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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stroller system with an expandable base, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a stroller system with an expandable base;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof, in a non-expanded state;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof, in a partially-expanded state;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof, in a fully-expanded state;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof, in a non-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the left side view;

FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof, in a partially-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the left side view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 7 is a side view thereof; in a fully-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the left side view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof, in a non-expanded state;

FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof, in a partially-expanded state;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view thereof, in a fully-expanded state;

FIG. 11 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a non-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 12 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a partially-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 13 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a fully-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 14 is a rear right side perspective view thereof, in a non-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the rear left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 15 is a rear right side perspective view thereof, in a partially-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the rear left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 16 is a rear right side perspective view thereof, in a fully-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the rear left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 17 is a top view thereof, in a non-expanded state;

FIG. 18 is a top view thereof, in a partially-expanded state;

FIG. 19 is a top view thereof, in a fully-expanded state;

FIG. 20 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a partially folded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 21 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a second partially folded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

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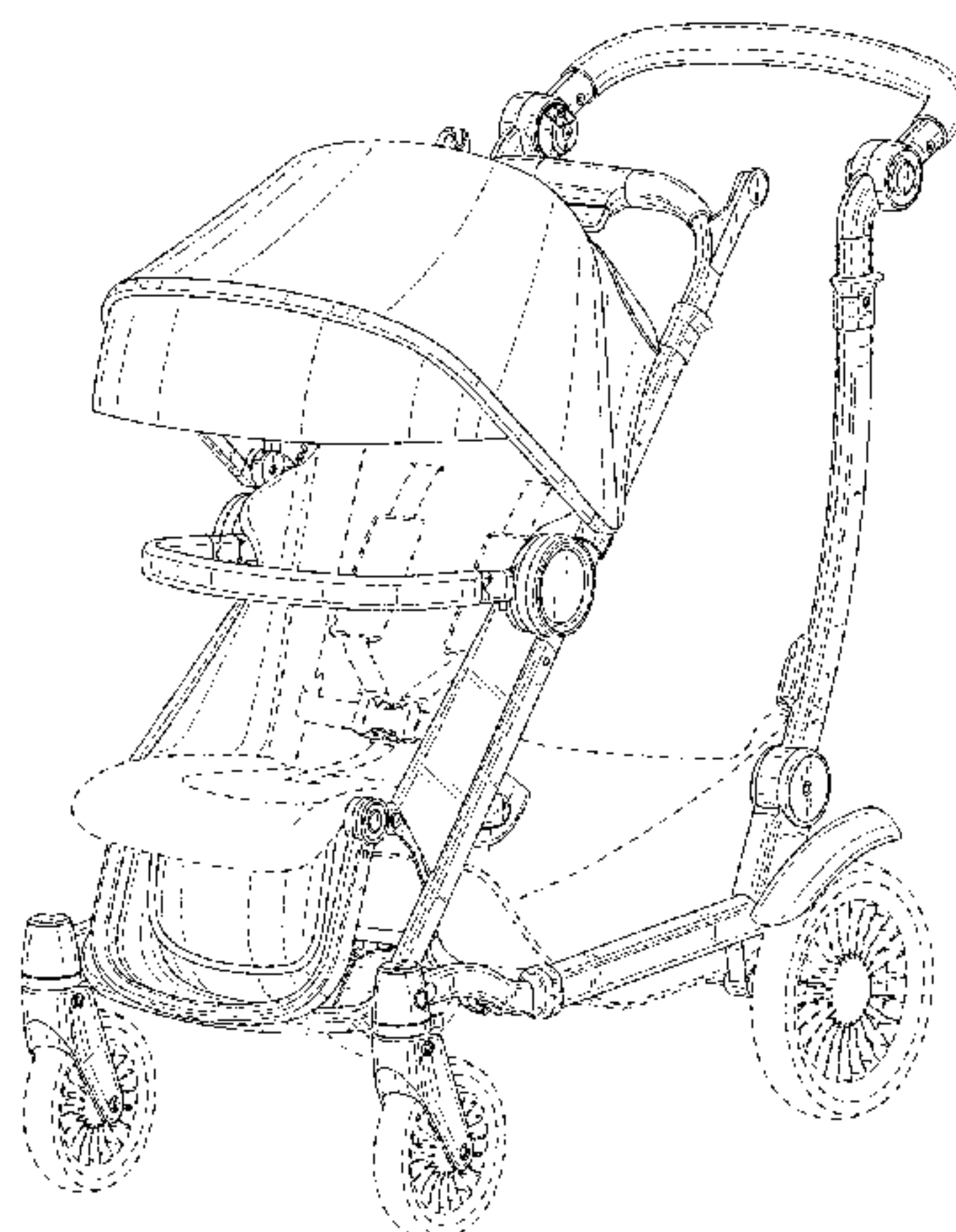


FIG. 22 is a front right side perspective view thereof, in a third partially folded state, view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 28 is a front right side perspective view thereof, fully reclined with the base in a non-expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller;

FIG. 29 is a front right side perspective view thereof, fully reclined with the base in an partially expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller; and,

FIG. 30 is a front right side perspective view thereof, fully reclined with the base in a fully expanded state, this view is a mirror image of the front left perspective view of the first embodiment of the stroller.

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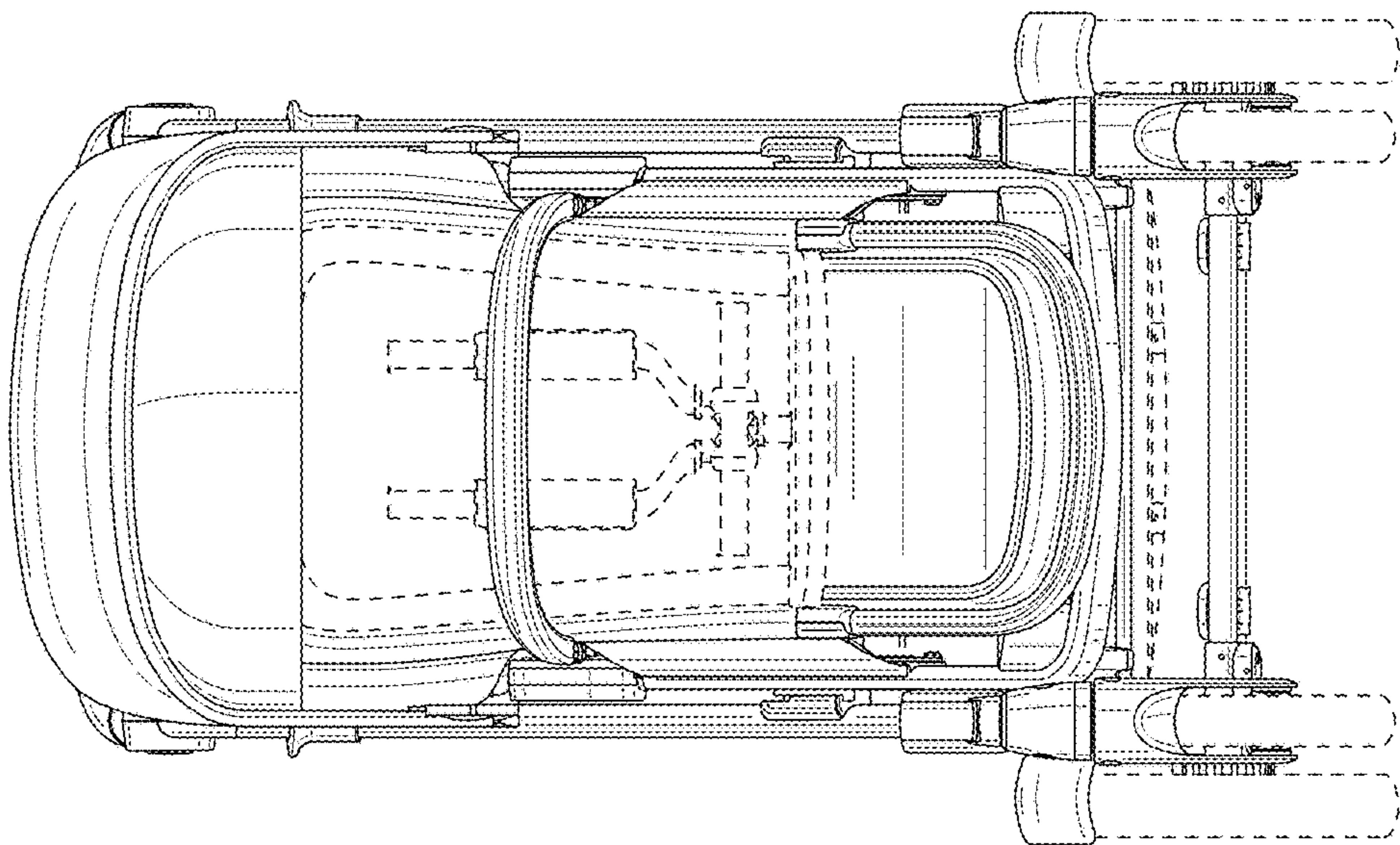

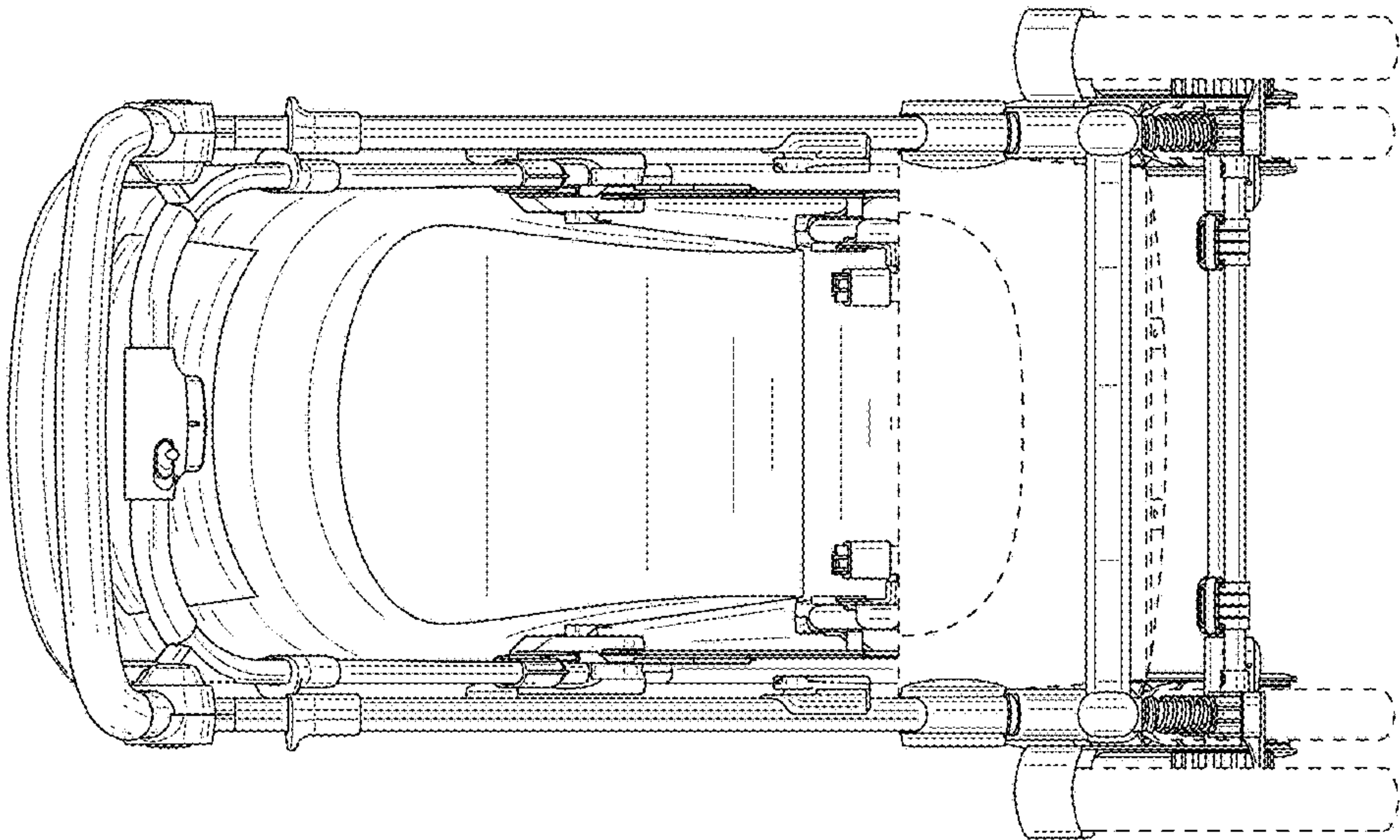

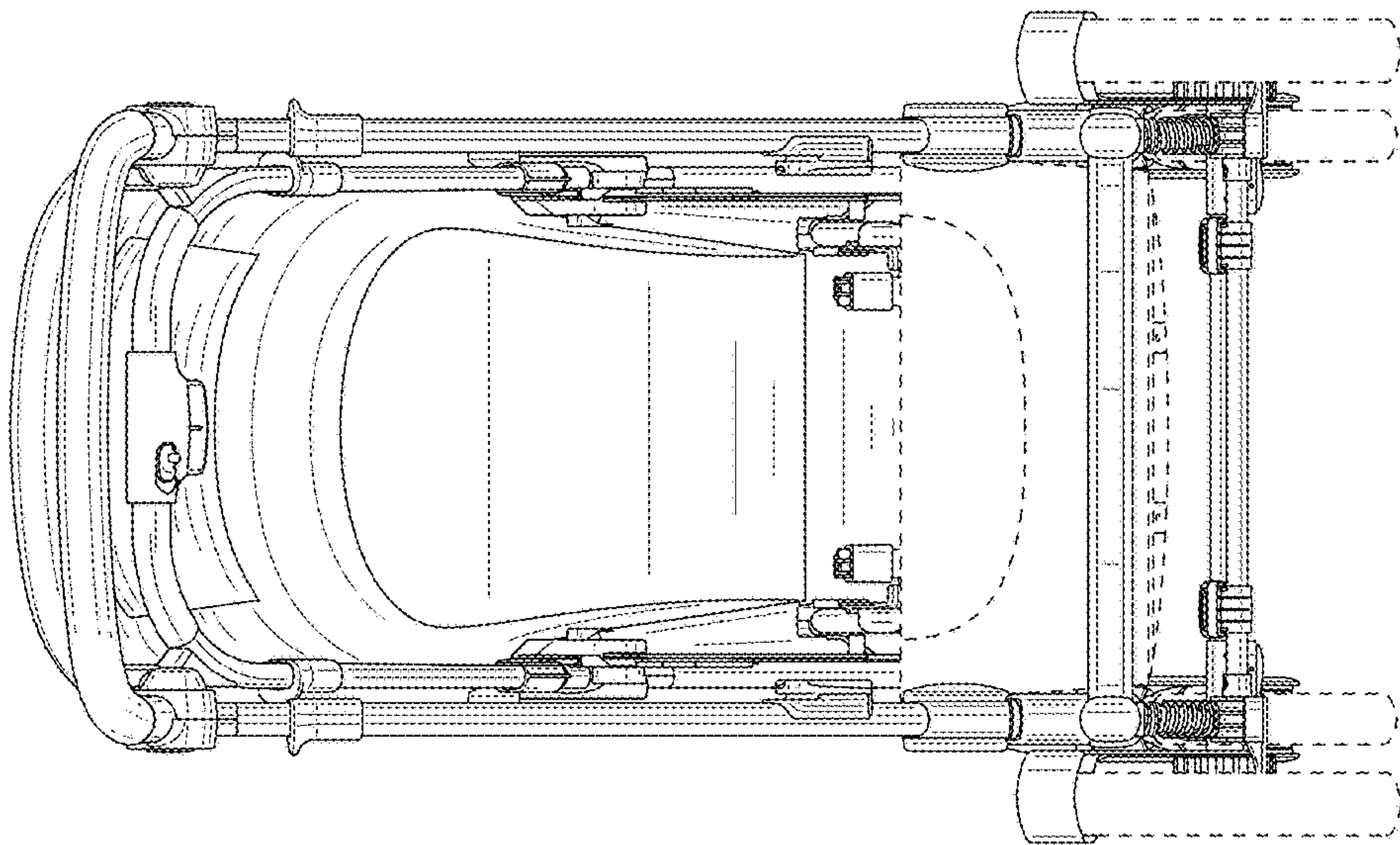

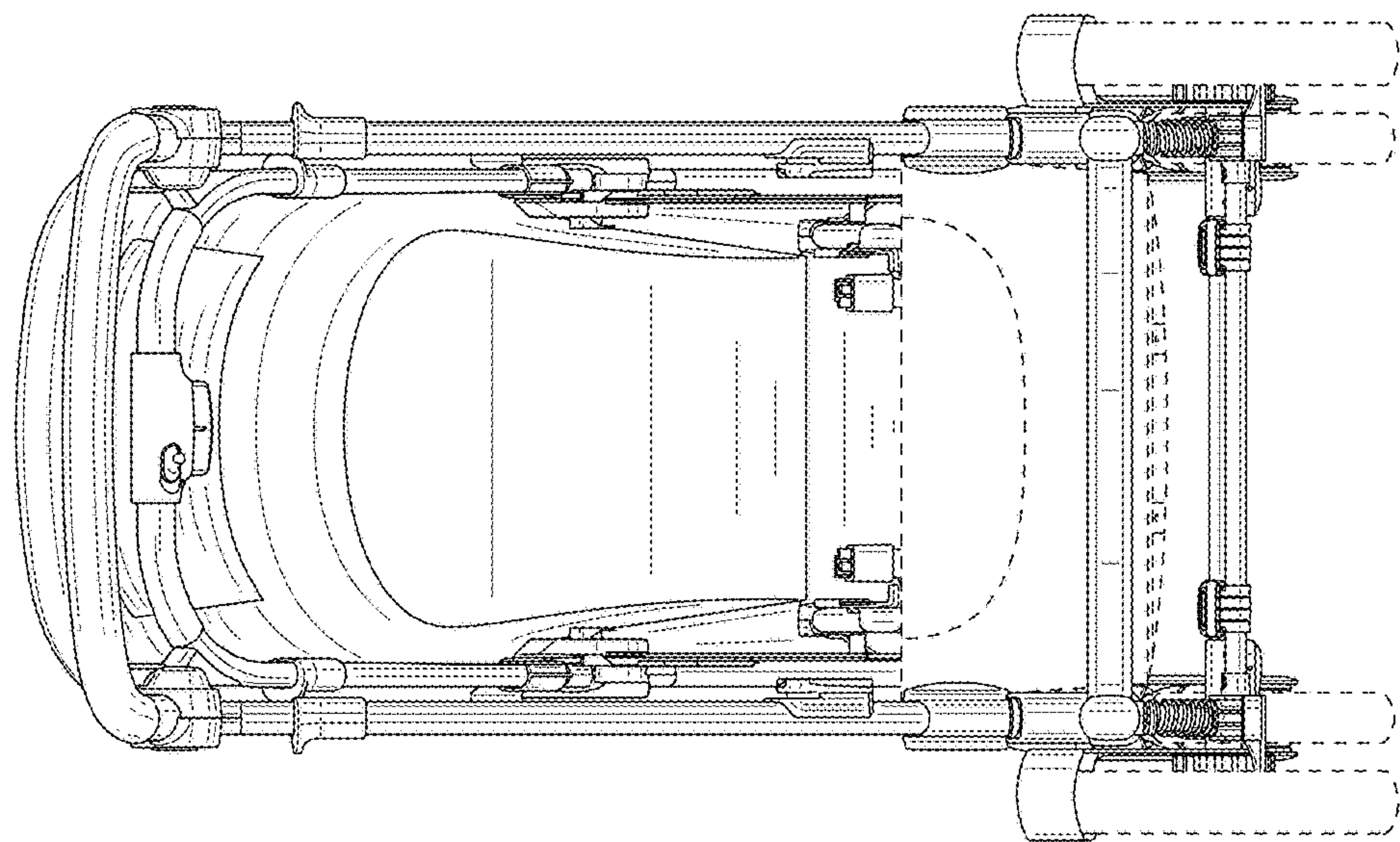

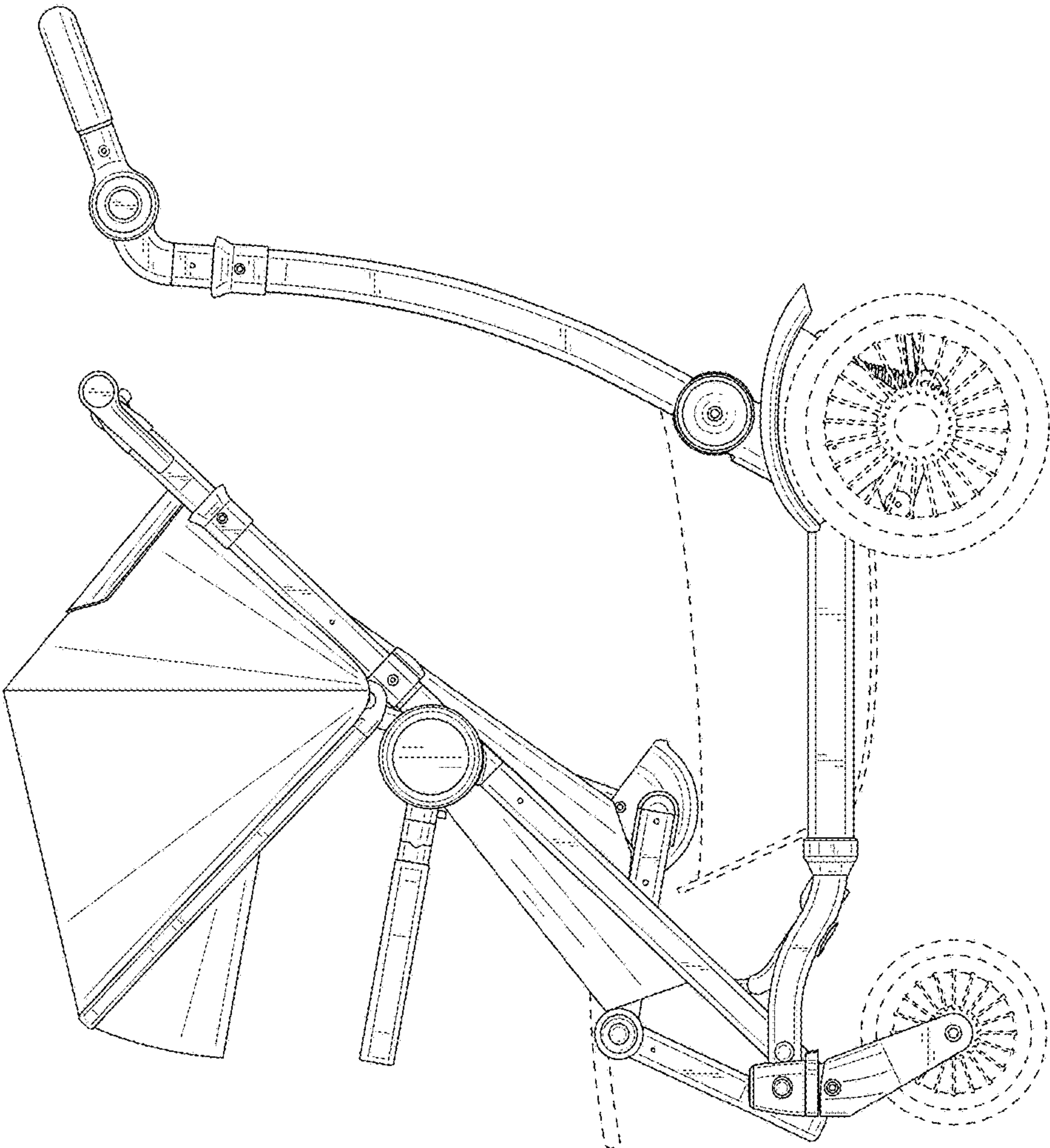

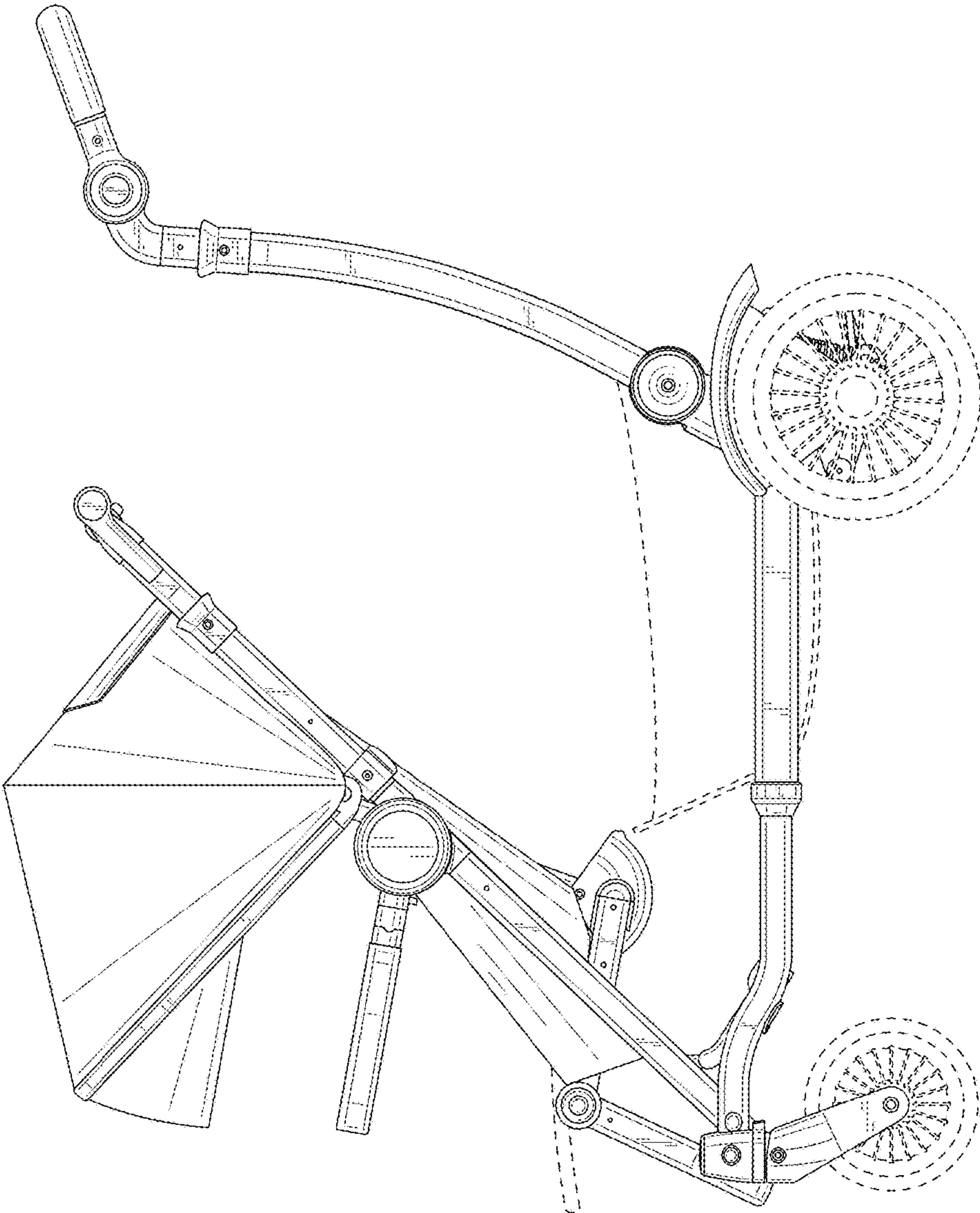

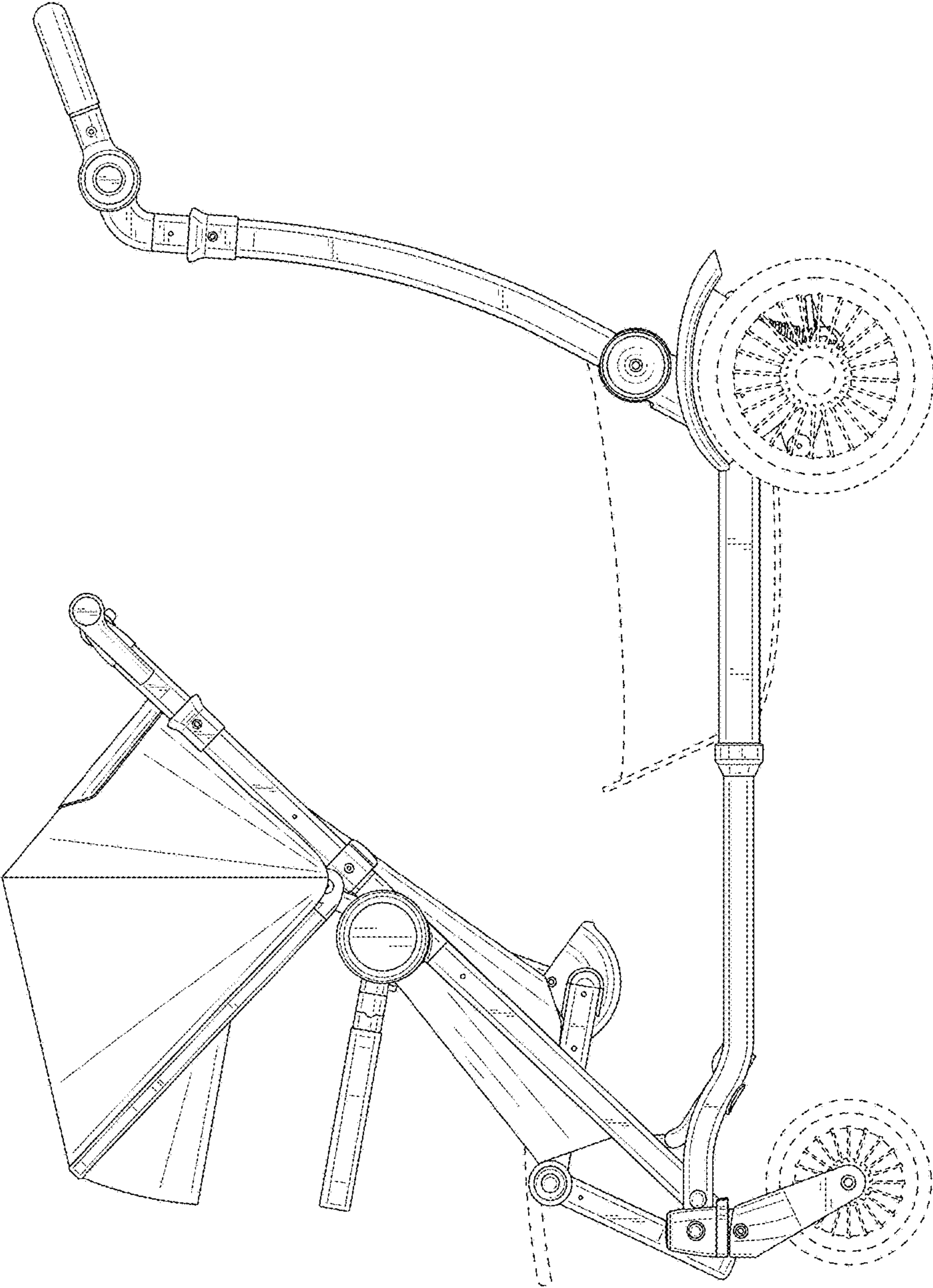

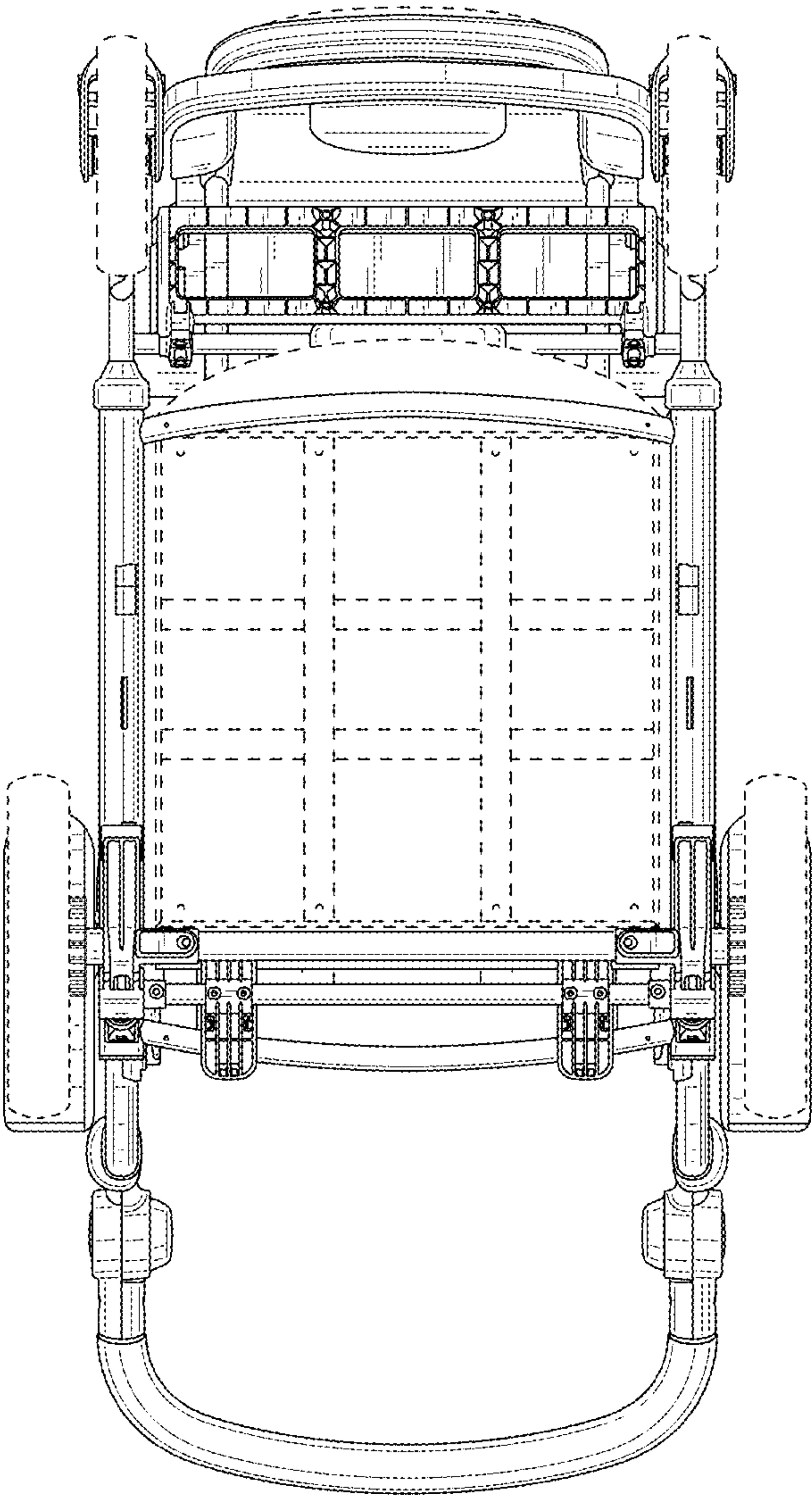

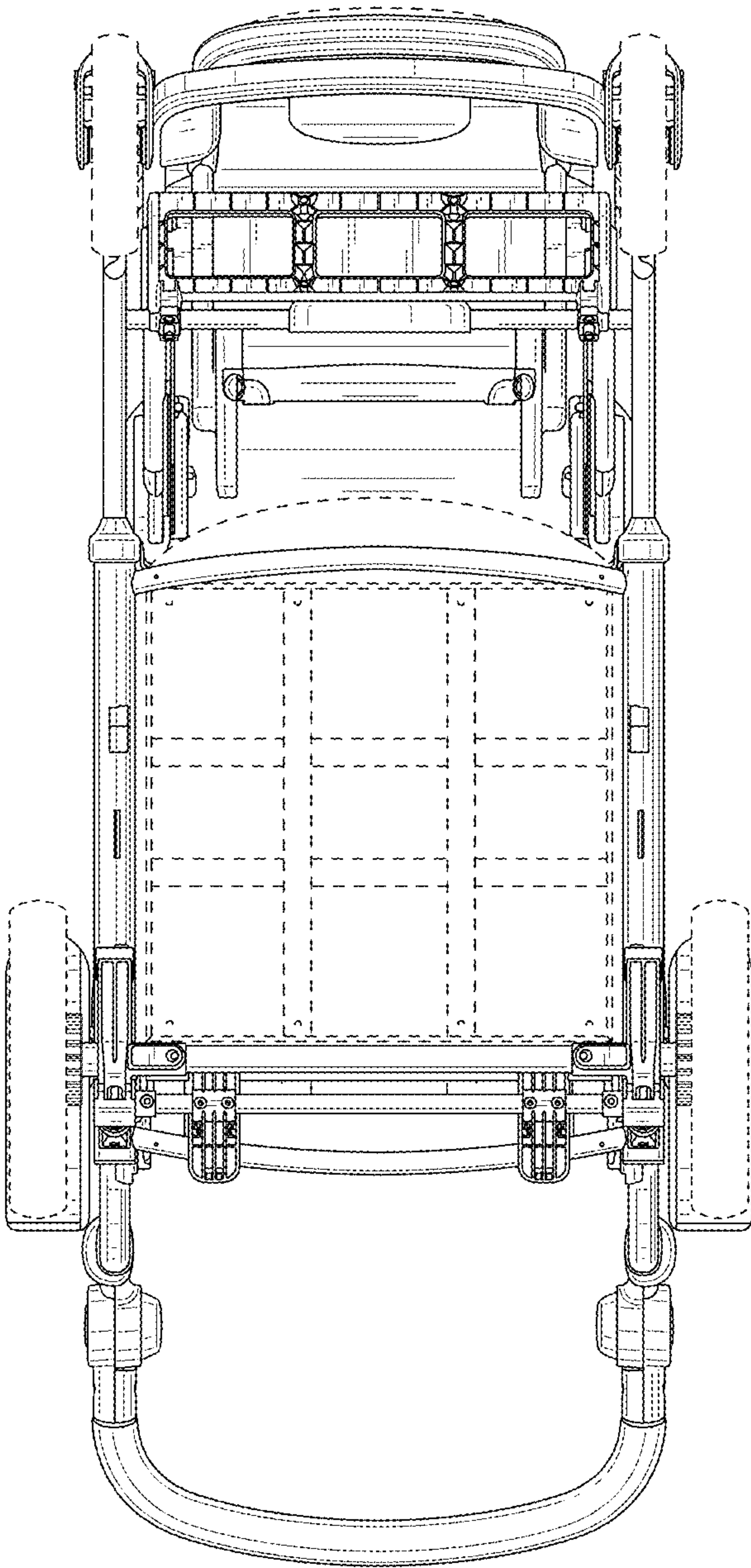

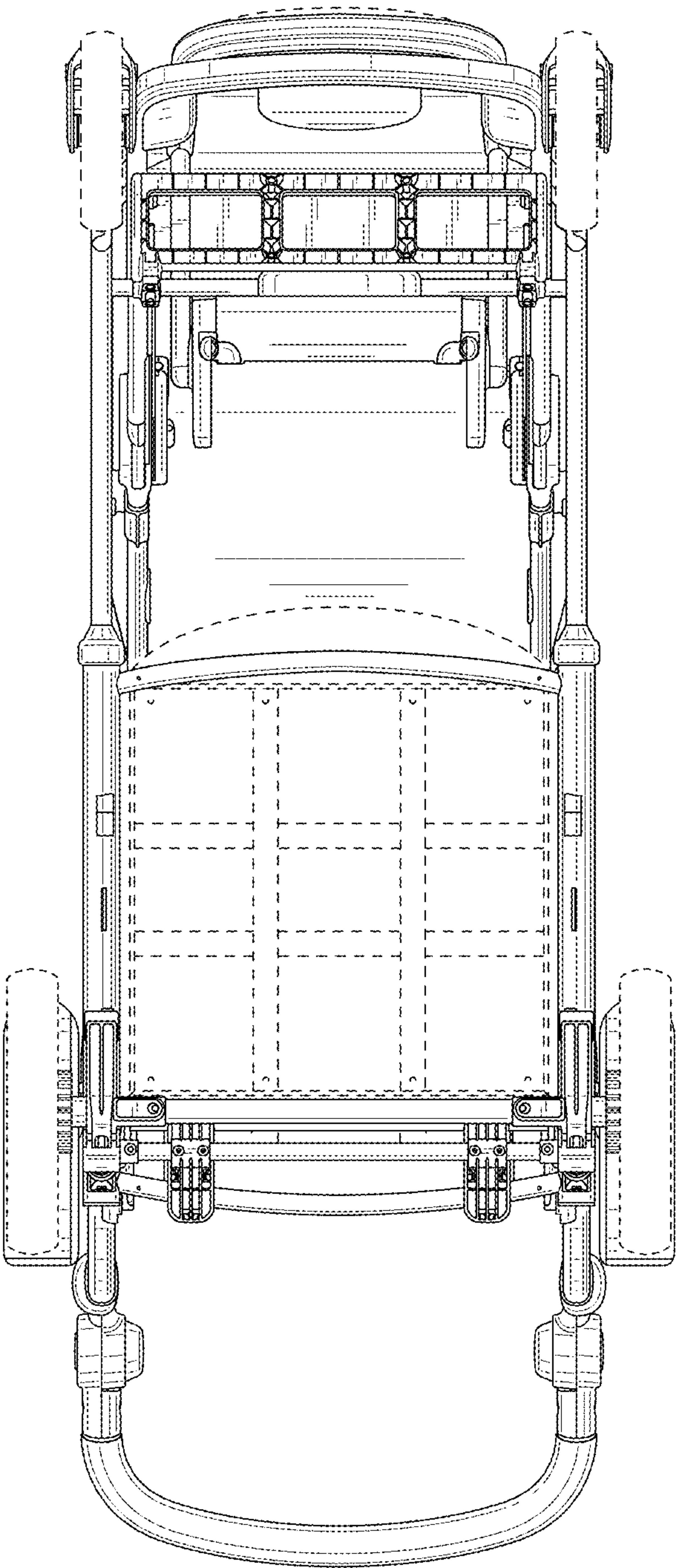

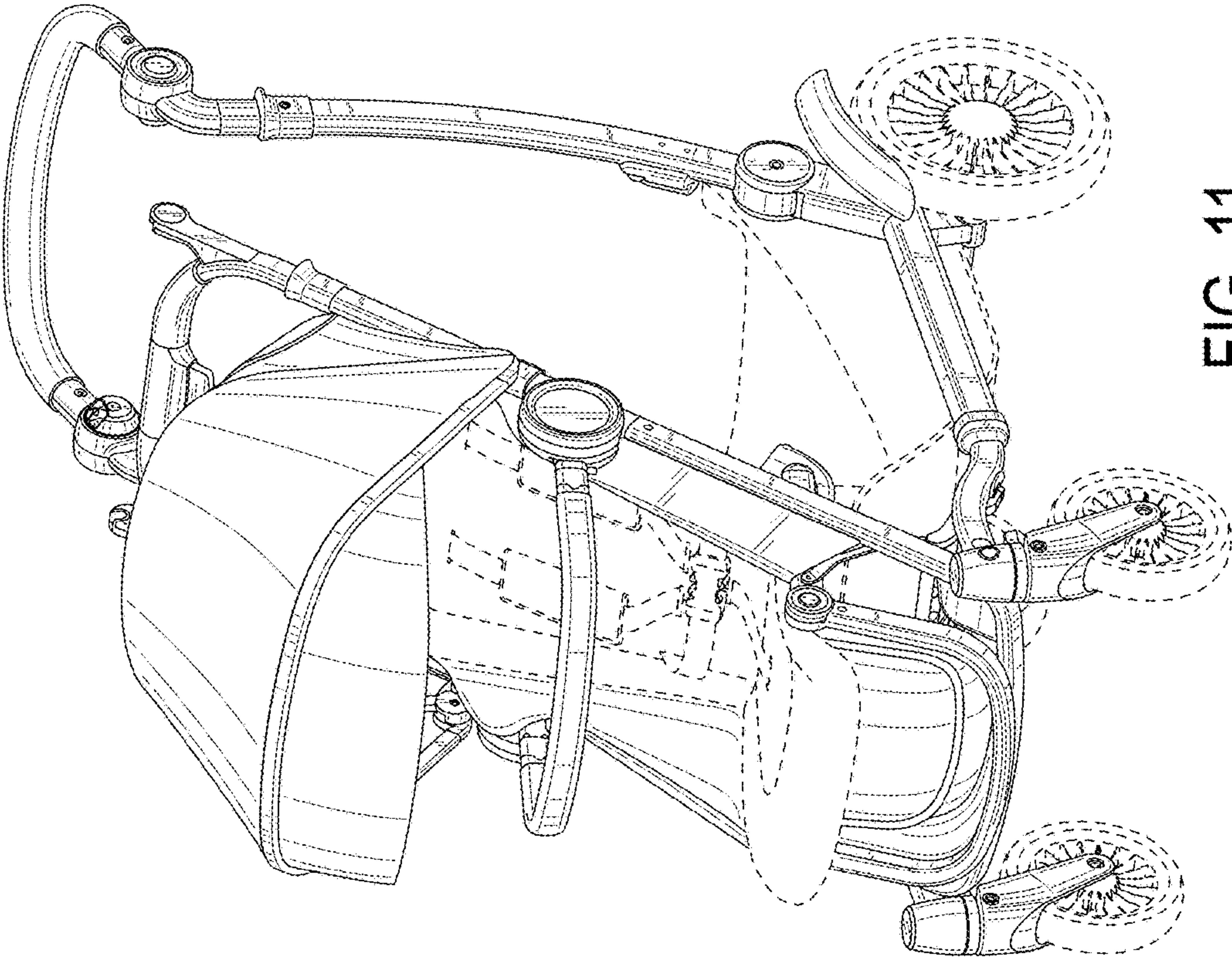

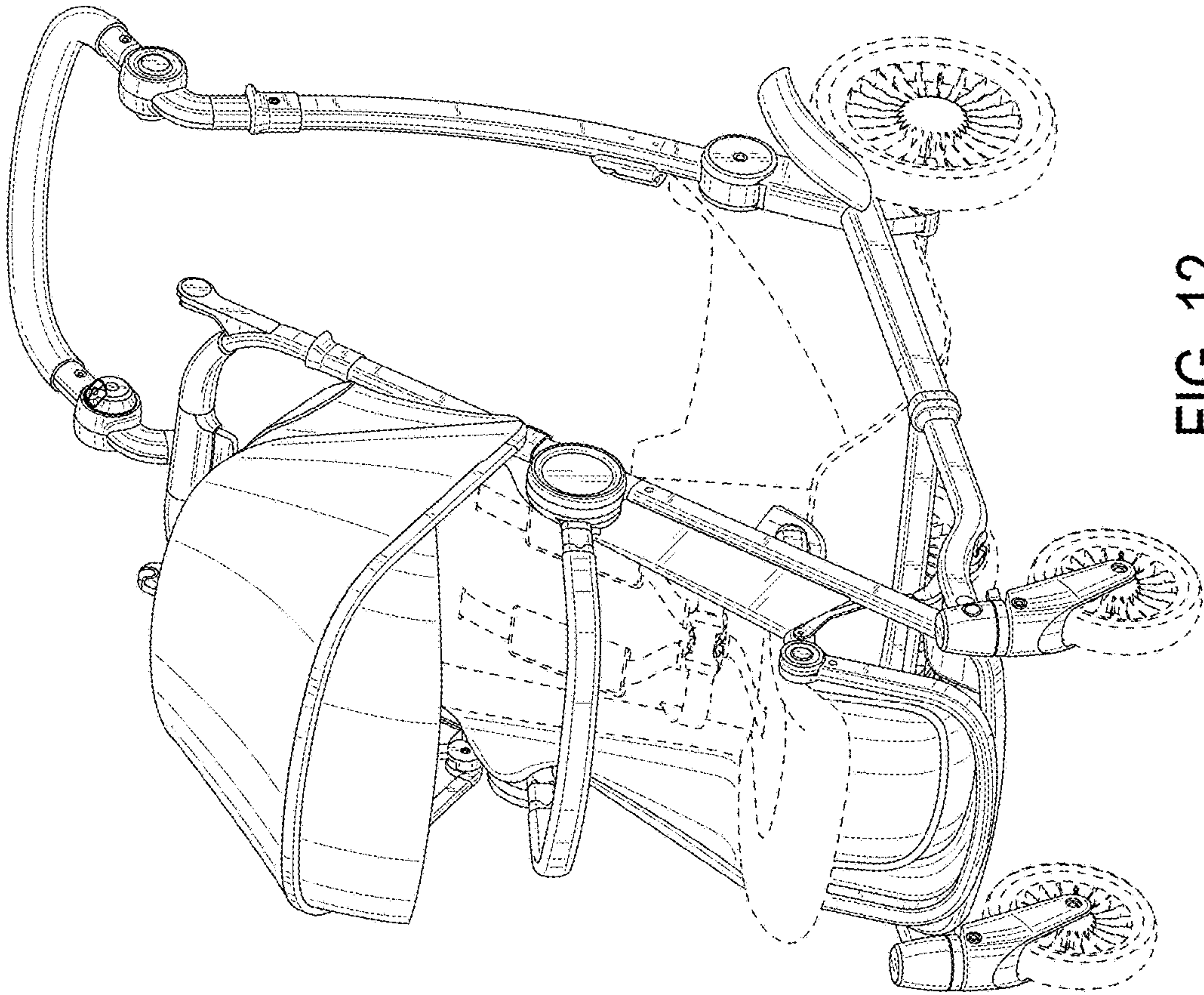

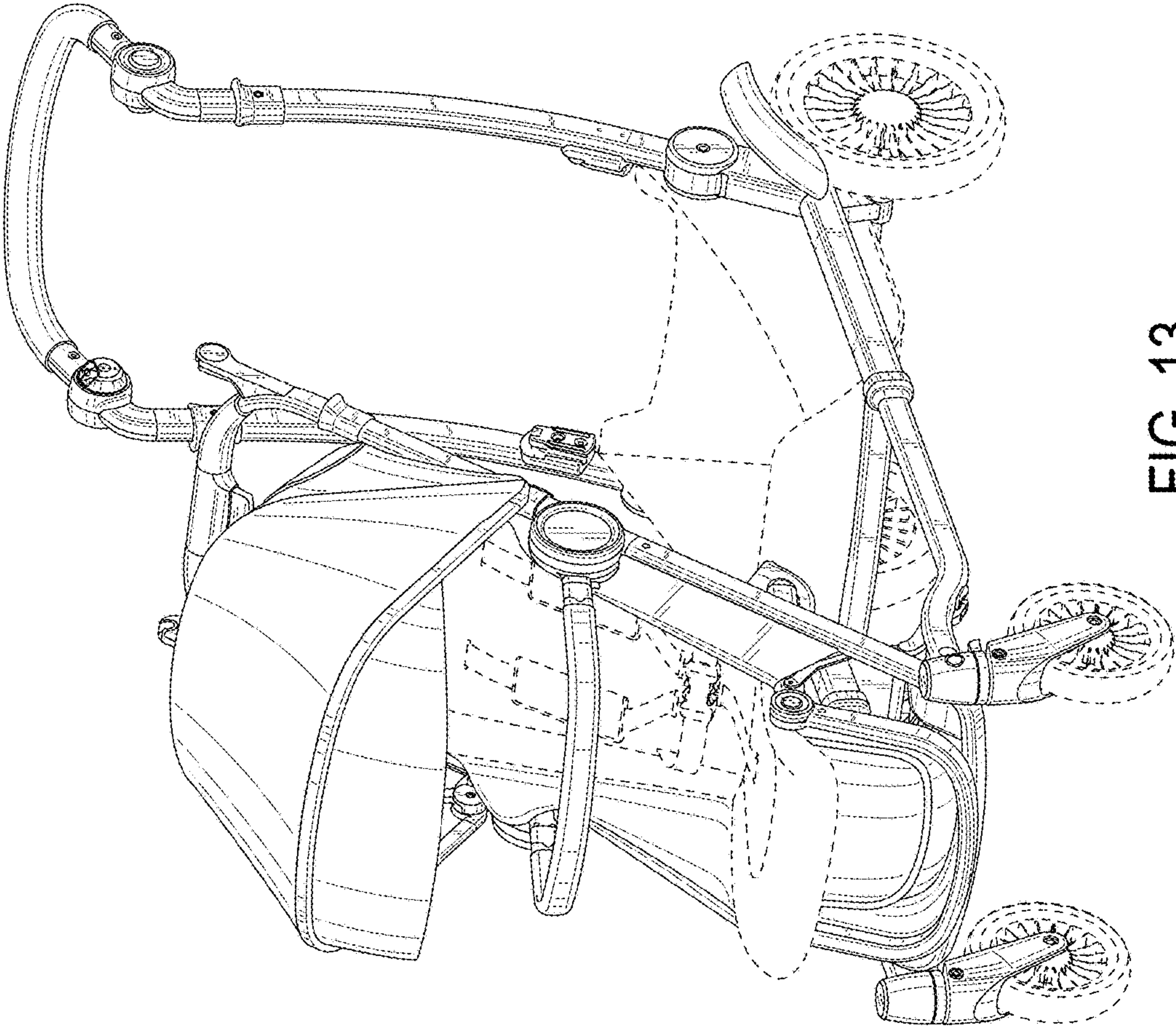


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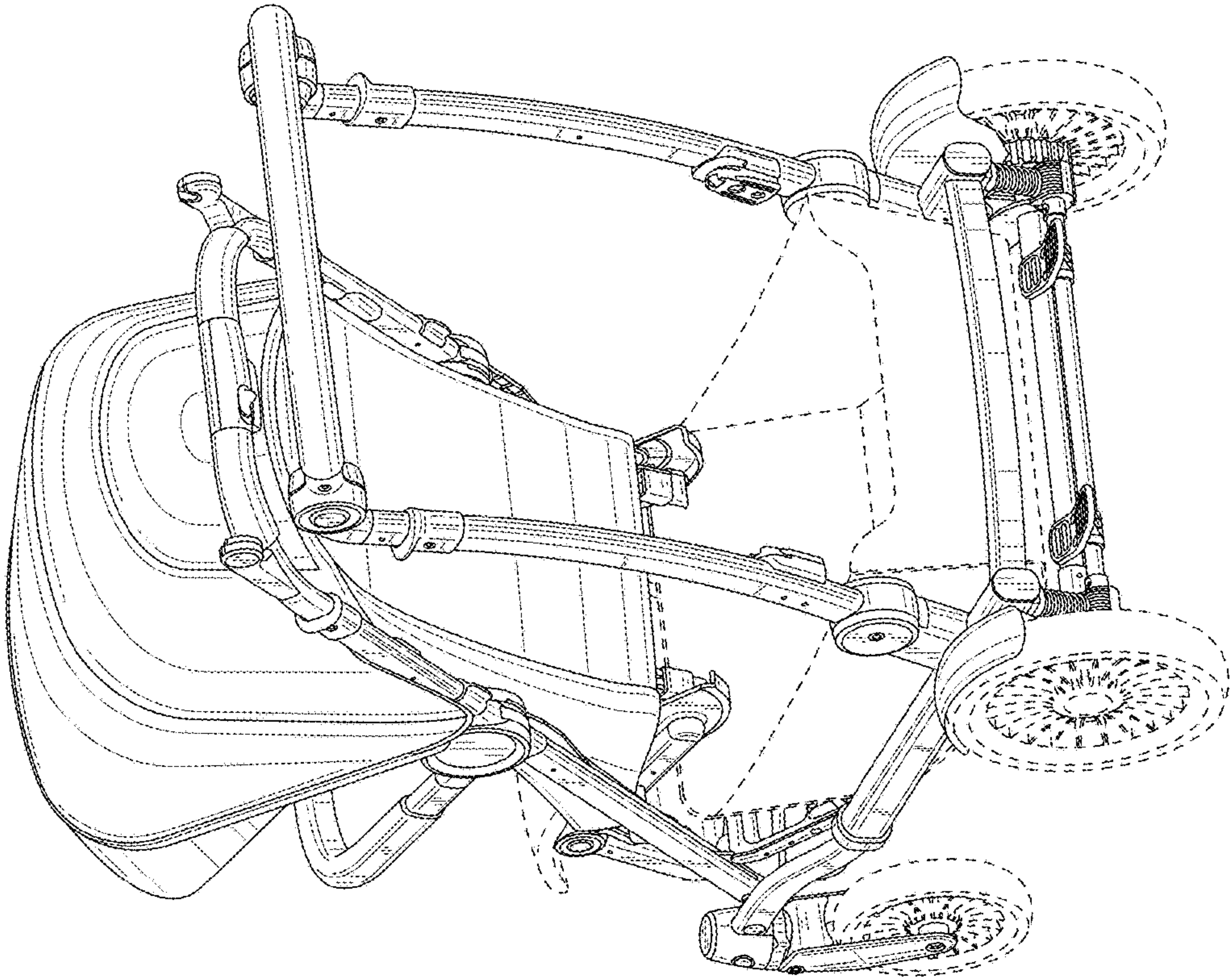

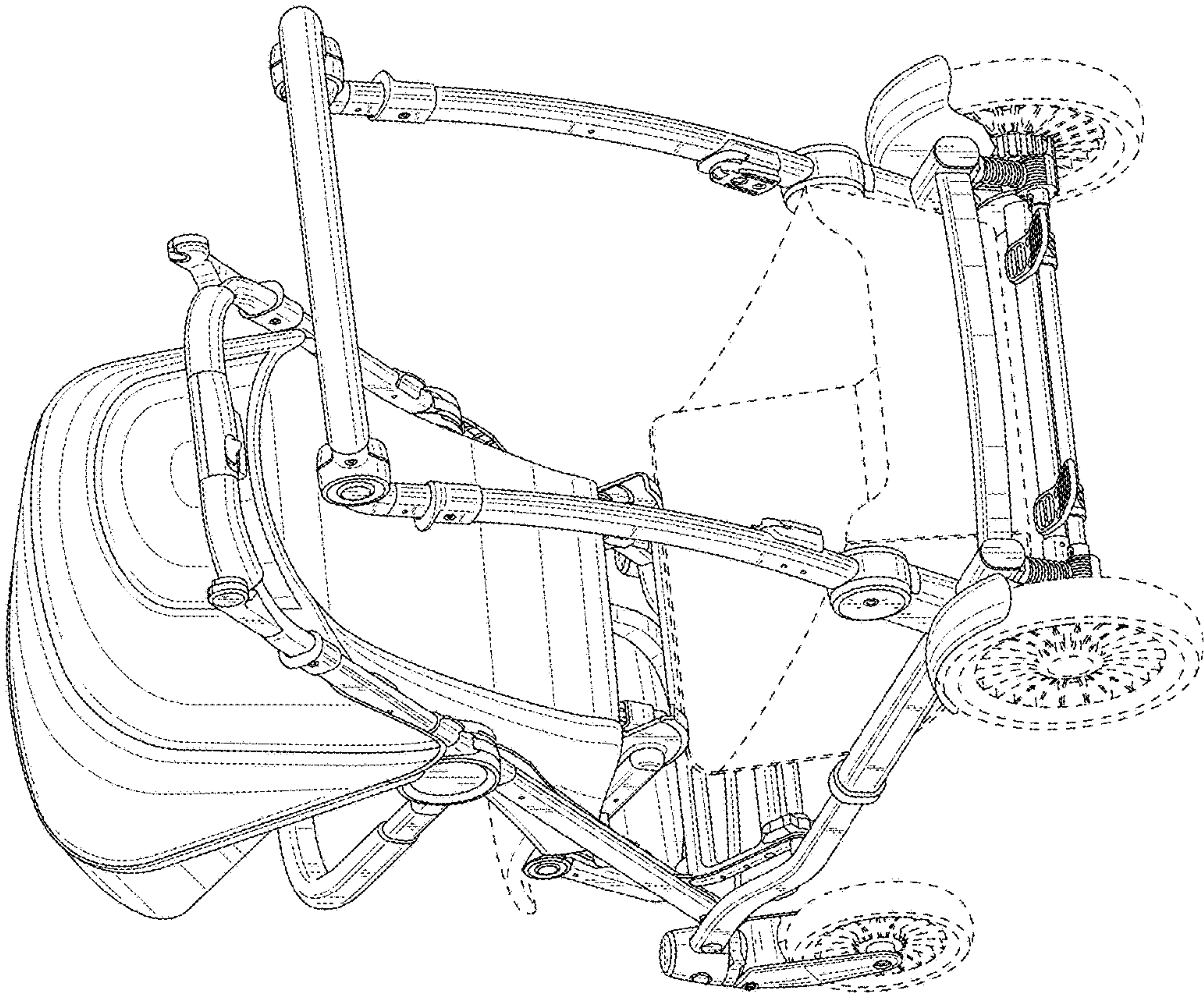

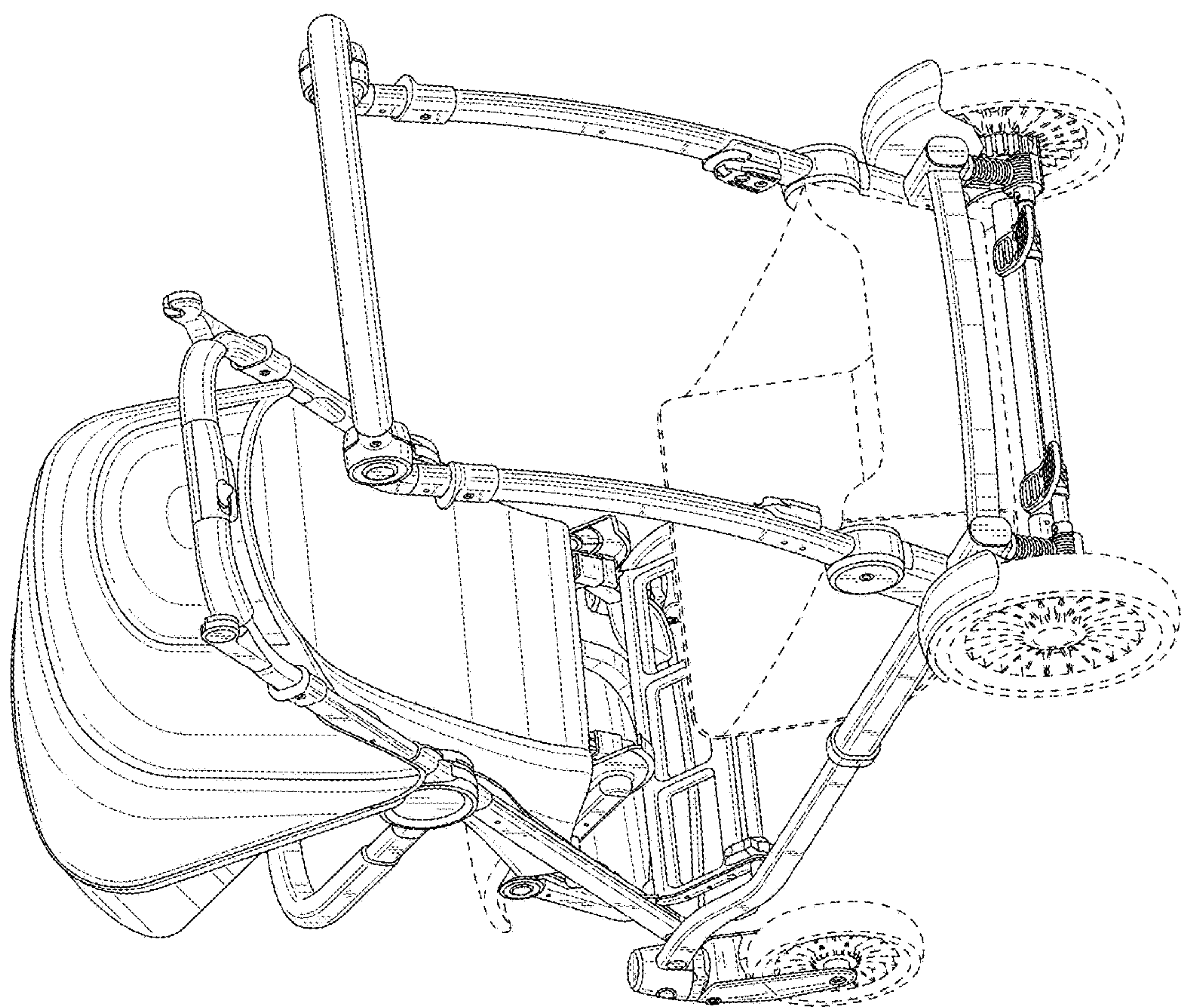

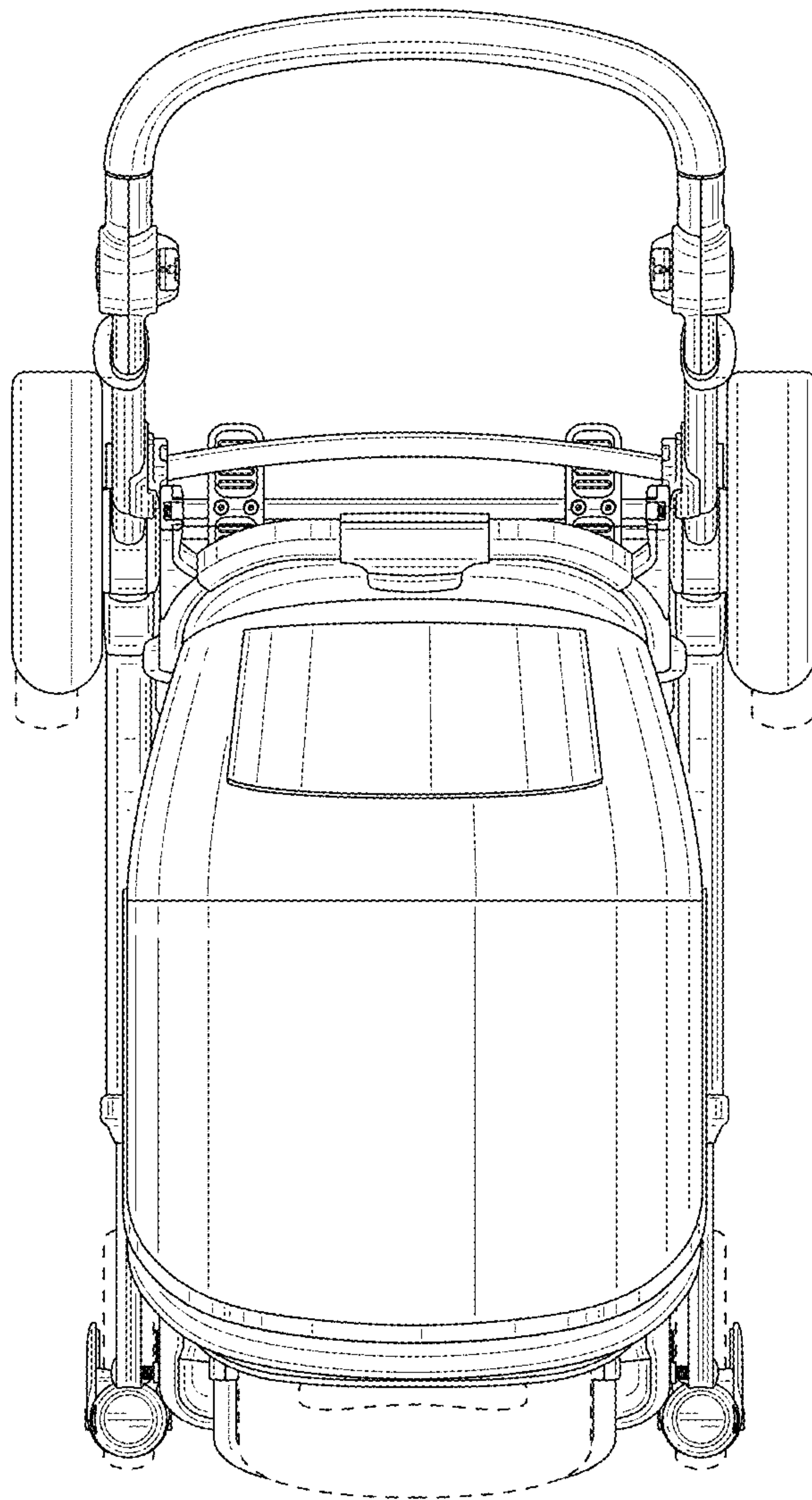


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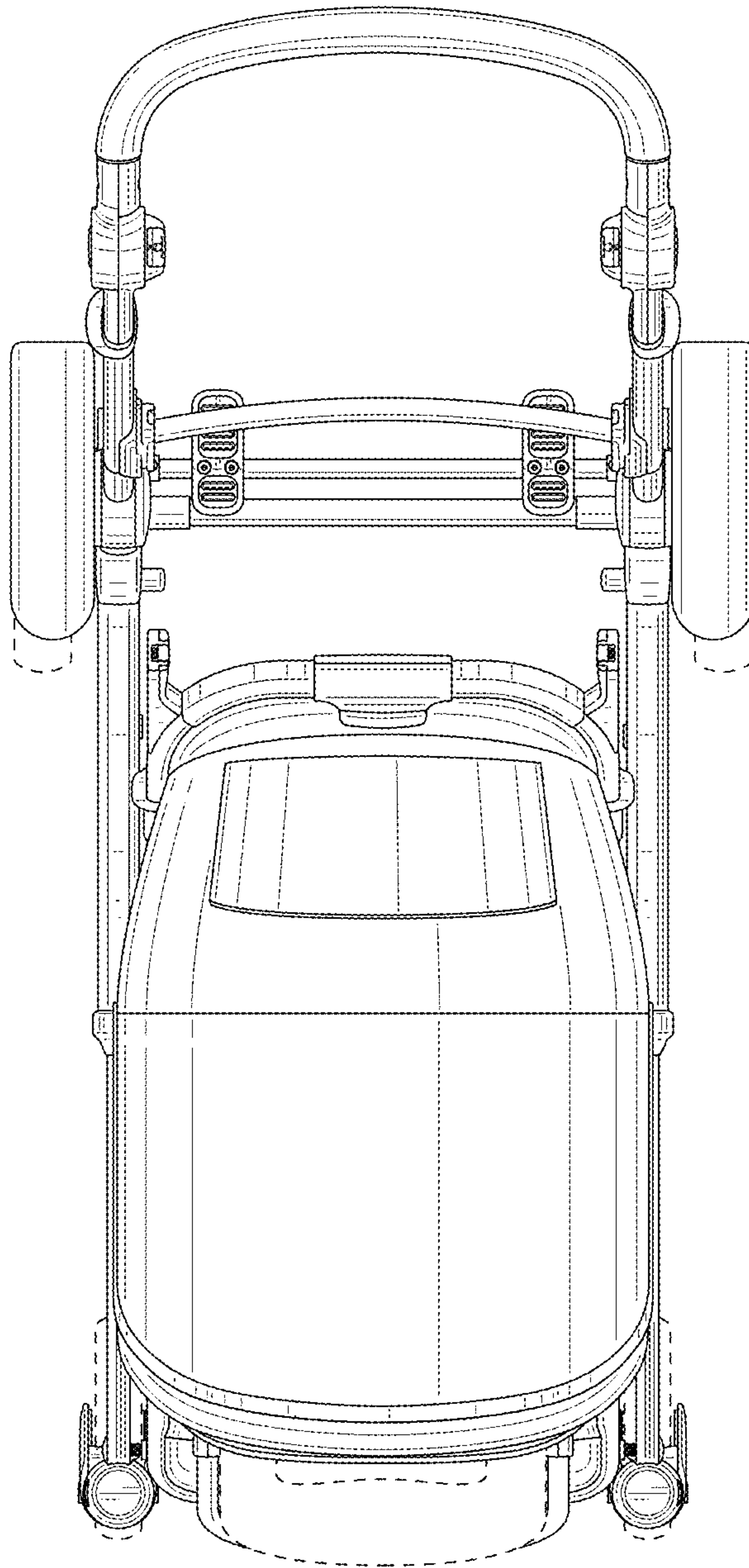

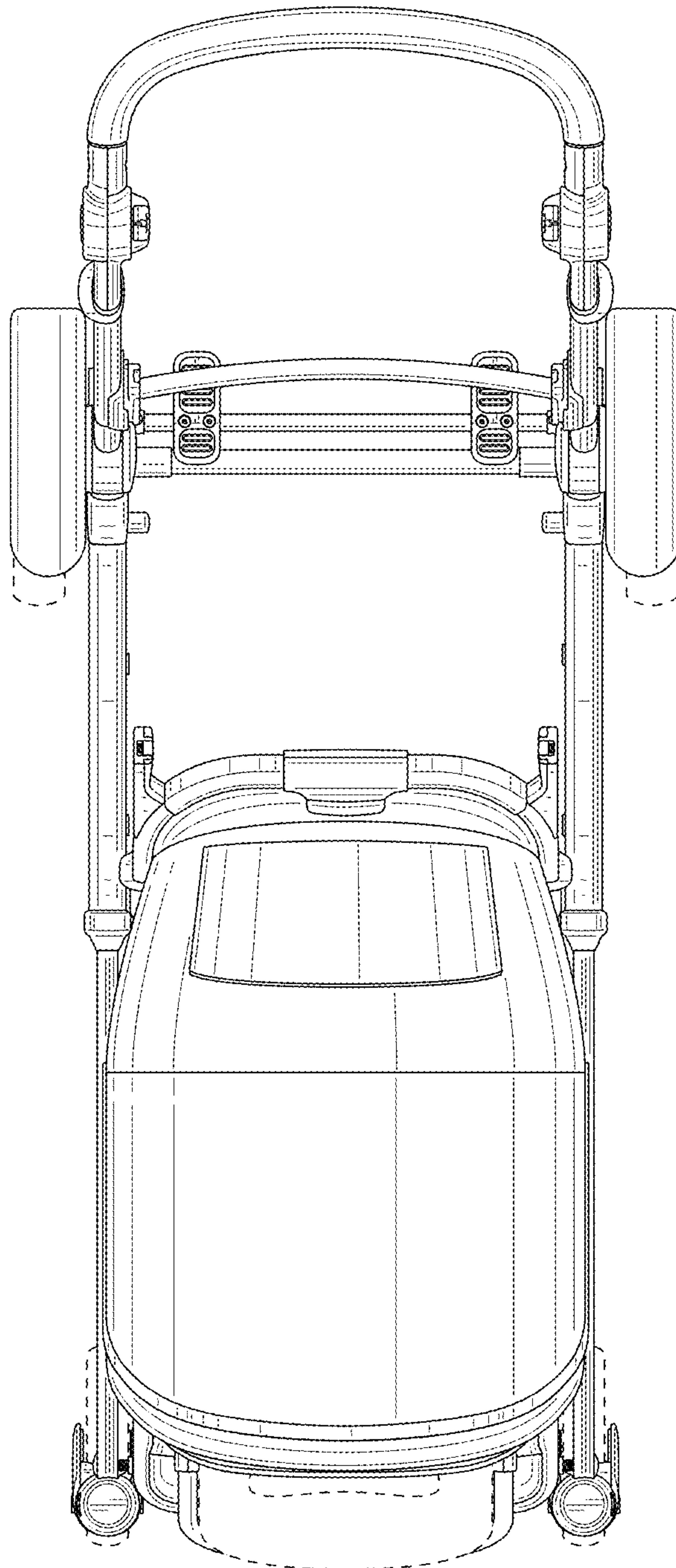

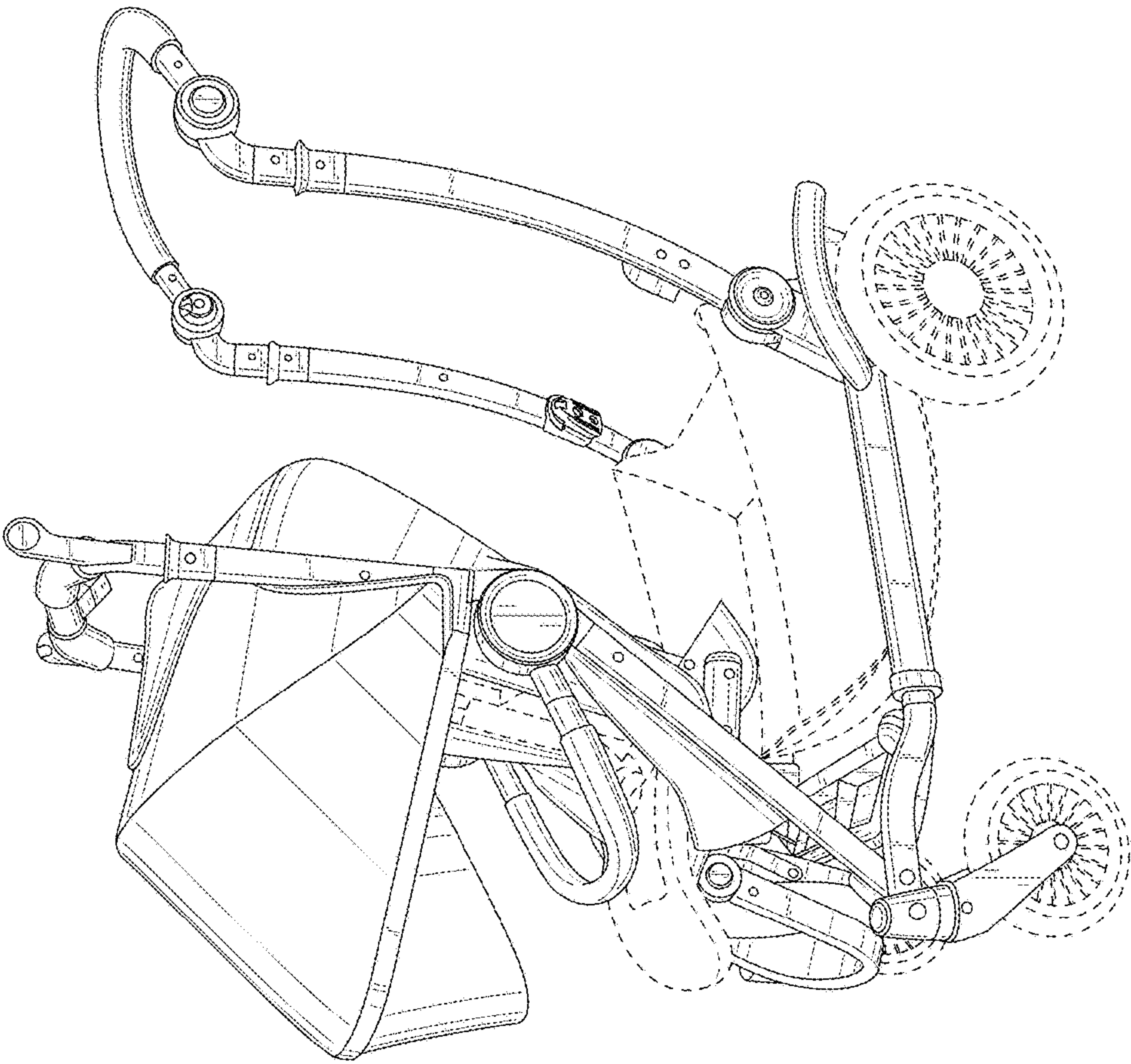


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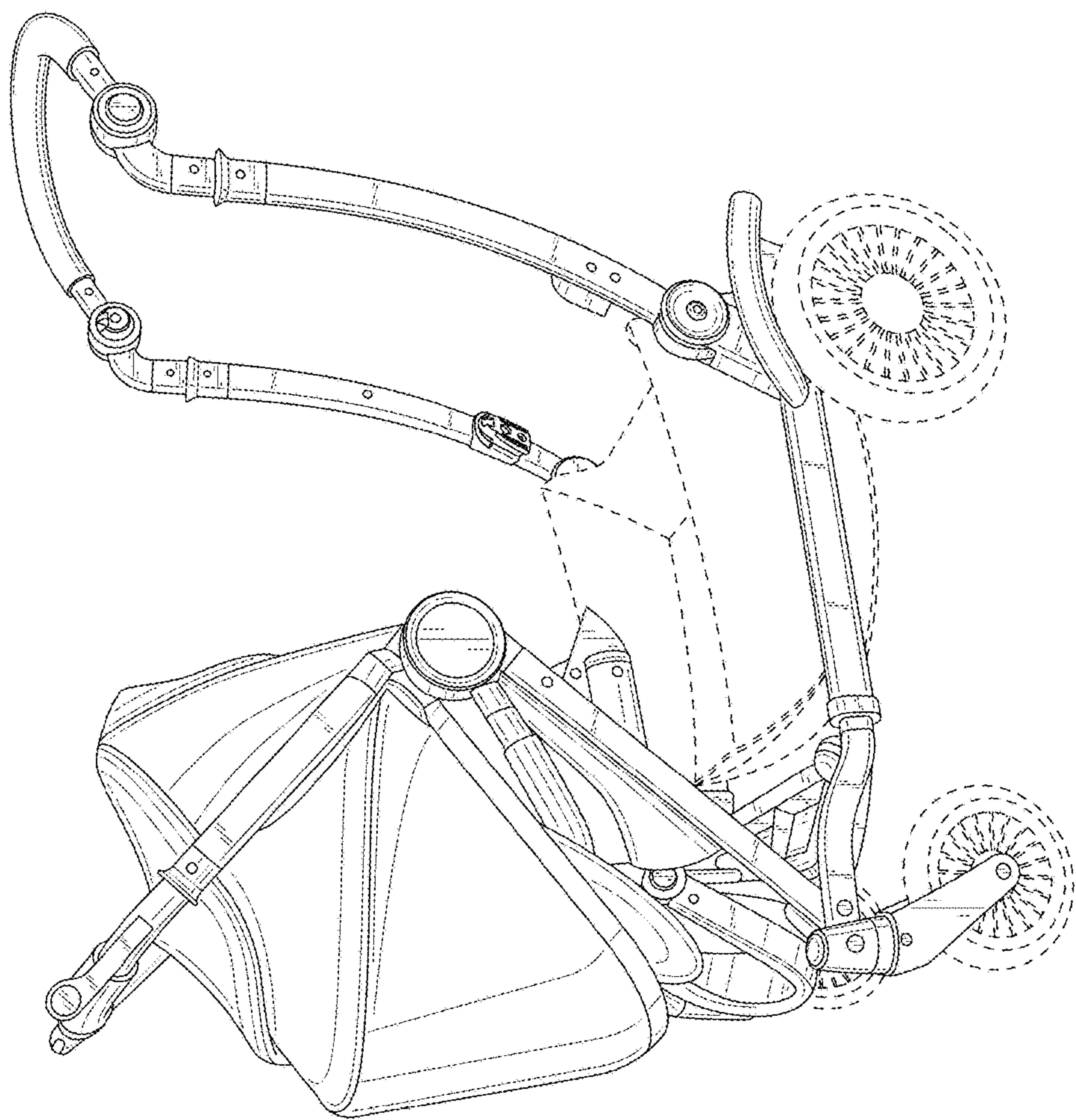

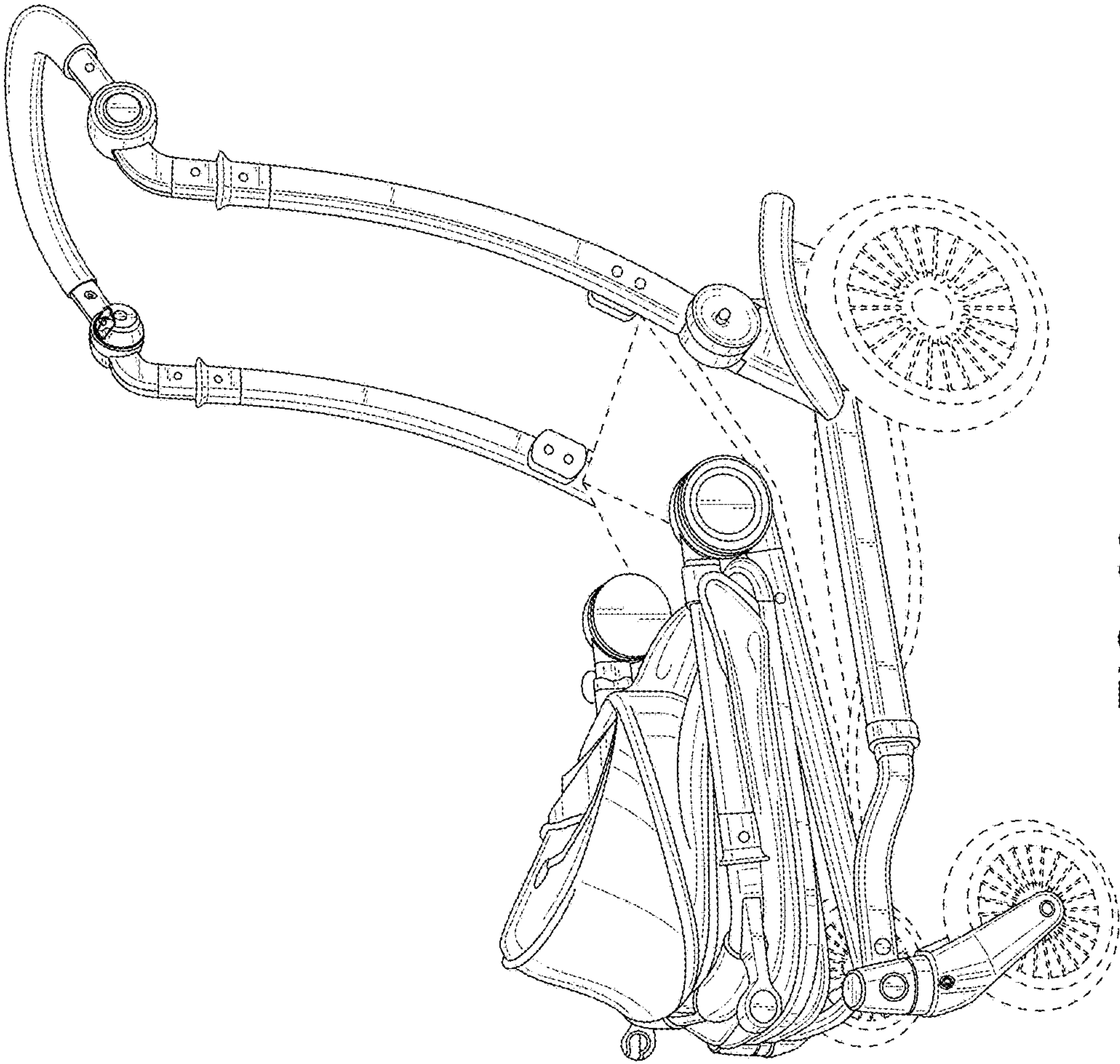


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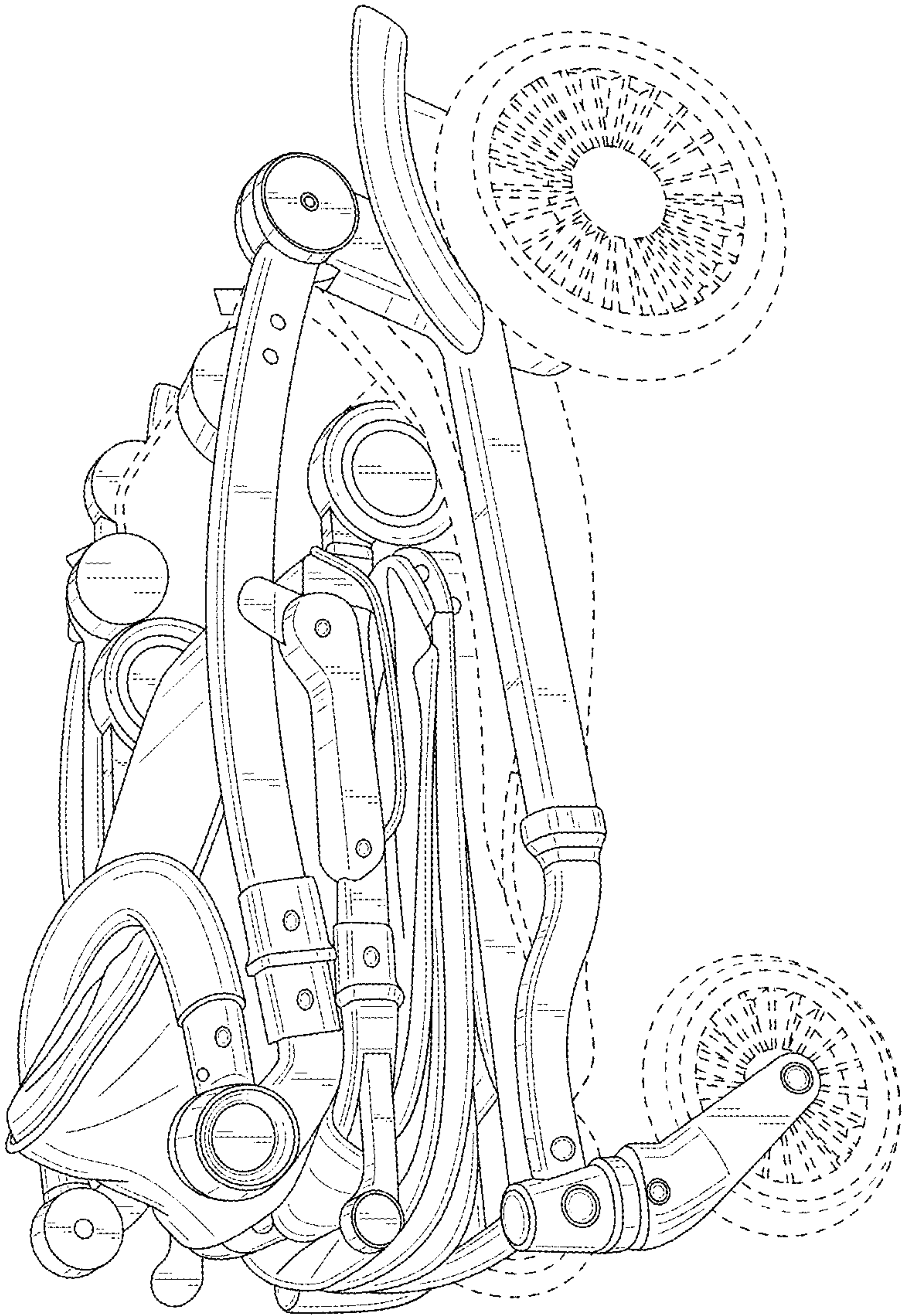

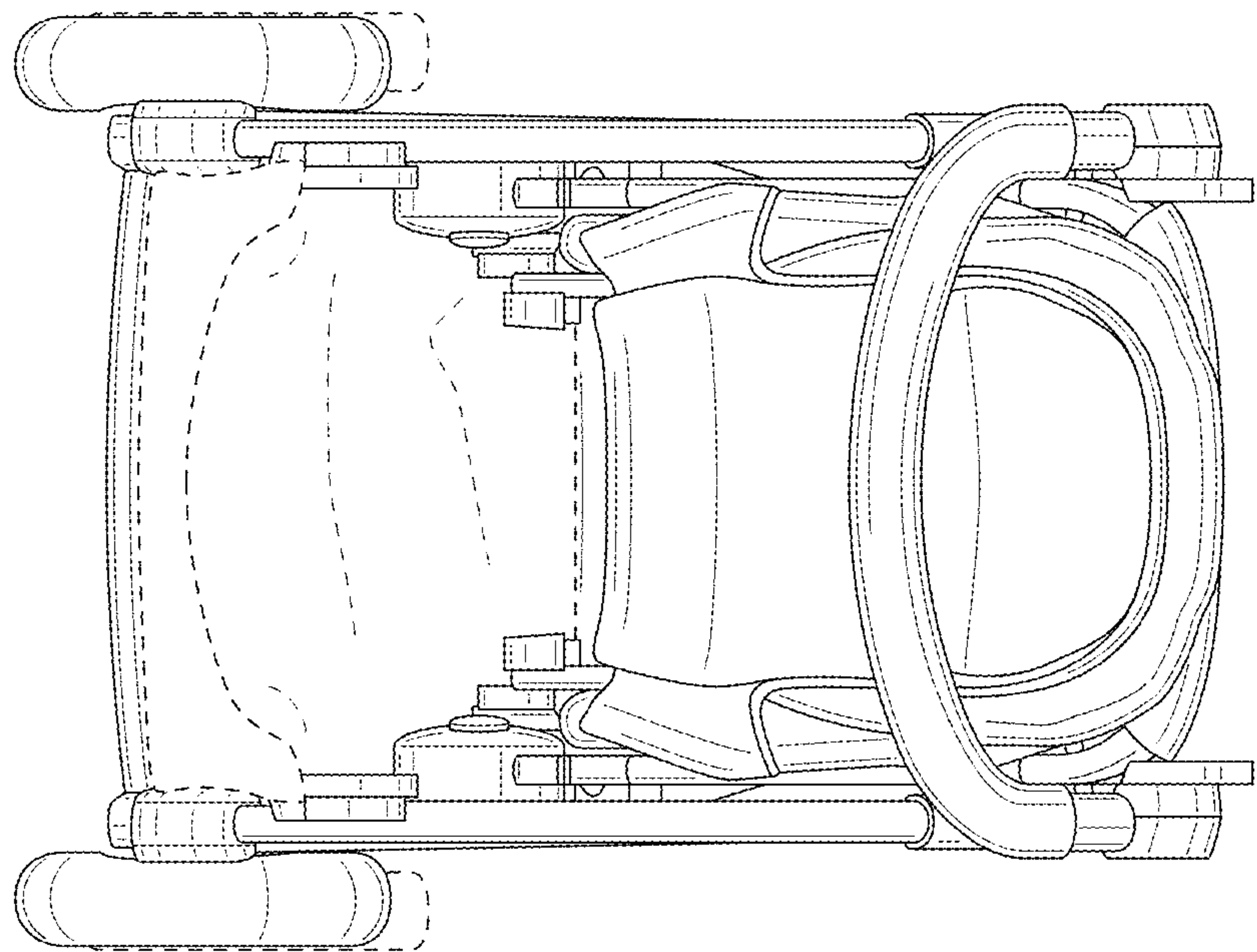


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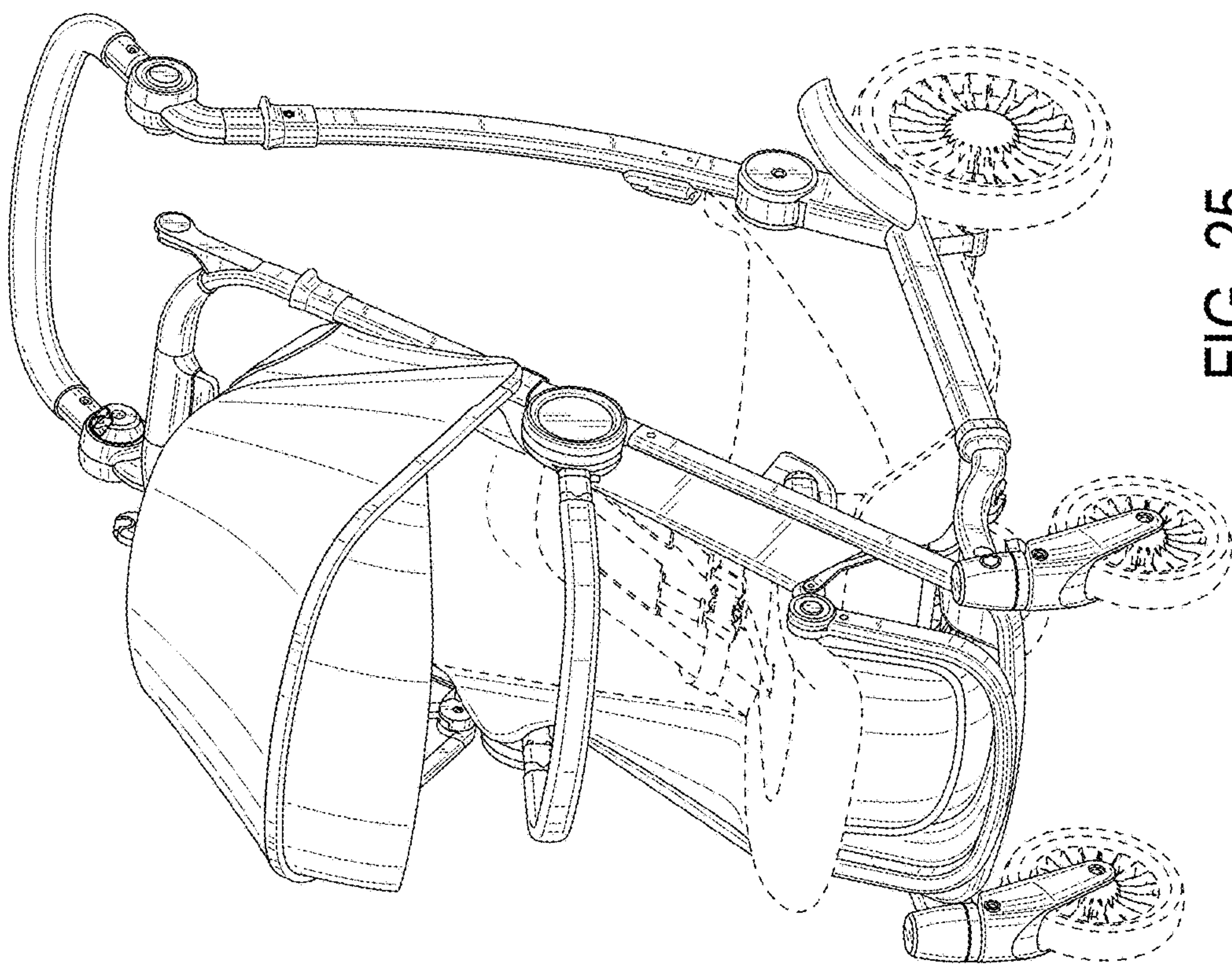

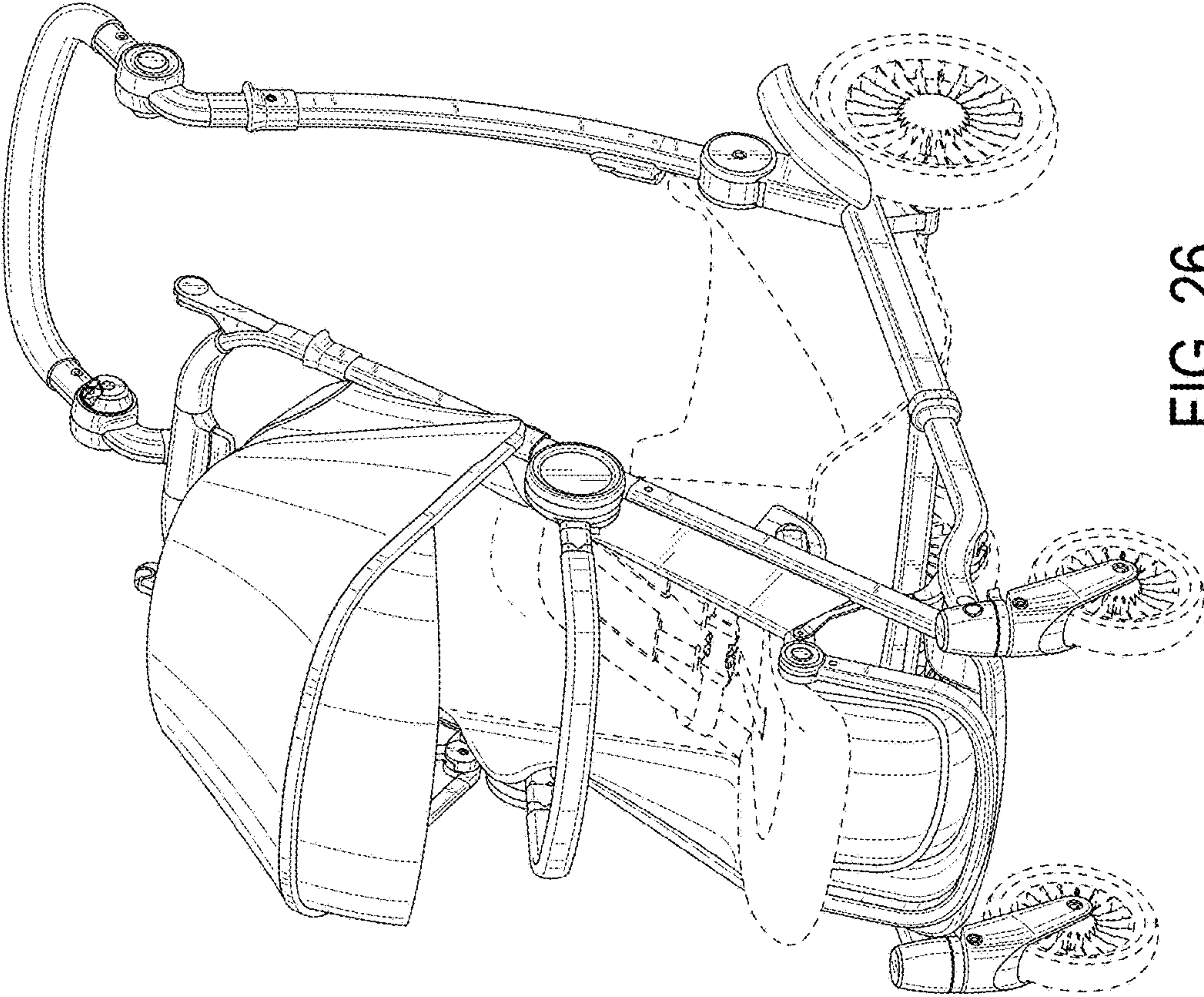


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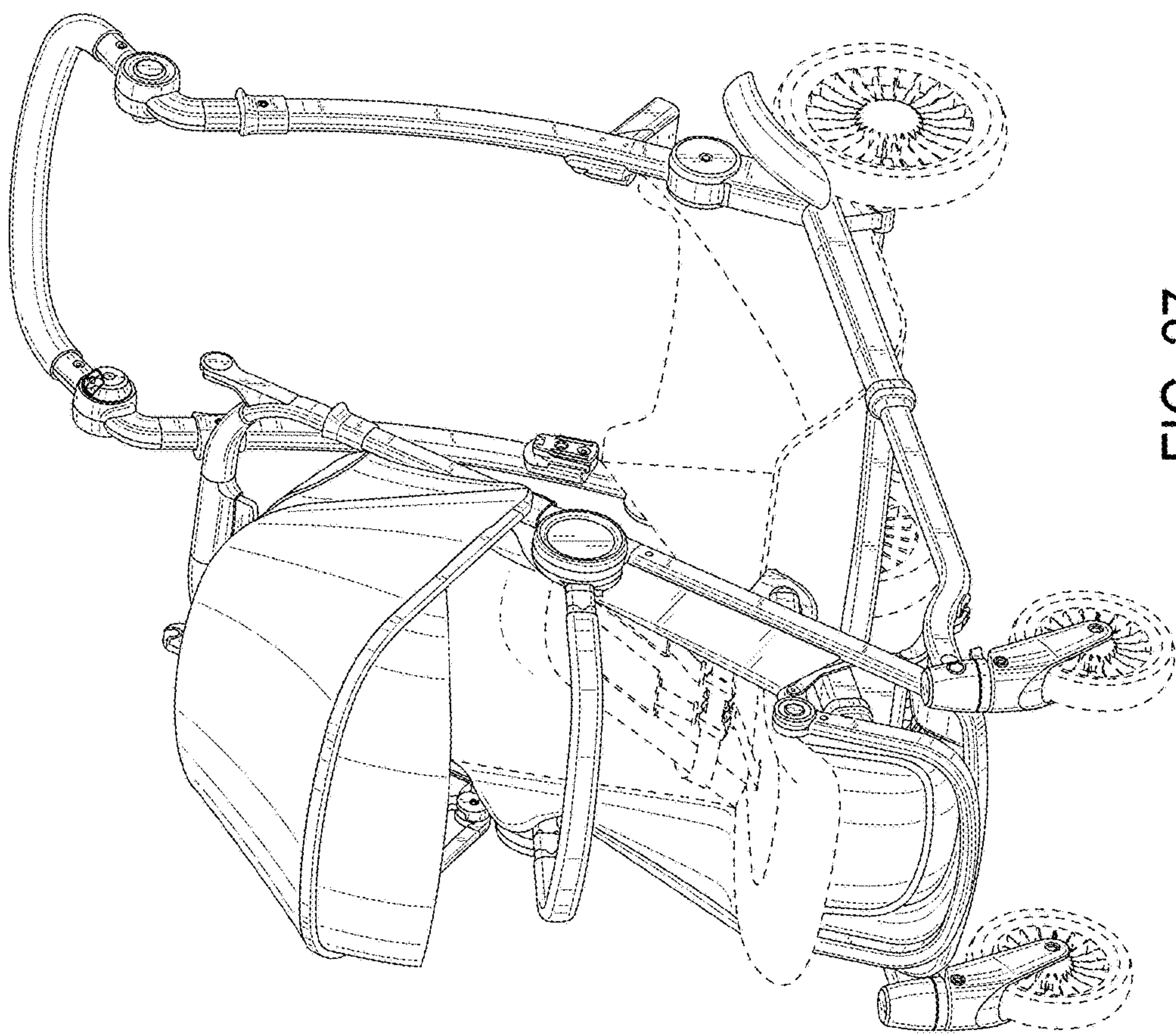

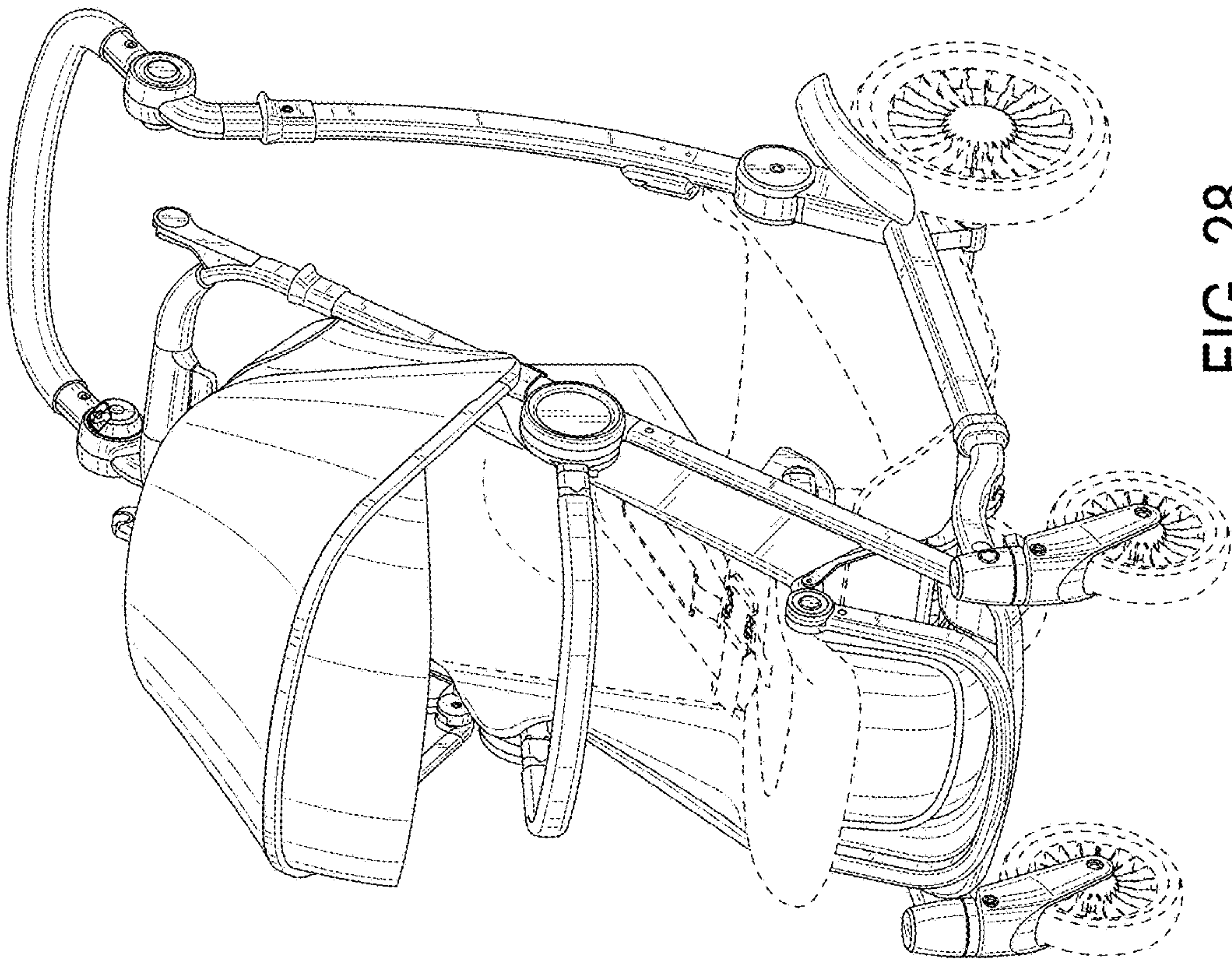

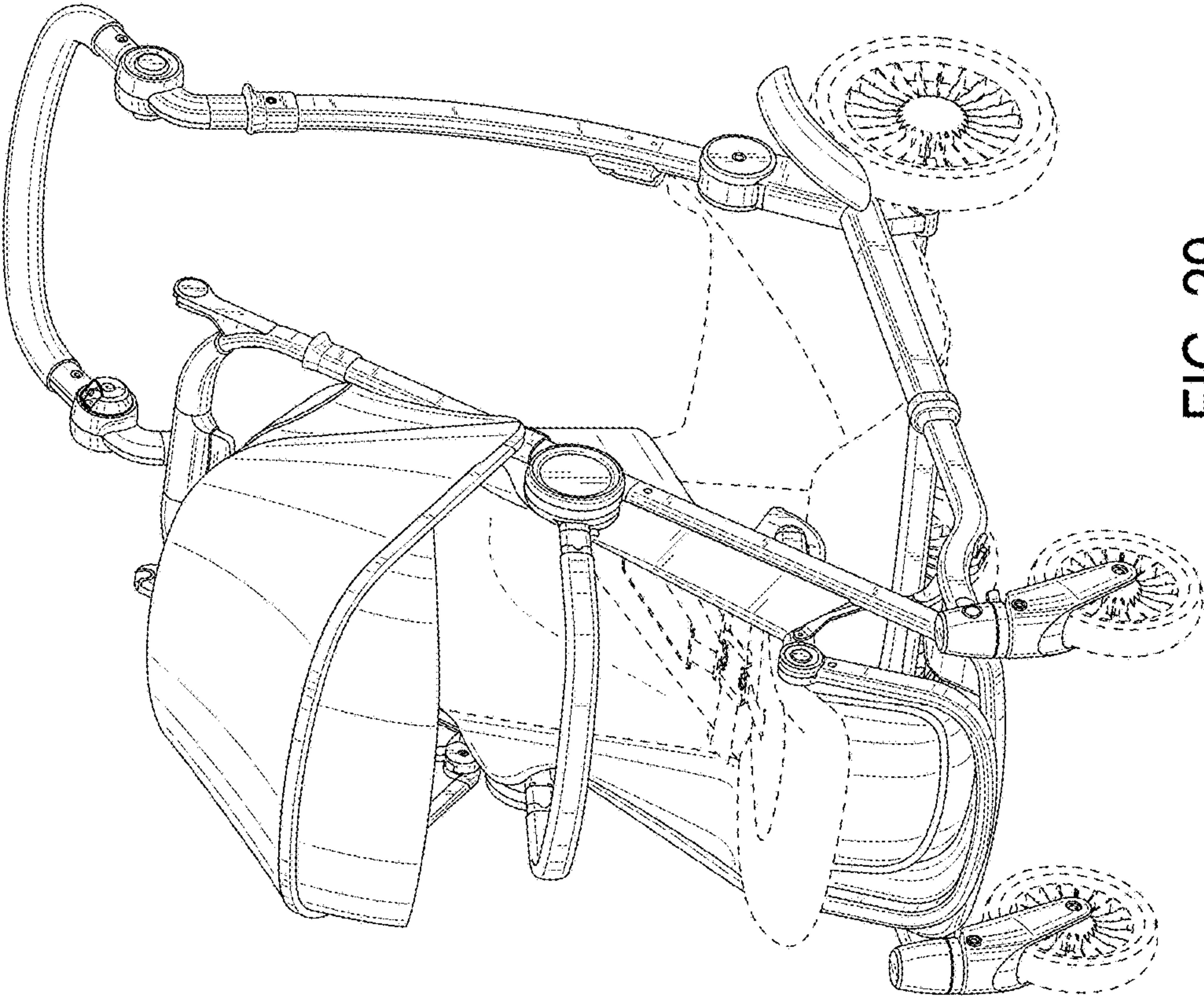

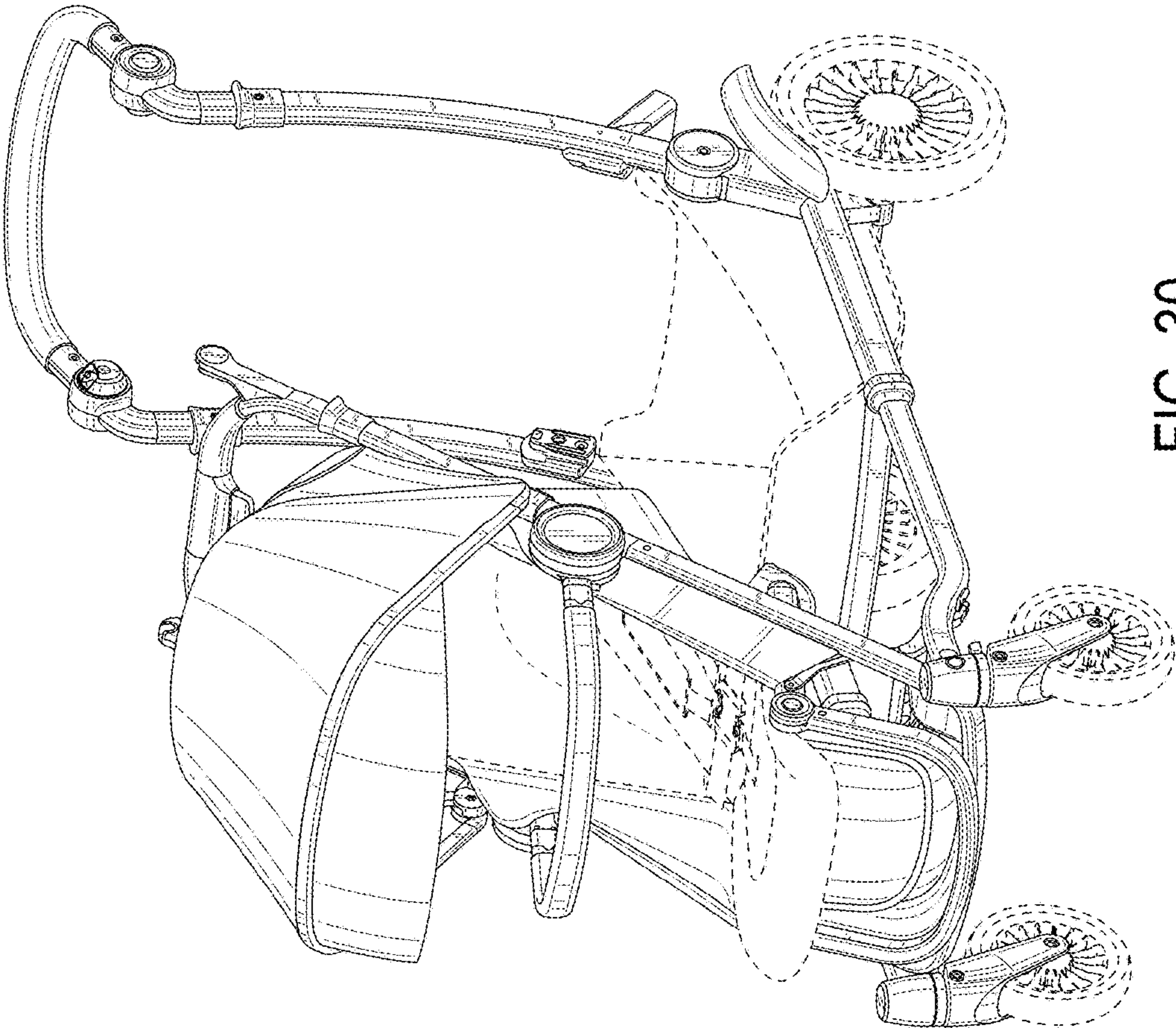
