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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a front bumper air dam for a vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

This application contains subject matter related to the following co-pending U.S. design patent application: application Ser. No. 29/572,848, filed herewith and entitled "Truck Cab, Toy, and/or Replicas Thereof".

FIG. 1 is a left, front perspective view of a front bumper air dam for a vehicle according to our new design, the right, front perspective view being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

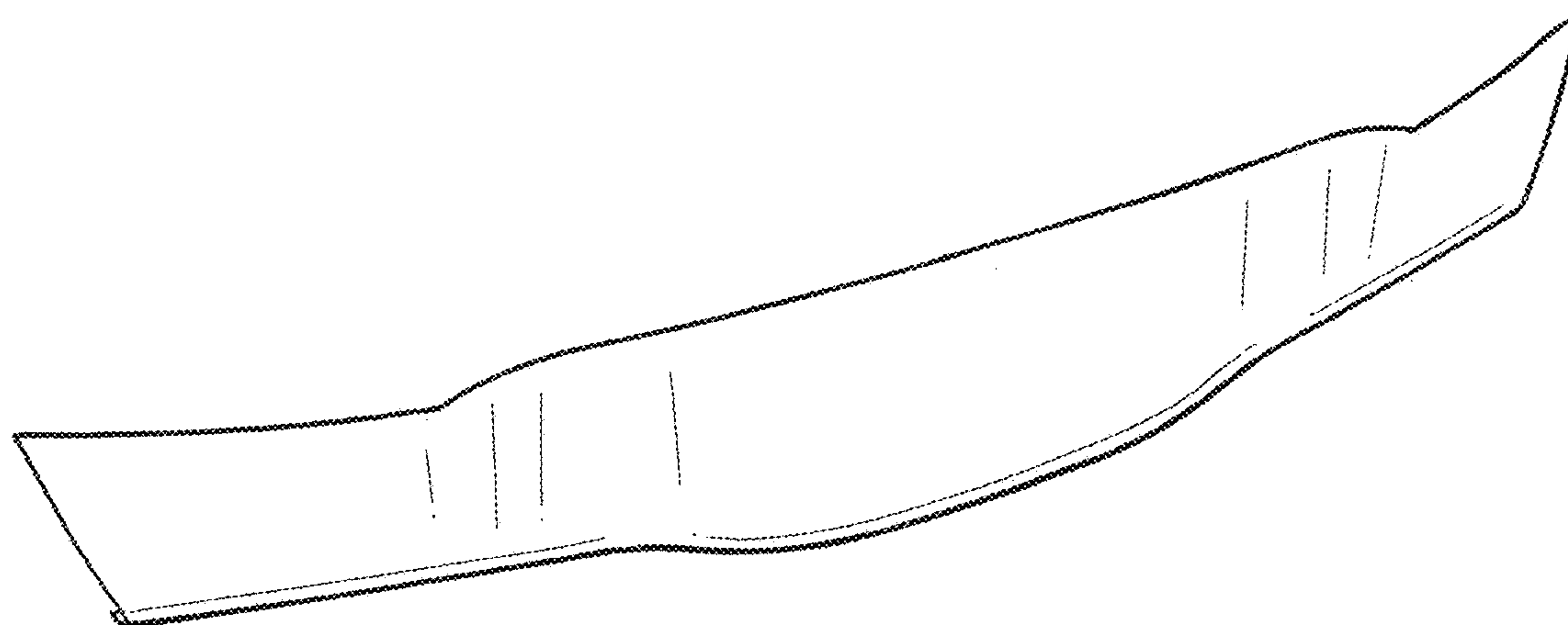
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

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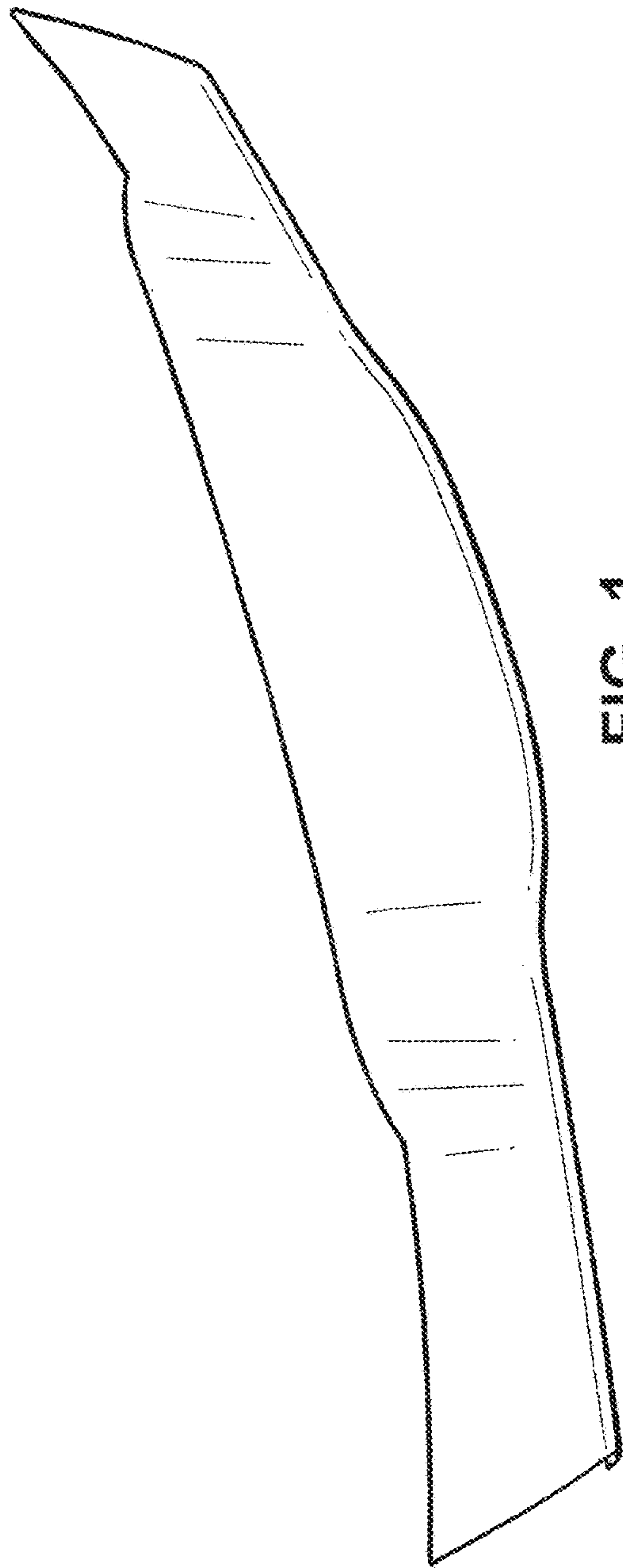

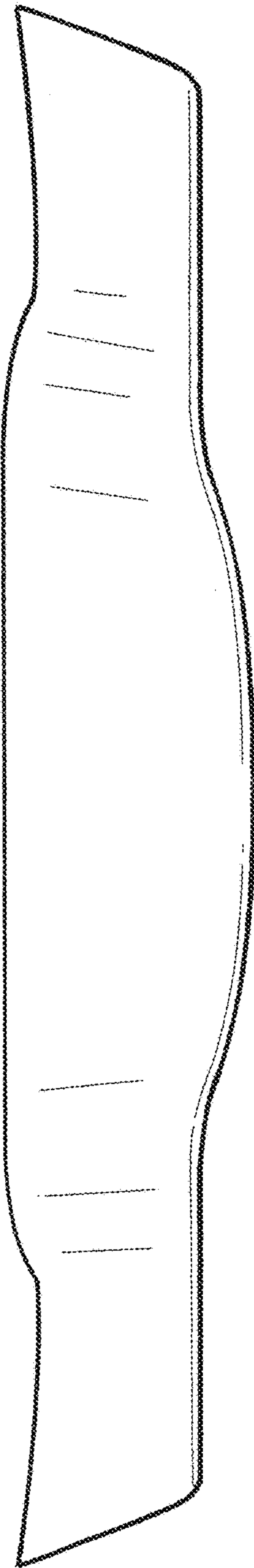

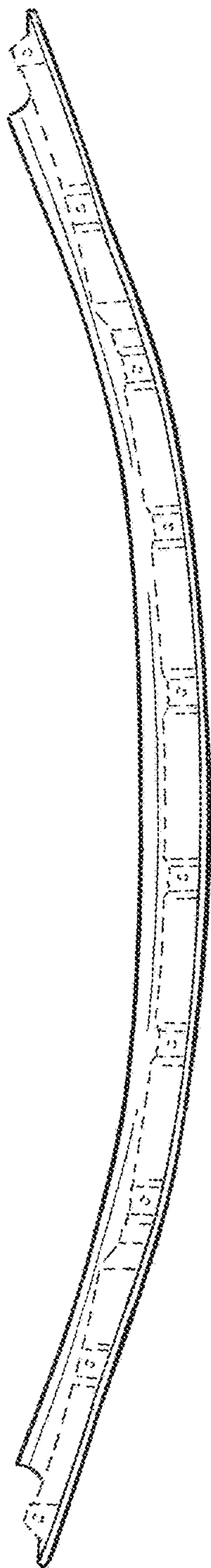

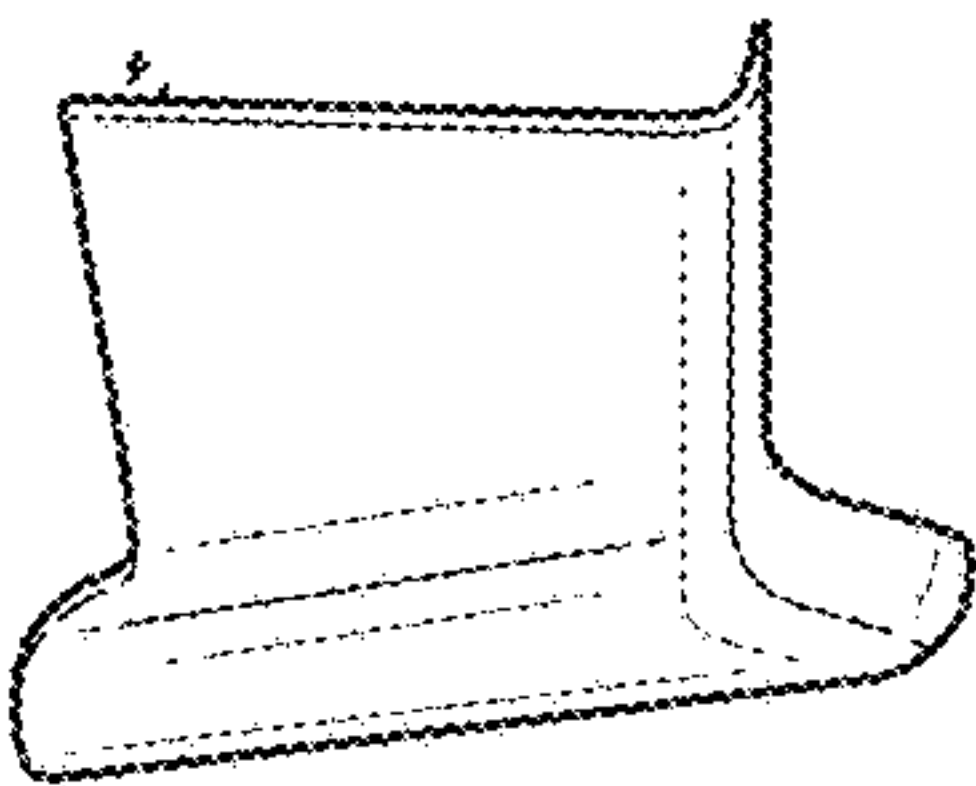

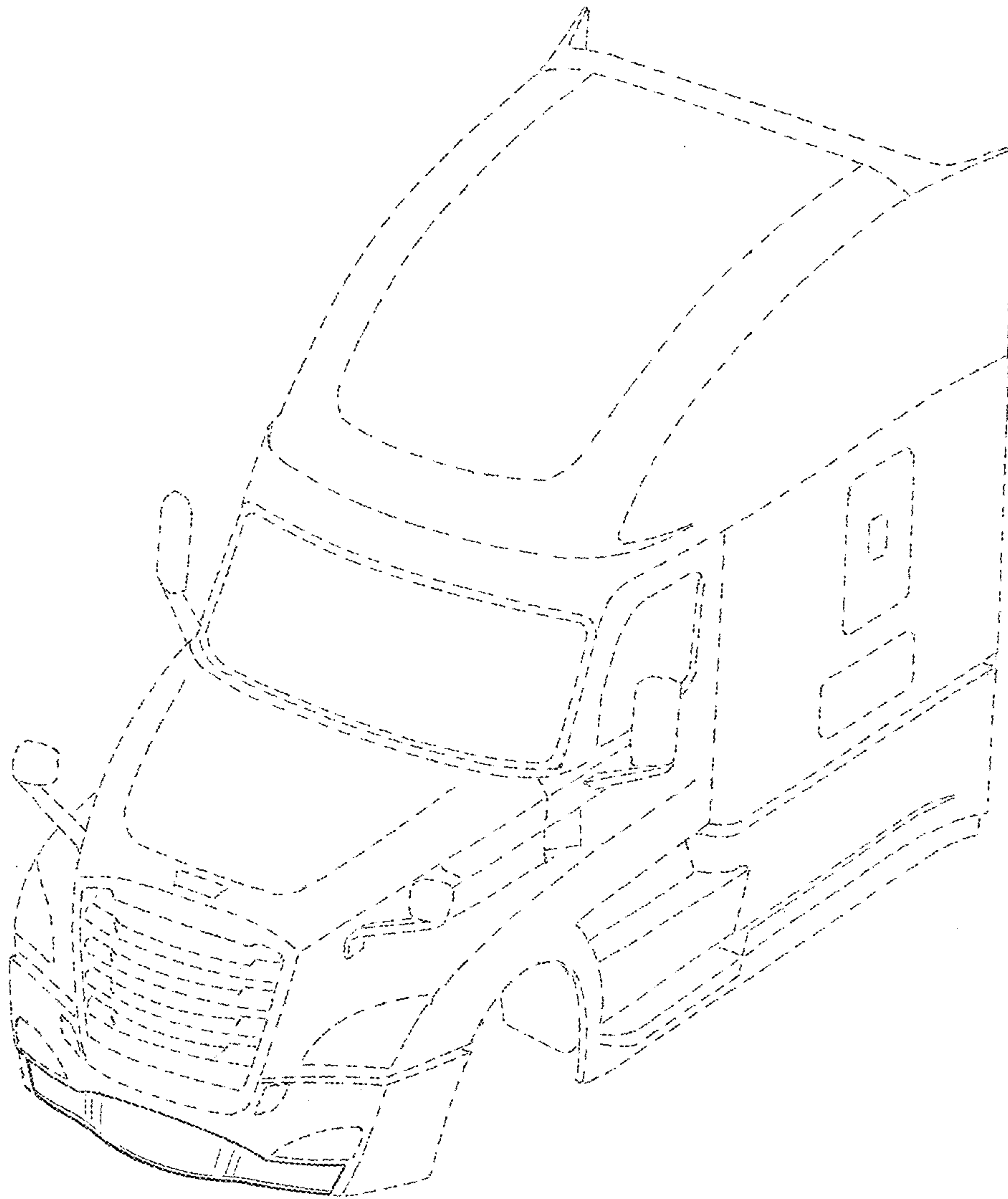
