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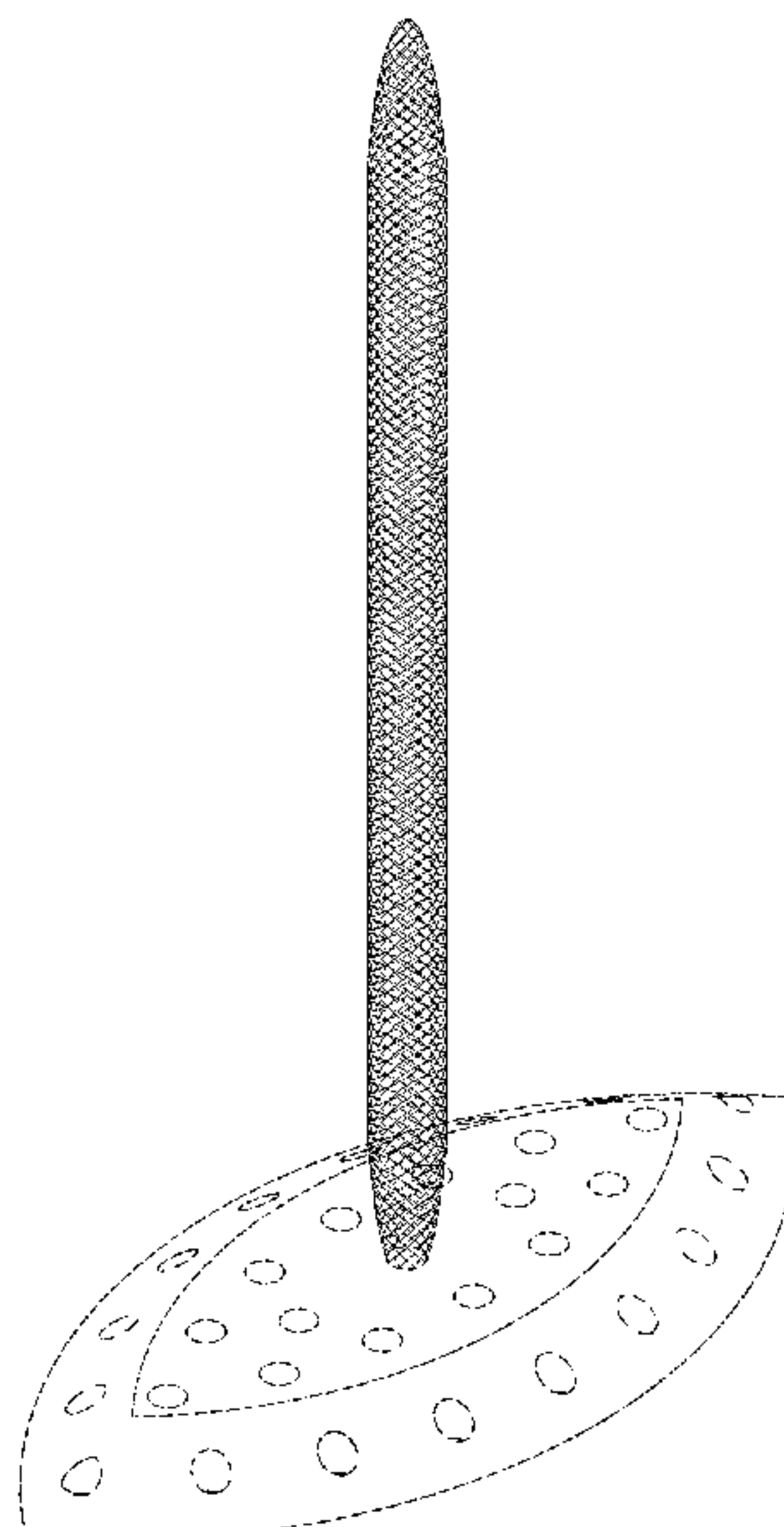
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ornament for aquarium, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front and to one side of an ornament for aquarium incorporating the design;
FIG. 2 is an elevation view of both the front and the rear thereof, as they are identical;
FIG. 3 is an elevation view of both sides thereof, as they are identical;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view from the front and to one side thereof as shown in a collection thereof.

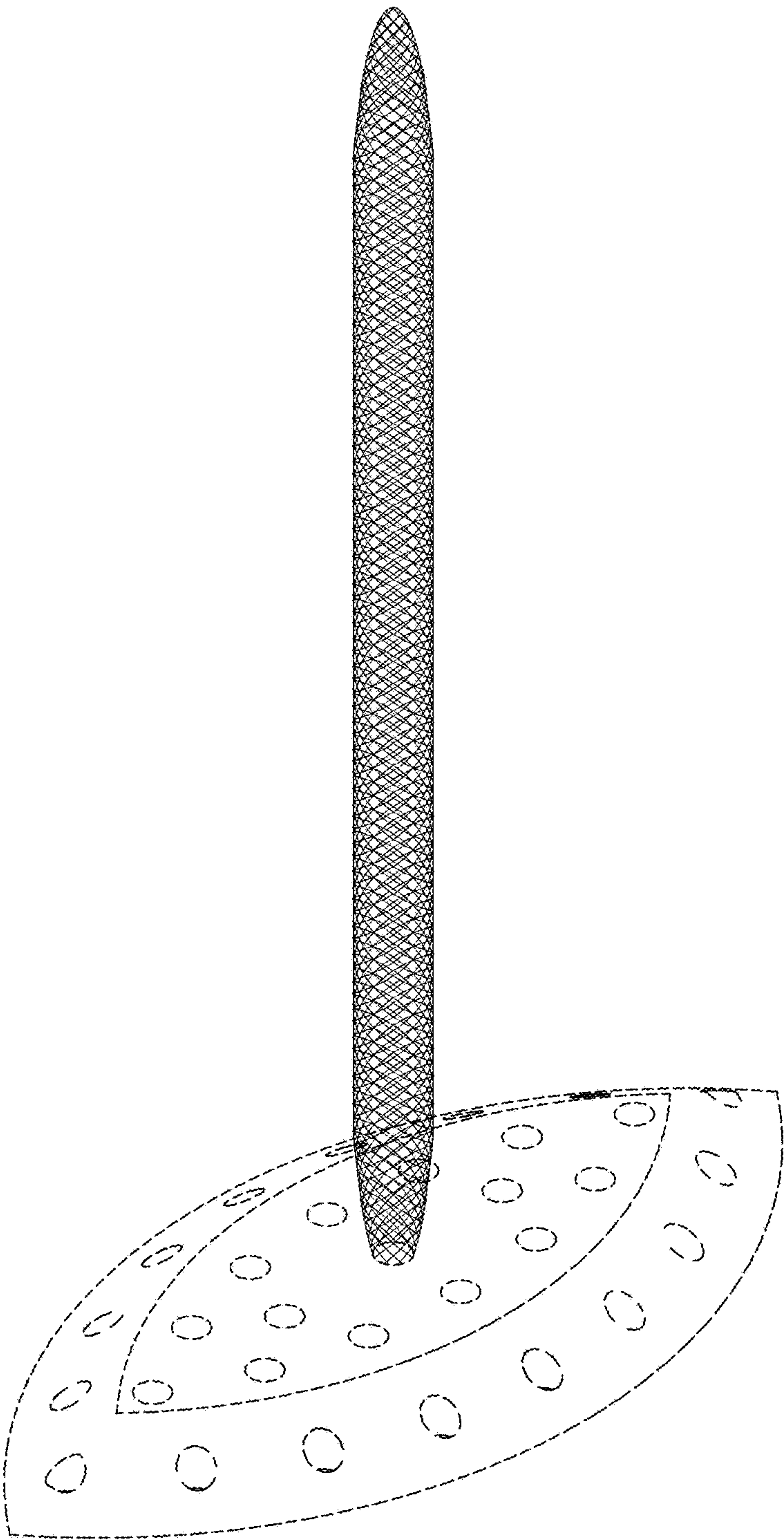

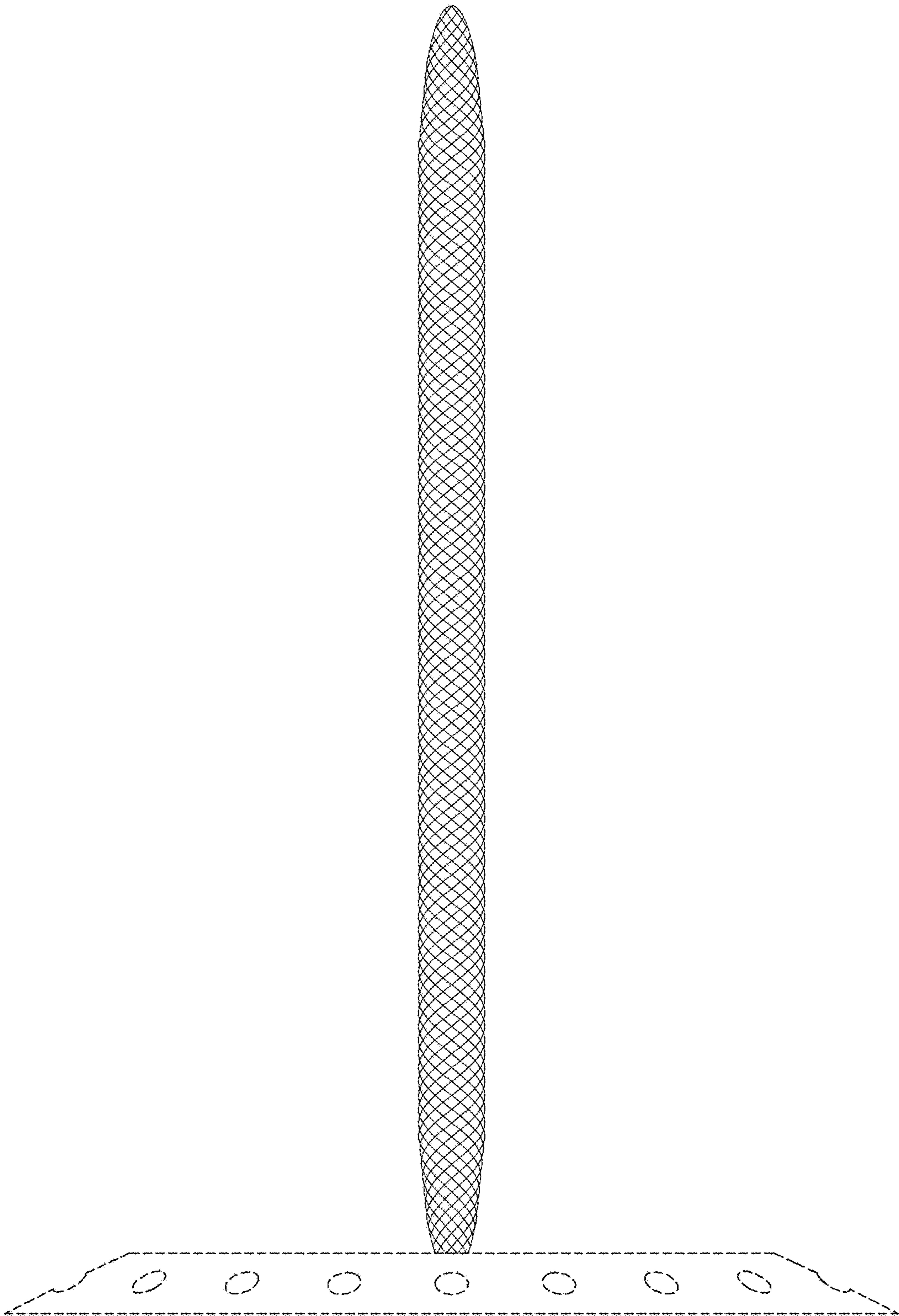

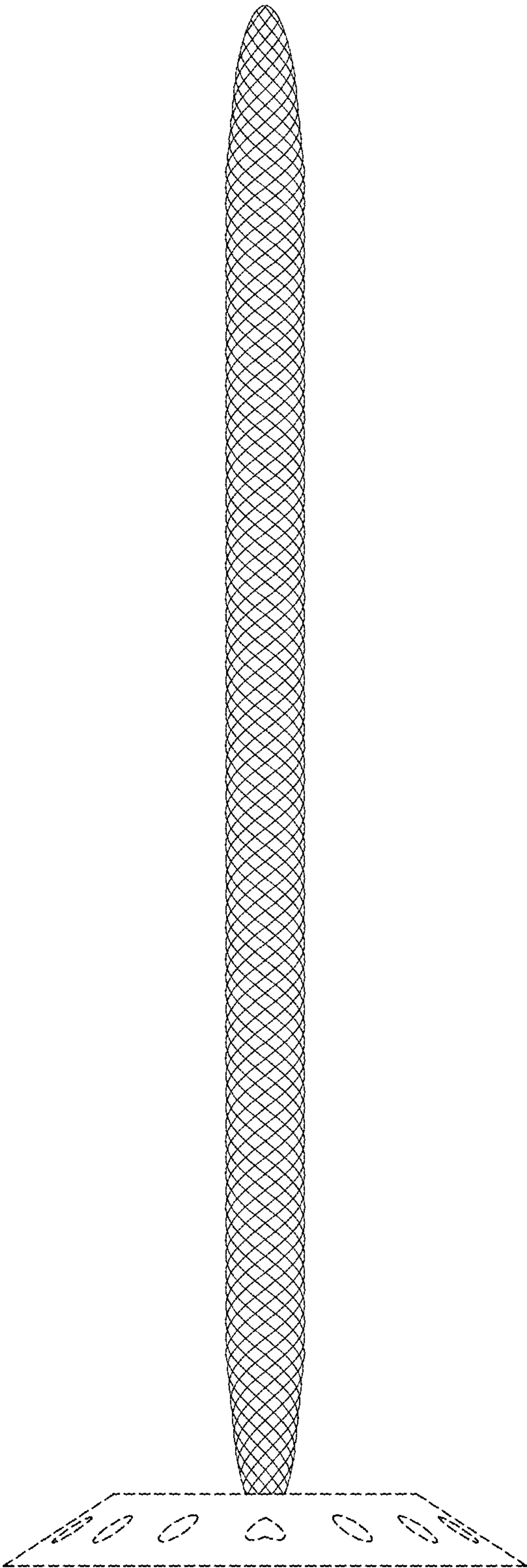

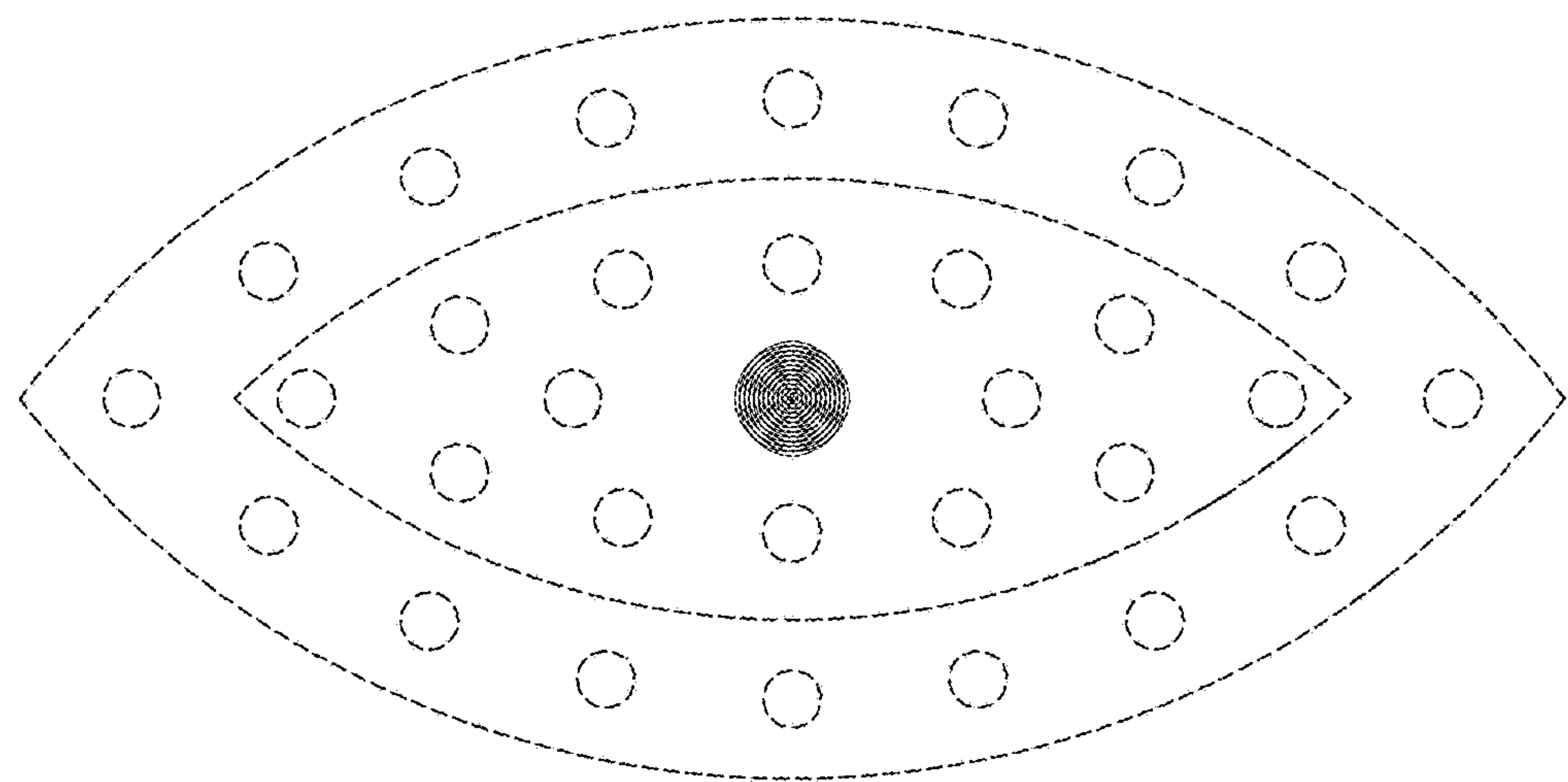

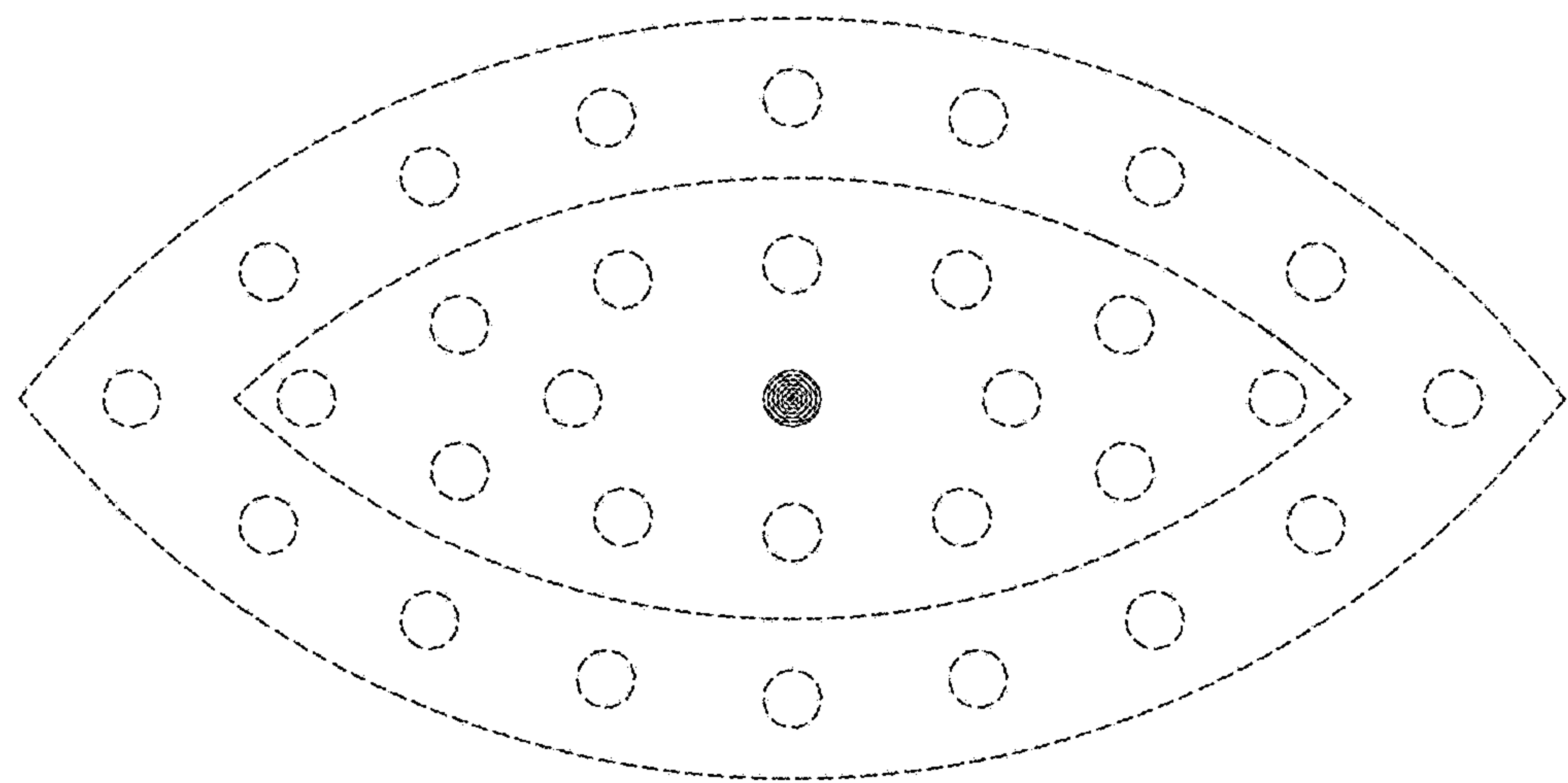

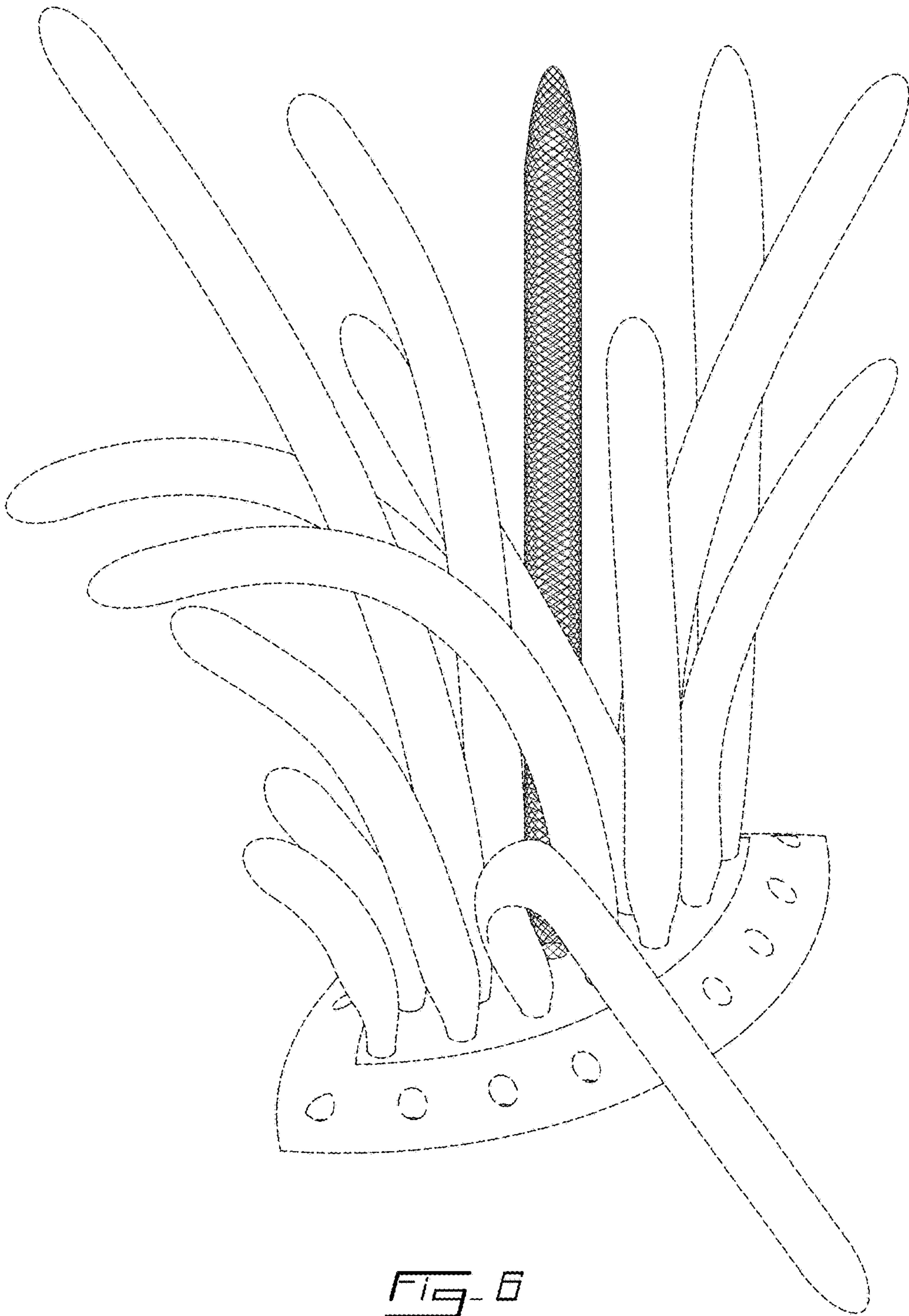
