DESCRIPTION

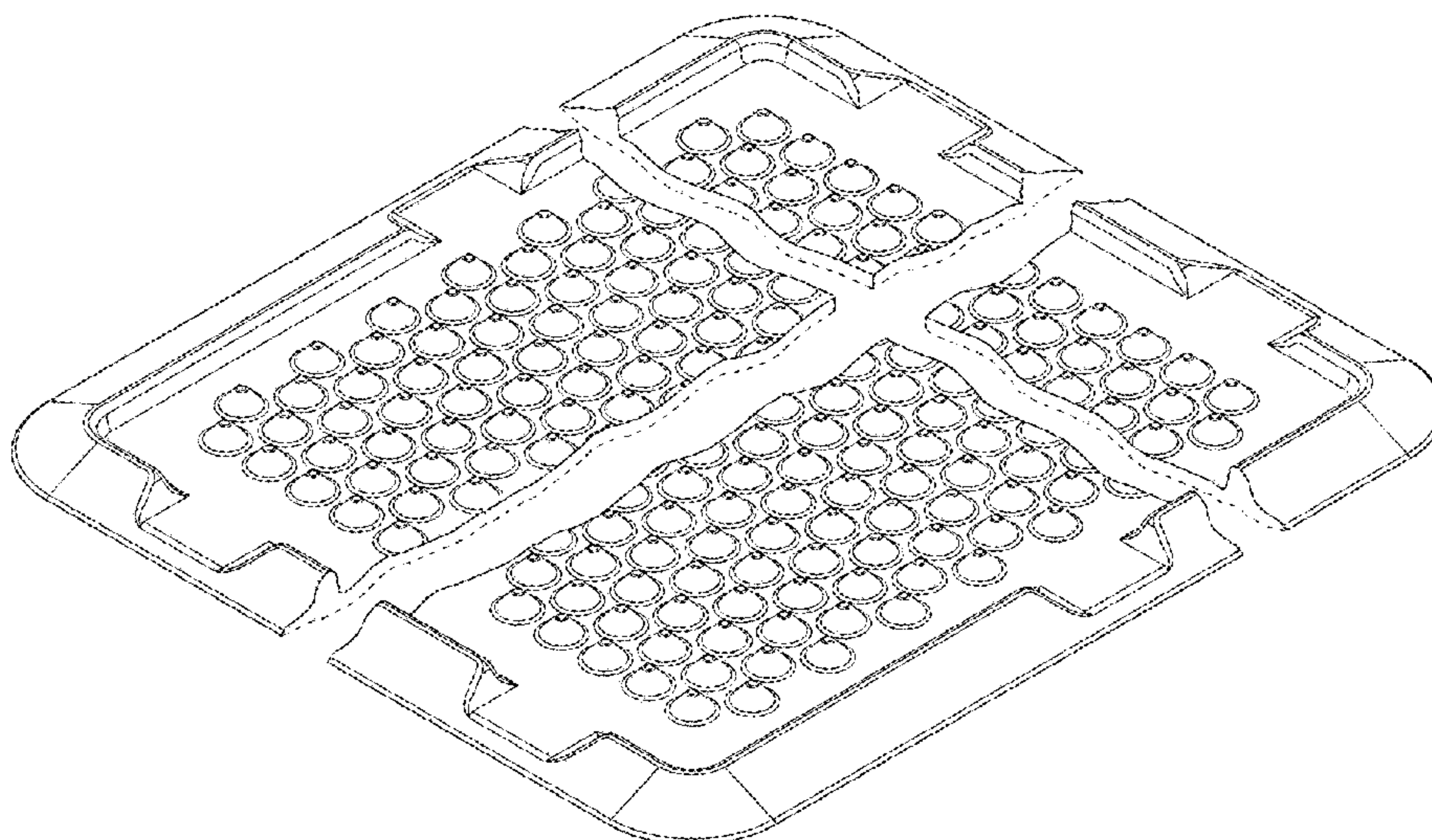
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 1 is an enlarged partial perspective view of FIGS. 6-8 showing our new design, sections of the outdoor mat are shown broken away to more clearly illustrate the details of the design;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of FIG. 1

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of FIG. 1, the left side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken across line 5-5 in FIG. 1;

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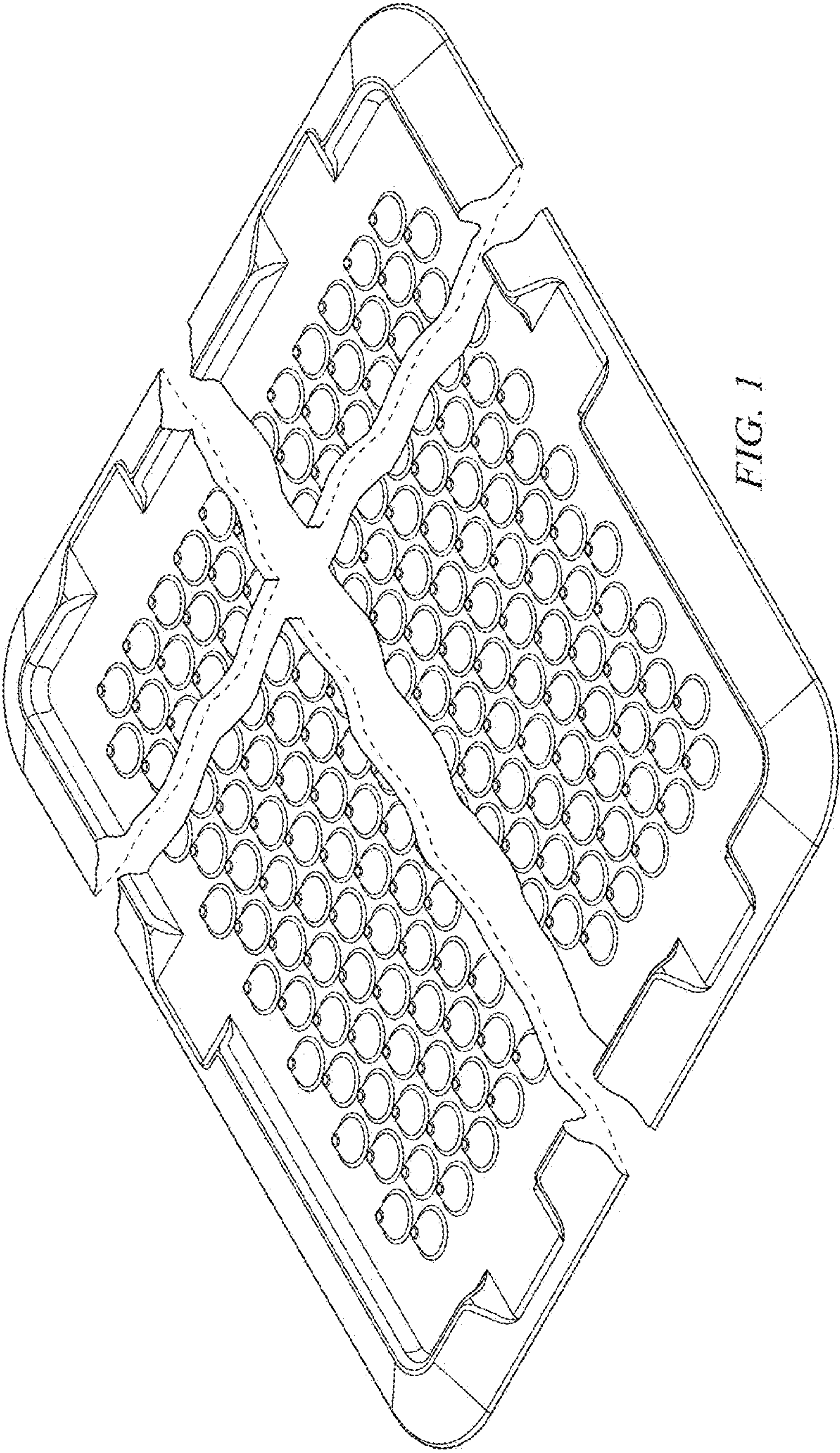

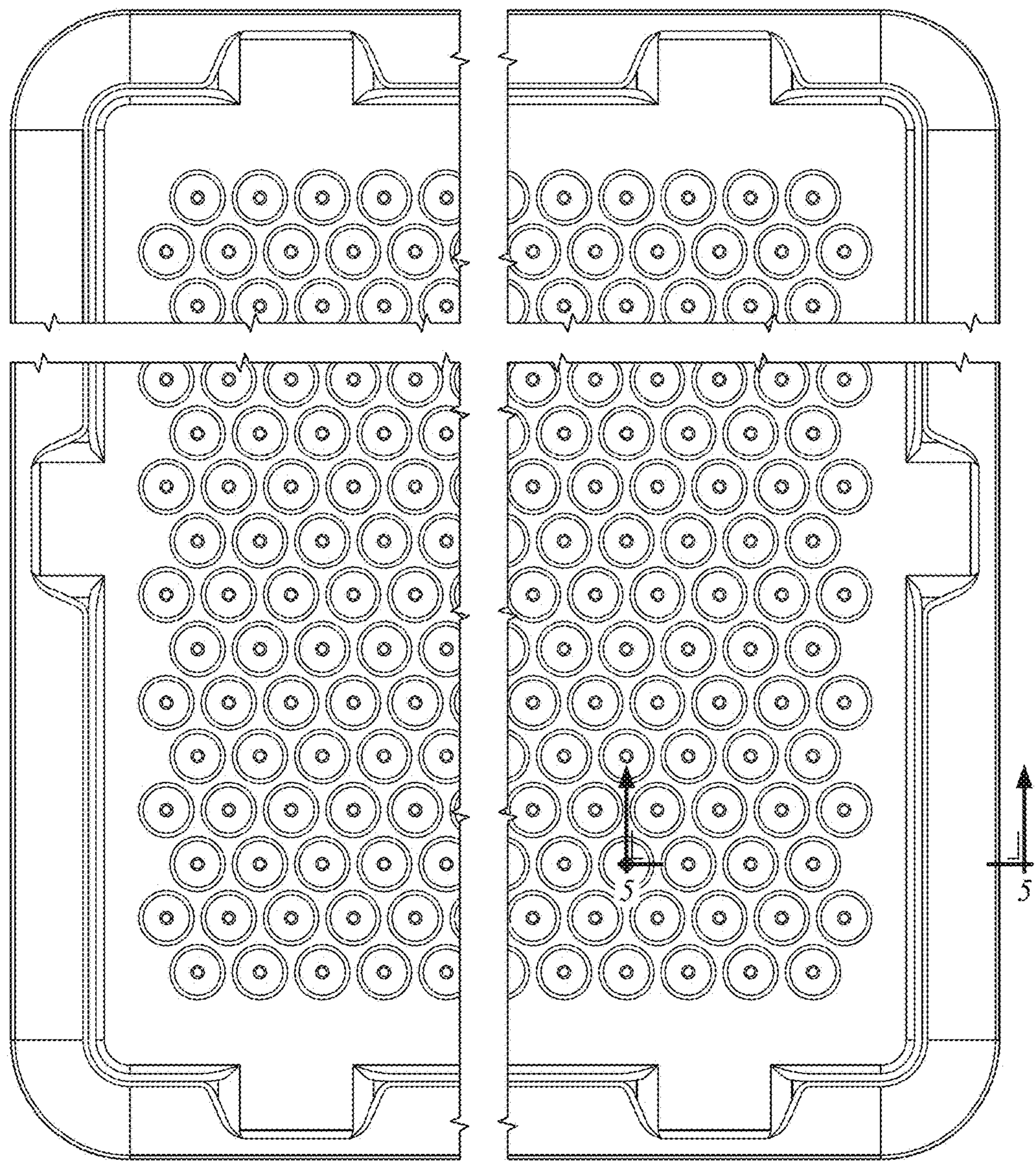

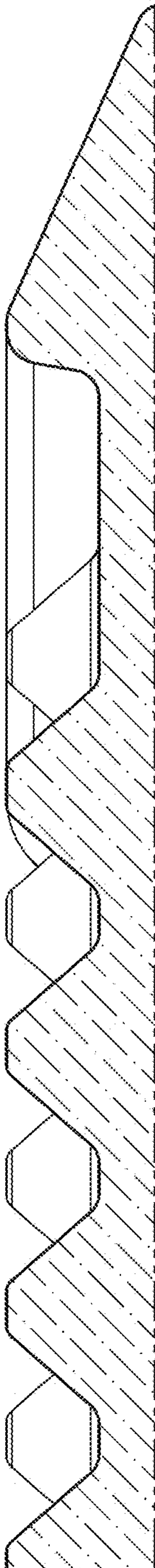
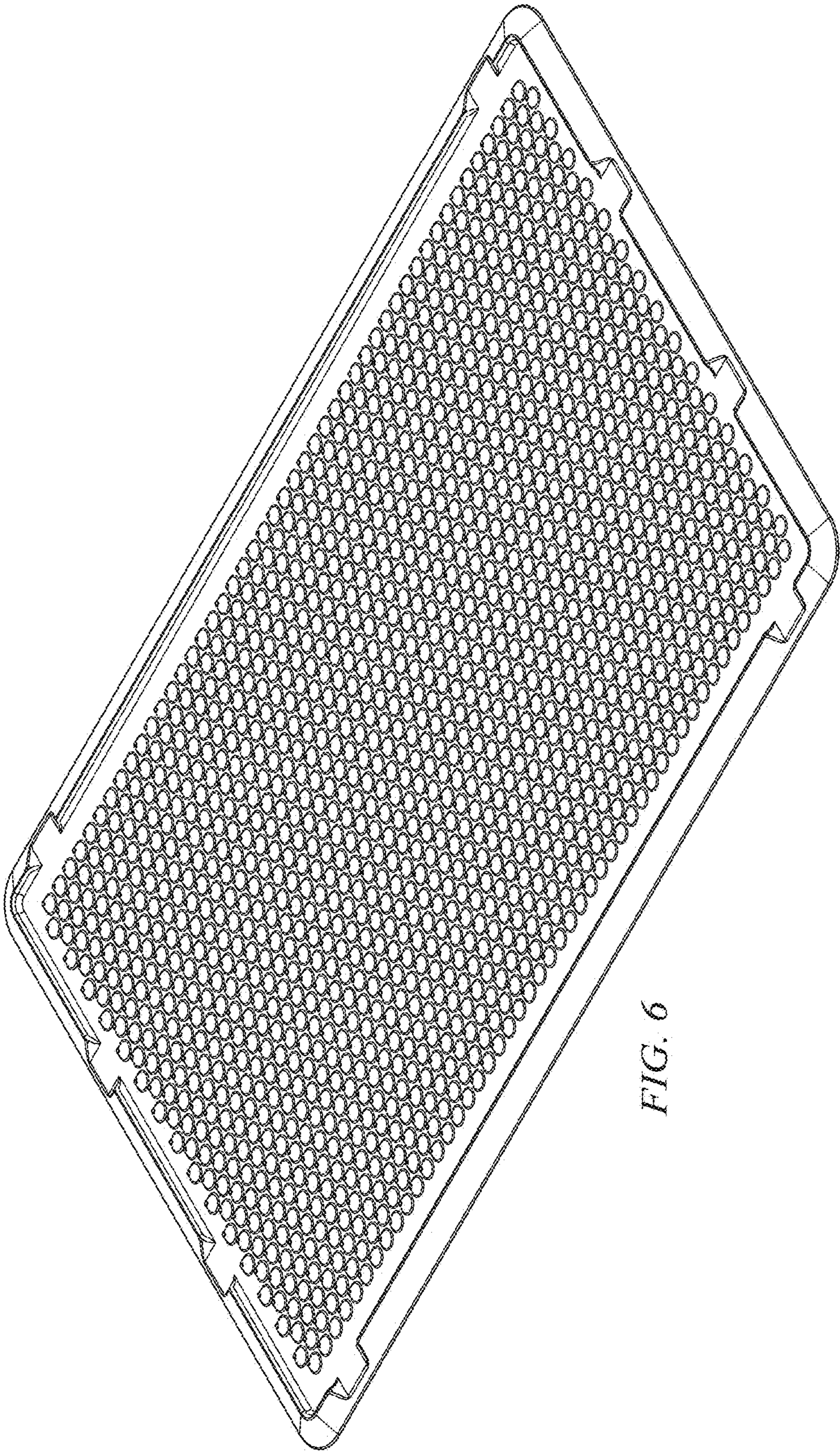

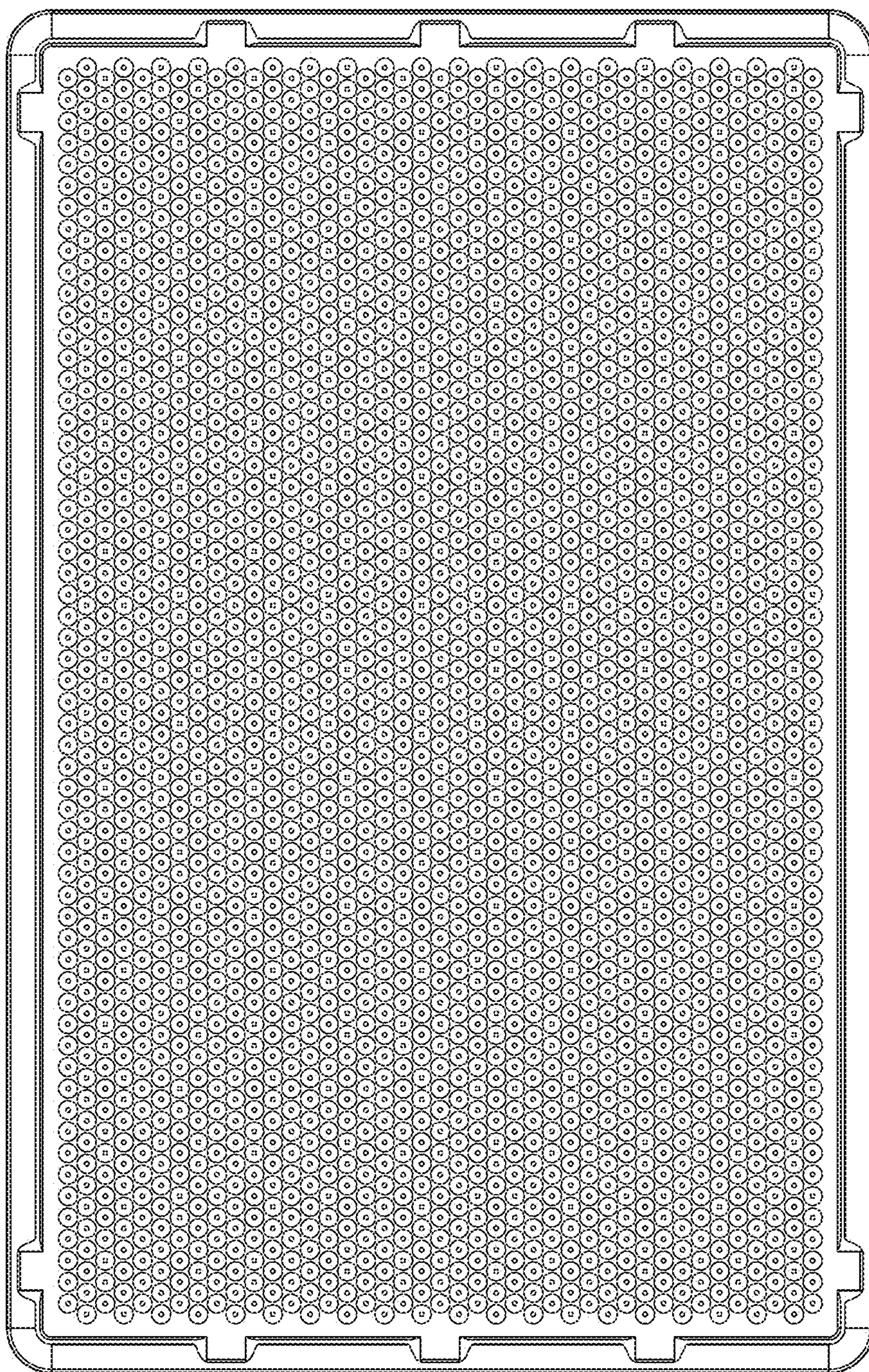

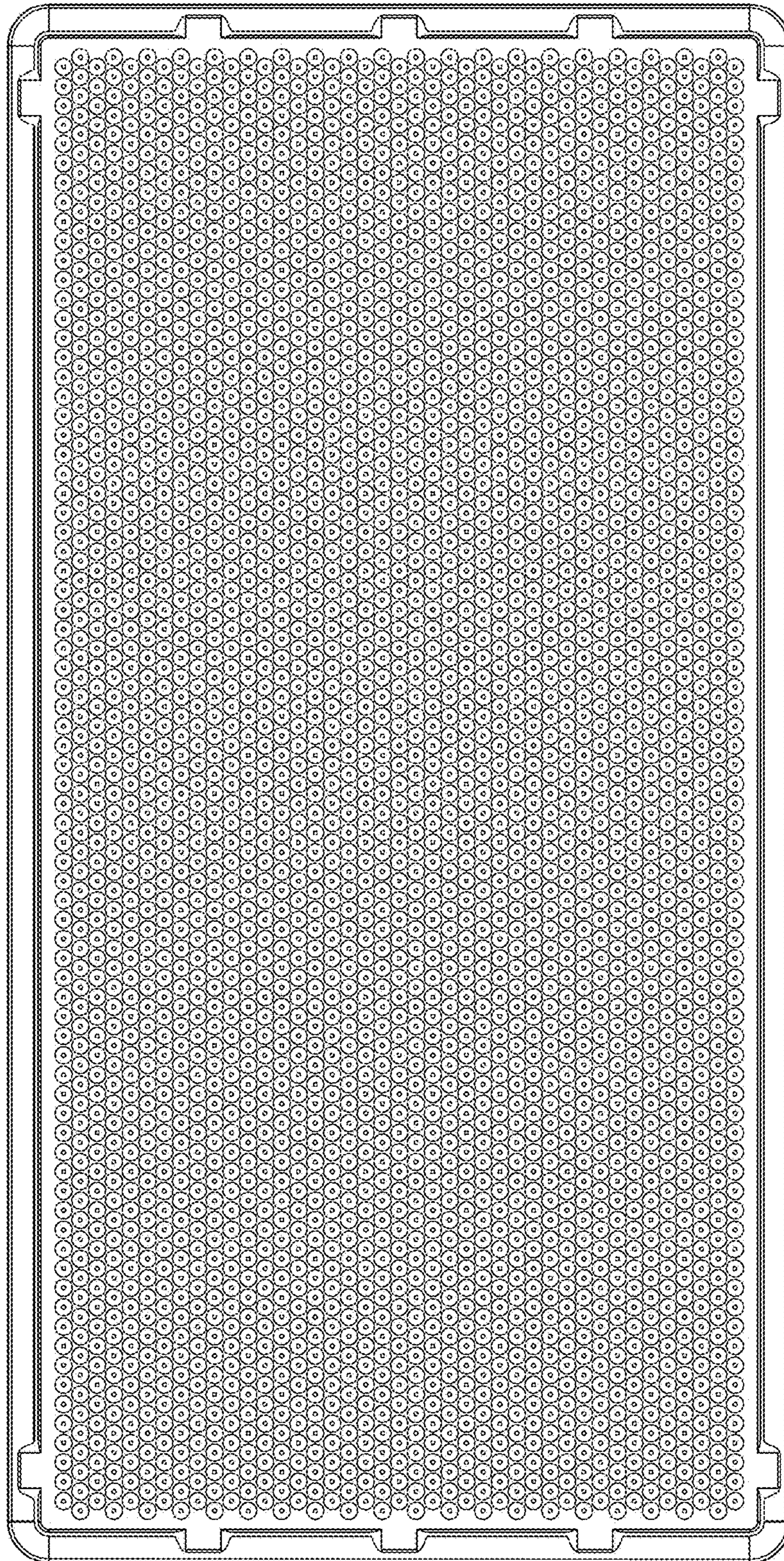
