FIG. 1 is a front view of a jewelry pendant showing our new design;

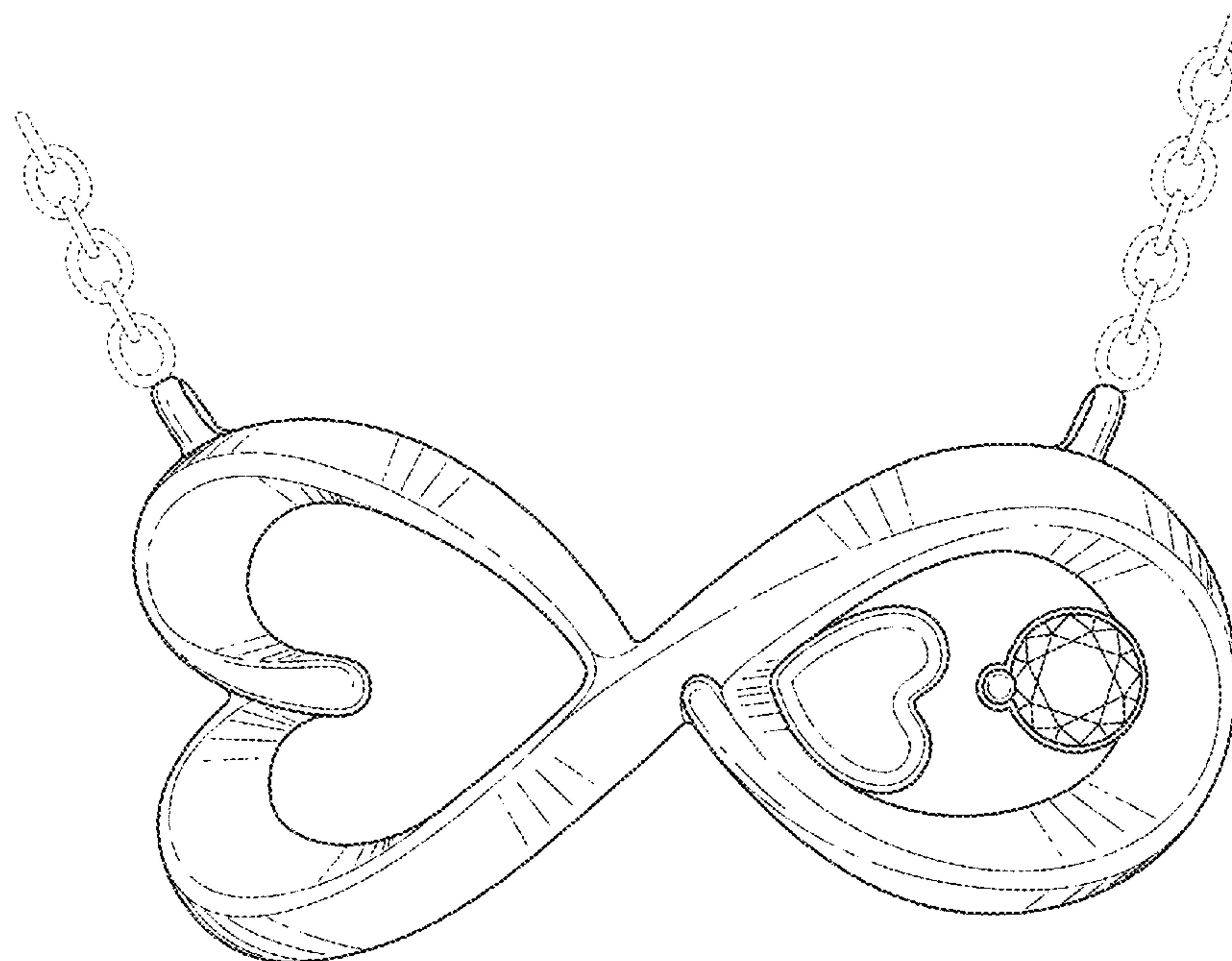
FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

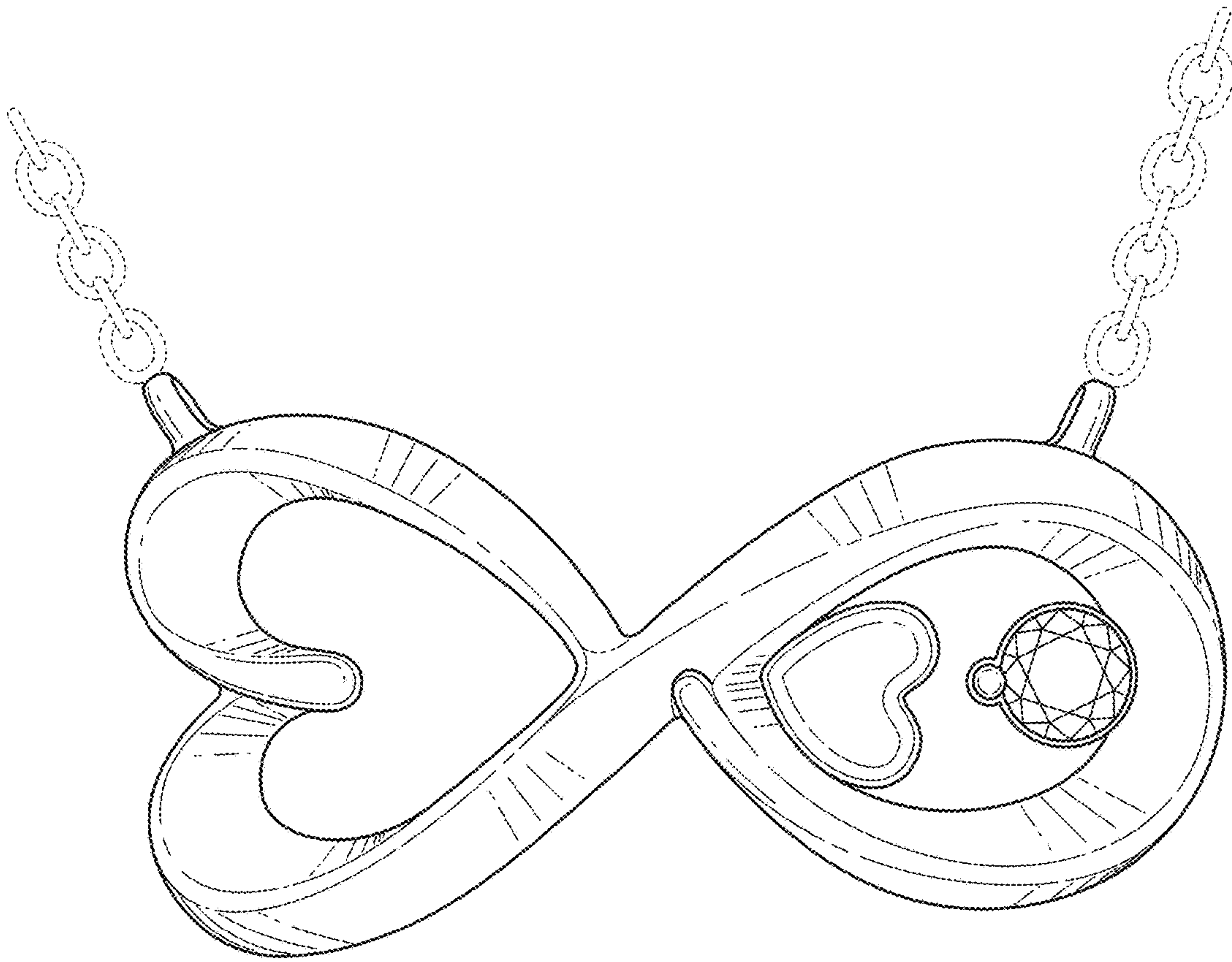

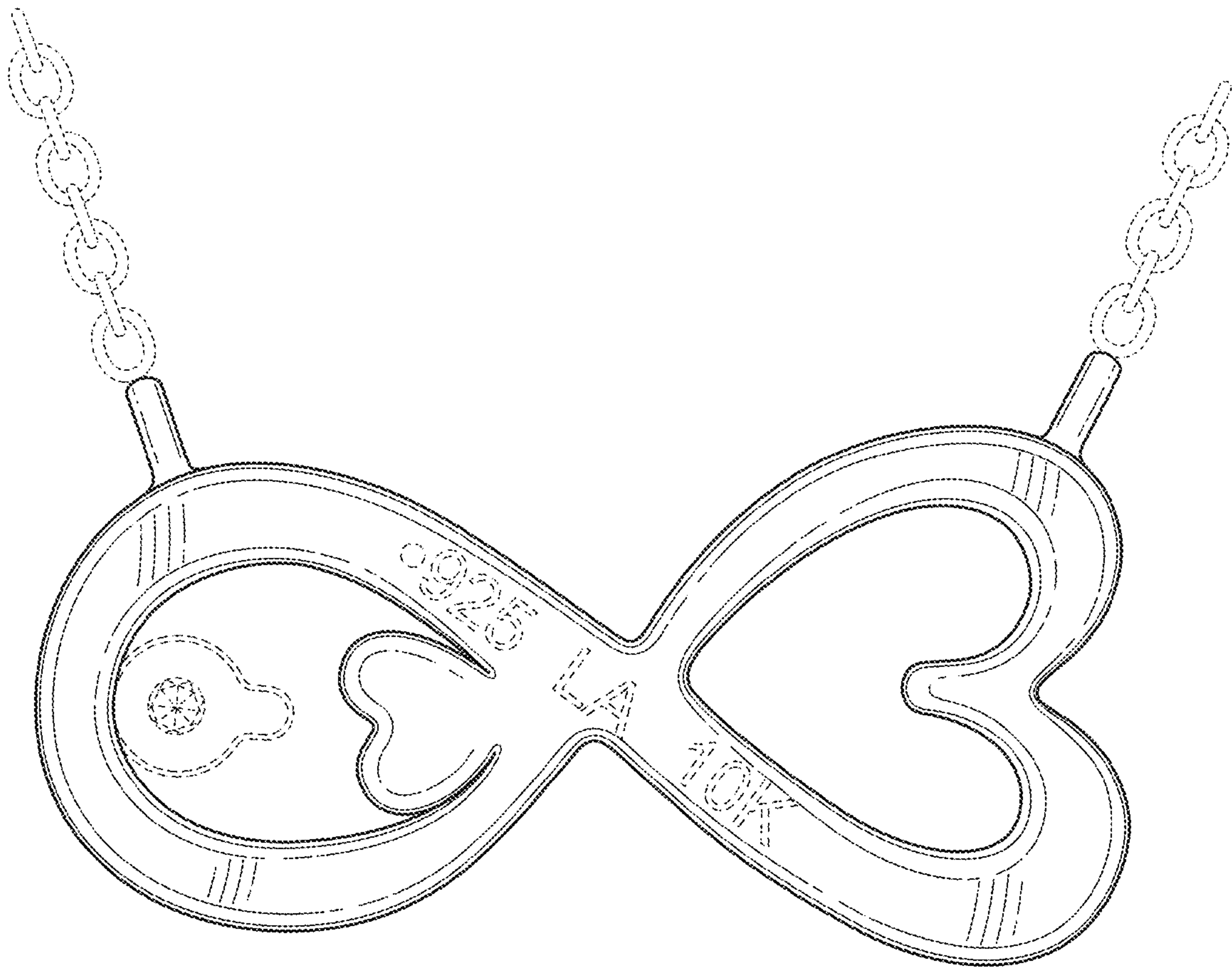

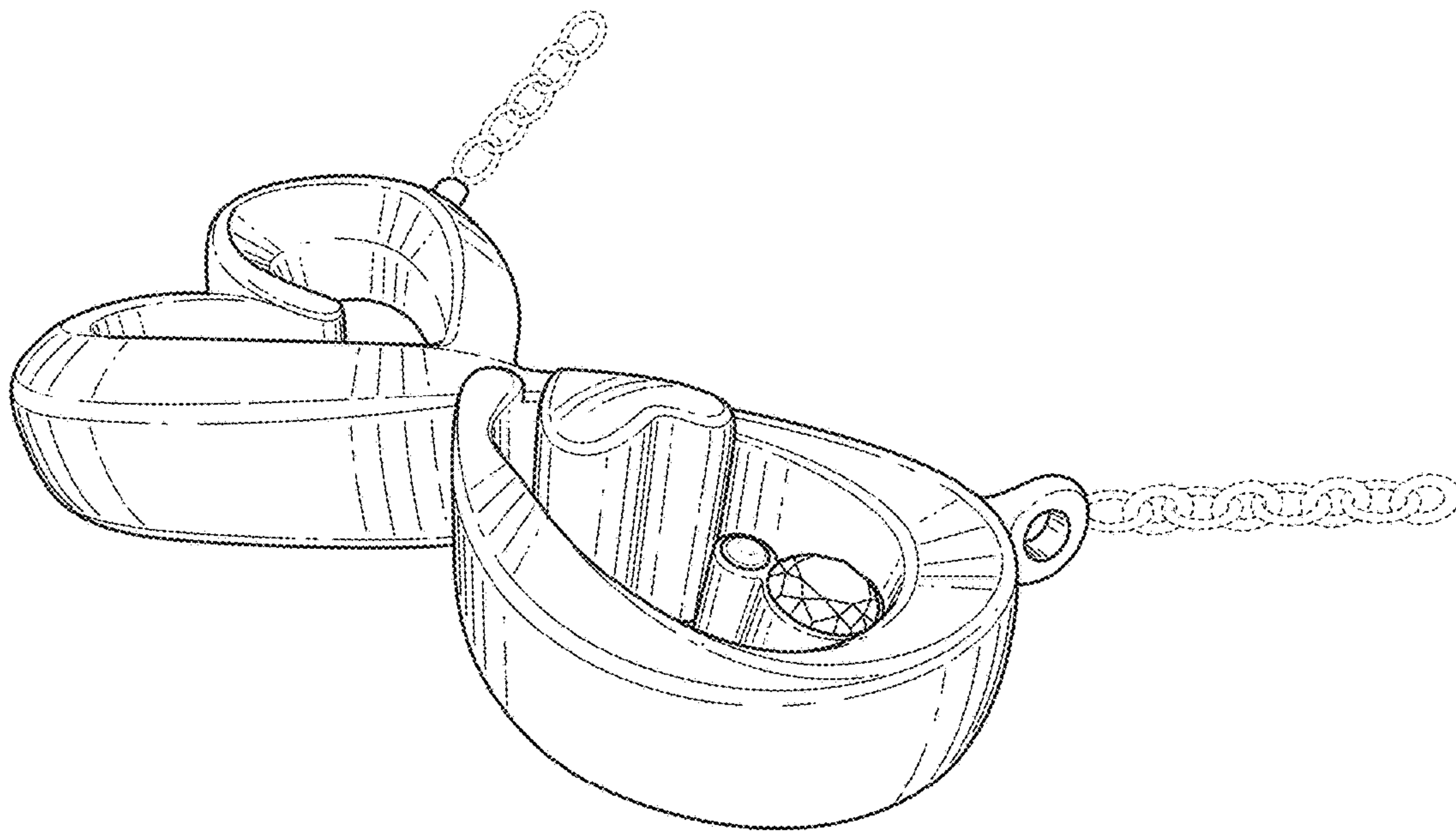

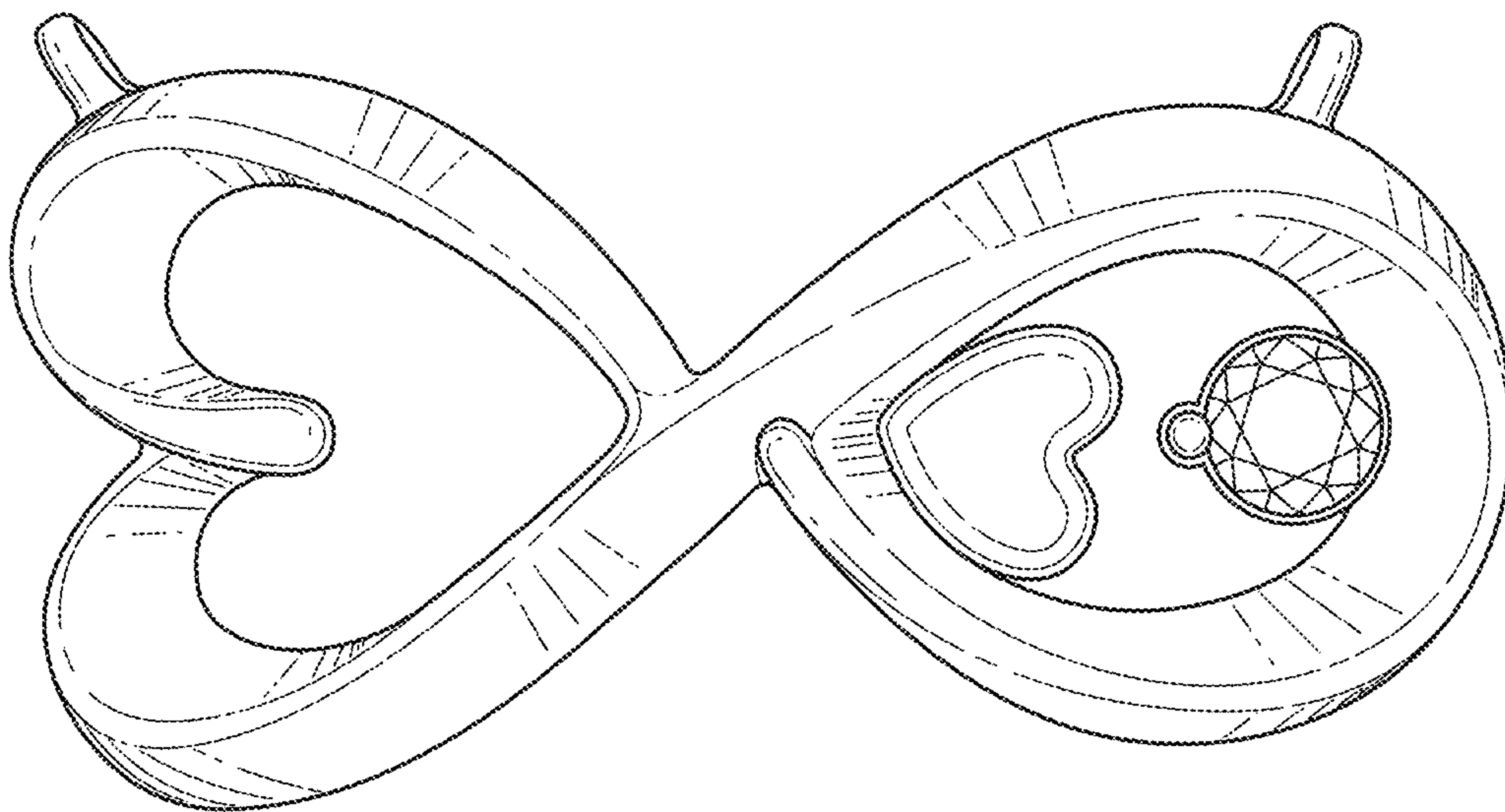
