(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf bag base, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first perspective view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom planar view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 3 is a first side view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 4 is a second side view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 5 is a front view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 6 is a rear view of the golf bag base of this invention;
 FIG. 7 is a side view of the golf bag base of this invention showing the base in an alternative position;
 FIG. 8 is a close-up view of the region of the golf ball base of this invention as indicated in FIG. 7 with heavy broken lines; and,
 FIG. 9 is a second perspective view of the golf bag base of this invention.

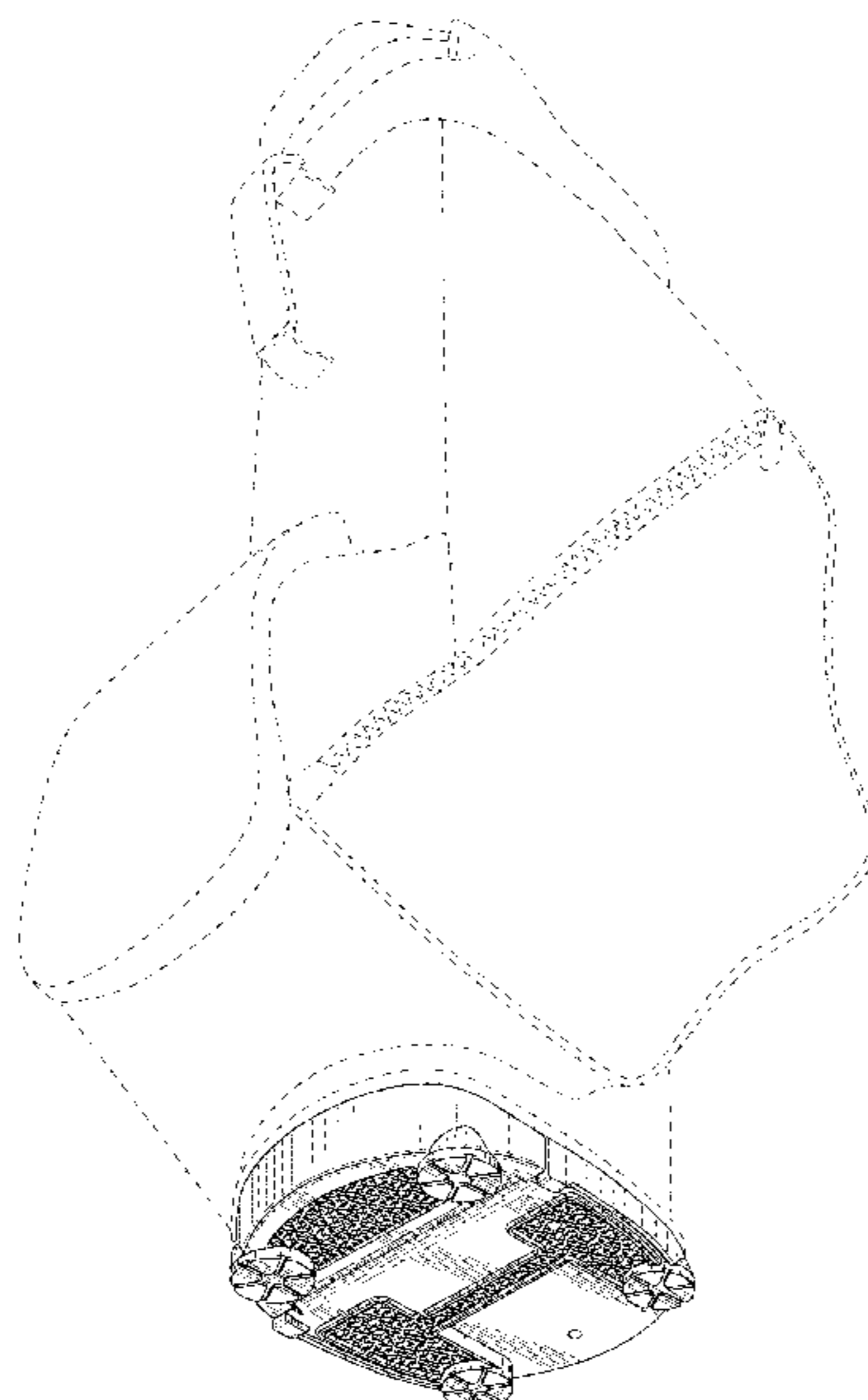

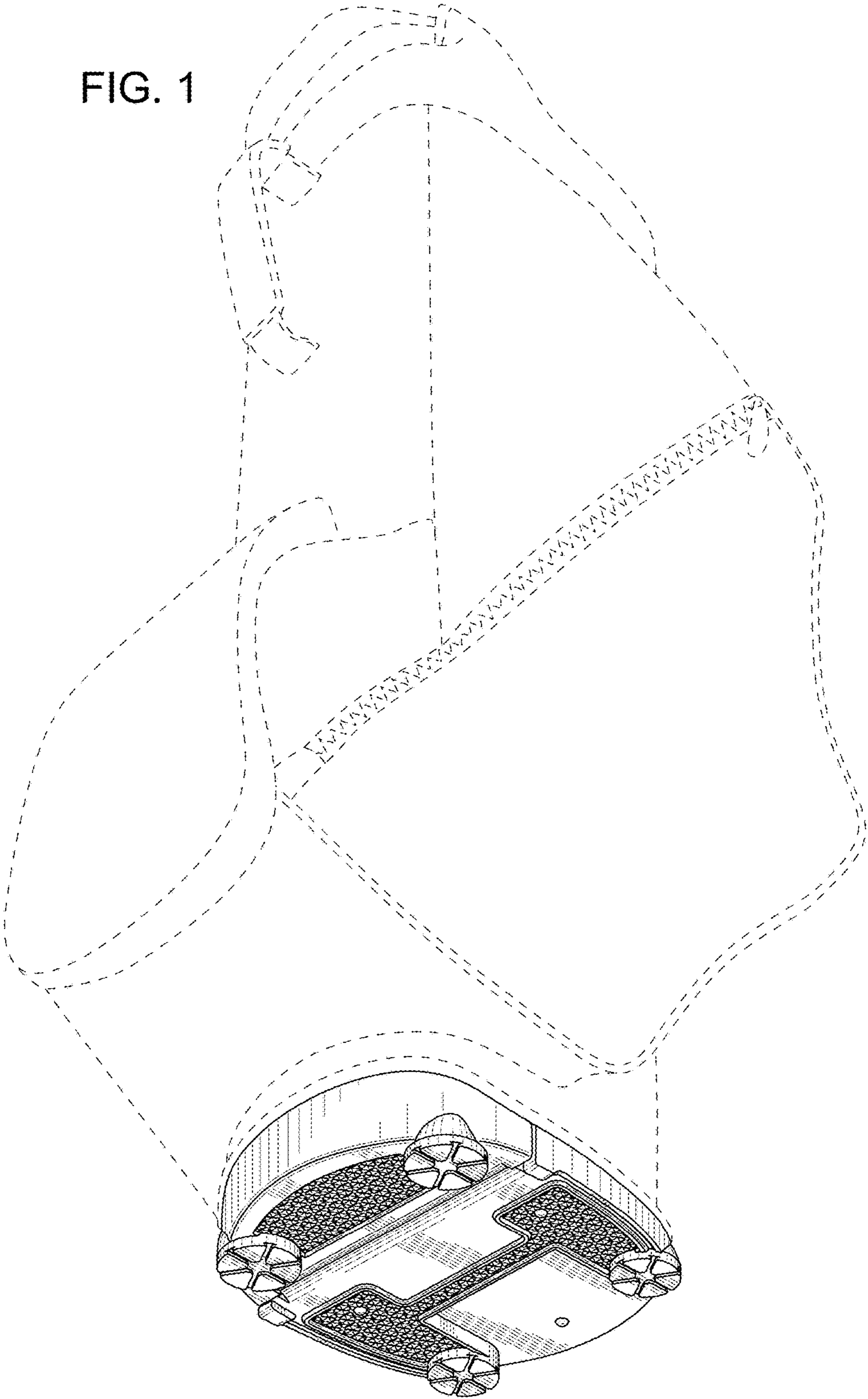

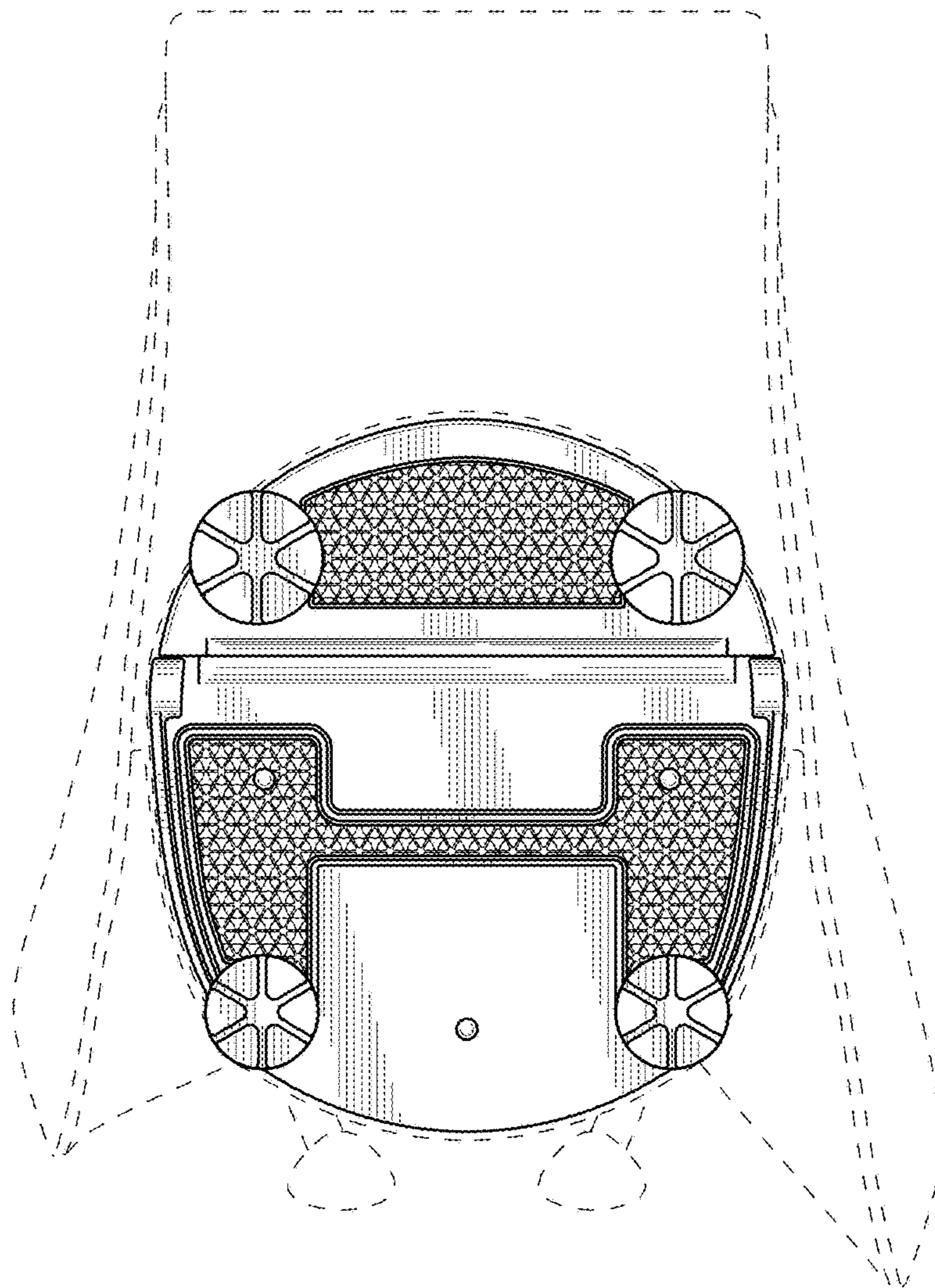

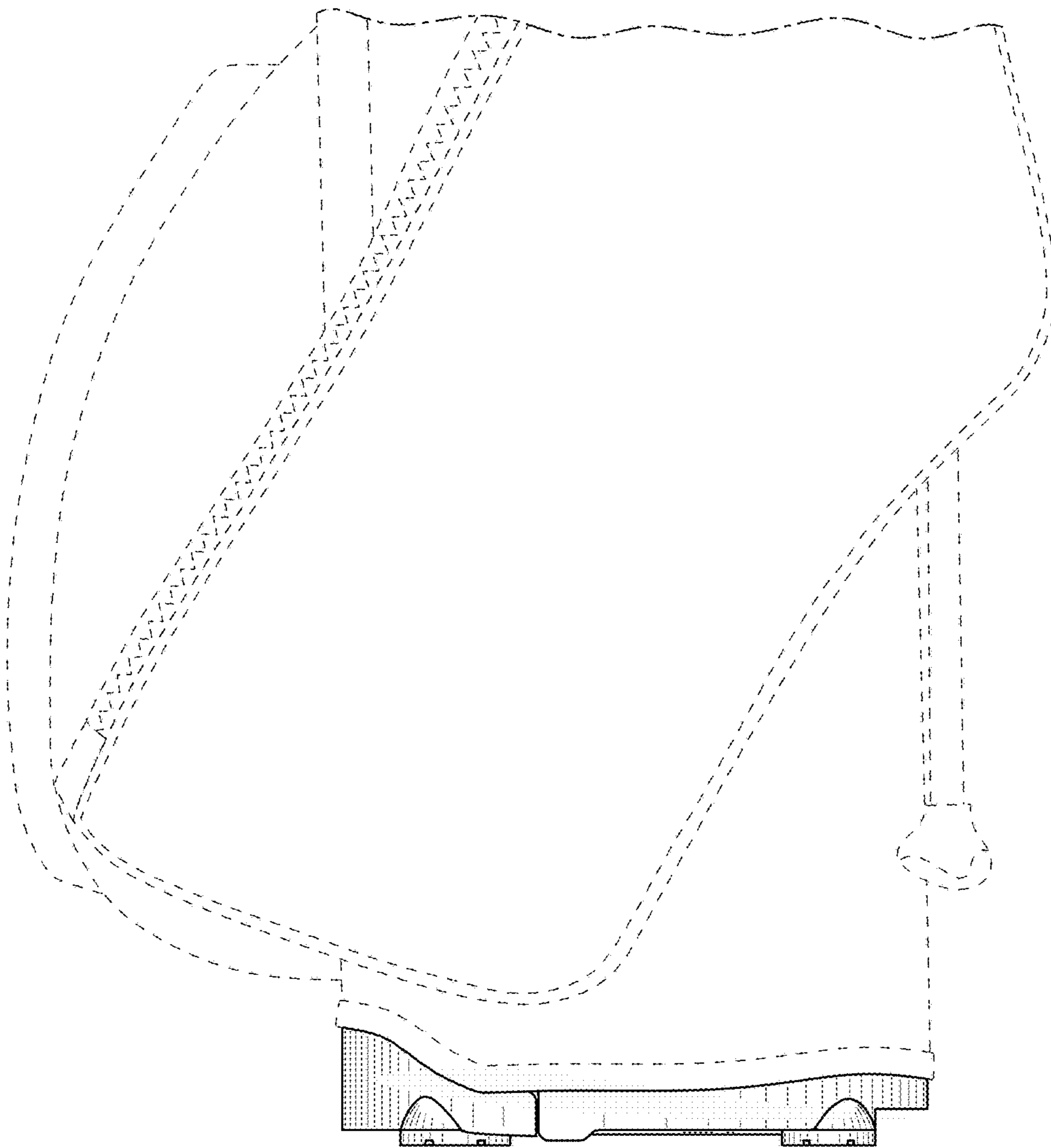

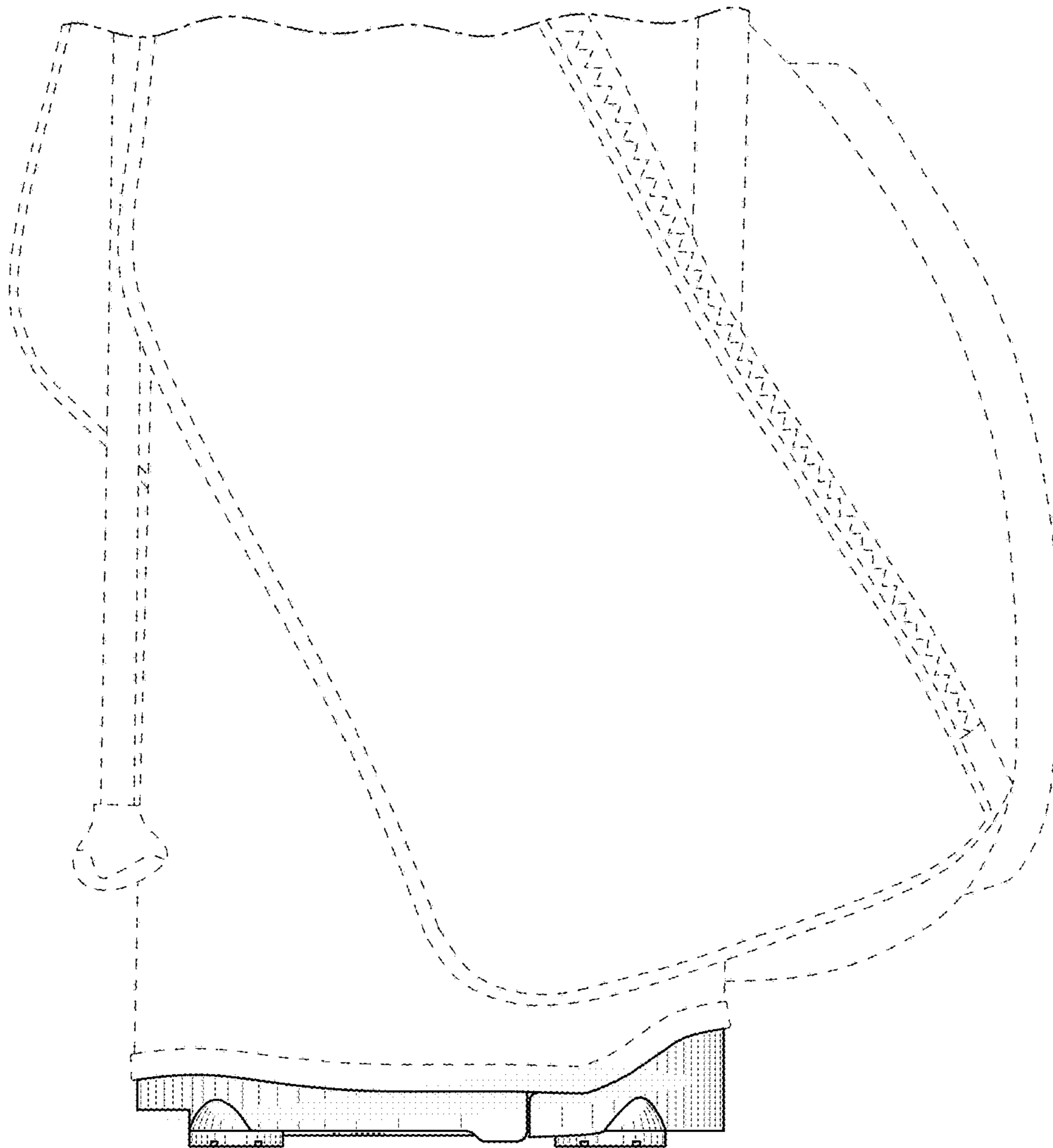

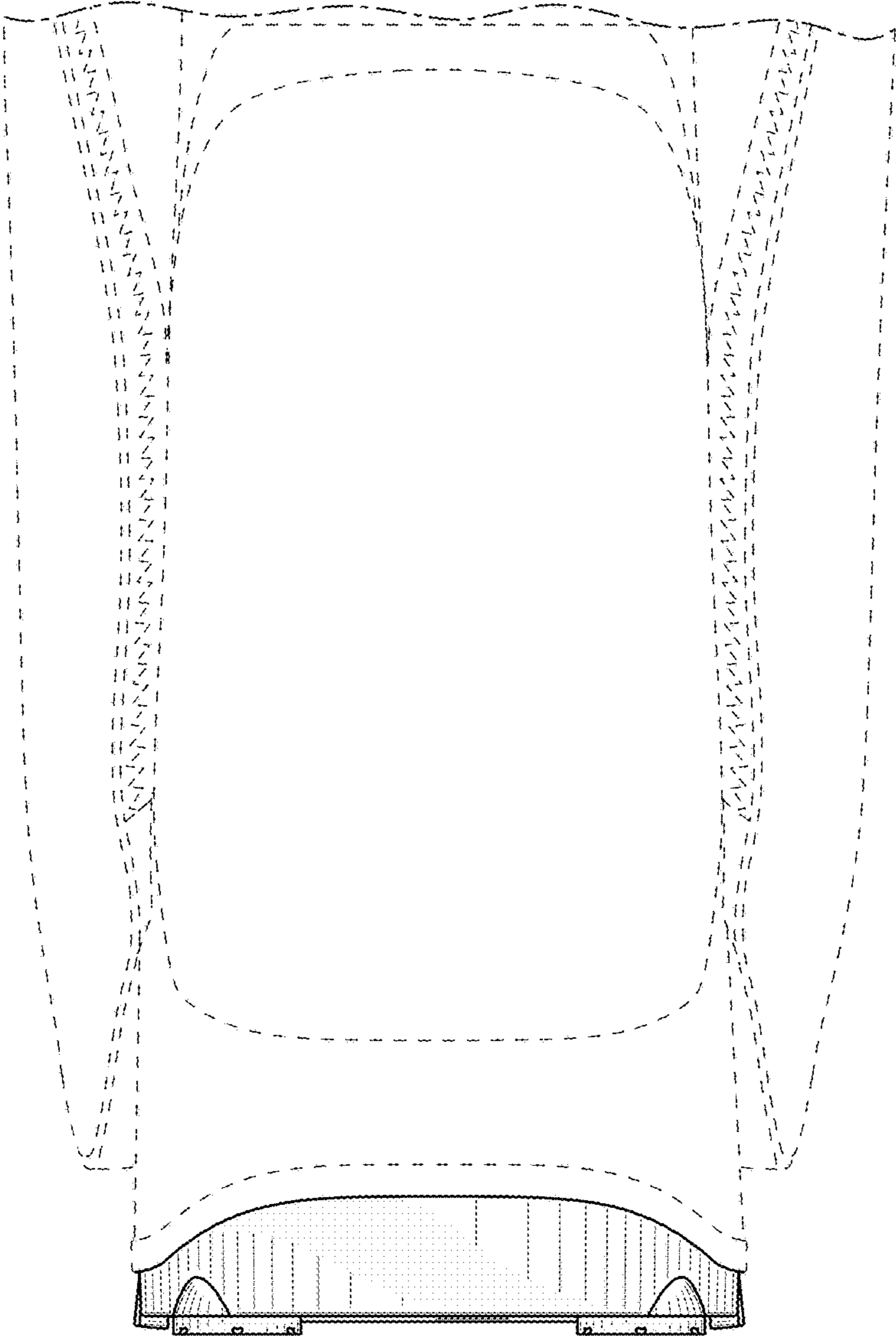

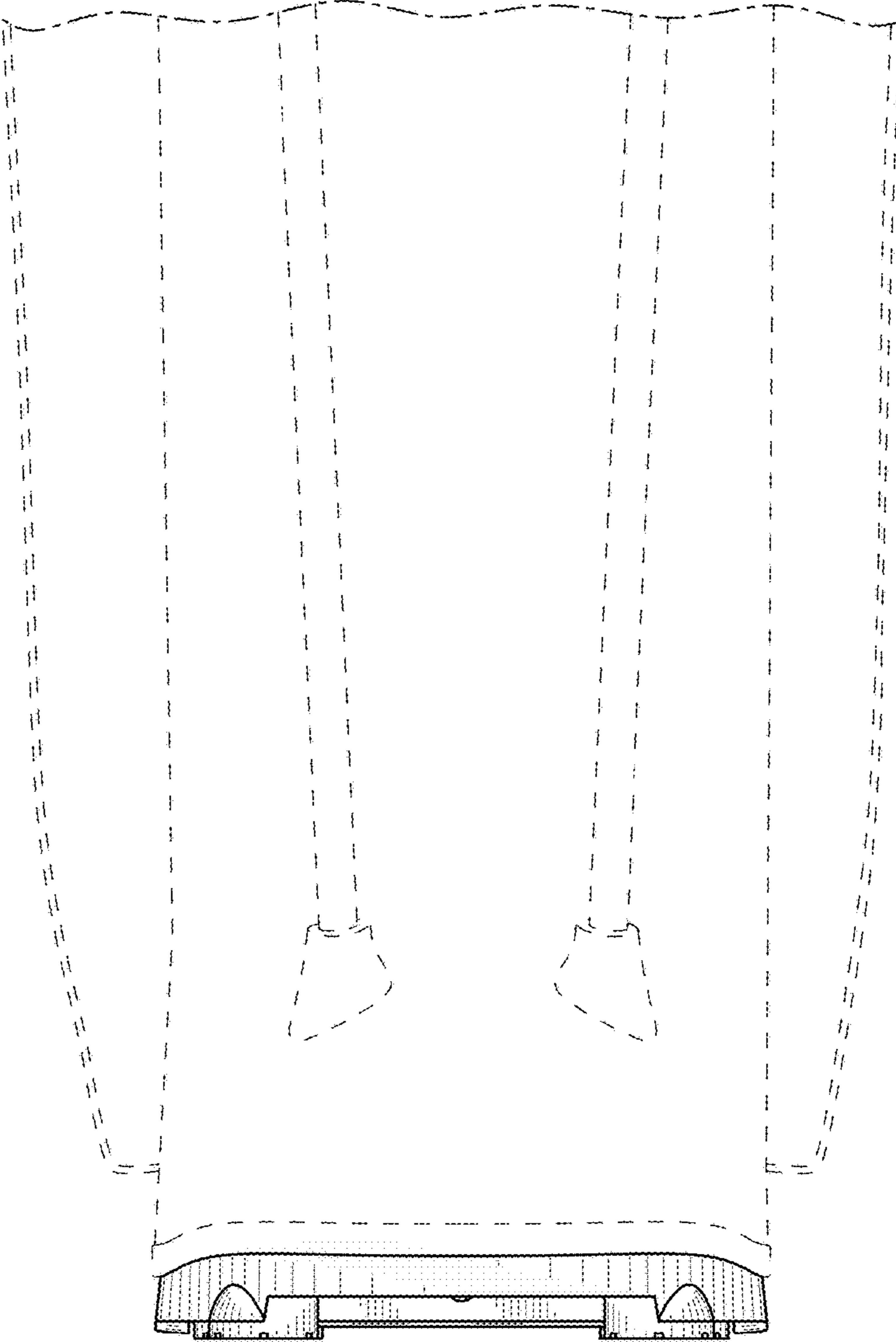

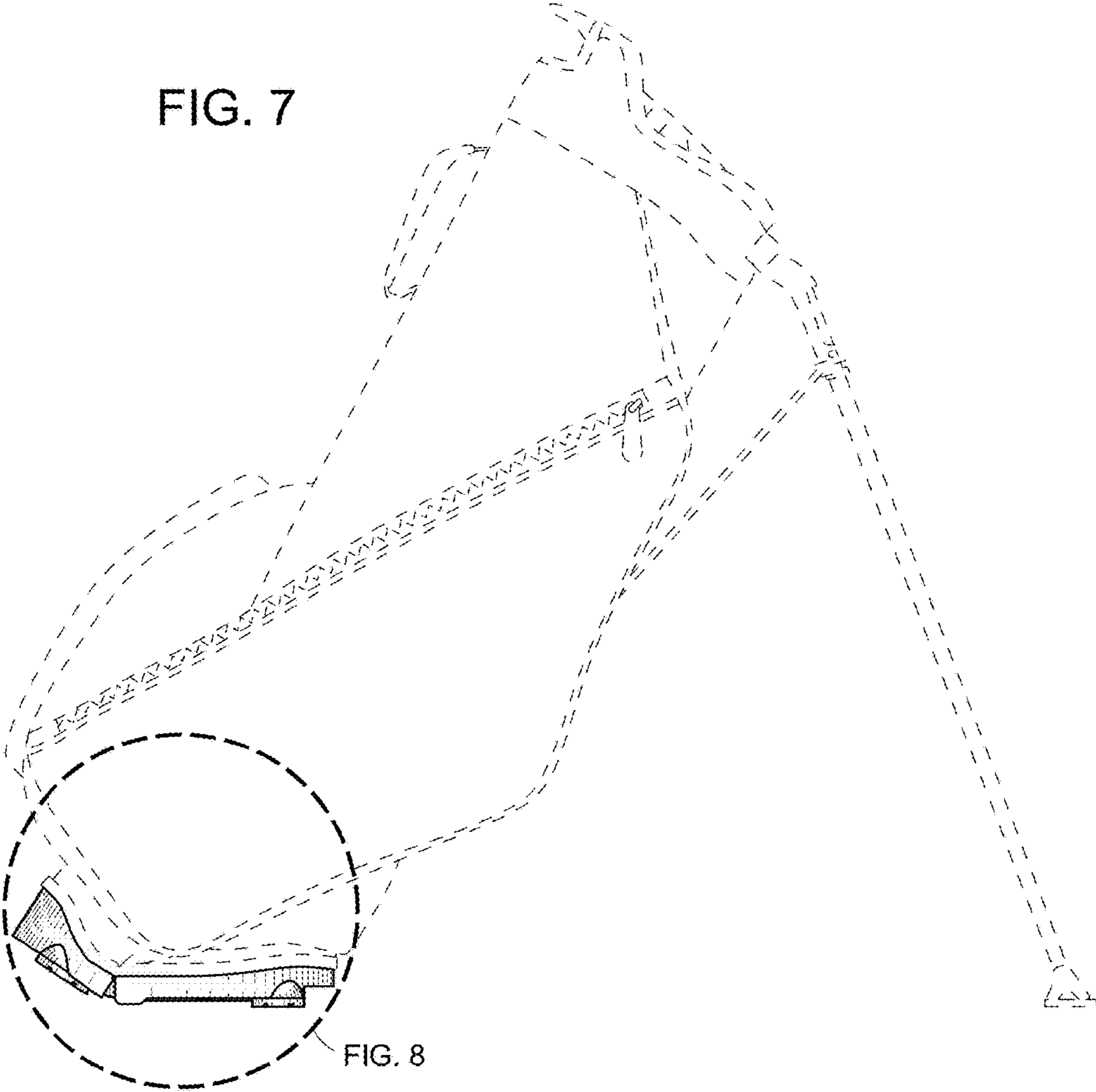

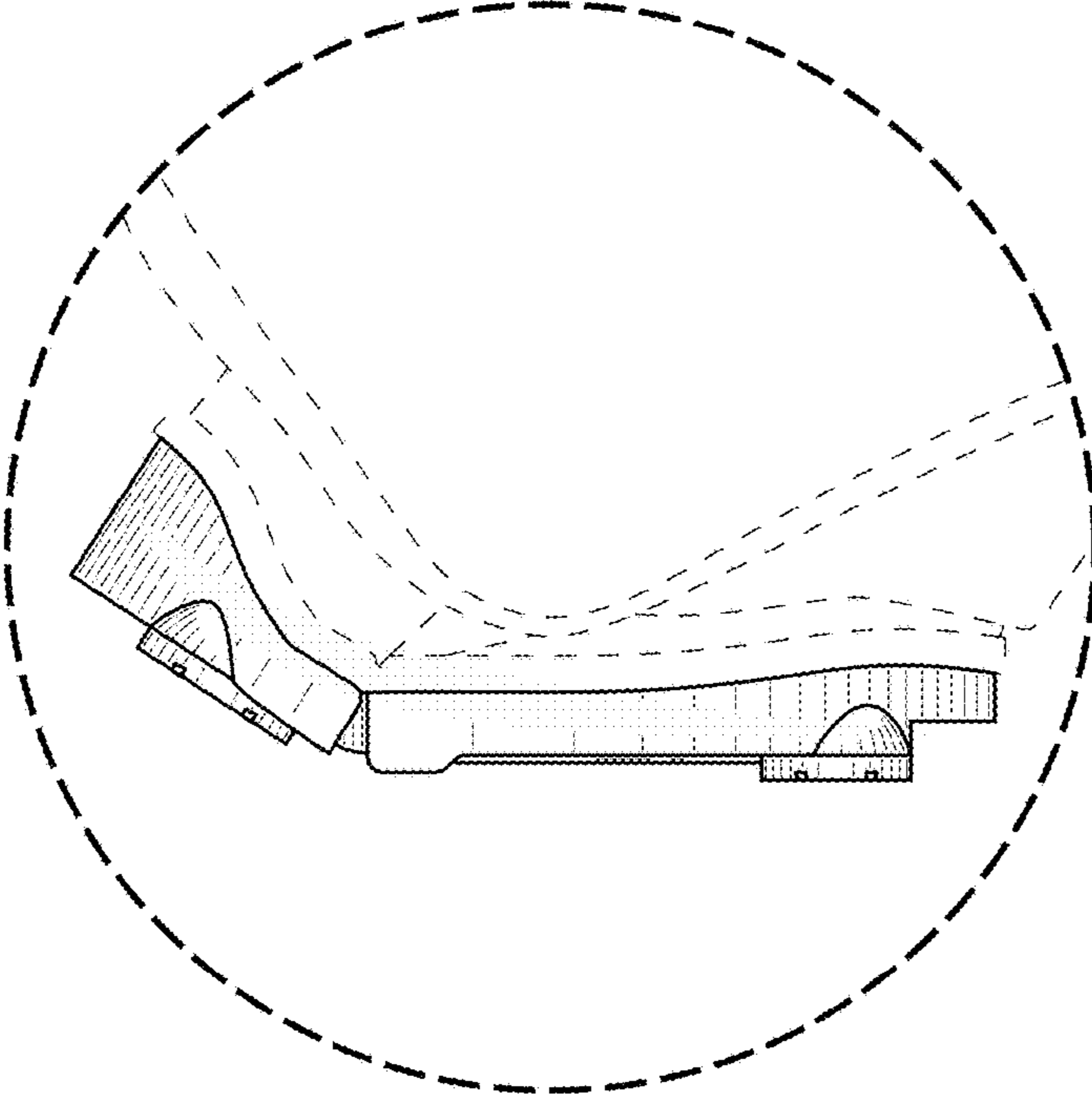
