FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

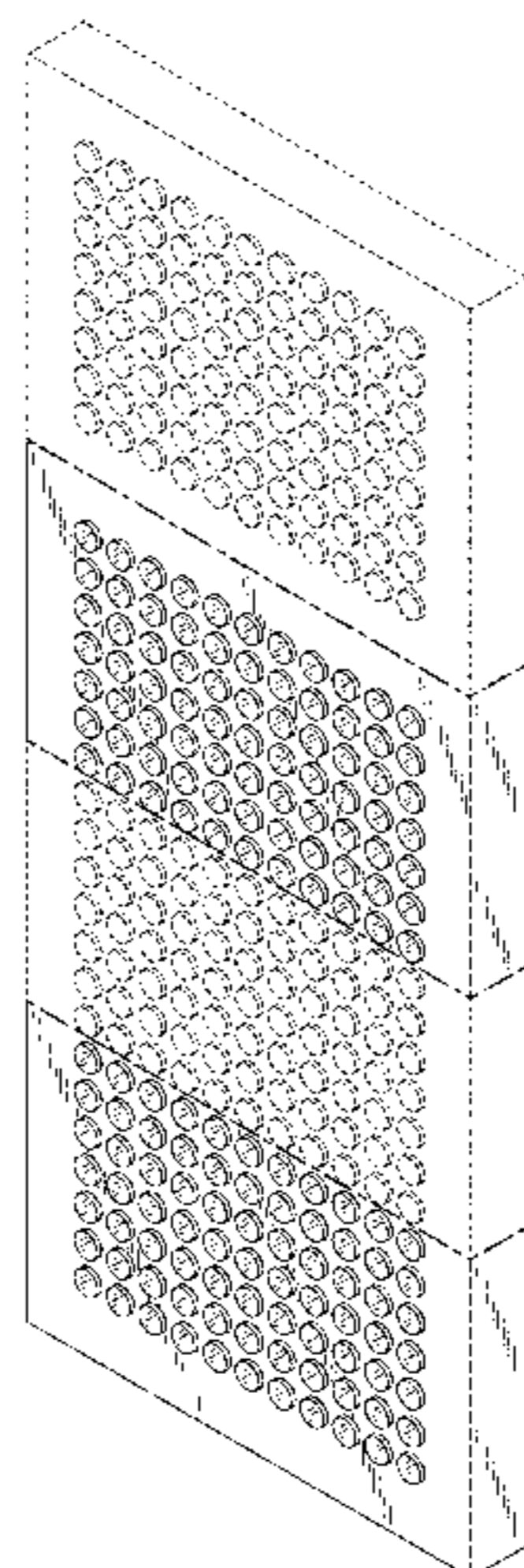

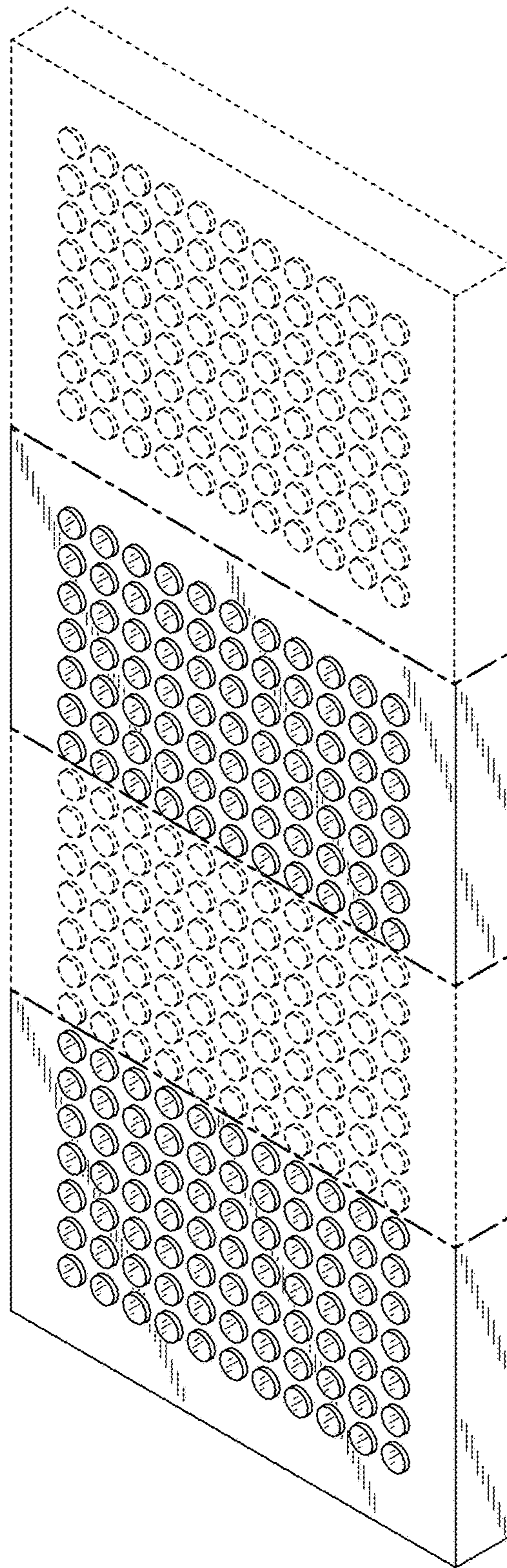

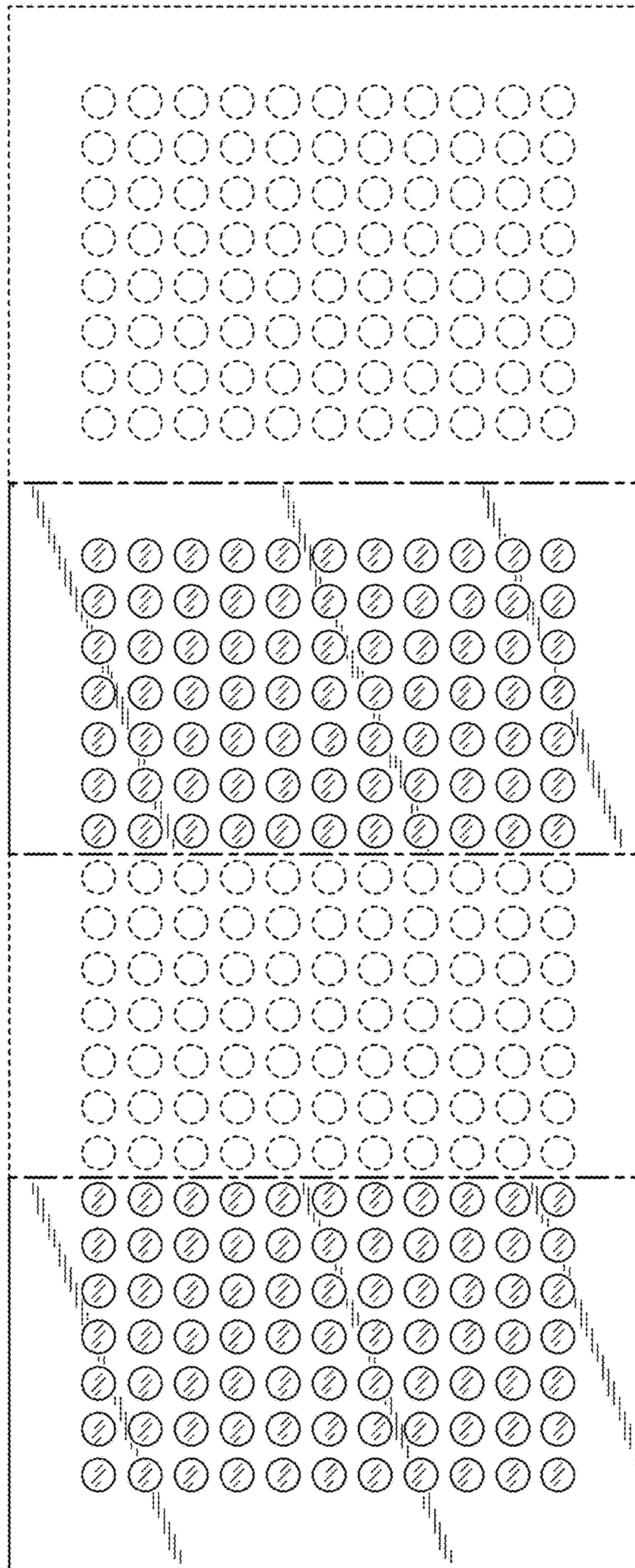

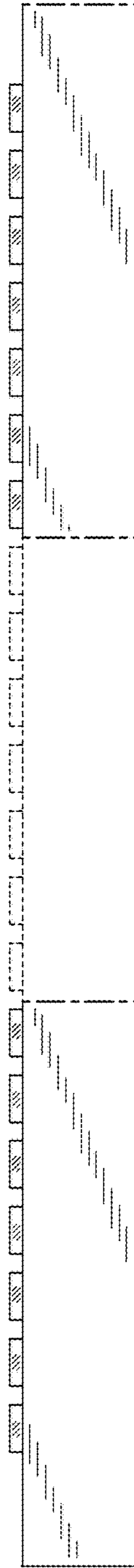
