(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for the pipe splitting tool and base, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pipe splitting tool and base, in accordance with the present design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the pipe splitting tool and base of FIG. 1, wherein the tool is disengaged from its base;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the pipe splitting tool and base depicted in FIG. 1;

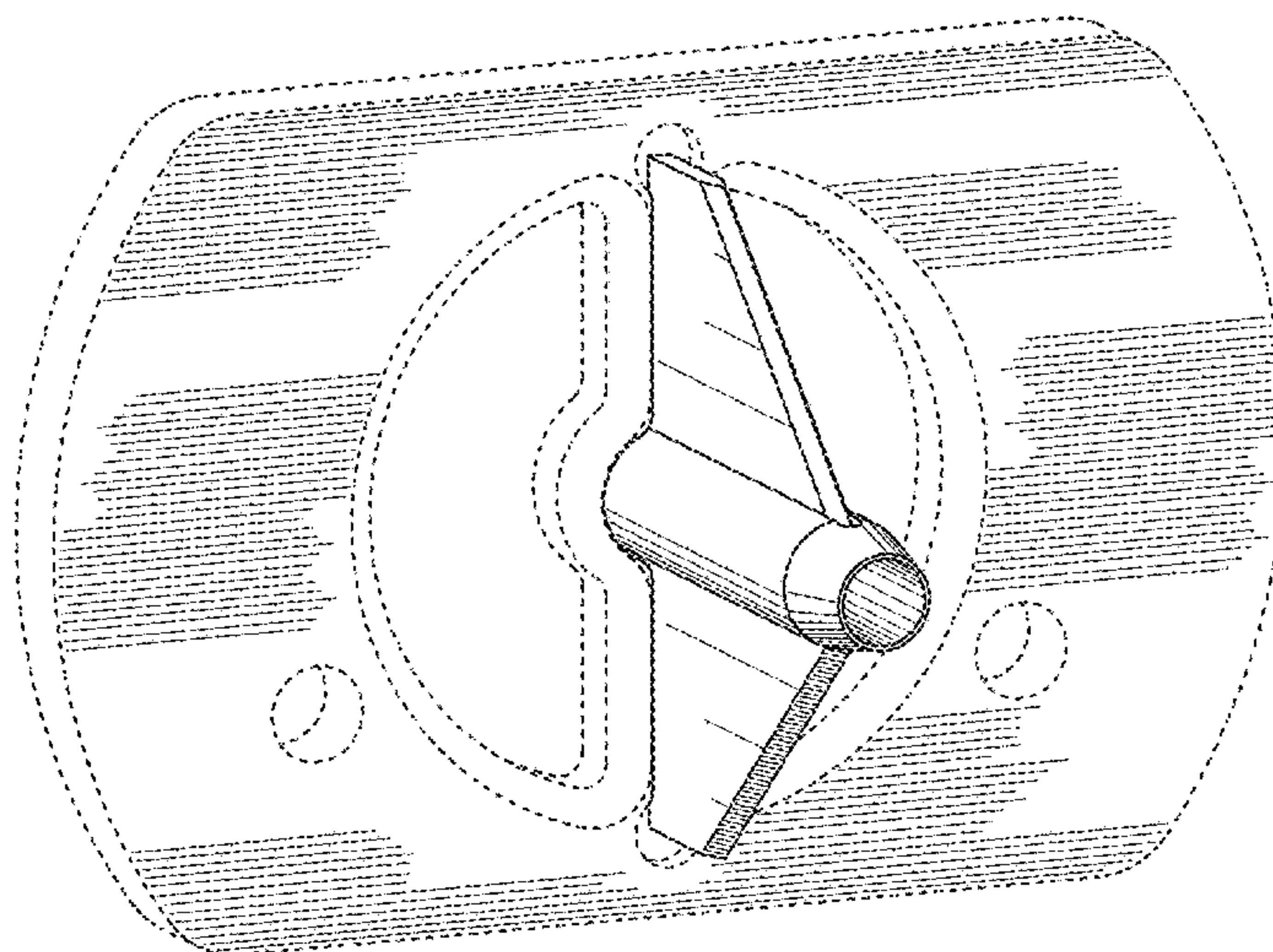
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the pipe splitting tool and base depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side view of the pipe splitting tool and base depicted in FIG. 1, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top view of the pipe splitting tool and base depicted in FIG. 1, it being understood that the bottom view not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof.

The broken lines show portions of the pipe splitting tool and base which form no part of the claimed design. The line shading merely represents surface shading and is not intended to depict a particular color, texture or tone.

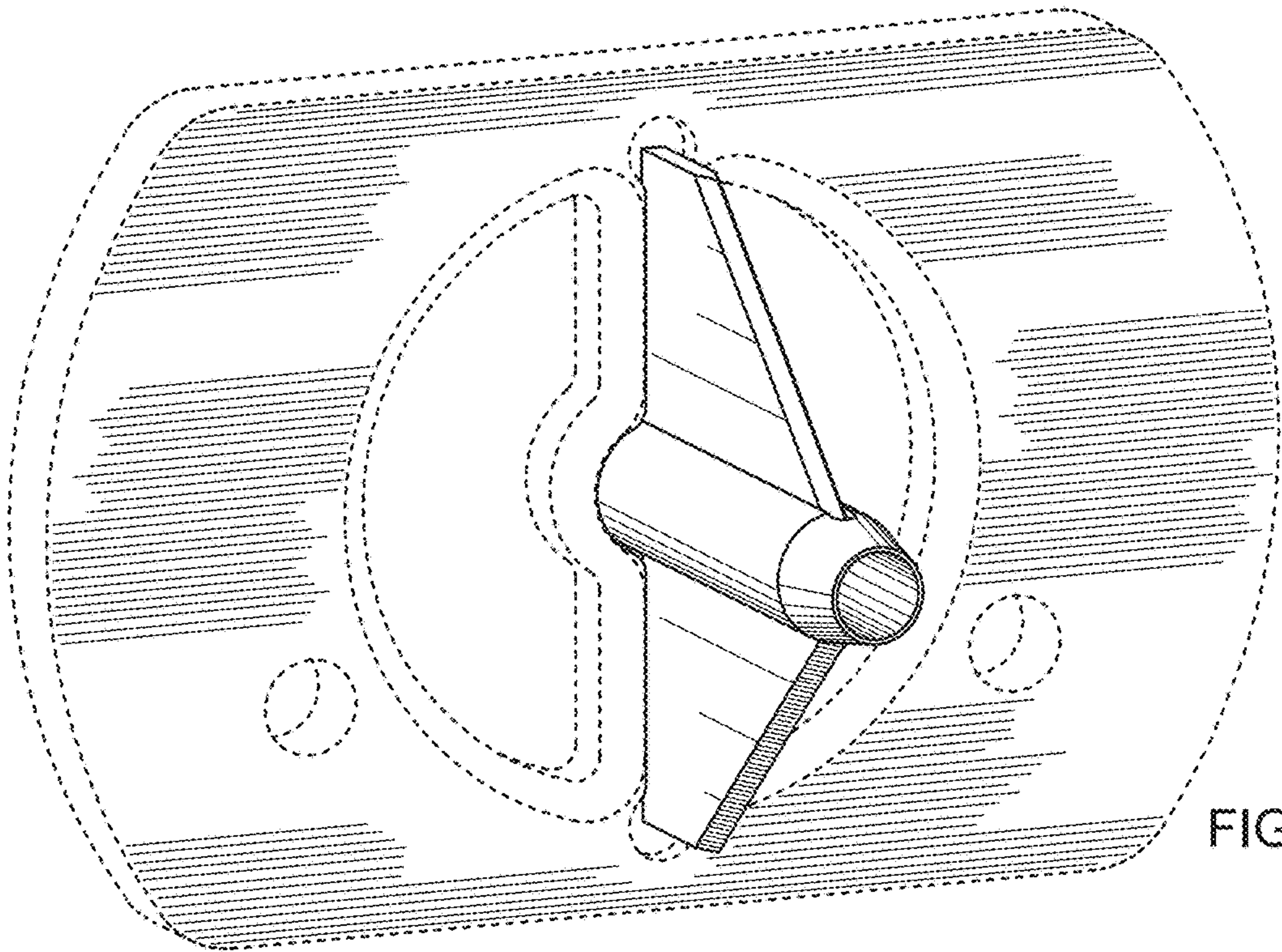

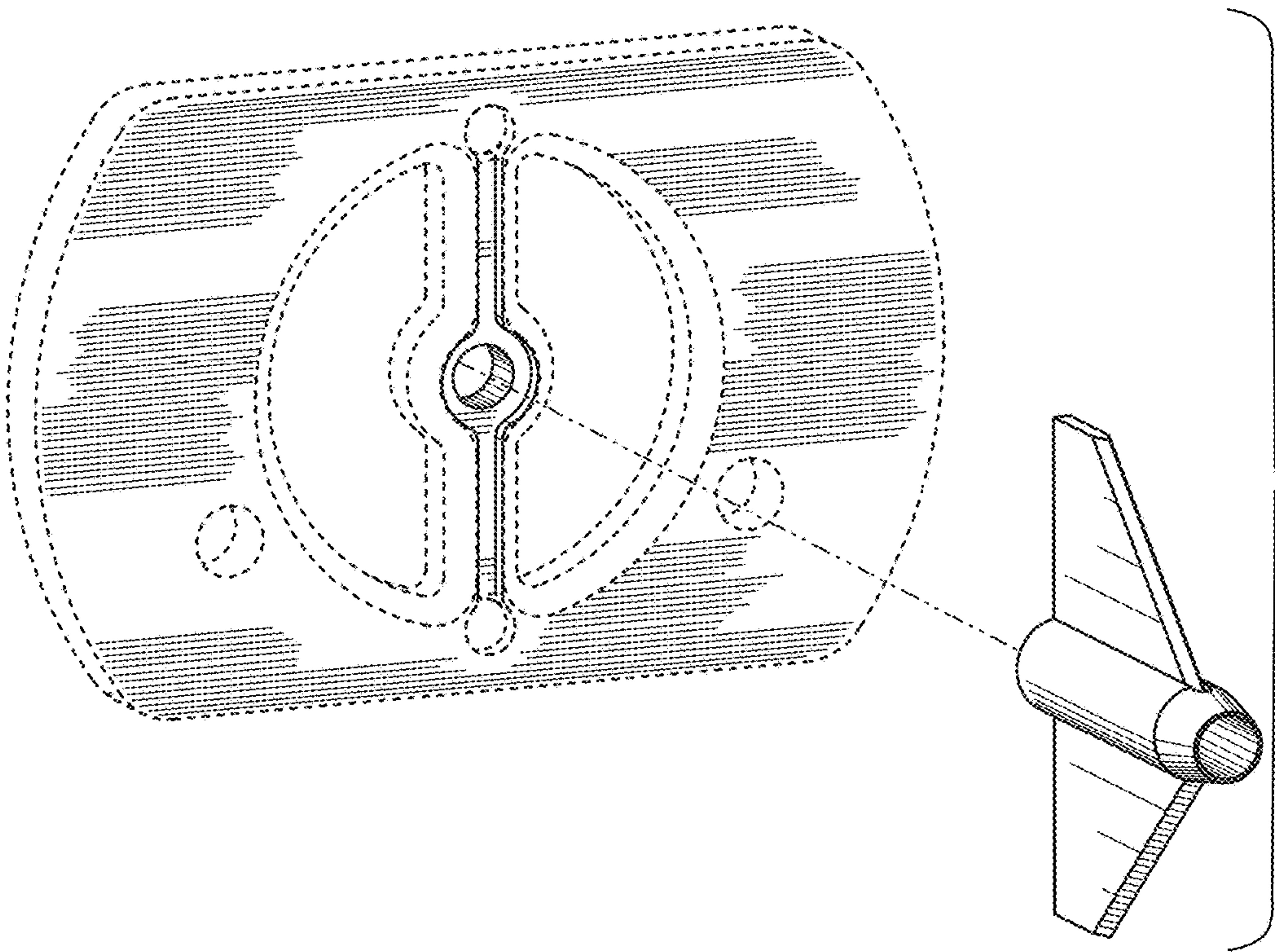

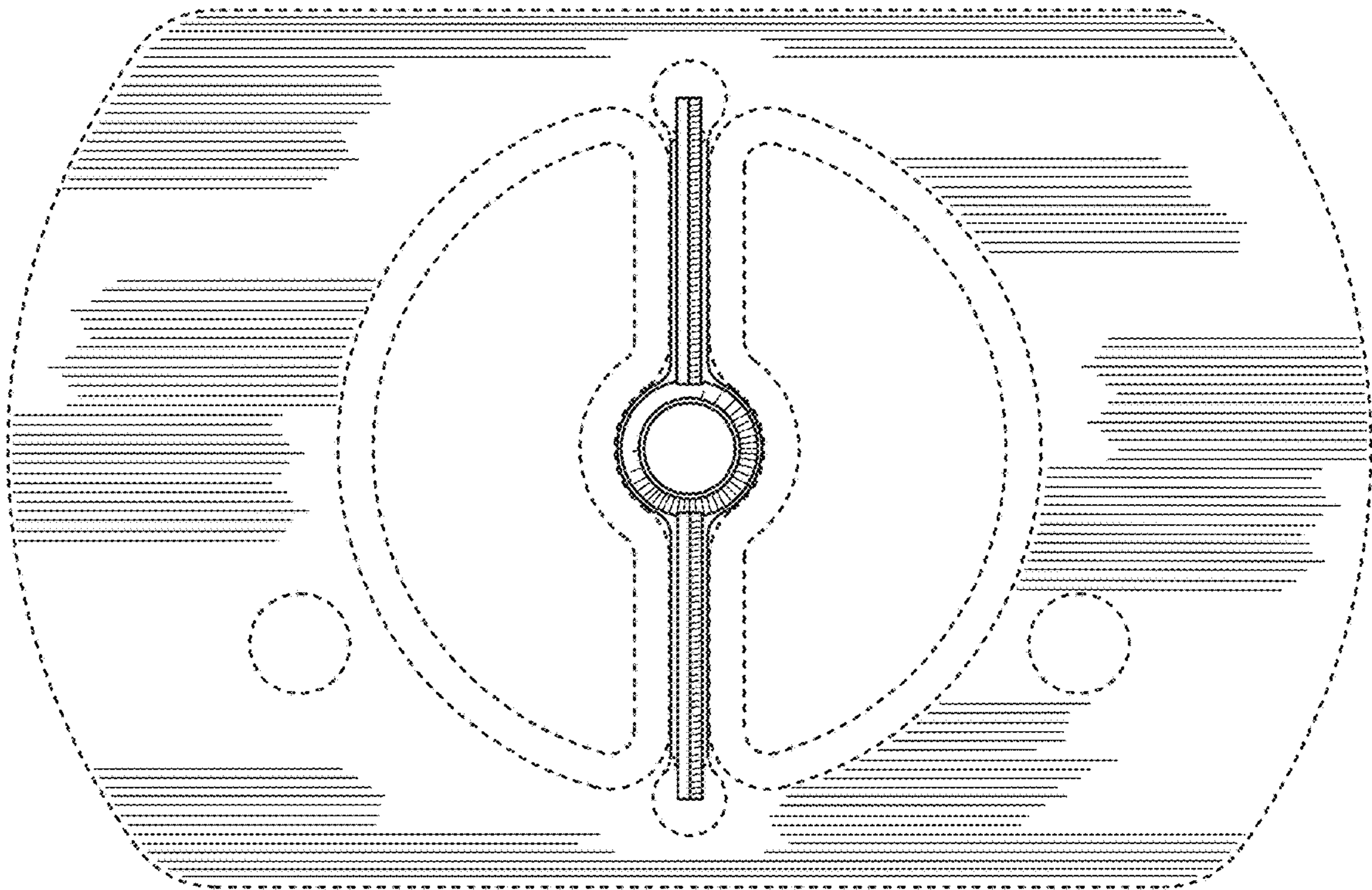

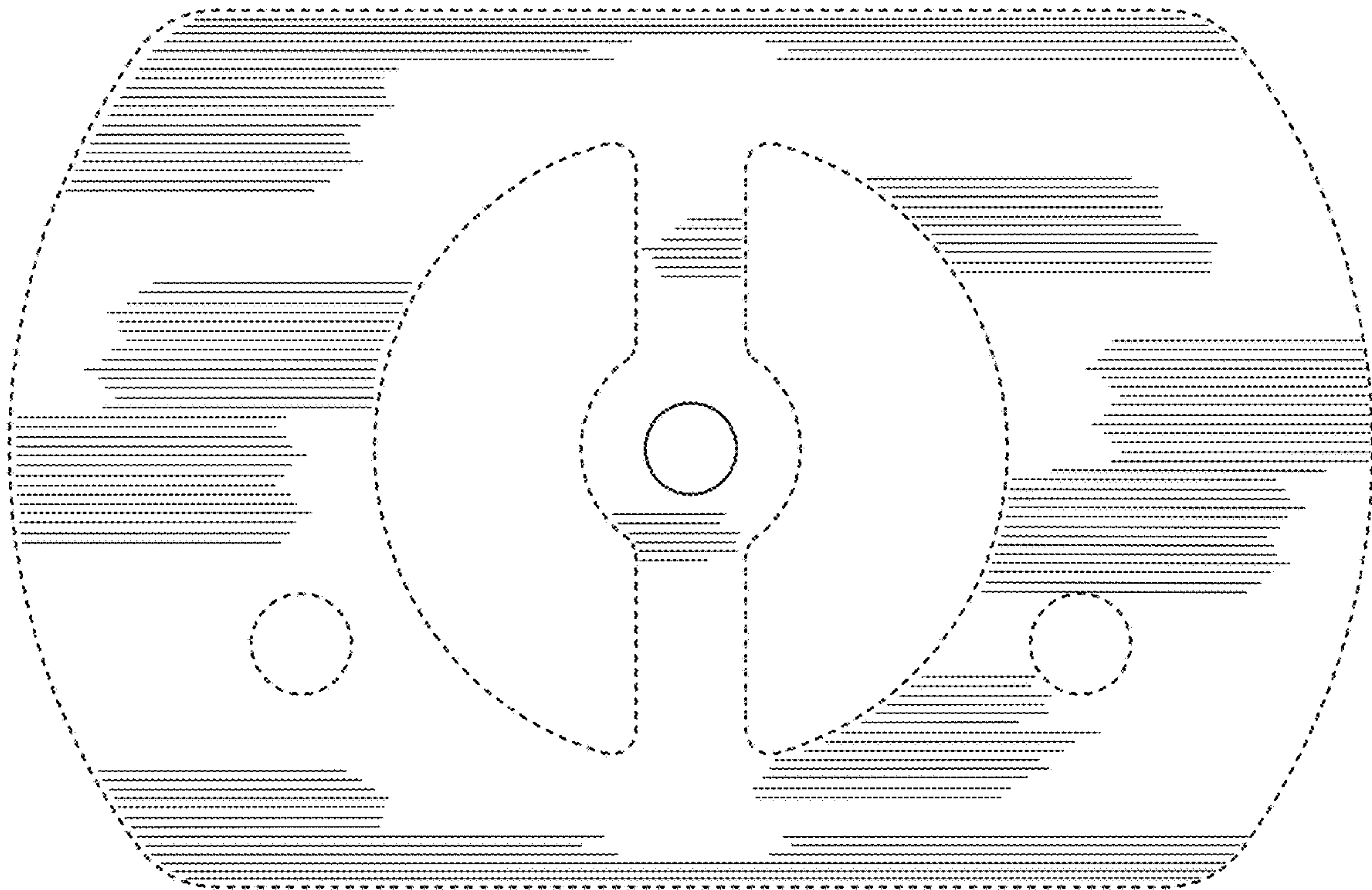

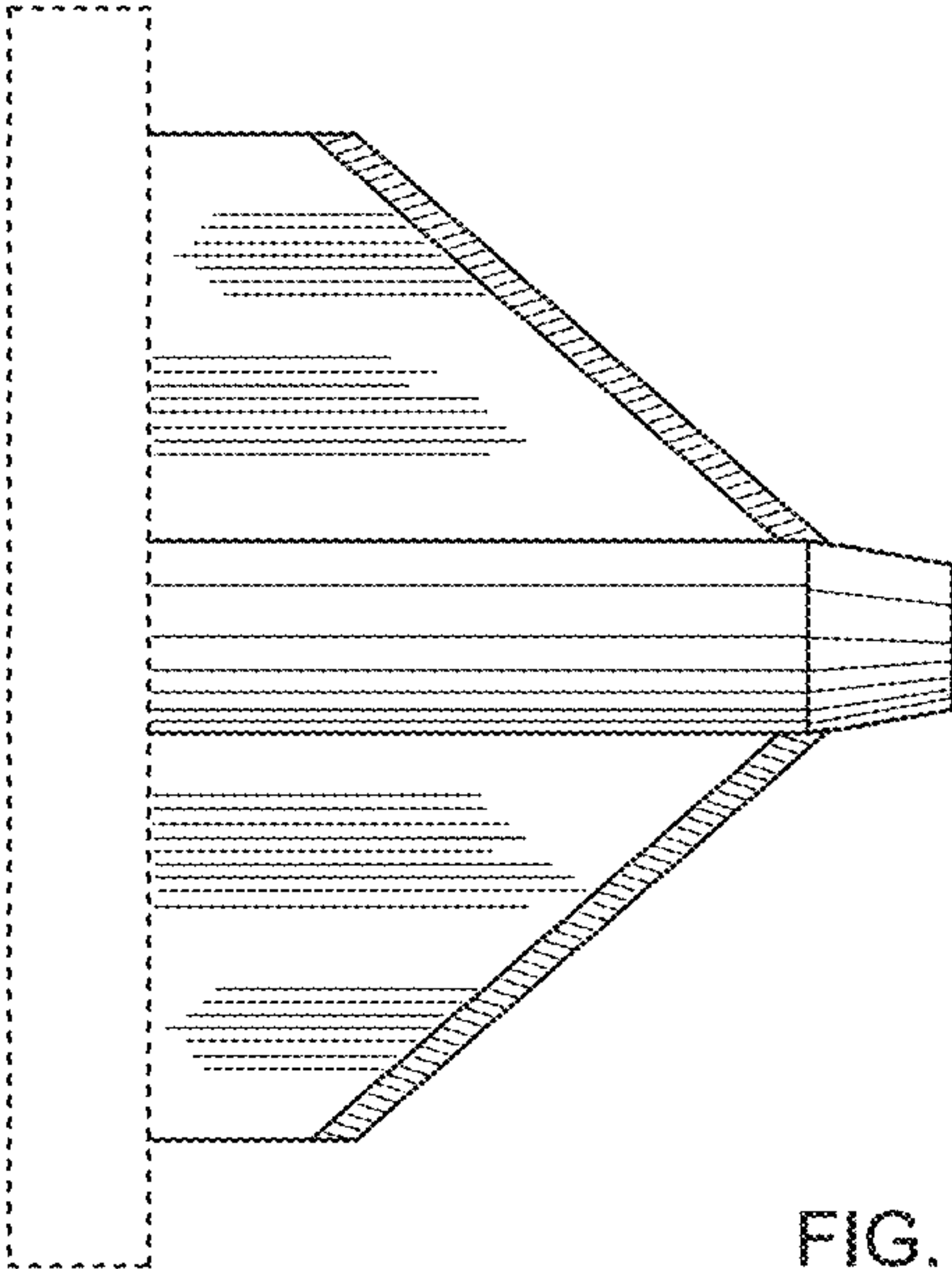

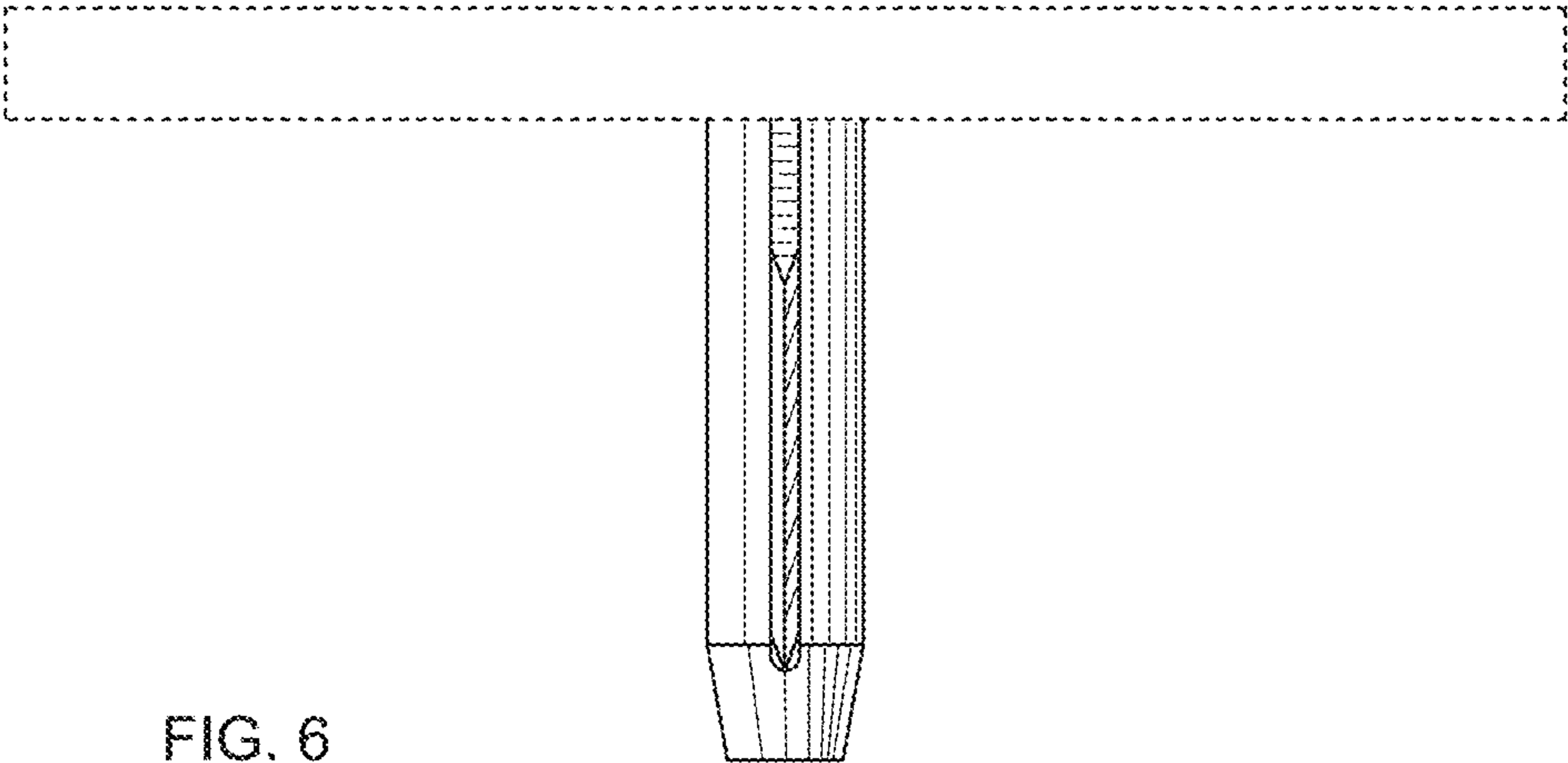
