DESCRIPTION

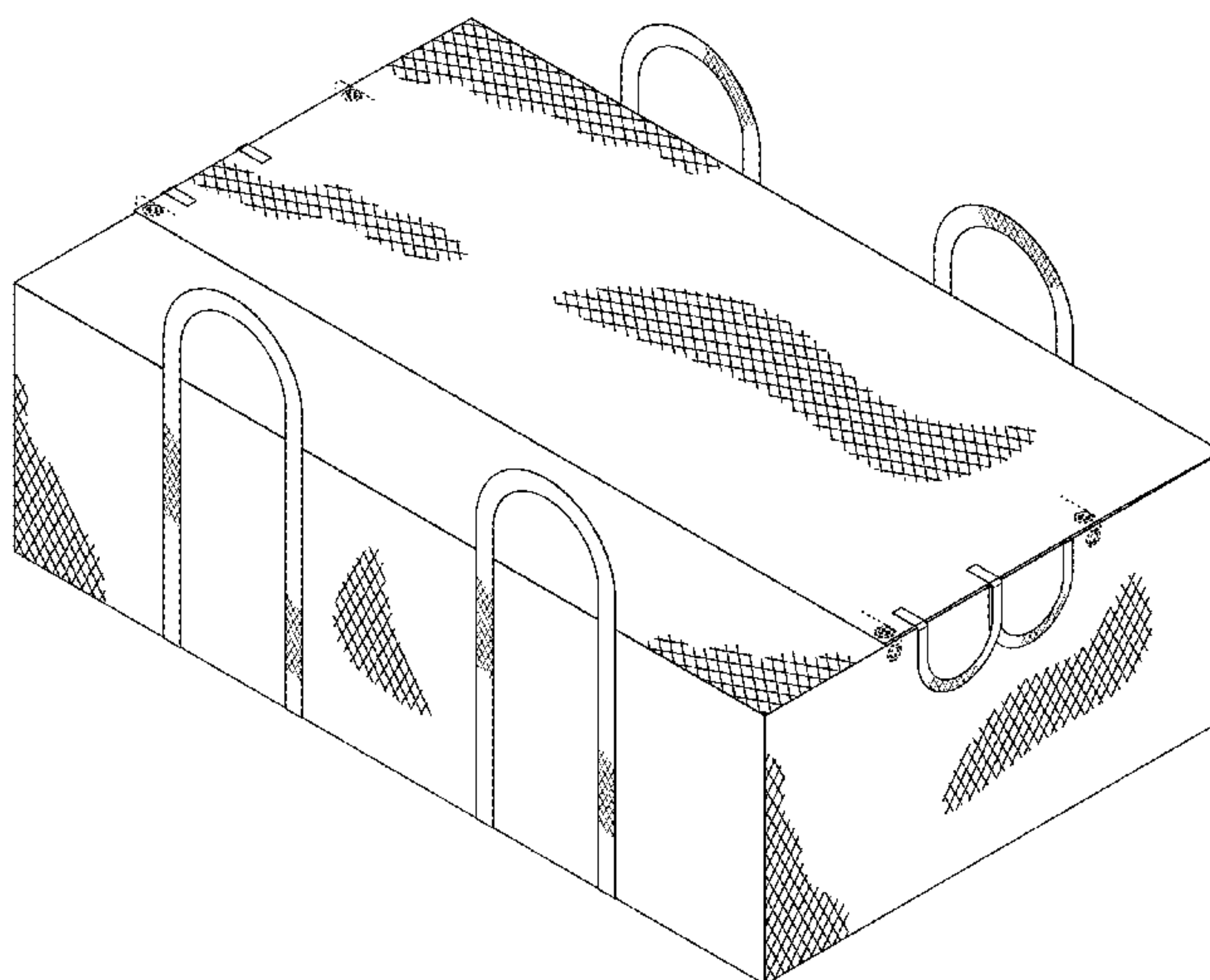
FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a storage waste device;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a front, bottom and right left perspective view of the storage waste device.
The broken lines shown in the Figures are for the purpose of illustrating portions of the storage waste device and form no part of the claimed design.
The cross-hatching shading in the figures is fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration, it being understood that the shading is uniformly continued over the surfaces on which it appears.

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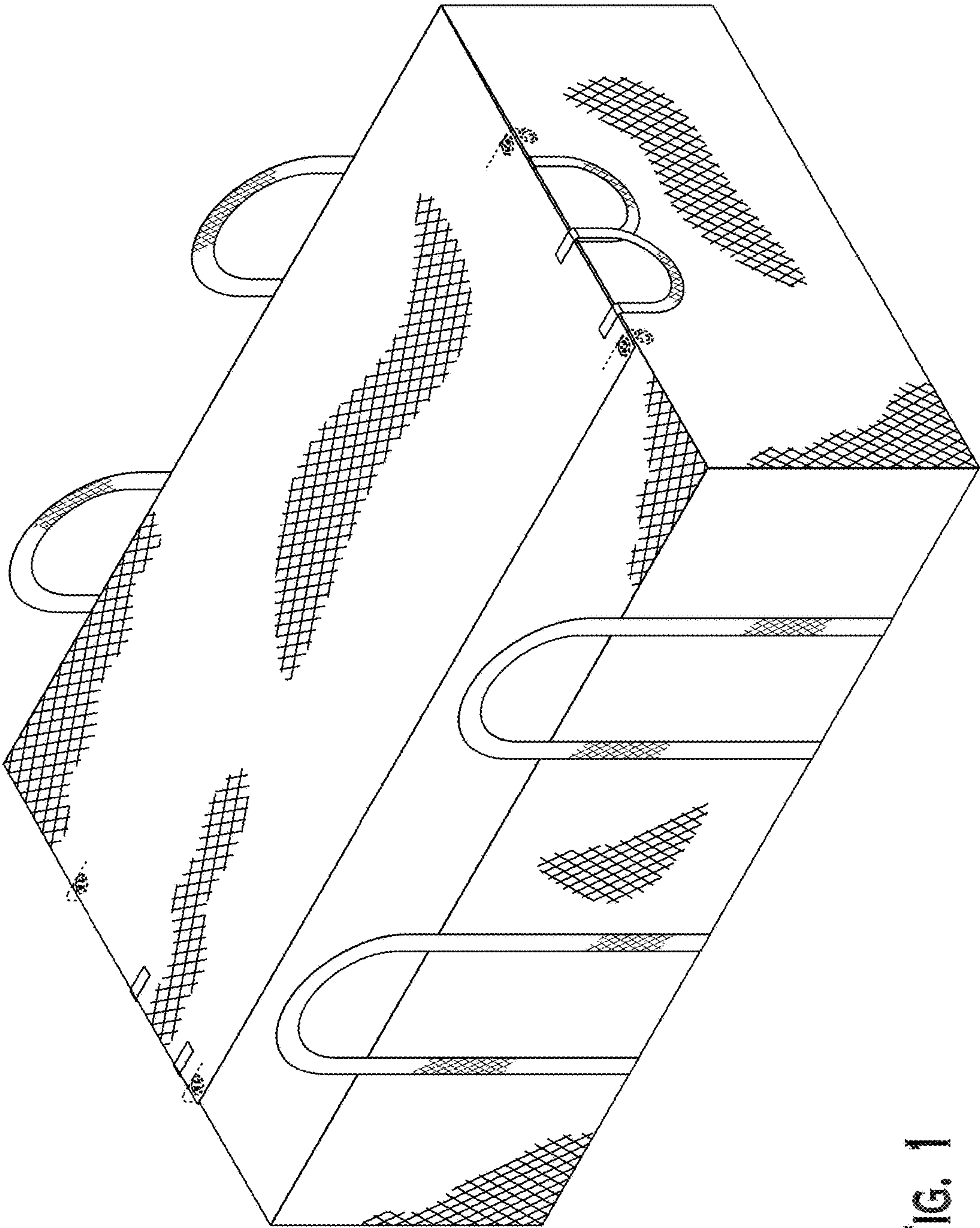

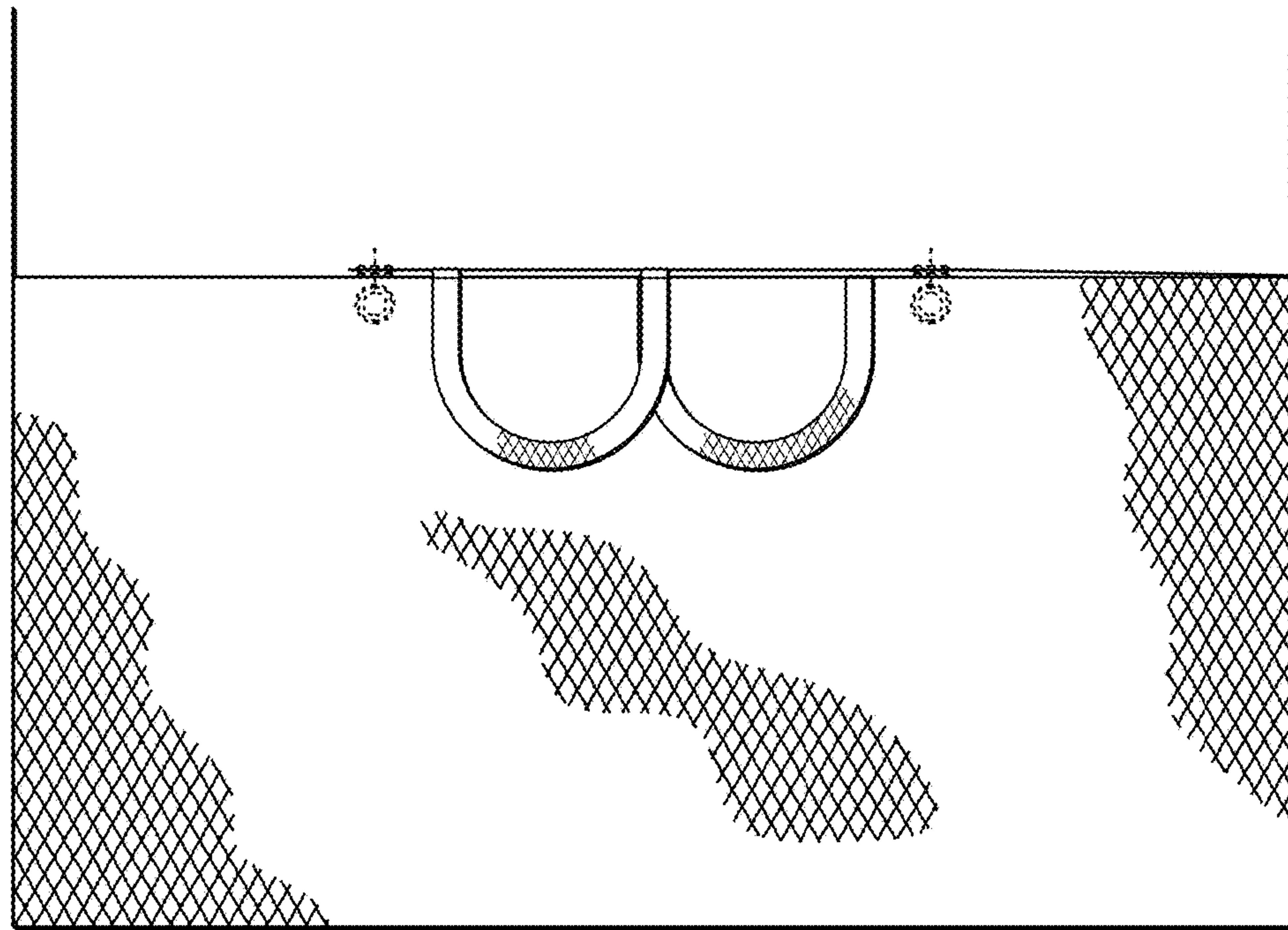

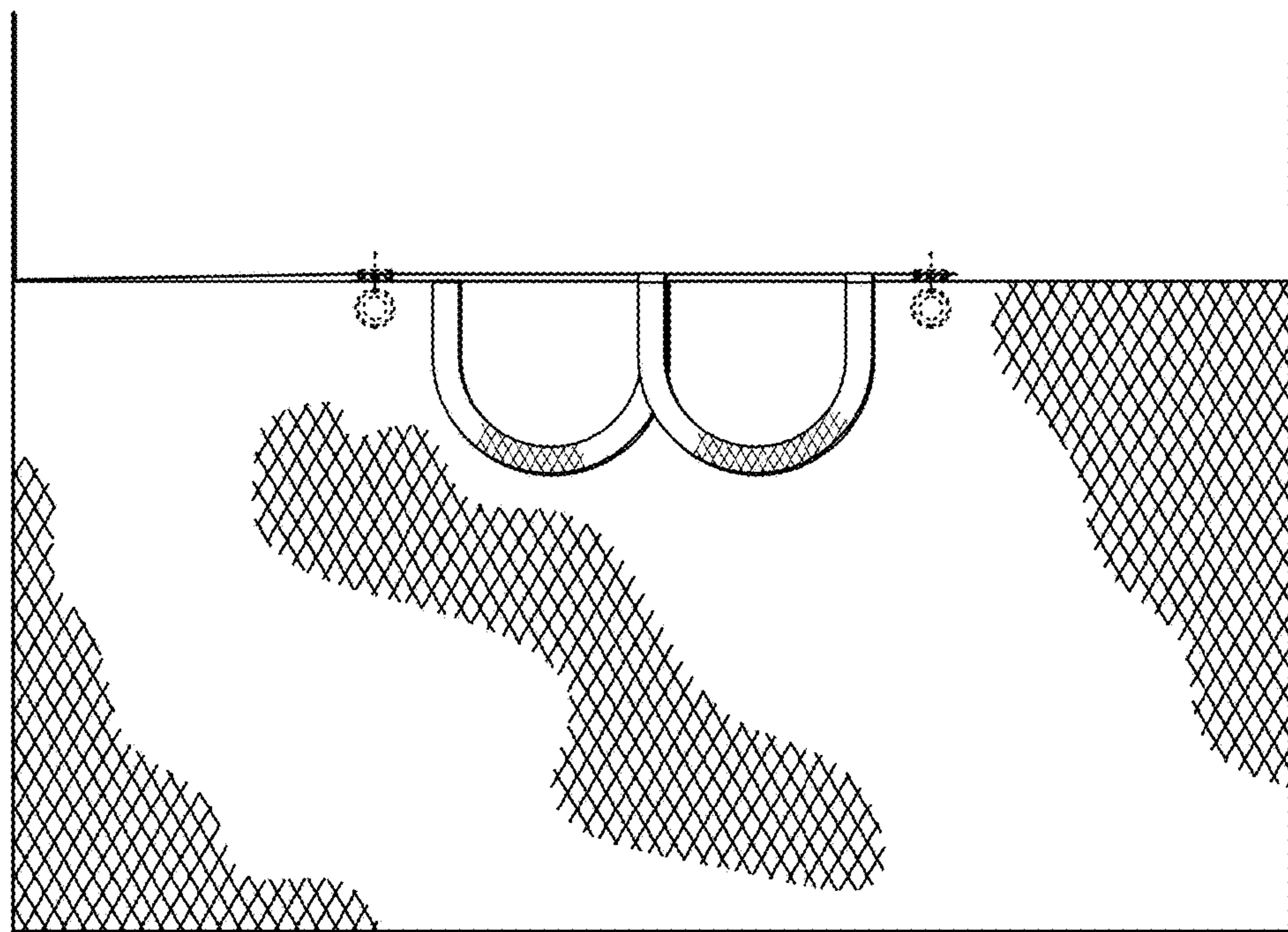

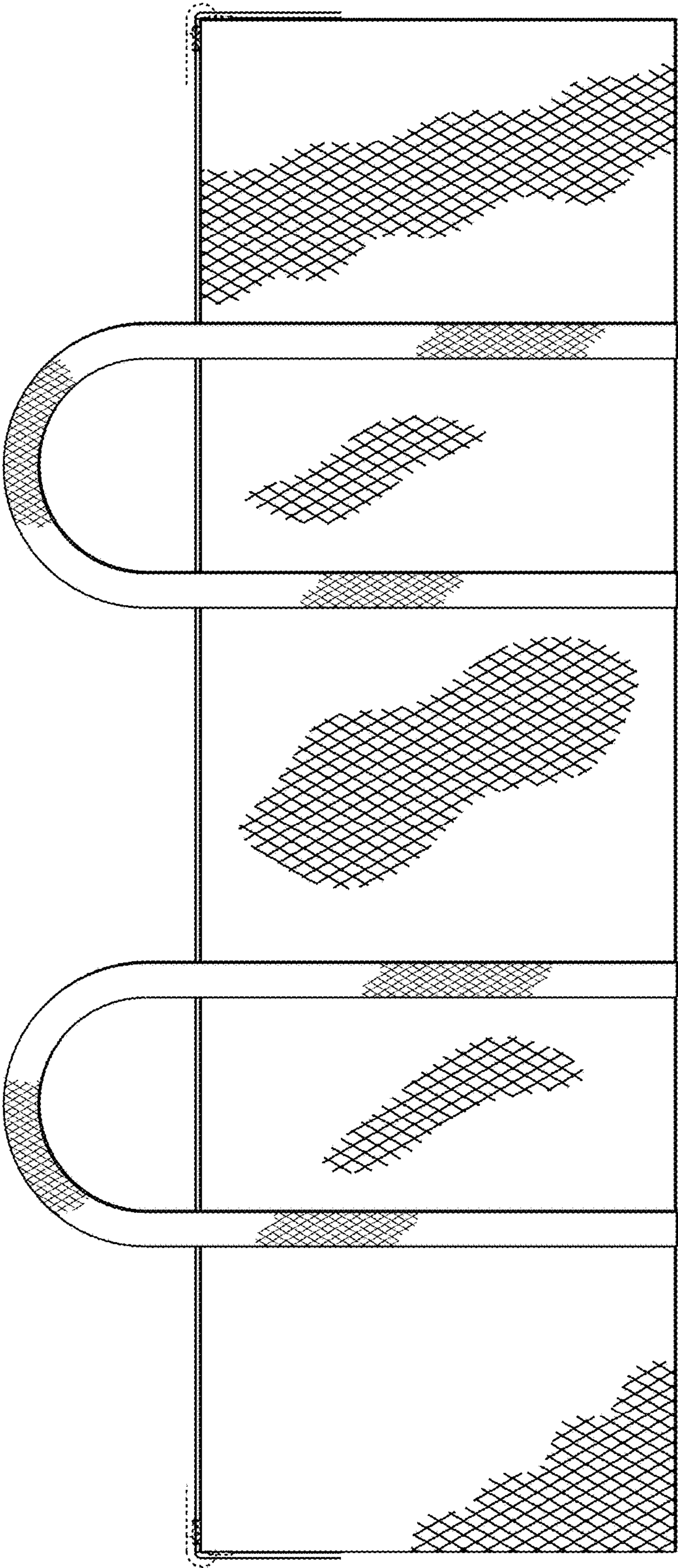

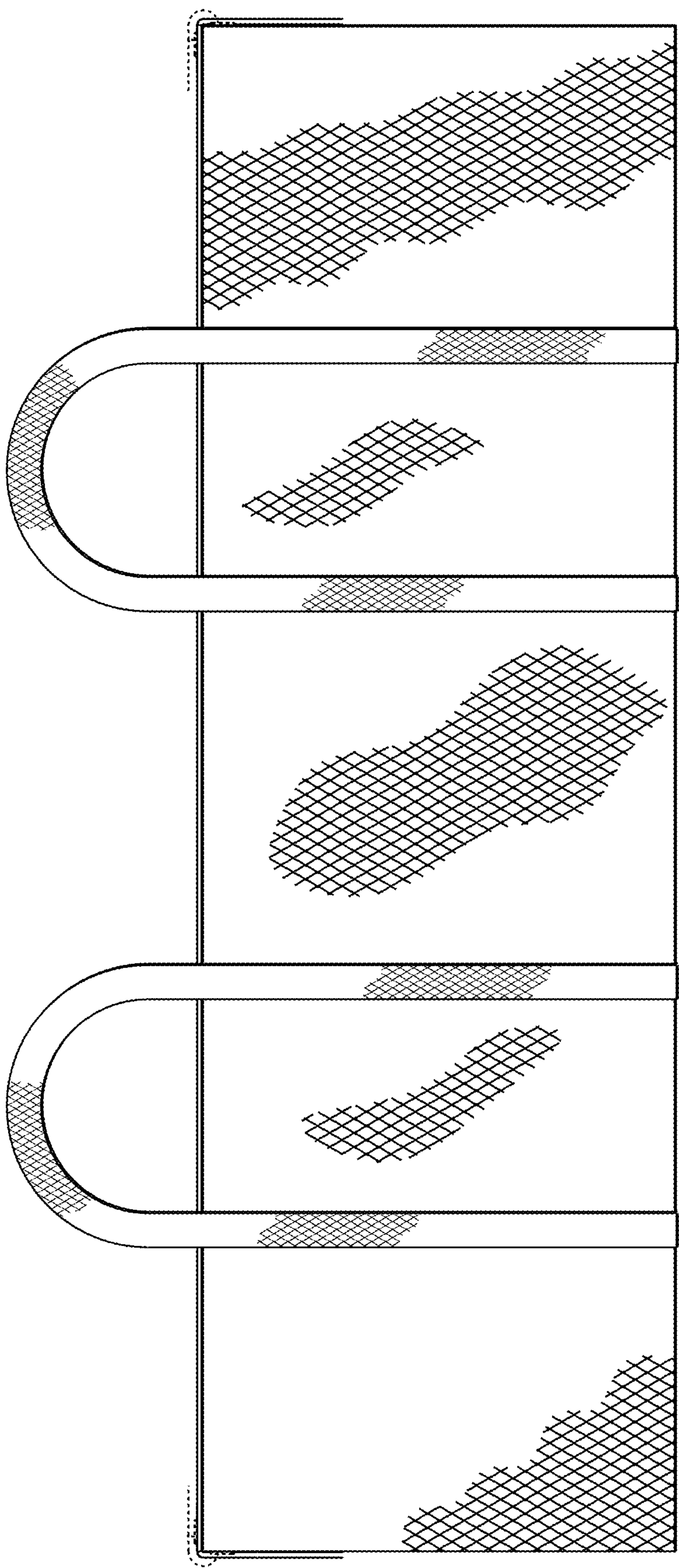

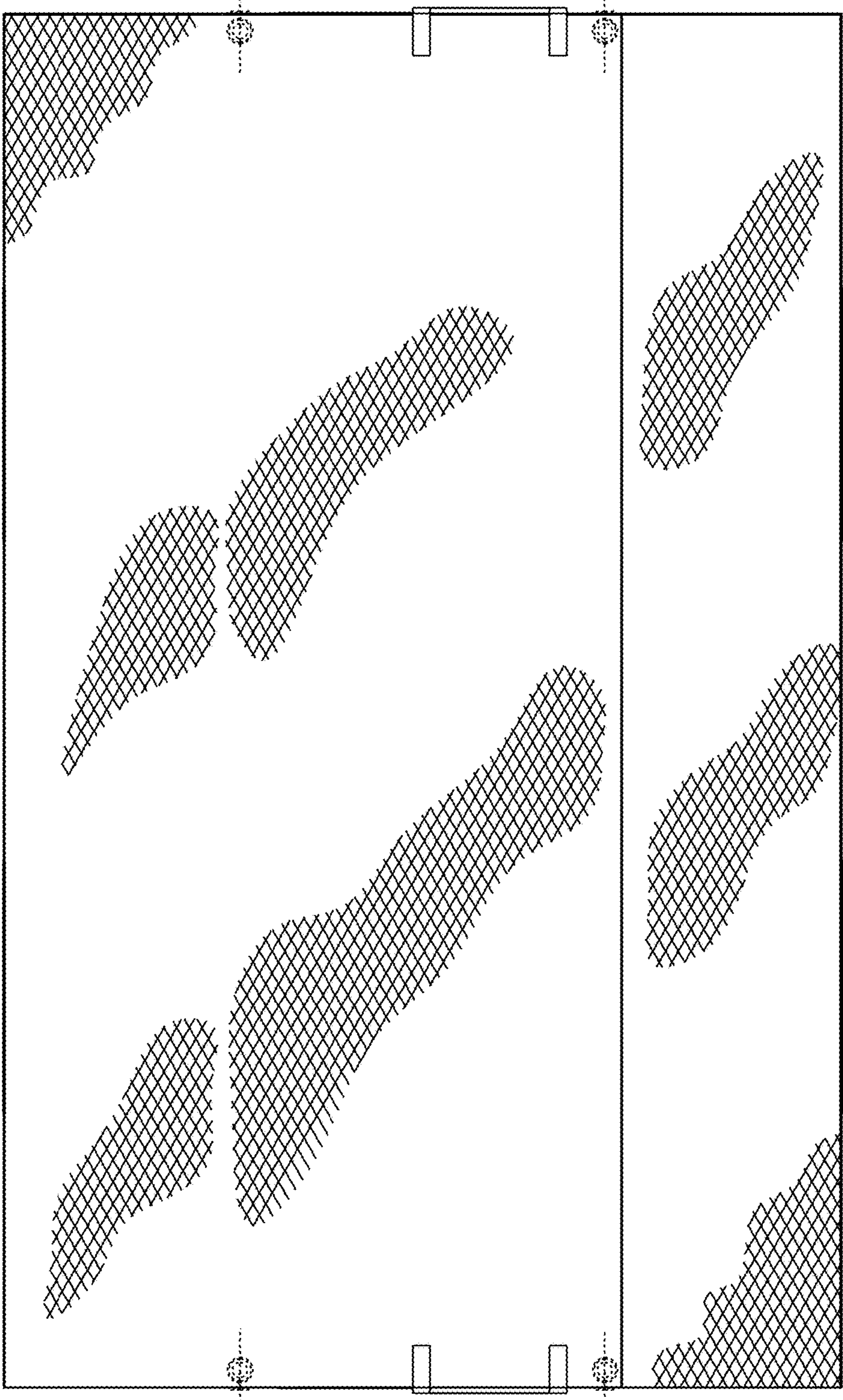

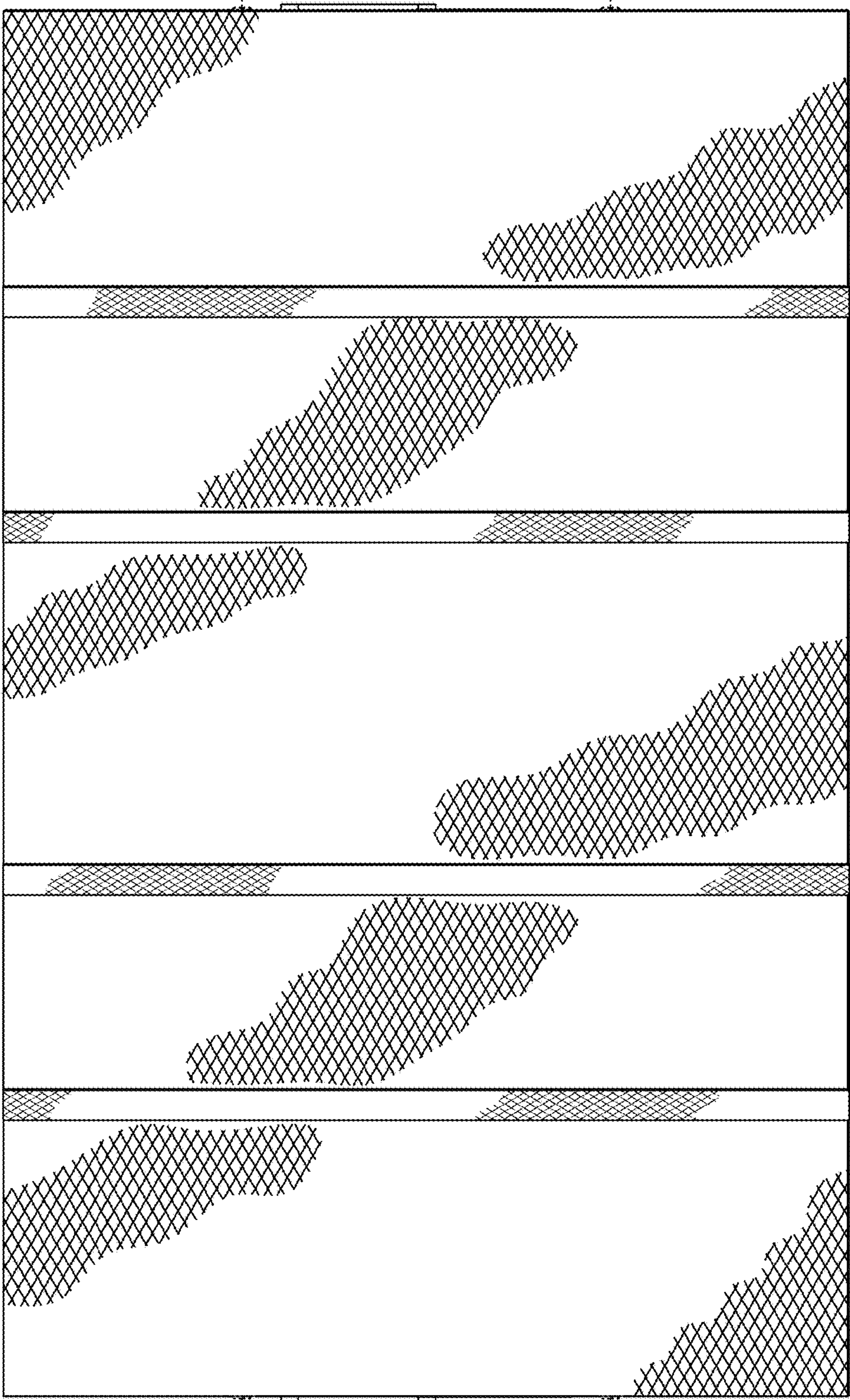

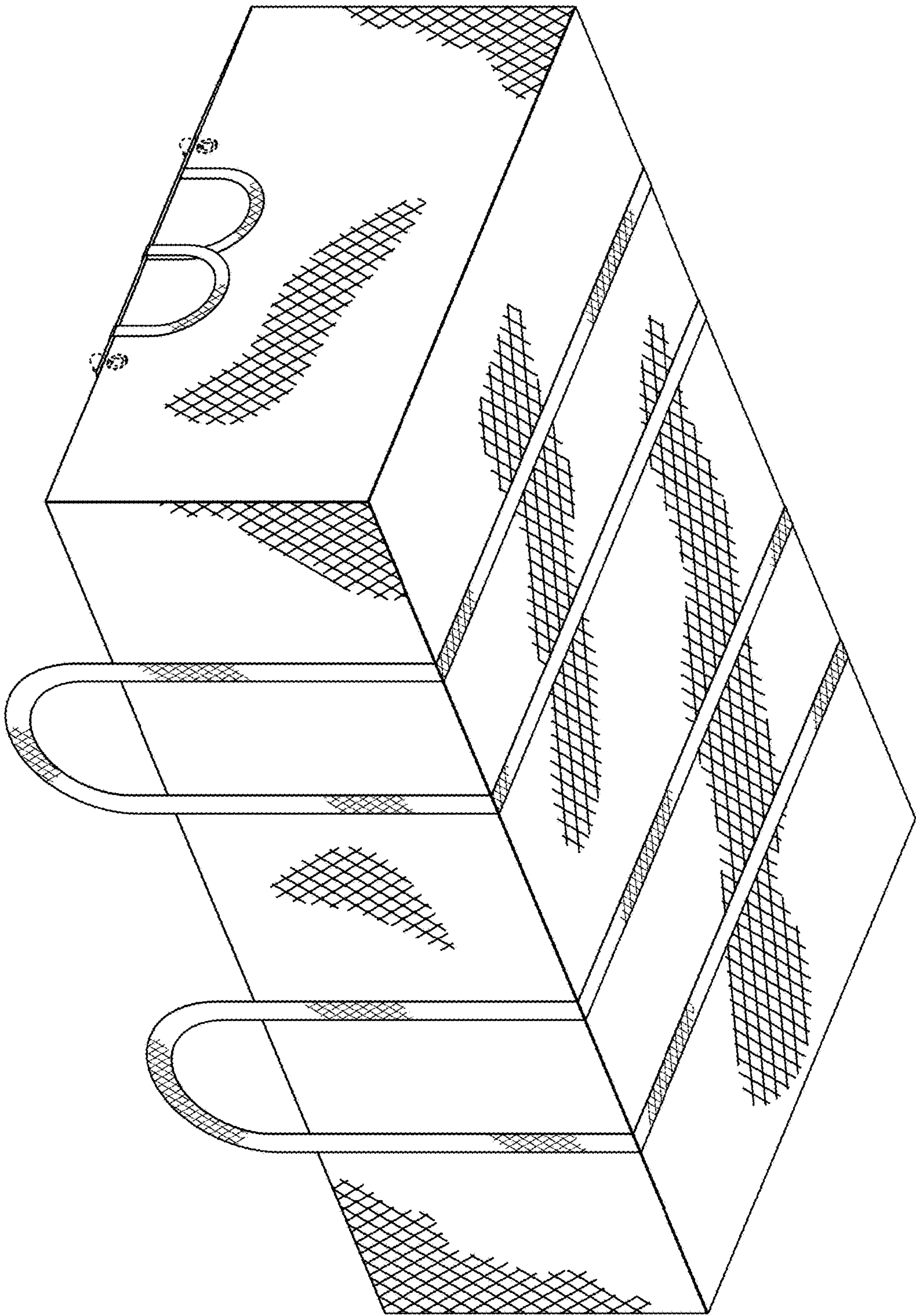
