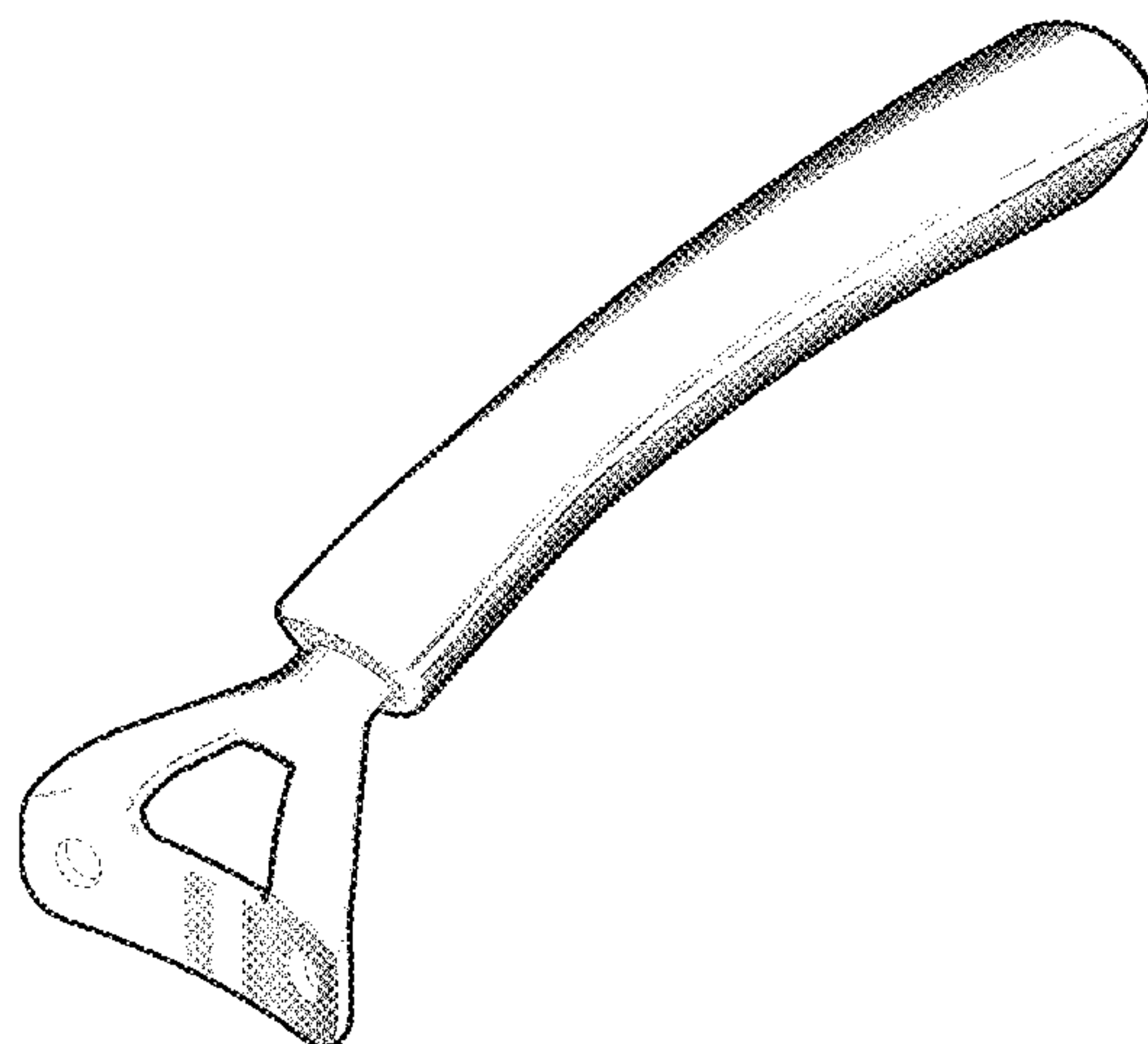
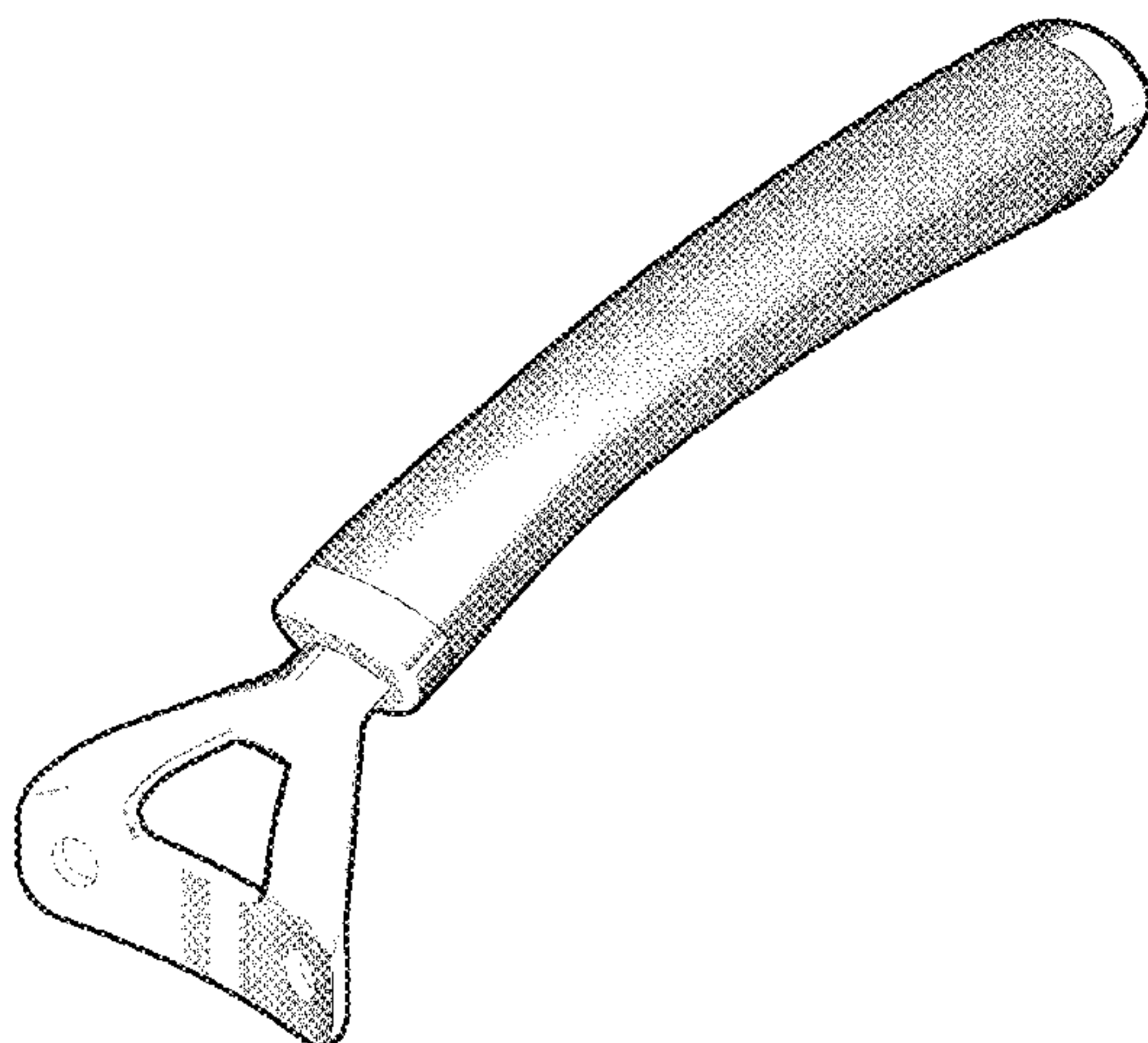
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an elongated side handle for cookware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the “elongated side handle for cookware”, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a back elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the “elongated side handle for cookware”, showing my new design;
FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 12 is a back elevation view thereof.
The first and second embodiments of the invention have the same external curvature and shape.
The dot-dash lines in FIGS. 4 and 10 indicate a portion of the design that has an internal depth and surface curvature that forms not part of the claimed design. The broken lines in FIGS. 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11 and 12 are for illustrative purposes only, depicting the environment of the new design, forming no part thereof as claimed.

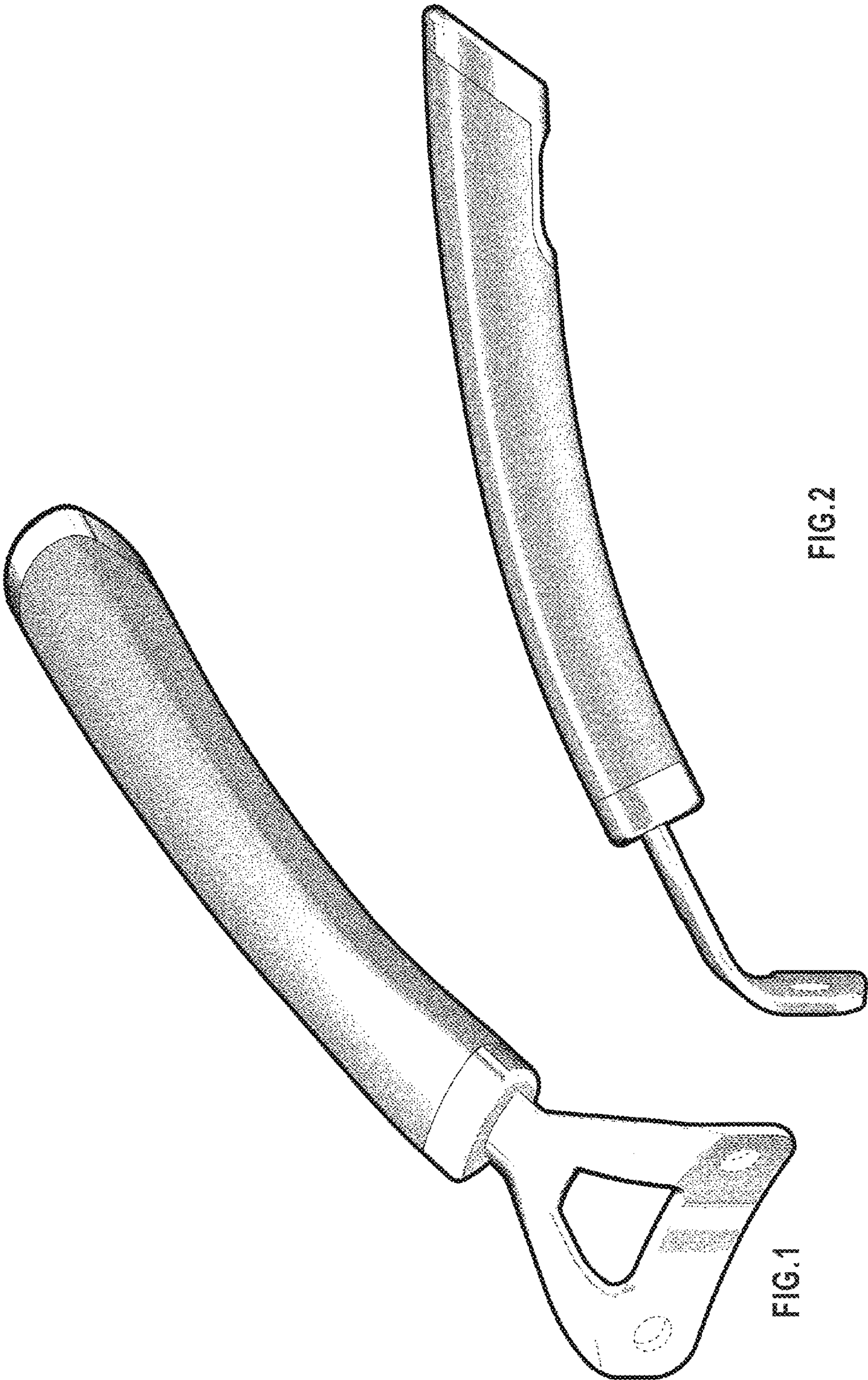

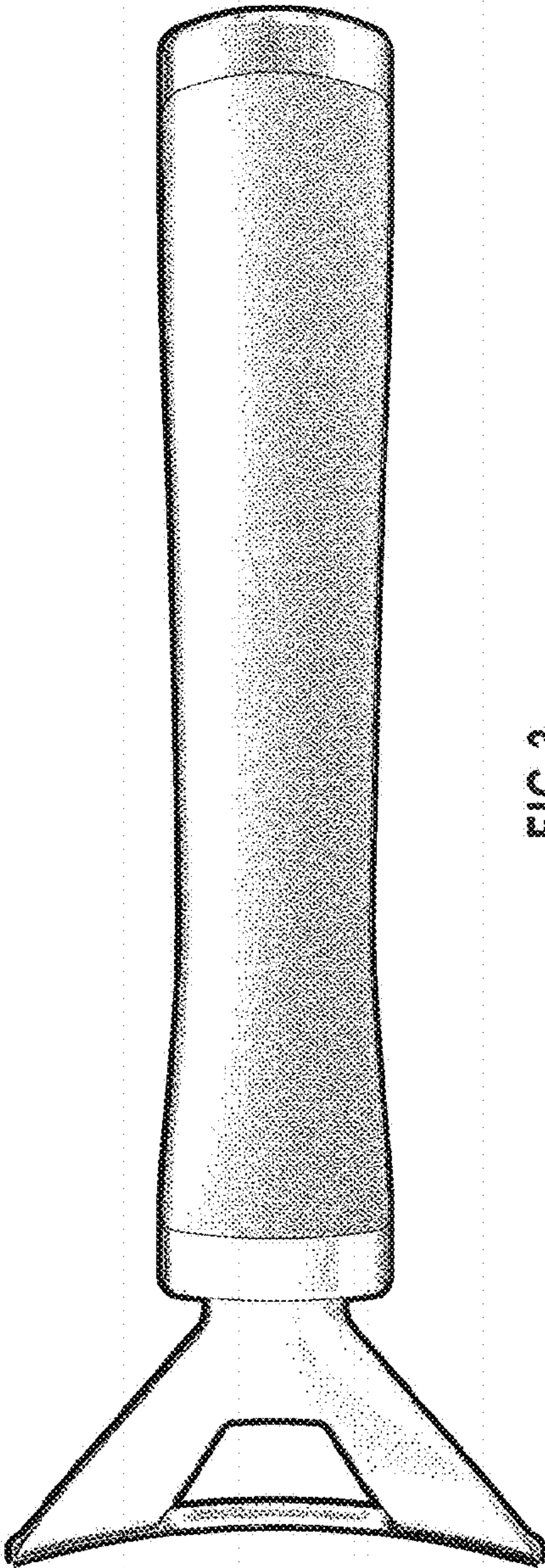

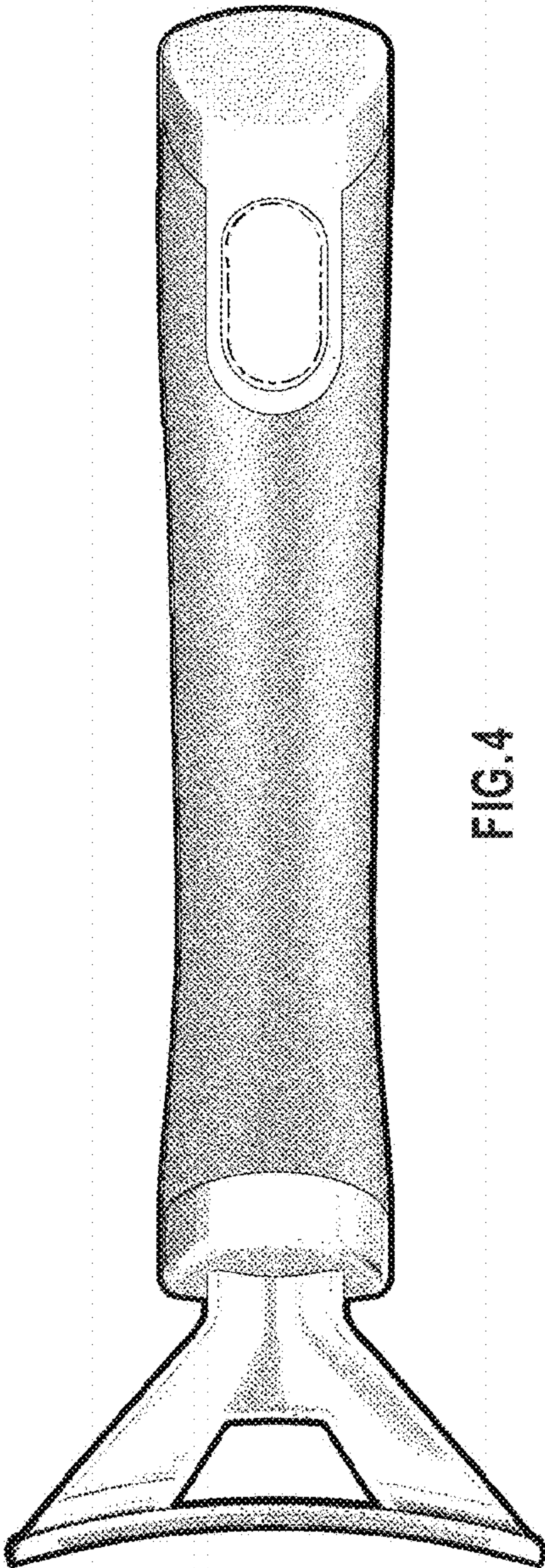

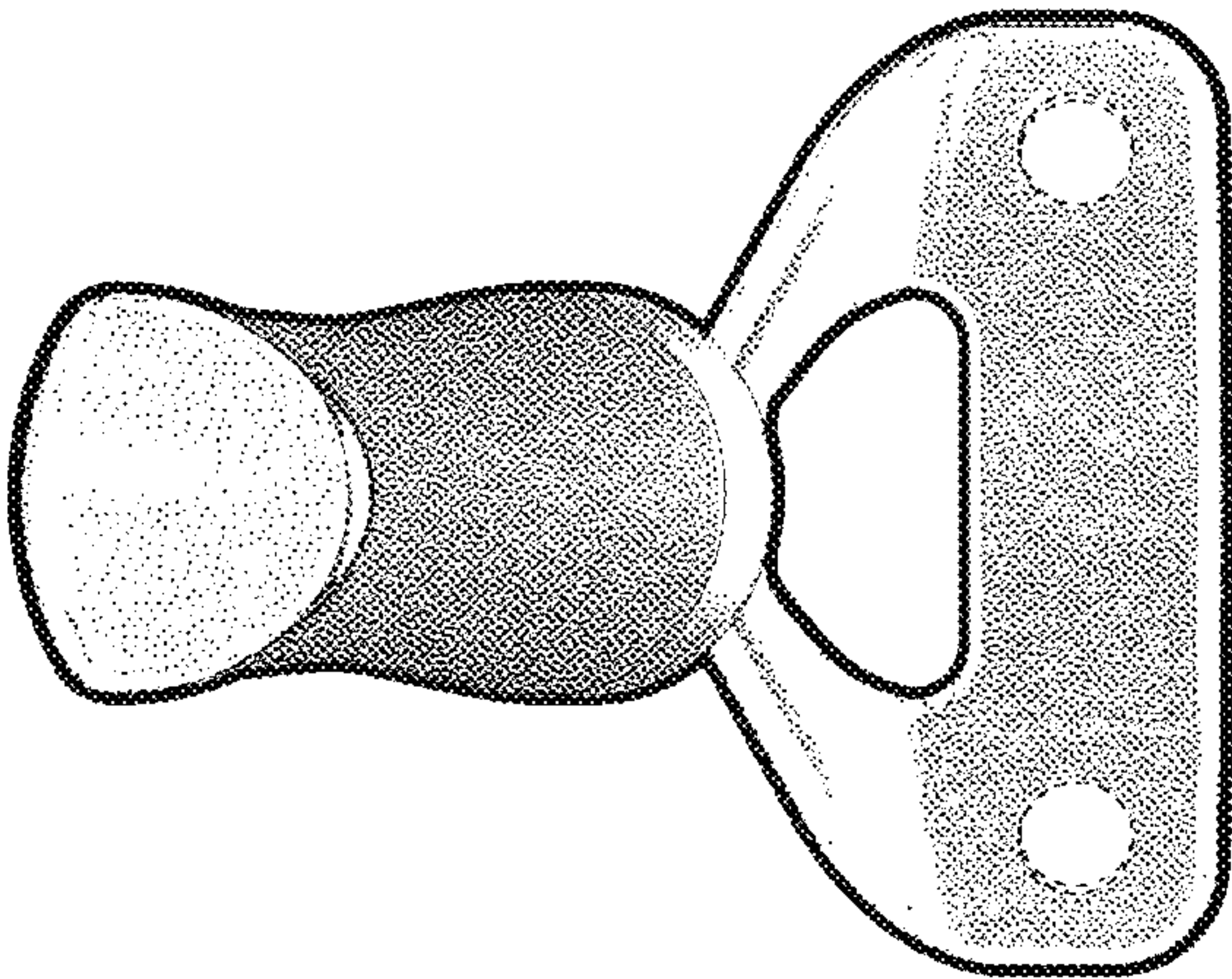

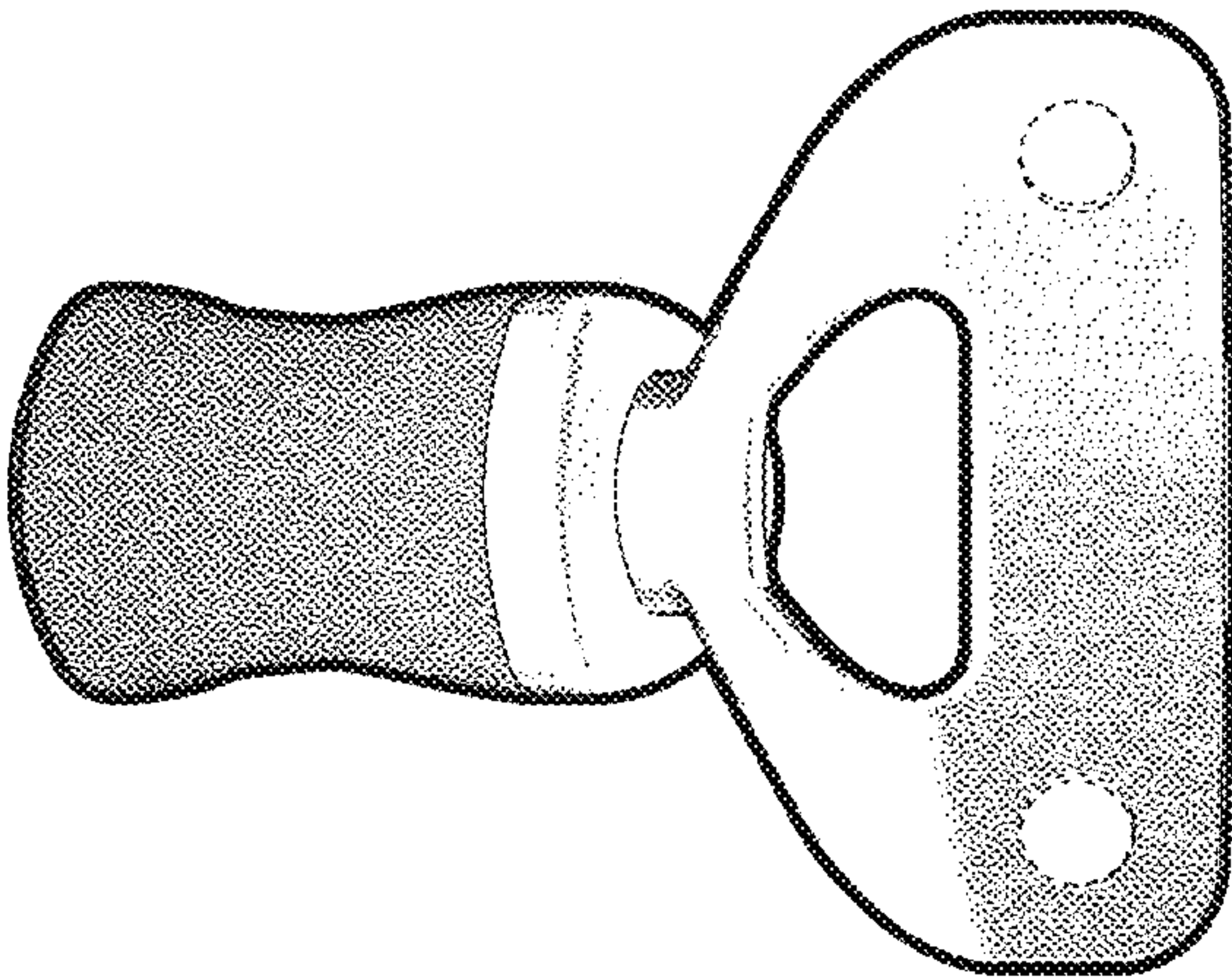

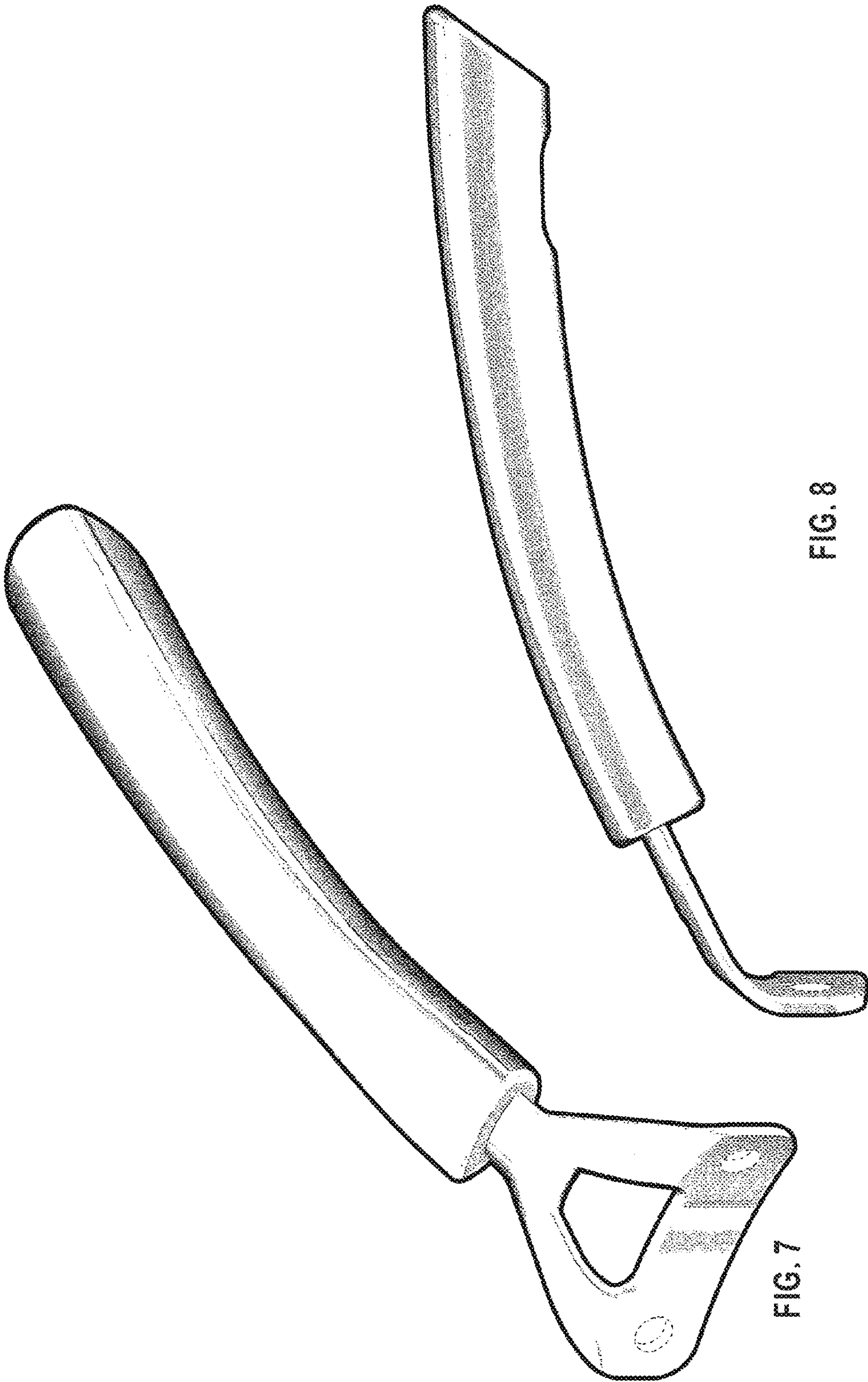

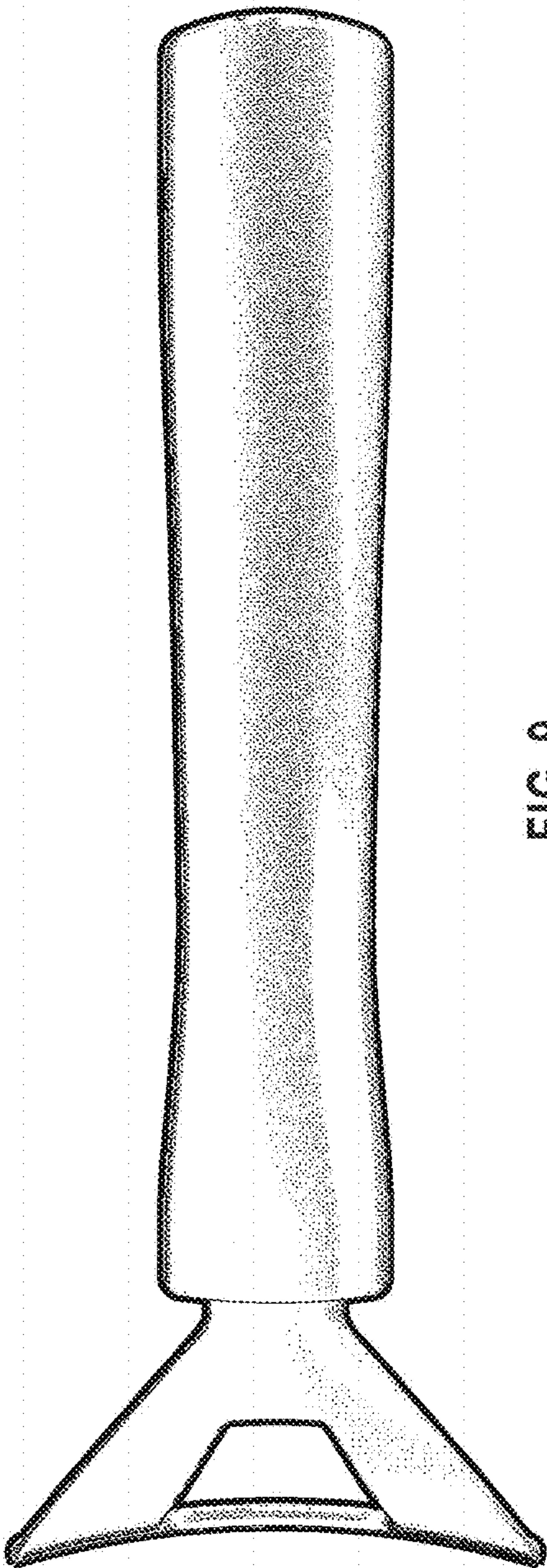

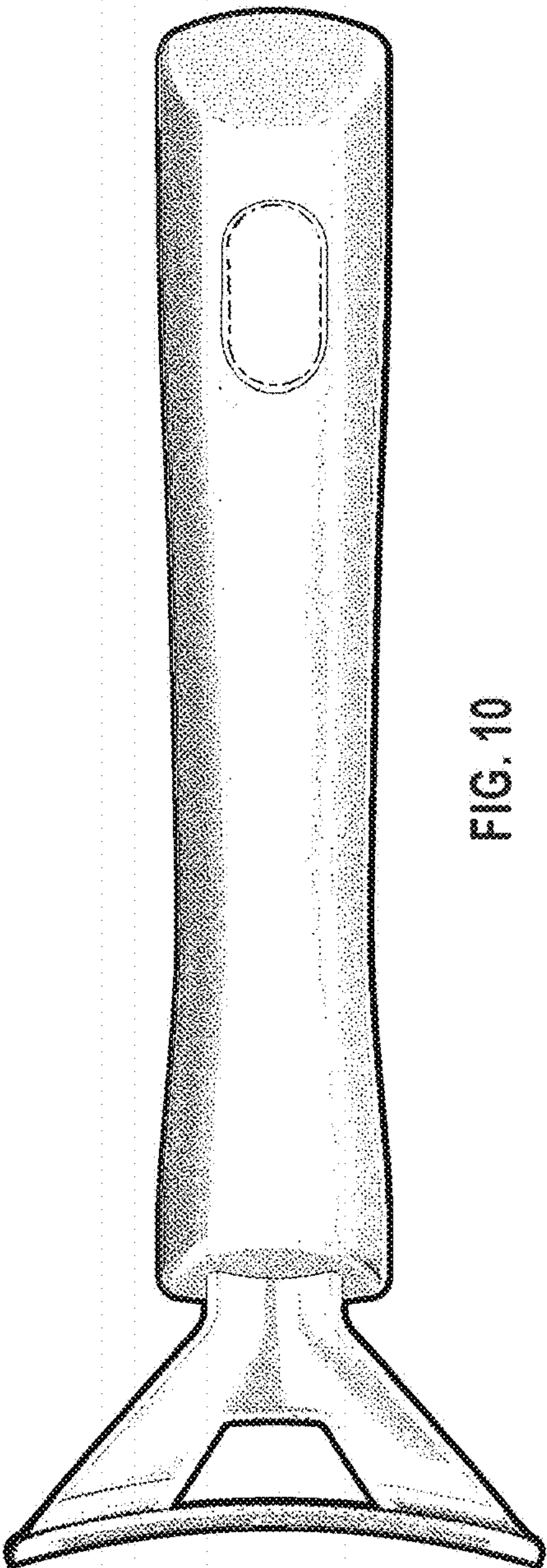

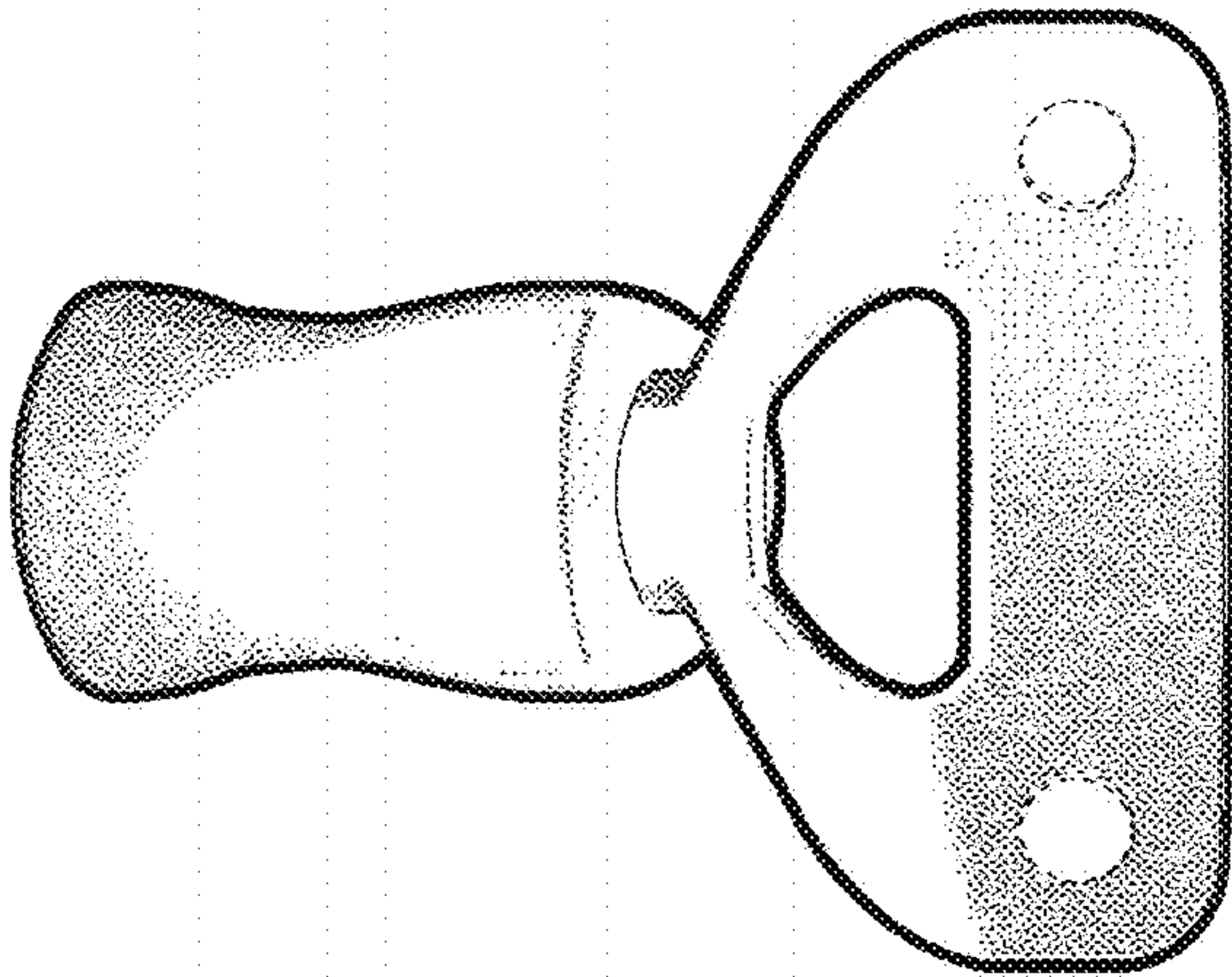

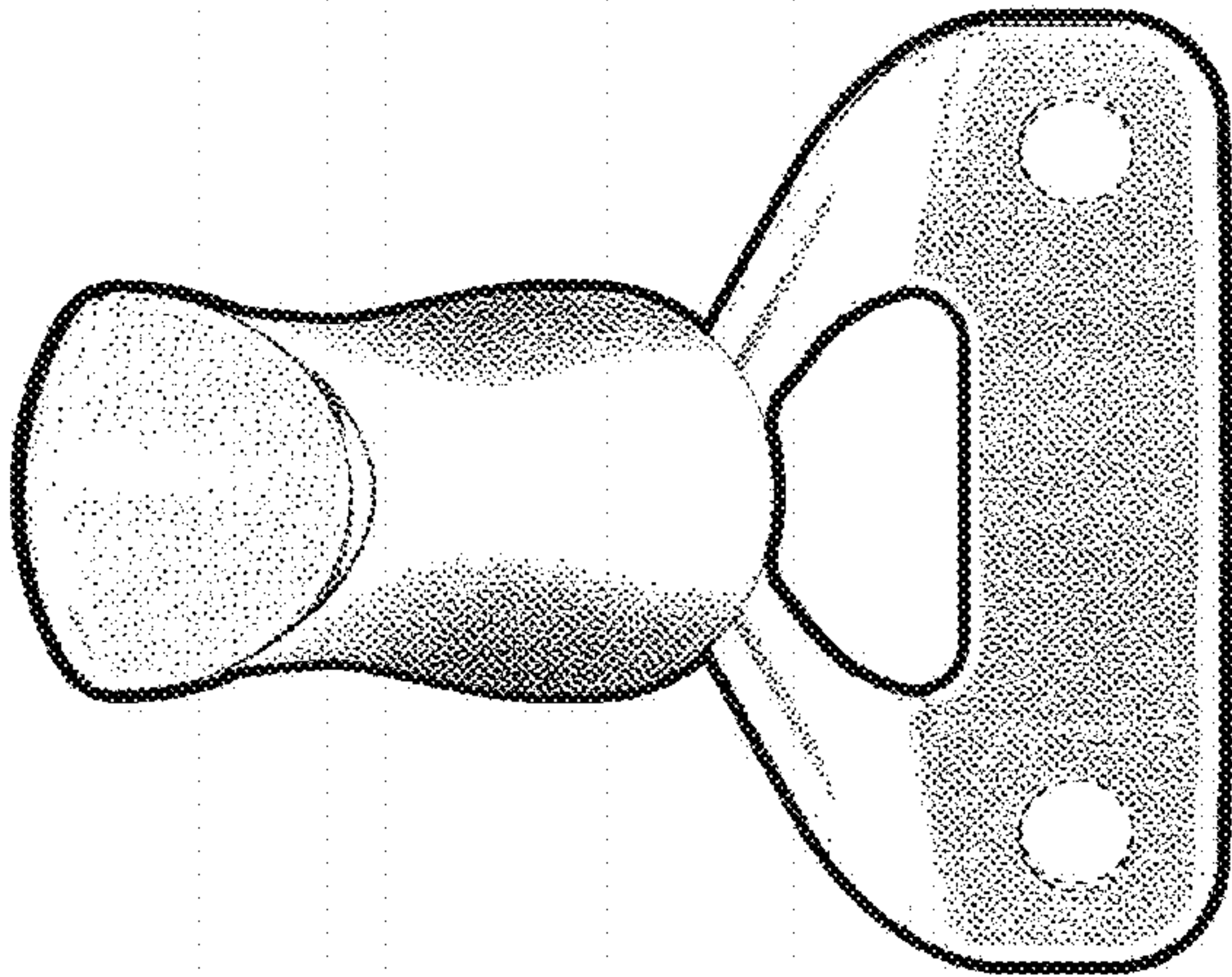
