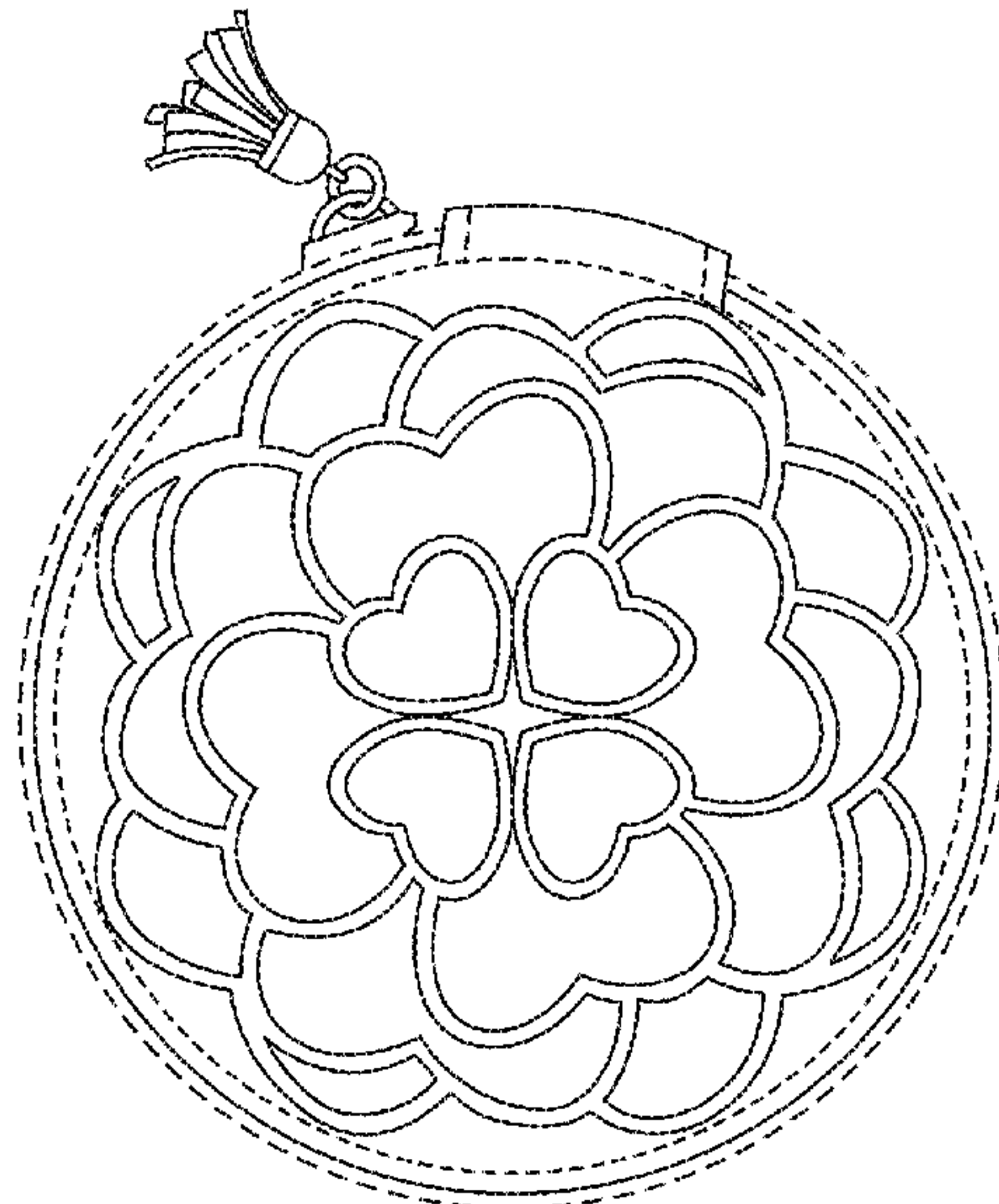

FIG. 1 is a front view of a wallet, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 5 is a first side view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is an opposite side view thereof. The broken lines represent claimed stitching. The broken lines on the front and rear surfaces of the wallet represent claimed stitching. The broken lines on the outer edges of the wallet, depicting a zipper, represent unclaimed portions of the wallet.

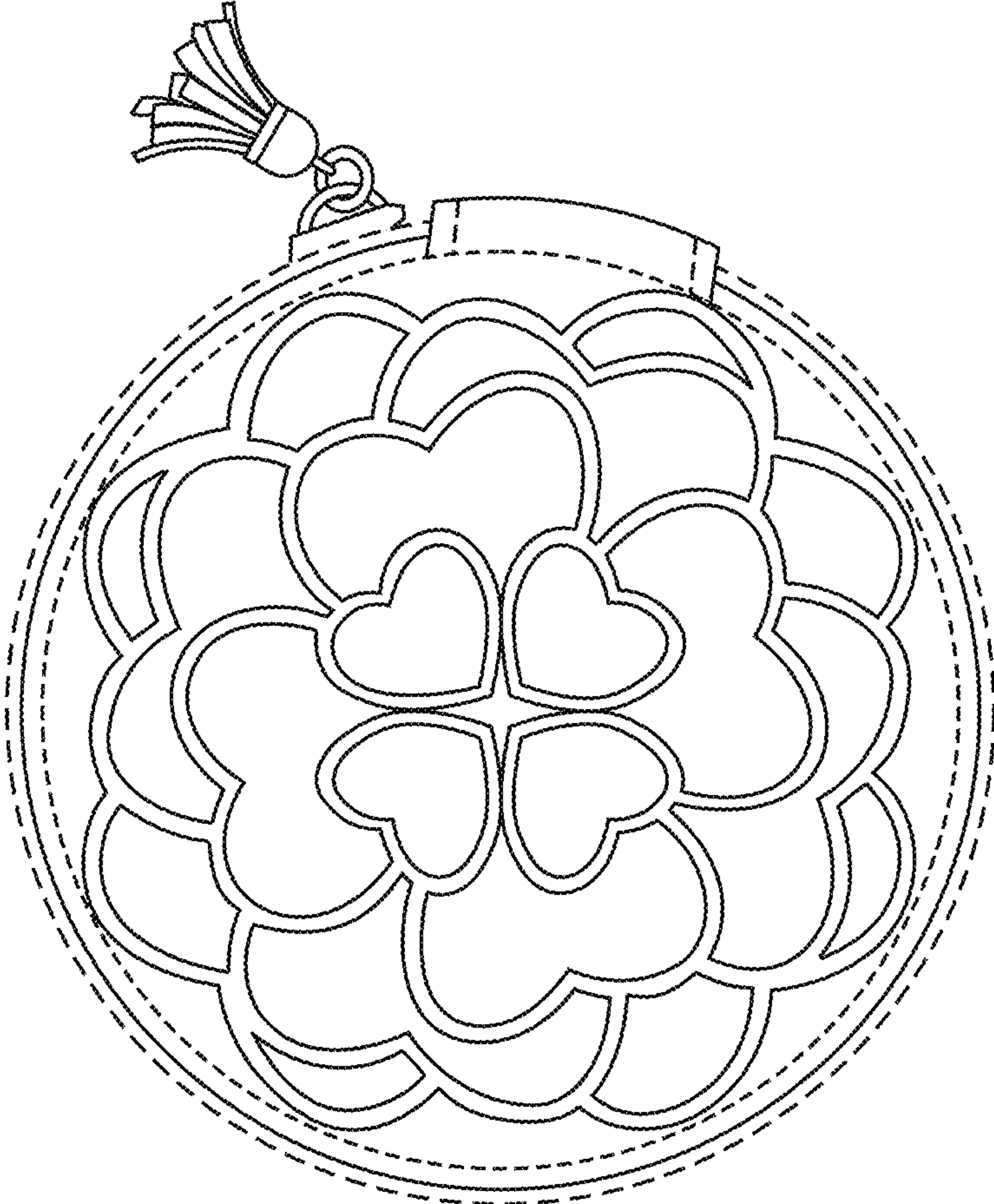

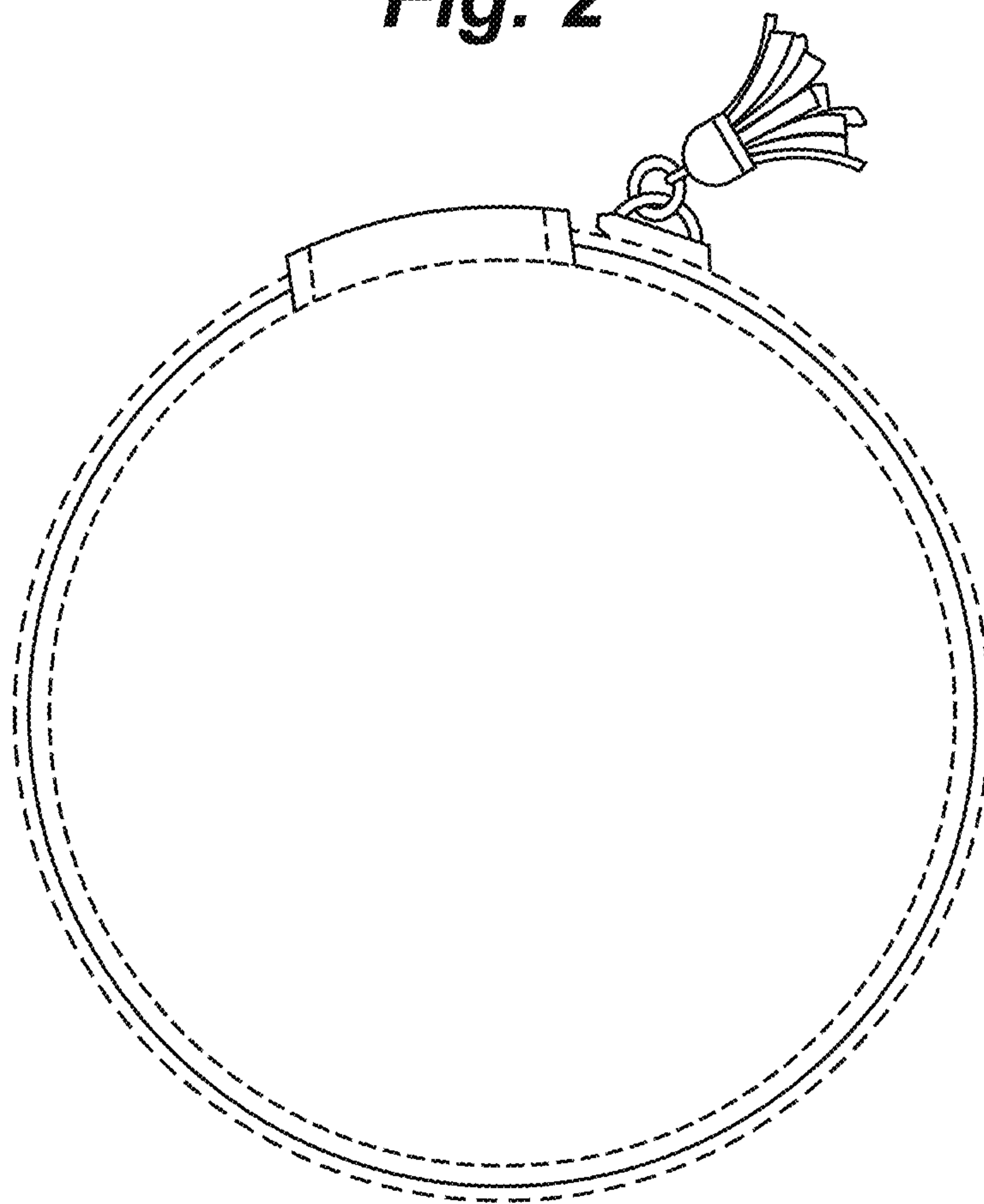

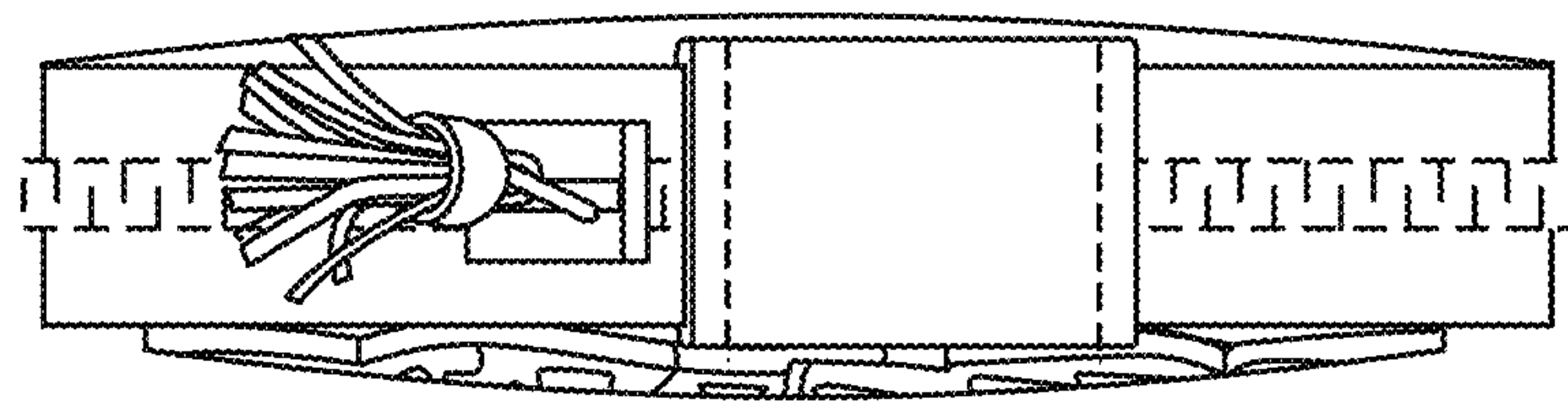

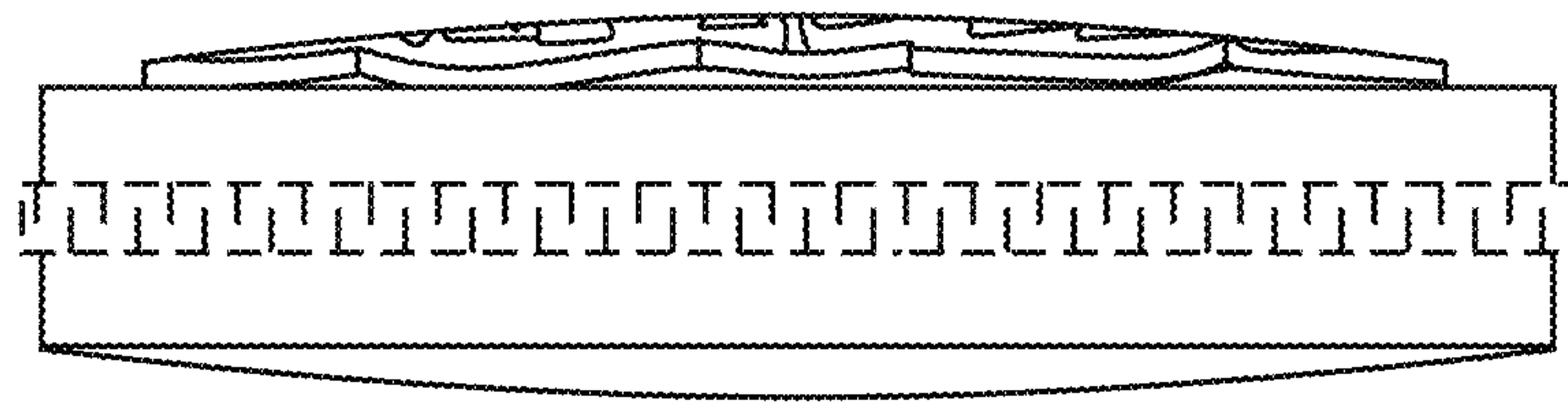

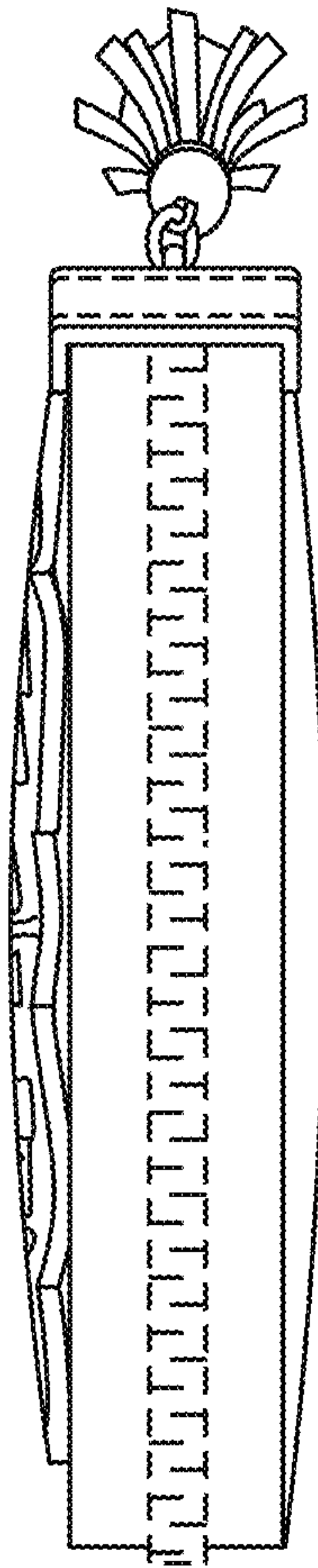
