FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;

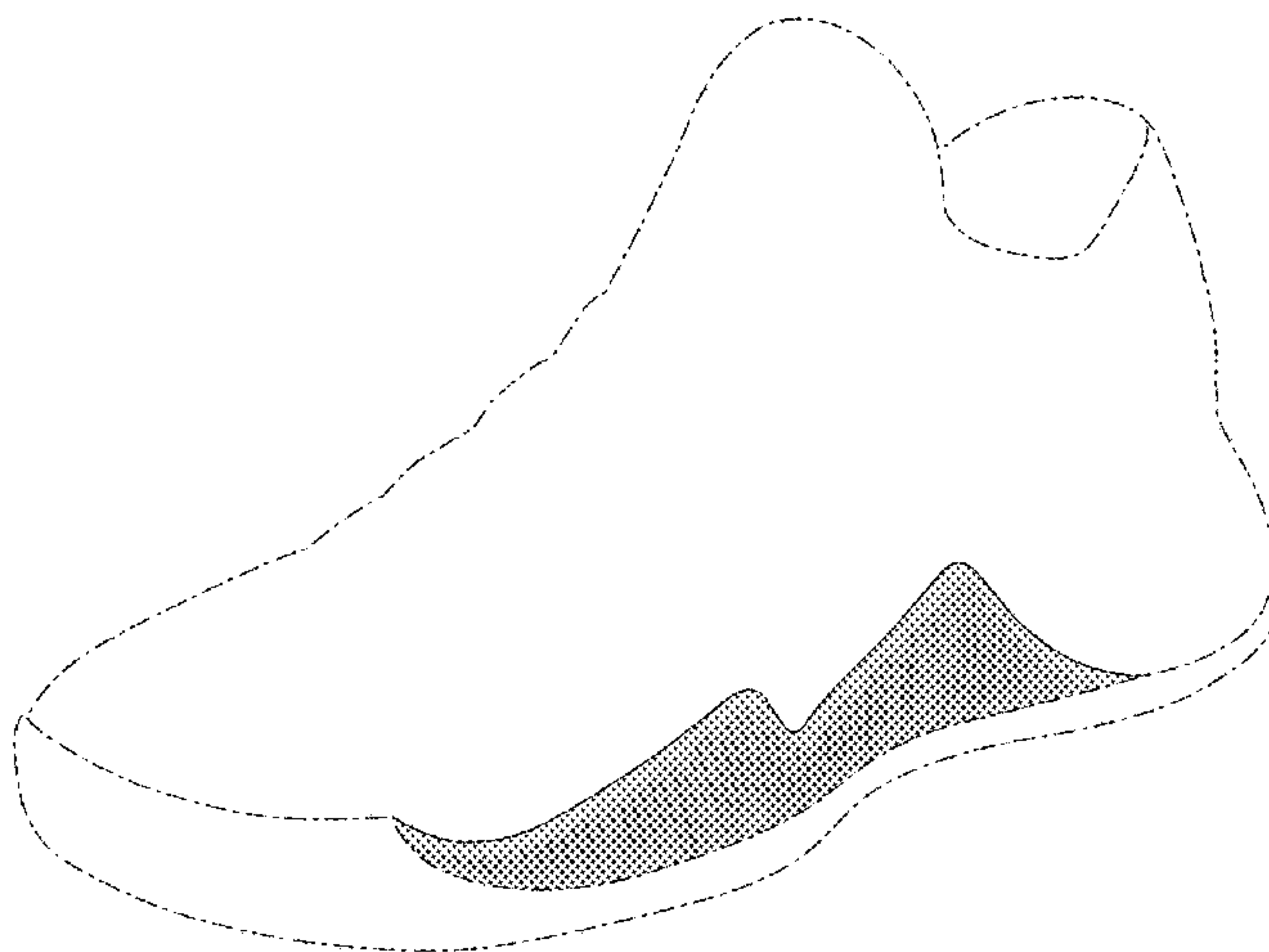
FIG. 4 is an enlarged view of FIG. 1 with environmental subject matter omitted;

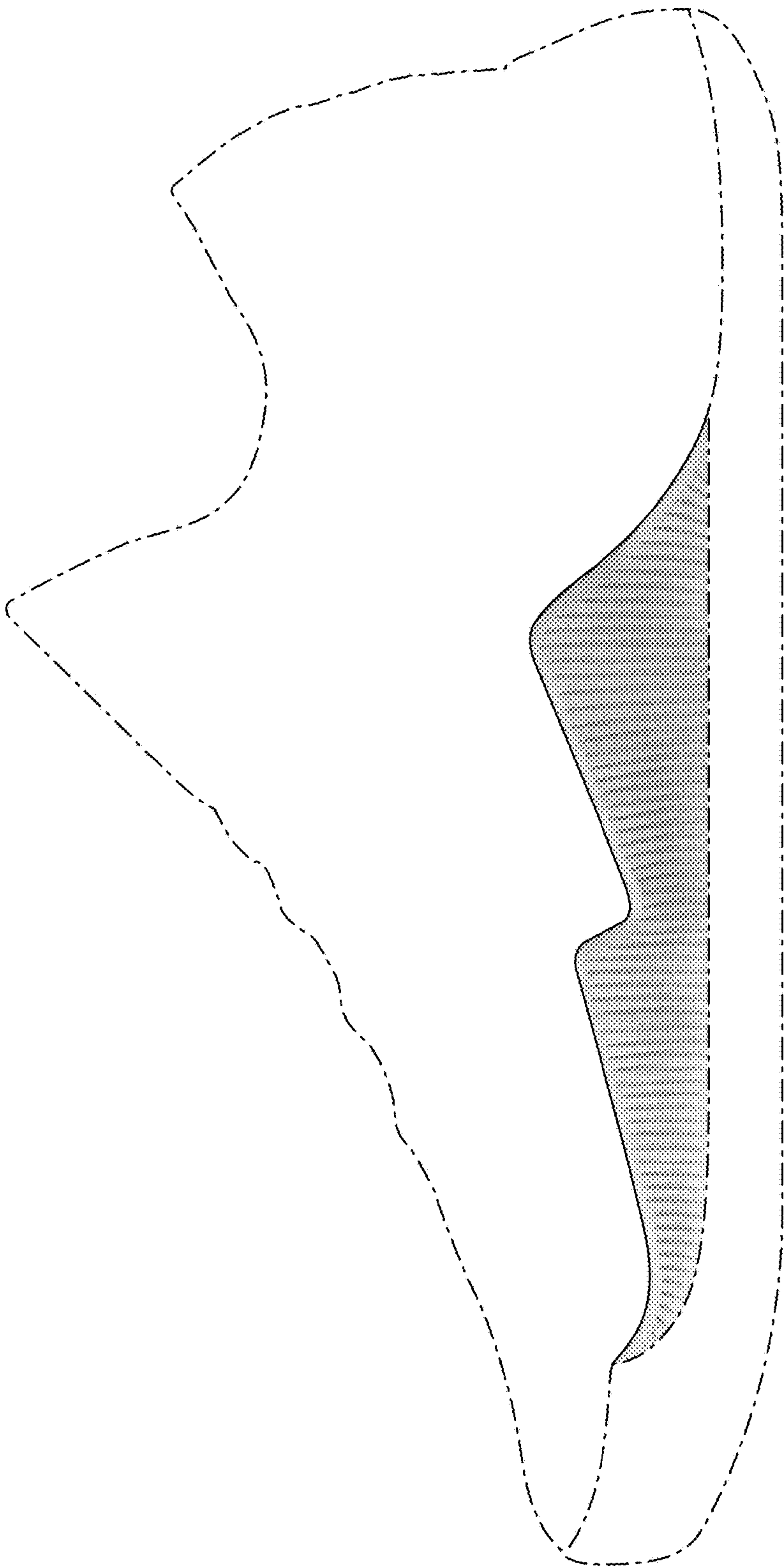

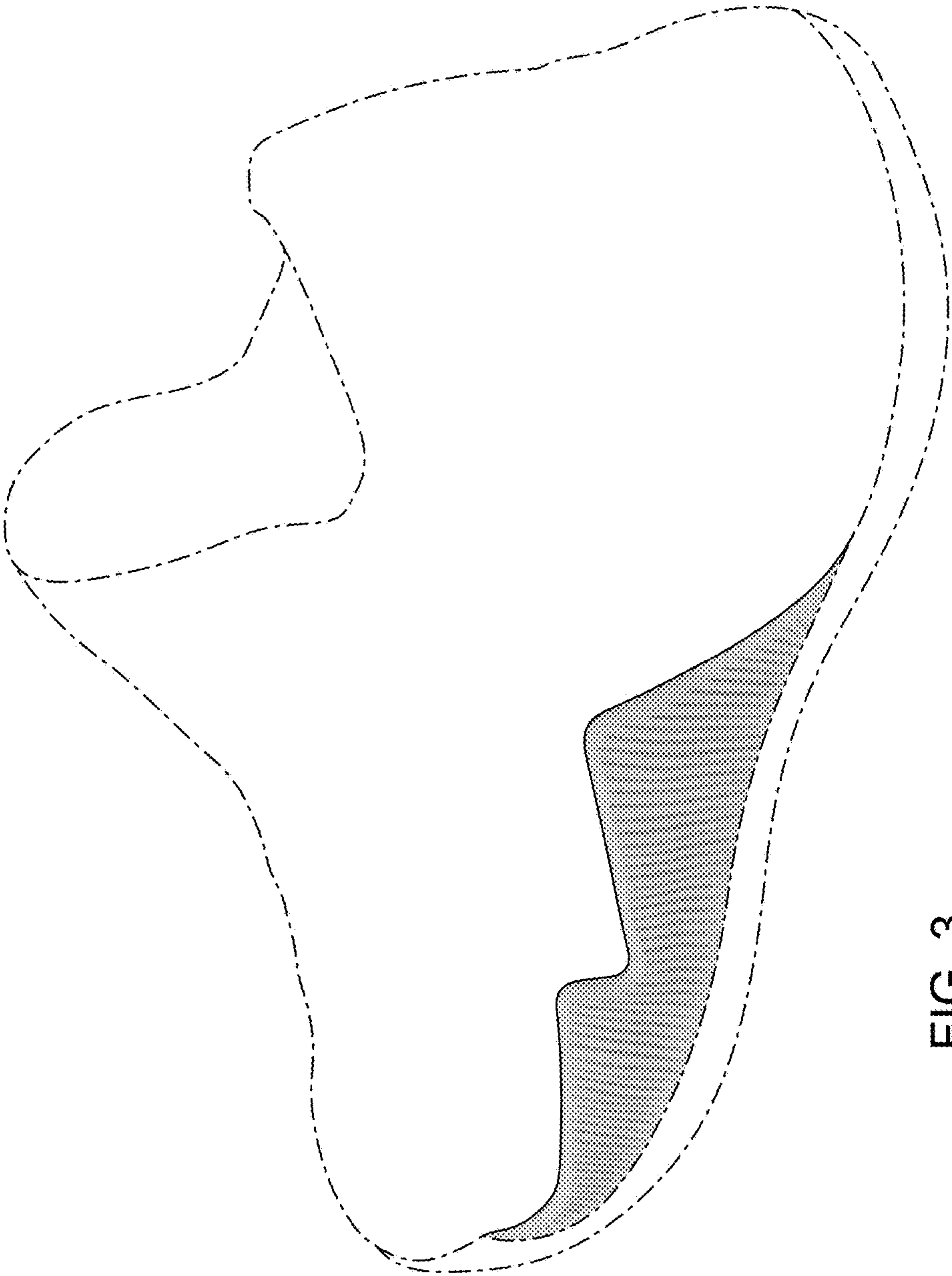

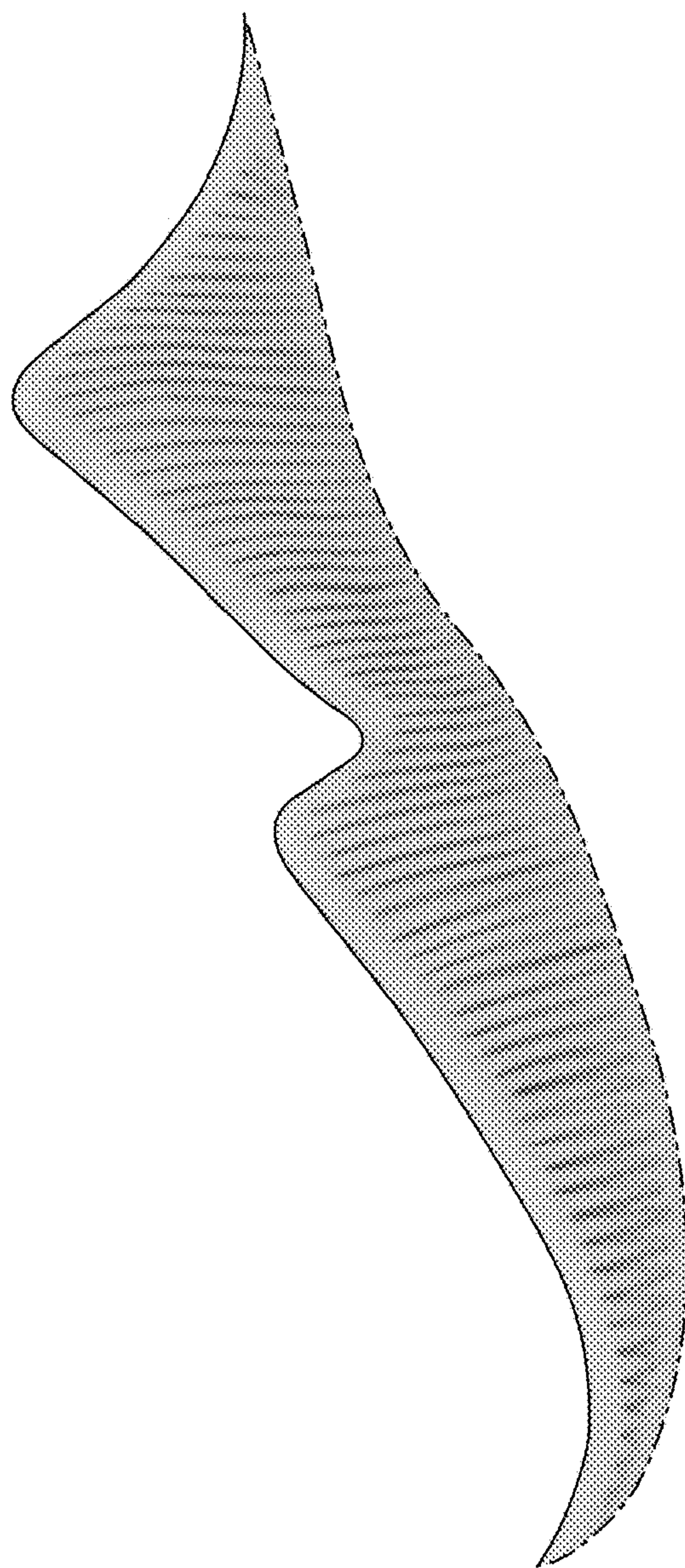

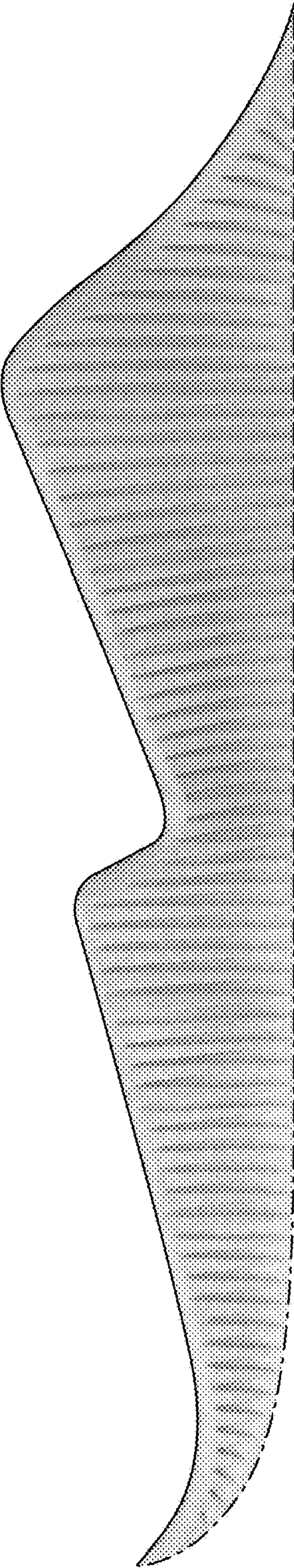

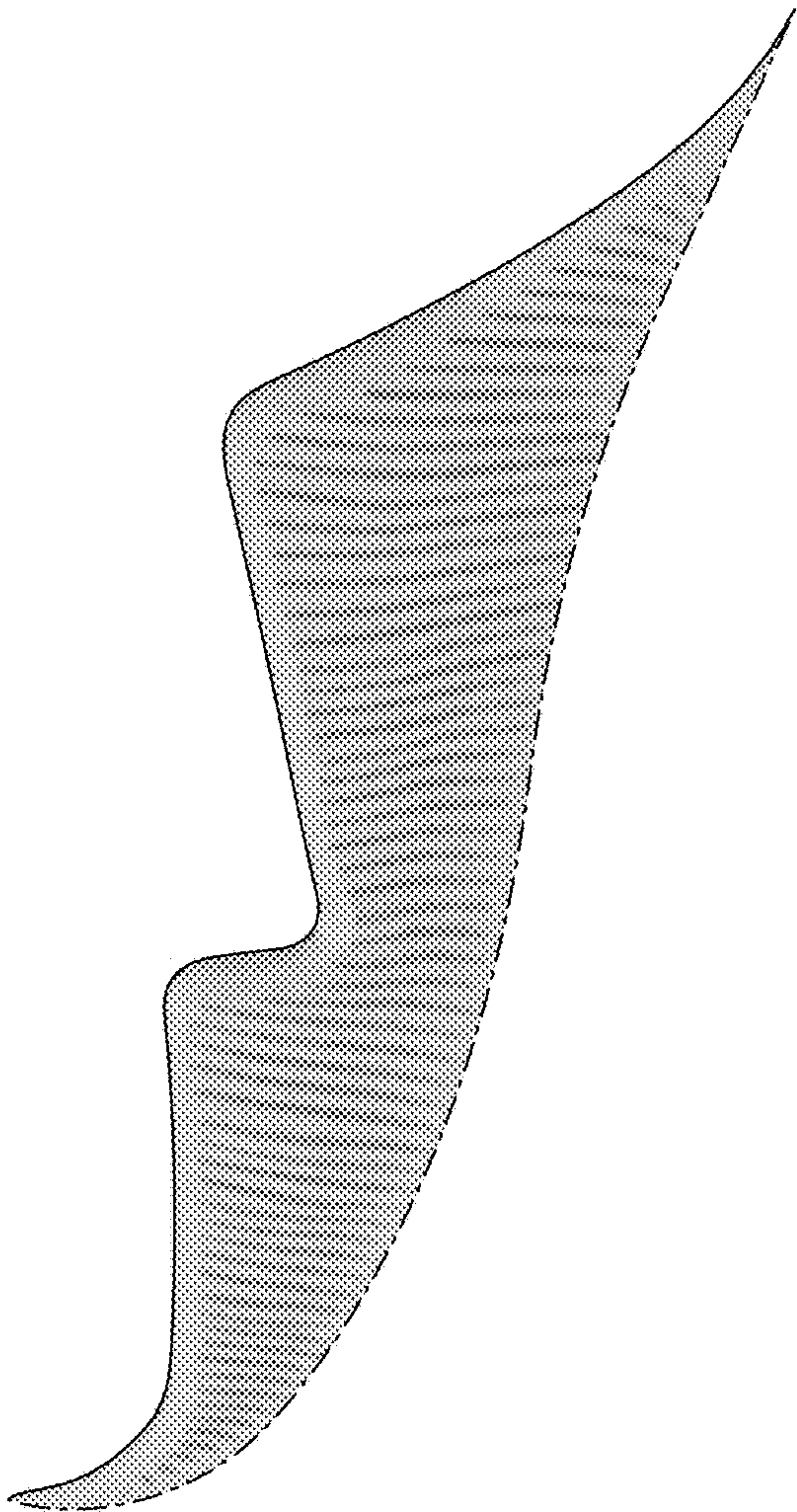
