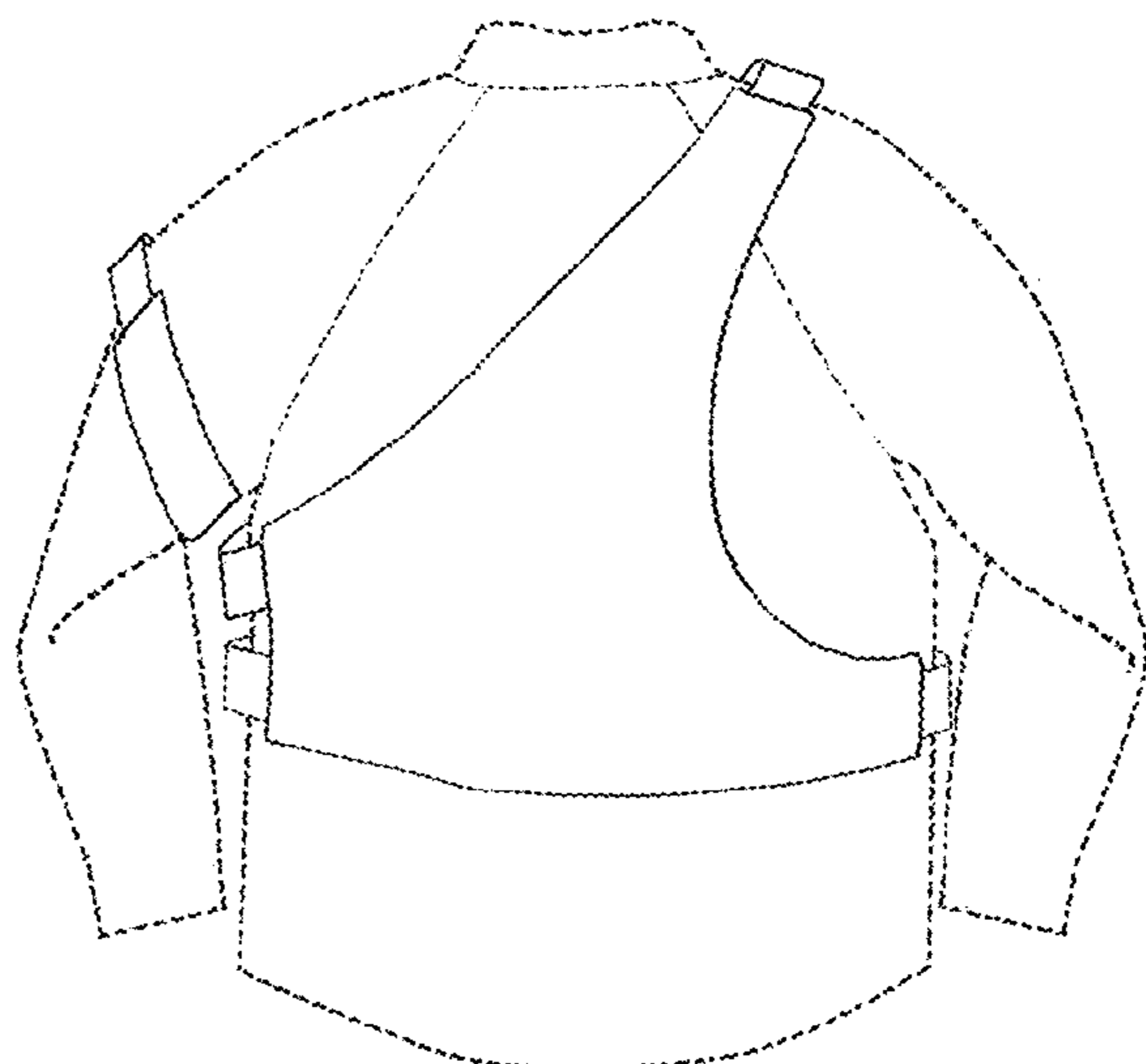
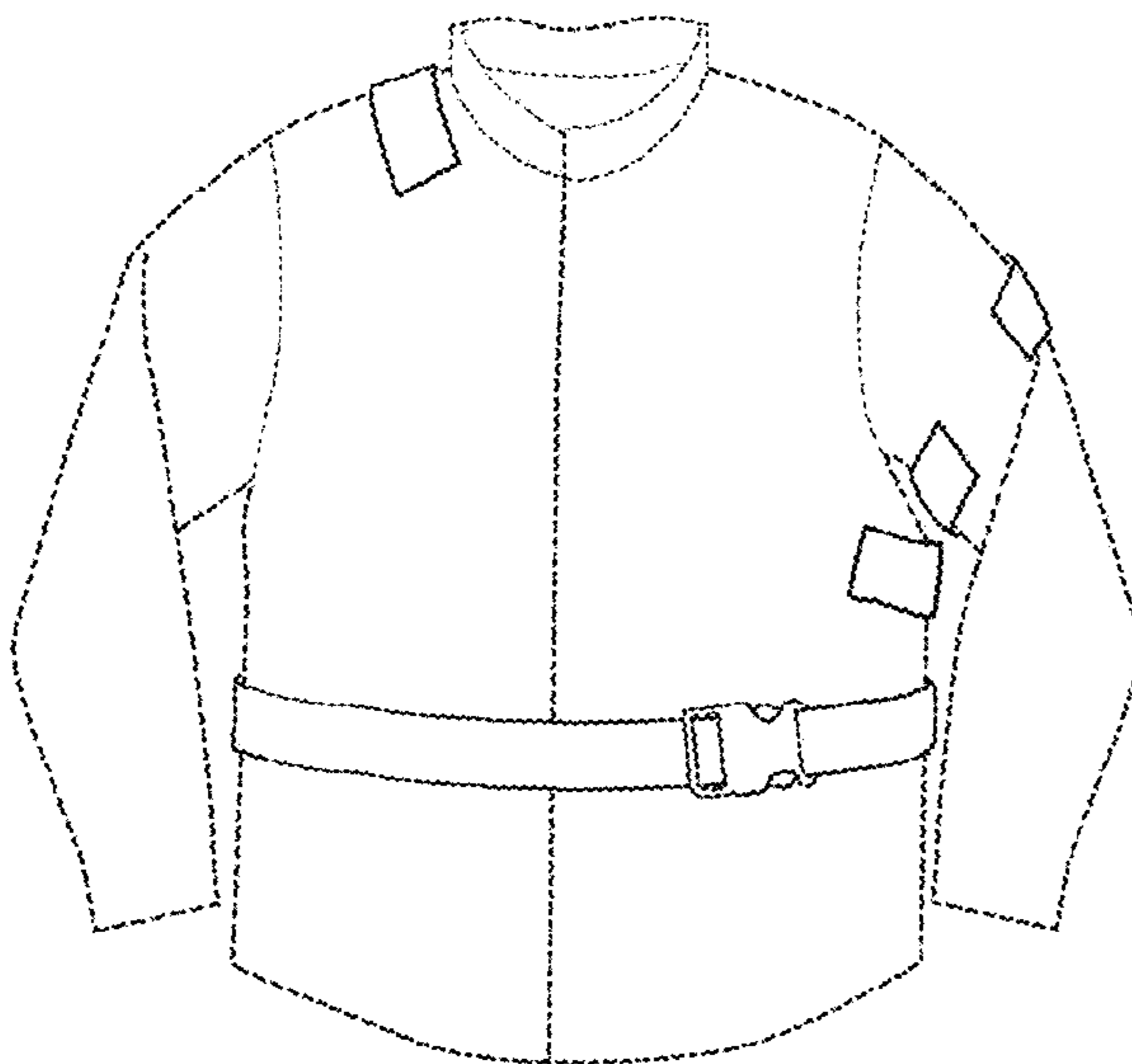
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a marksmanship shirt with strap attachments for supporting a weapon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a marksmanship shirt with strap attachments for supporting a weapon, showing our new design in a first, right-handed embodiment manufactured using opaque materials;
FIG. 2 is a rear view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear view of a second, right-handed embodiment of the marksmanship shirt manufactured using transparent materials, the front view being identical to FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front view of a third, left-handed embodiment of the marksmanship shirt manufactured using opaque materials;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the embodiment of FIG. 4; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear view of a fourth, left-handed embodiment of the marksmanship shirt manufactured using transparent materials, the front view being identical to FIG. 4.
The broken lines depict portions of the marksmanship shirt with strap attachments for supporting a weapon that form no part of the claim.

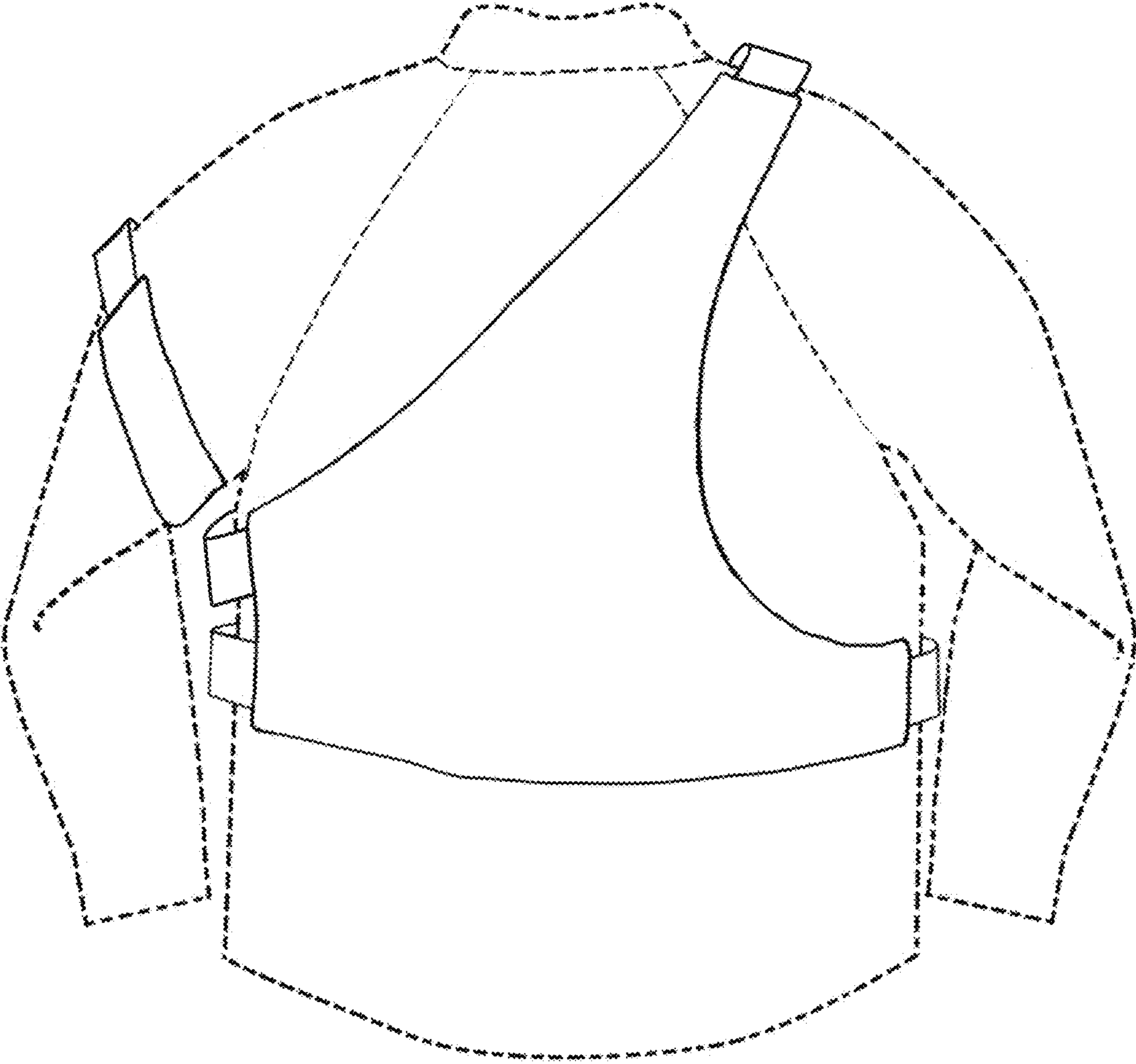

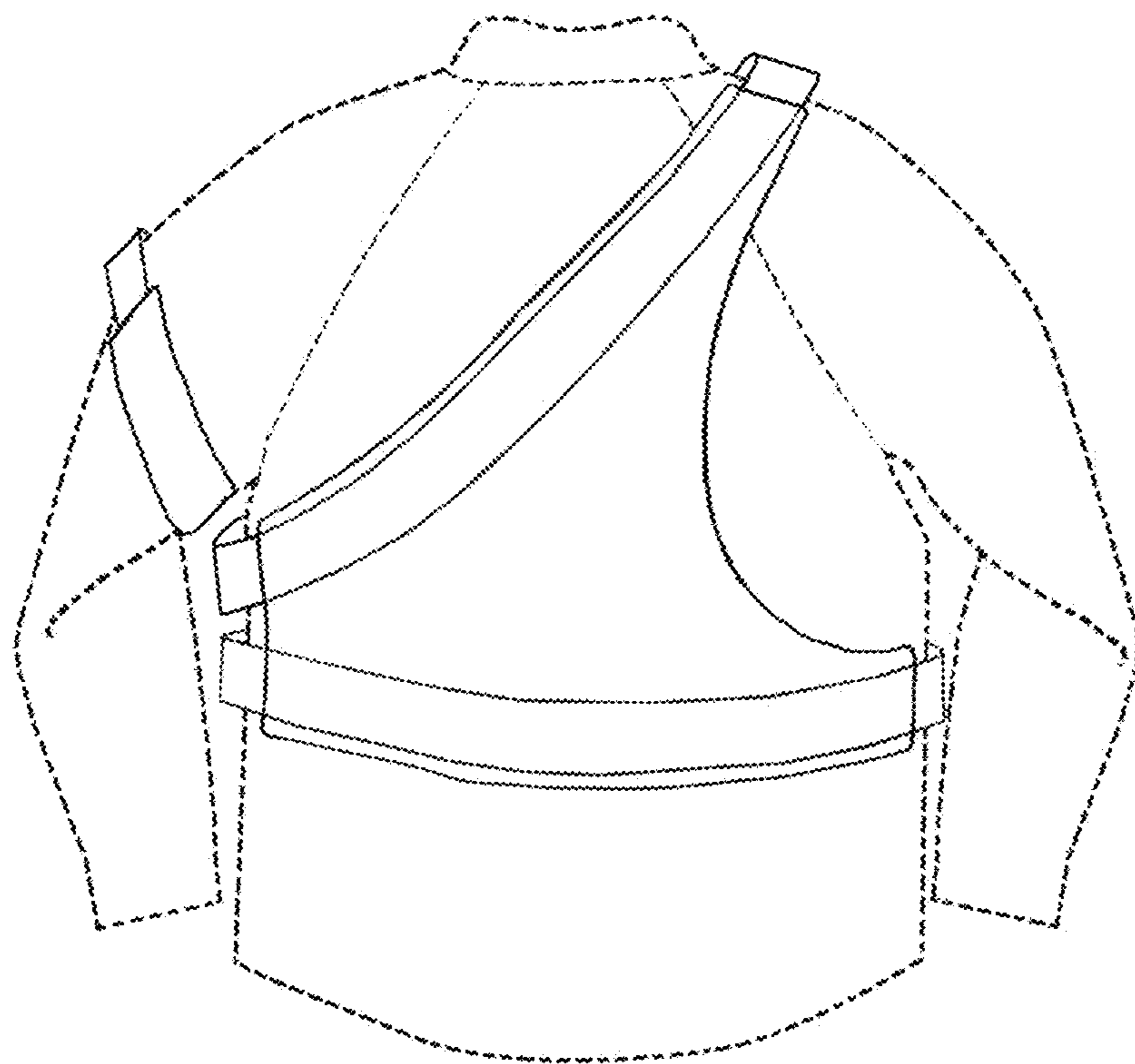

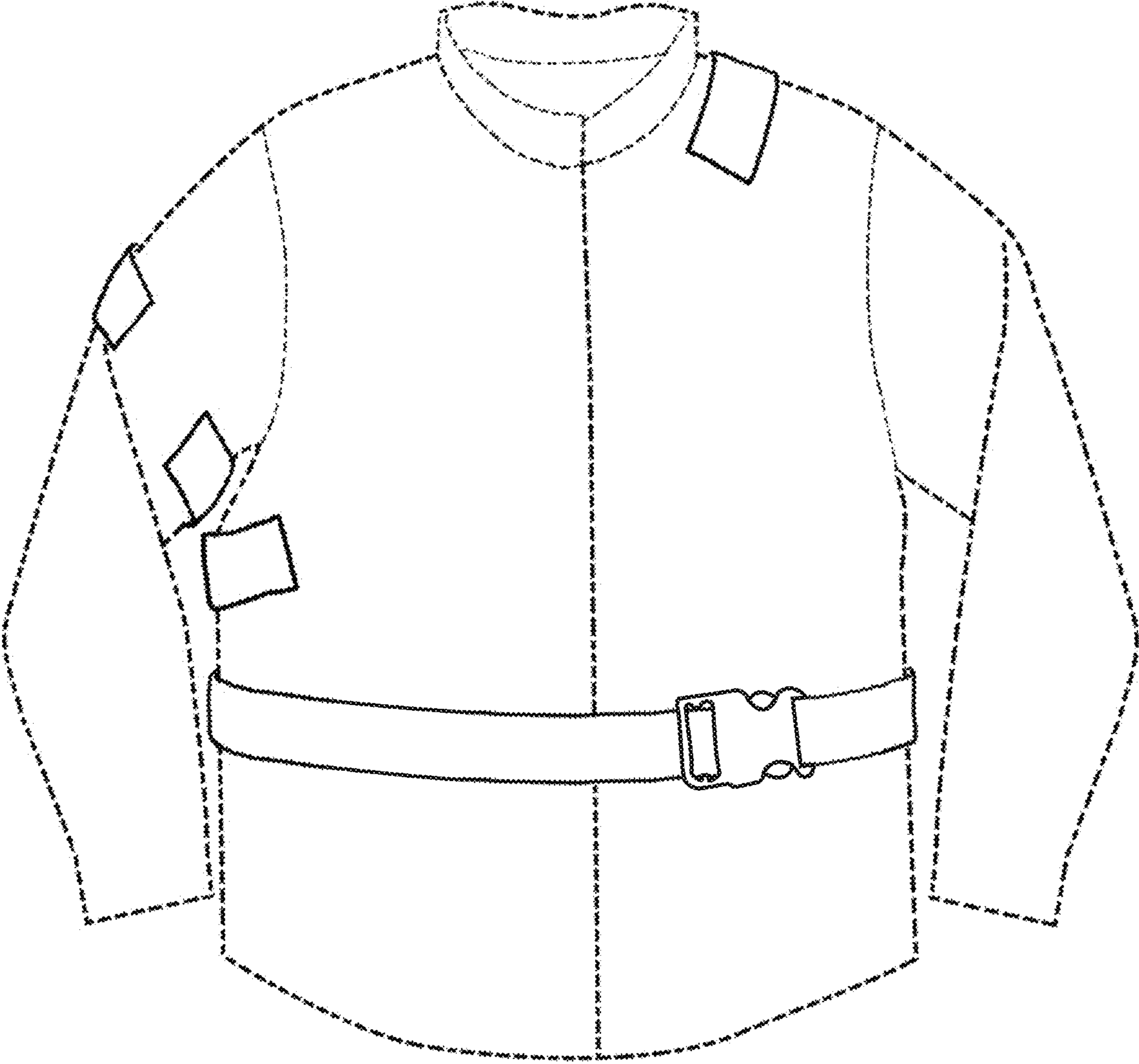

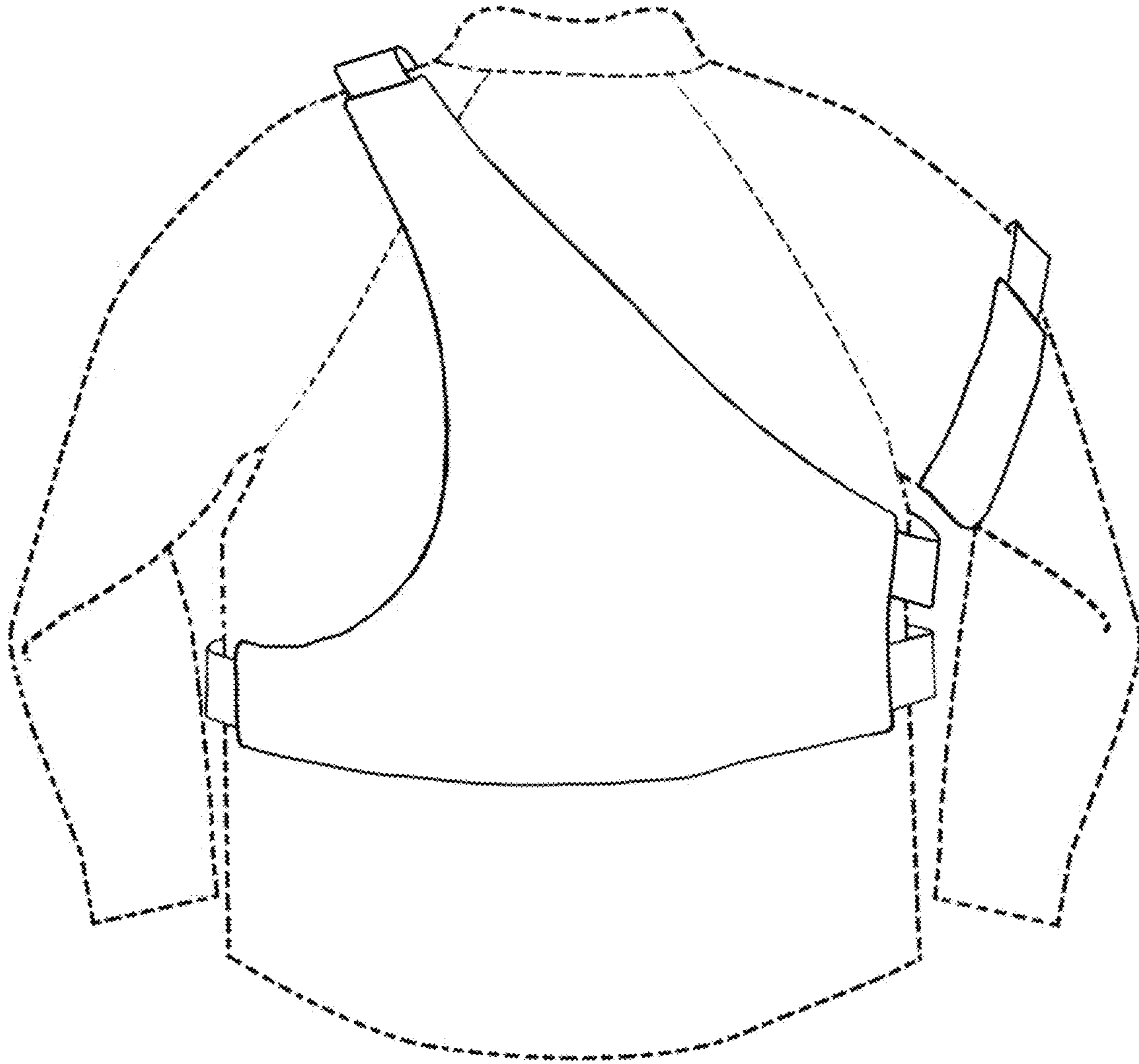

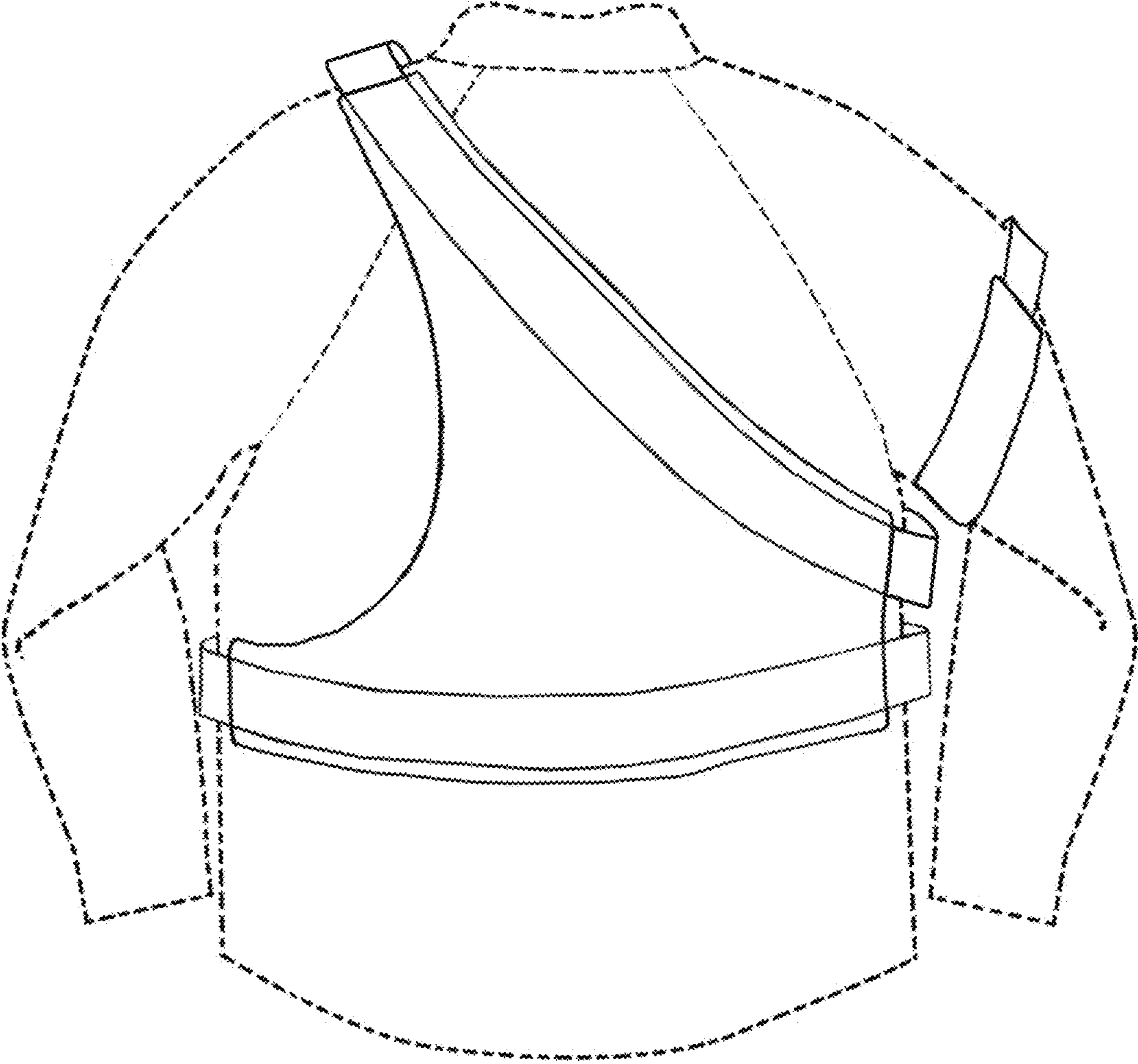
