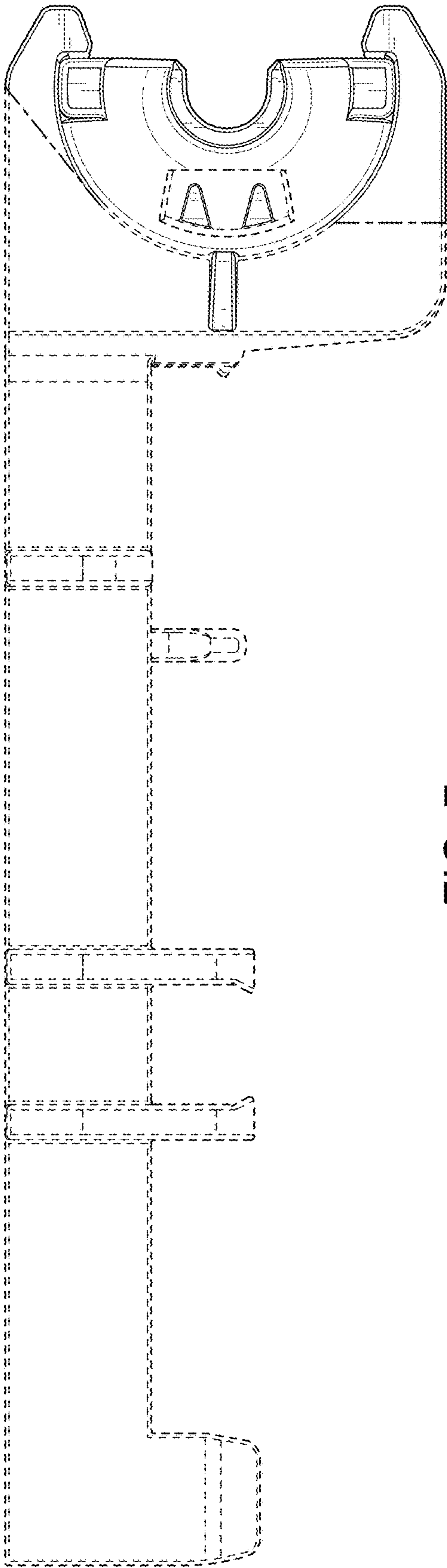
