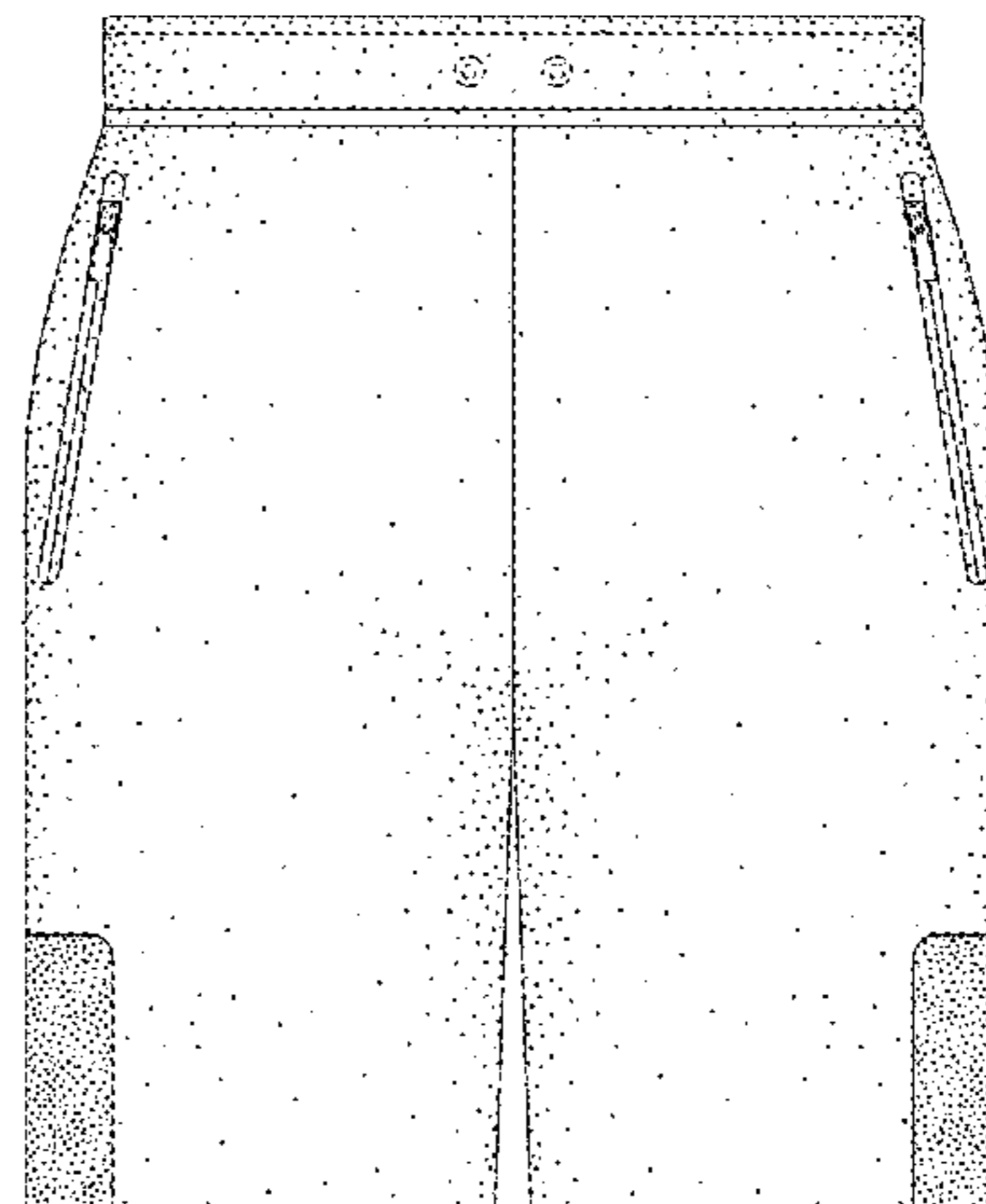
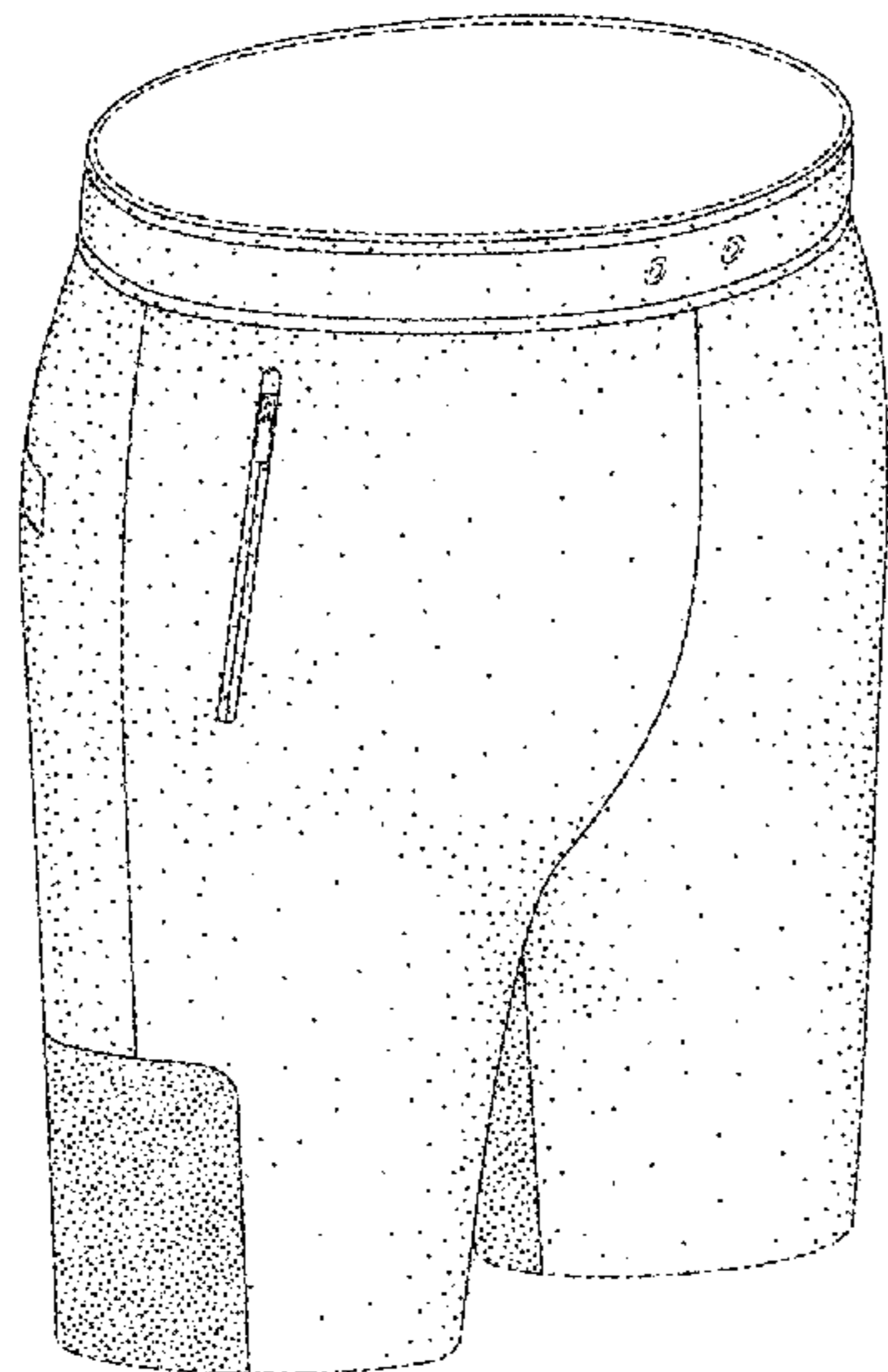

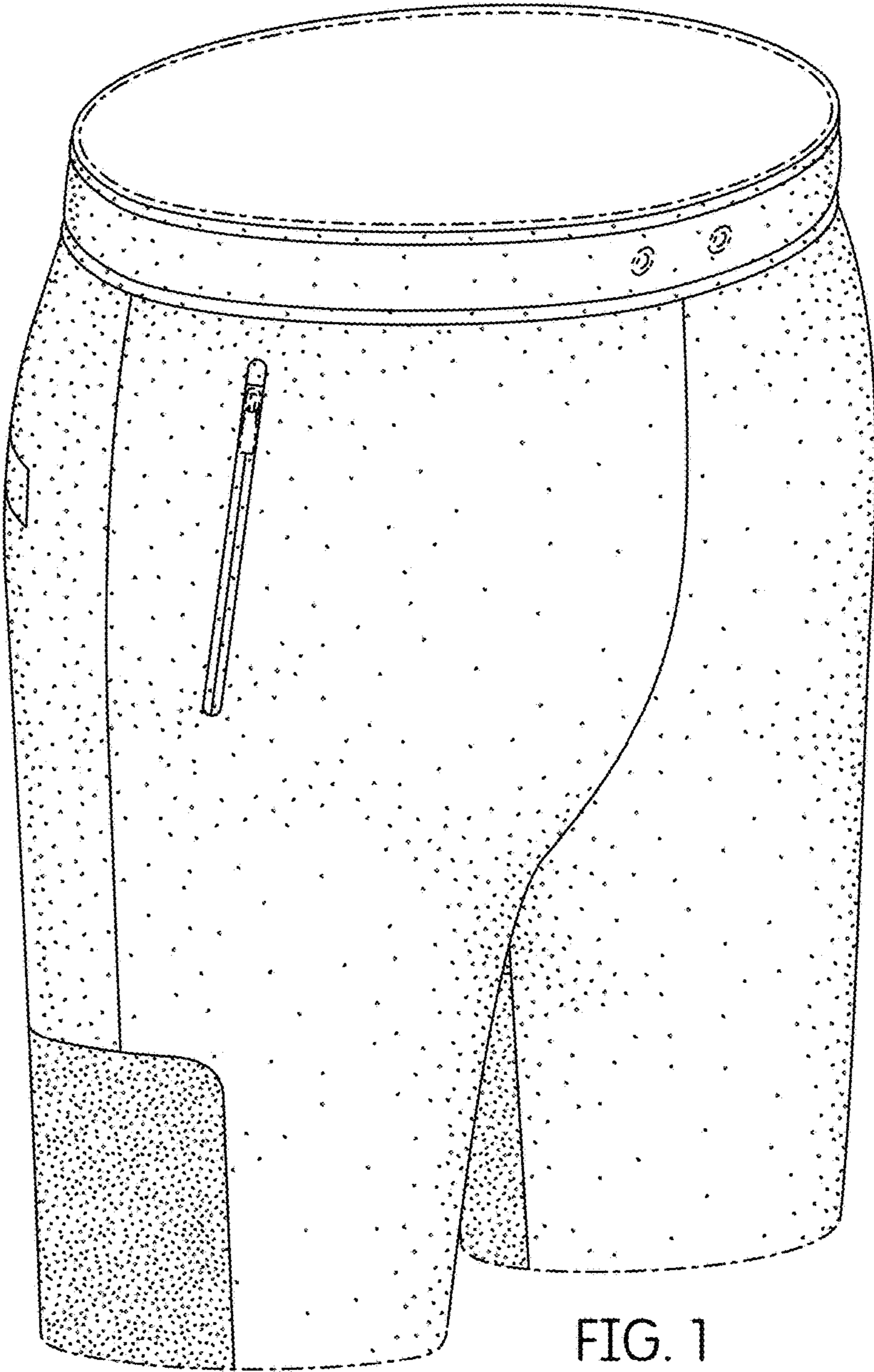

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of shorts showing my new design in an in-use configuration;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a second side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area define the bounds of the claim and form no part thereof. The contrast in stipple shading represents a contrast in appearance only. The areas demarcated by the dot-dash boundary line represent areas forming no part of the claim.

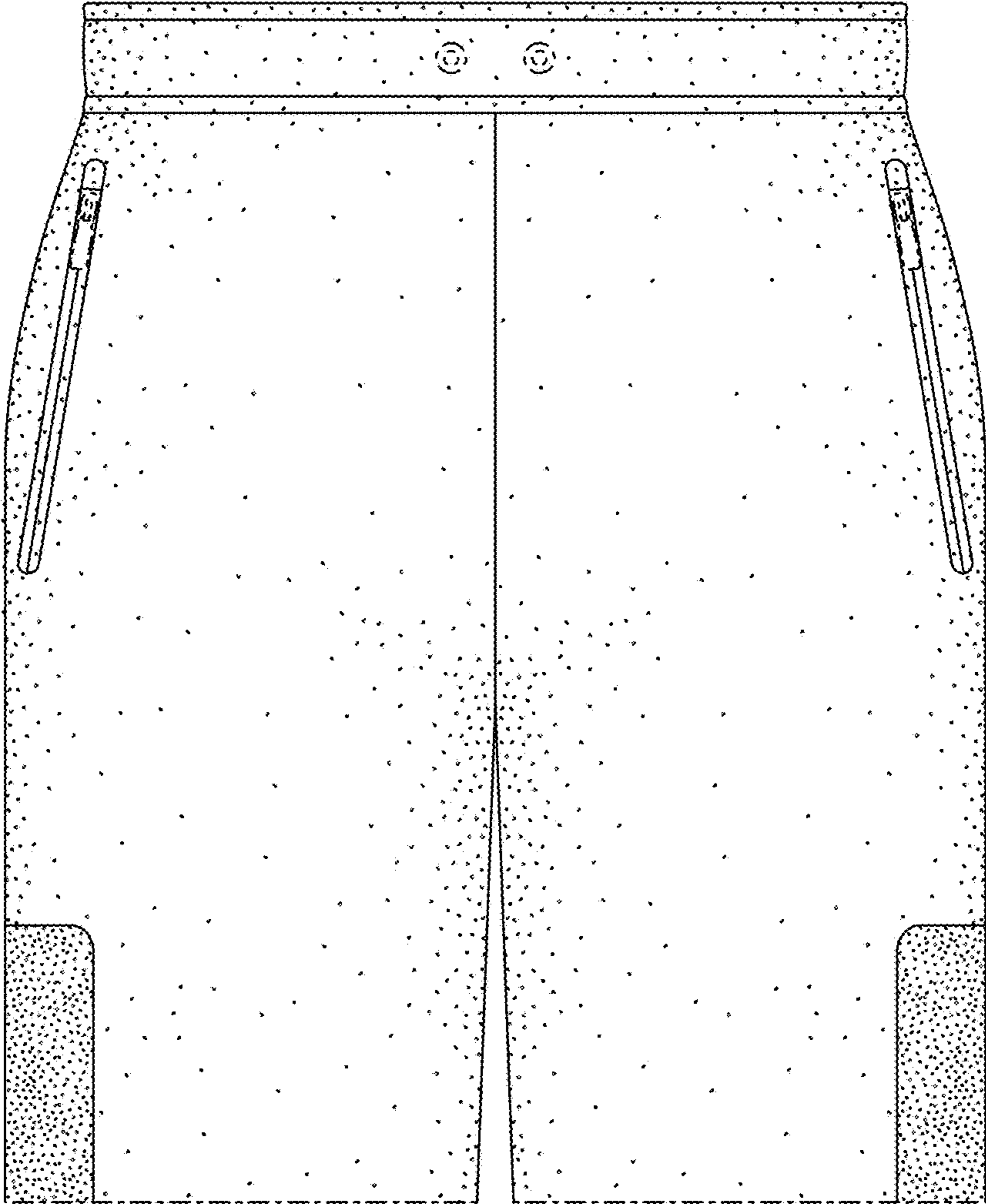

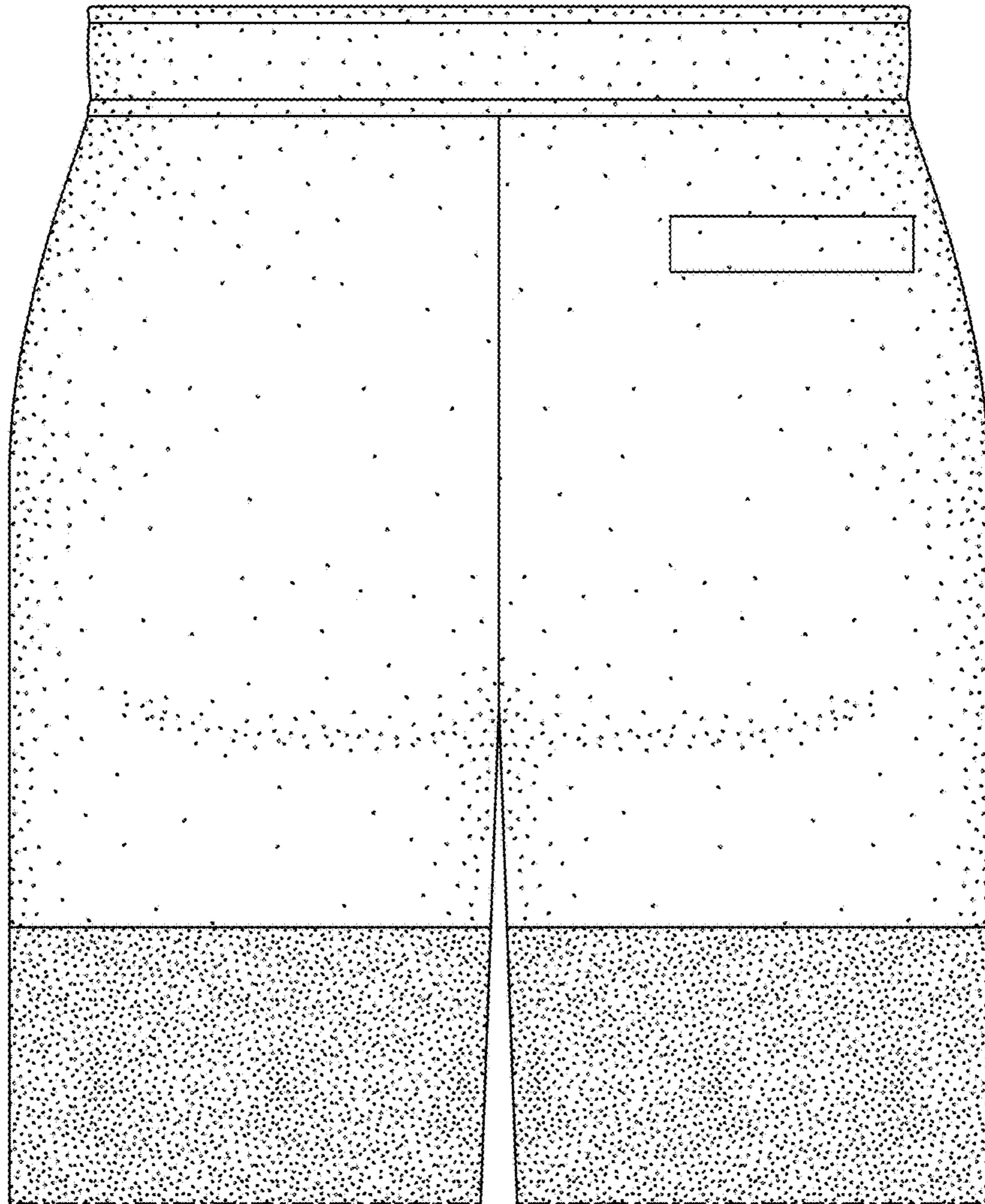

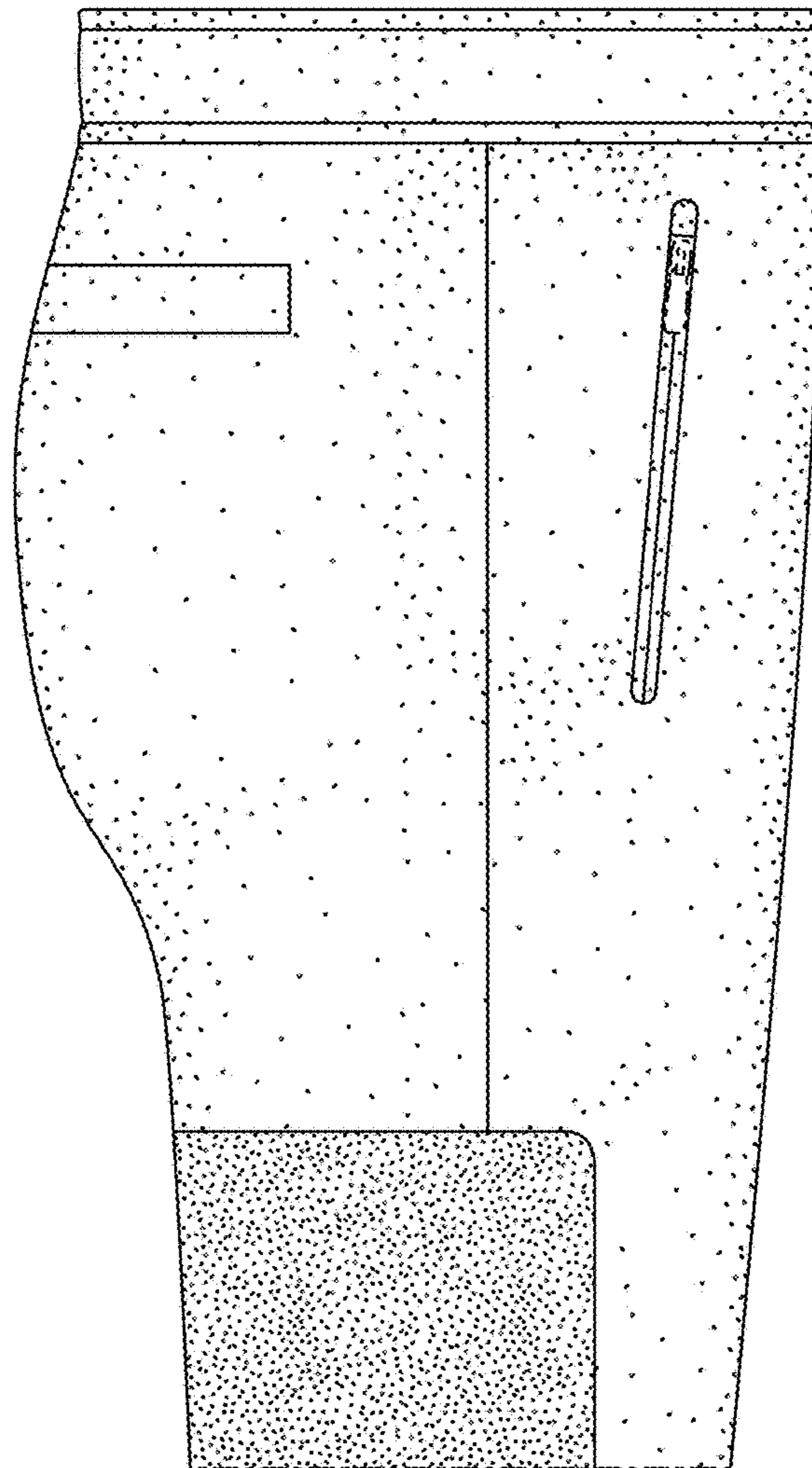

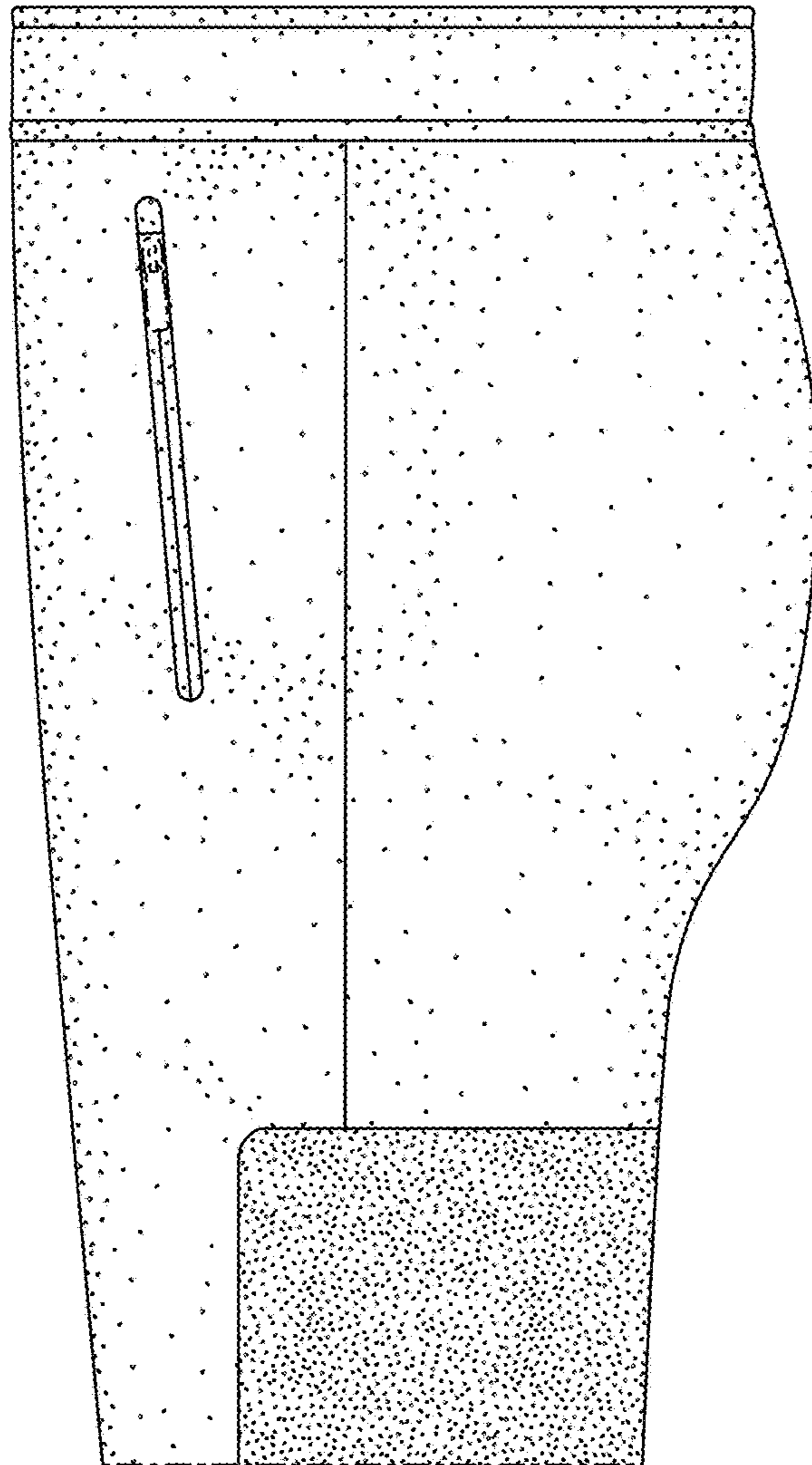

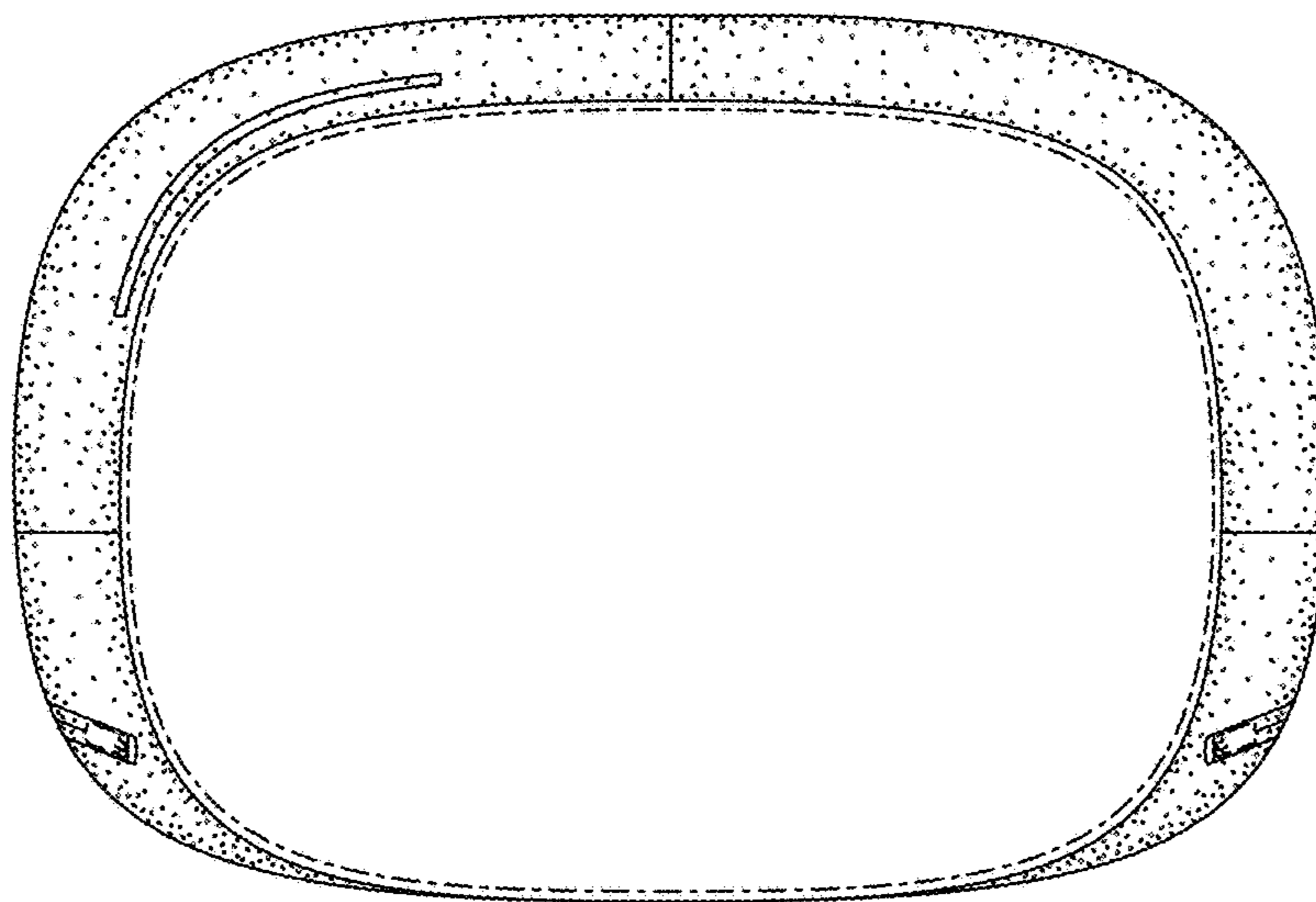

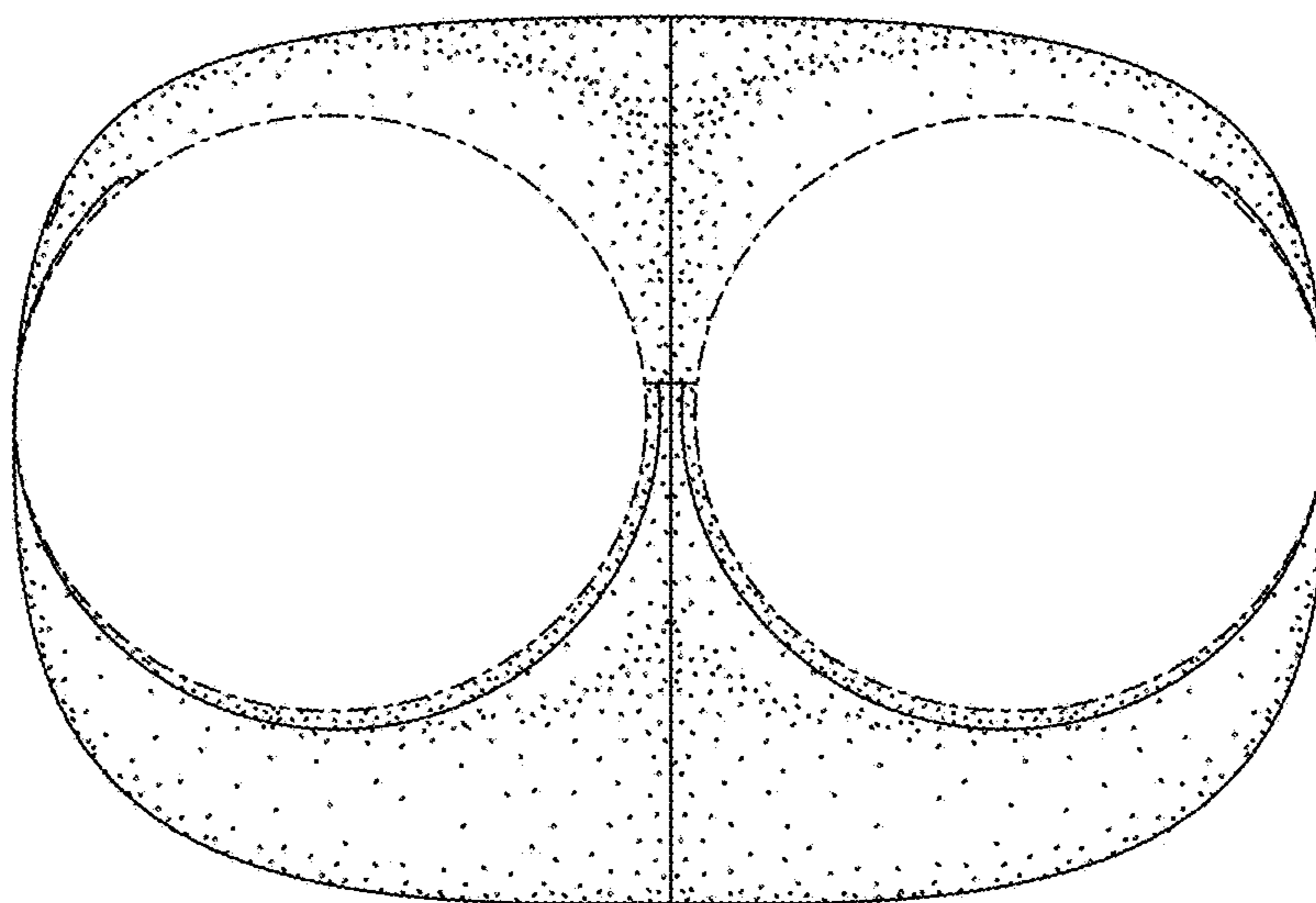
