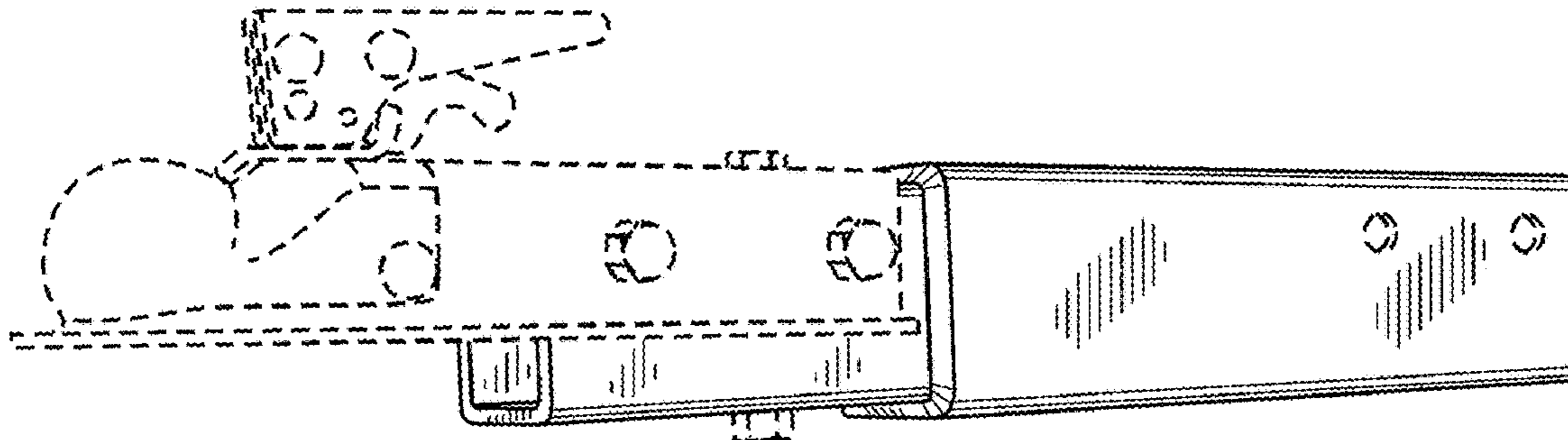
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a trailer tongue extender, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of a trailer tongue extender showing my new design in a position of use with an unclaimed trailer hitch and bolt;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of a trailer tongue extender;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a back side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a trailer tongue extender showing my new design in a position of use with an unclaimed trailer hitch and bolt;
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of a trailer tongue extender;
FIG. 11 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a front side view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a back side view thereof;
FIG. 15 is a left side view thereof; and,
FIG. 16 is a right side view thereof.
The trailer tongue extender includes a circular pipe that extends through the top of the article to the bottom side. The broken line renderings of the environment of a trailer hitch and bolt in FIGS. 1 and 9 form no part of the claimed design. All other broken lines depict portions of the trailer tongue extender that form no part of the claimed design.

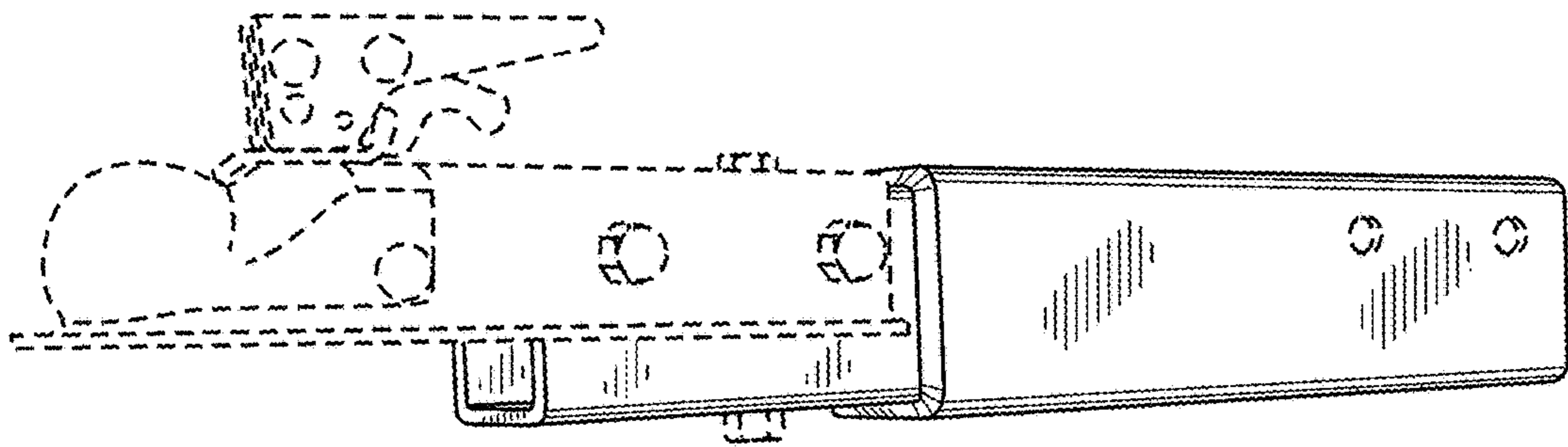

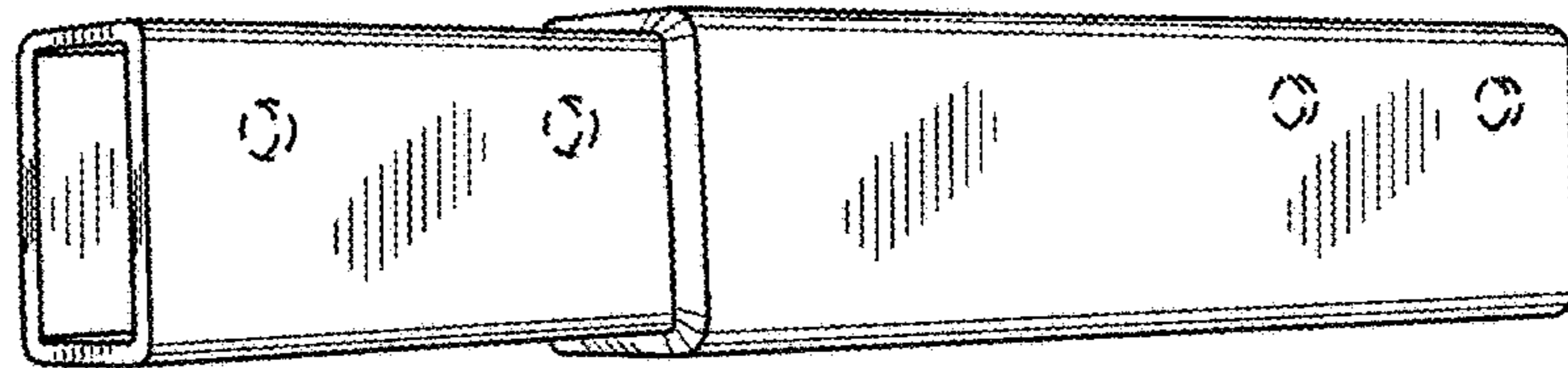

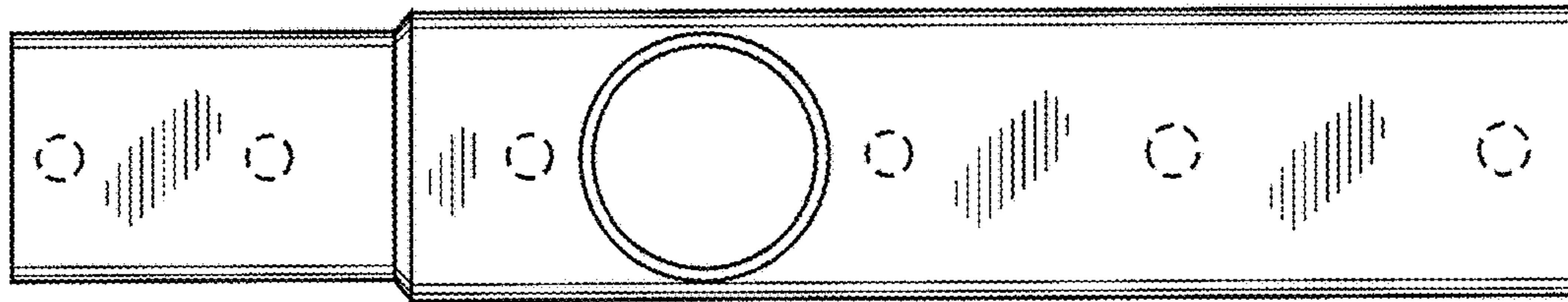

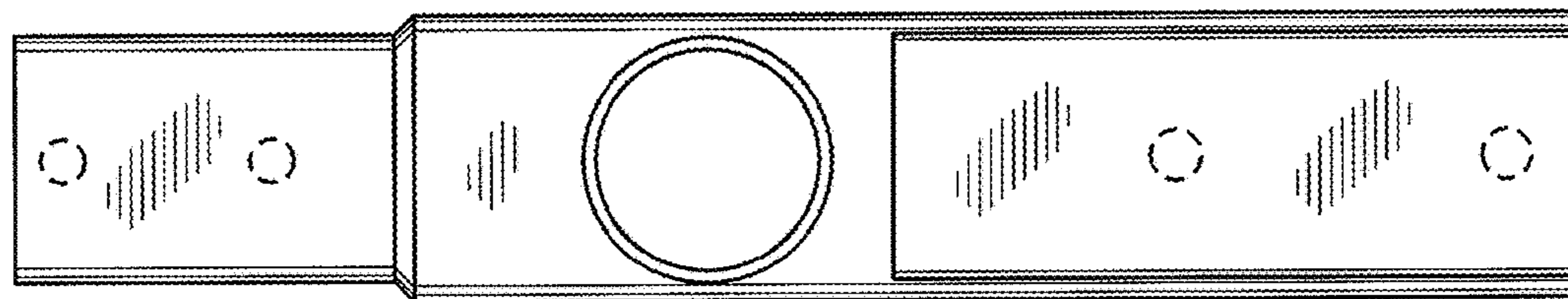

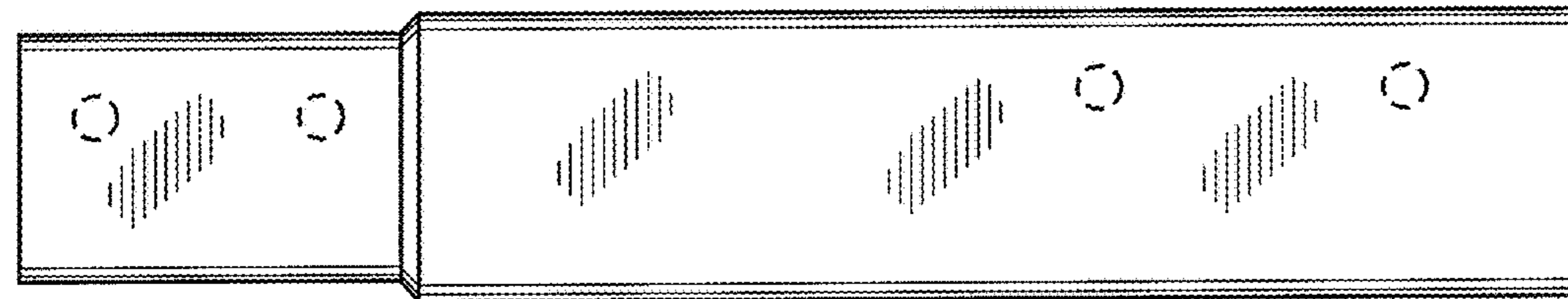

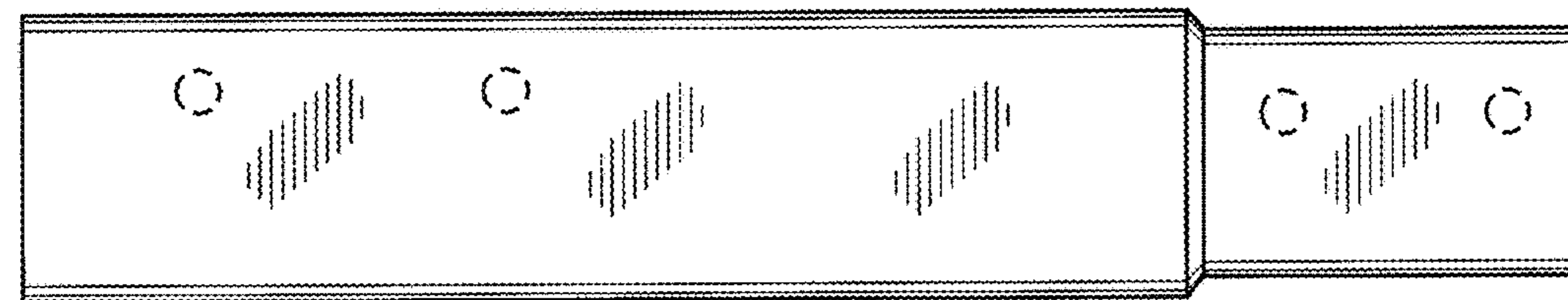

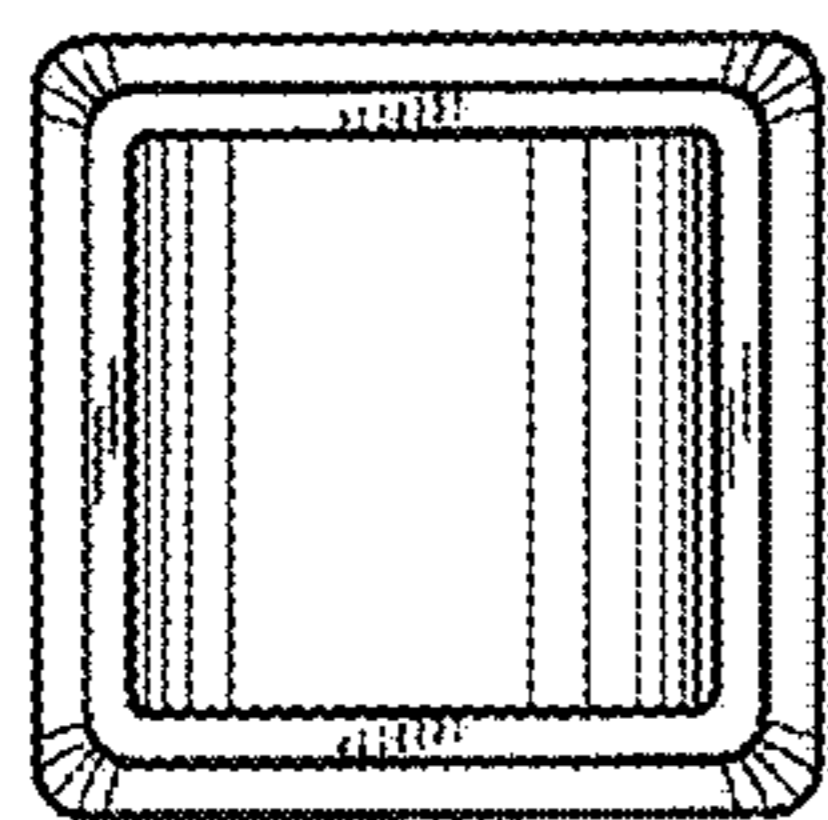

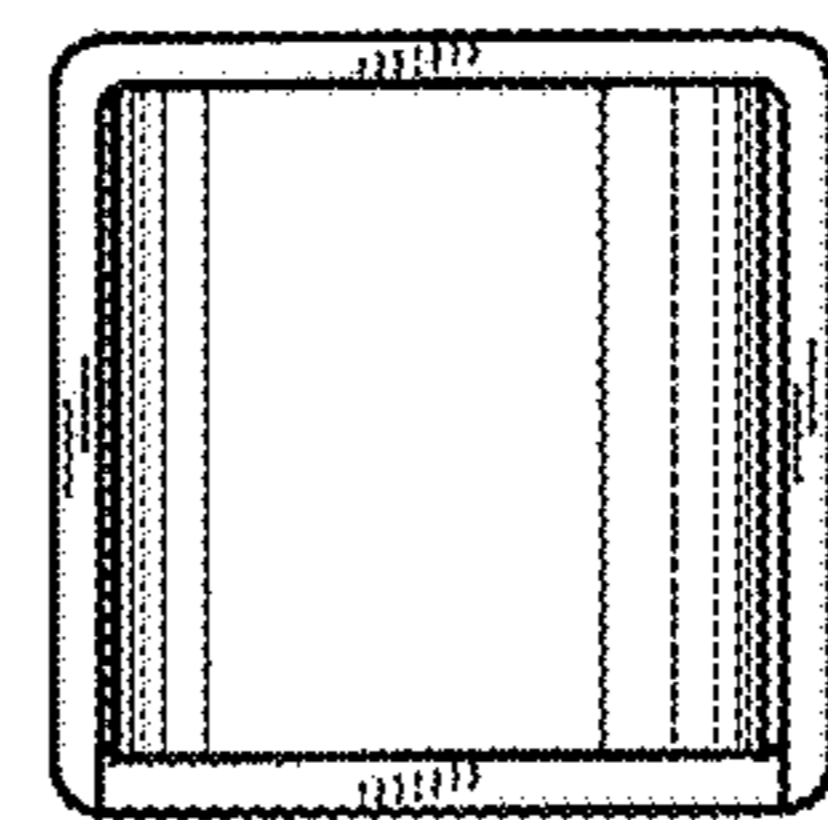

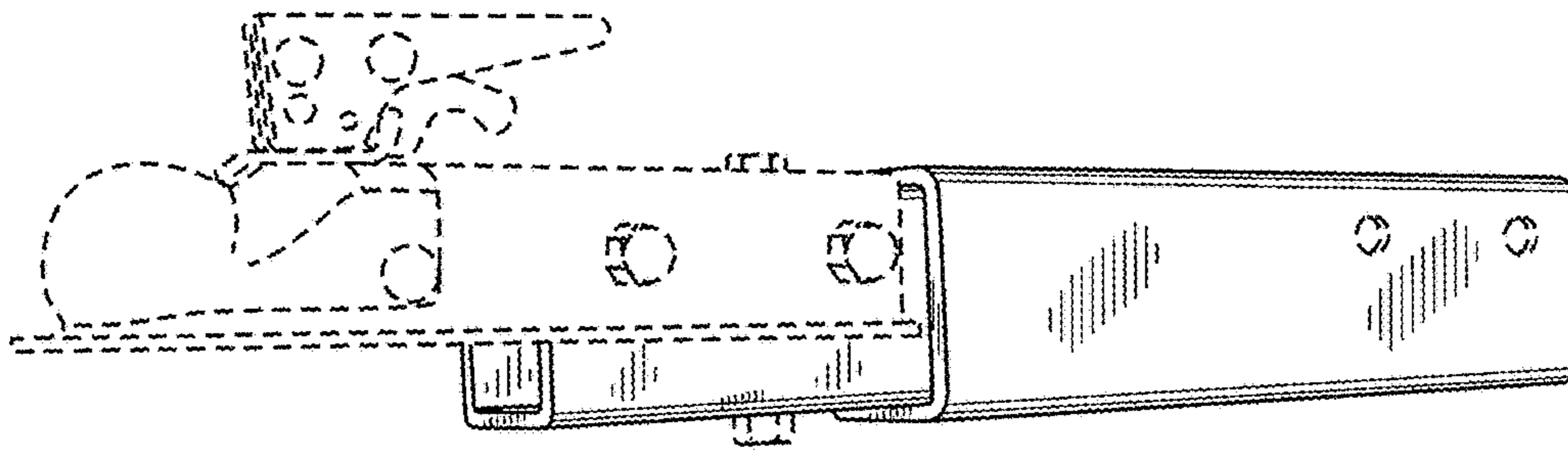

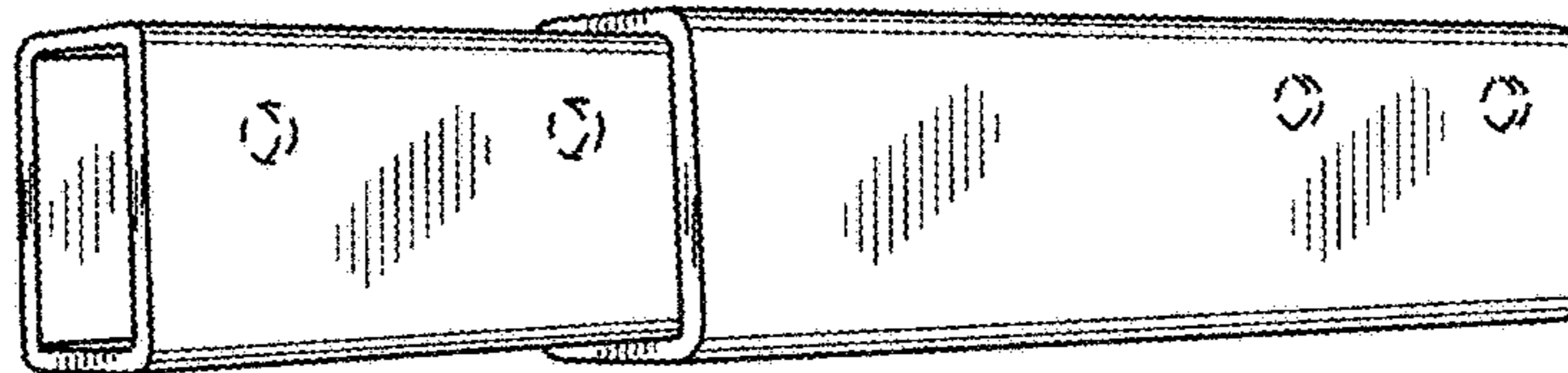

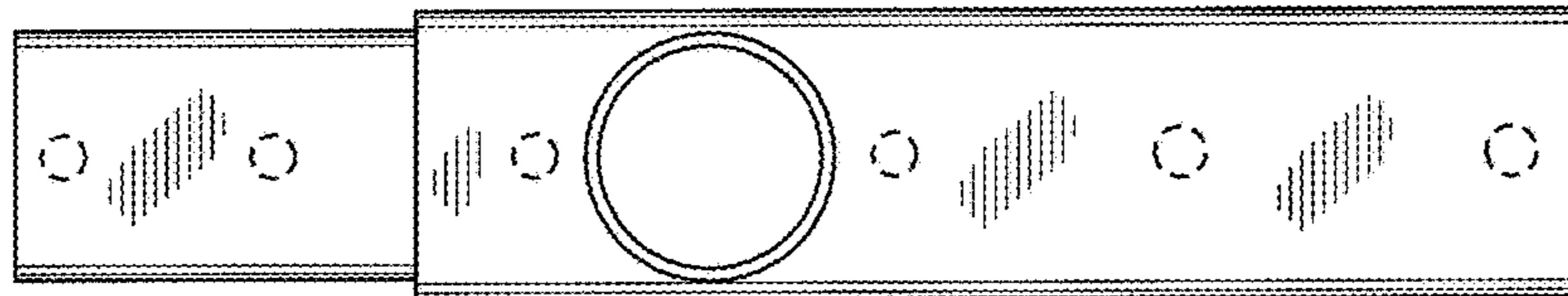

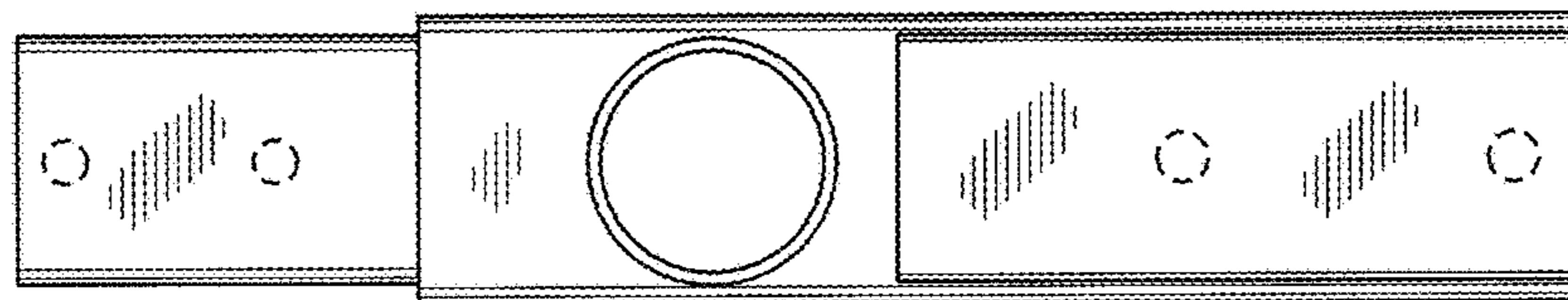

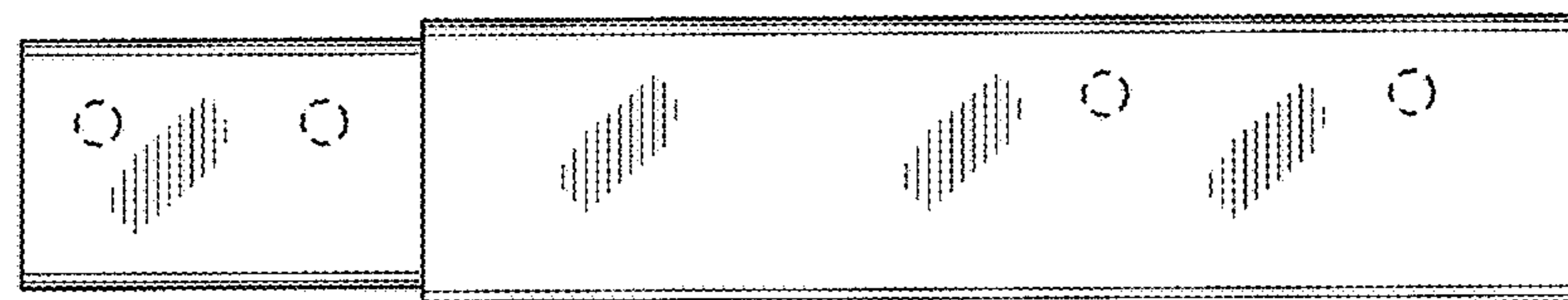

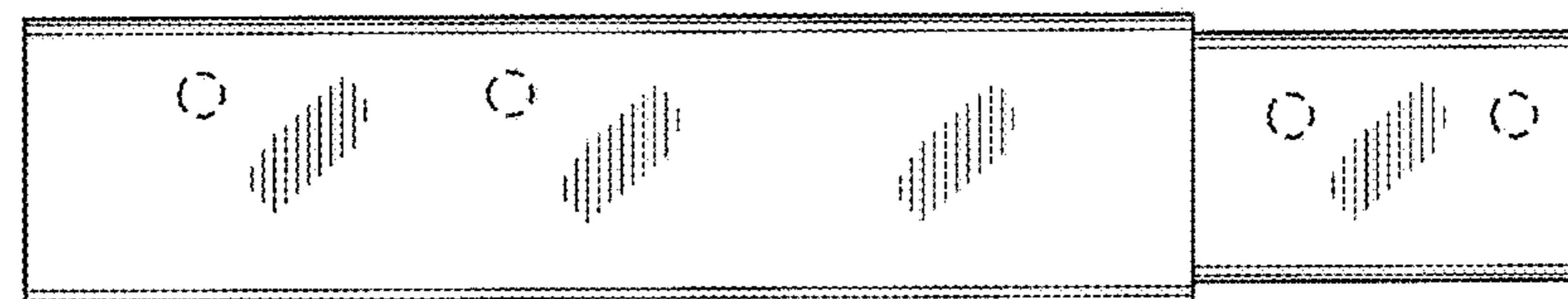

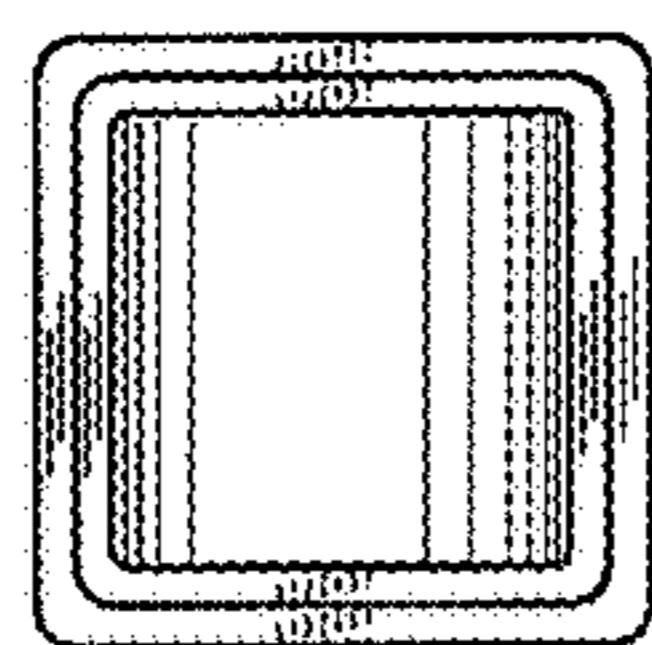

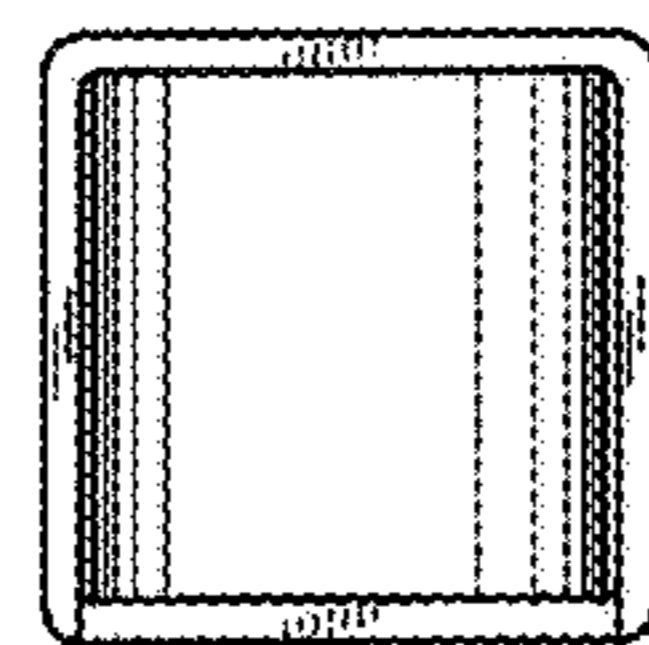
