FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

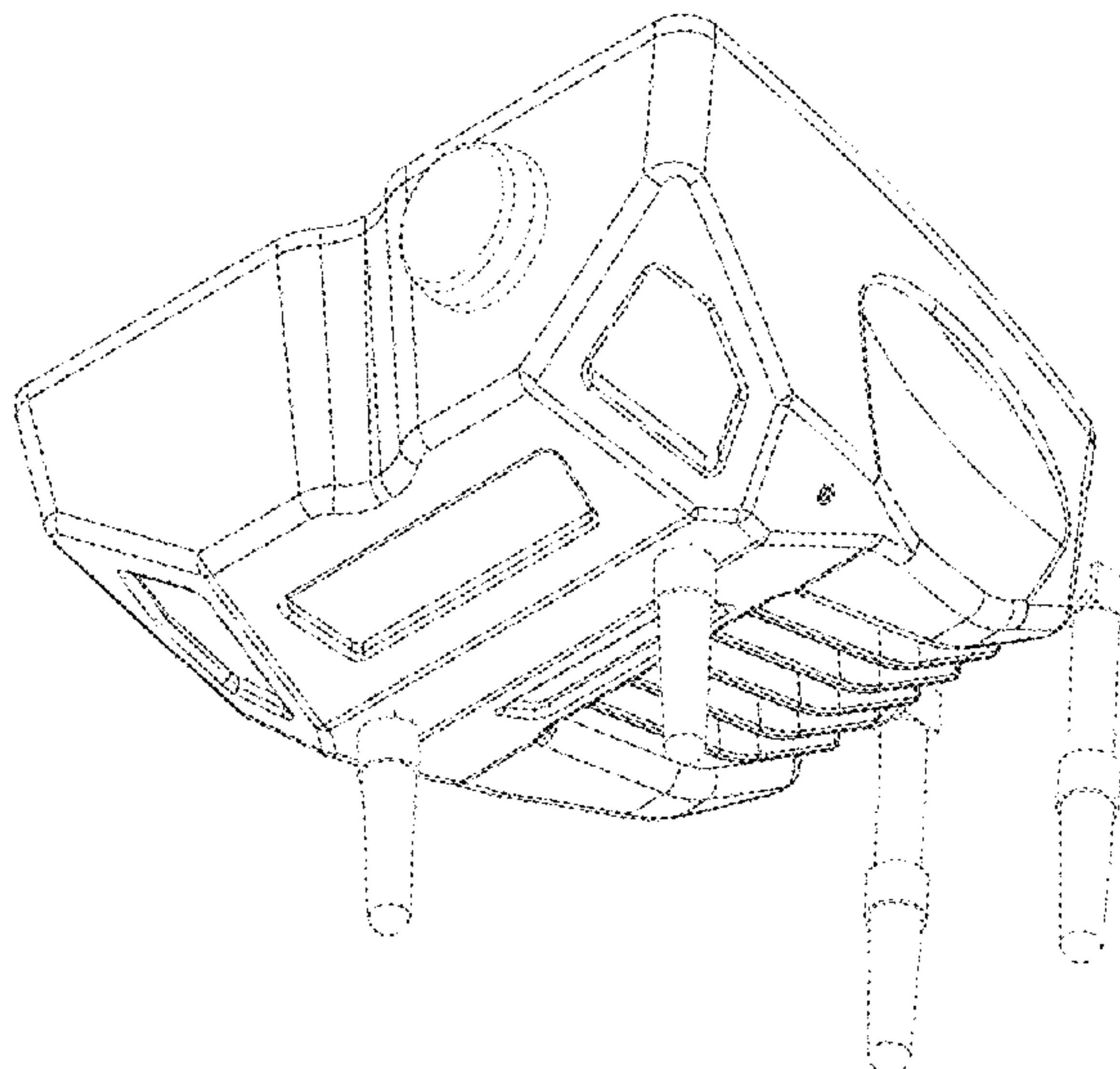
FIG. 4 is a side thereof, the opposite side view being the same;

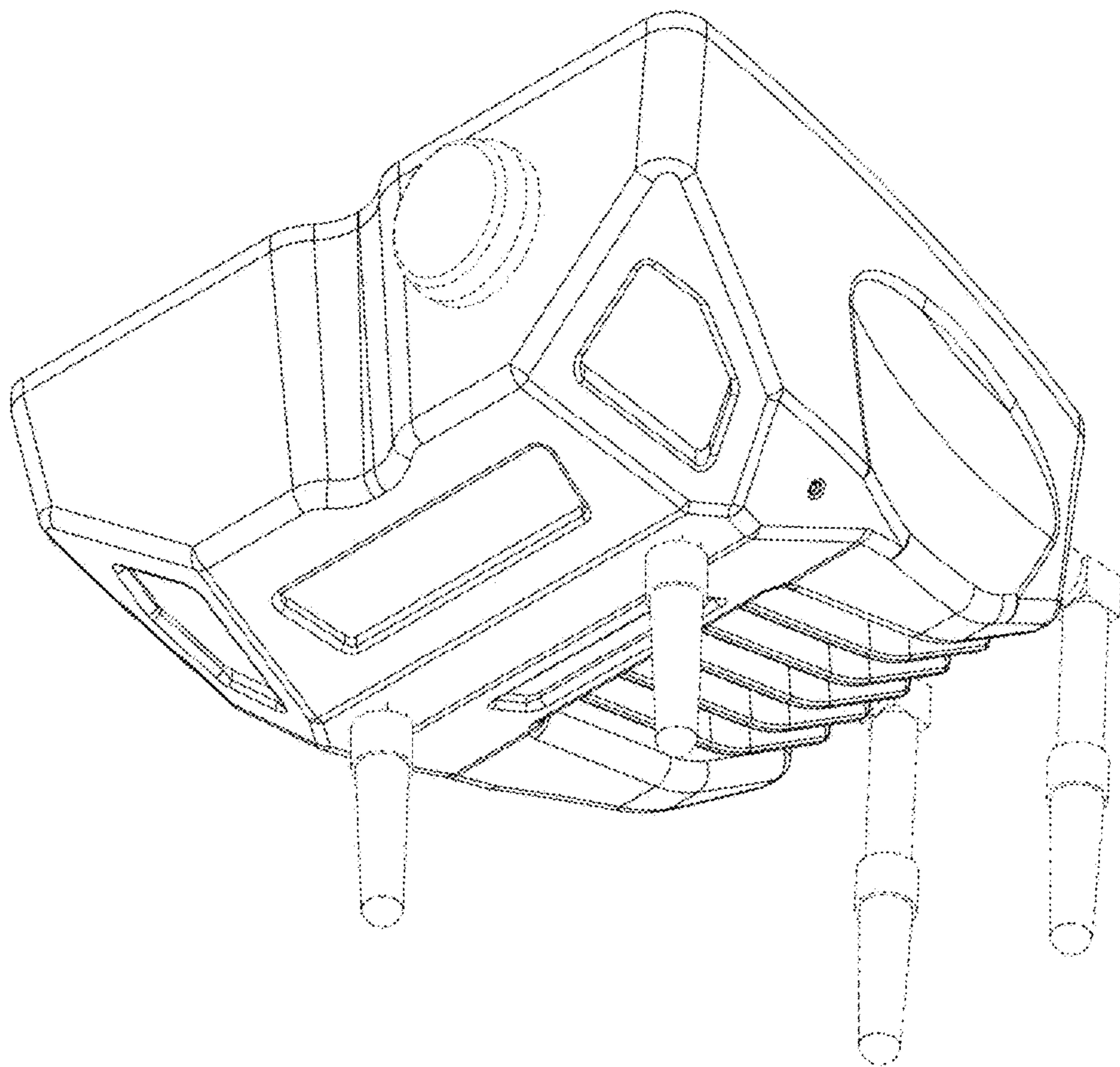

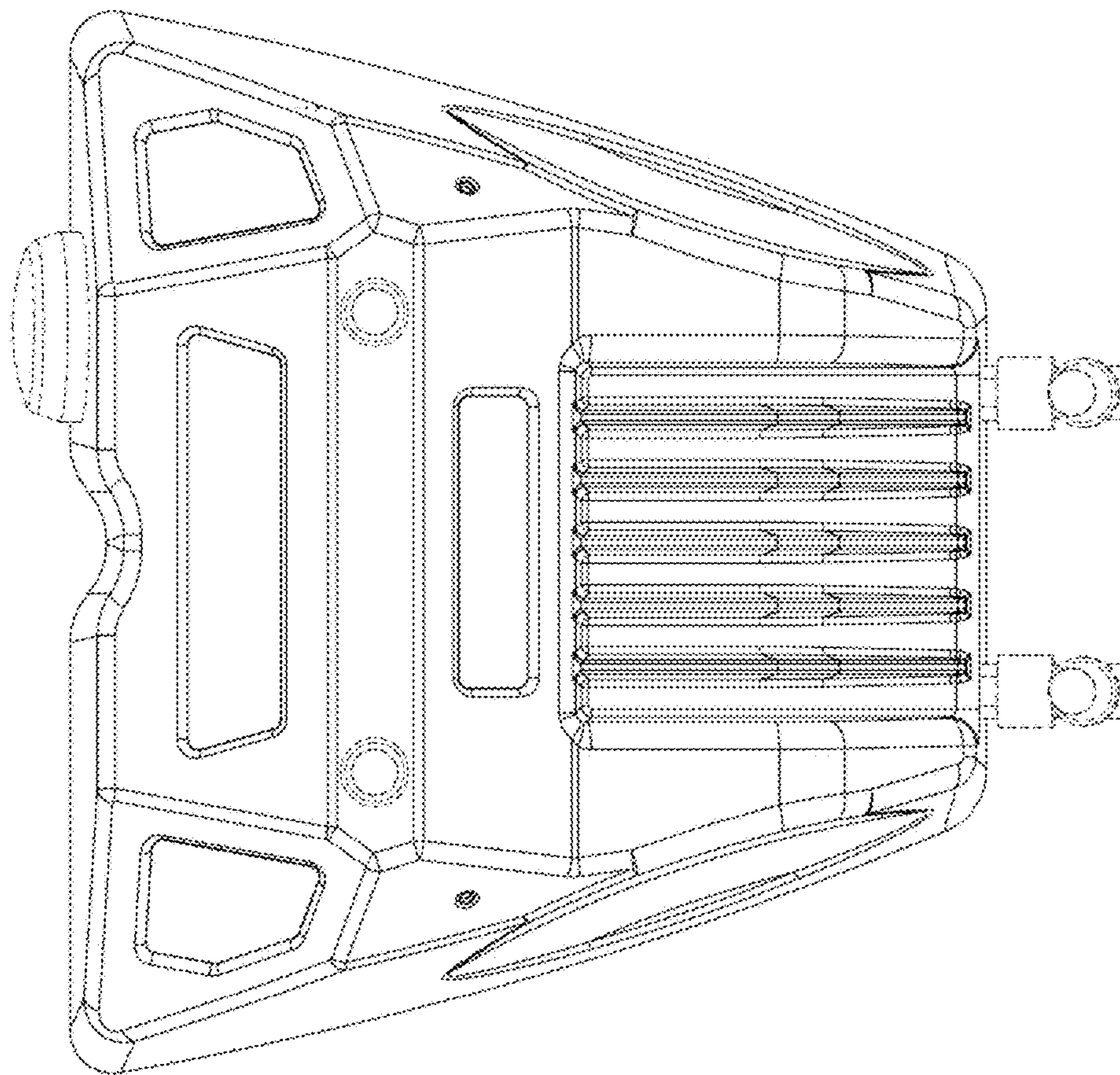

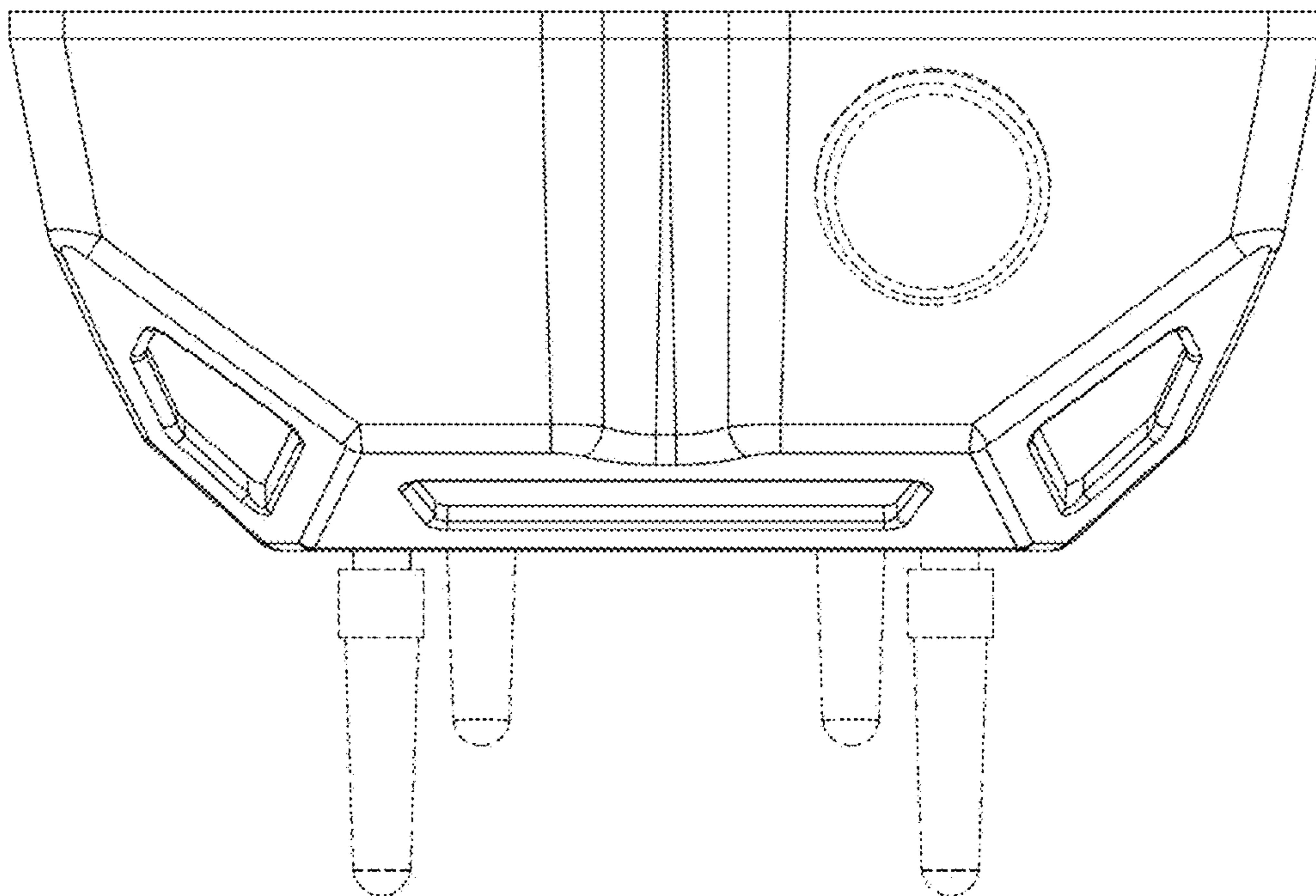

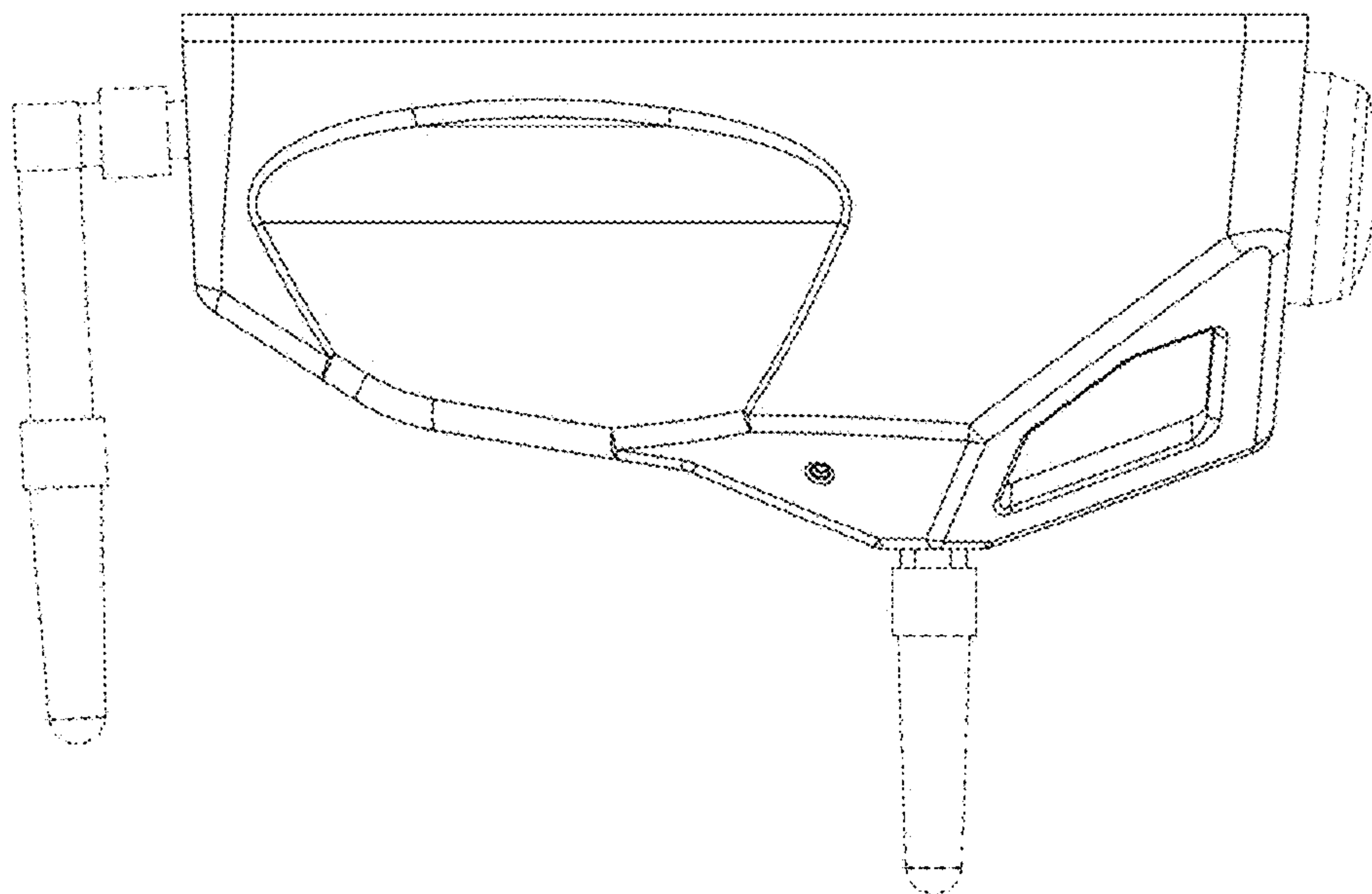

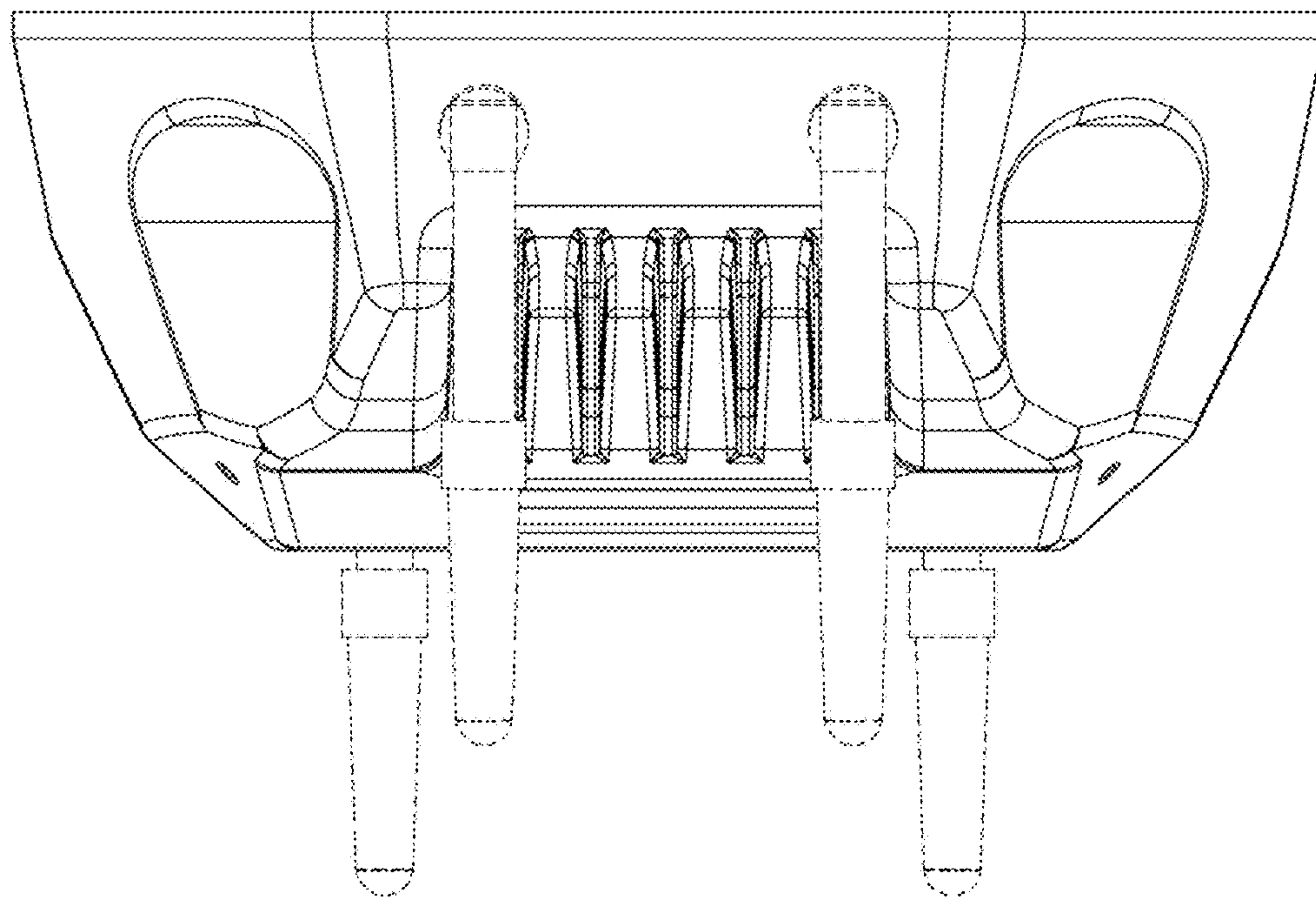

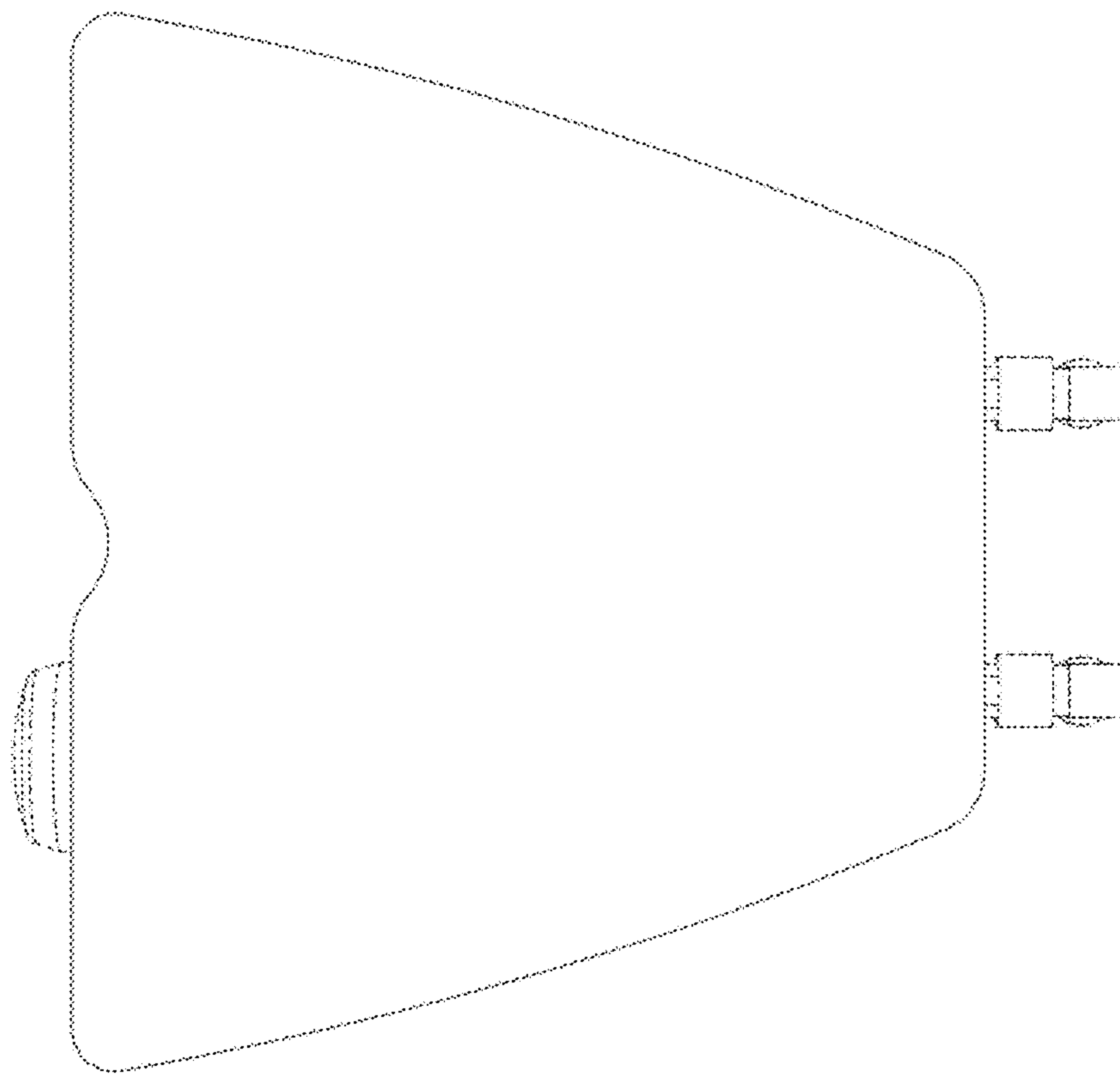
