**DESCRIPTION**

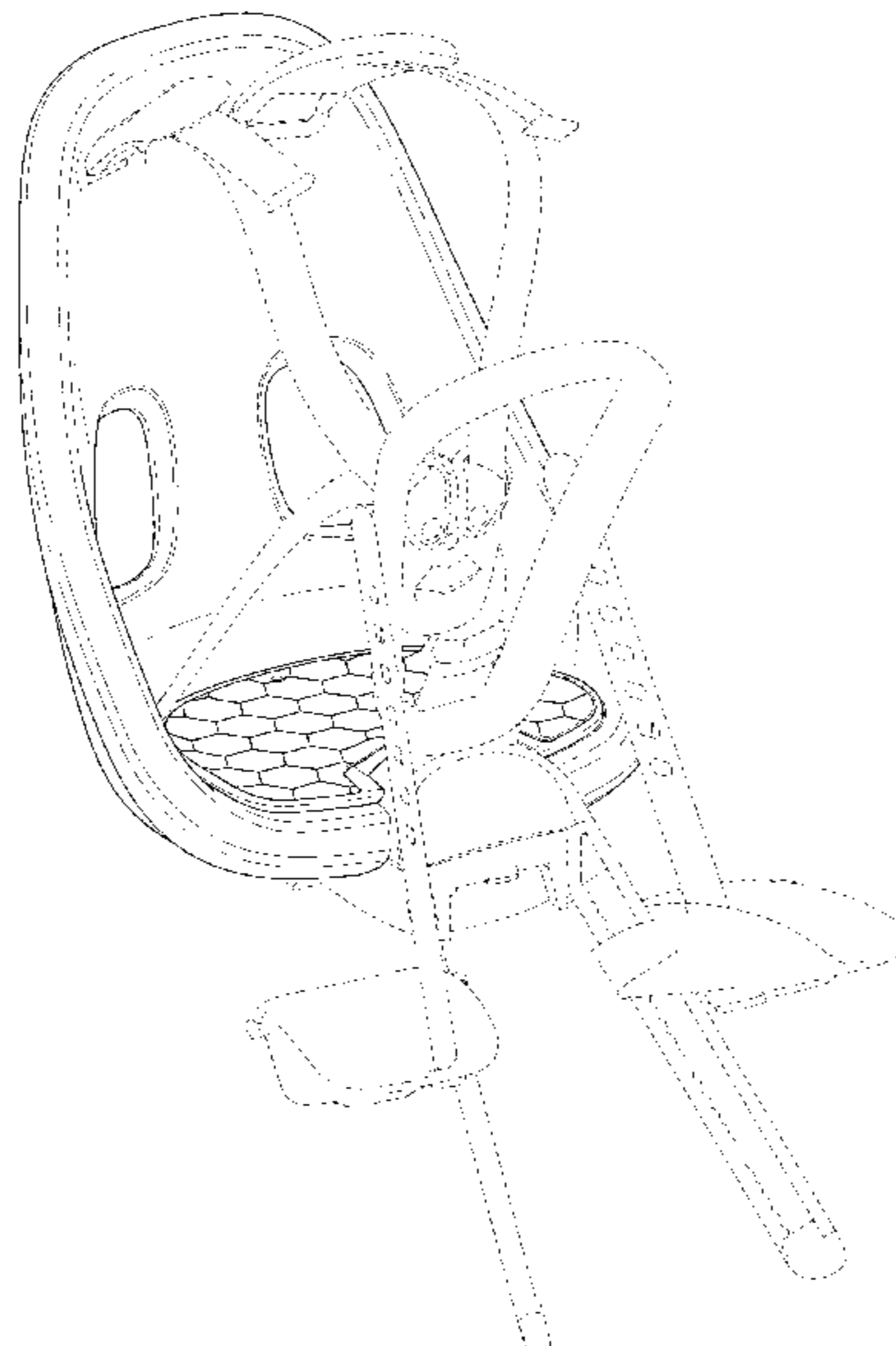
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a child’s seat showing the claimed design;

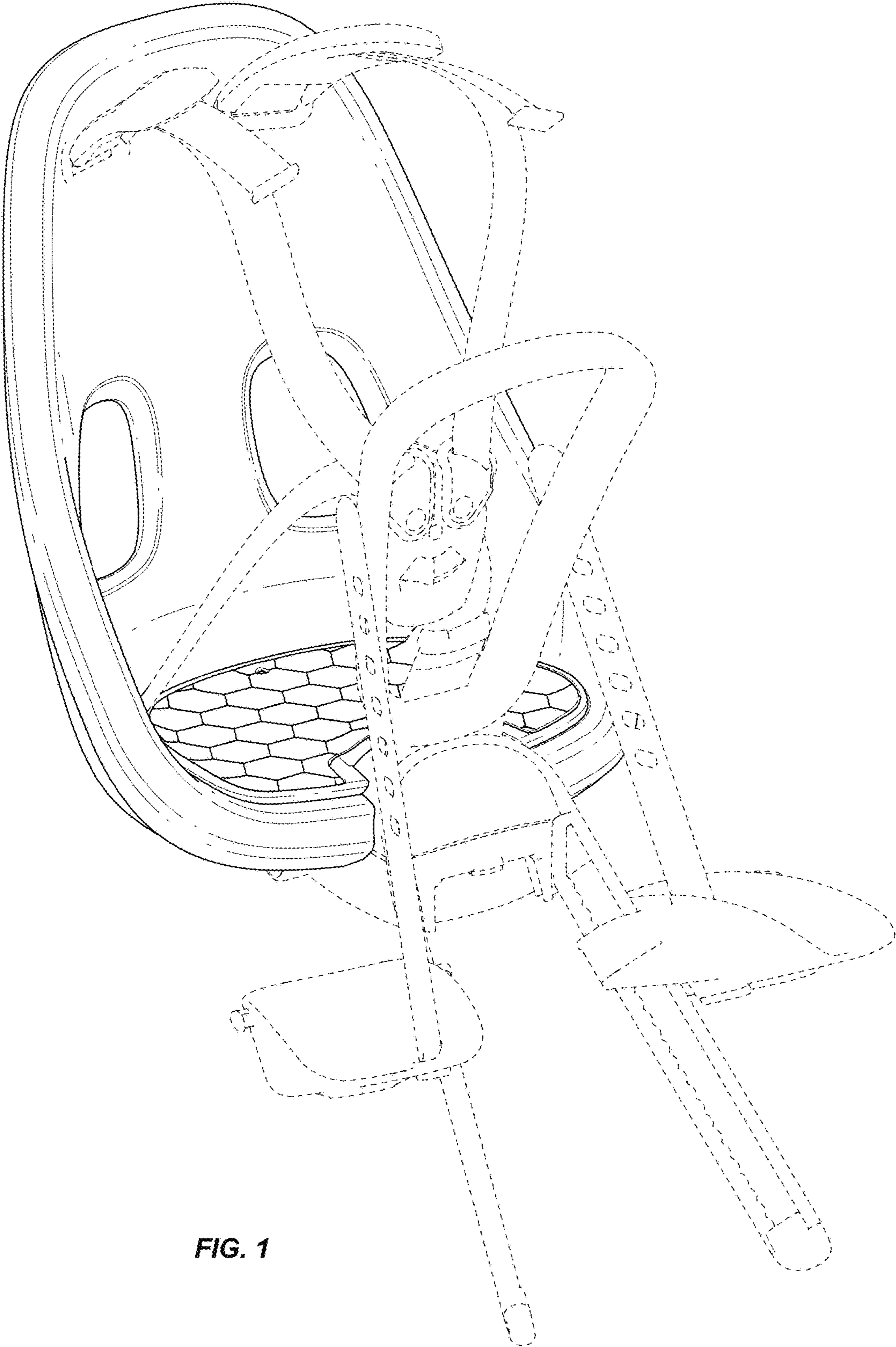

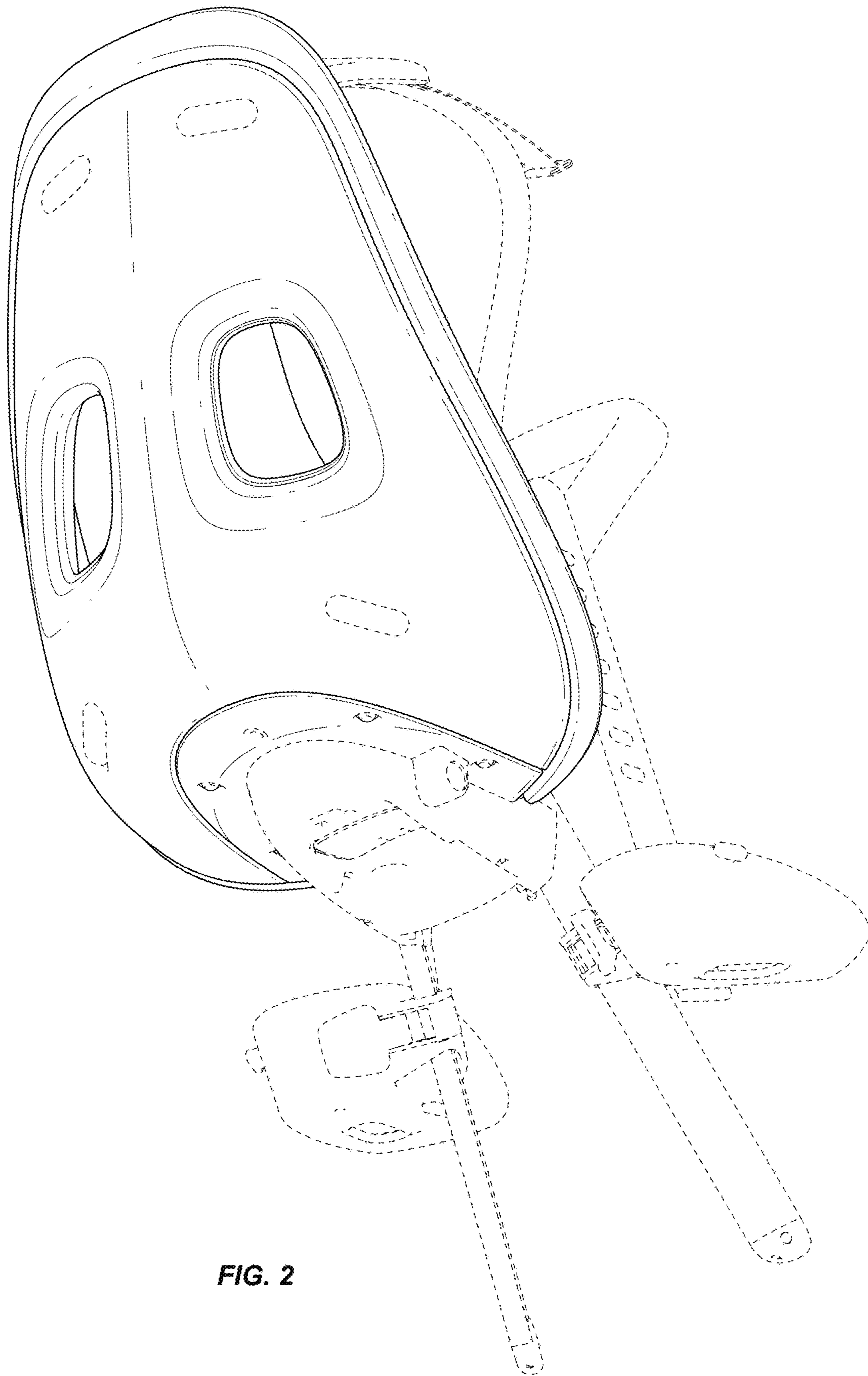

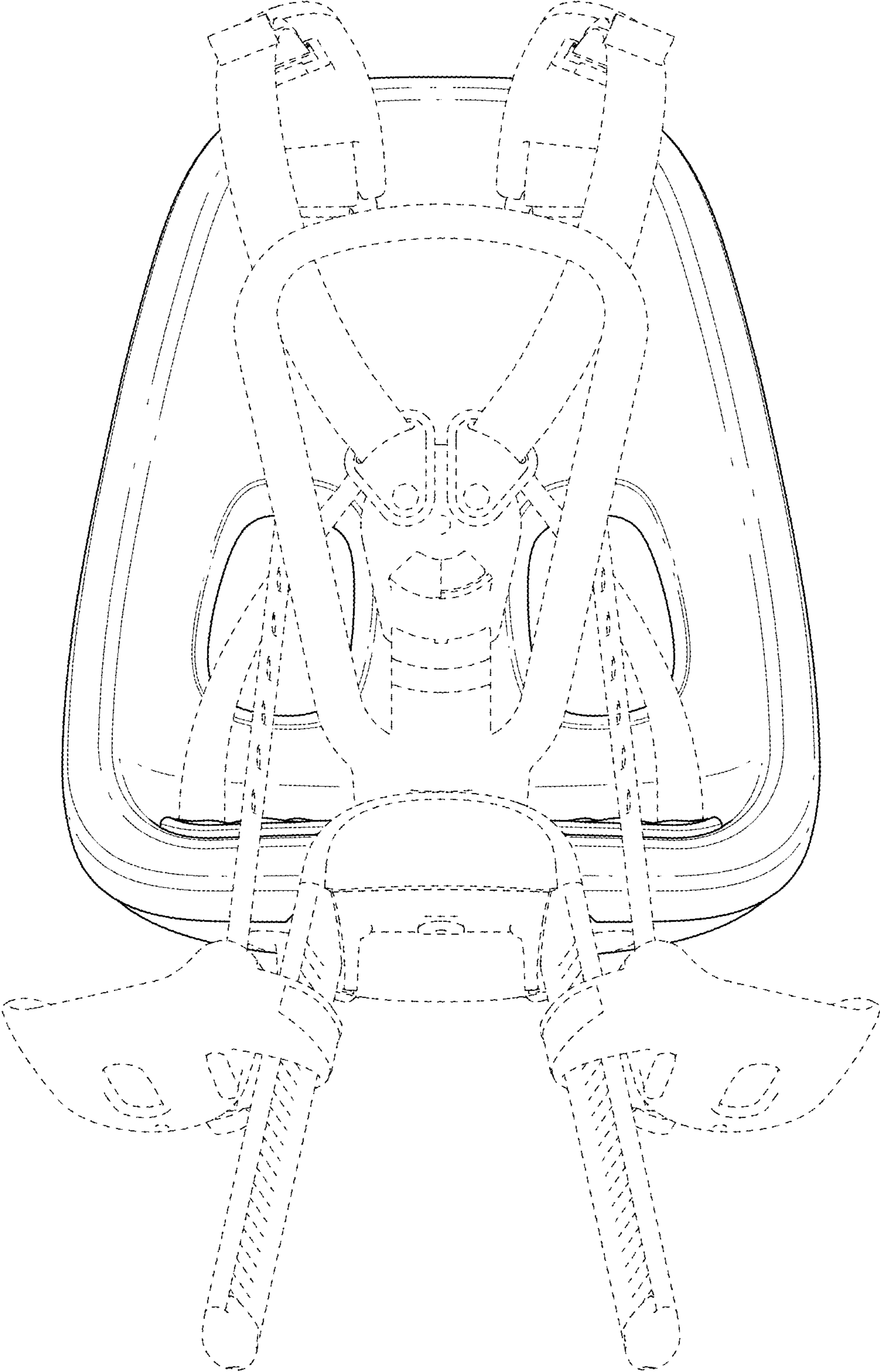

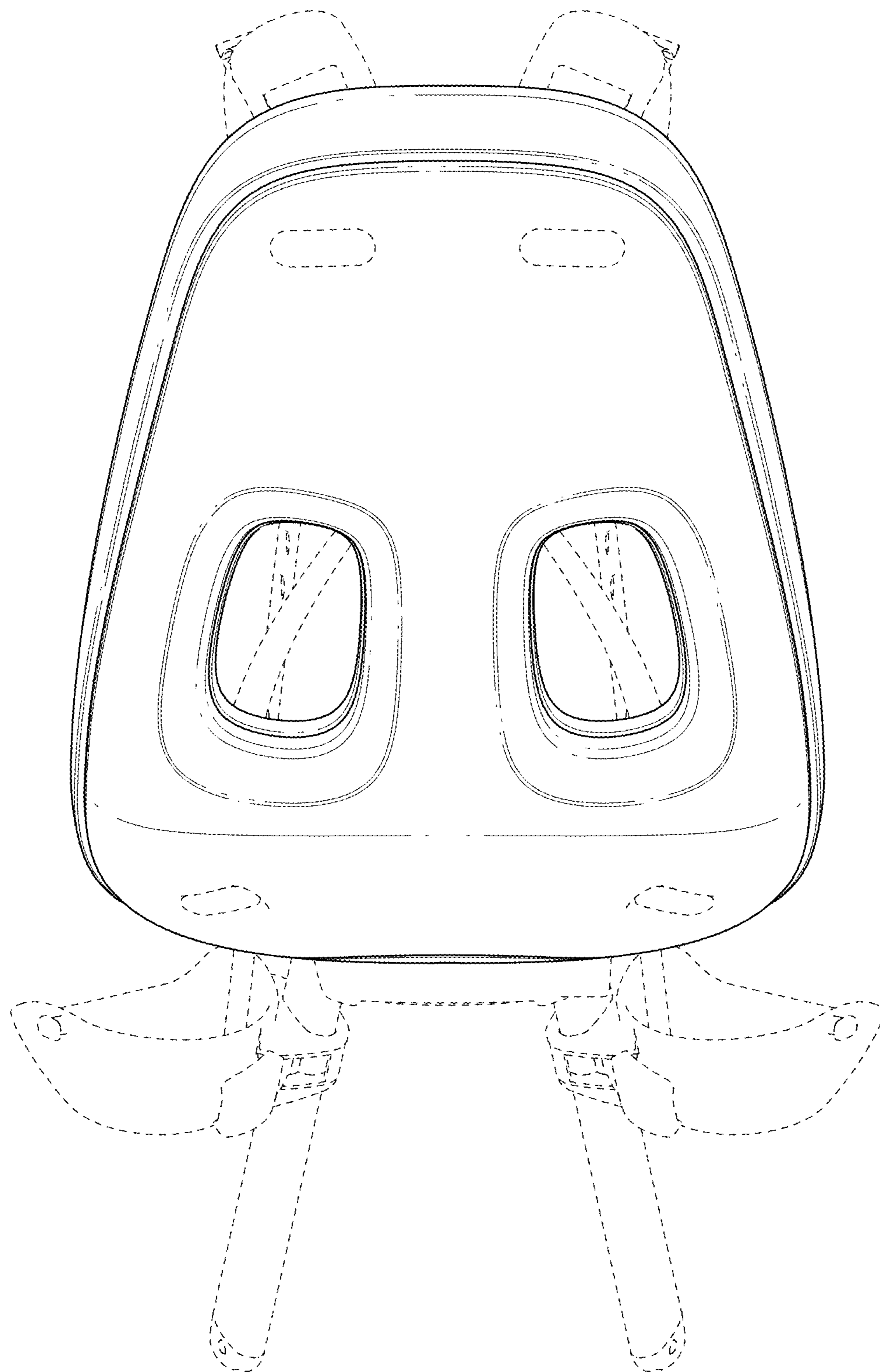

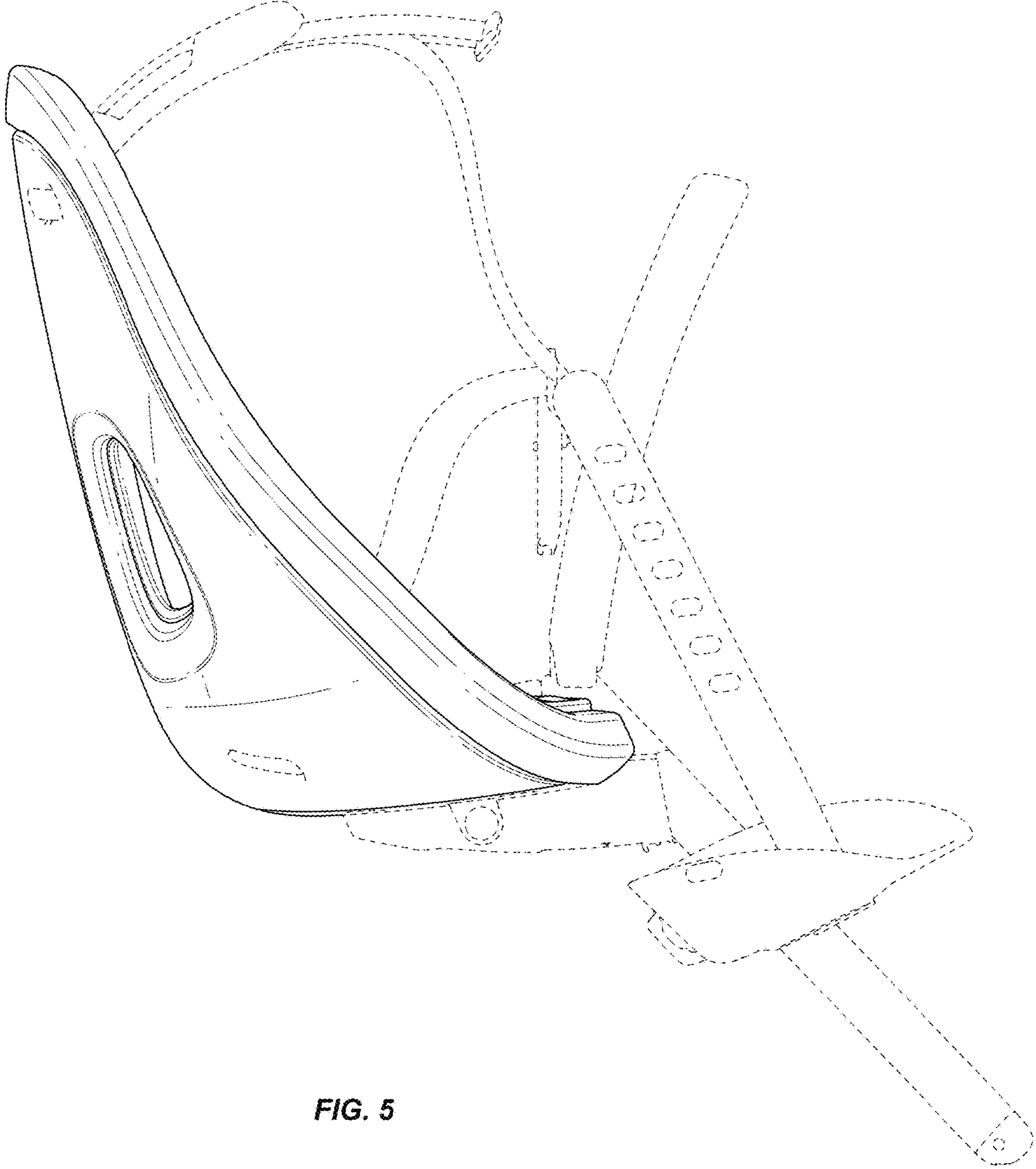

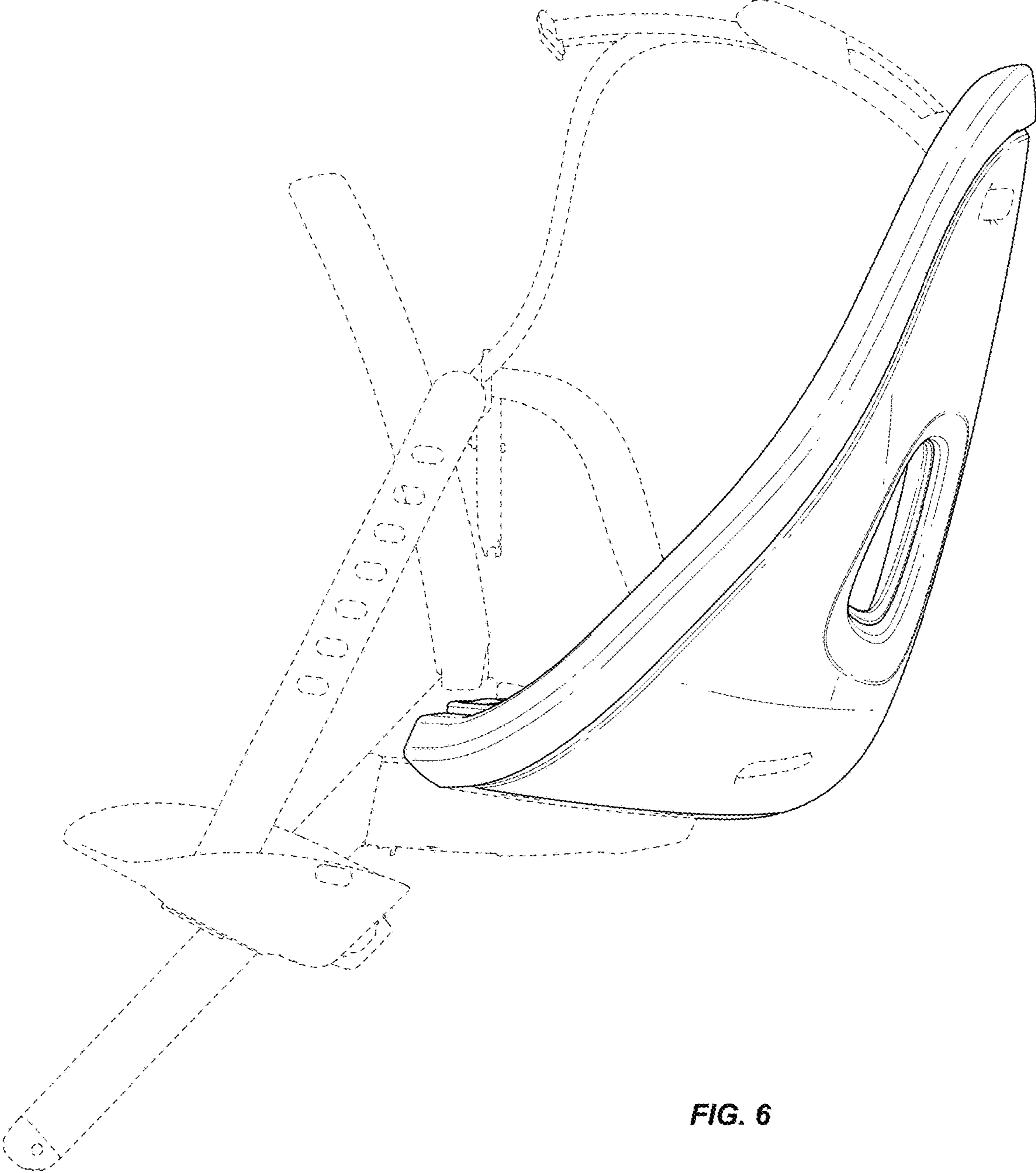

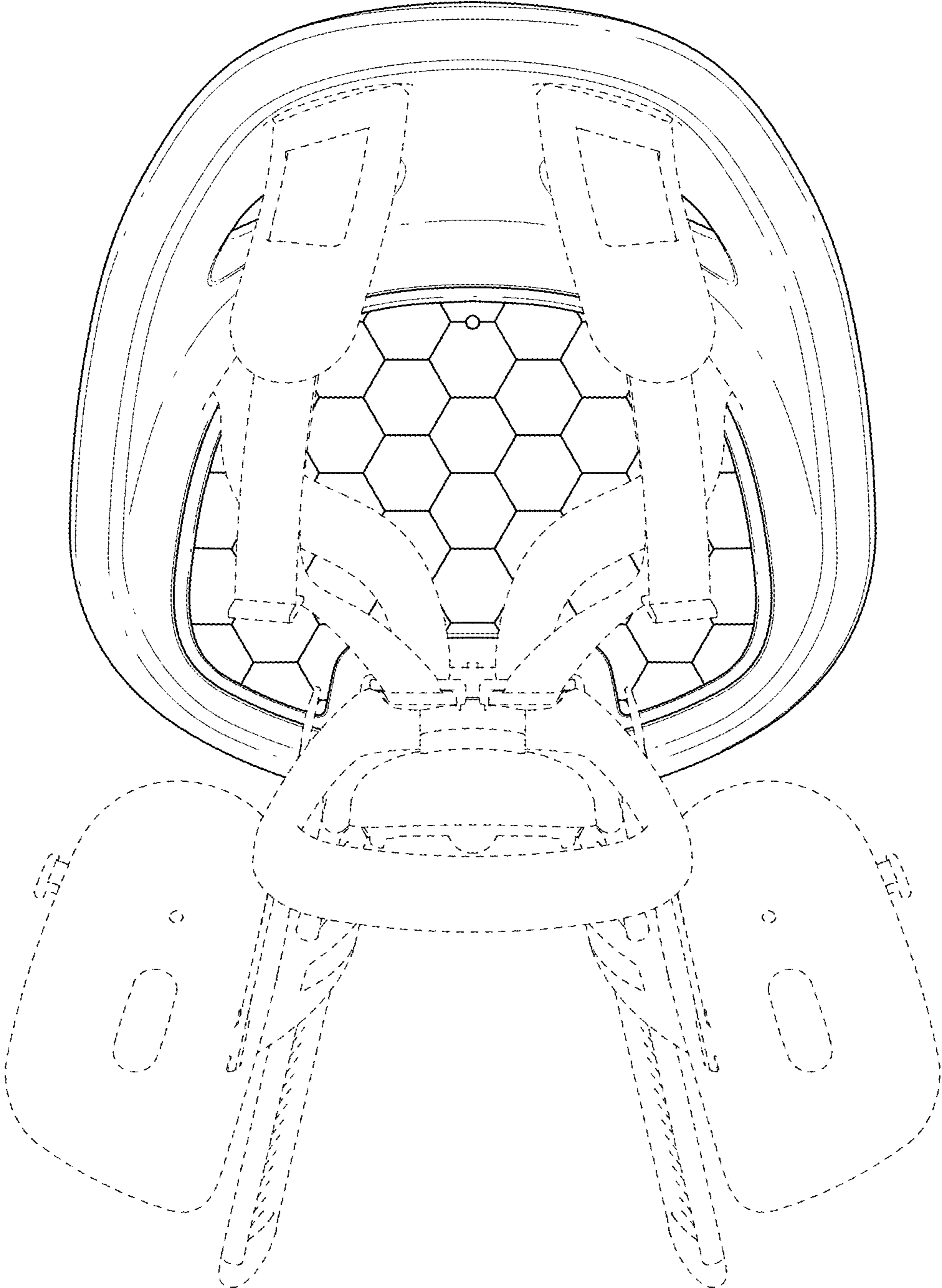

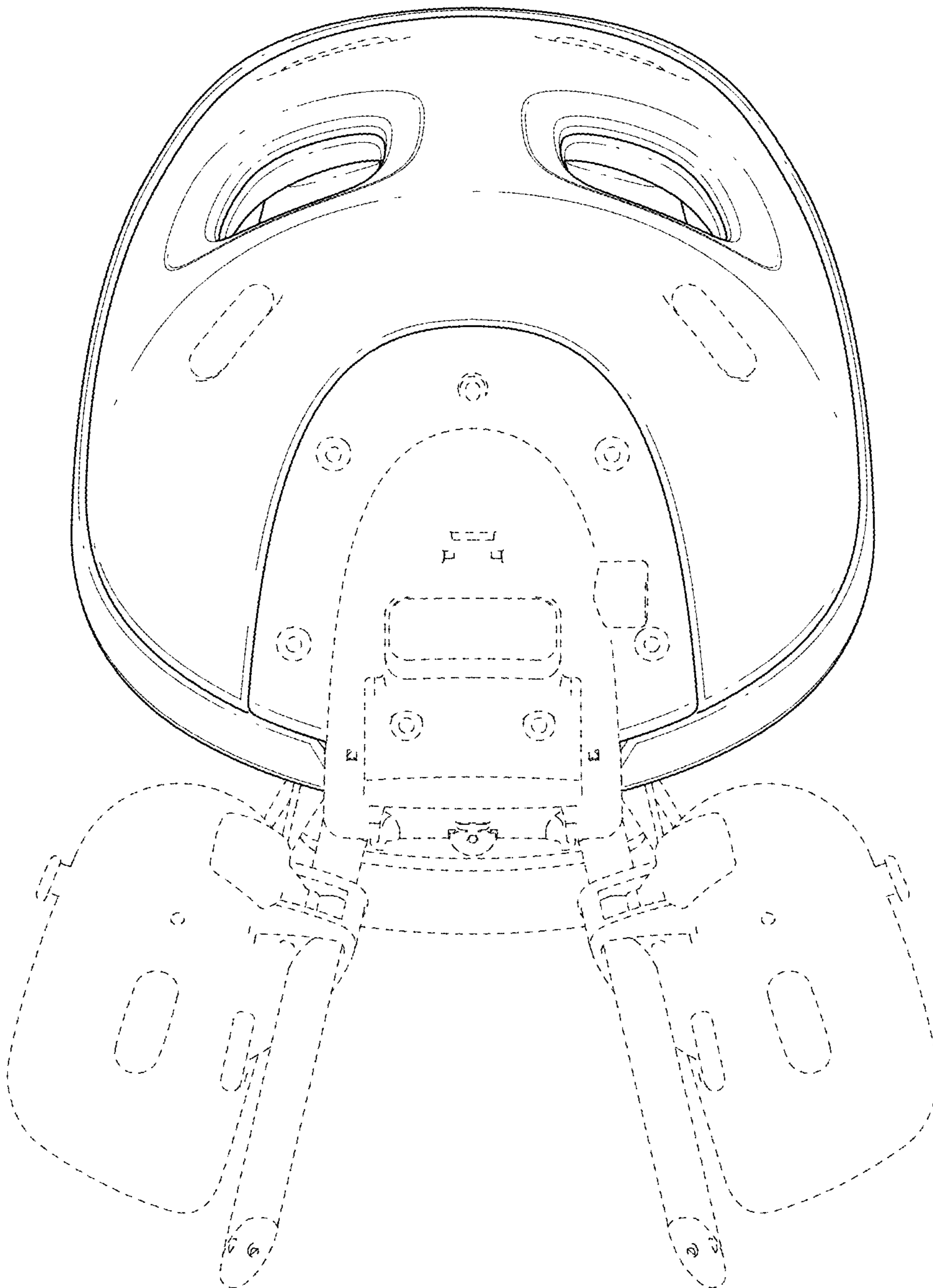
