The ornamental design for a snack food product, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 11 is a left side view of the second embodiment;

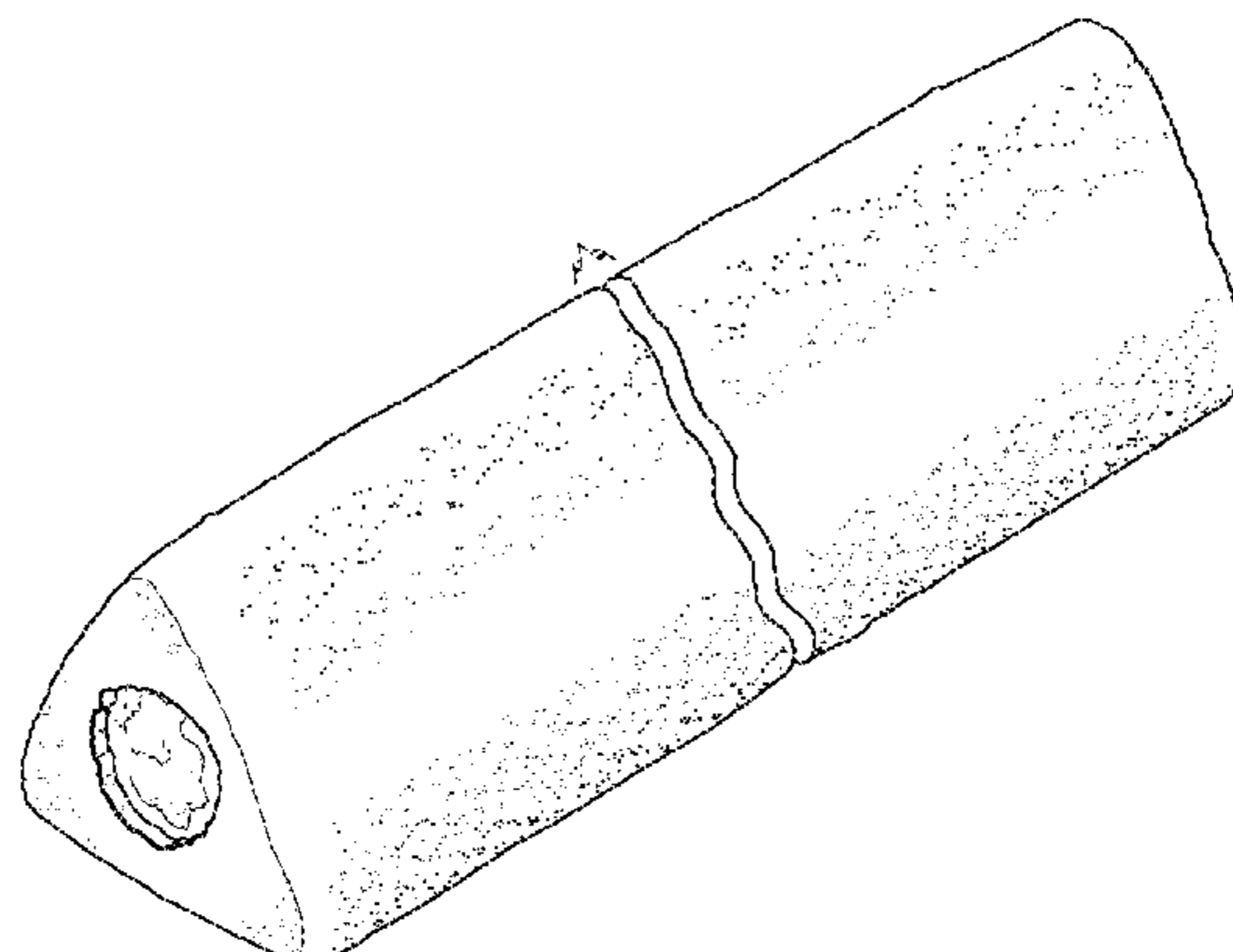
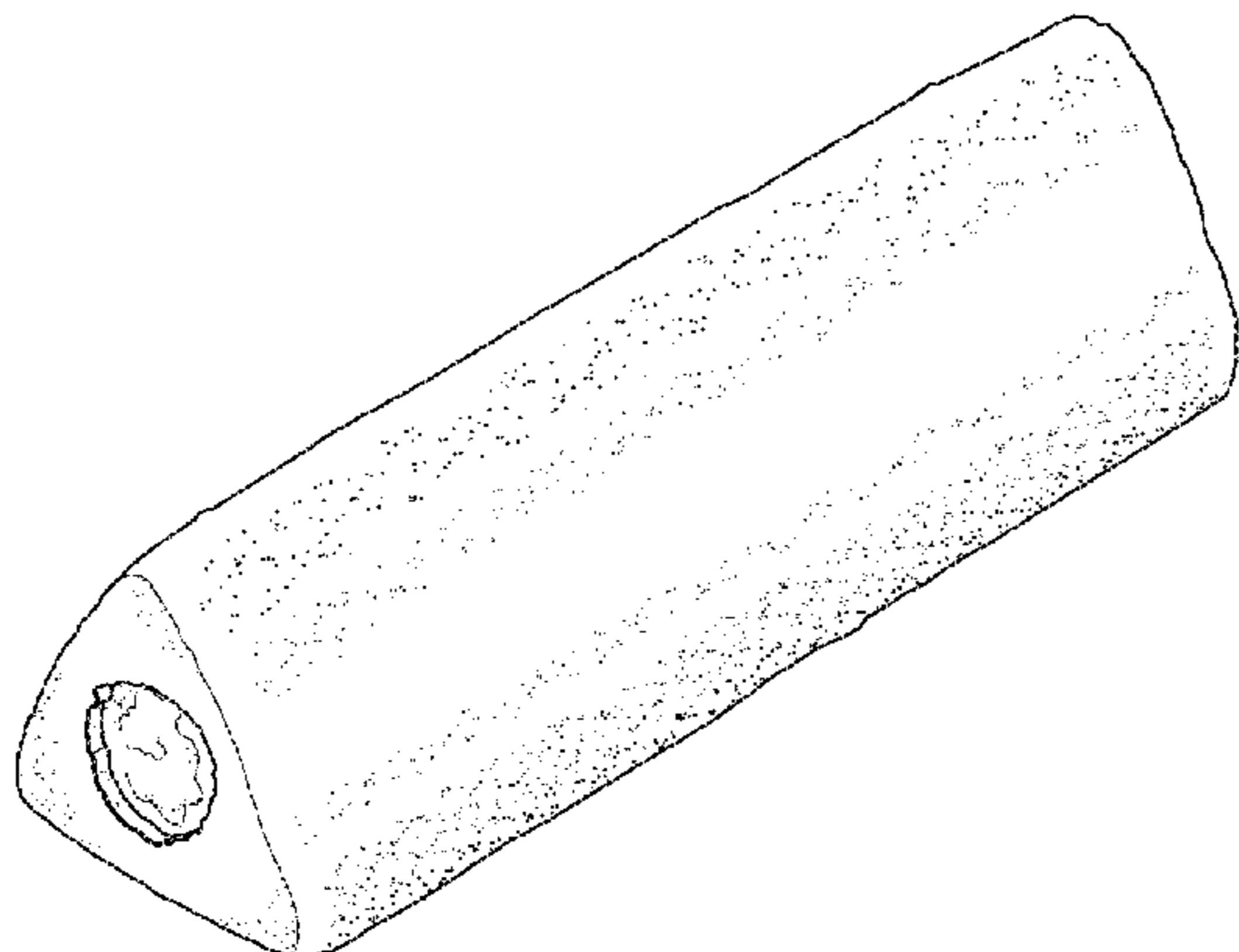
FIG. 12 is a right side view of the second embodiment;

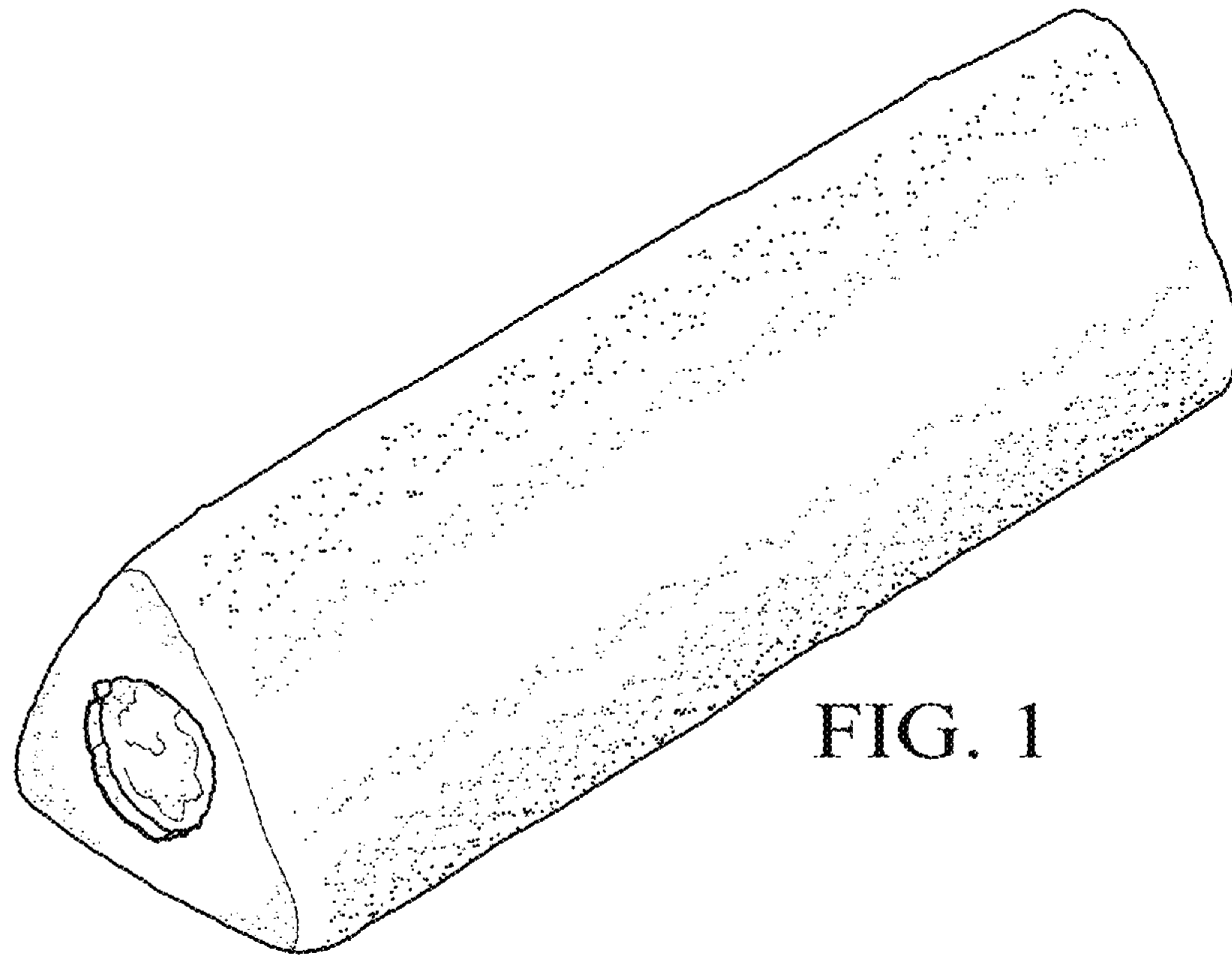

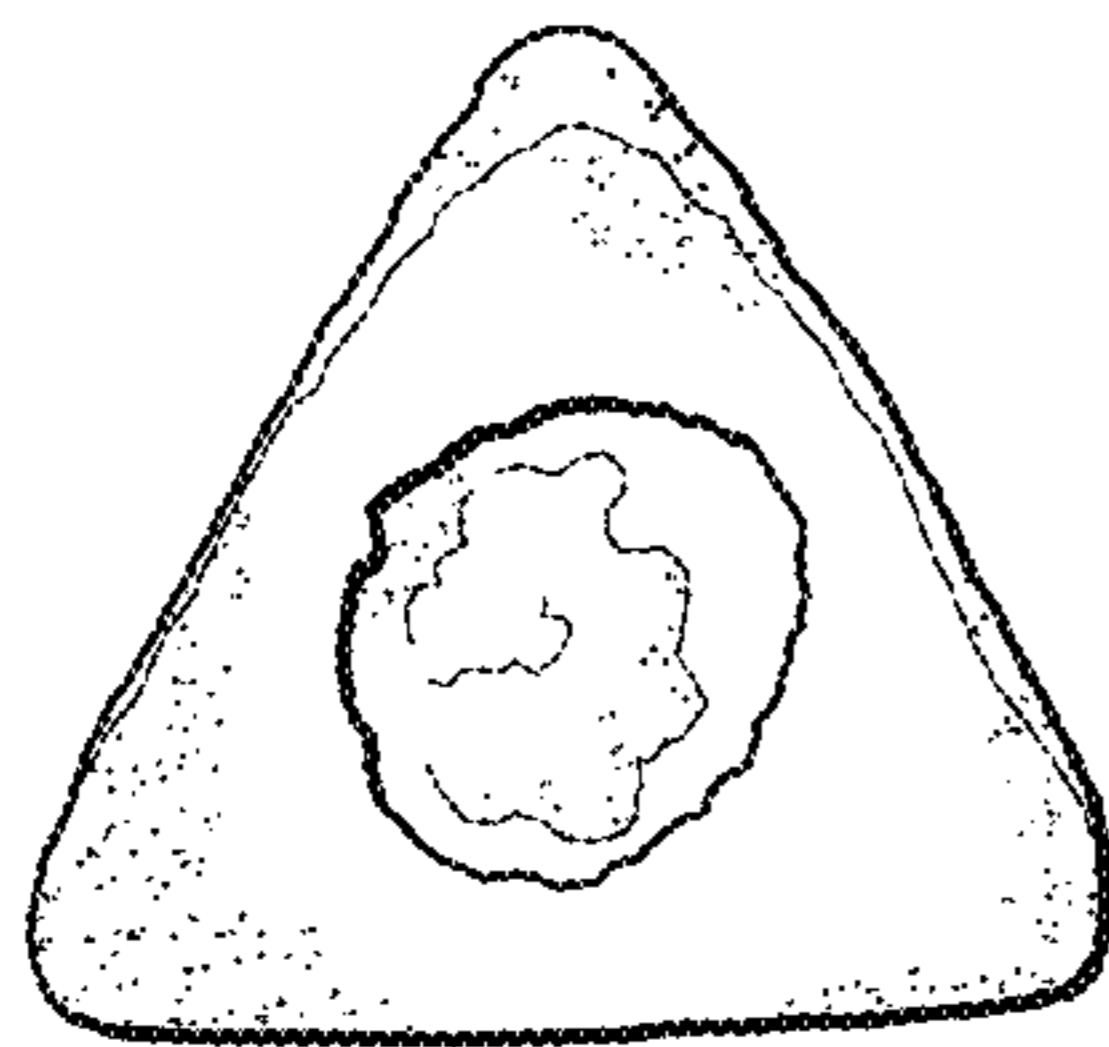

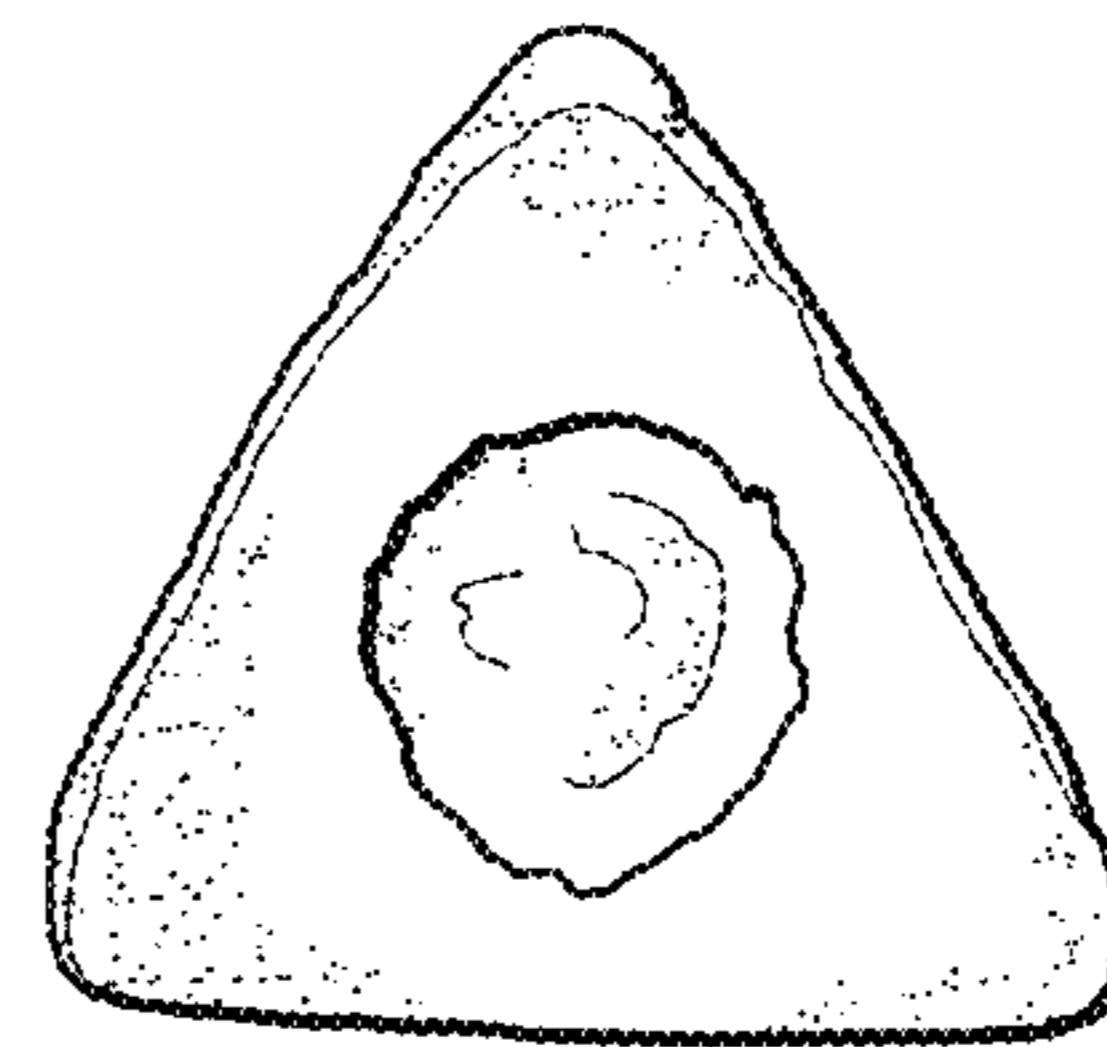

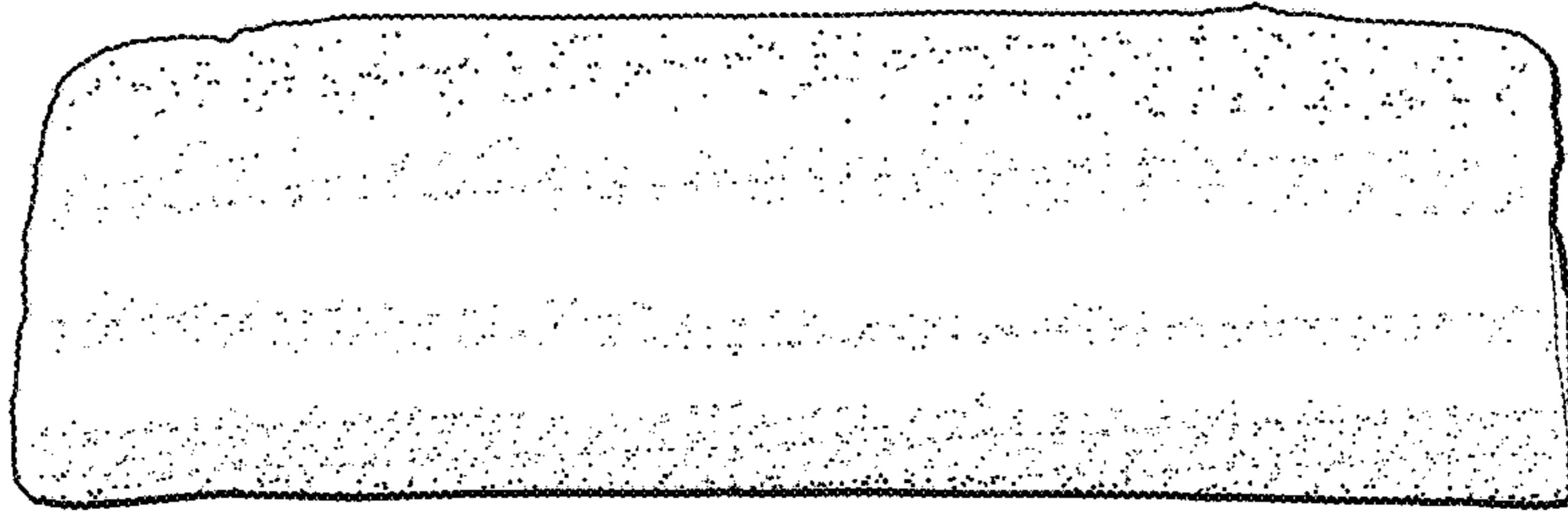

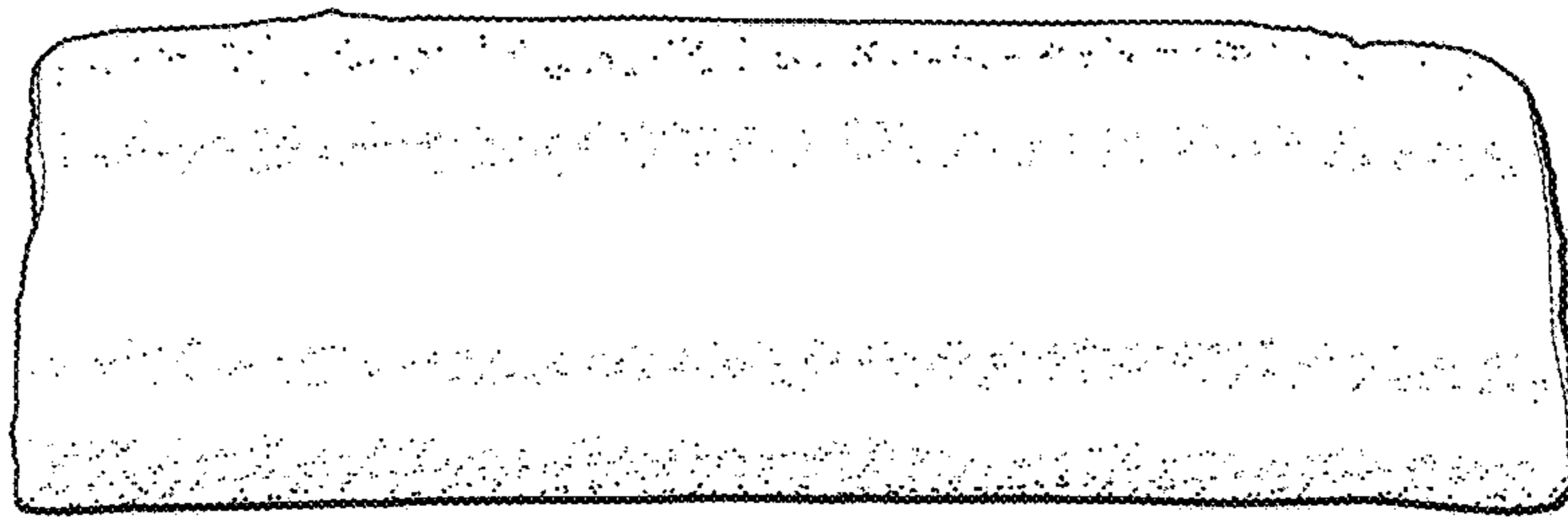

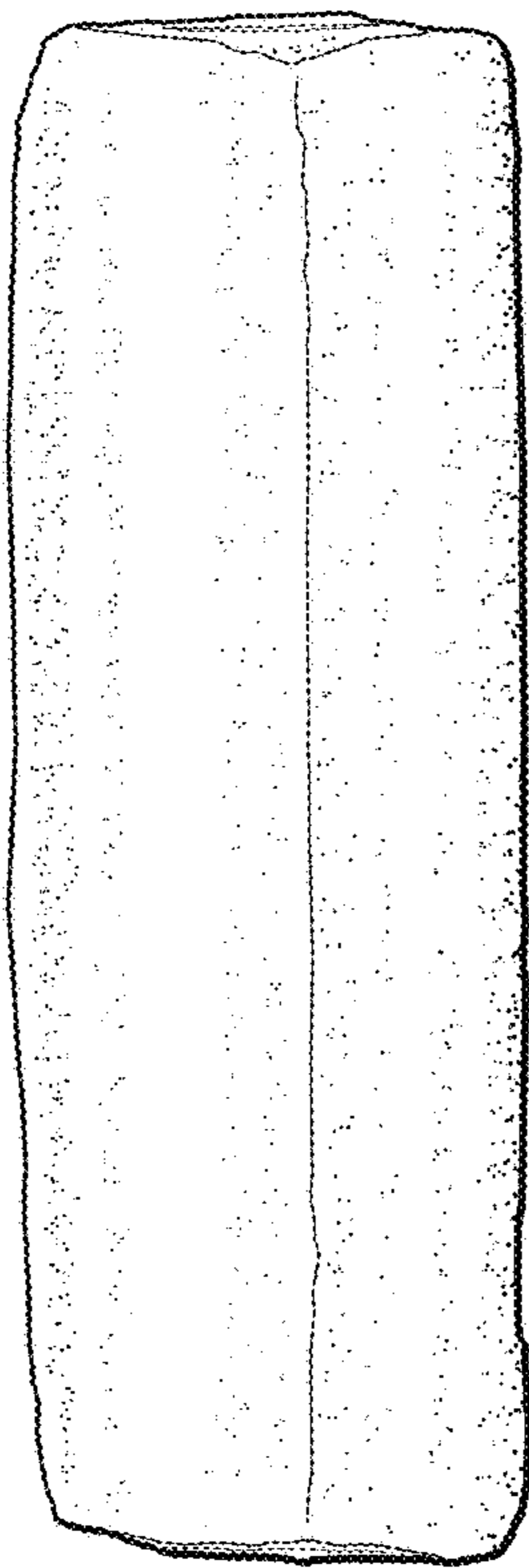

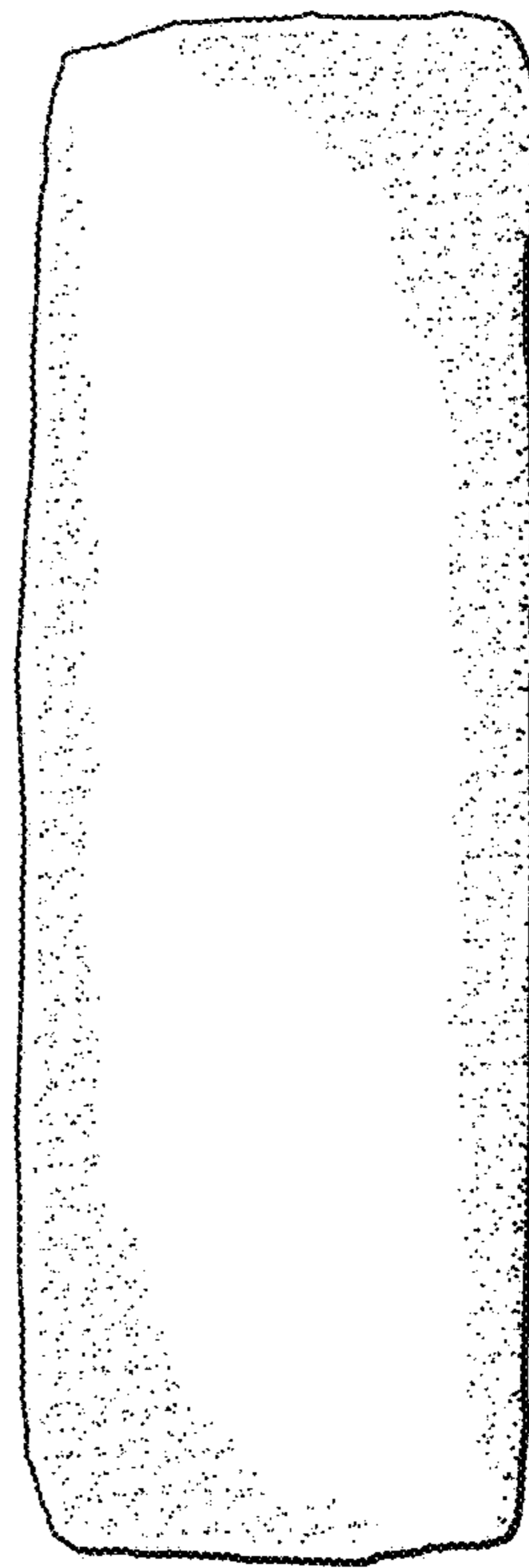

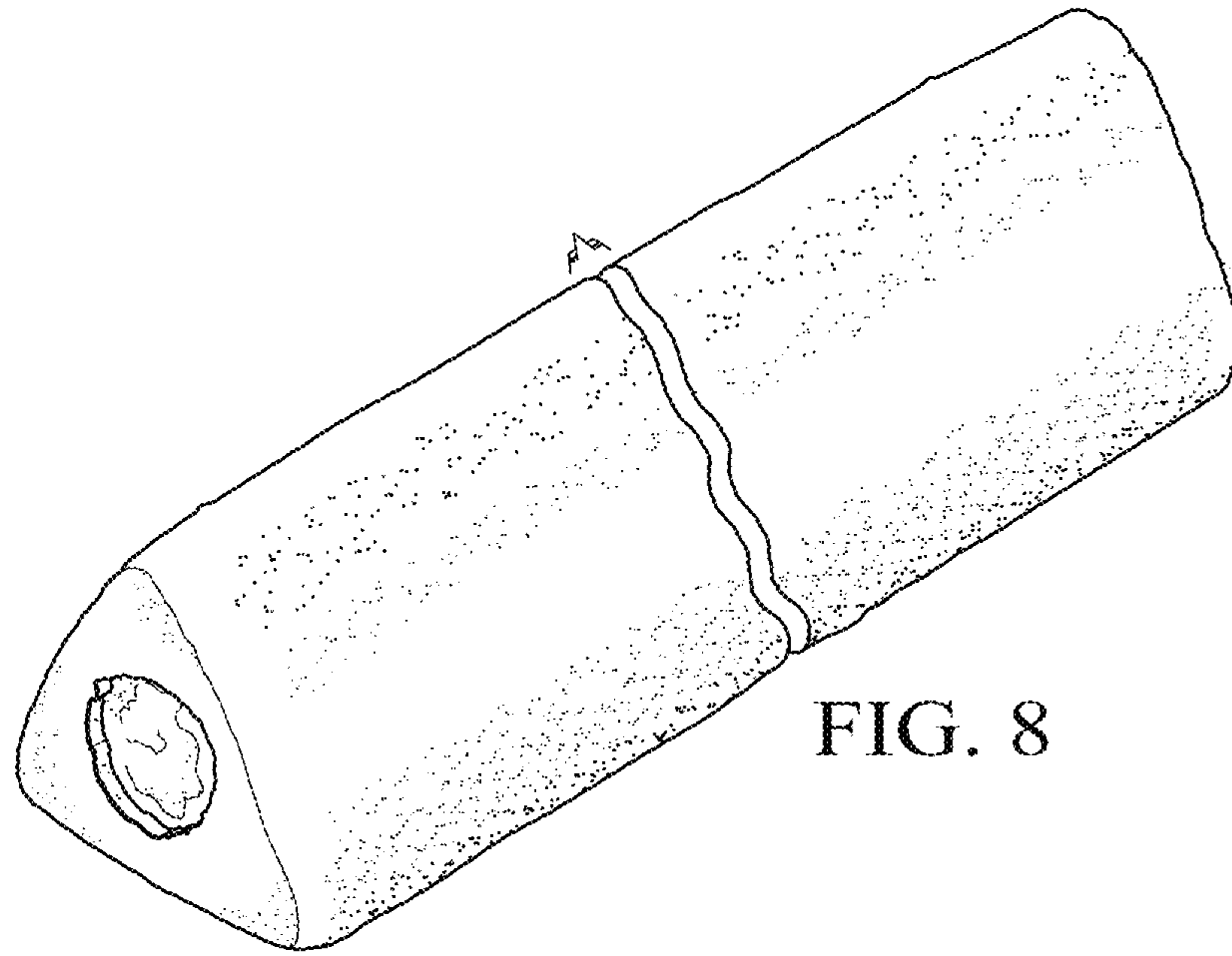

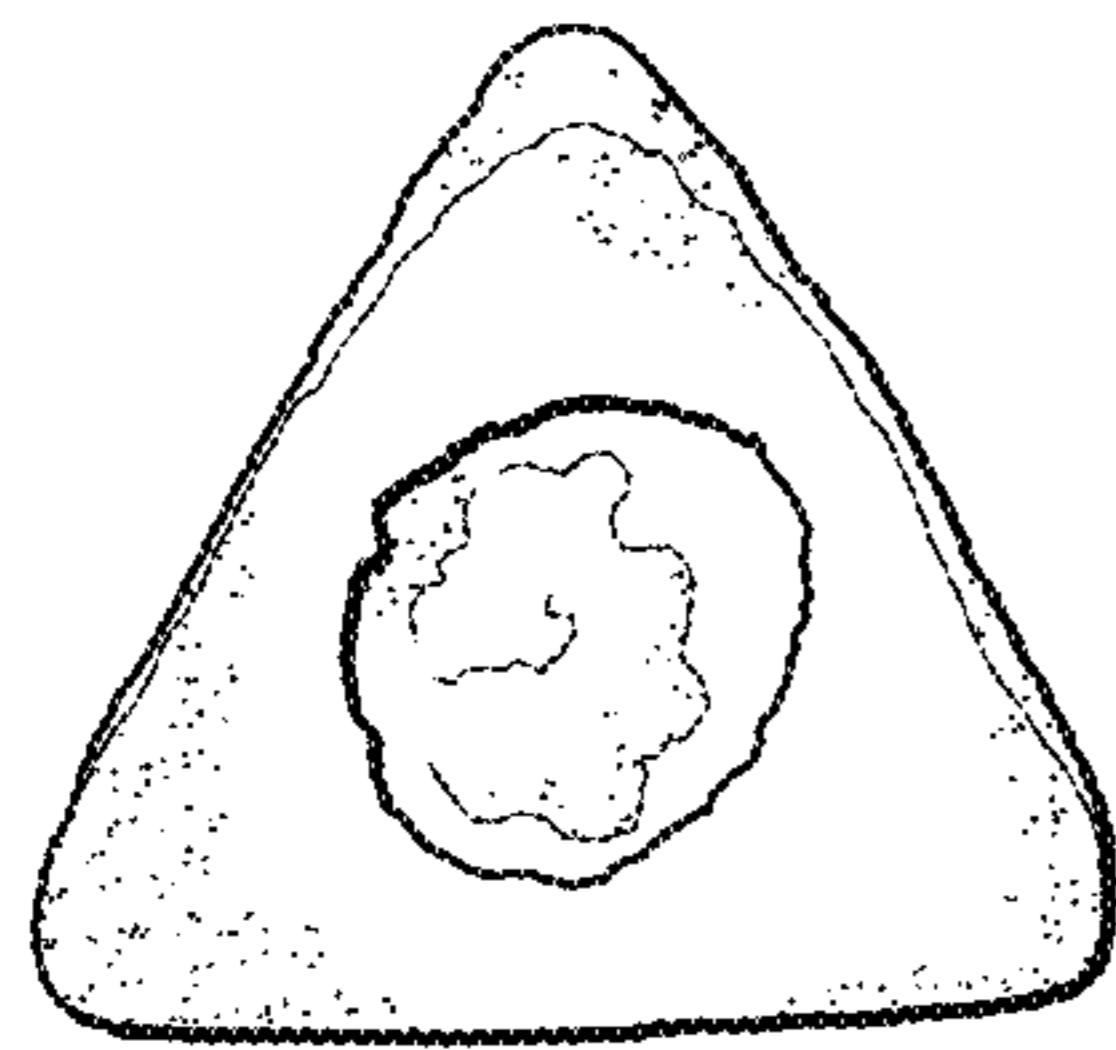

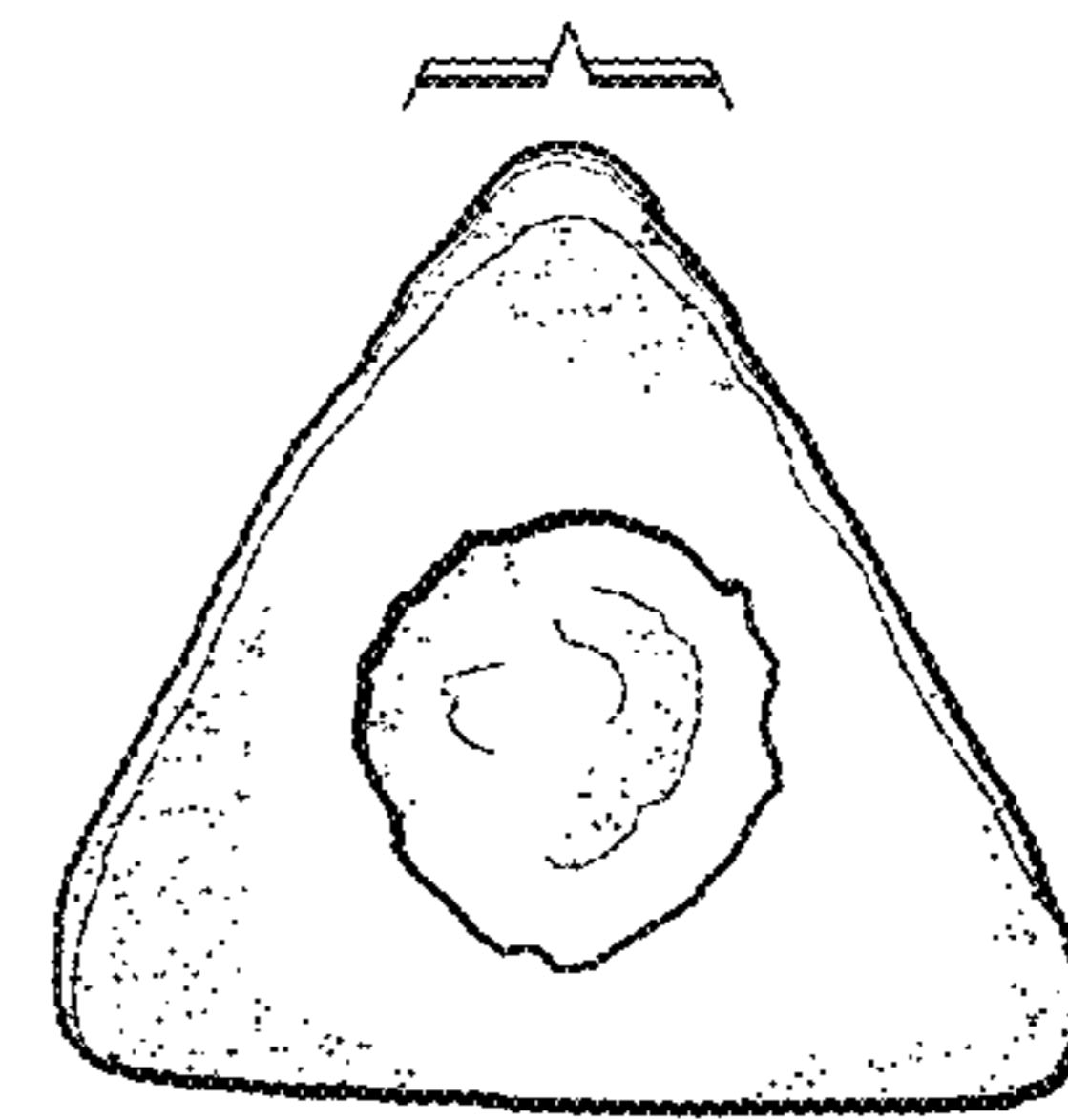

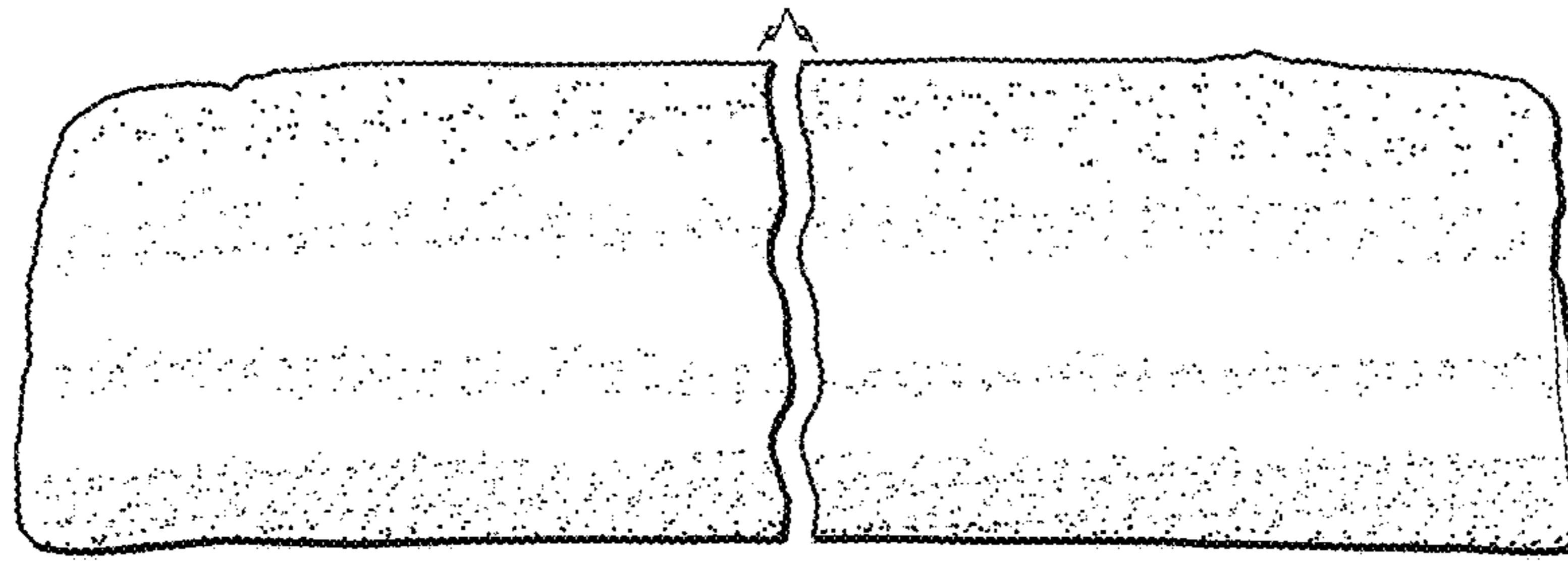

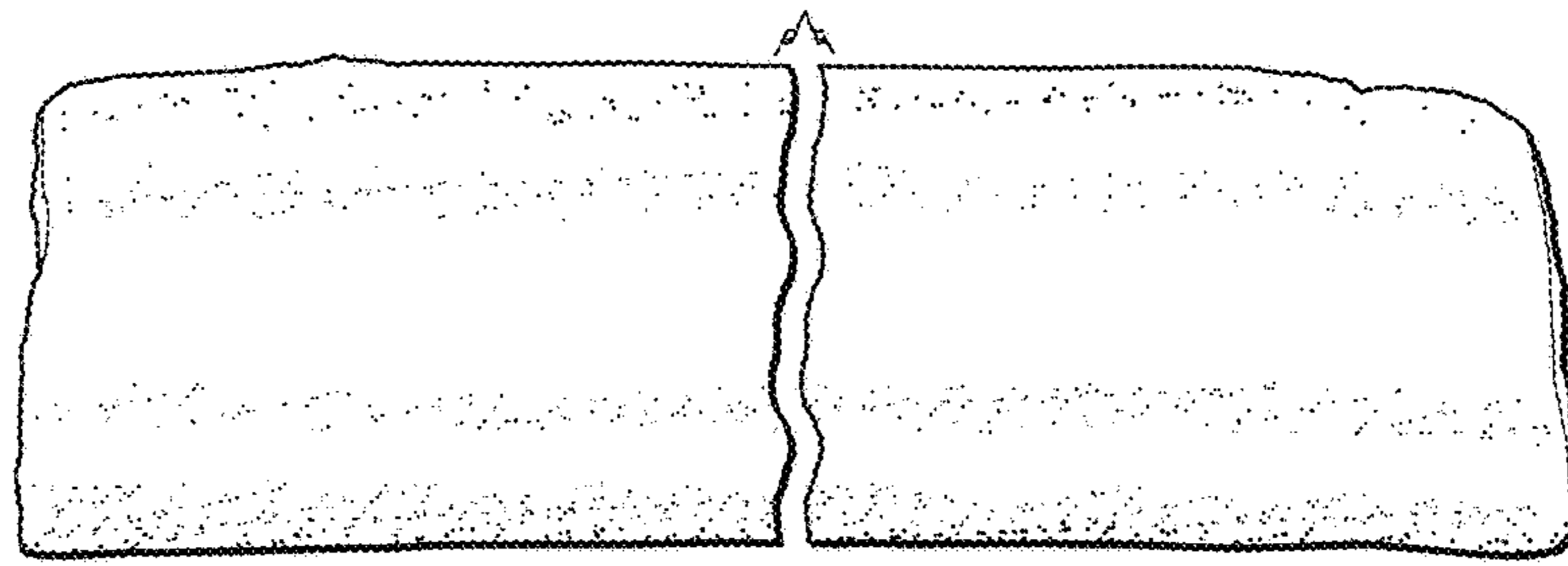

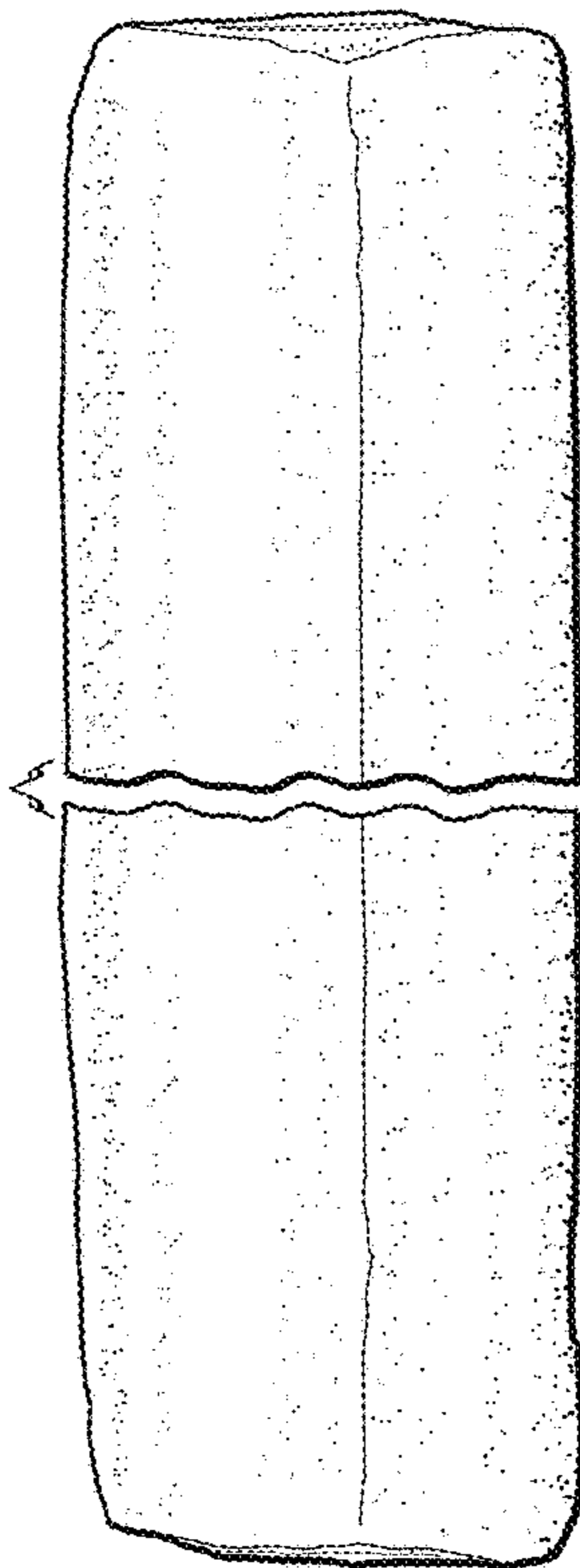

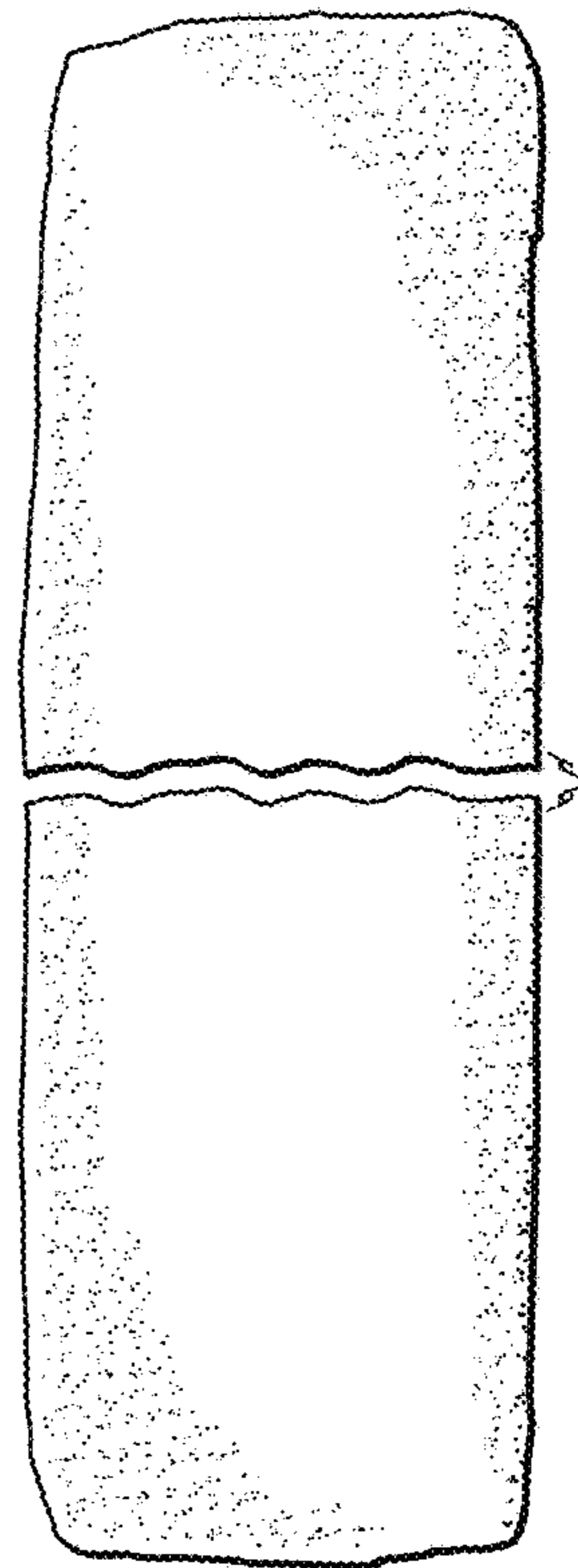
