
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a physical therapy and patient movement apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a physical therapy and patient movement apparatus showing our new design. FIG. 2 is a front view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a rear view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1. FIG. 4 is a left side view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a right side view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a top view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the apparatus design of FIG. 1. The broken lines in the figures are the purpose of illustrating environmental subject matter and form no part of the claim.












