FIG. 17 is a front view of the housing of FIG. 13; and

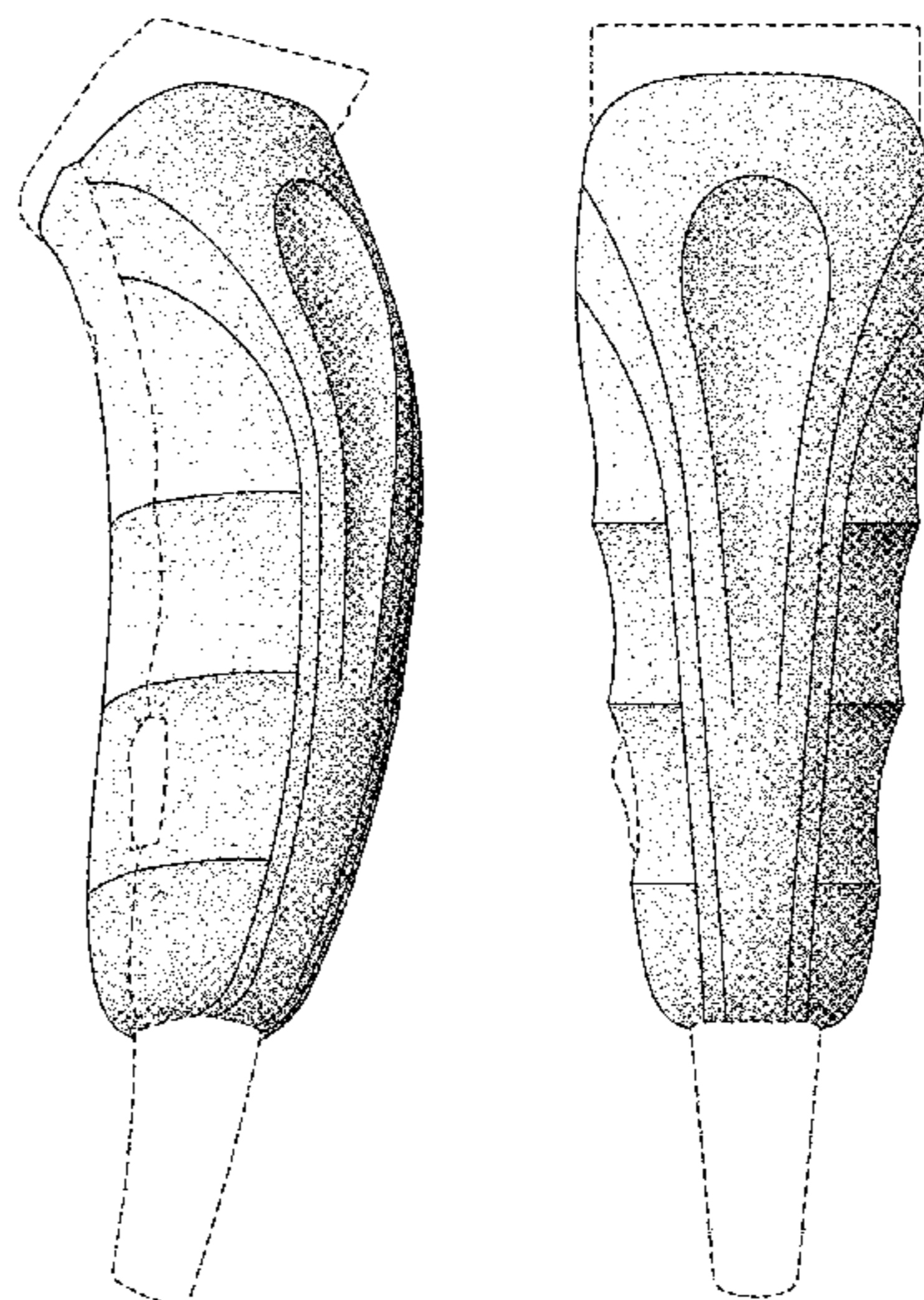
FIG. 18 is a rear view of same.

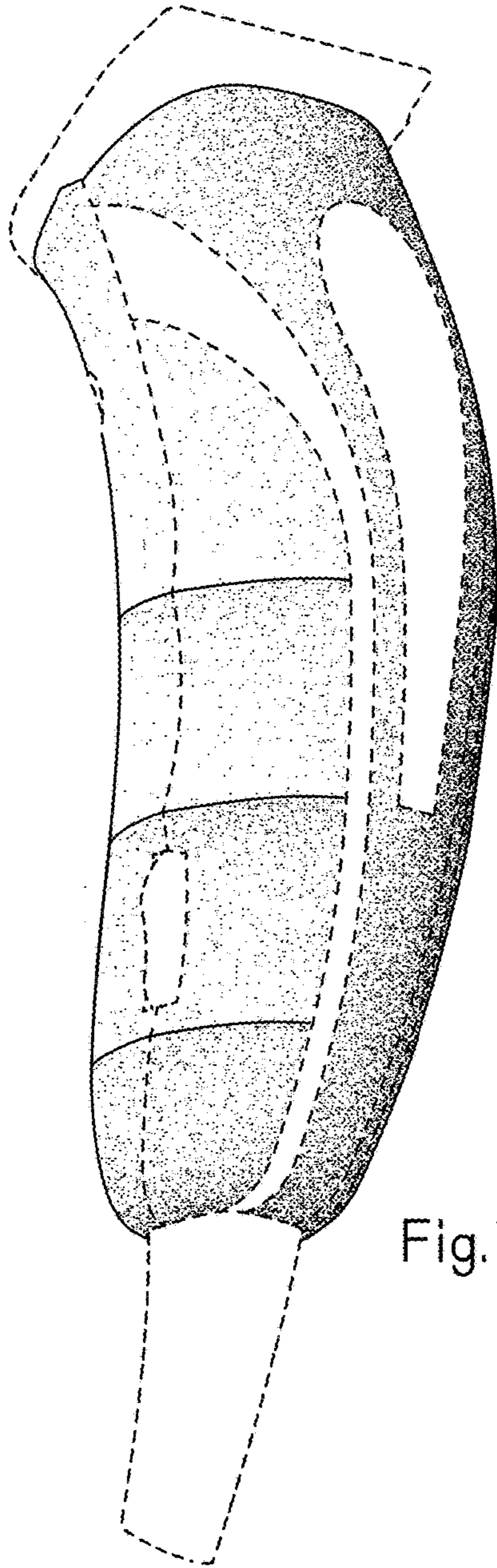

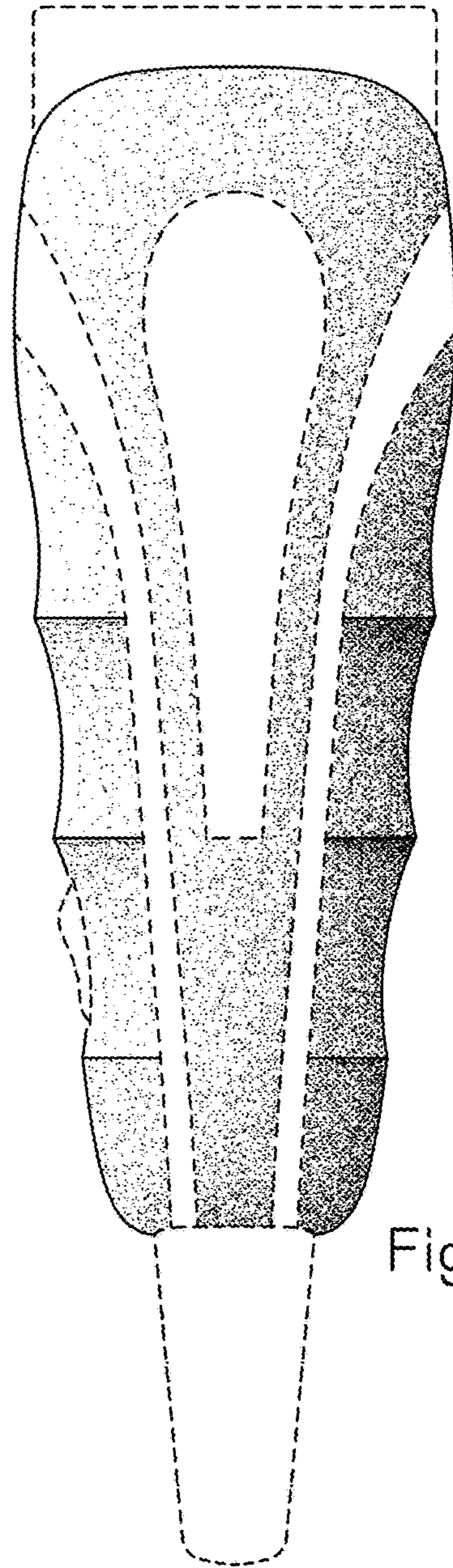

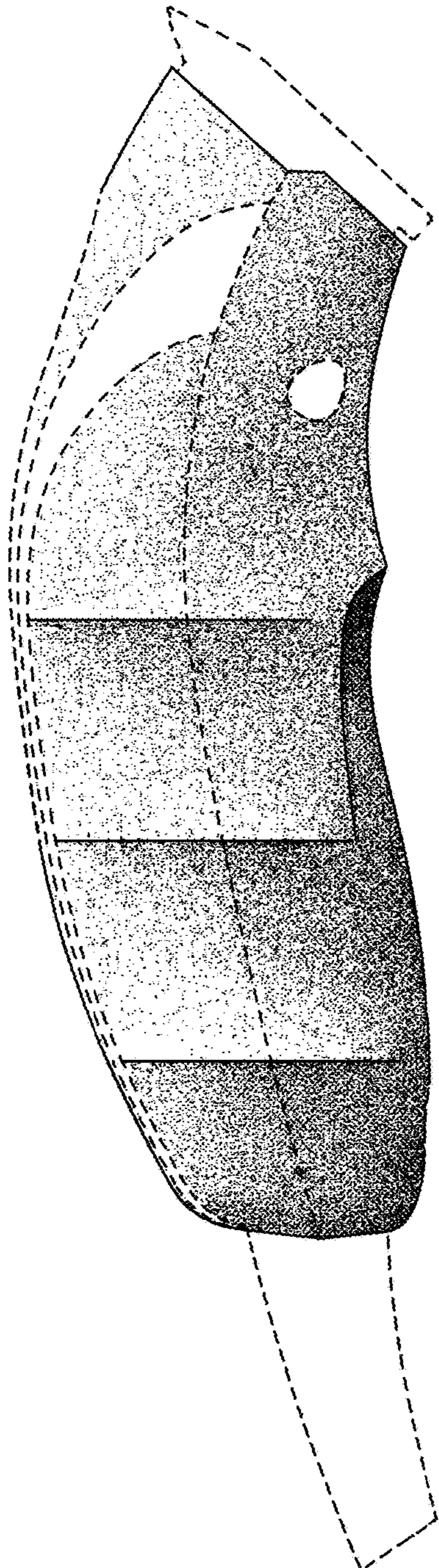

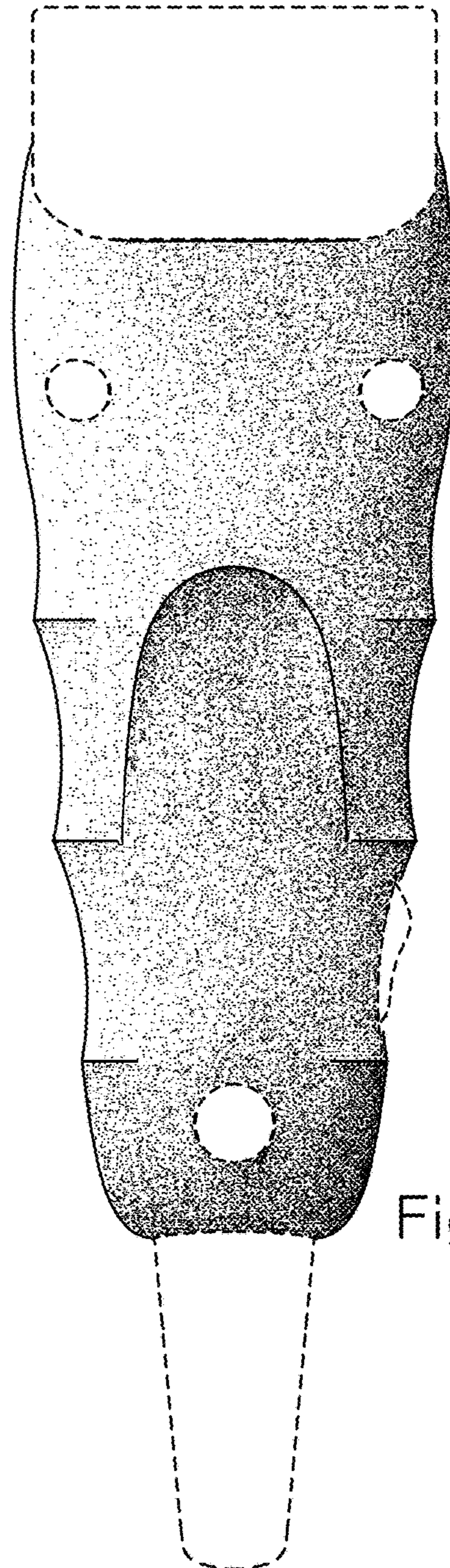

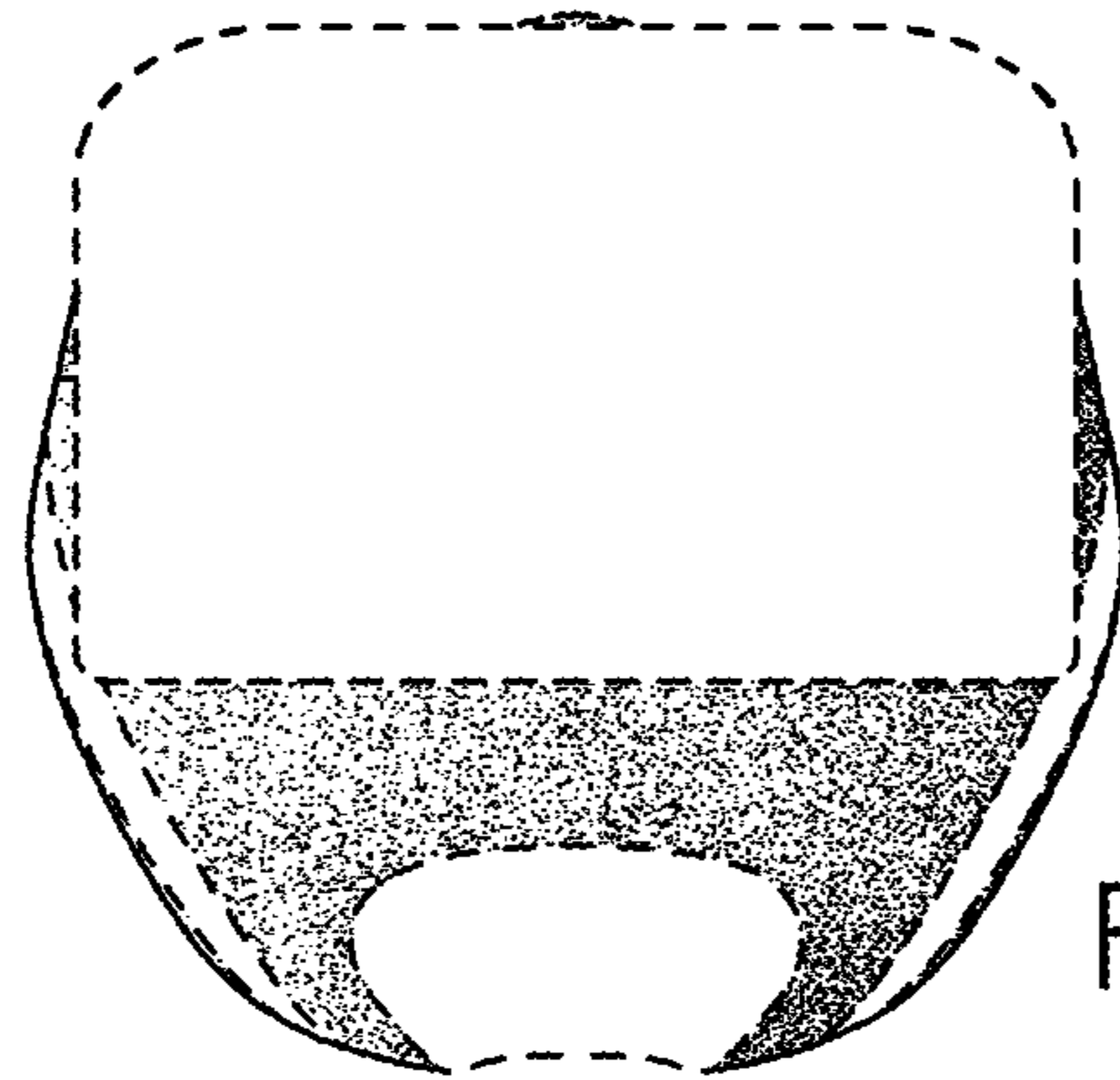

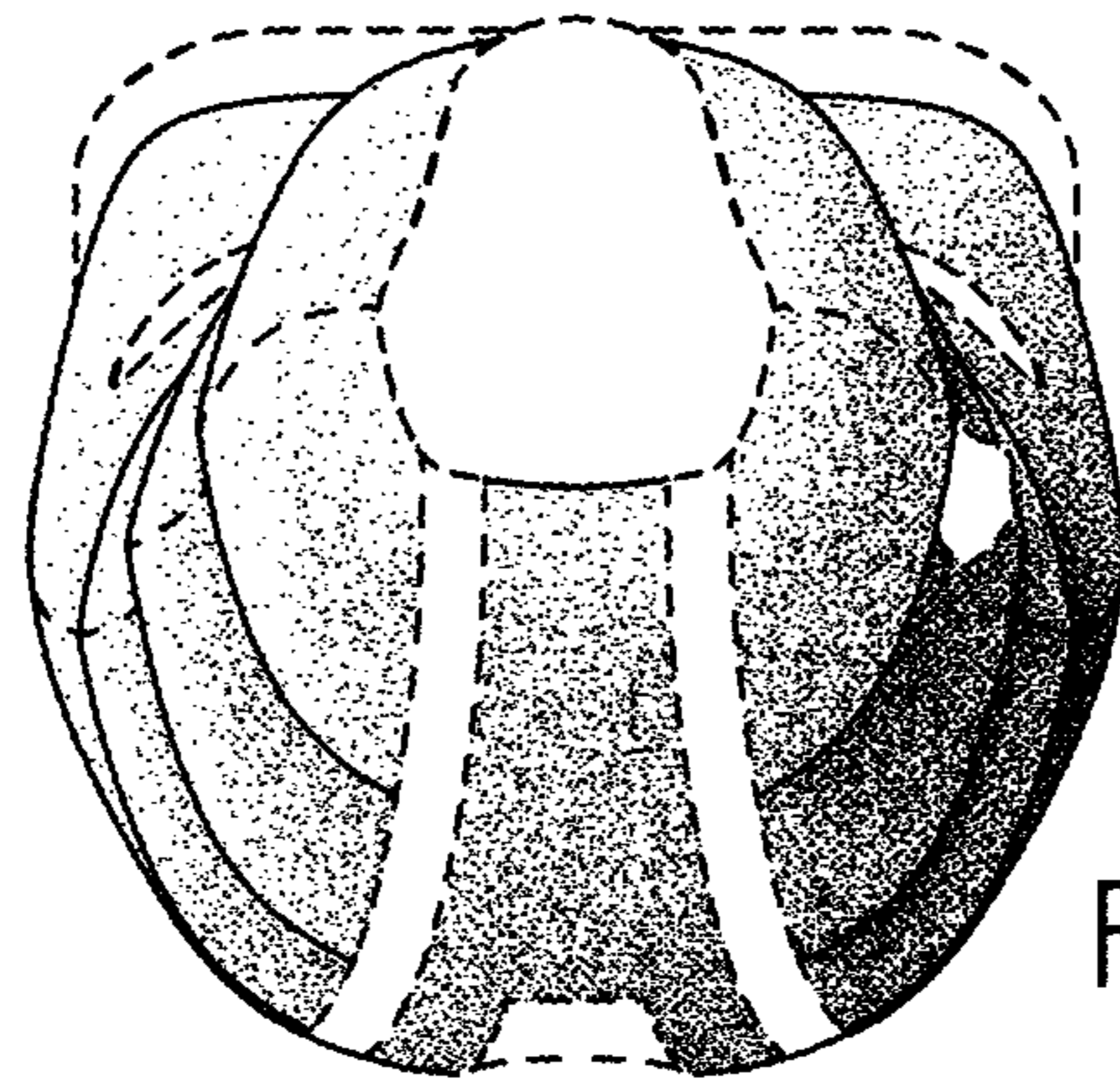
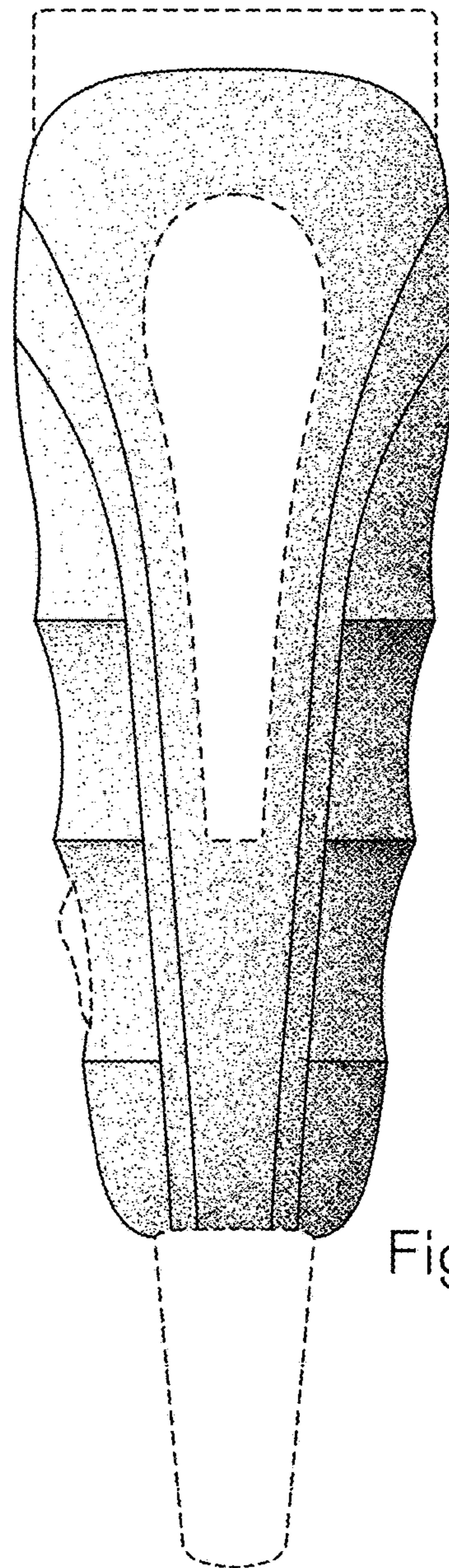
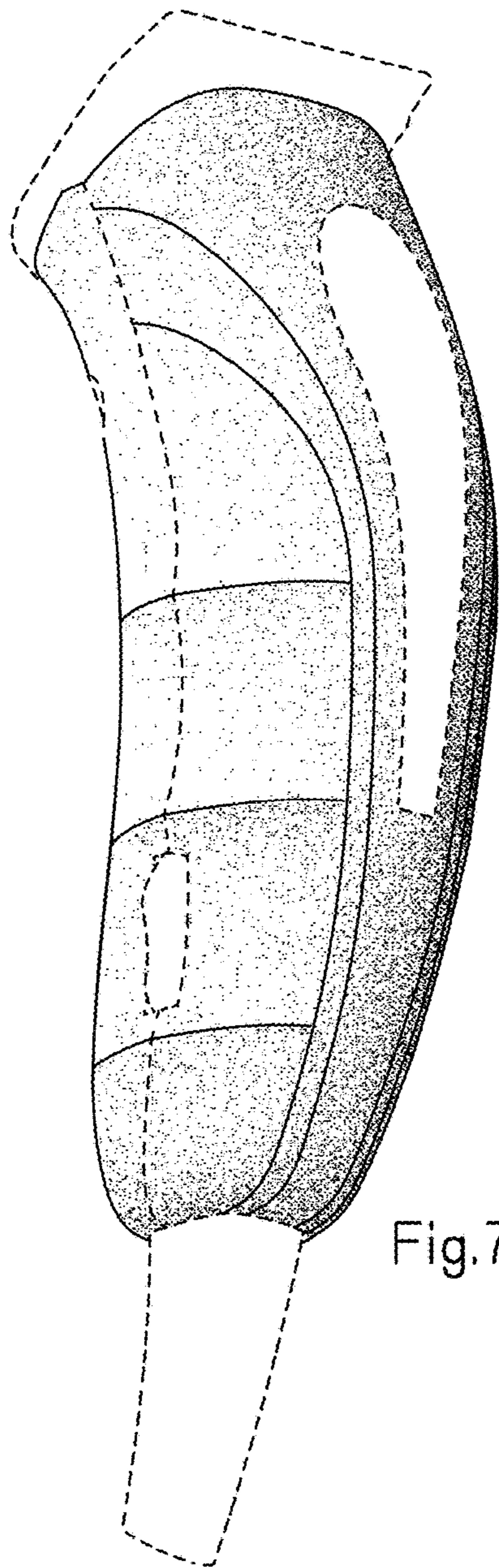

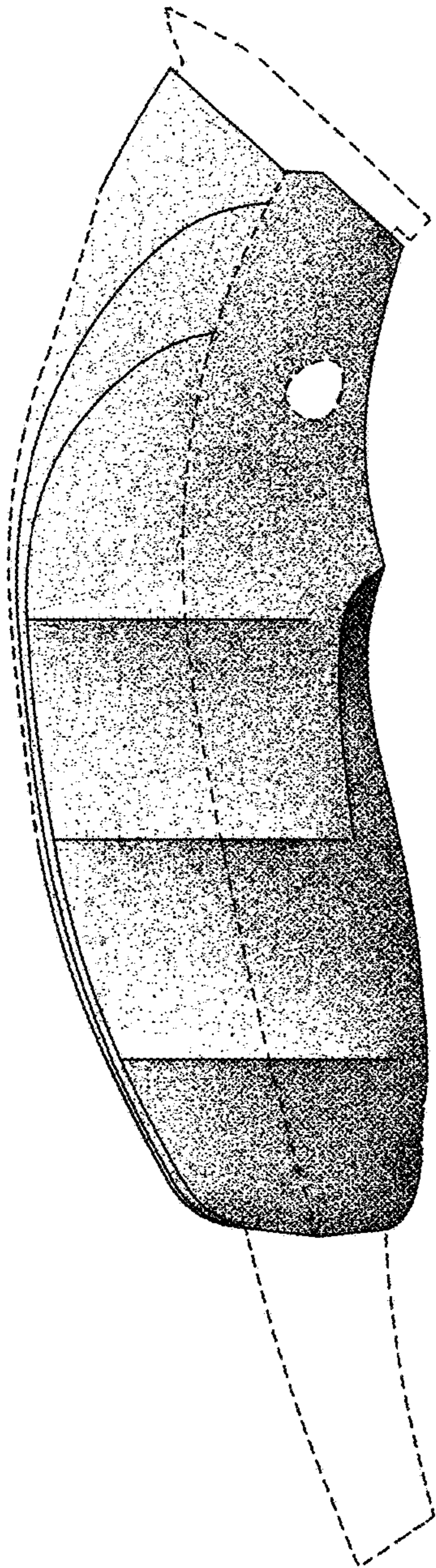

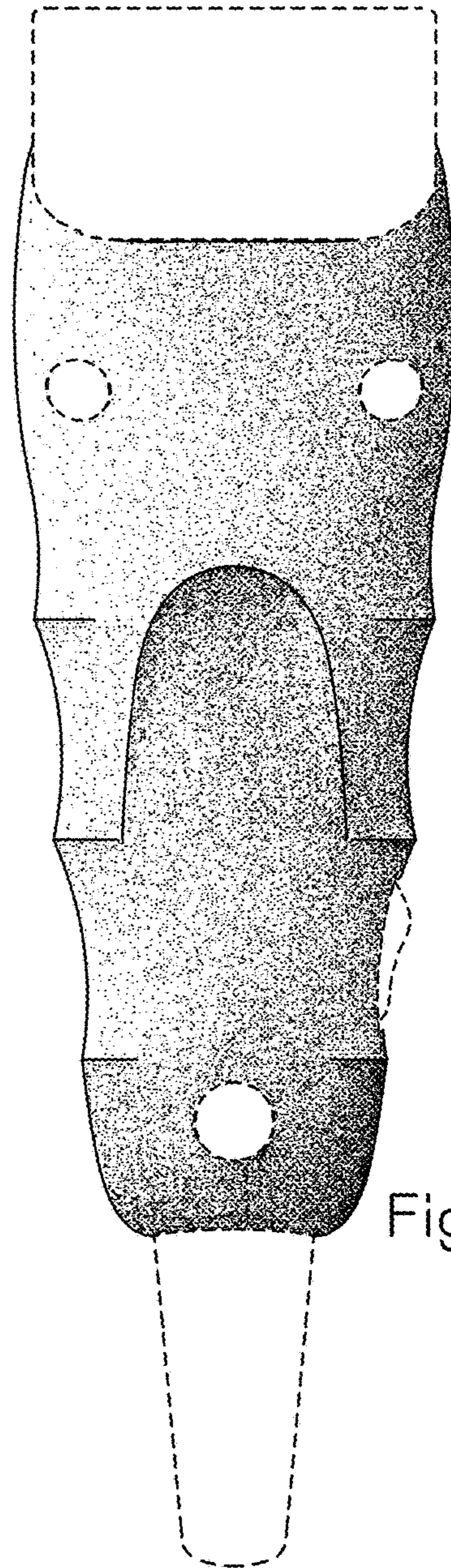

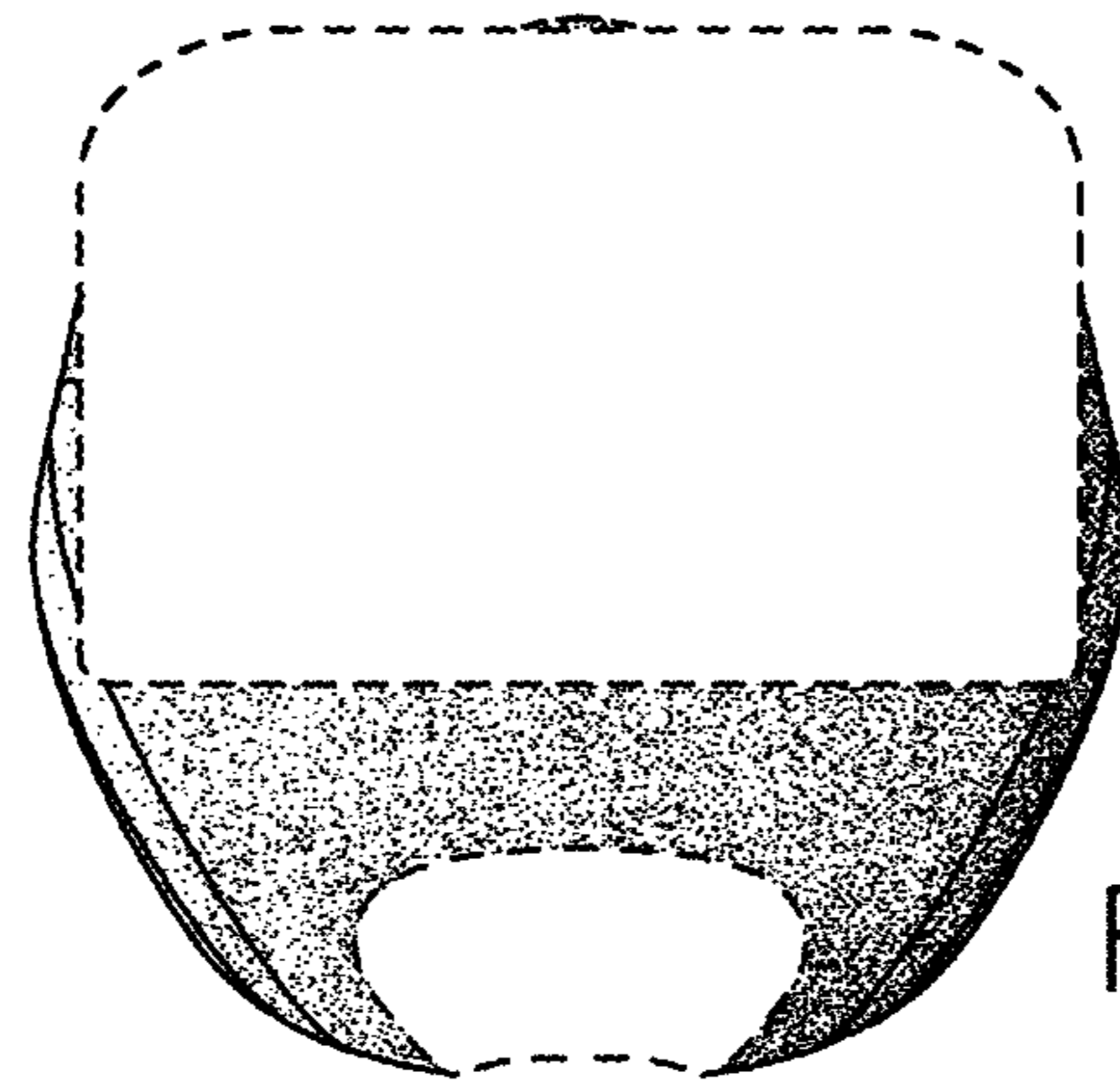

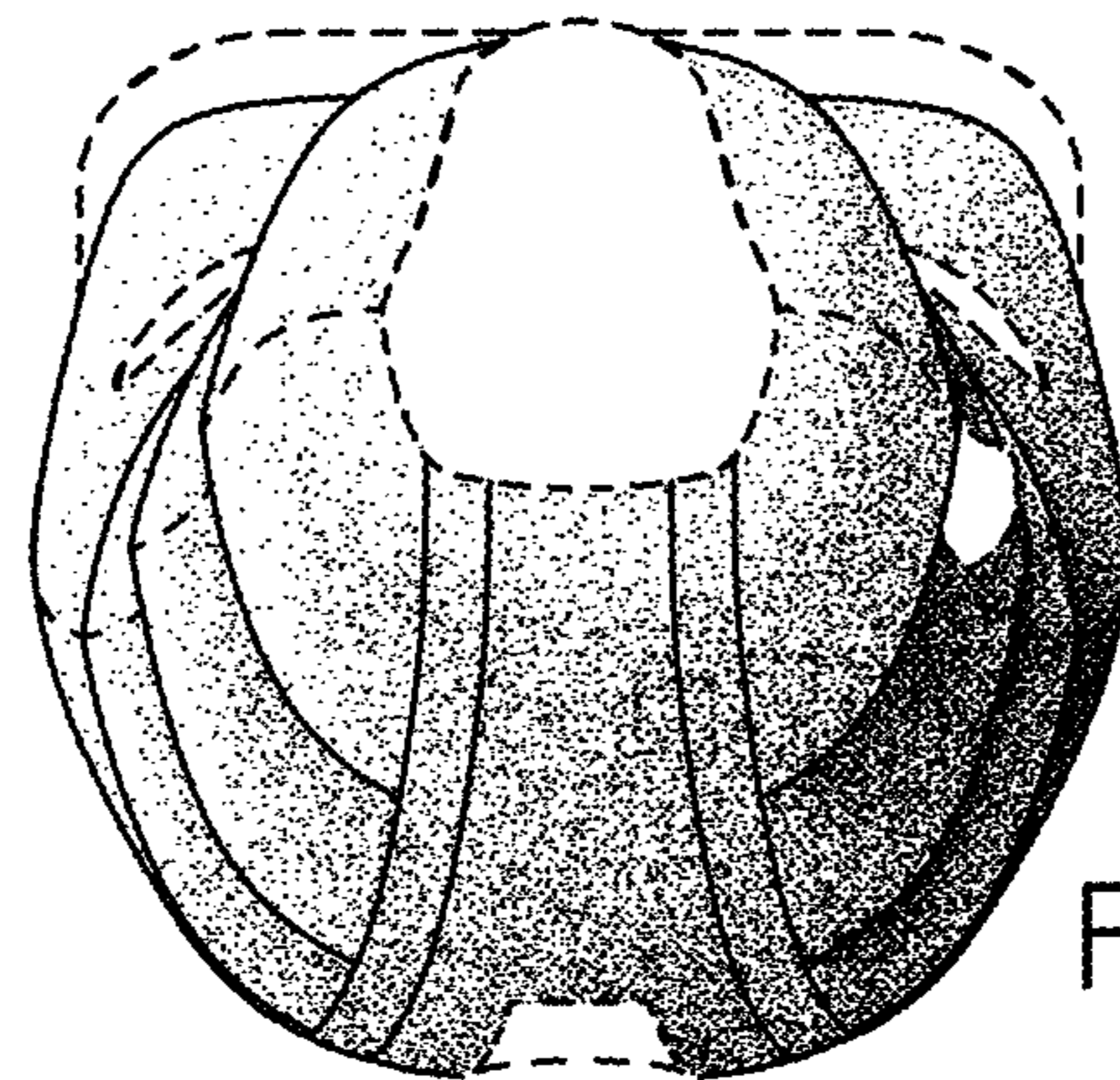

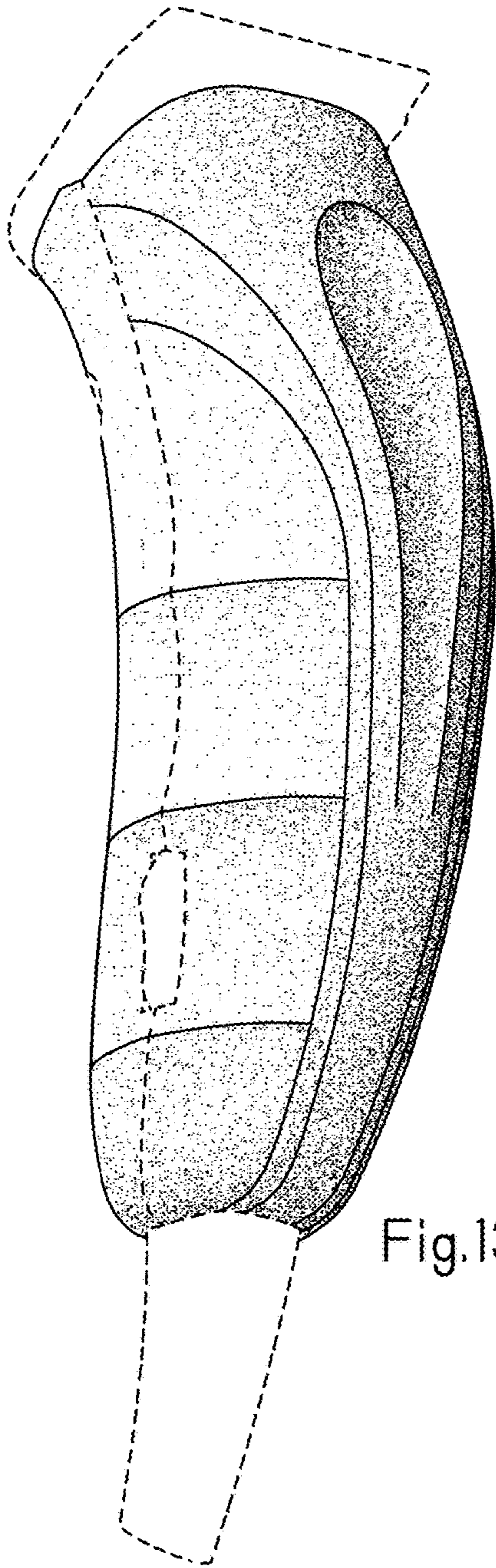

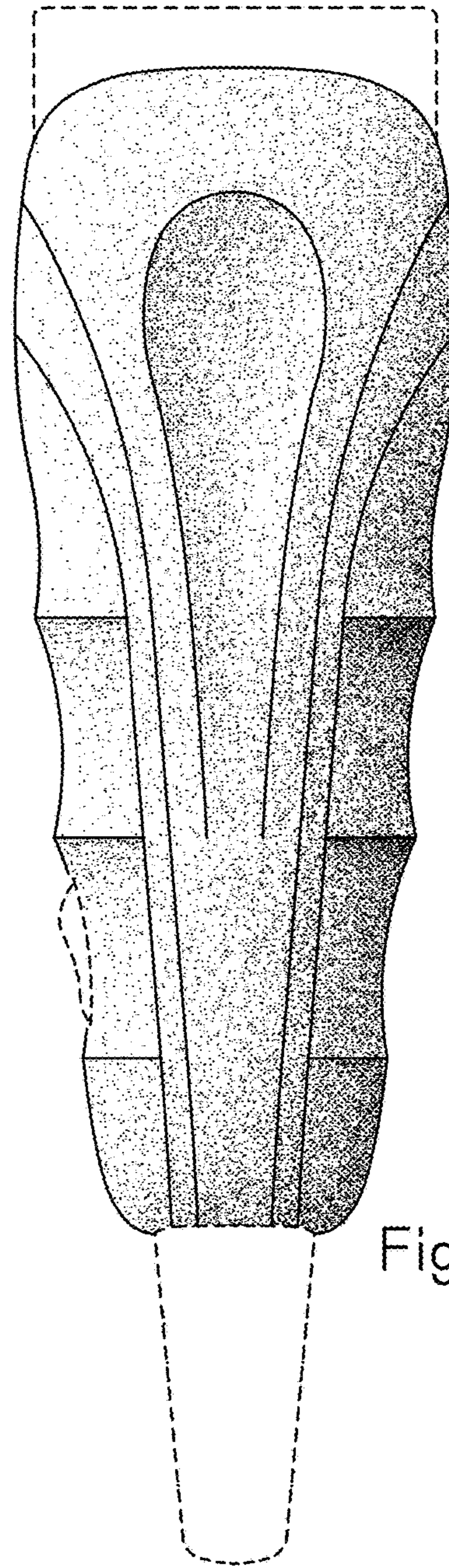

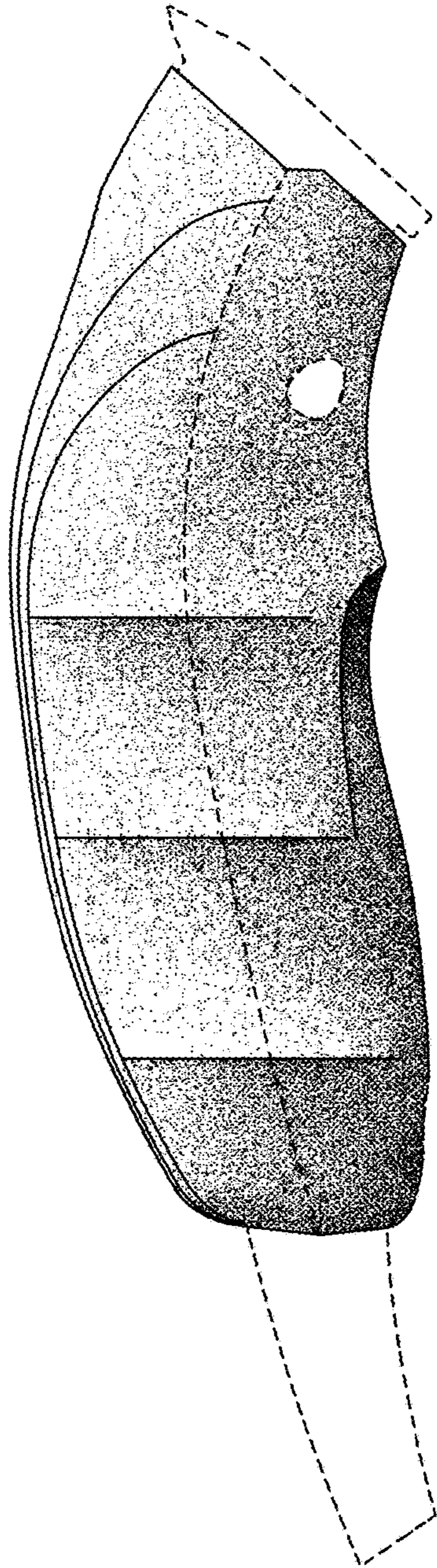

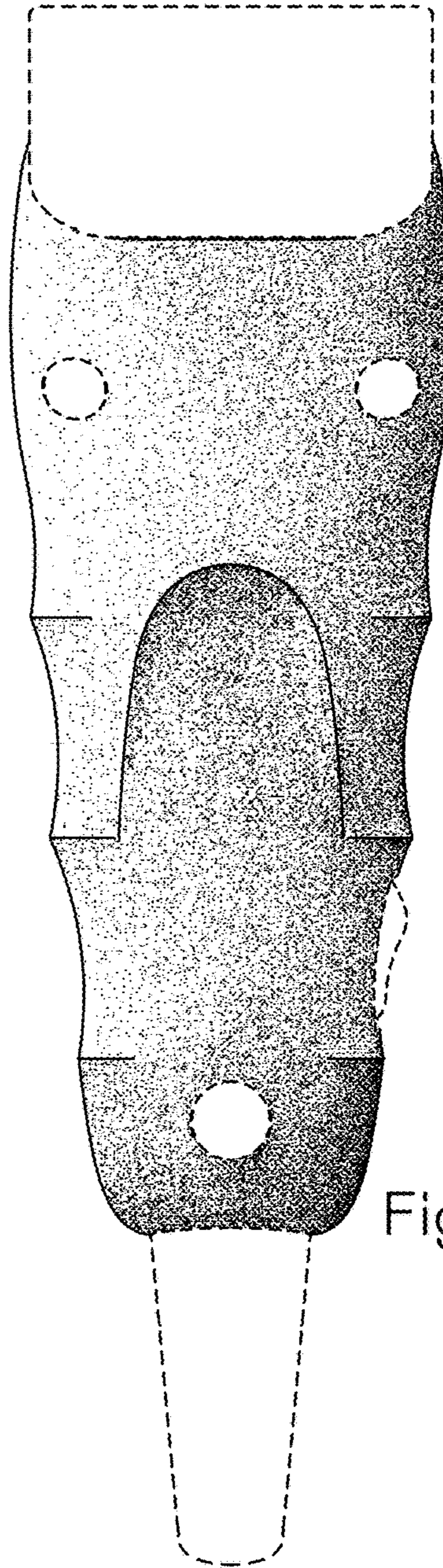

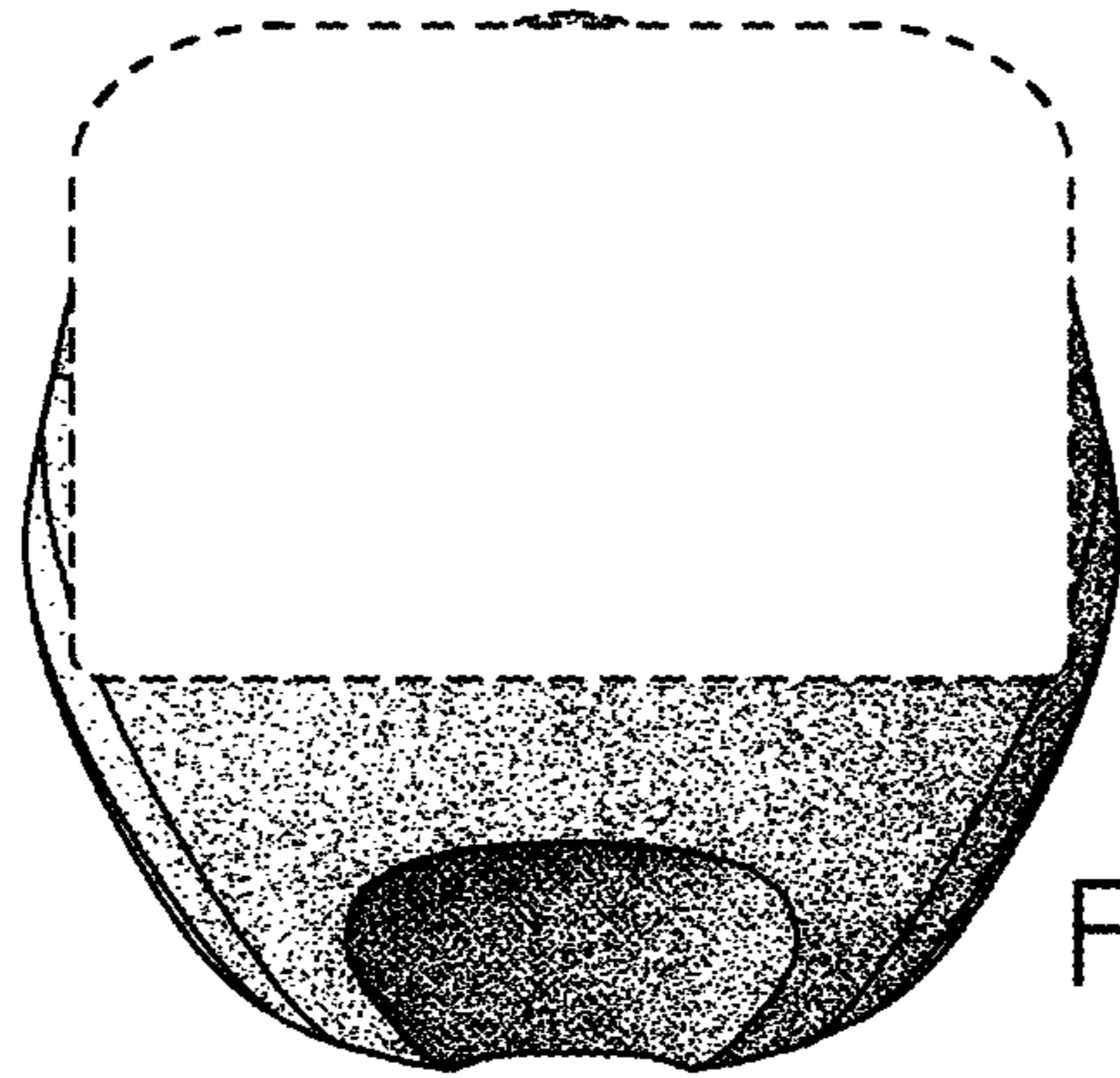

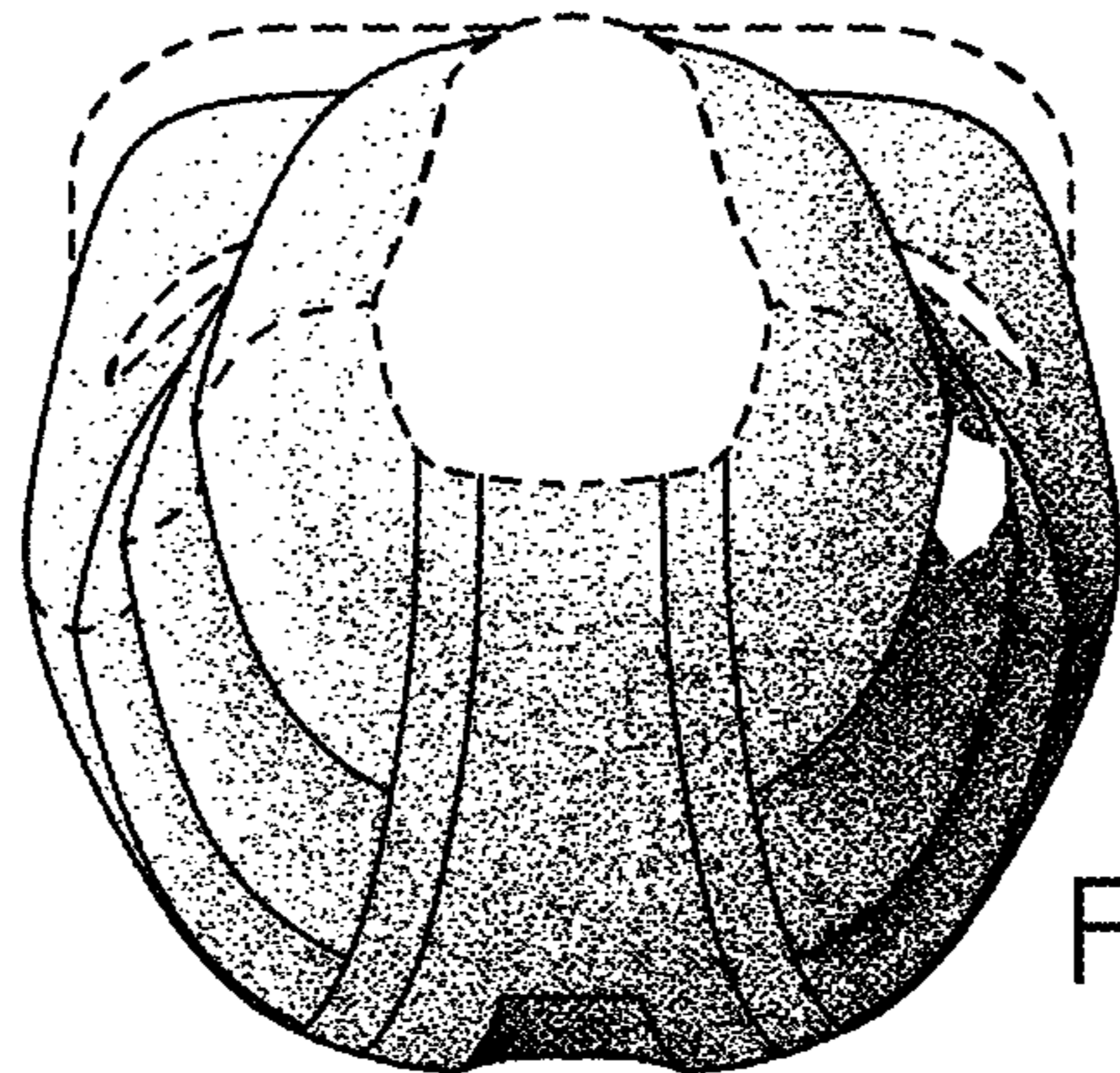
