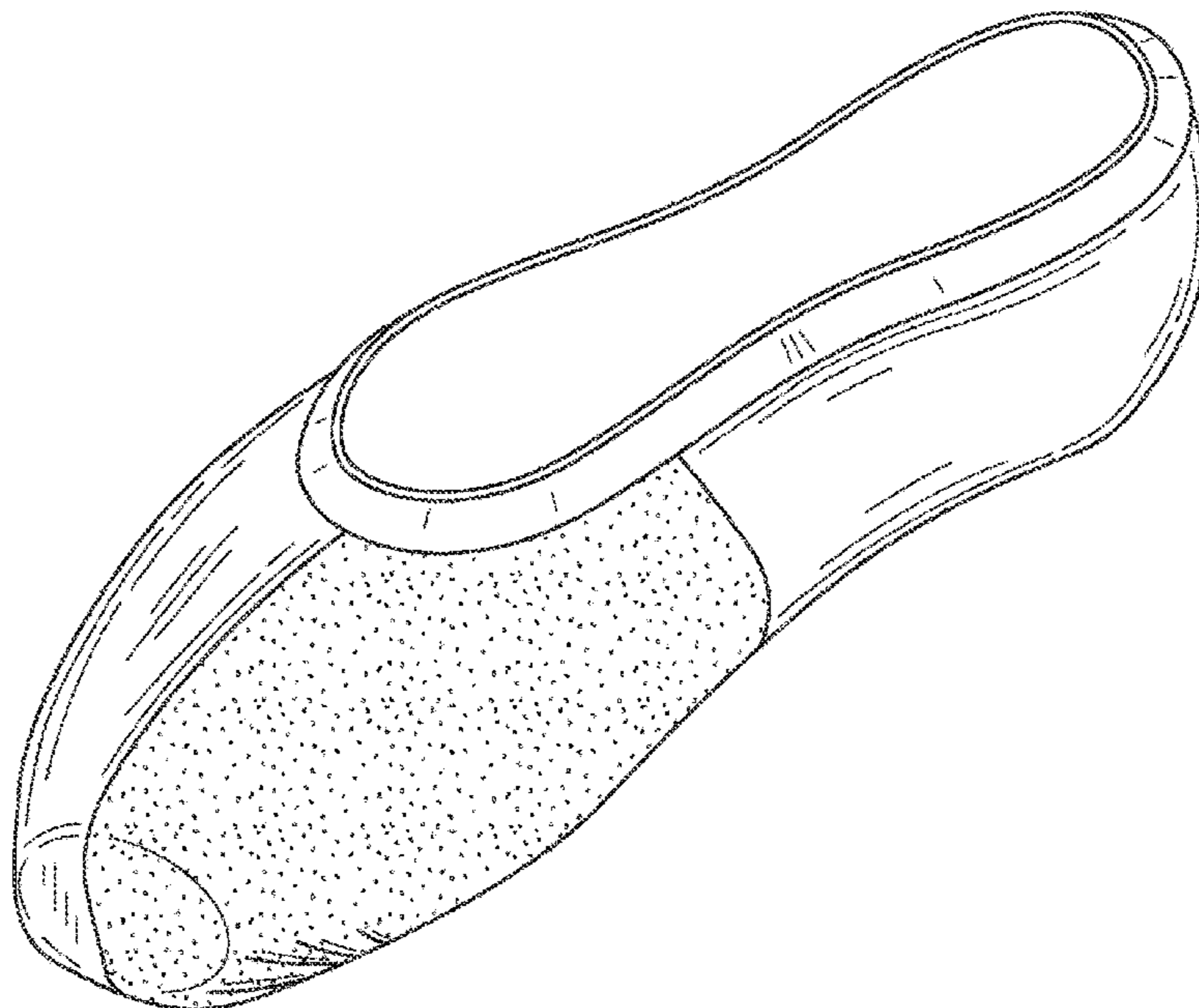

DESCRIPTION

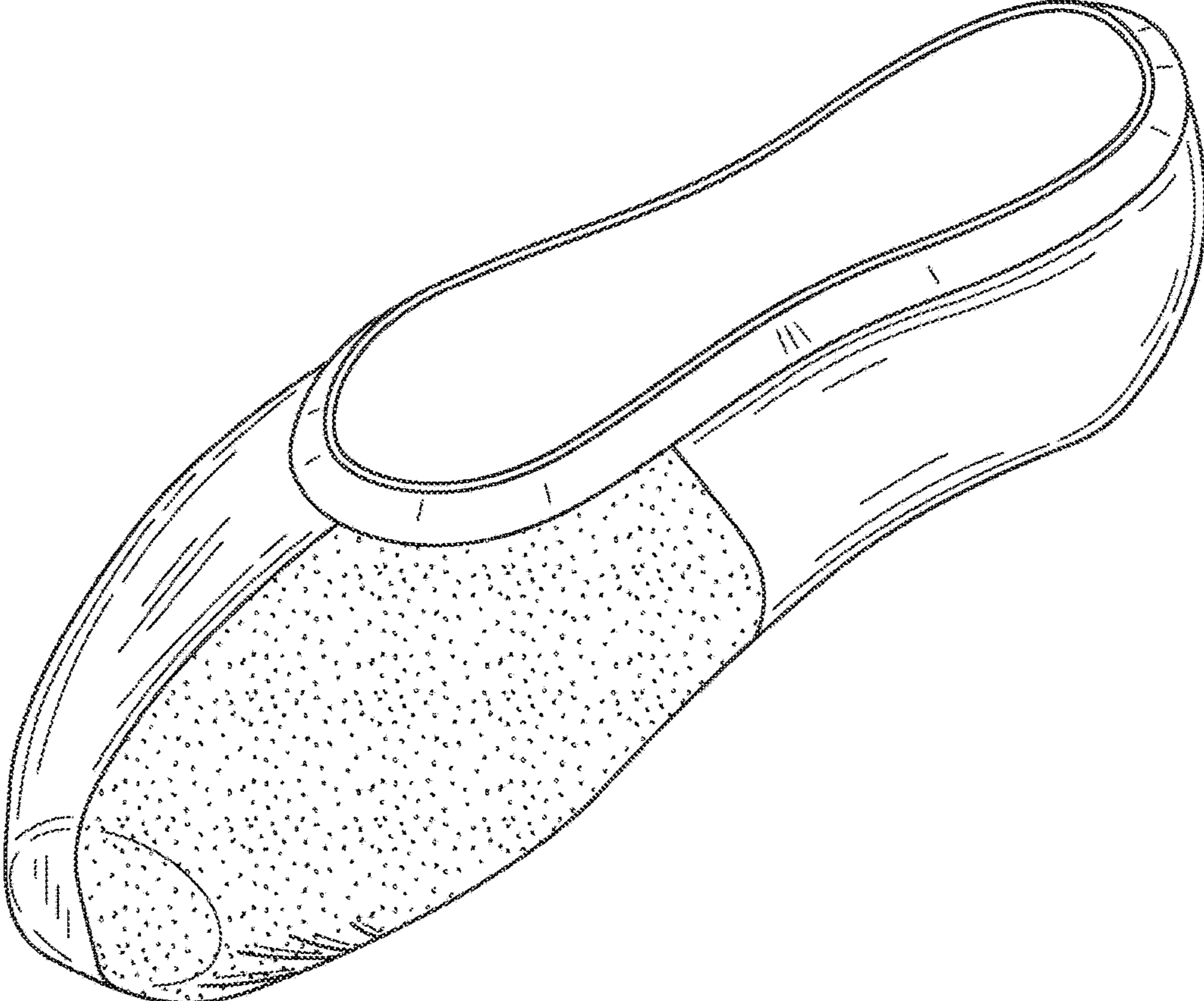

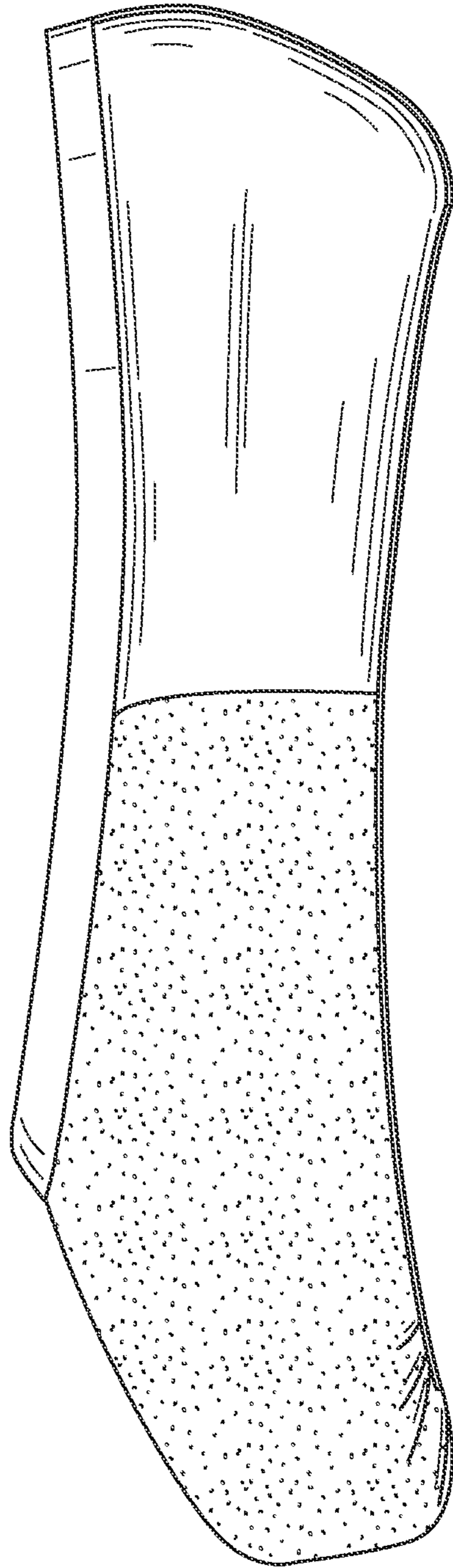

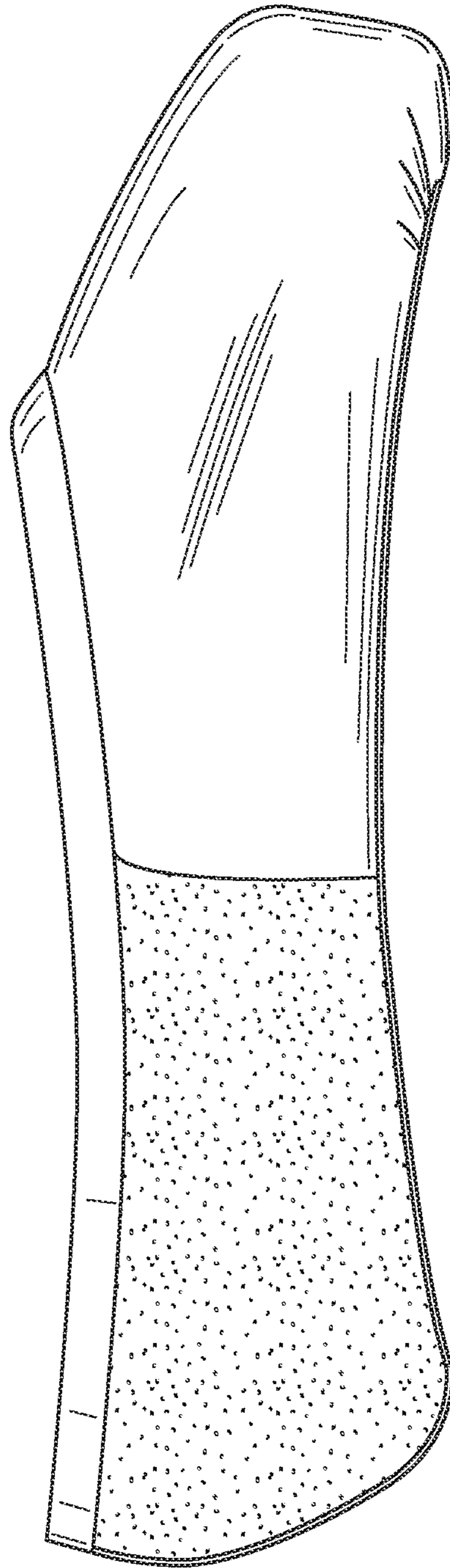

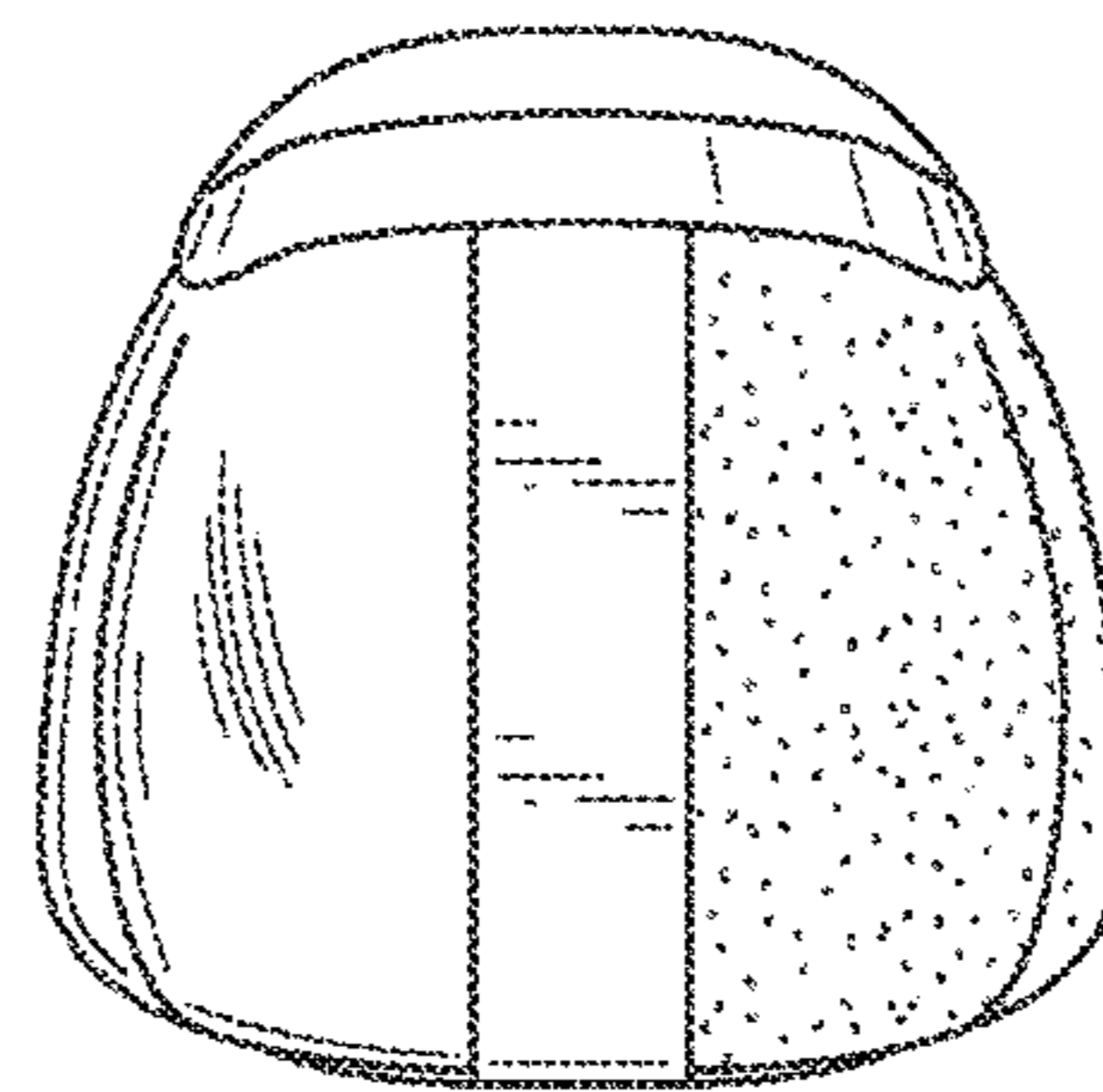

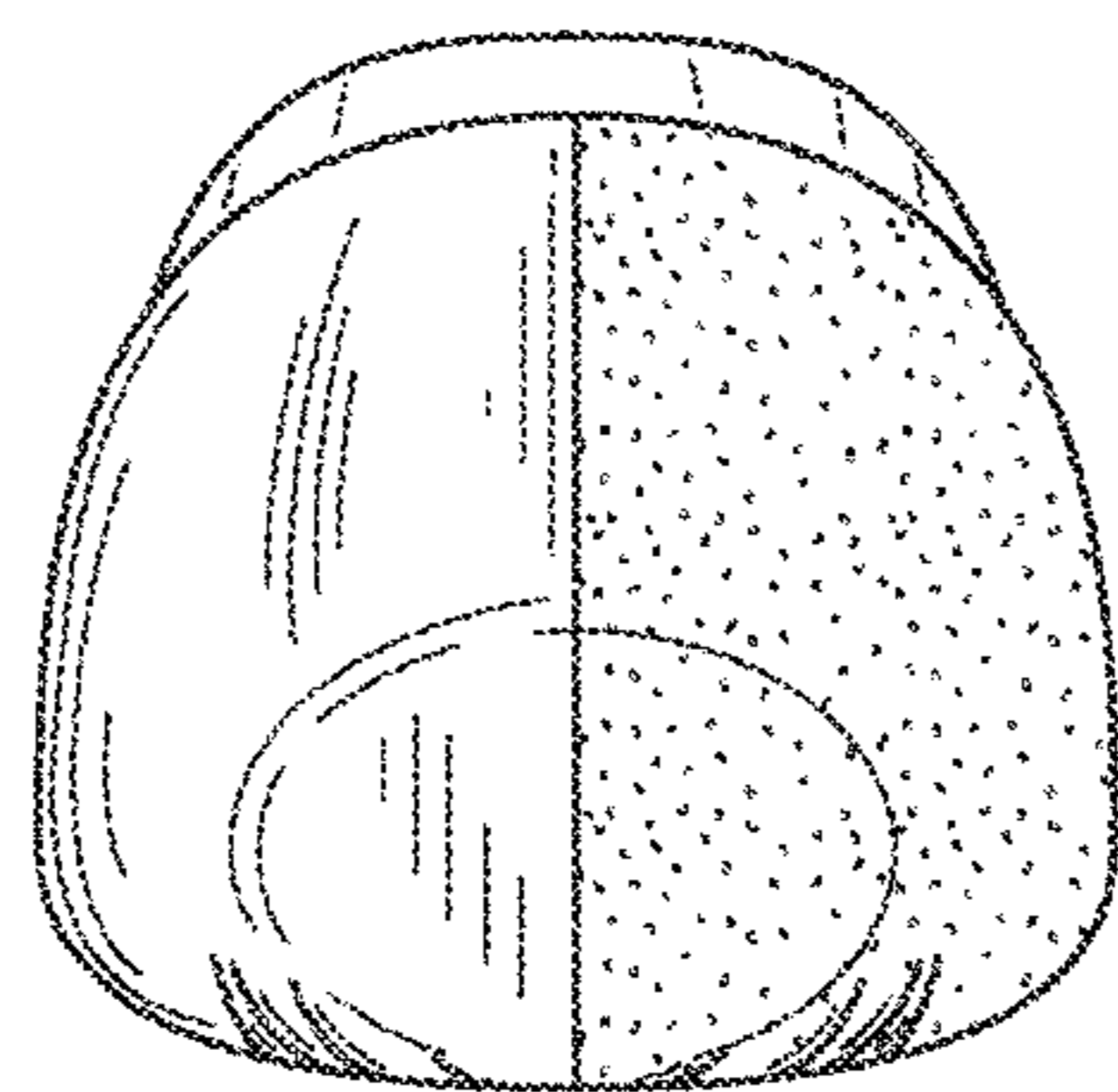

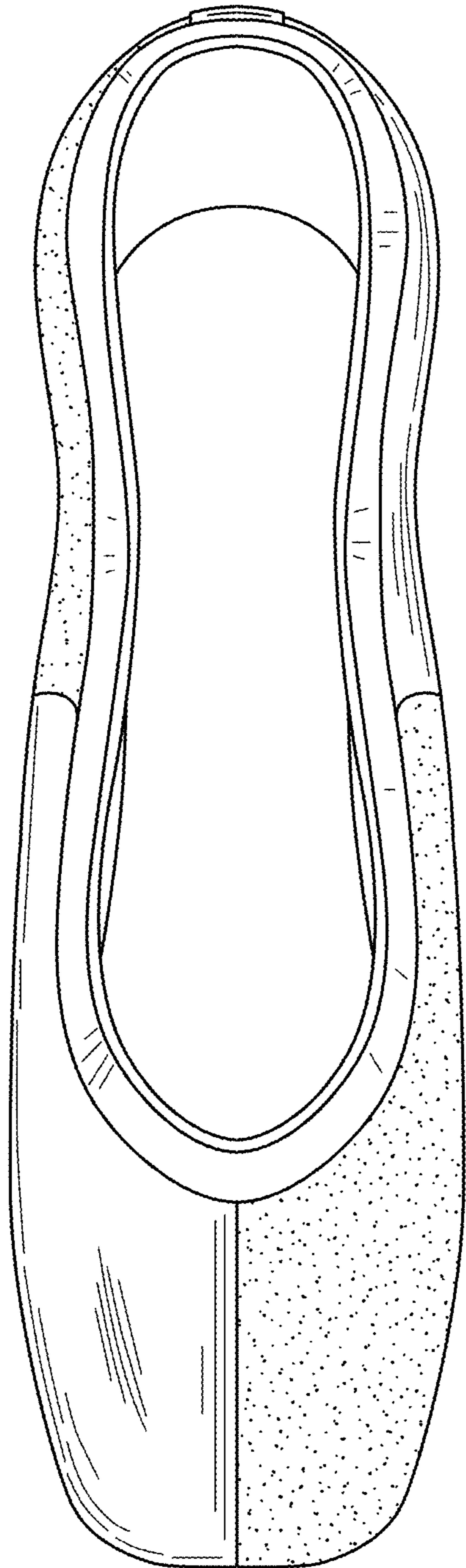

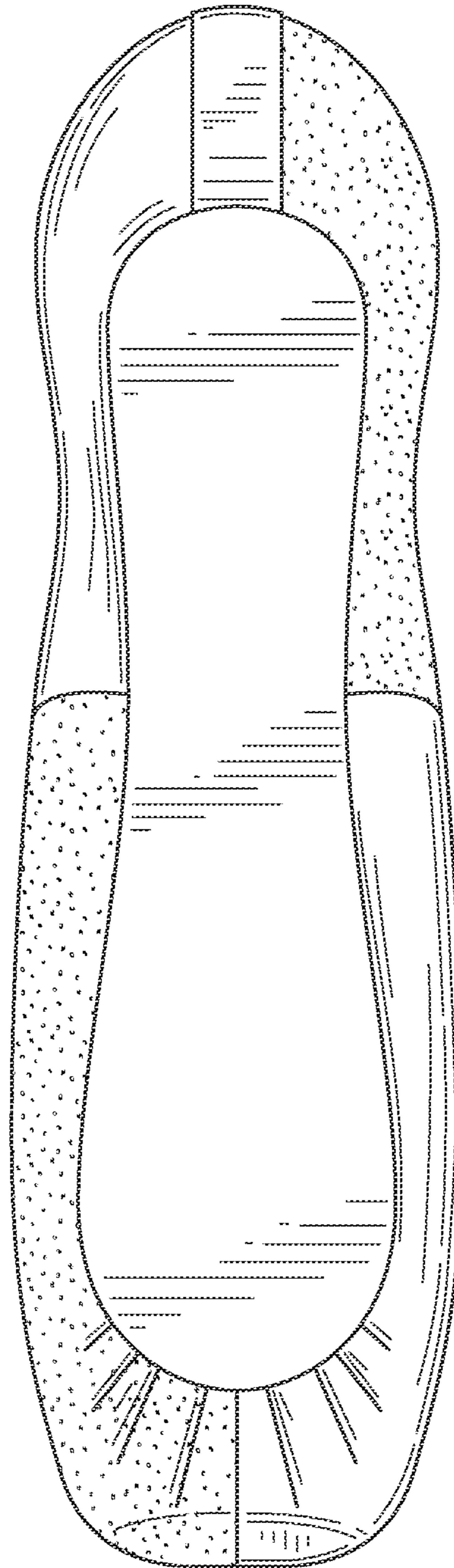
