upper, showing my new design;

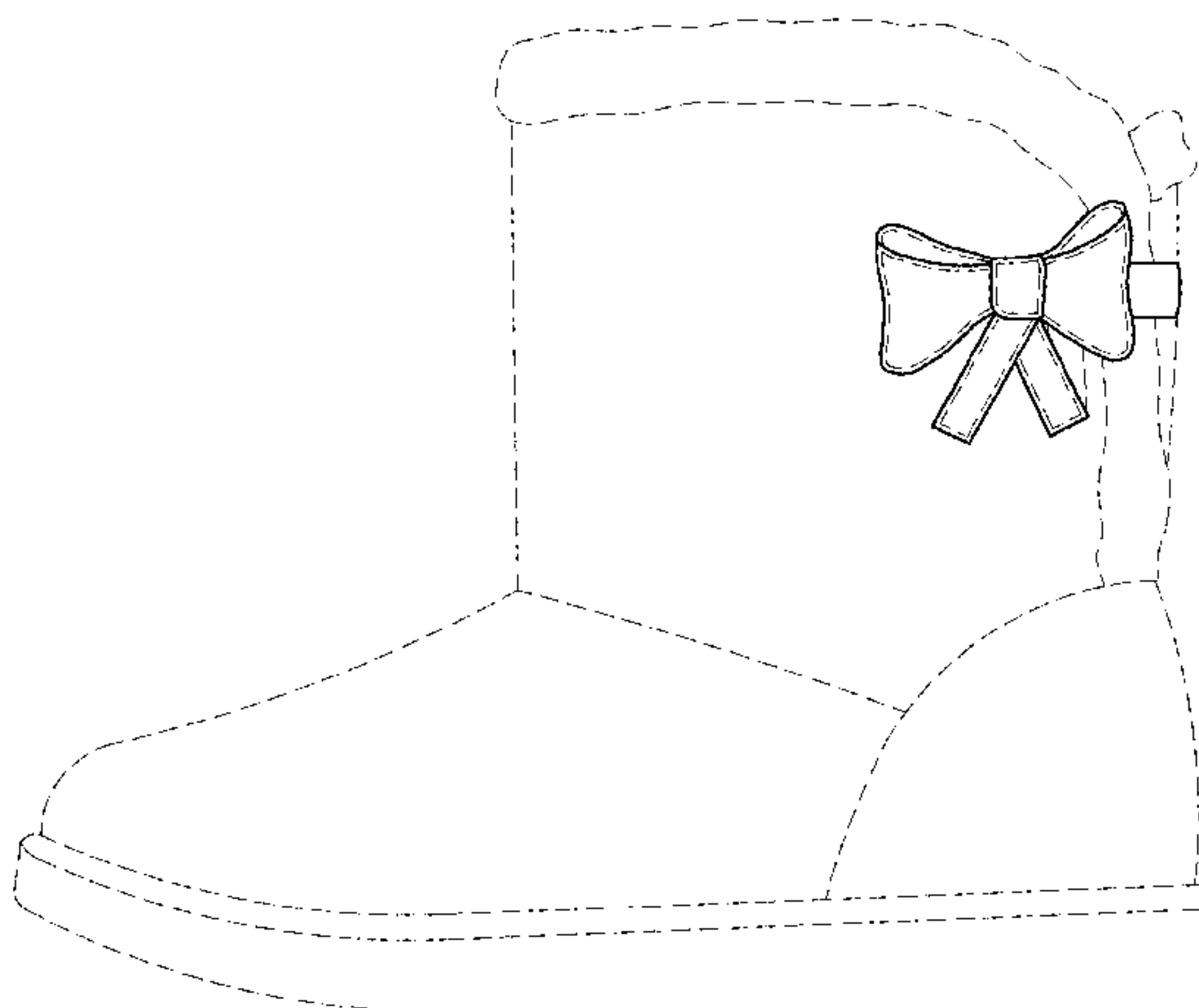
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

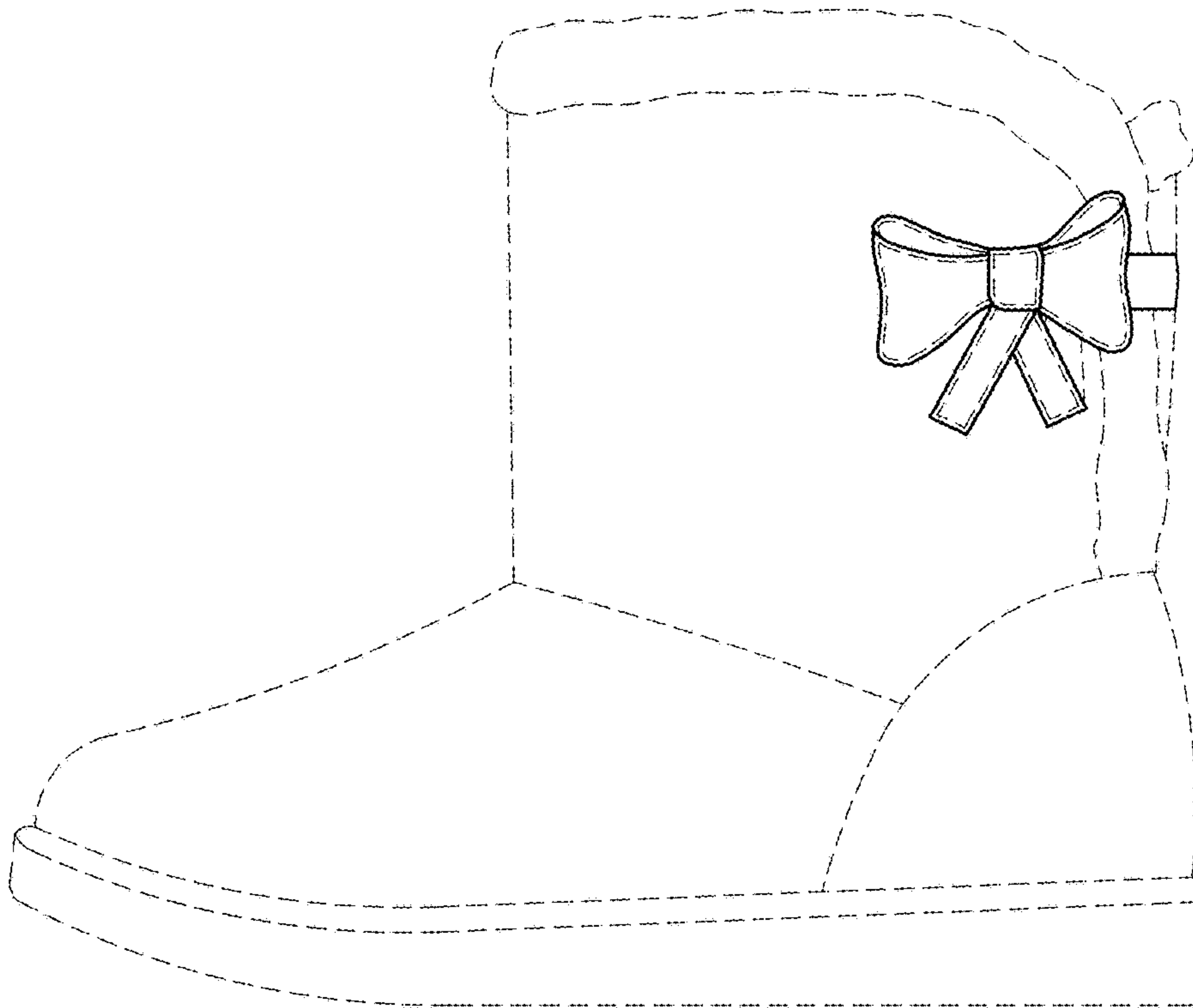

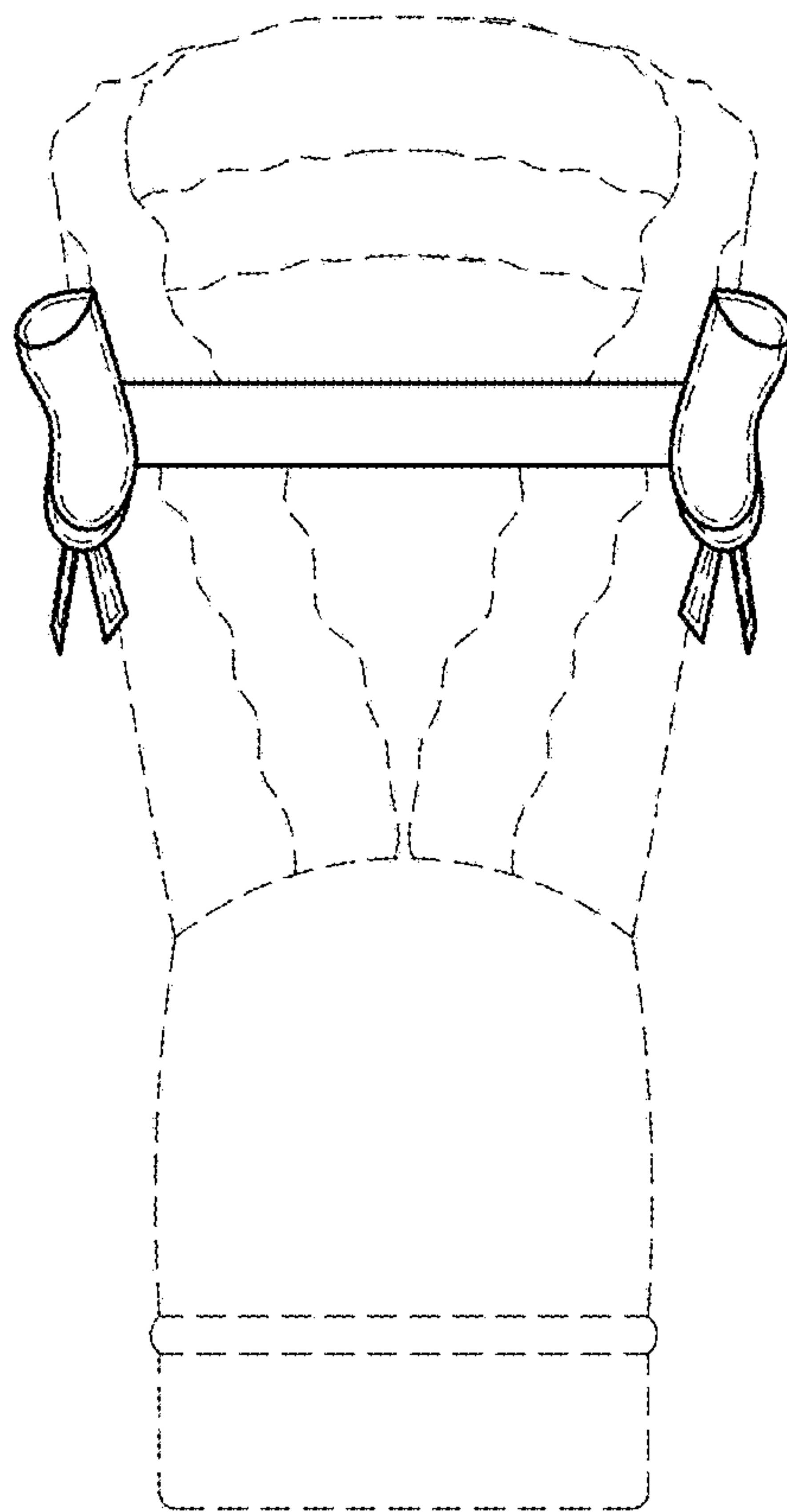
